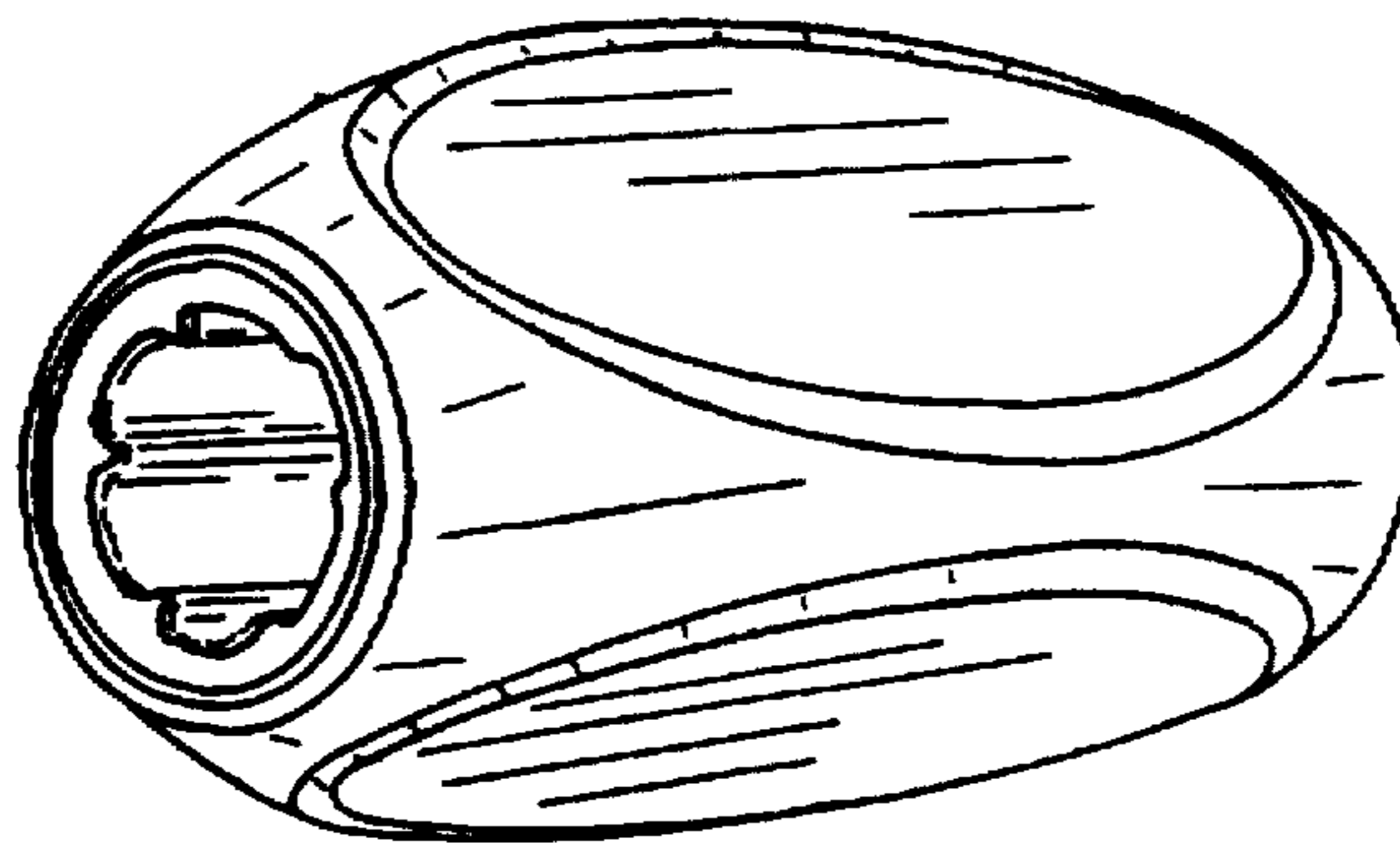
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the pen and pencil cushion, showing our new design;

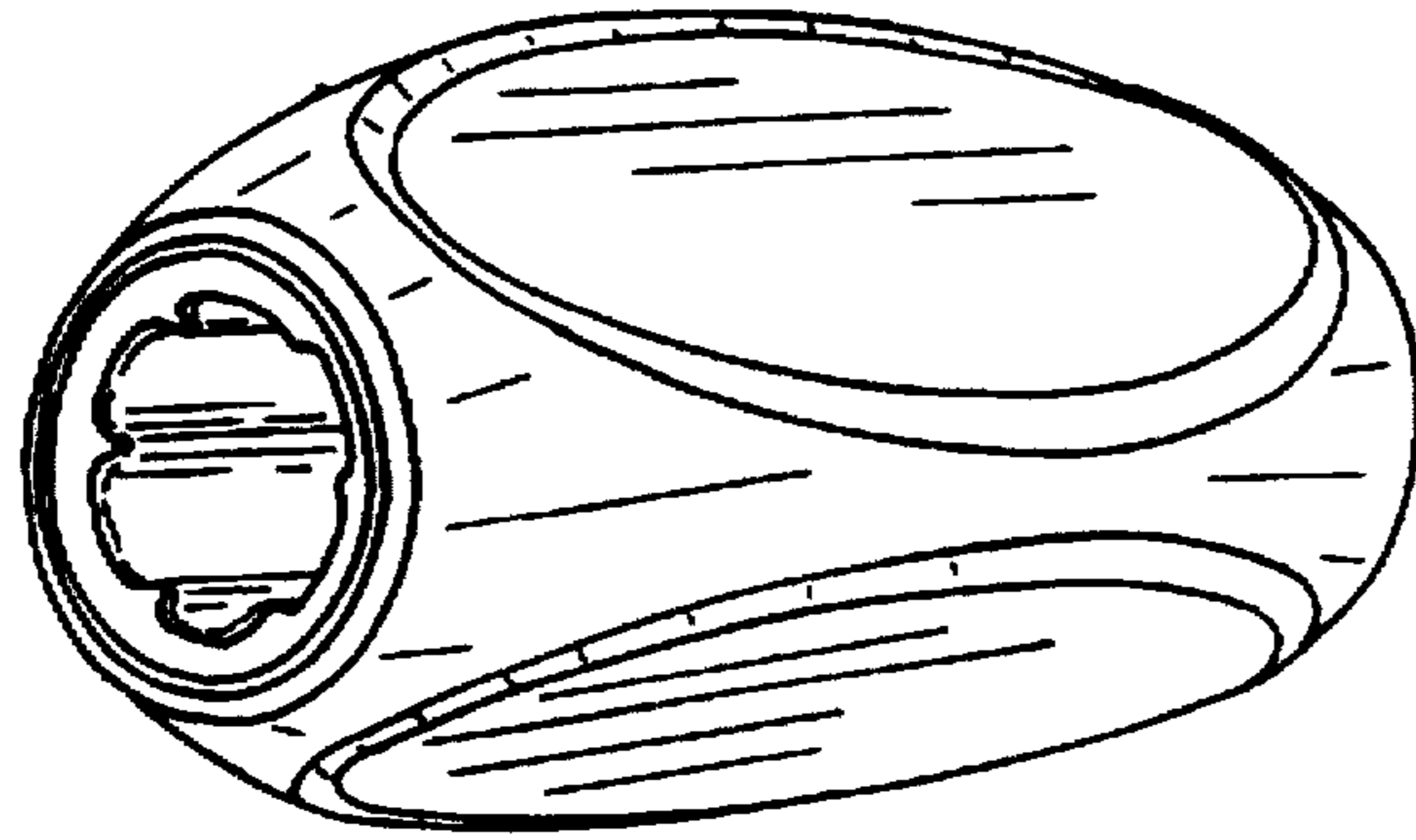

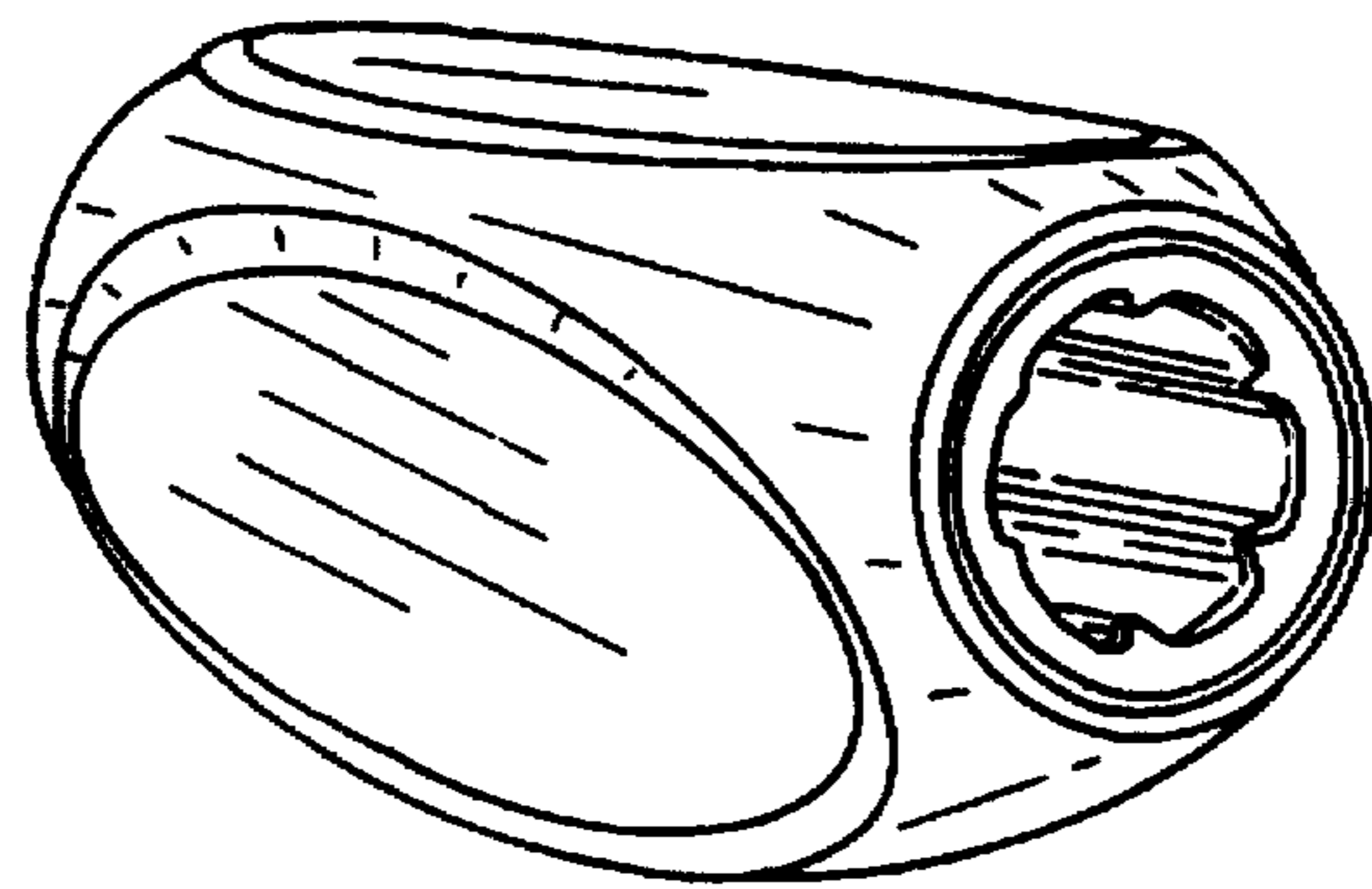

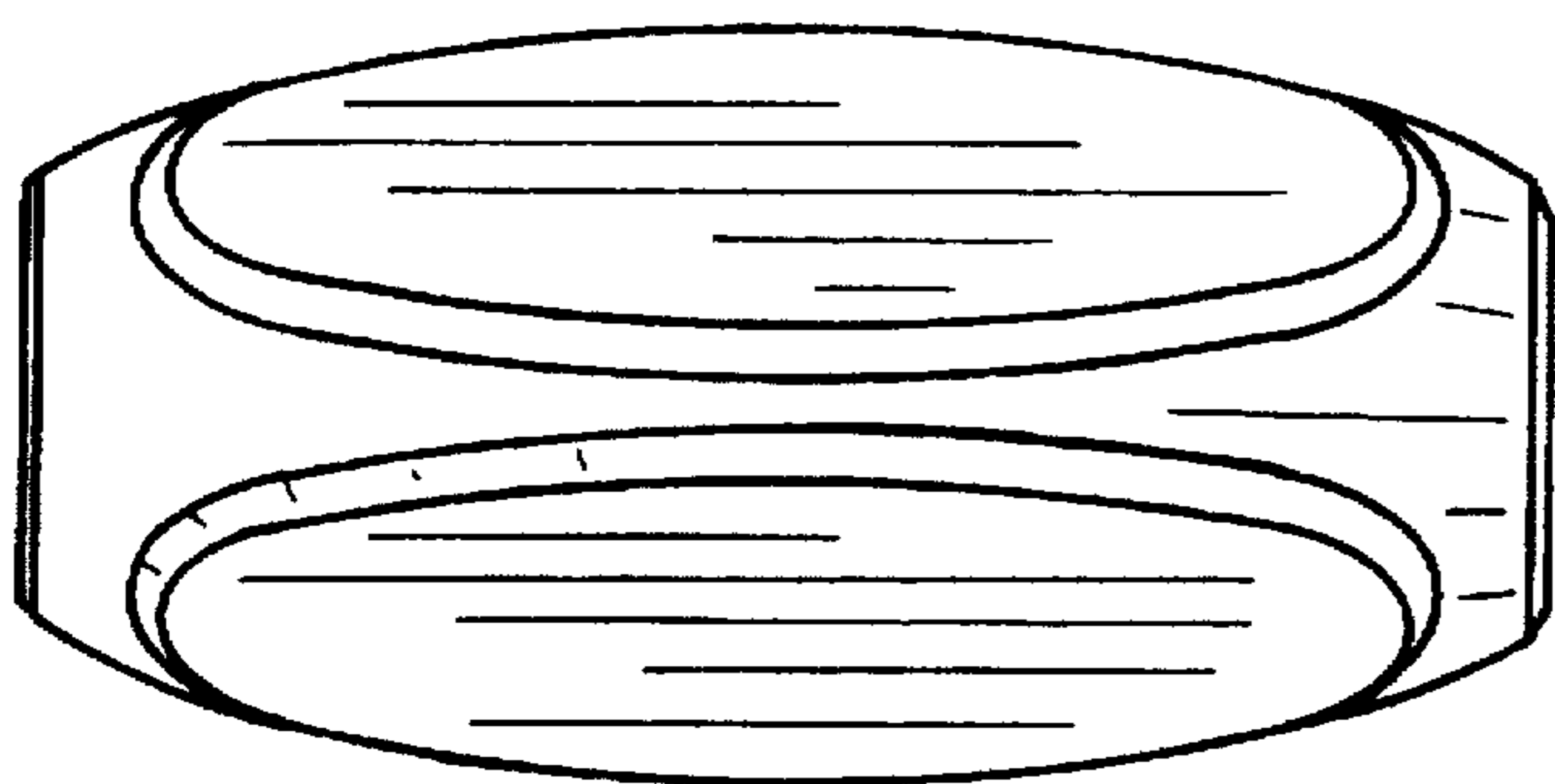

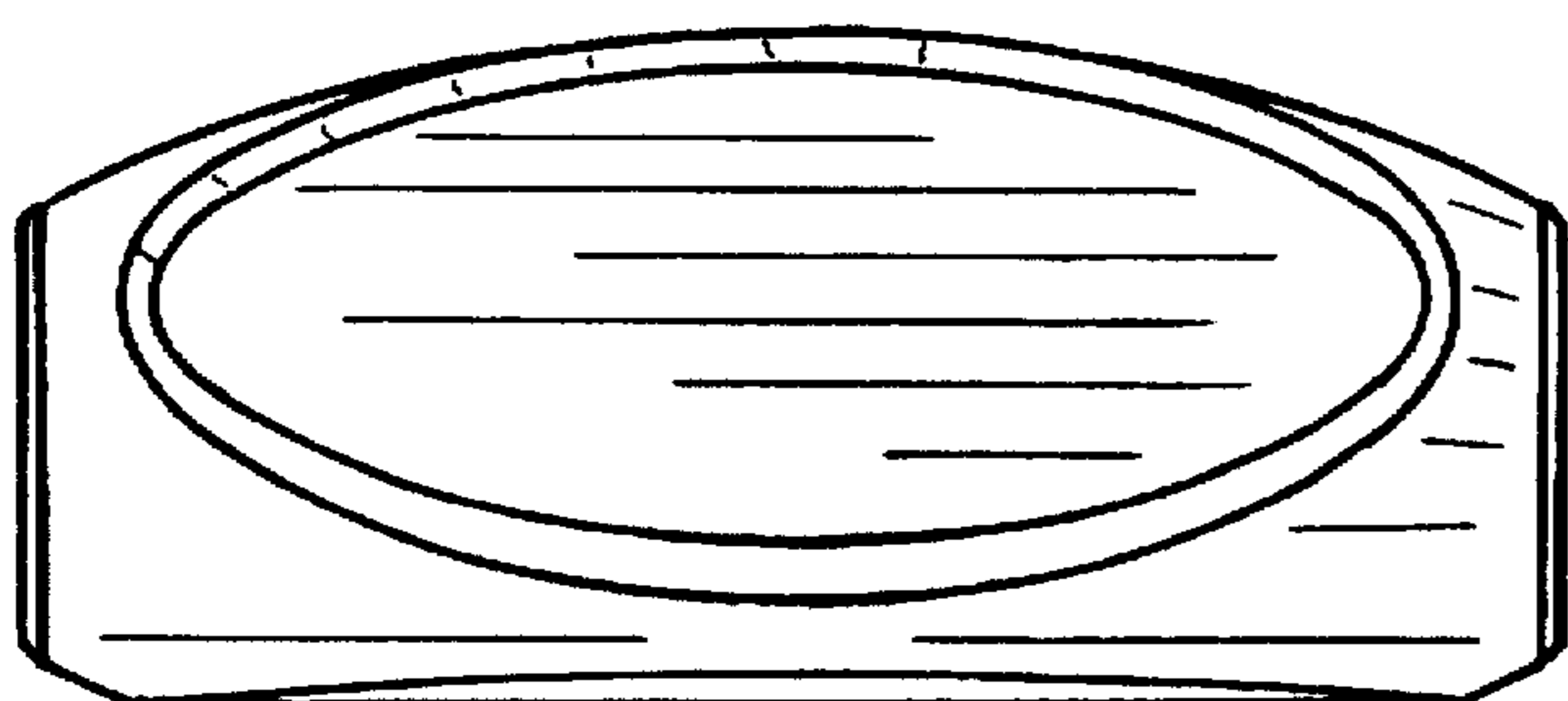

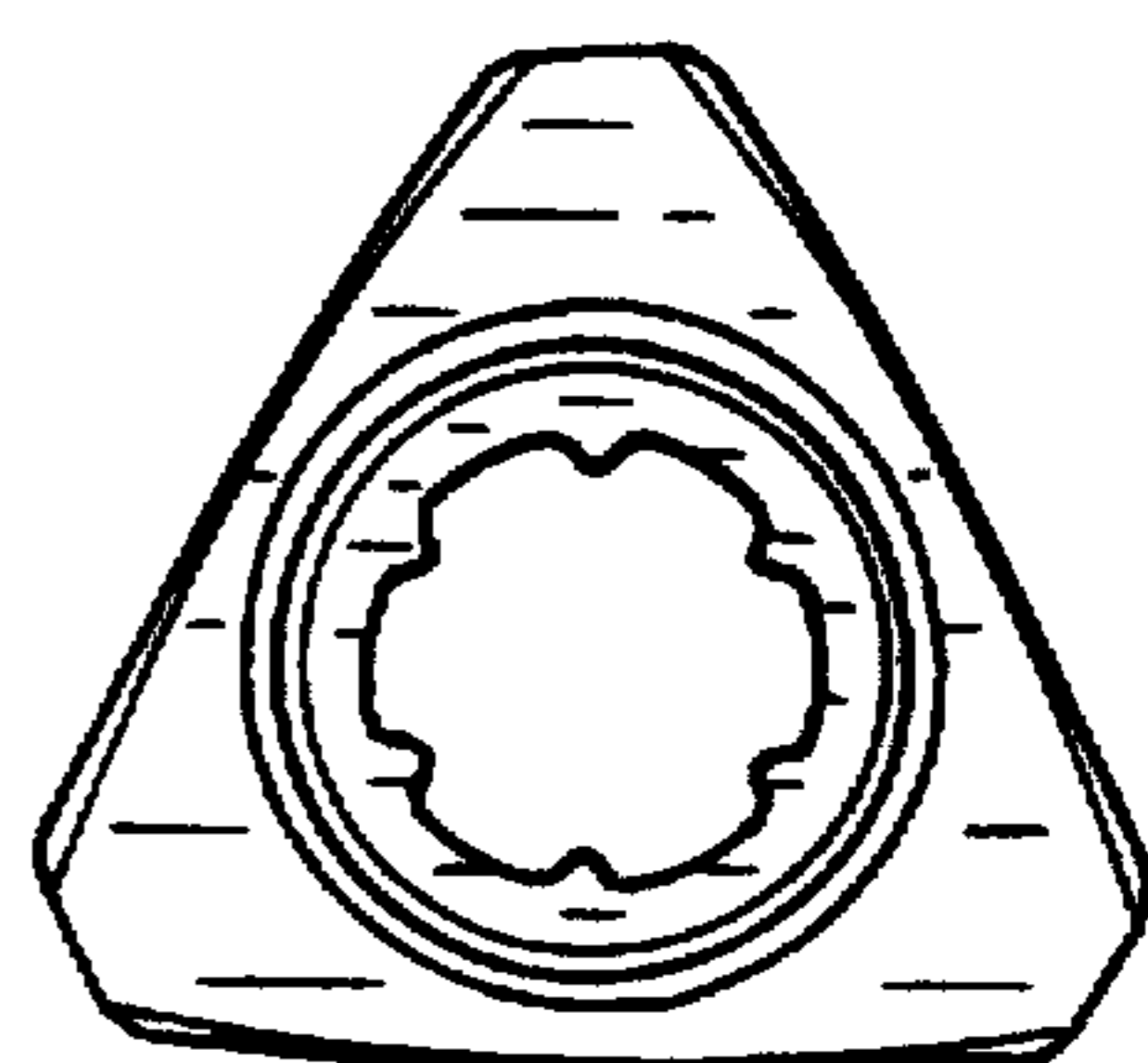

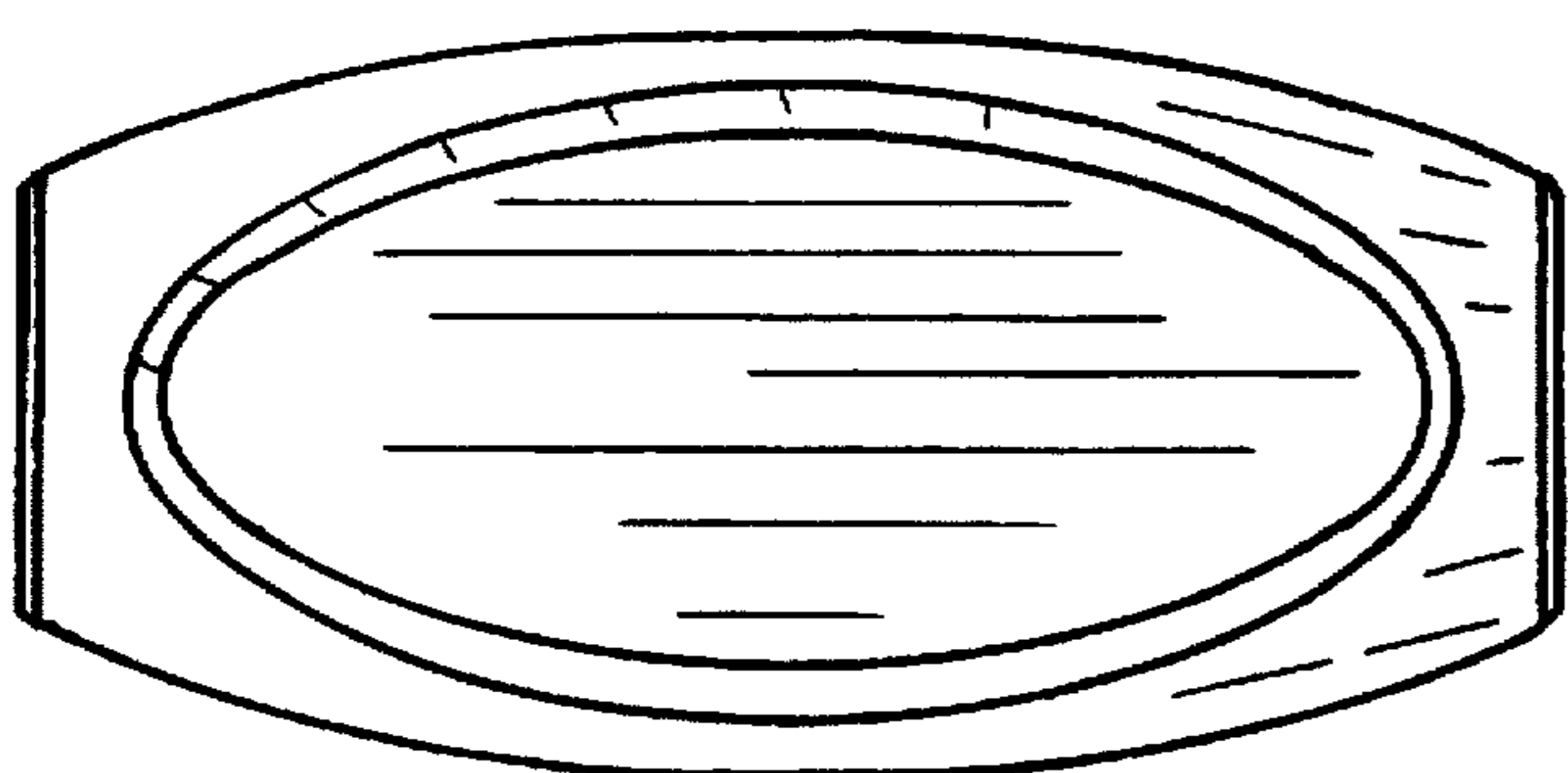

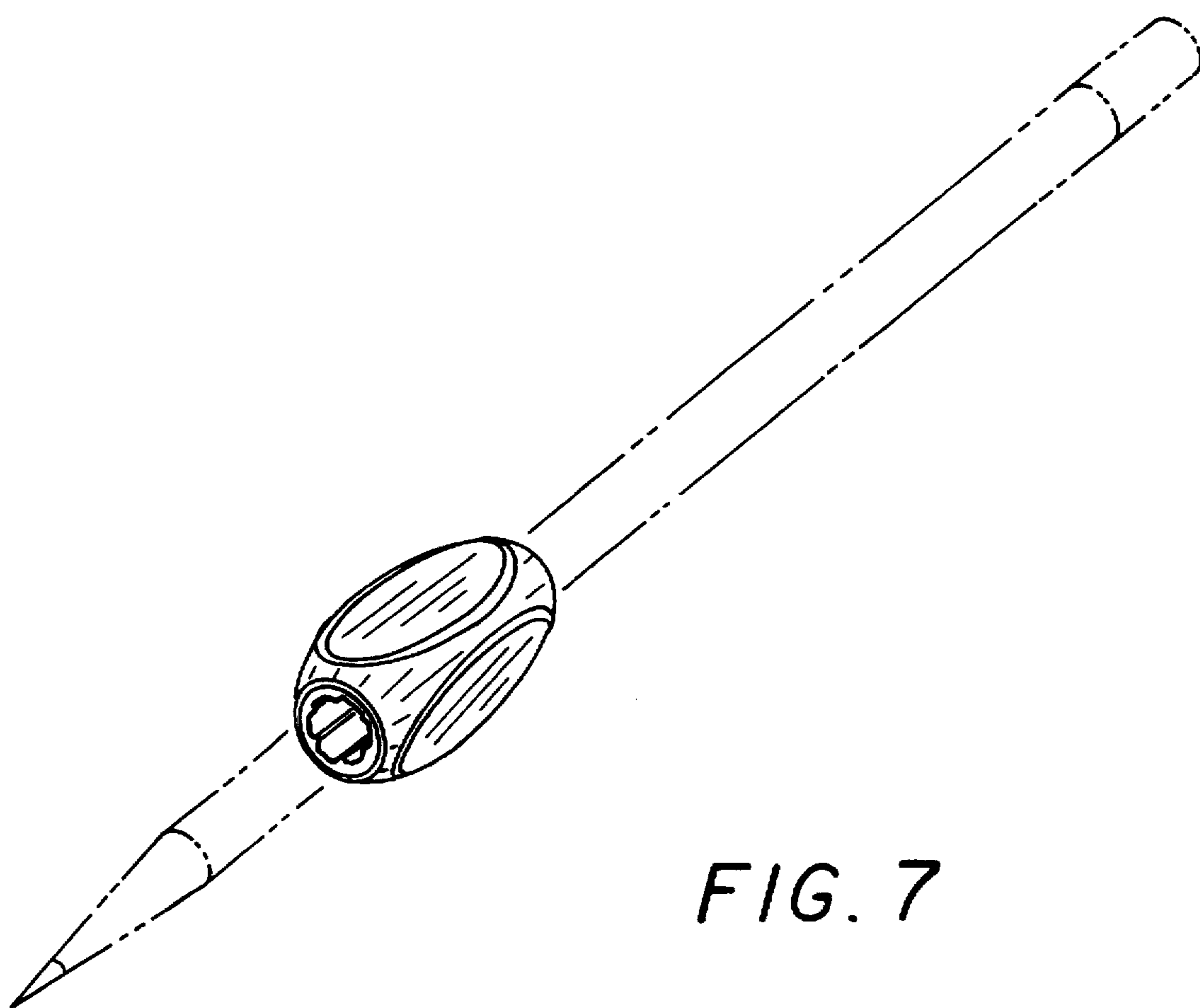
