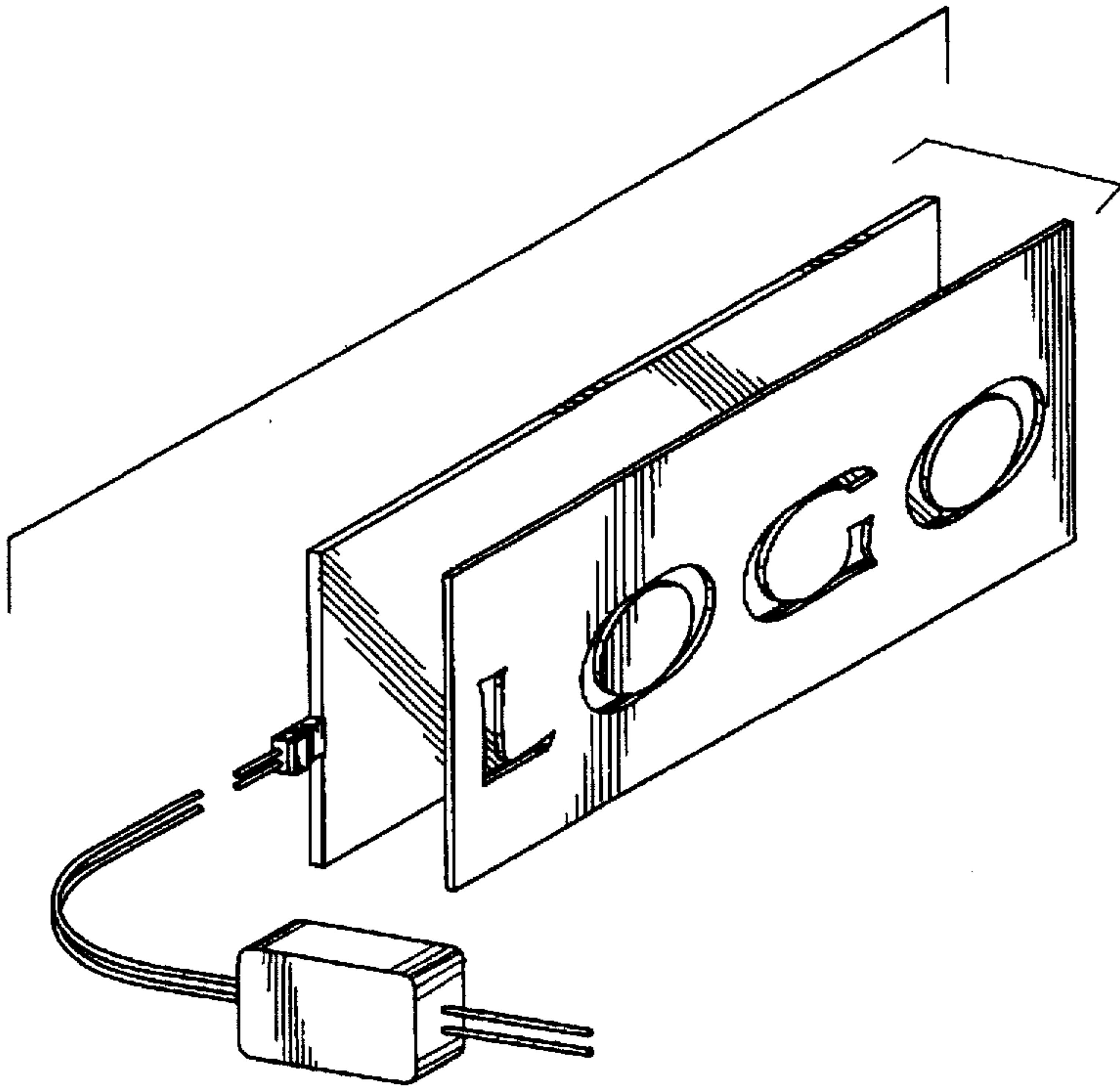

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of an illuminated sign showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a right view thereof.
The wires are fragmentarily shown to indicate indefinite length.

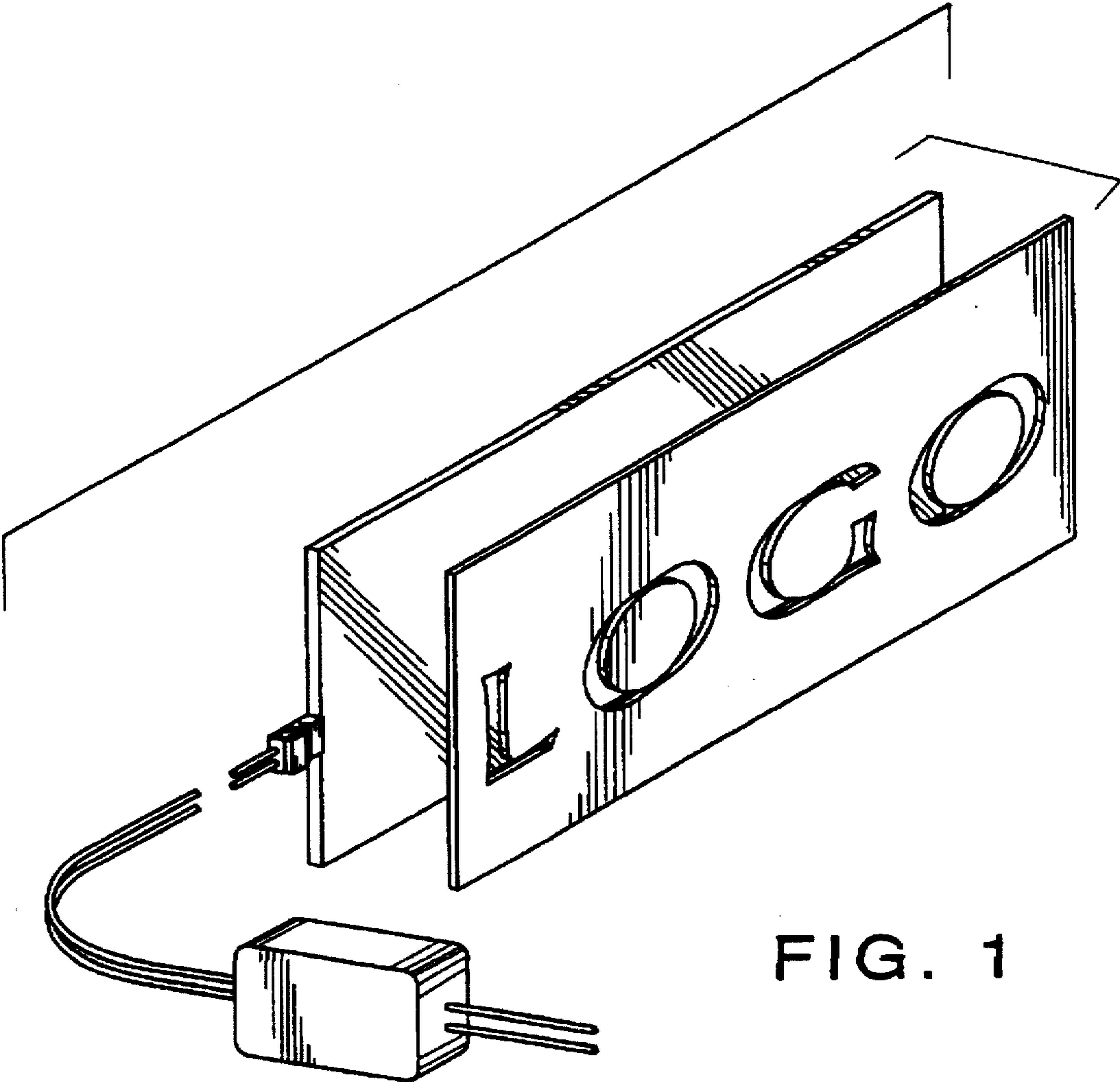

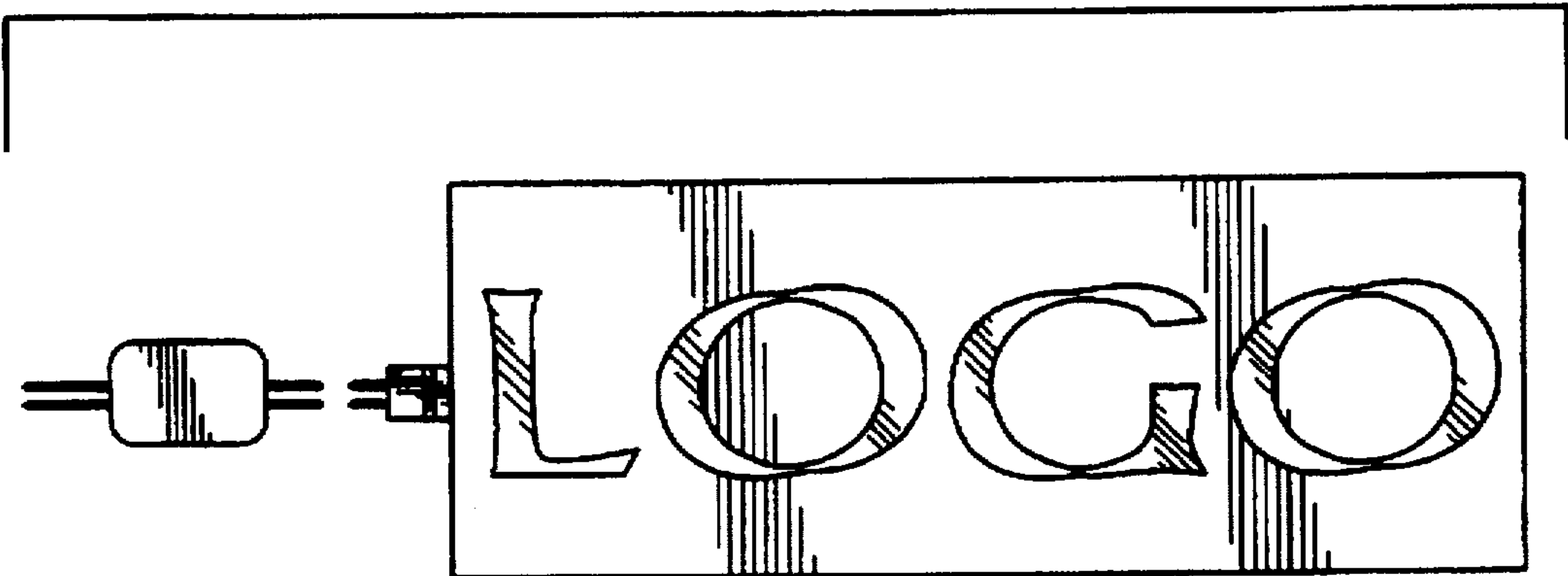

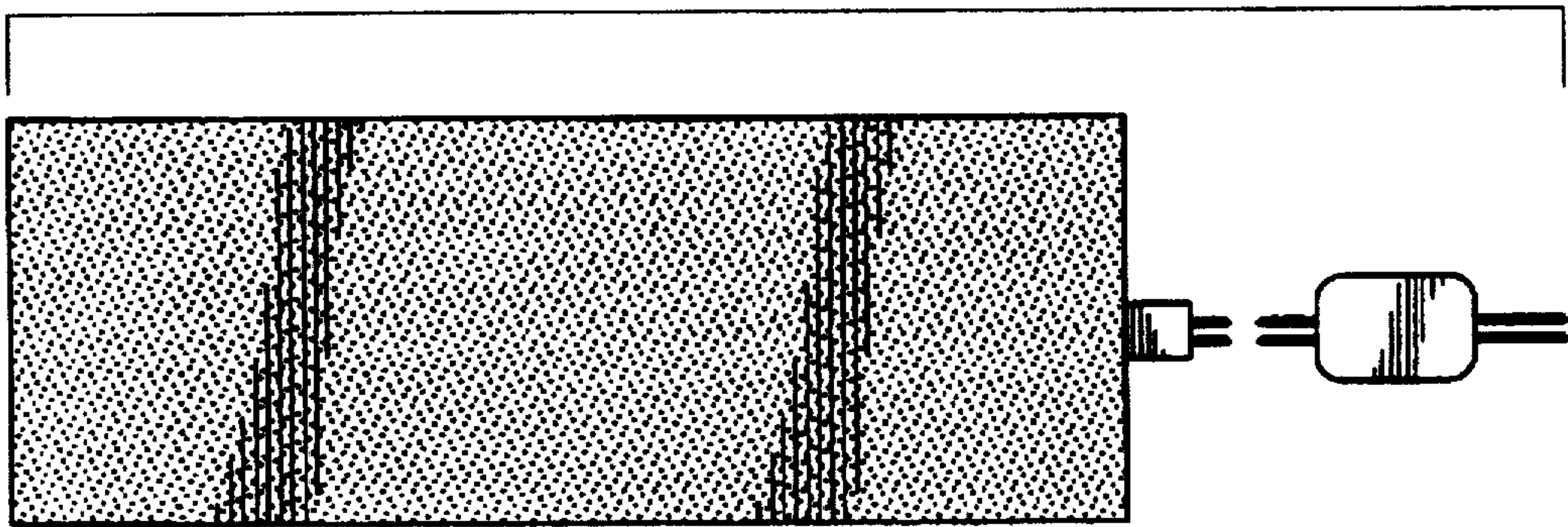

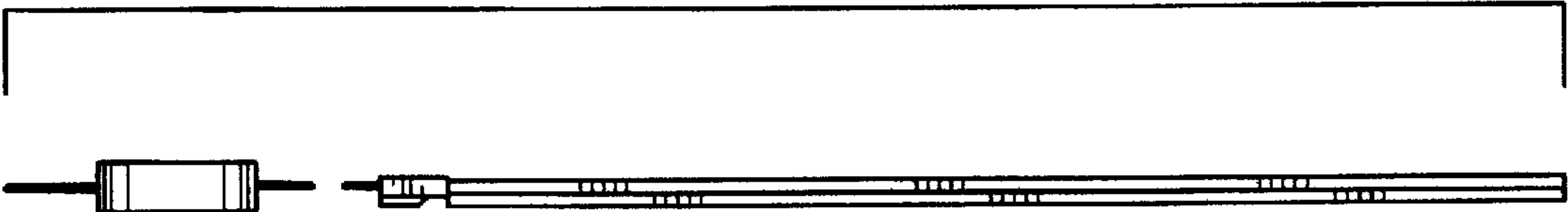

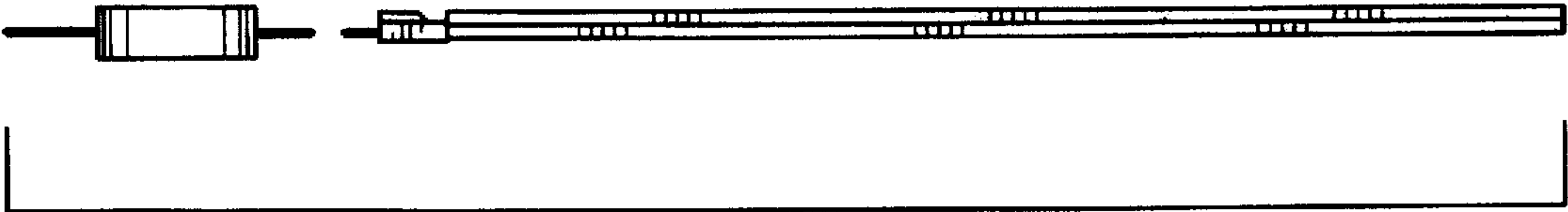
