DESCRIPTION

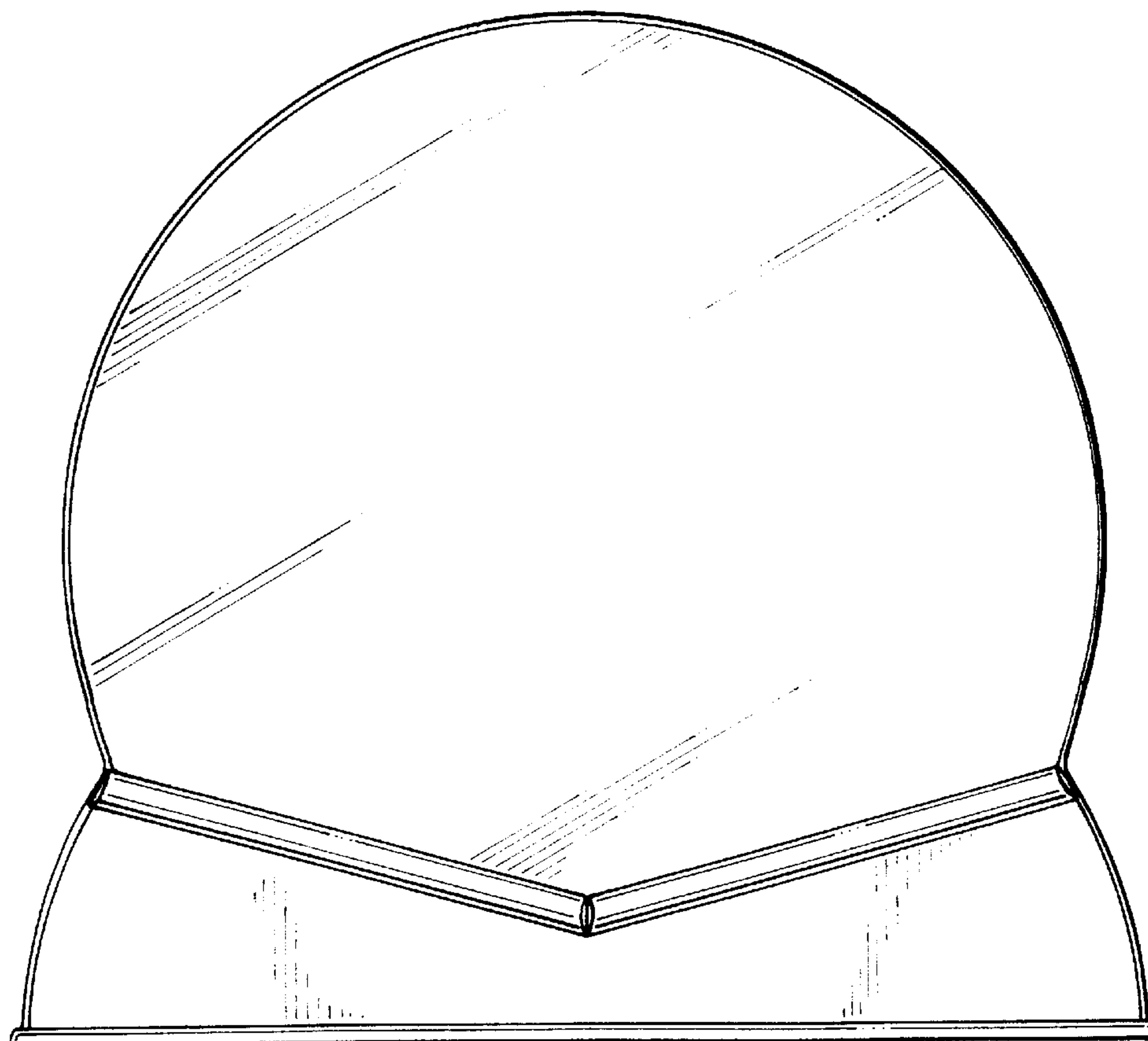
FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a mirror embodying our new design;

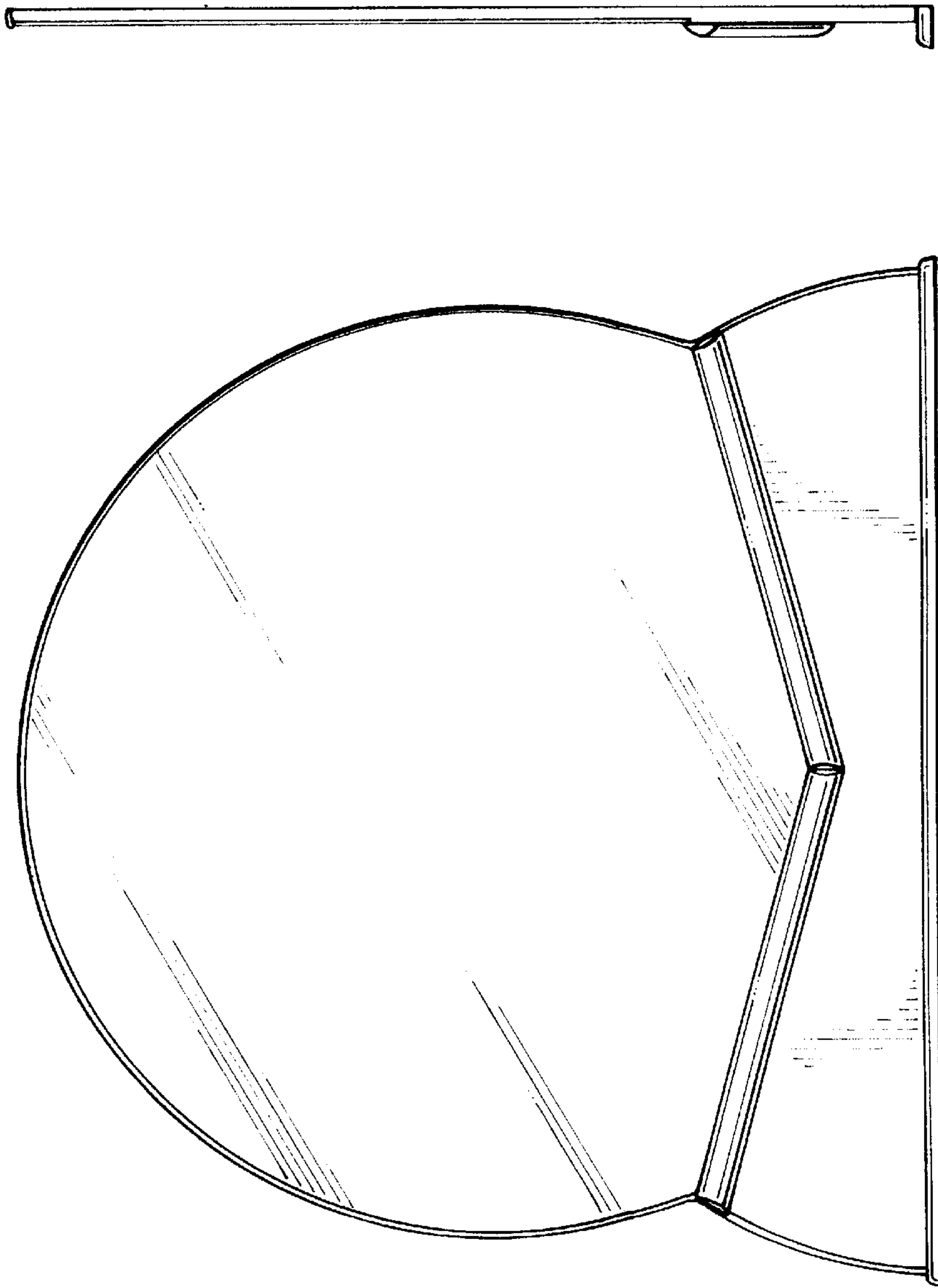

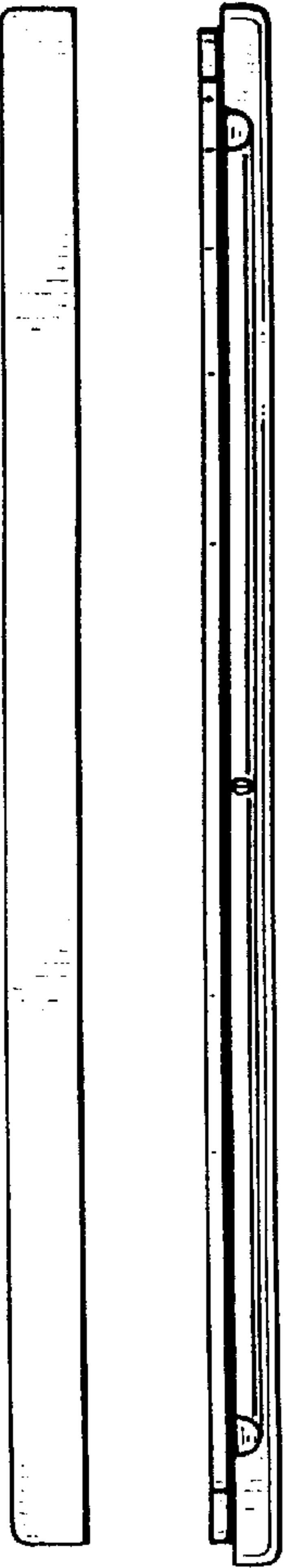
