FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

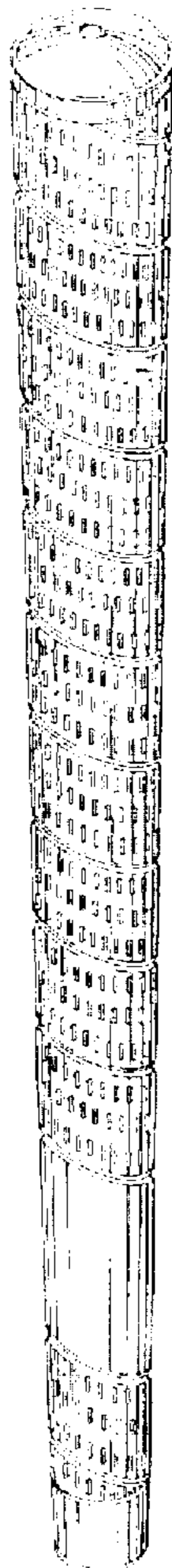
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the undisclosed opposite side being a mirror image;

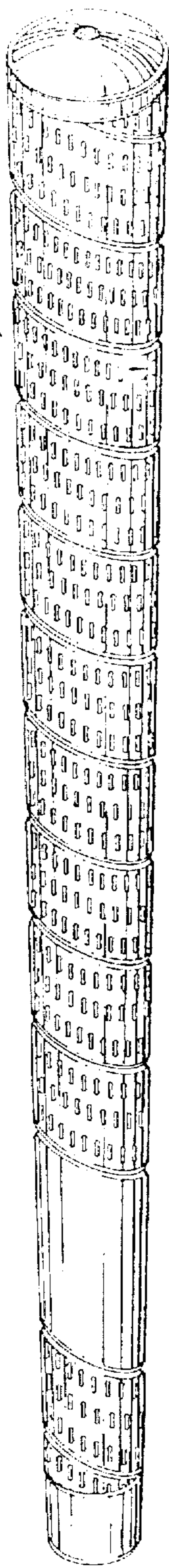

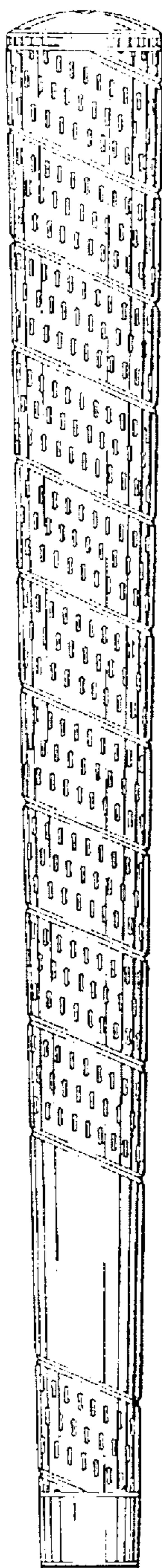

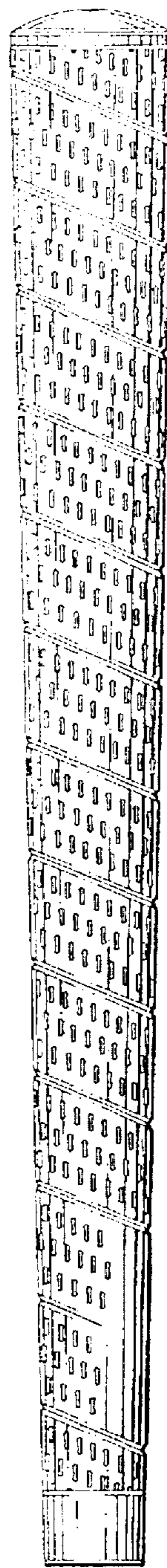

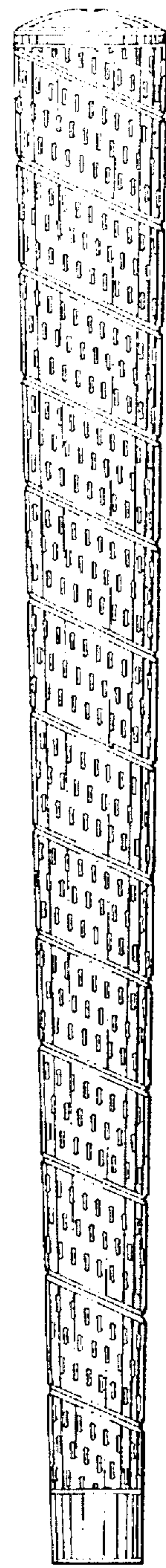

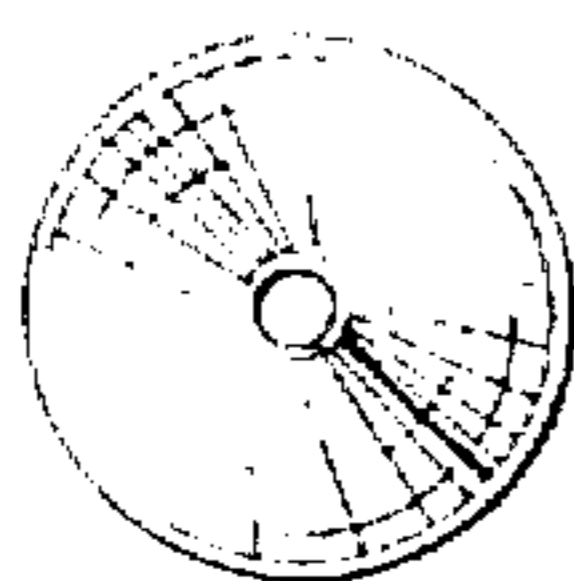

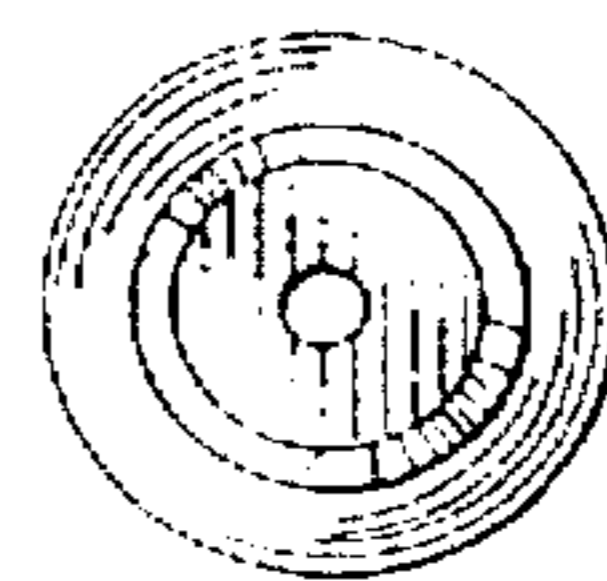
