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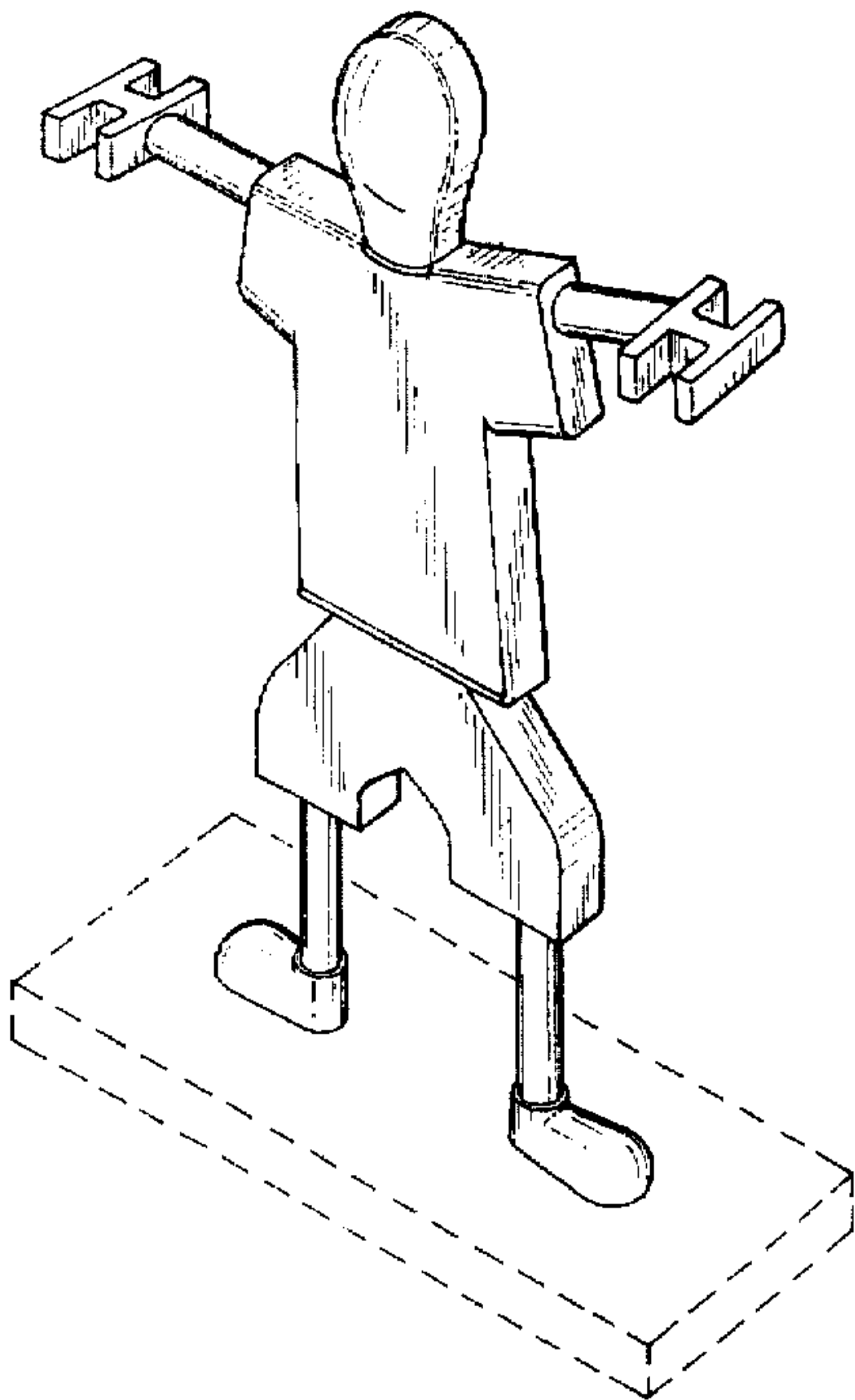
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a toothbrush holder showing my new design (unclaimed environmental structure being shown in broken lines); FIG. 2 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a toothbrush holder showing my new design (unclaimed environmental structure being shown in broken lines); FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof (unclaimed environmental structure being shown in broken lines); FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof (unclaimed environmental structure being shown in broken lines); FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof (unclaimed environmental structure being shown in broken lines); FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof (unclaimed environmental structure being shown by broken lines); FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof (unclaimed environmental structure being shown in broken lines); and, FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof. 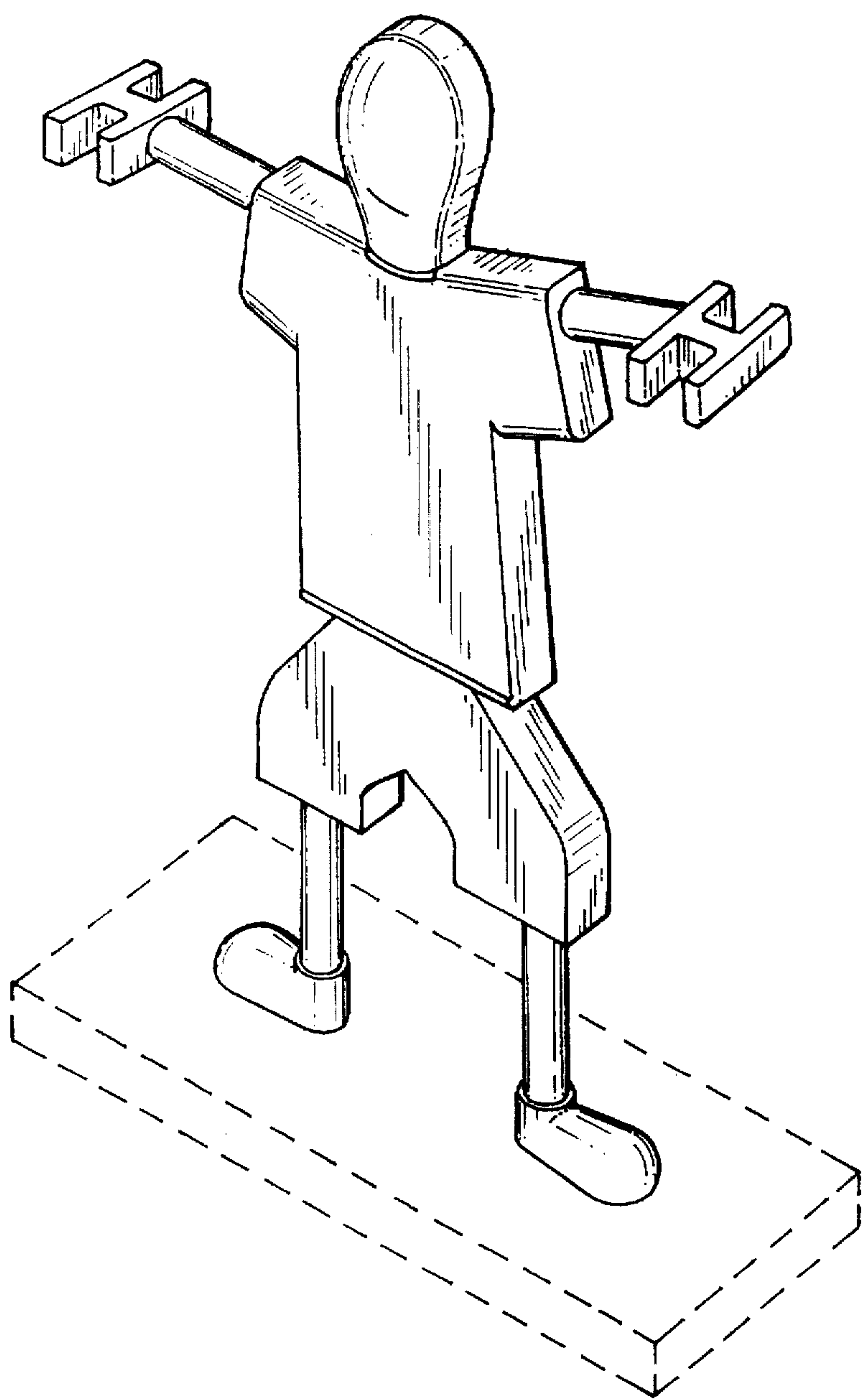

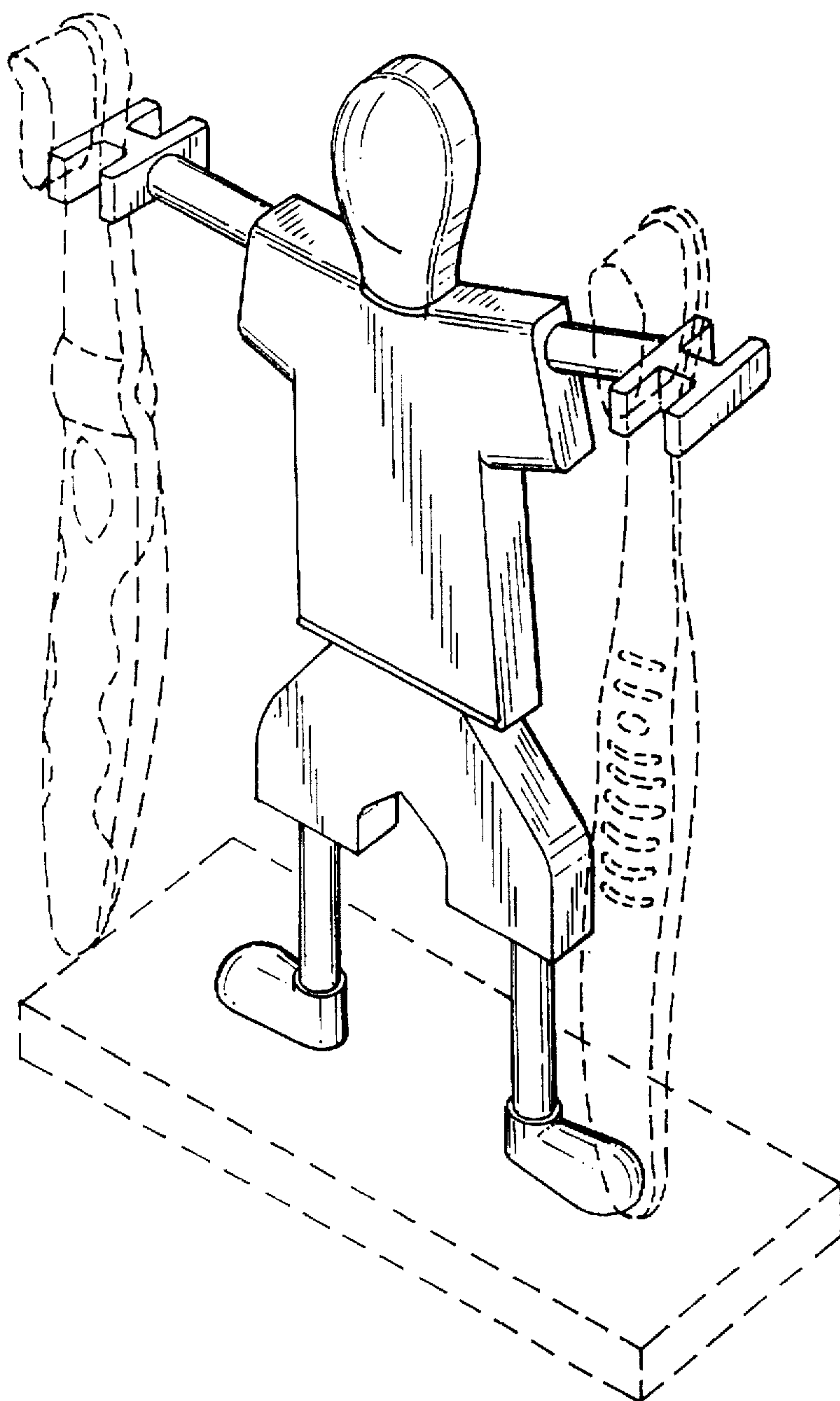

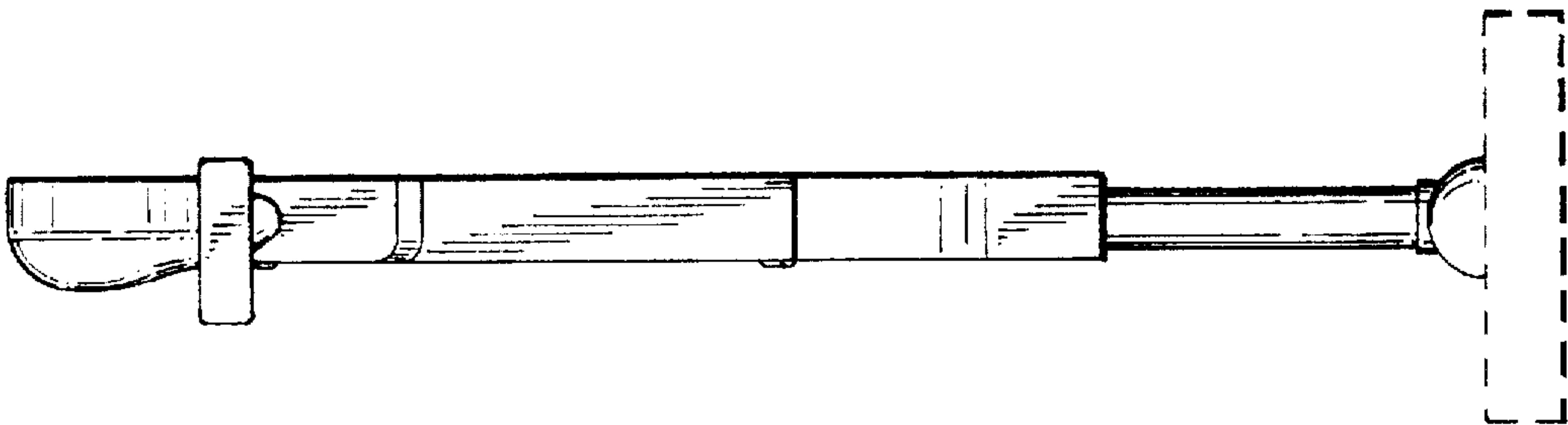

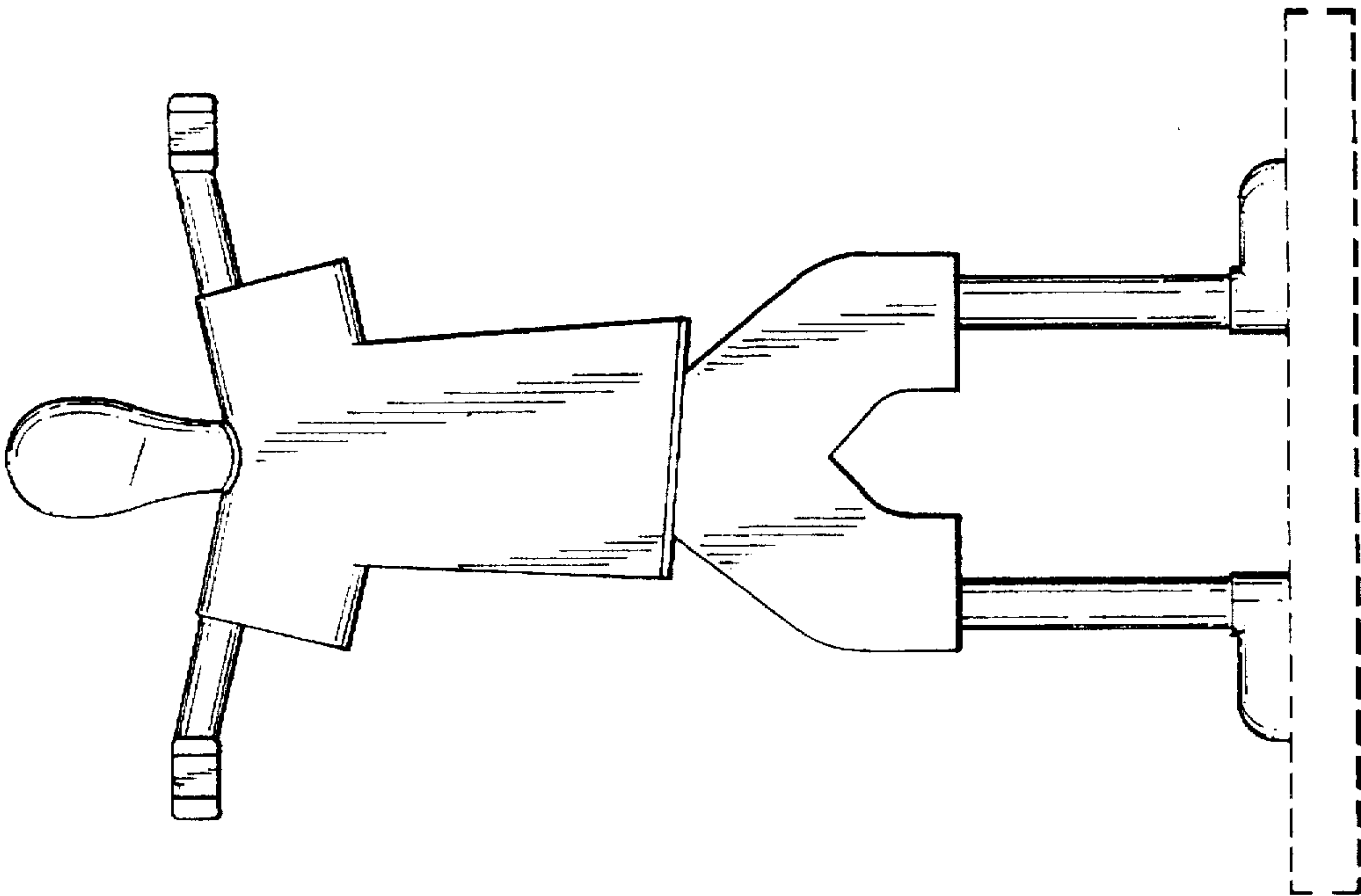

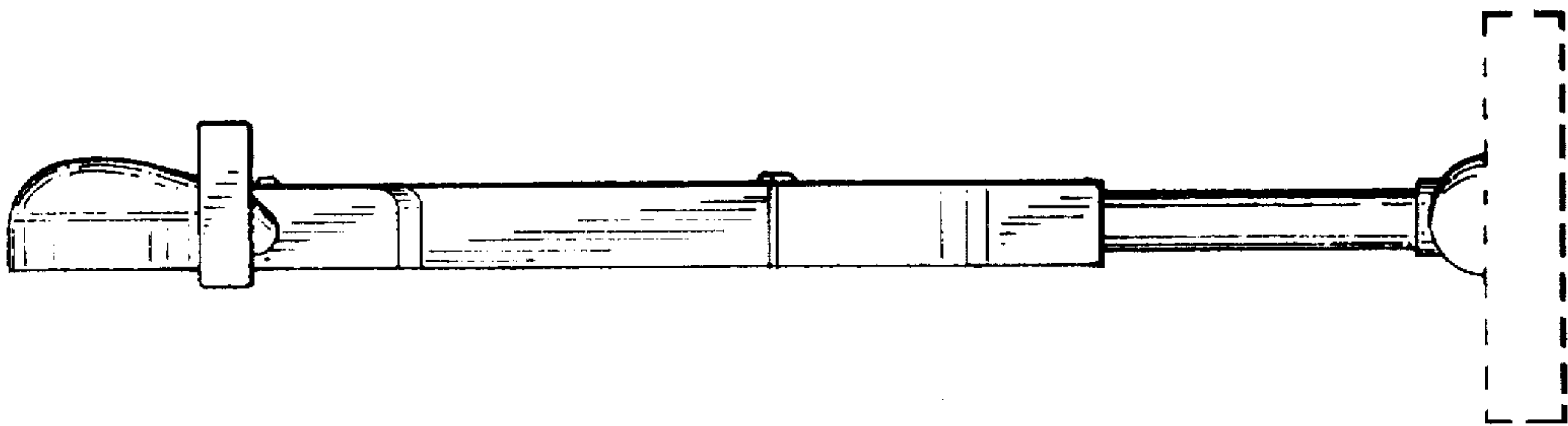

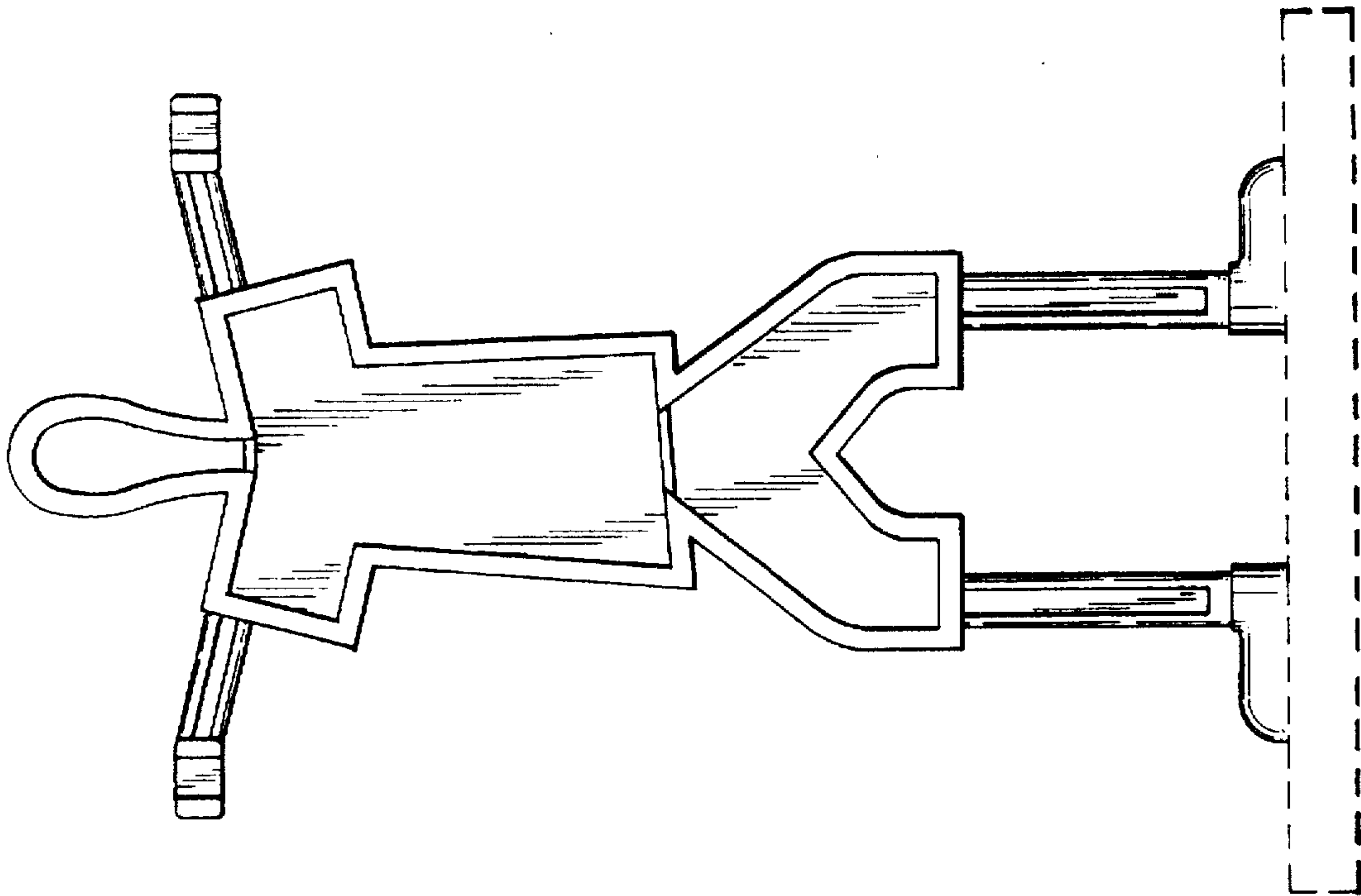

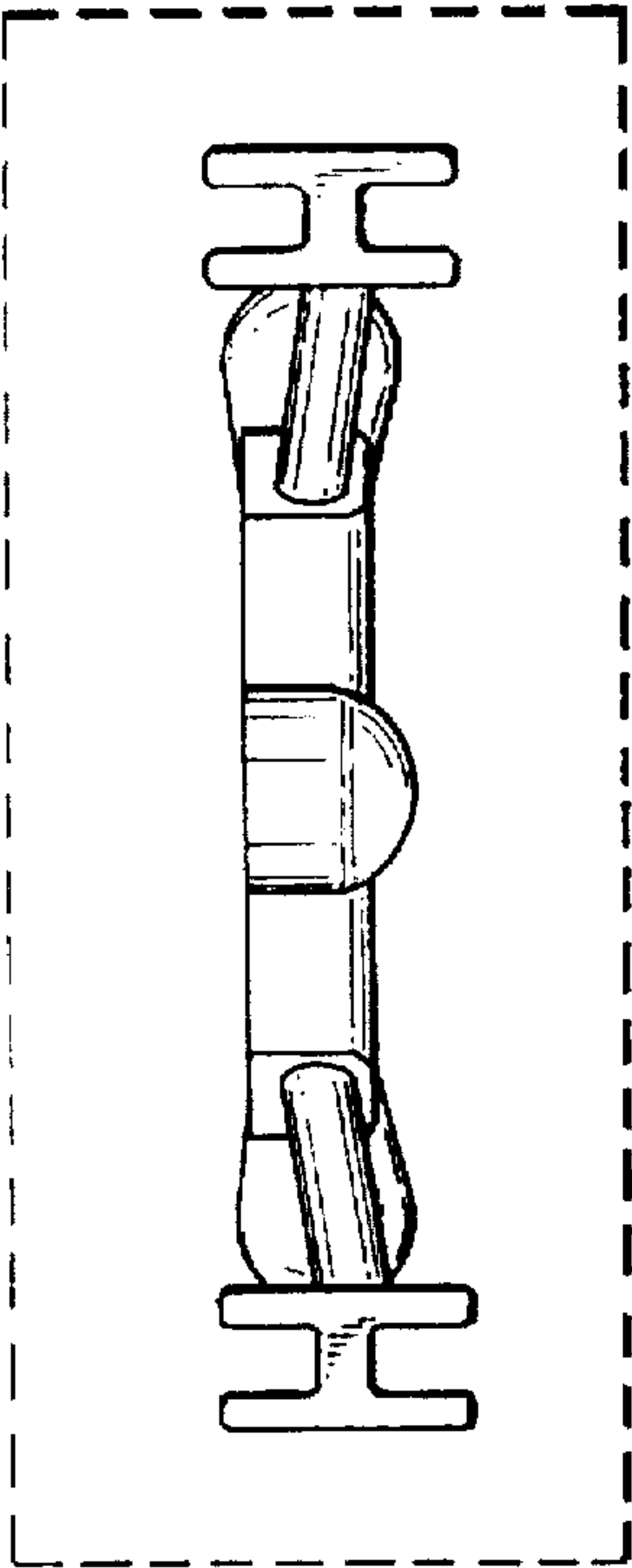

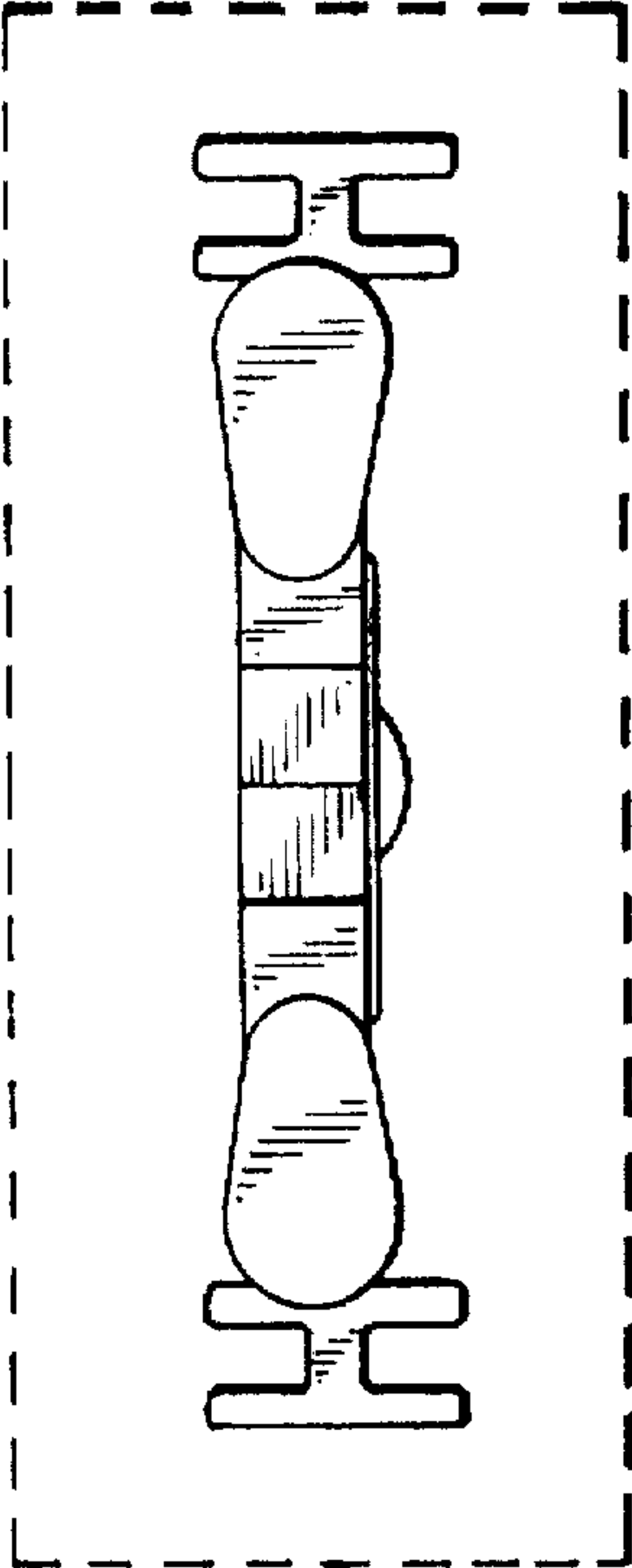
