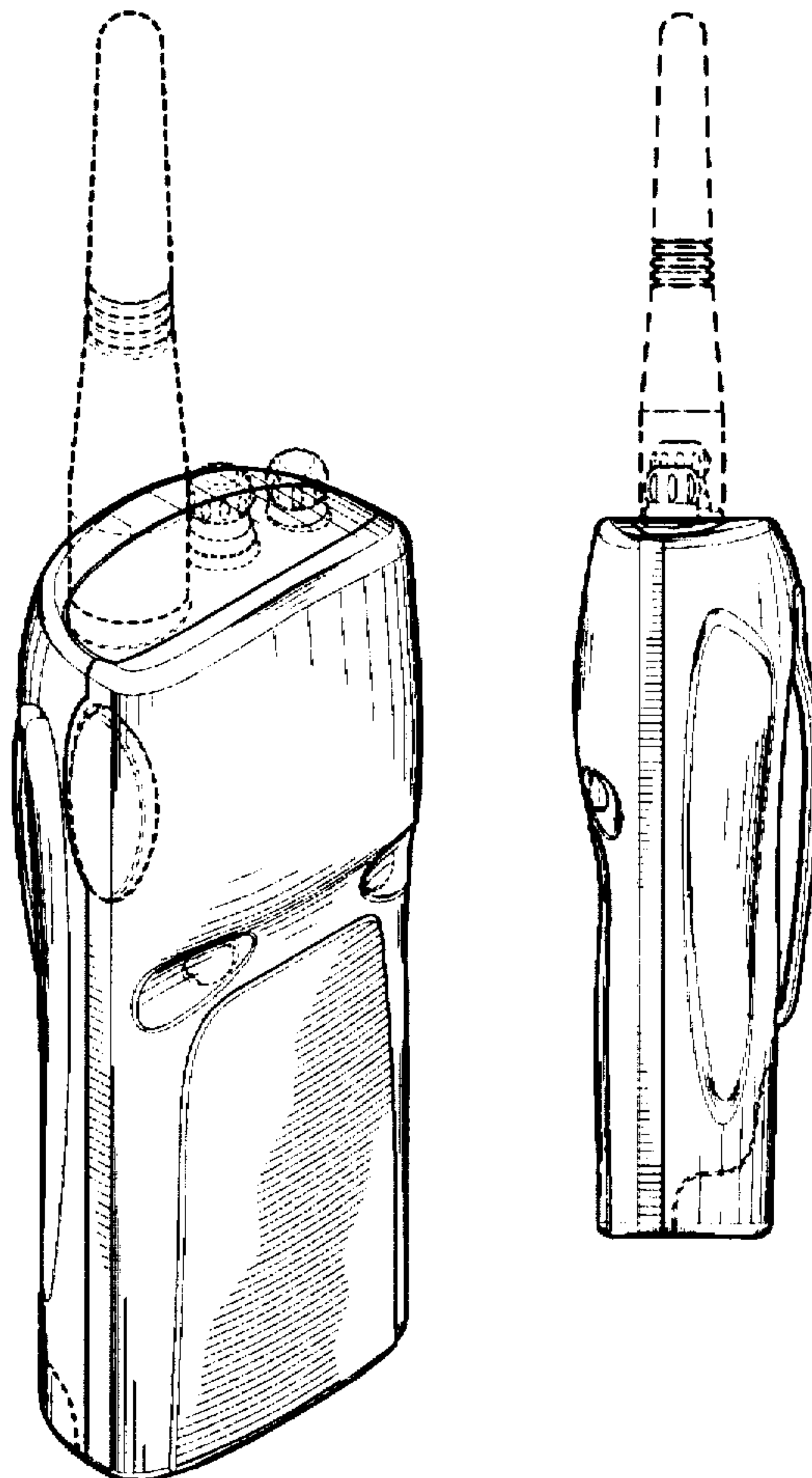
The ornamental design for communication device, as shown and described.

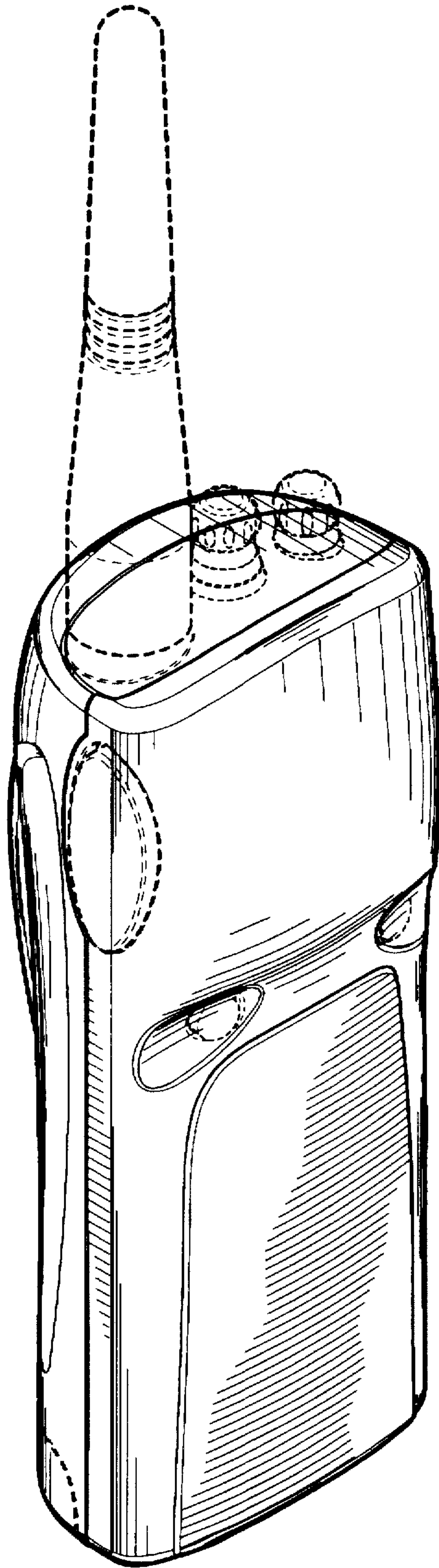
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

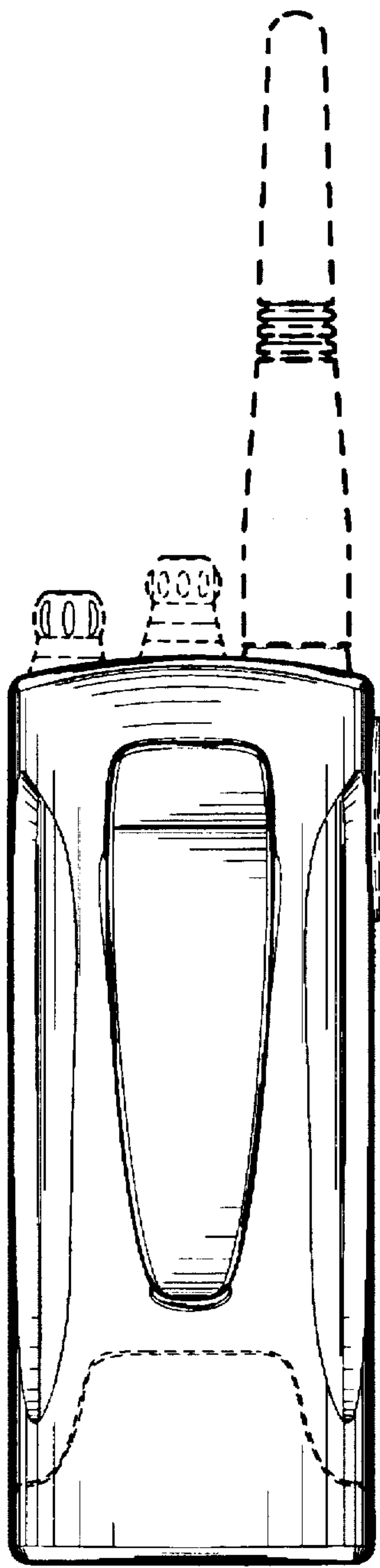
The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1-4 are included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and form no part of the claimed design.

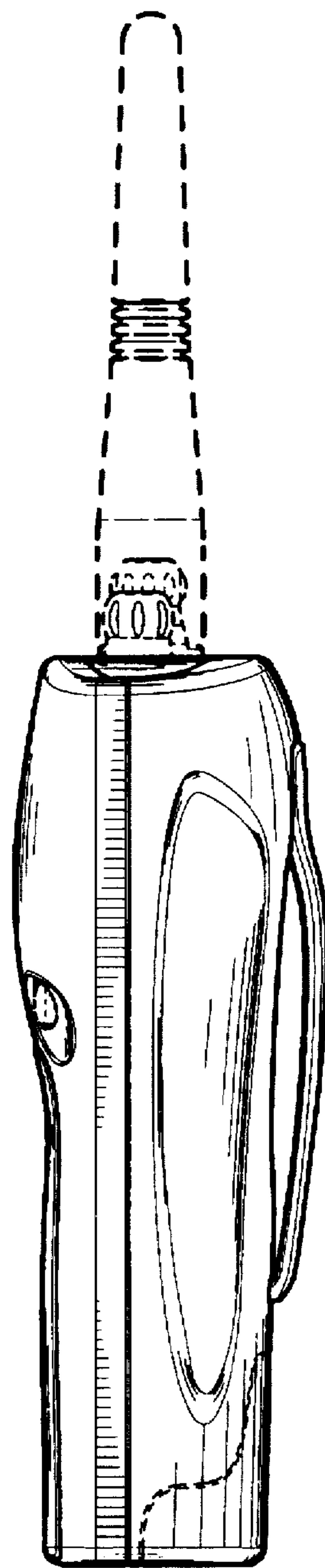




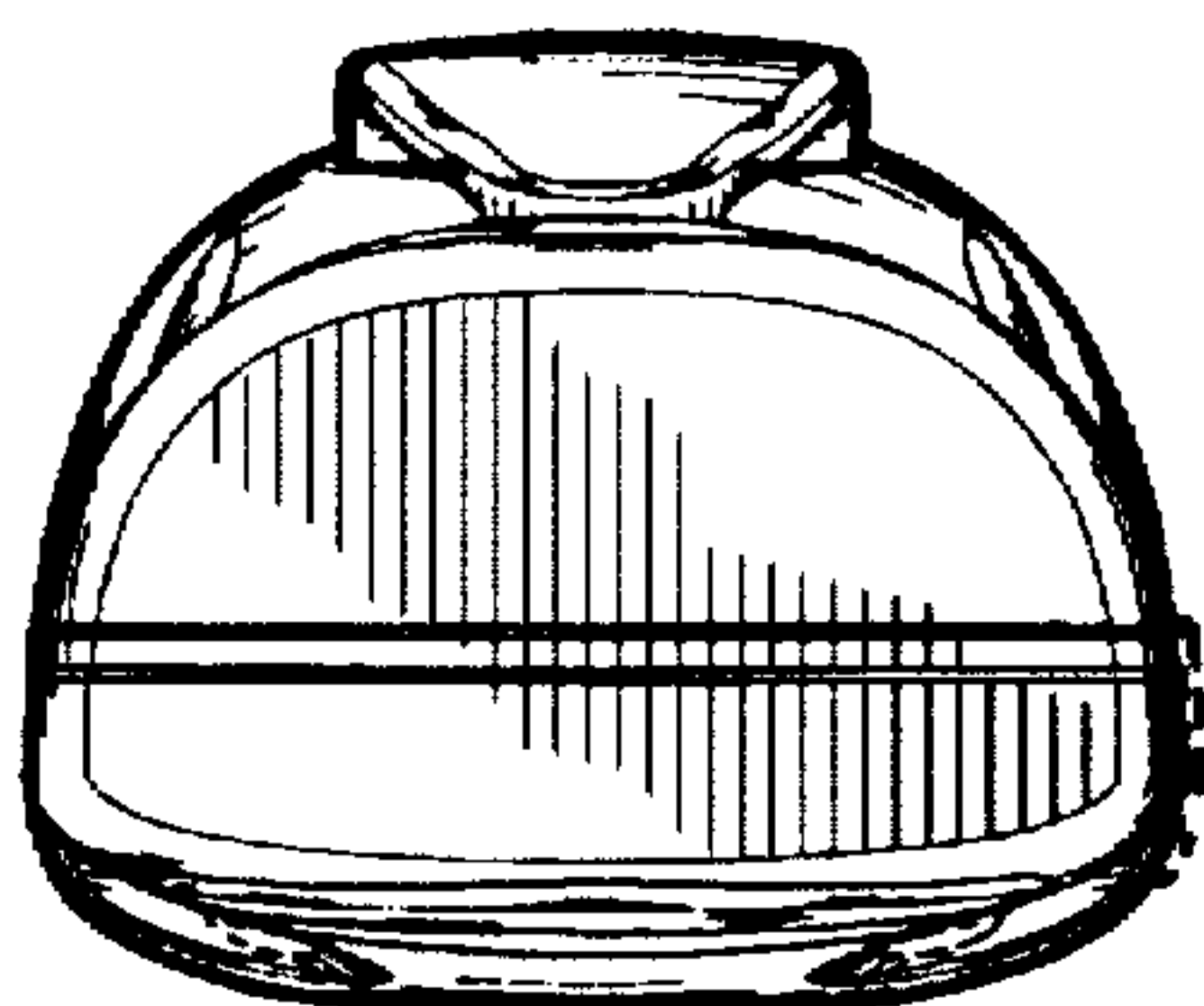
