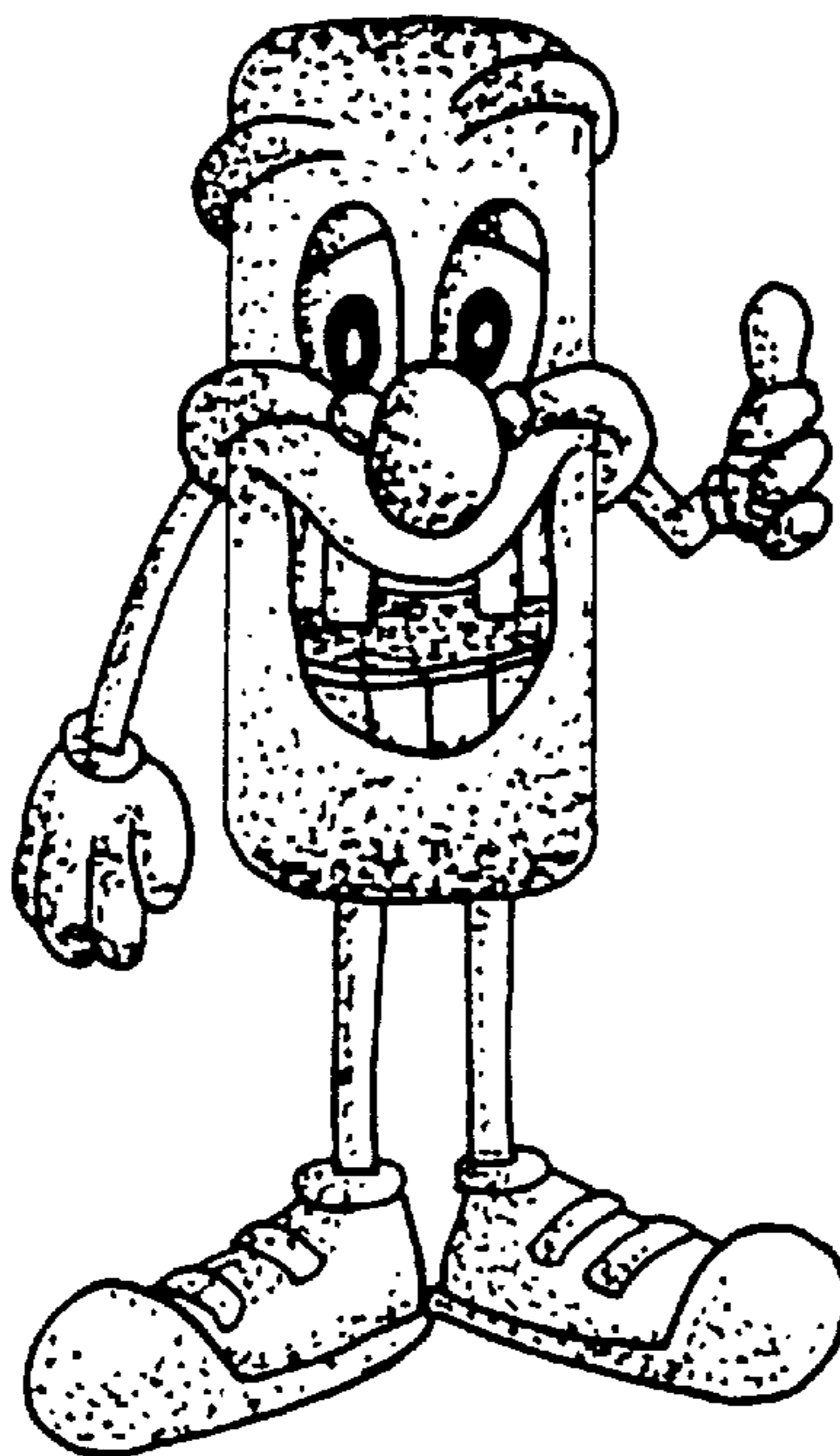
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hockey puck character, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a hockey puck character showing our design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of a hockey puck character;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the hockey puck character;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the hockey puck character;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the hockey puck character; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the hockey puck character.

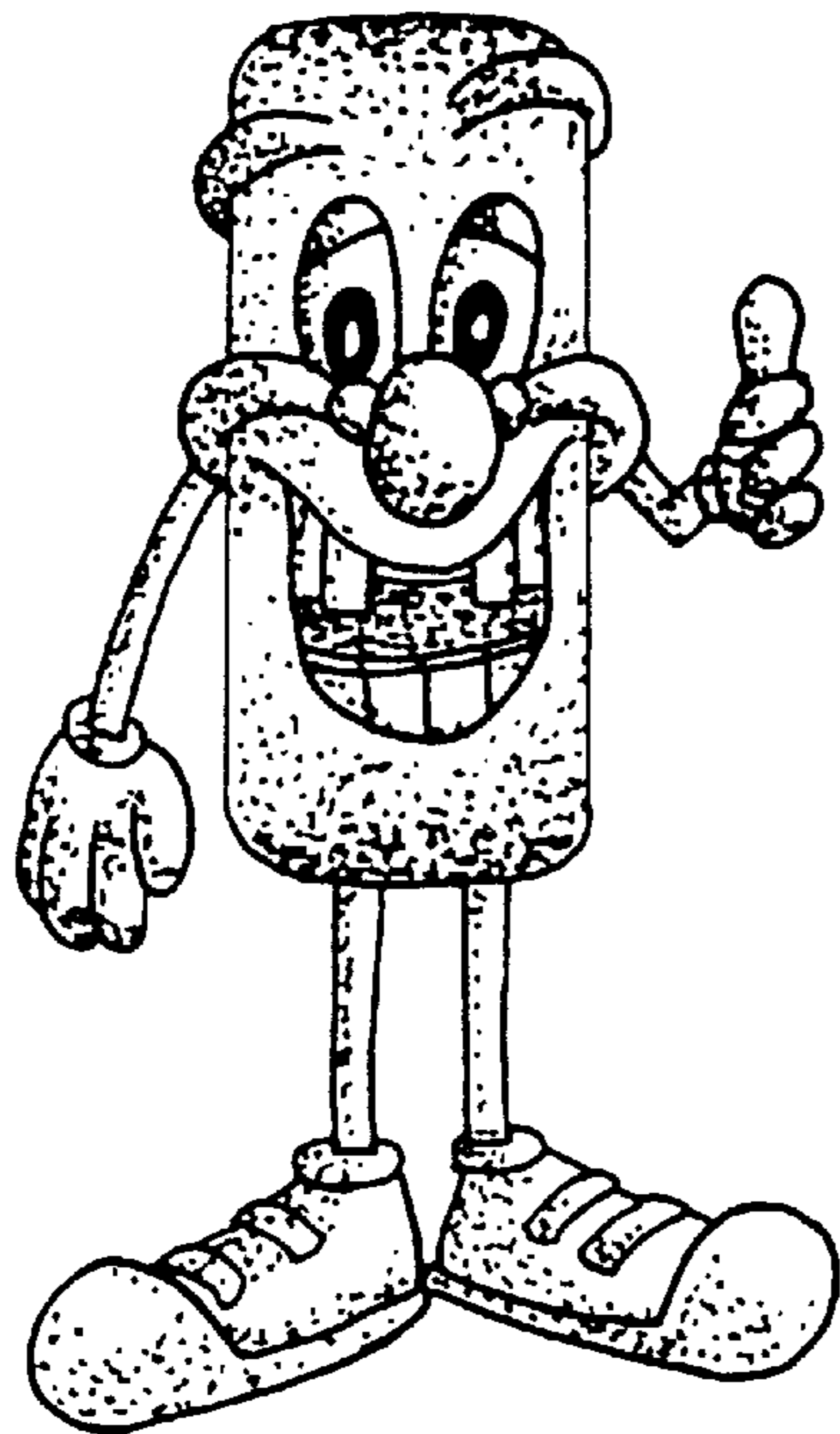

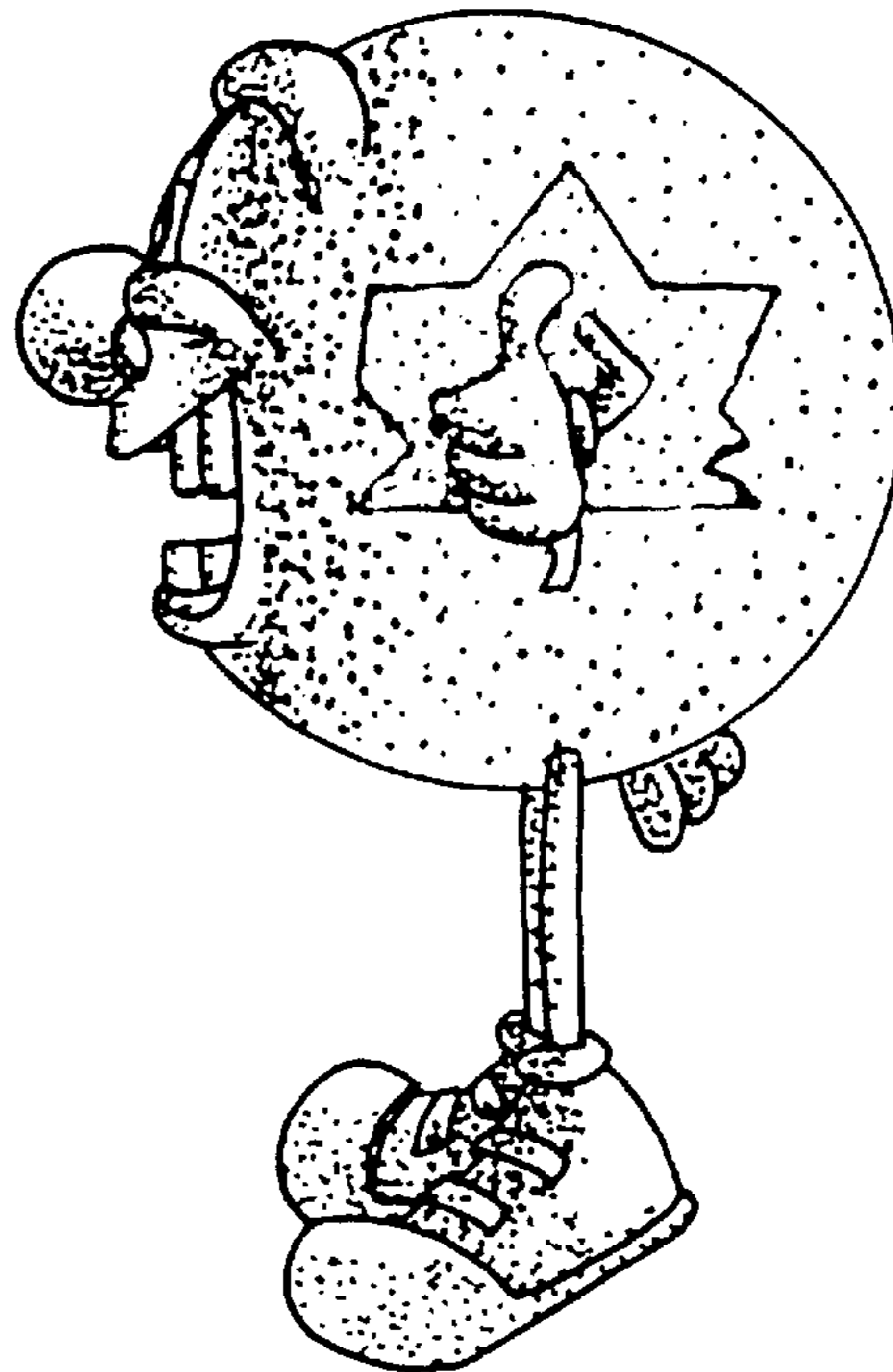

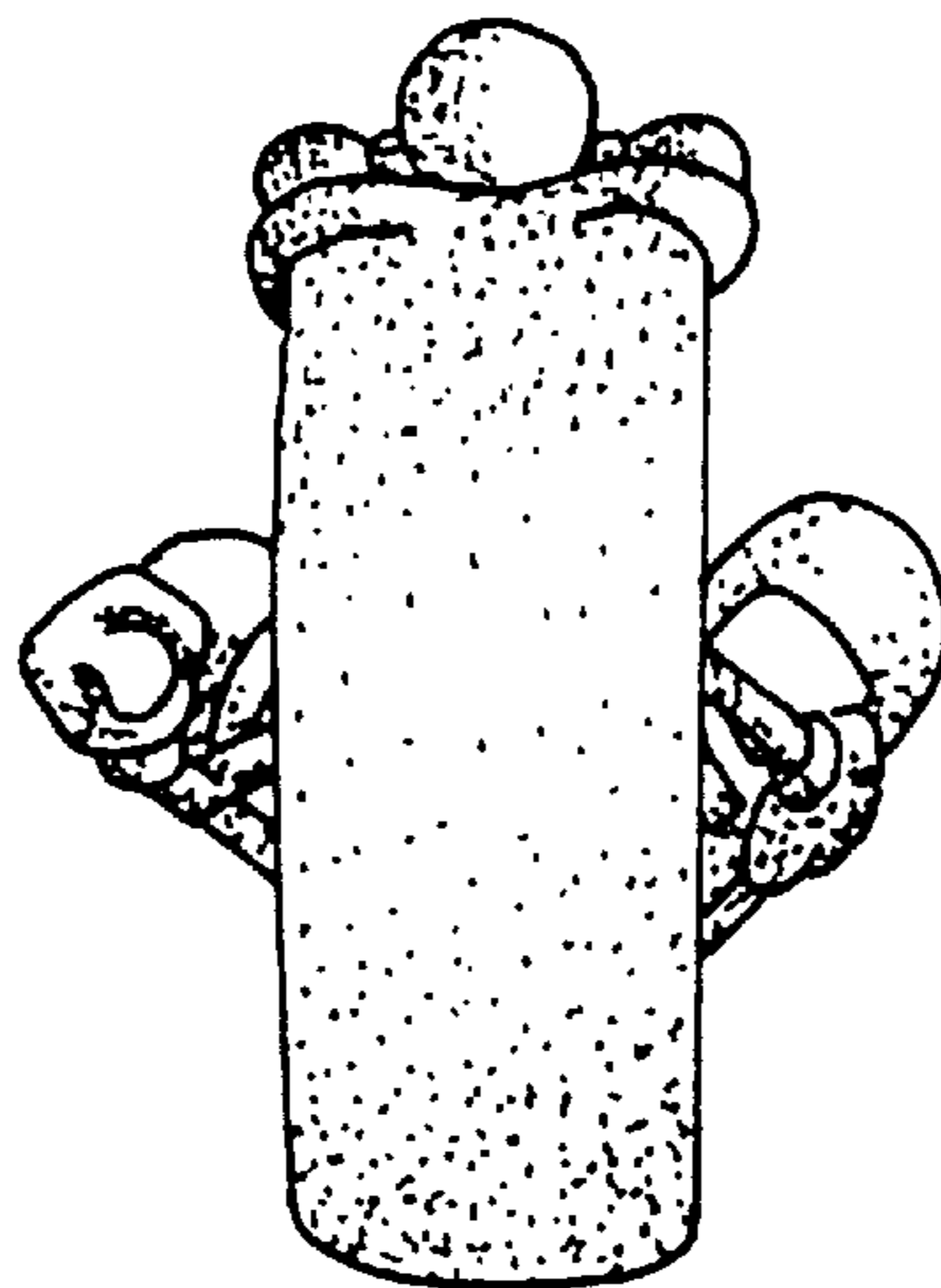

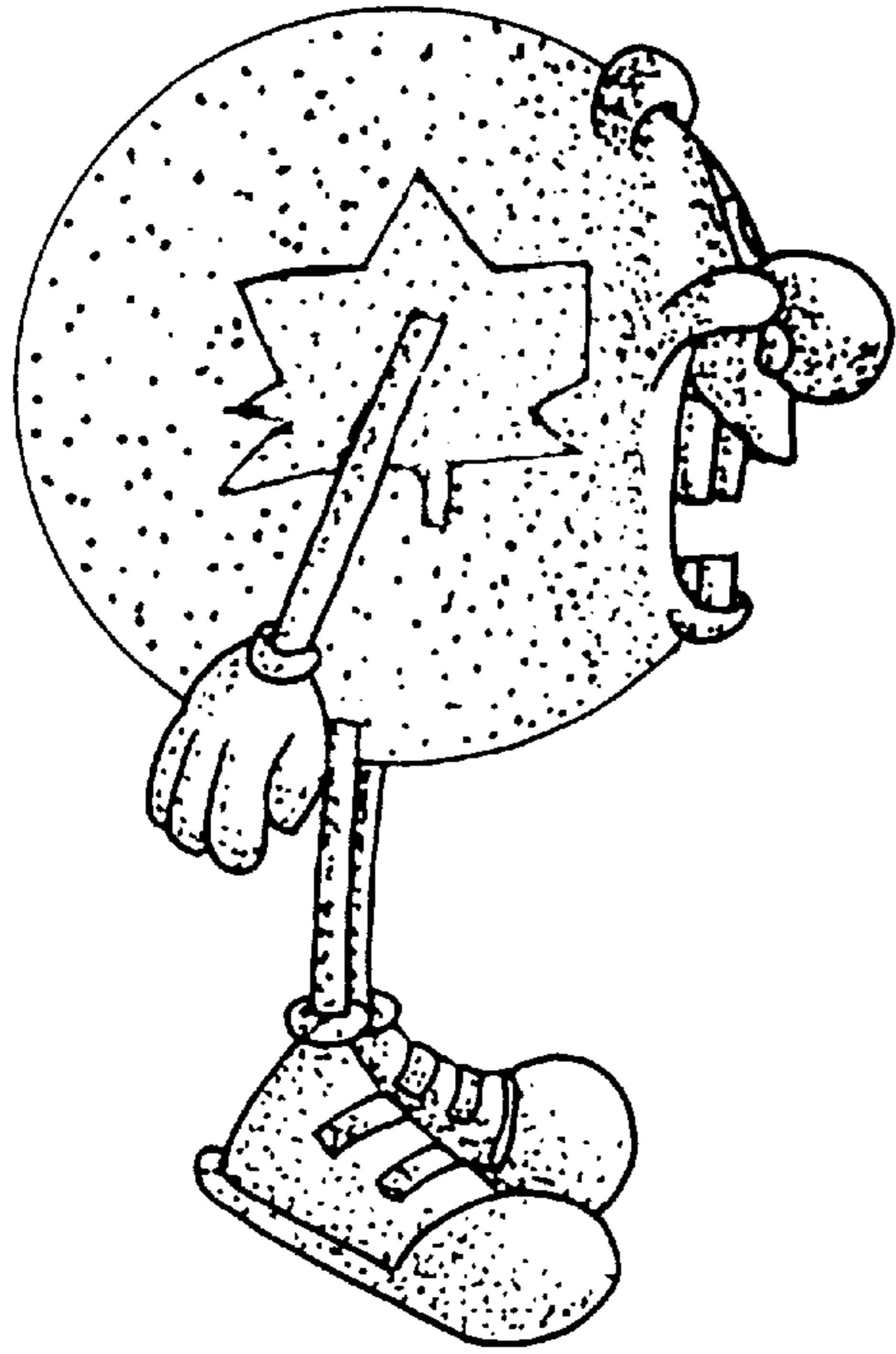

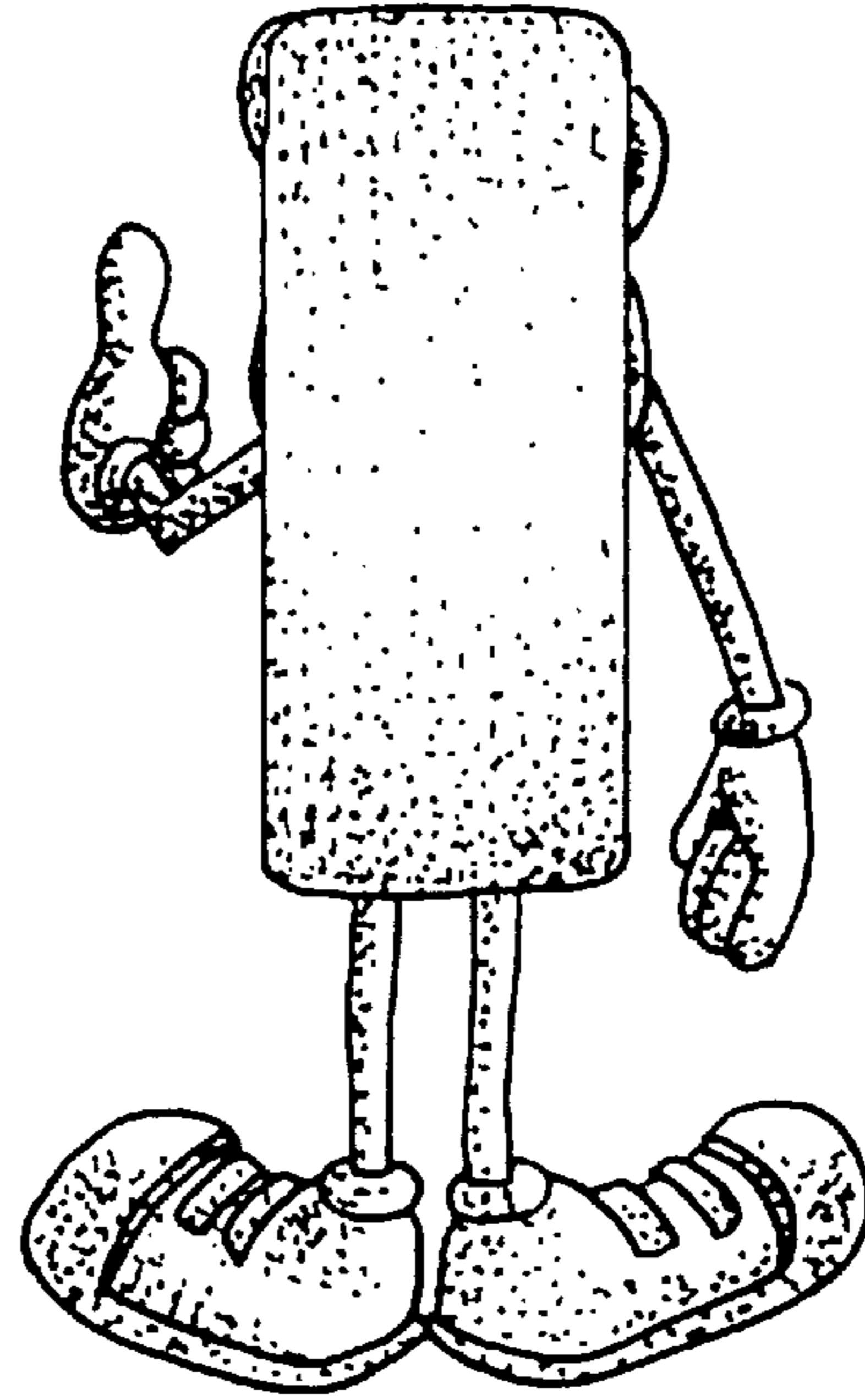

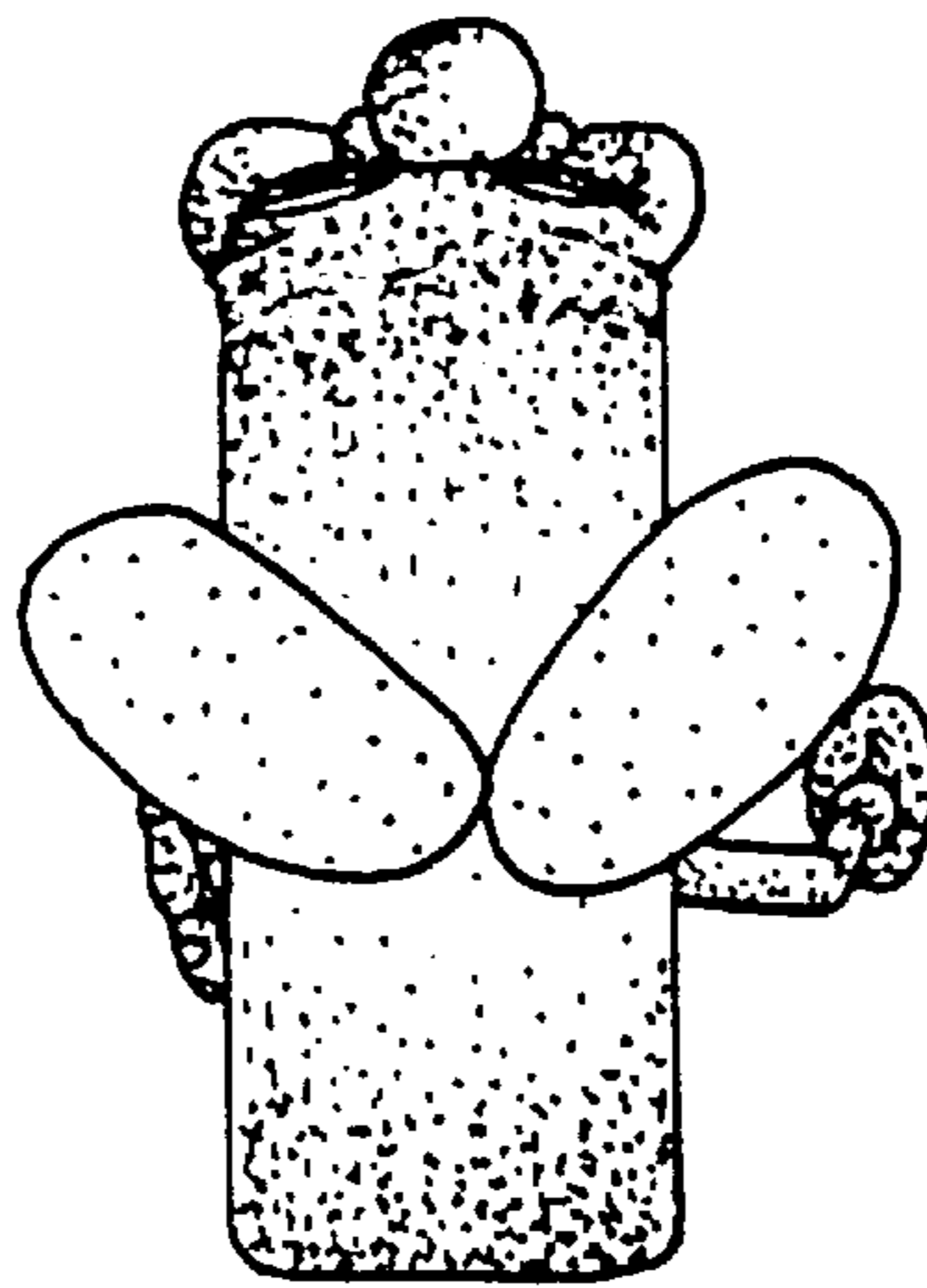
