FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

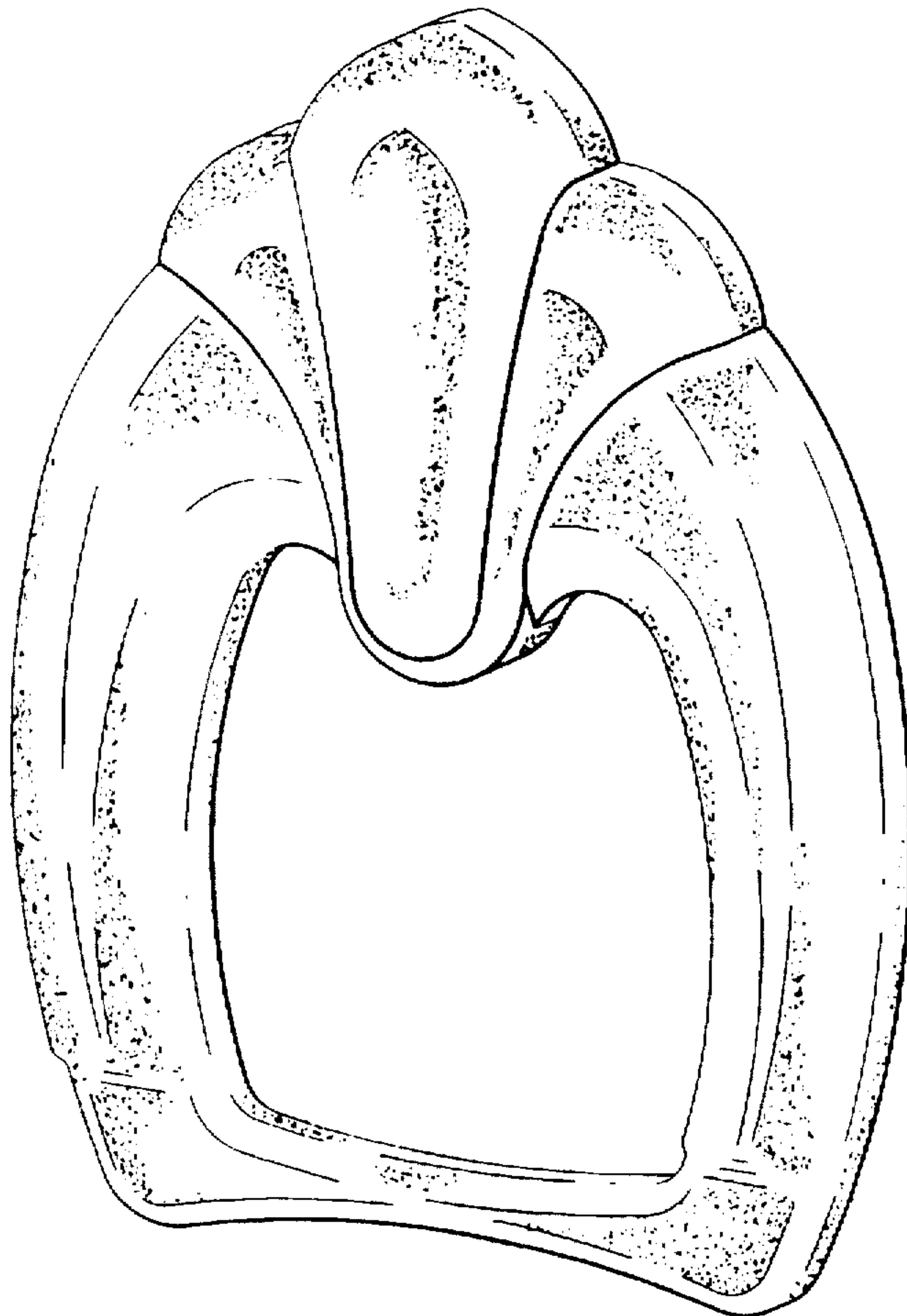
FIG. 3 is a right-side view thereof, with the left-side view being a mirror image thereof;

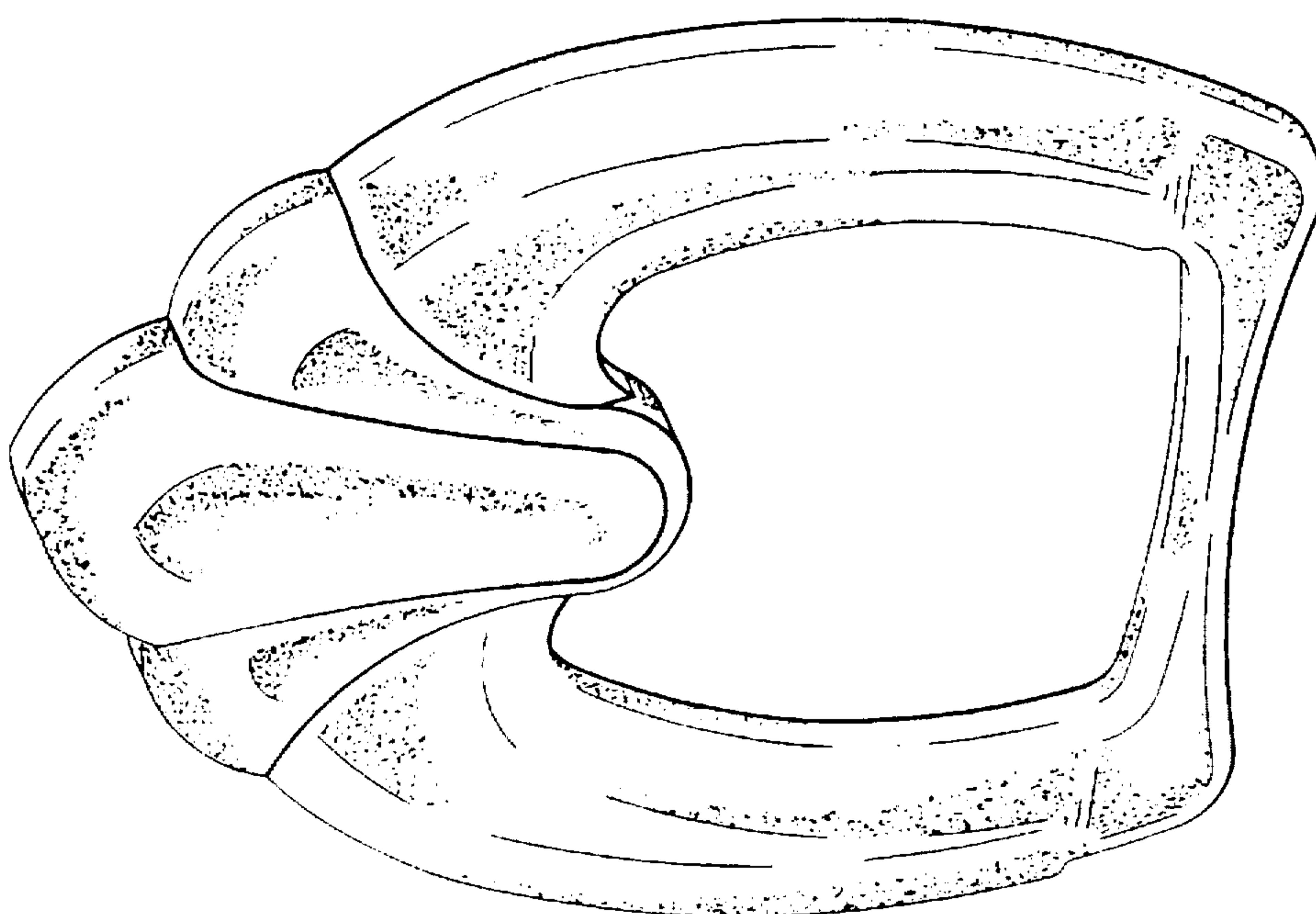

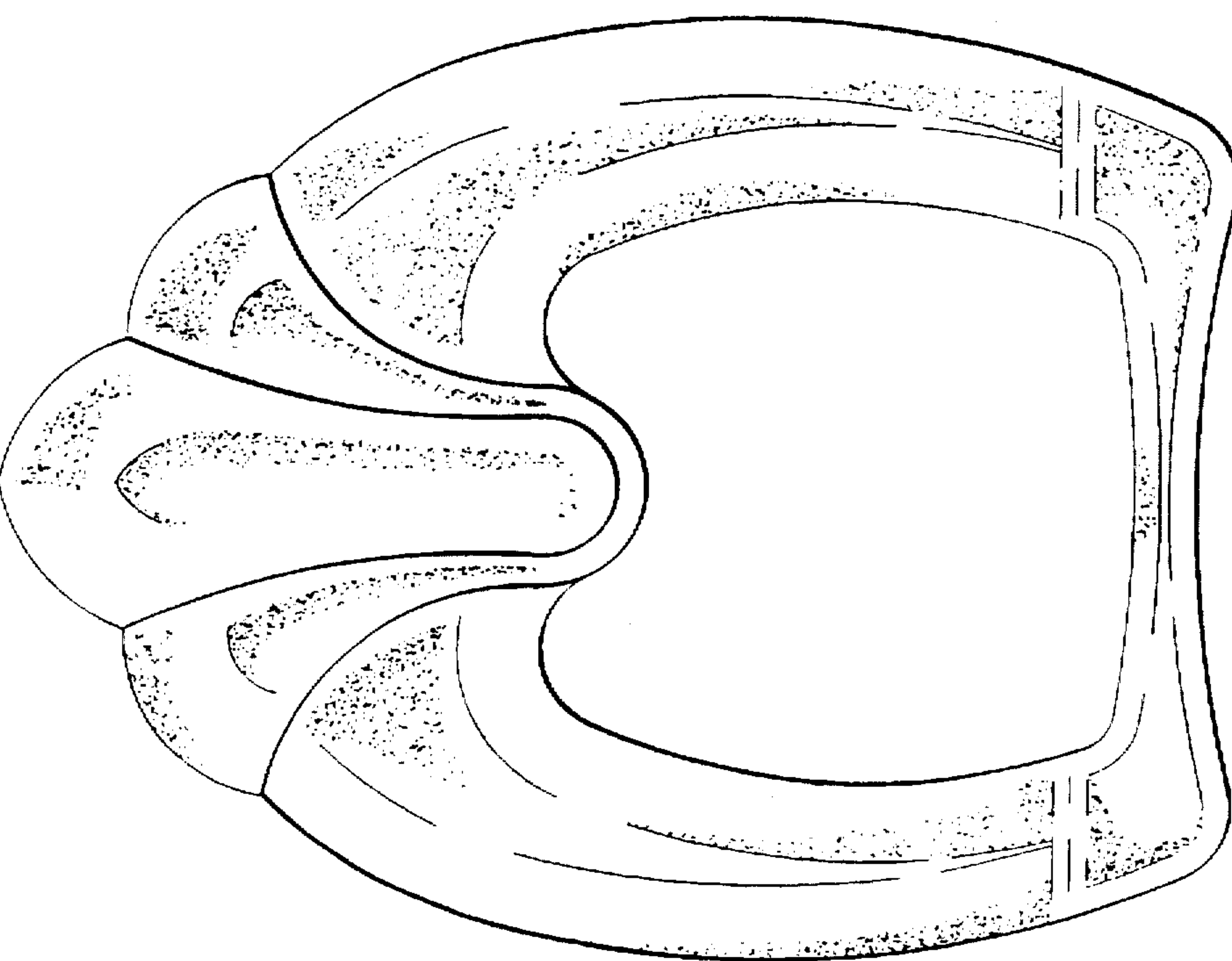

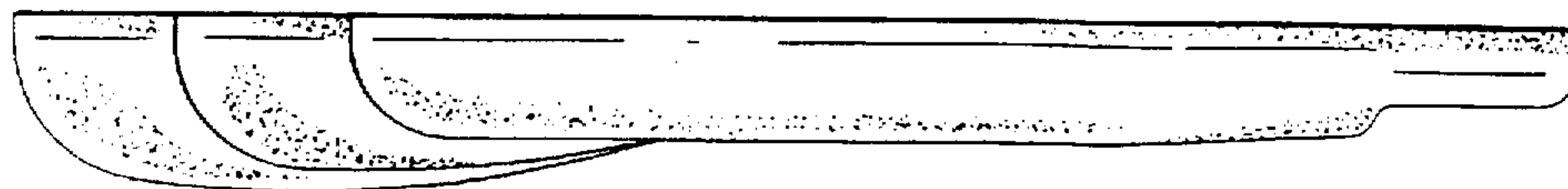

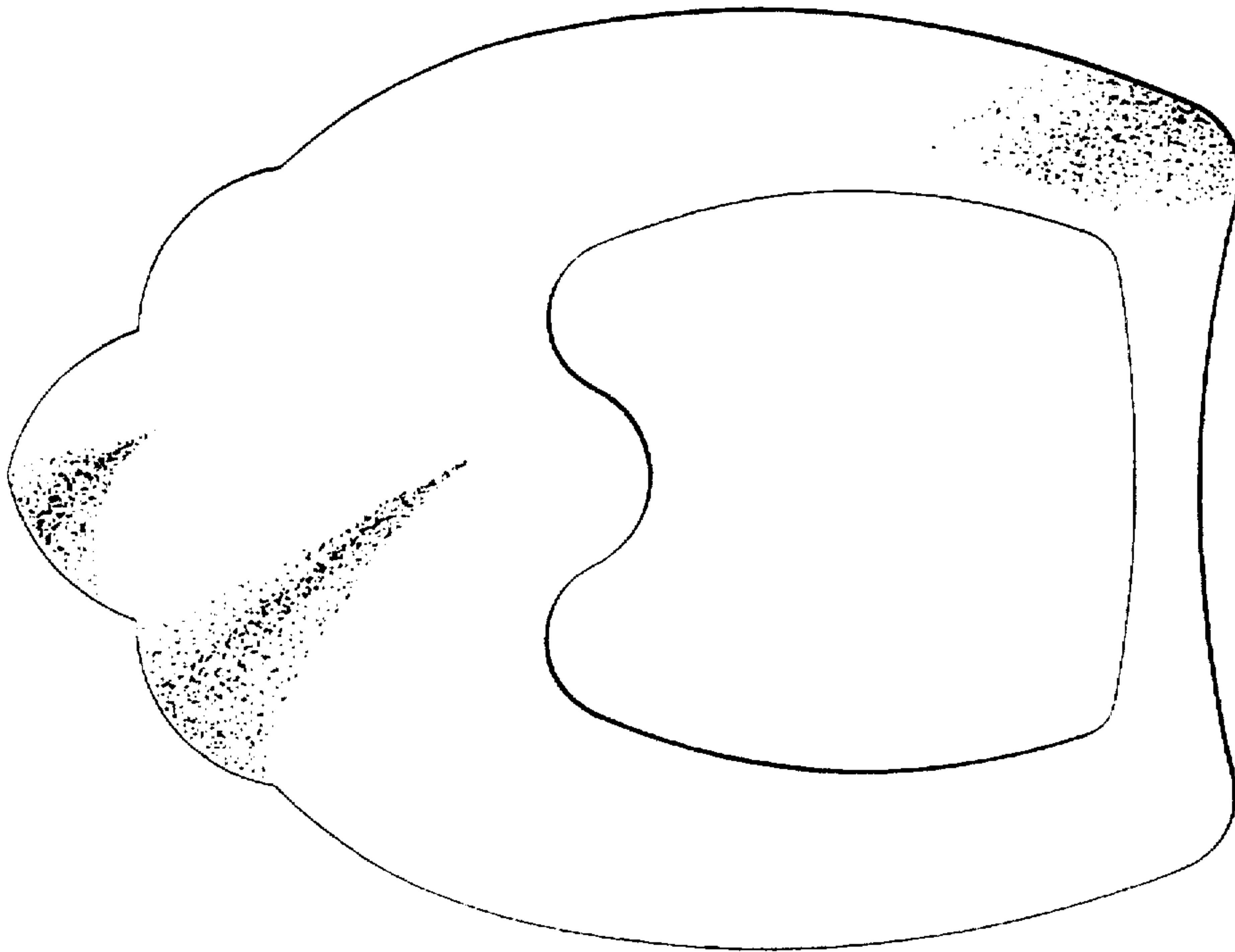

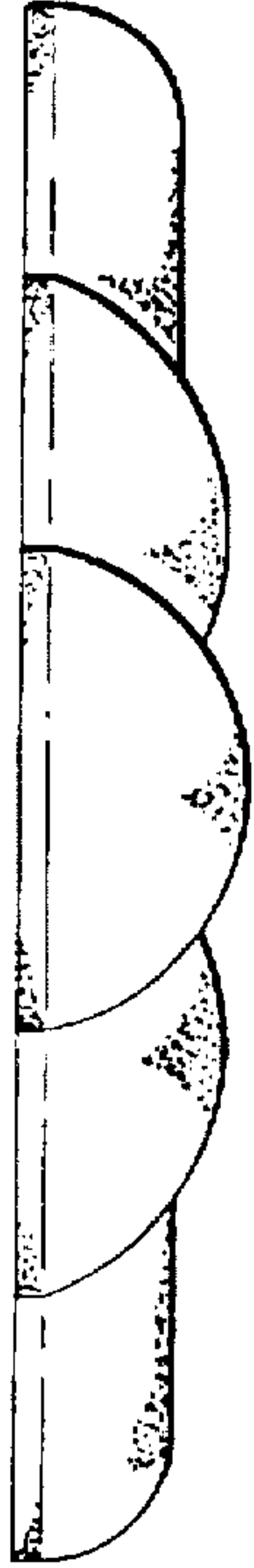

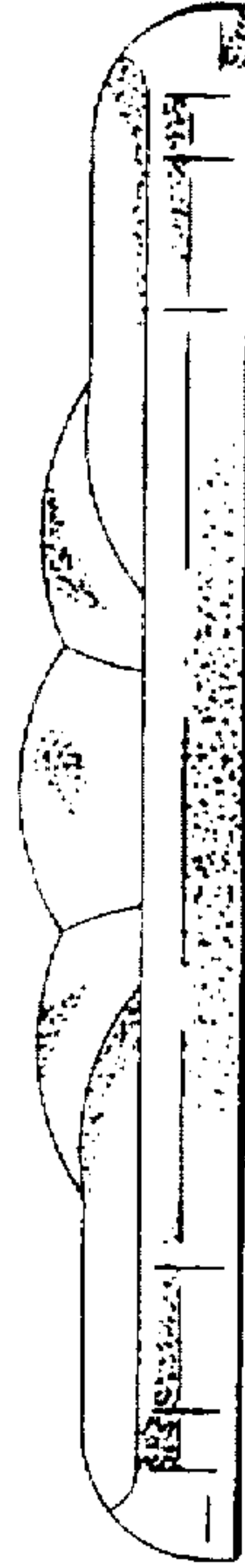
