**DESCRIPTION**

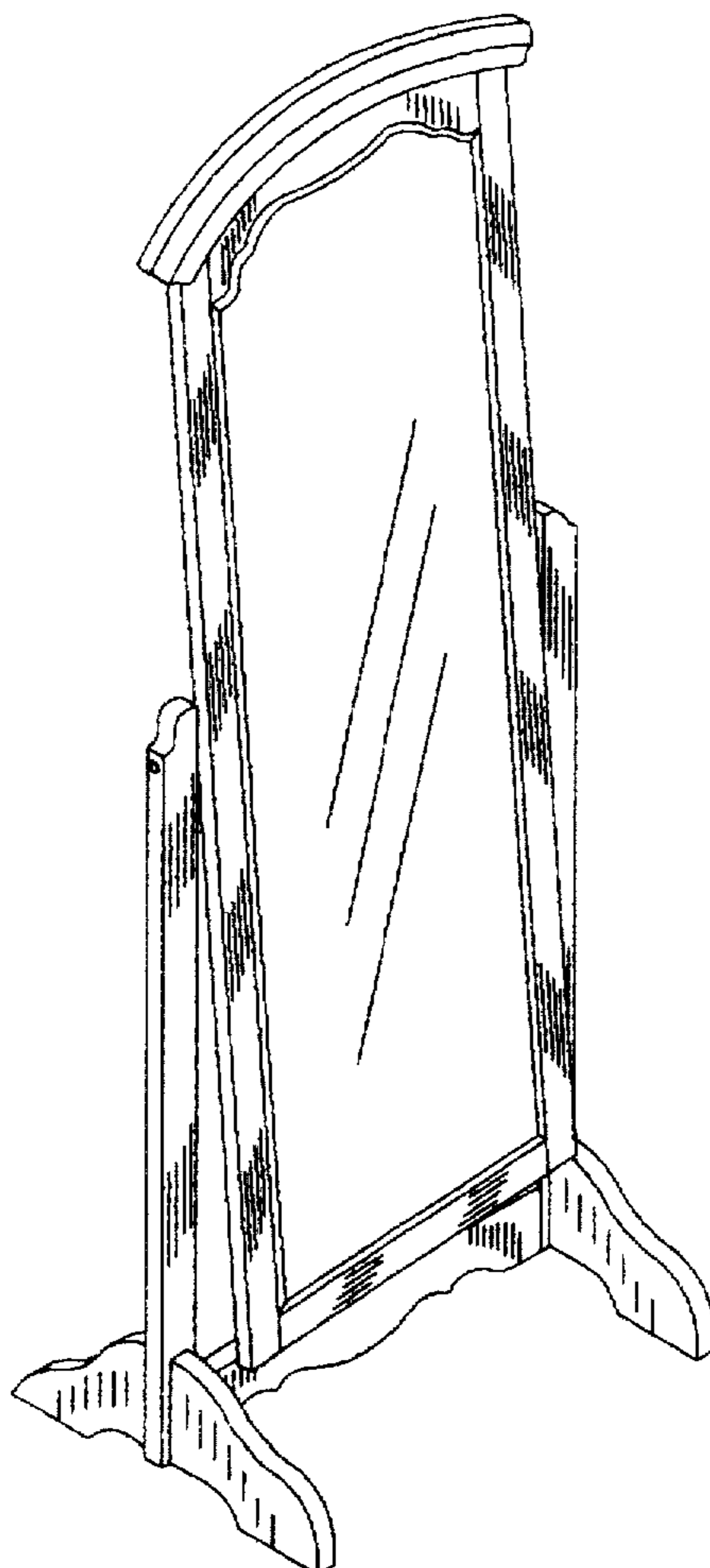
FIG. 1 is a top view of the cheval mirror showing my new

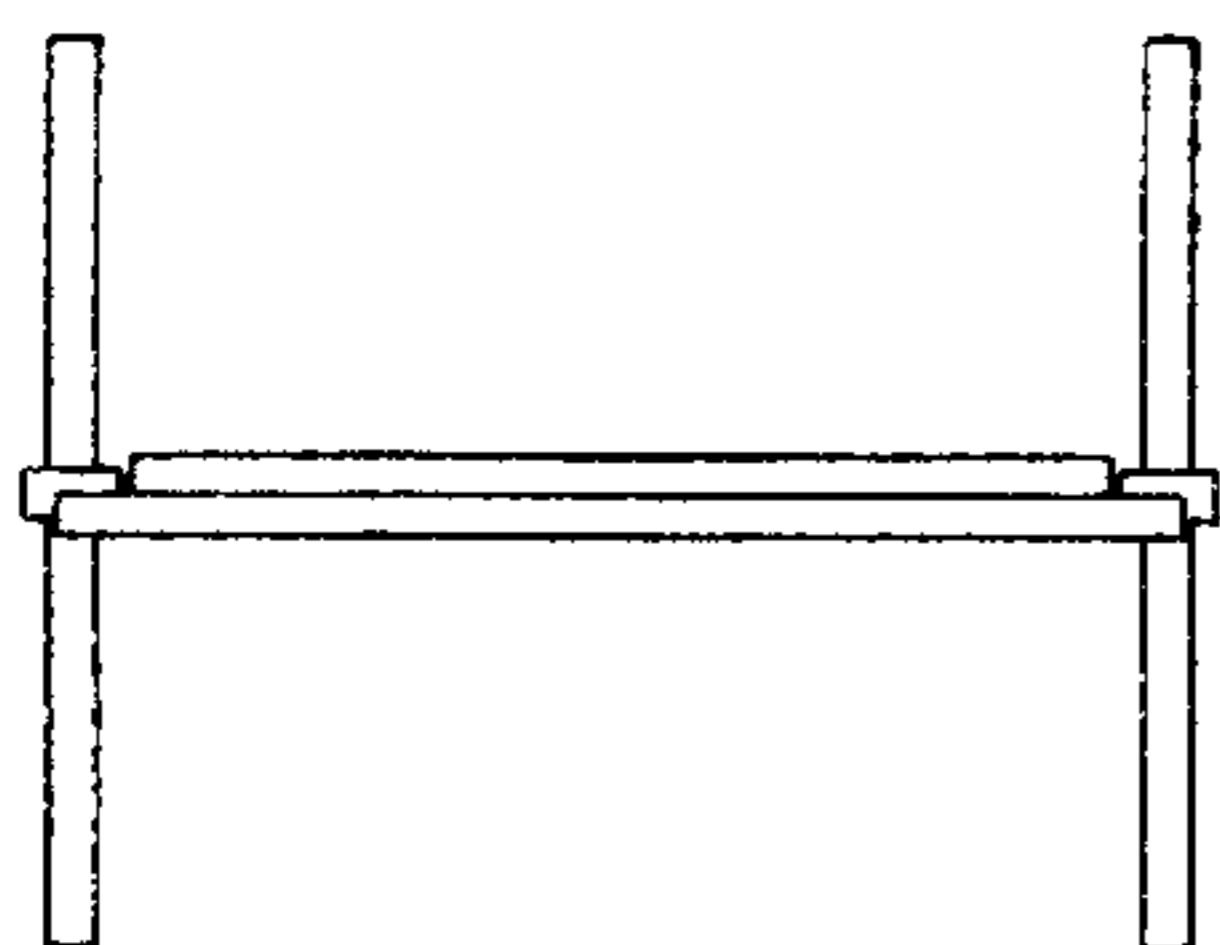

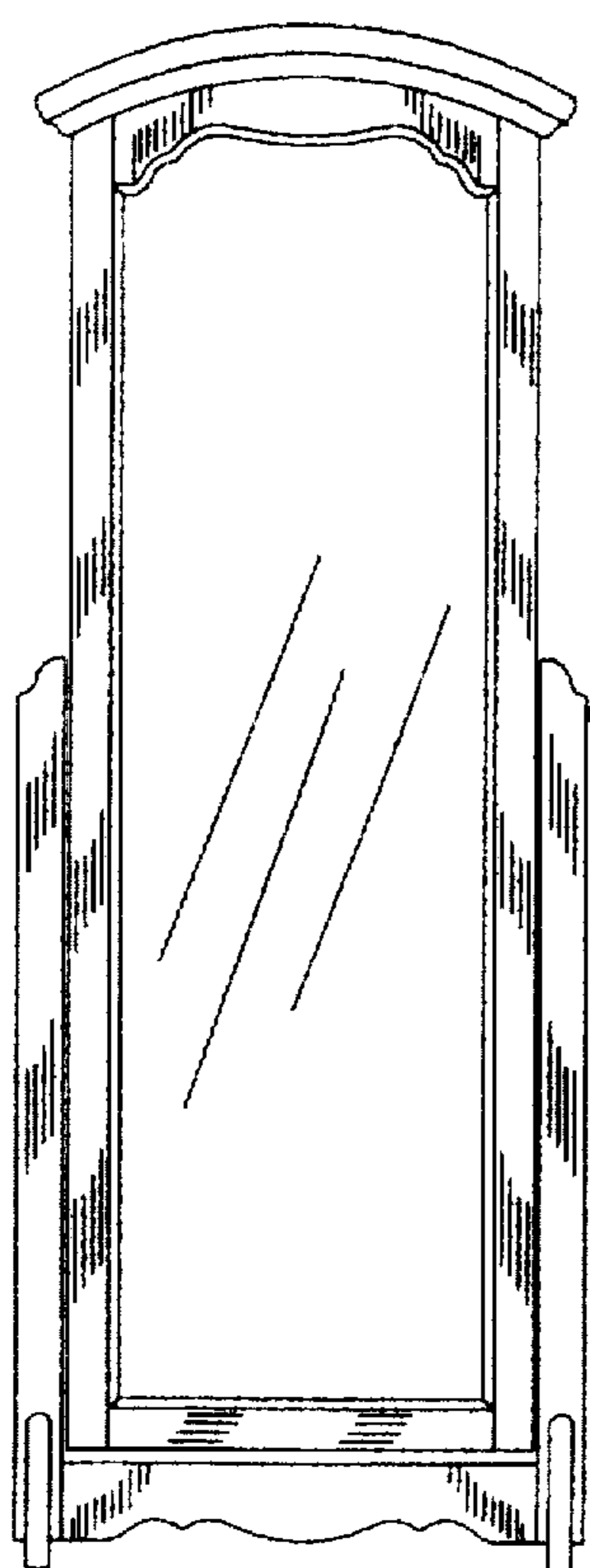

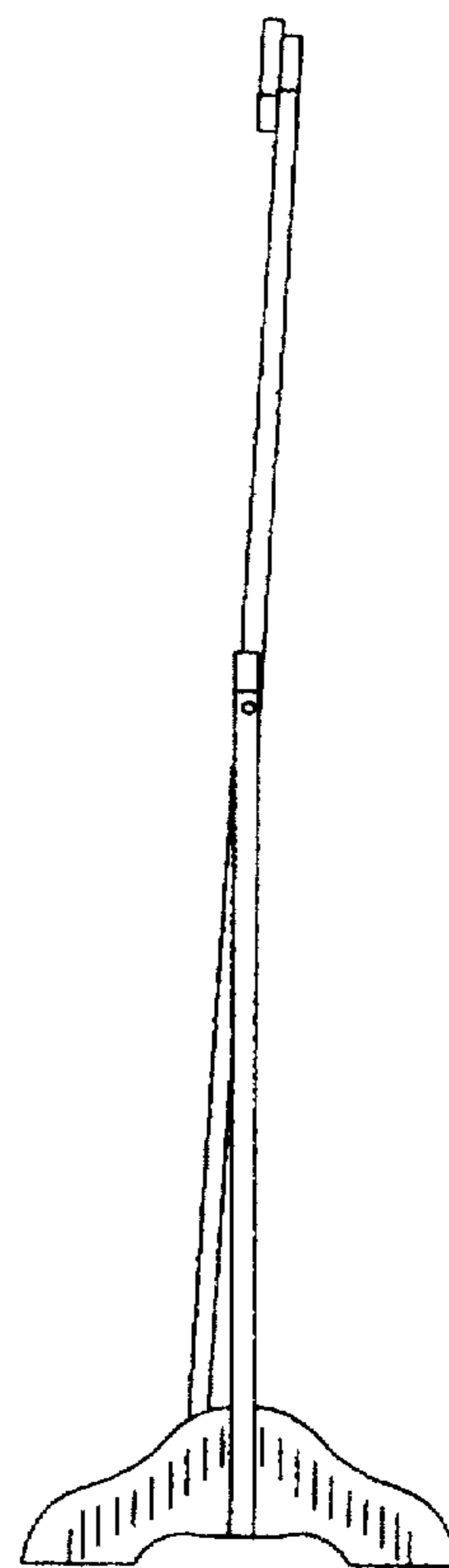

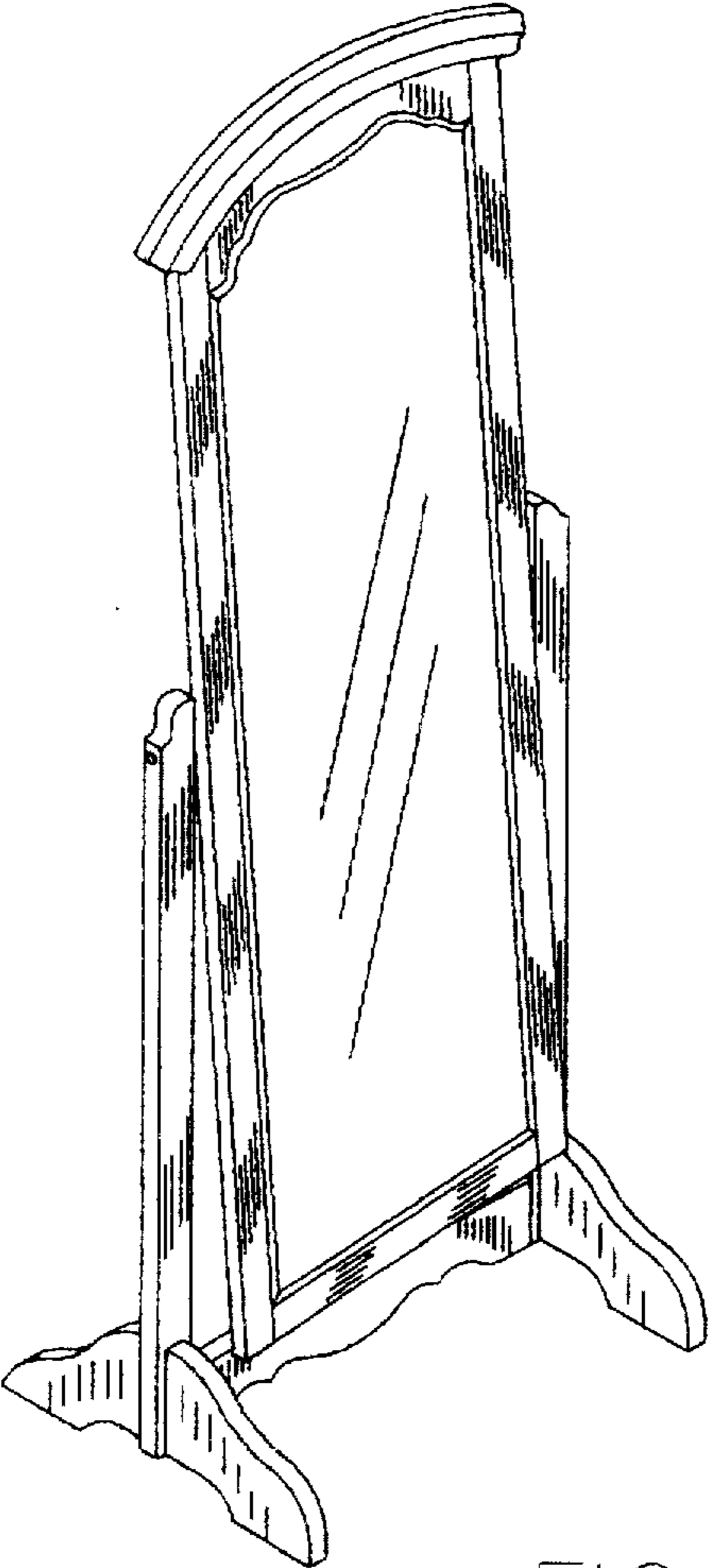
