FIG. 6 is a perspective left side view from the rear of an automobile body according to our novel design;


FIG. 7 is a perspective right side view from the rear of an automobile body according to our novel design;


FIG. 8 is a rear view of an automobile body according to our novel design; and,


FIG. 9 is a top view of an automobile body according to our novel design.























