[57] **CLAIM**

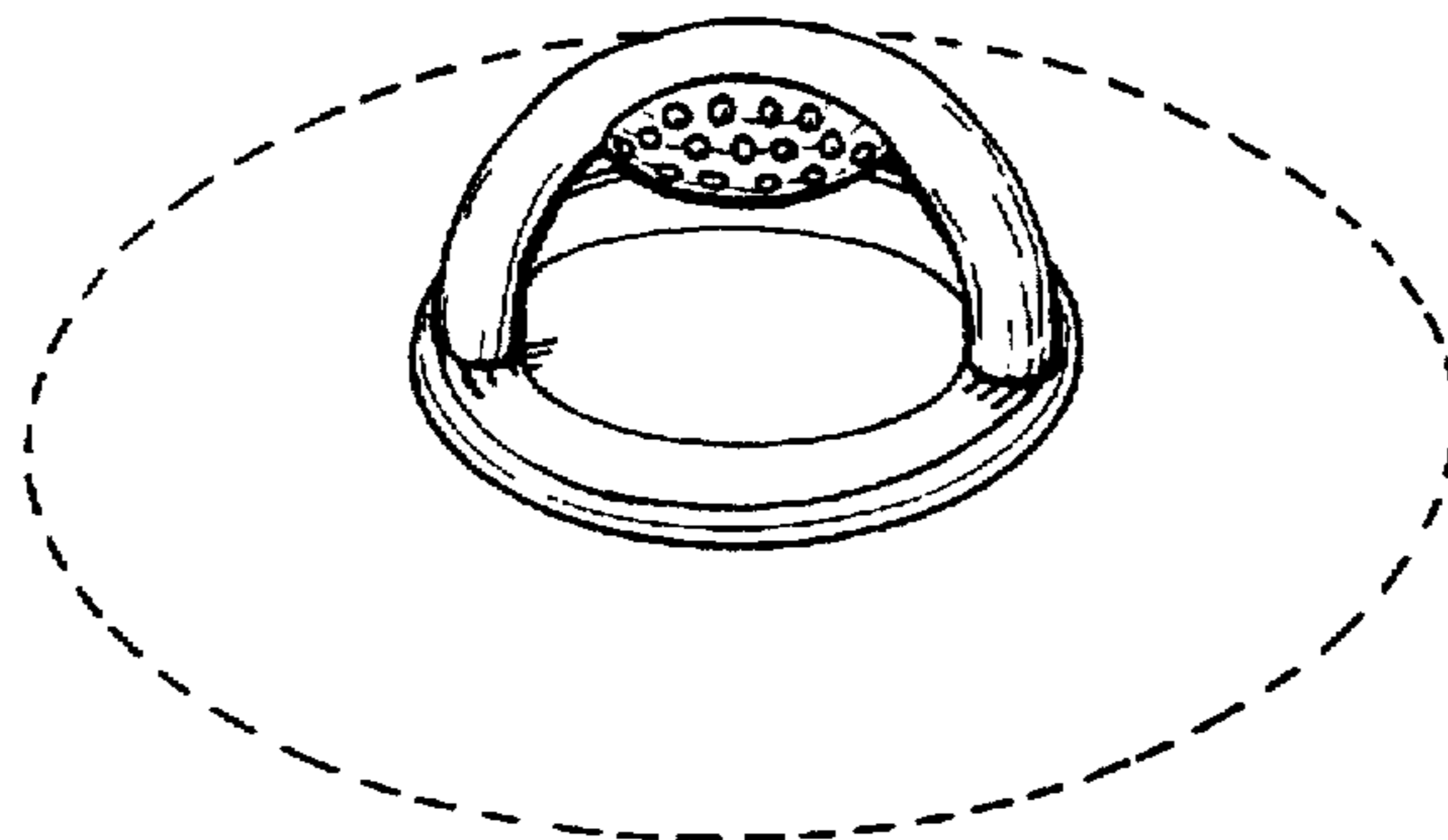
The ornamental design for a lid handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side, top perspective view of the invention showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof, the front being a mirror image of the rear;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side; and,
 FIG. 6 is a side, top perspective view of the invention connected to a sauce pan lid, which is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

The broken line showing of a kettle lid in FIGS. 1-5 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

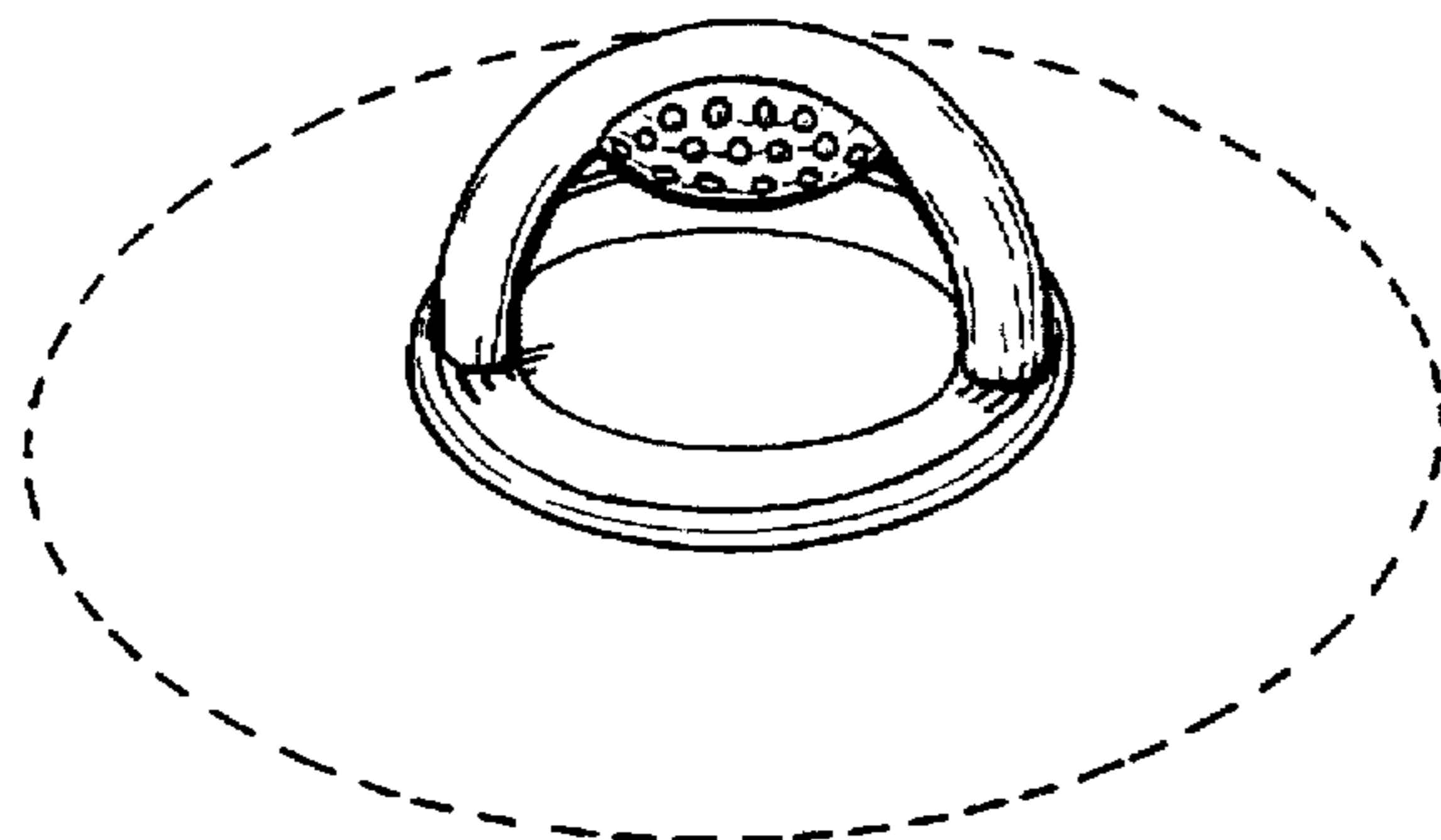

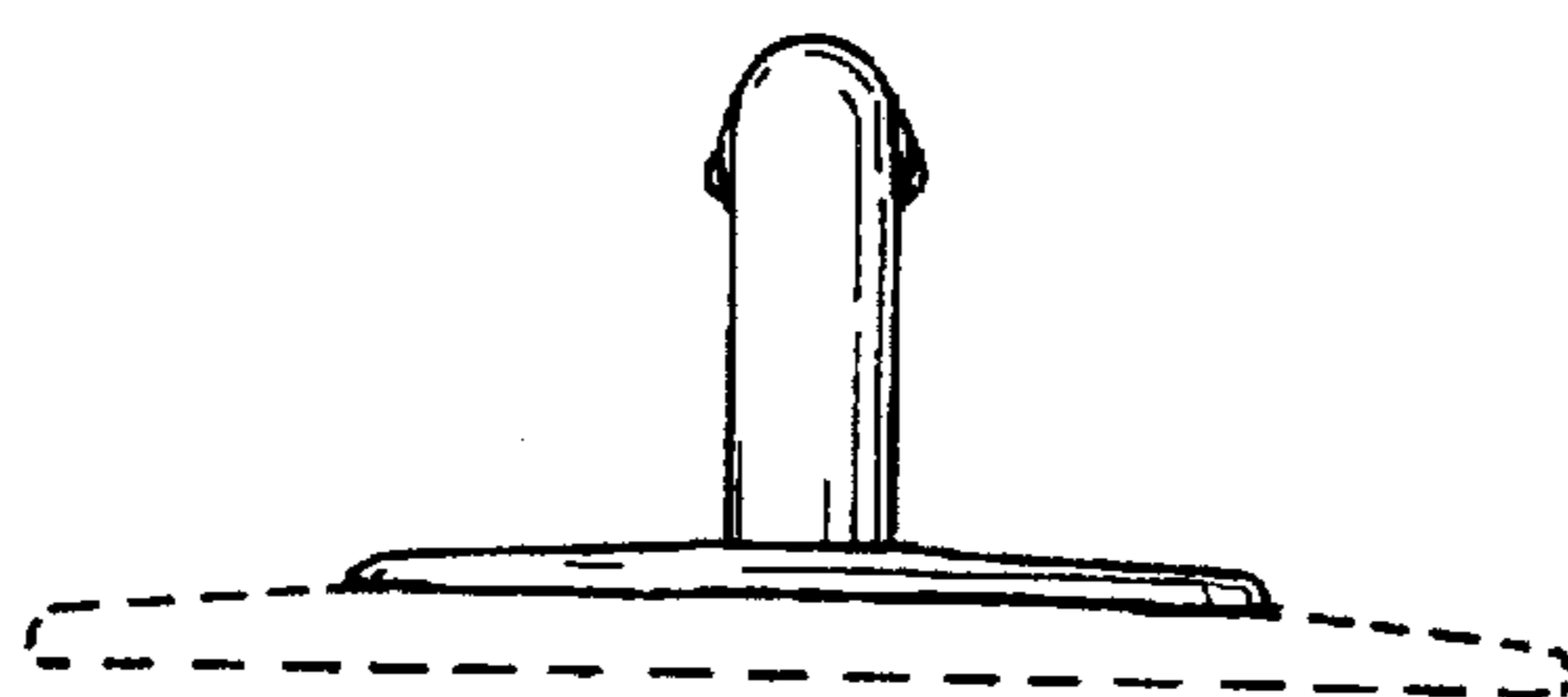

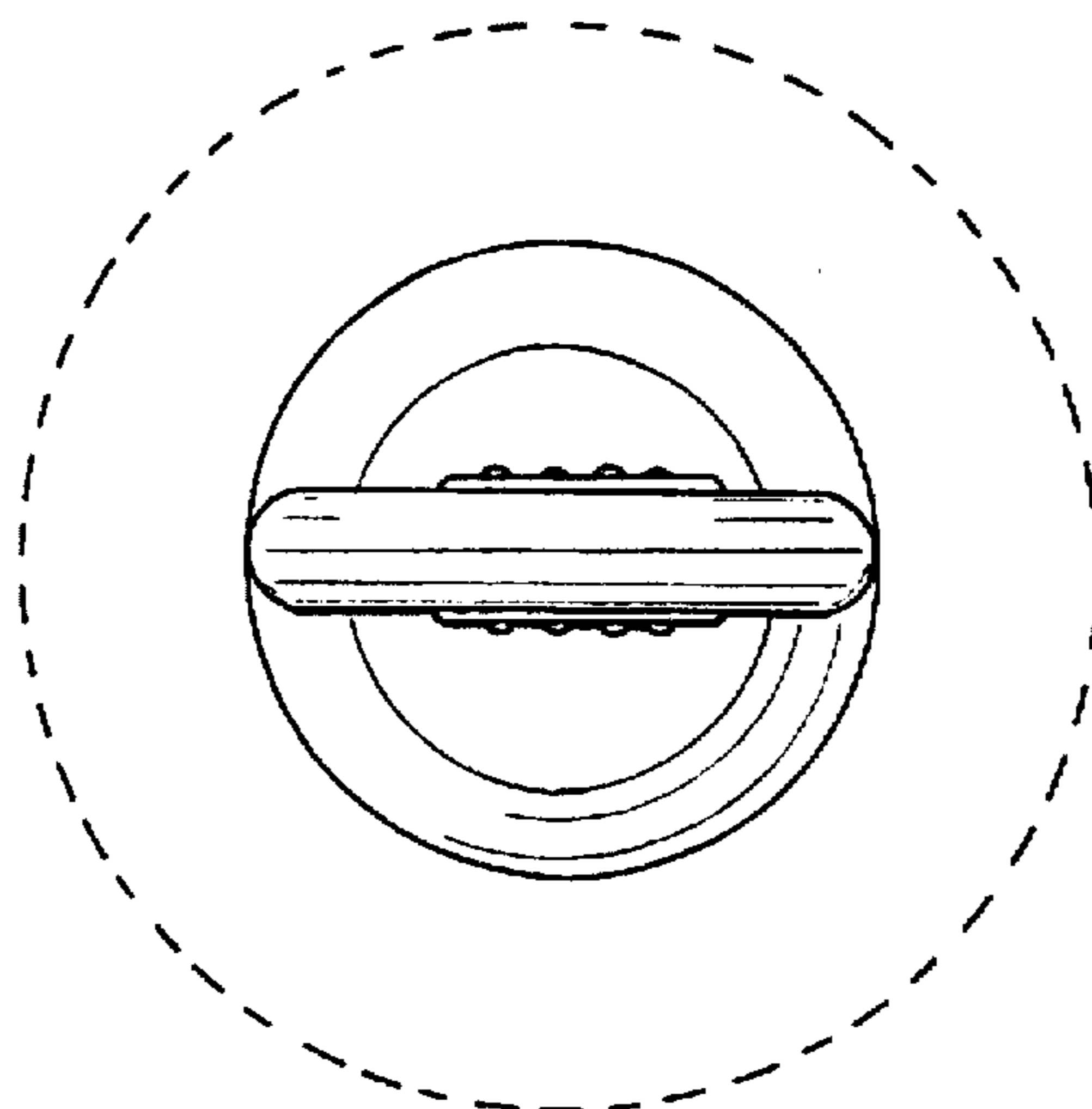

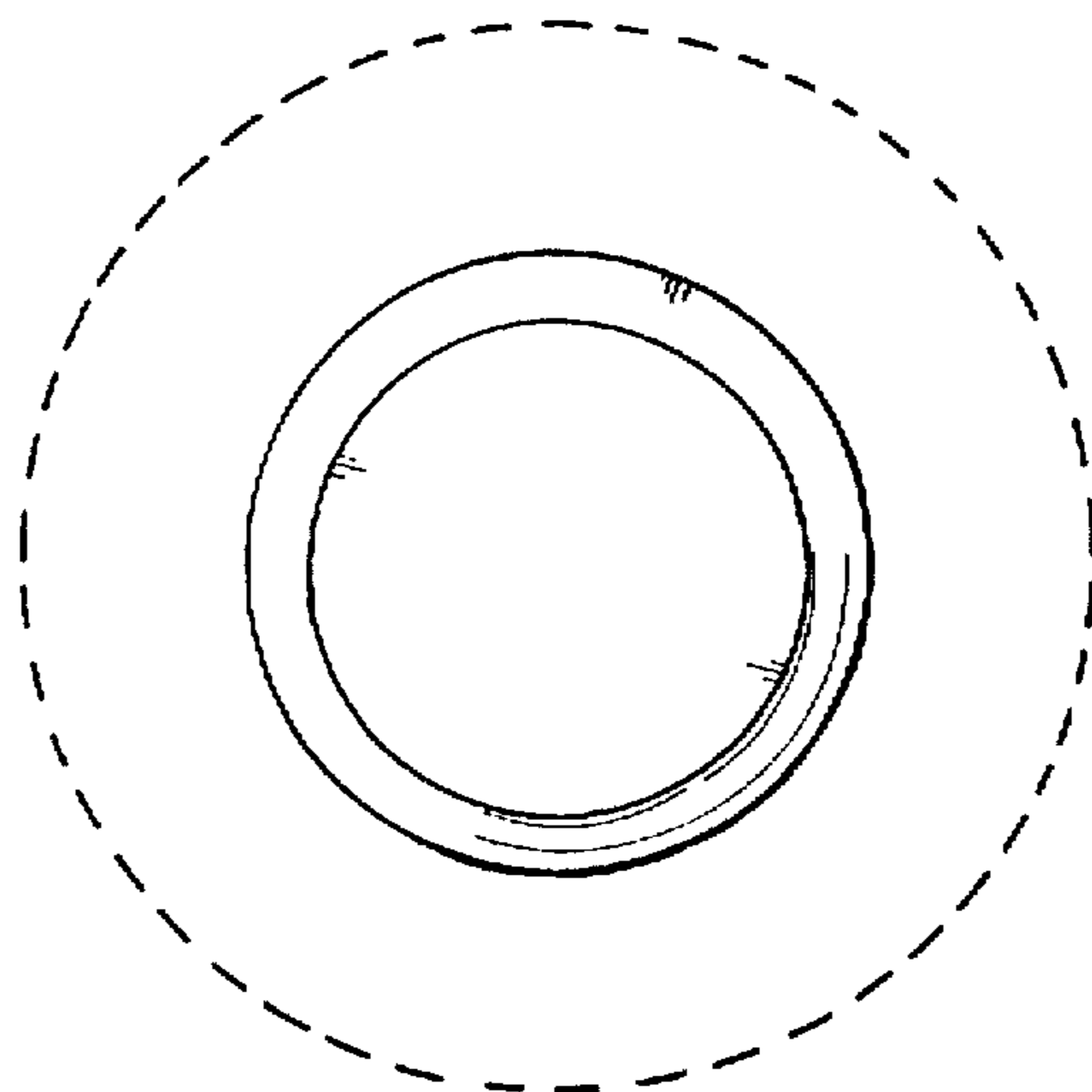

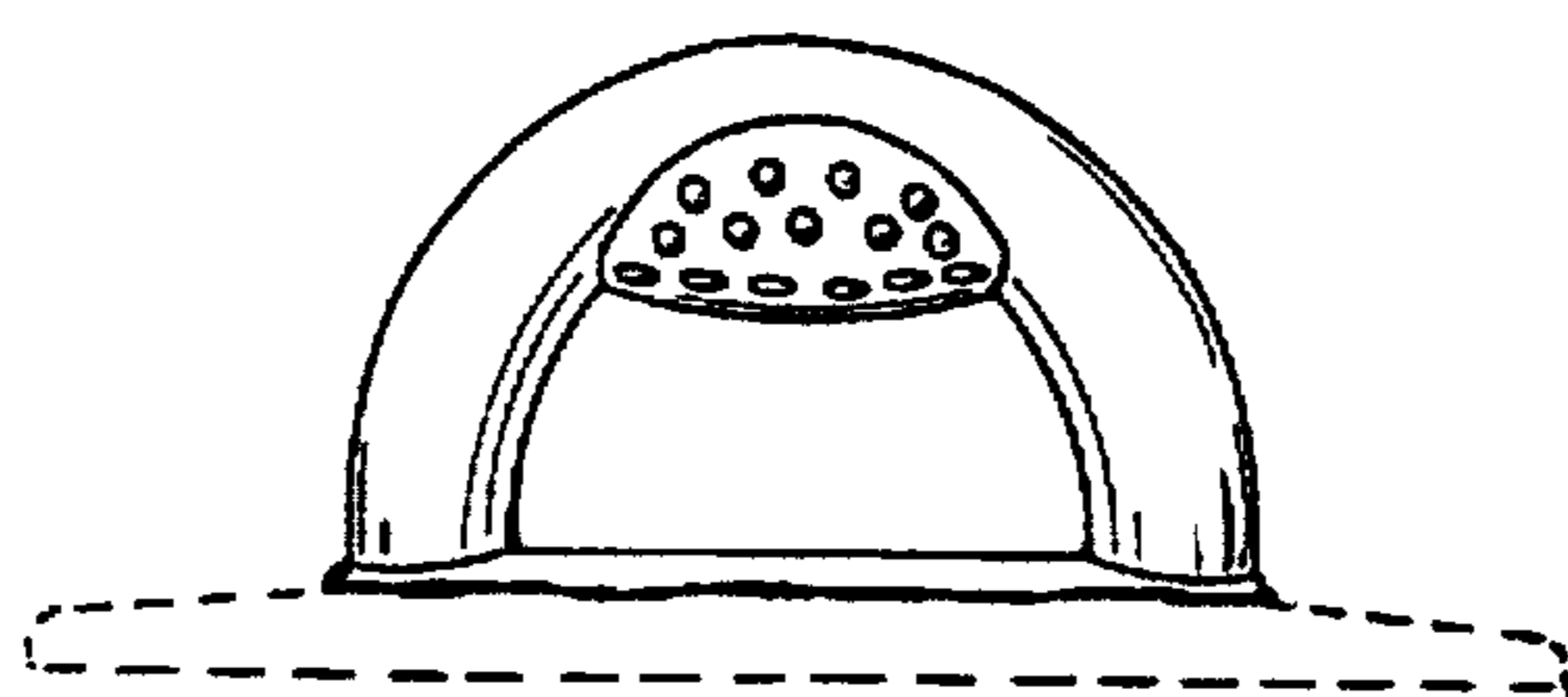

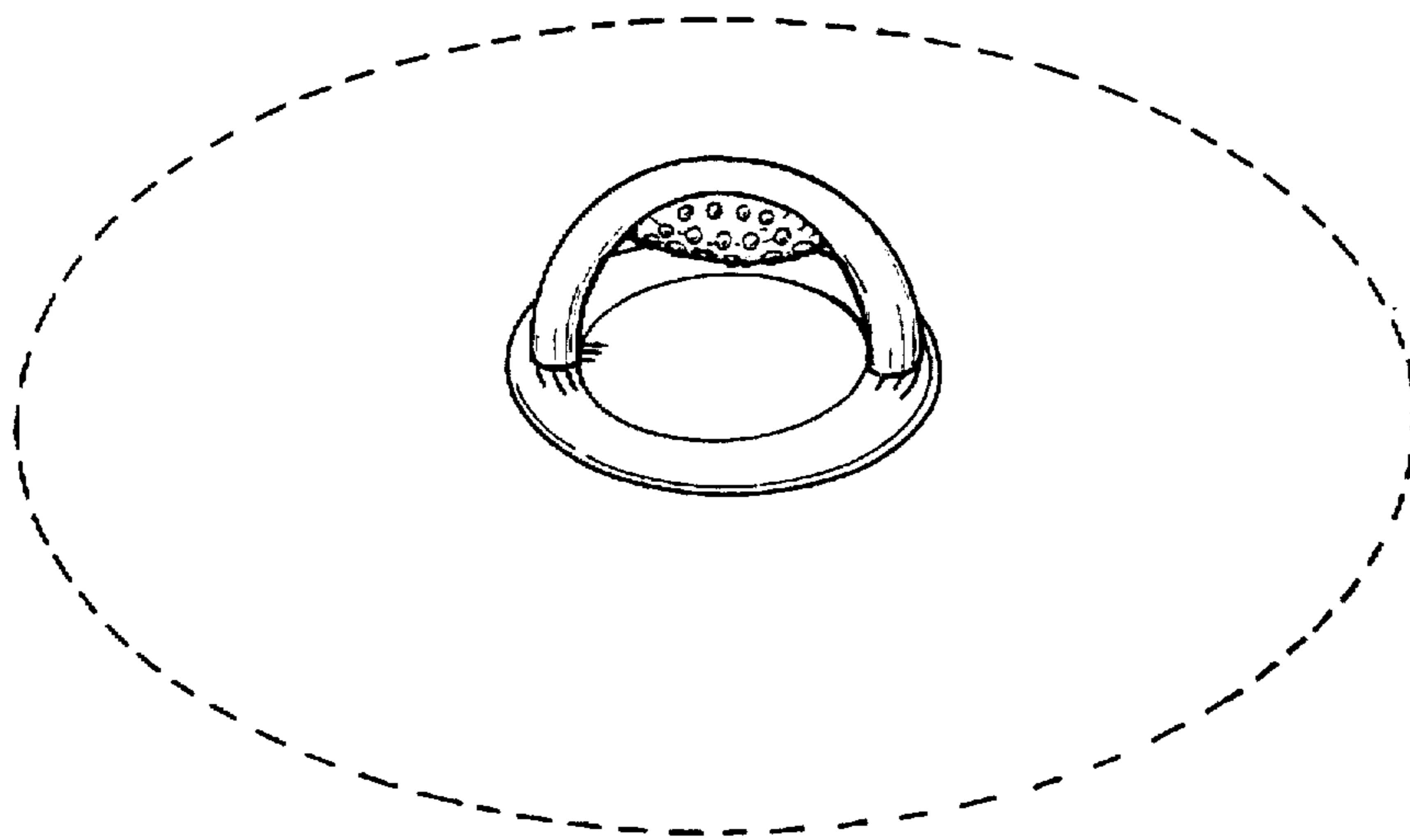
