The broken line showing on FIGS. 3 and 5–6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

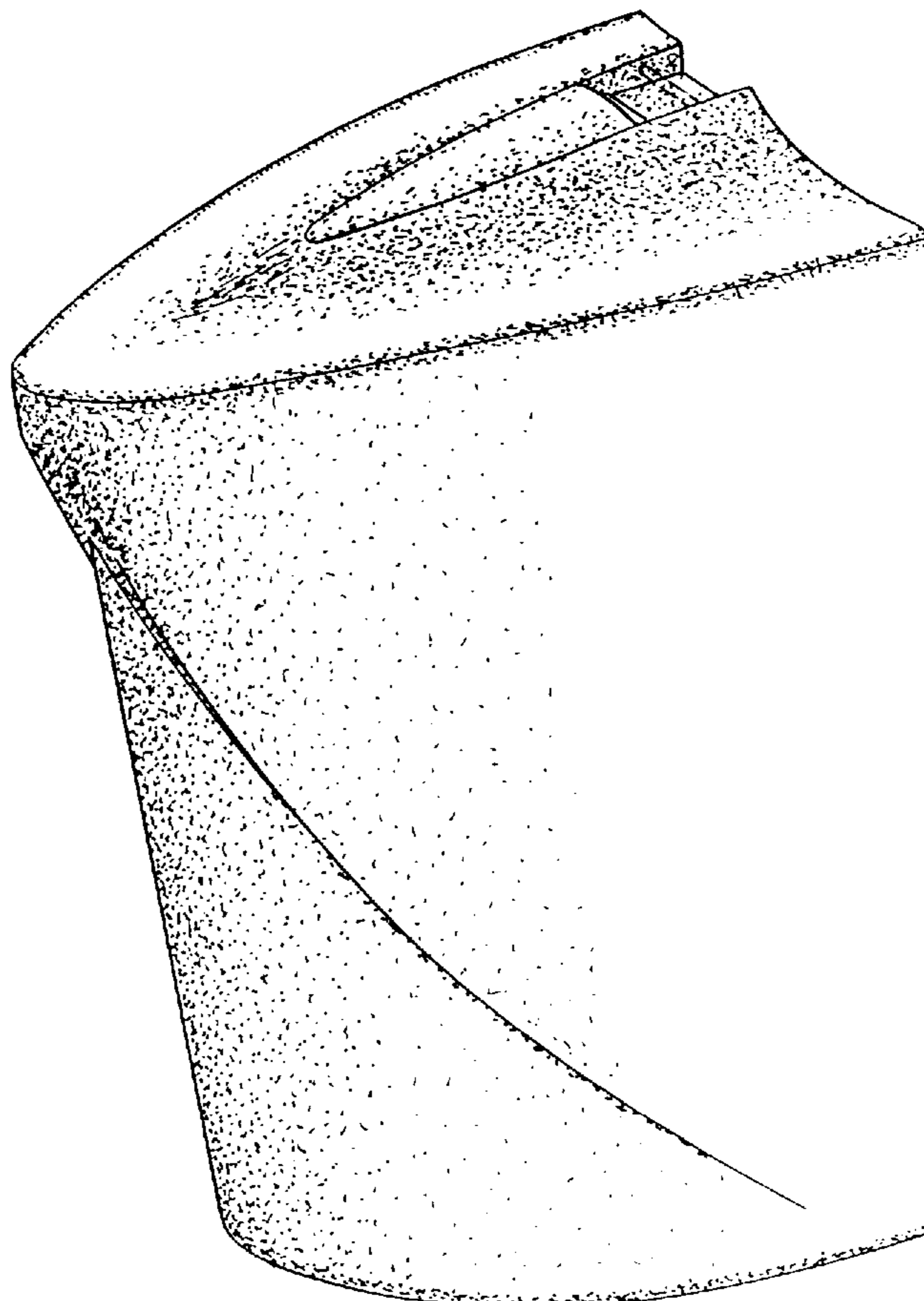

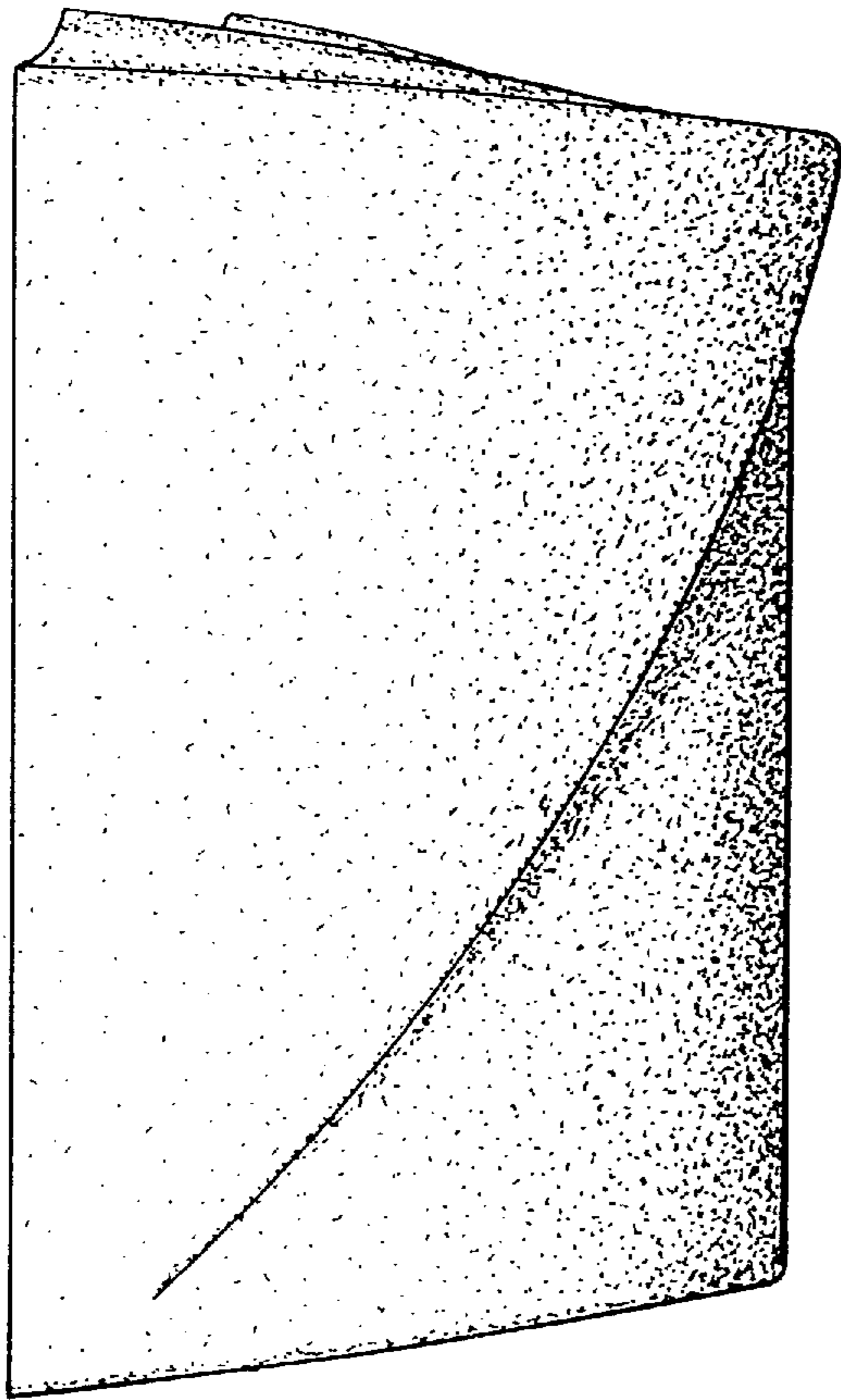

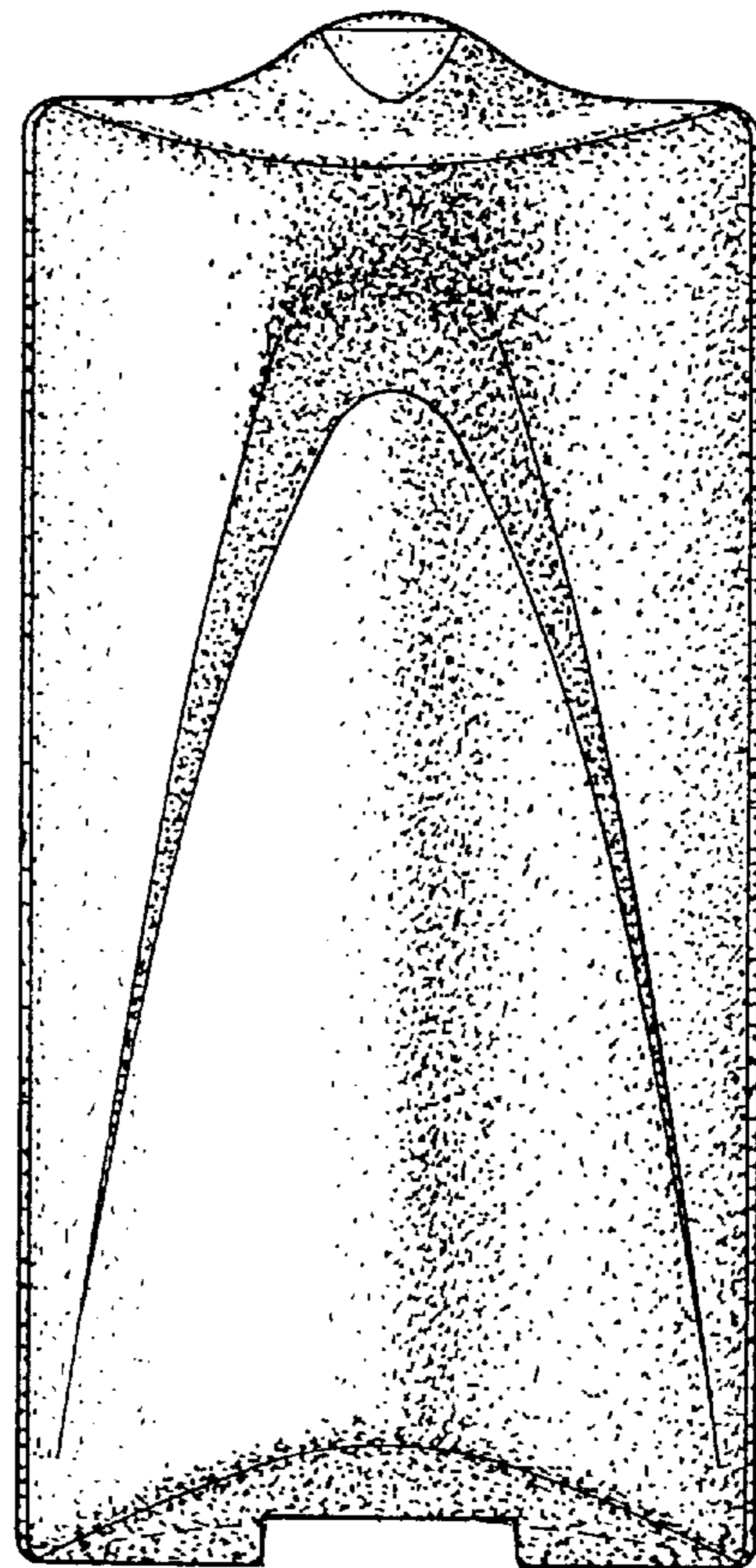

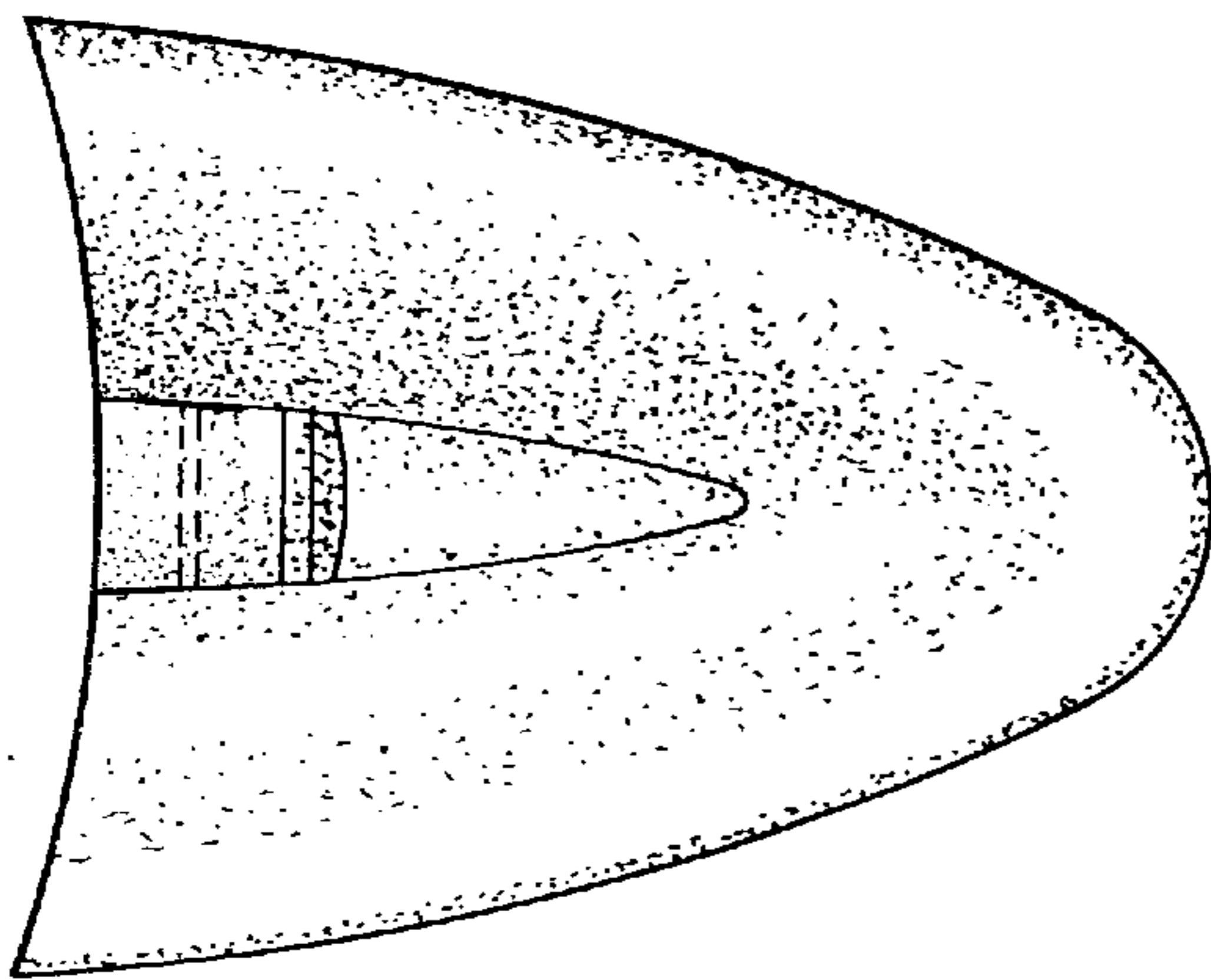

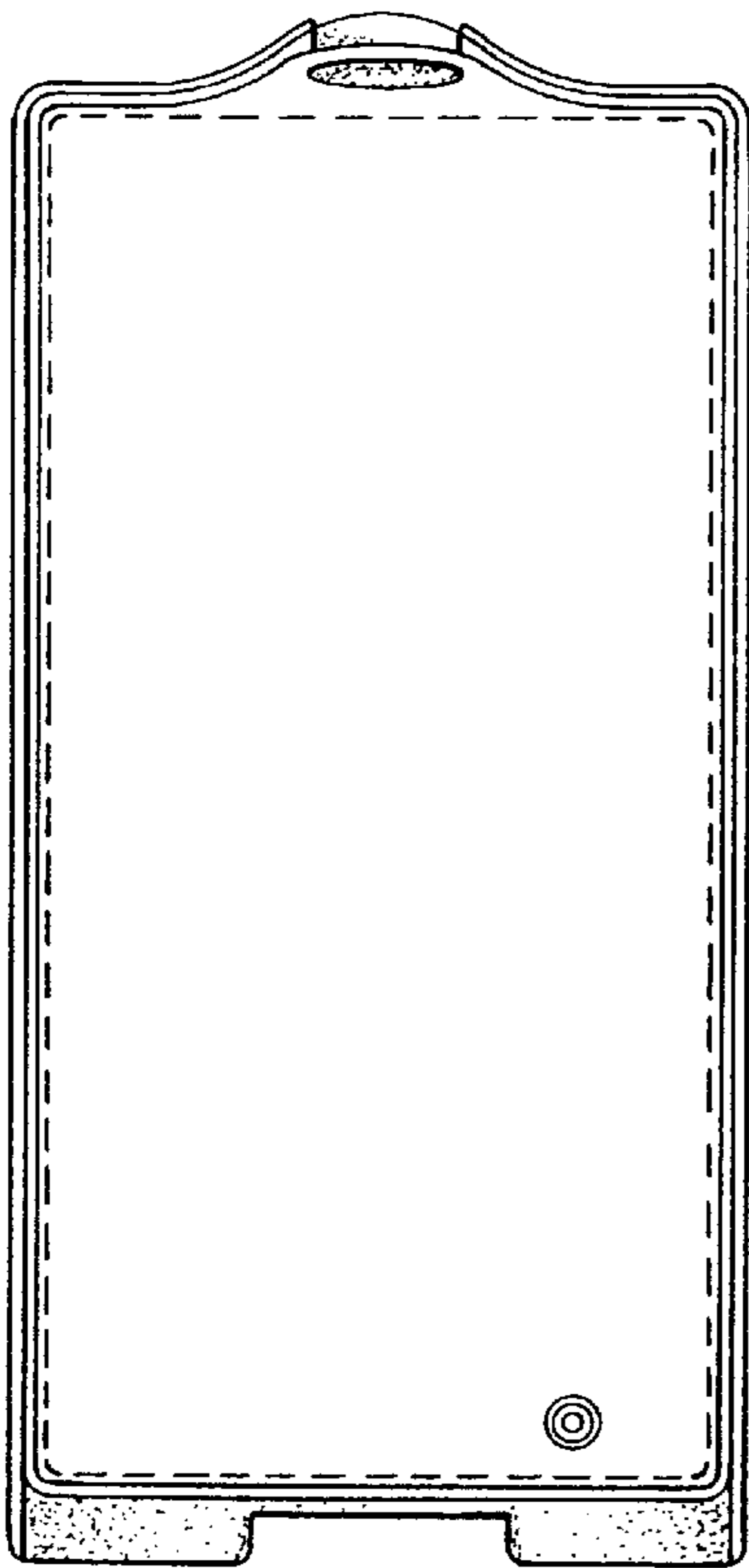

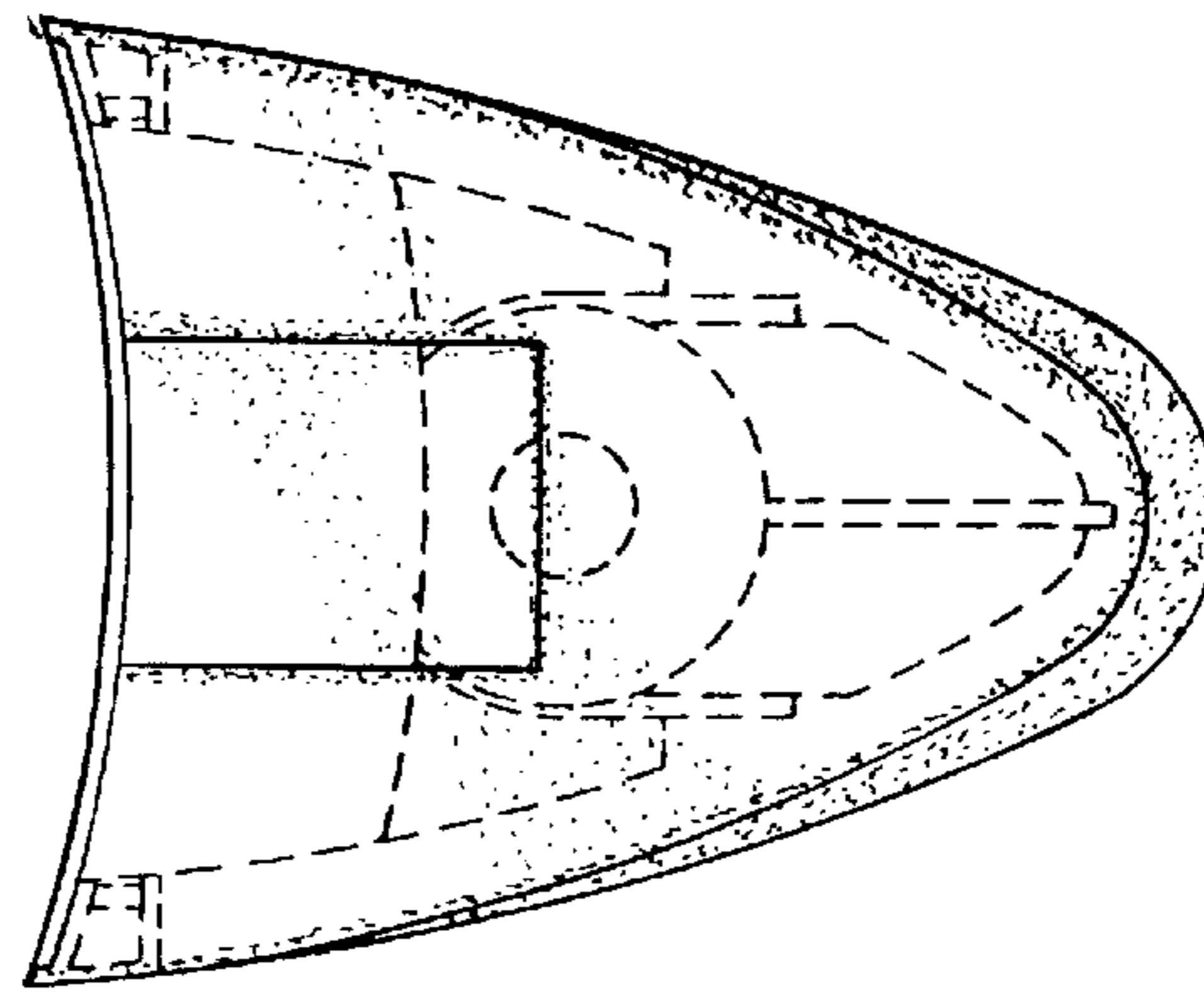

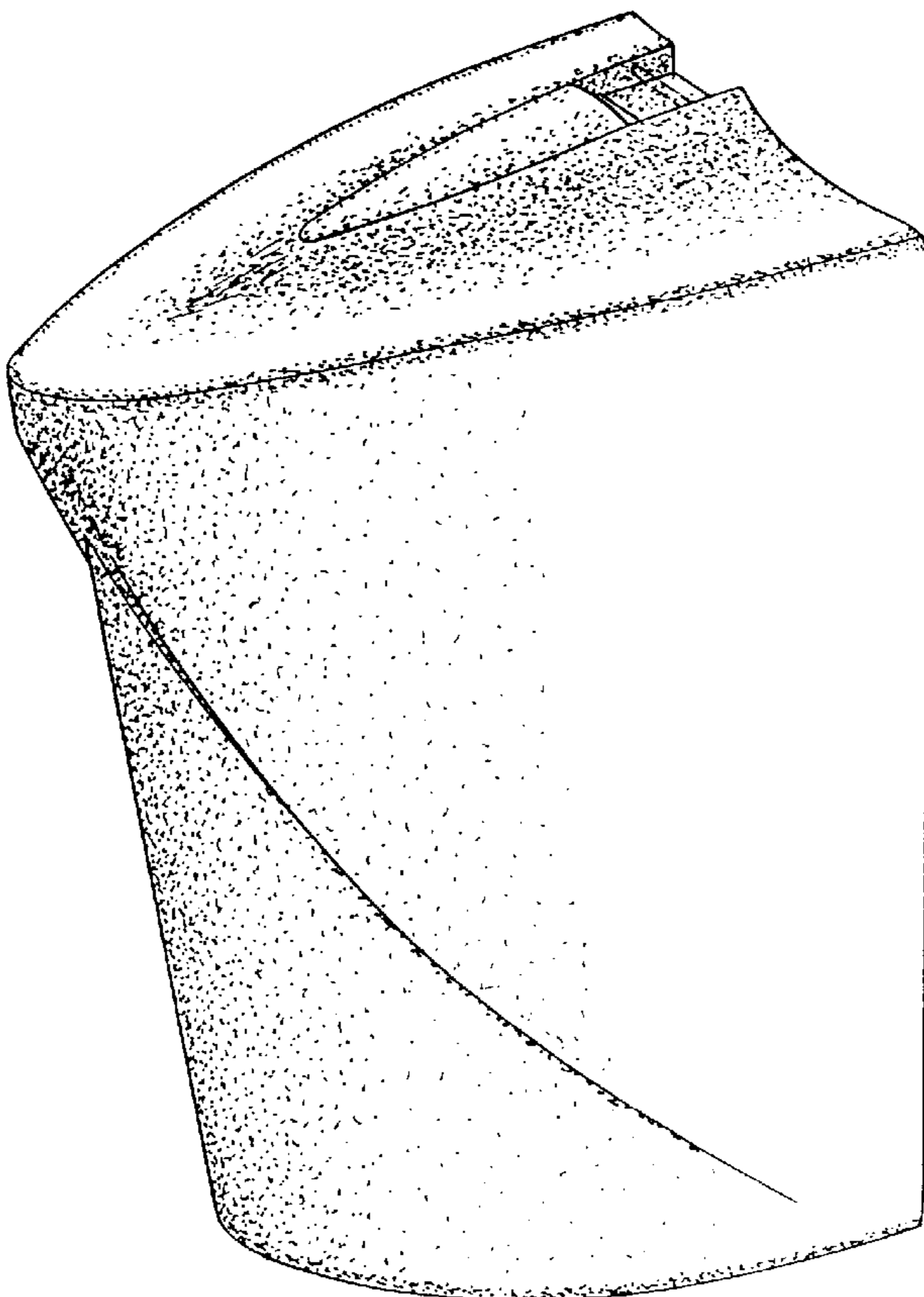
