The ornamental design for an advertizing carrying body for
use on a filler gun, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an advertising carrying
body for use on a filler gun showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view from below and other side
of the carrying body;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view from above and one side
of the top member forming part of my new design;

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view from below and other side
of the top member.

FIG. 5 is a front perspective view from above and one side
of the upper member forming part of my new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view from below and other side
of the upper member;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view from above and one side
of the lower member forming part of my new design; and,

FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view from below and other side
of the lower member.

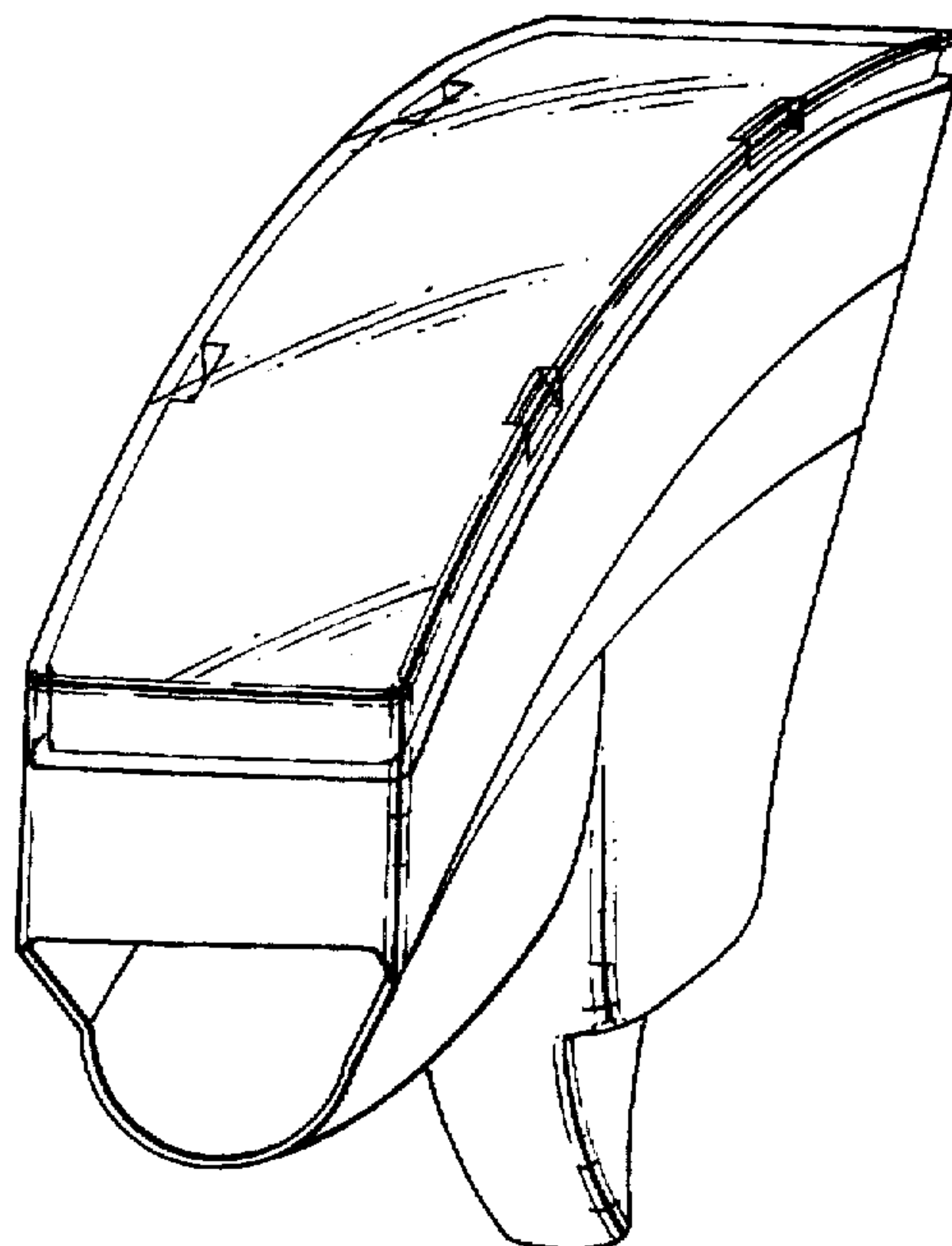

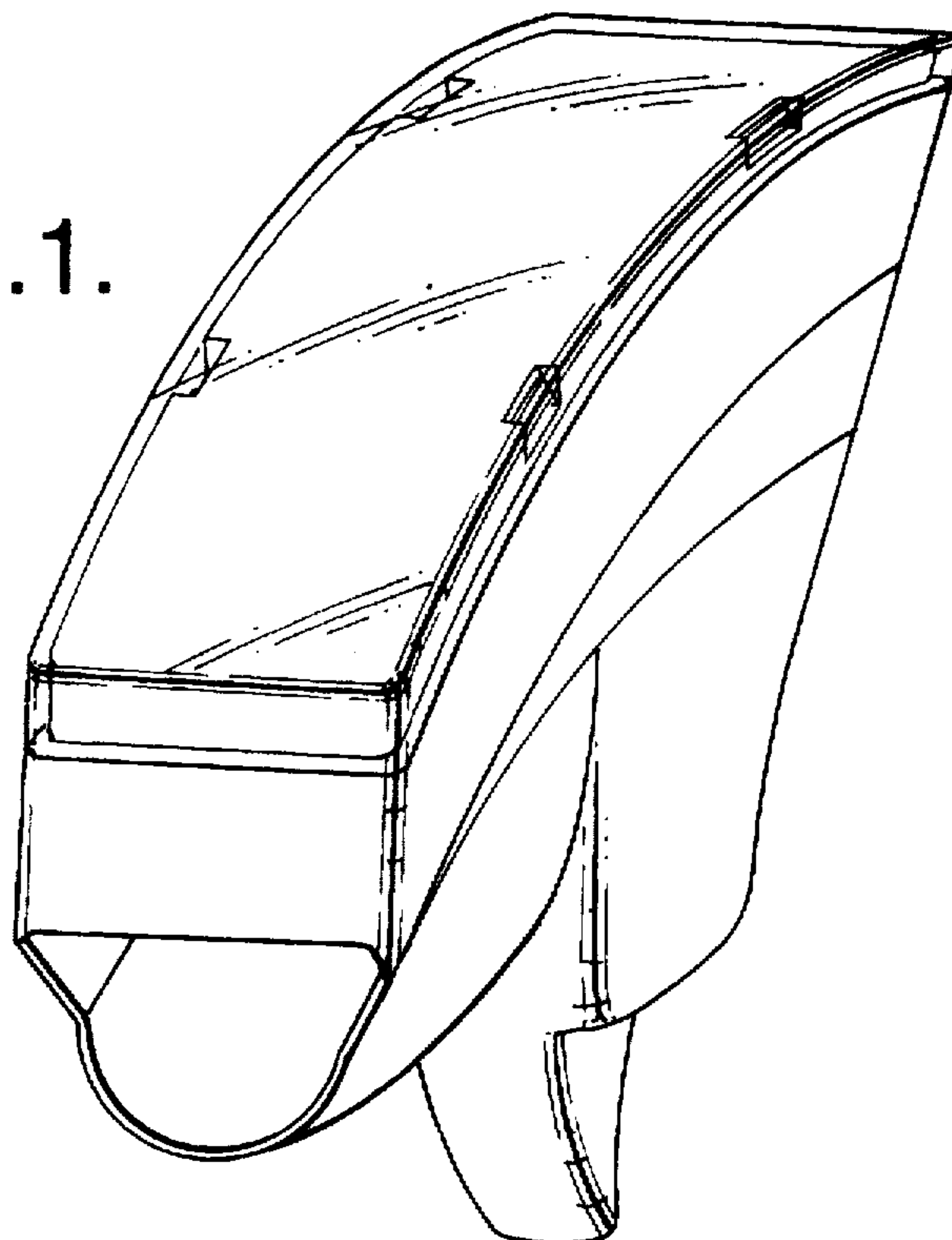

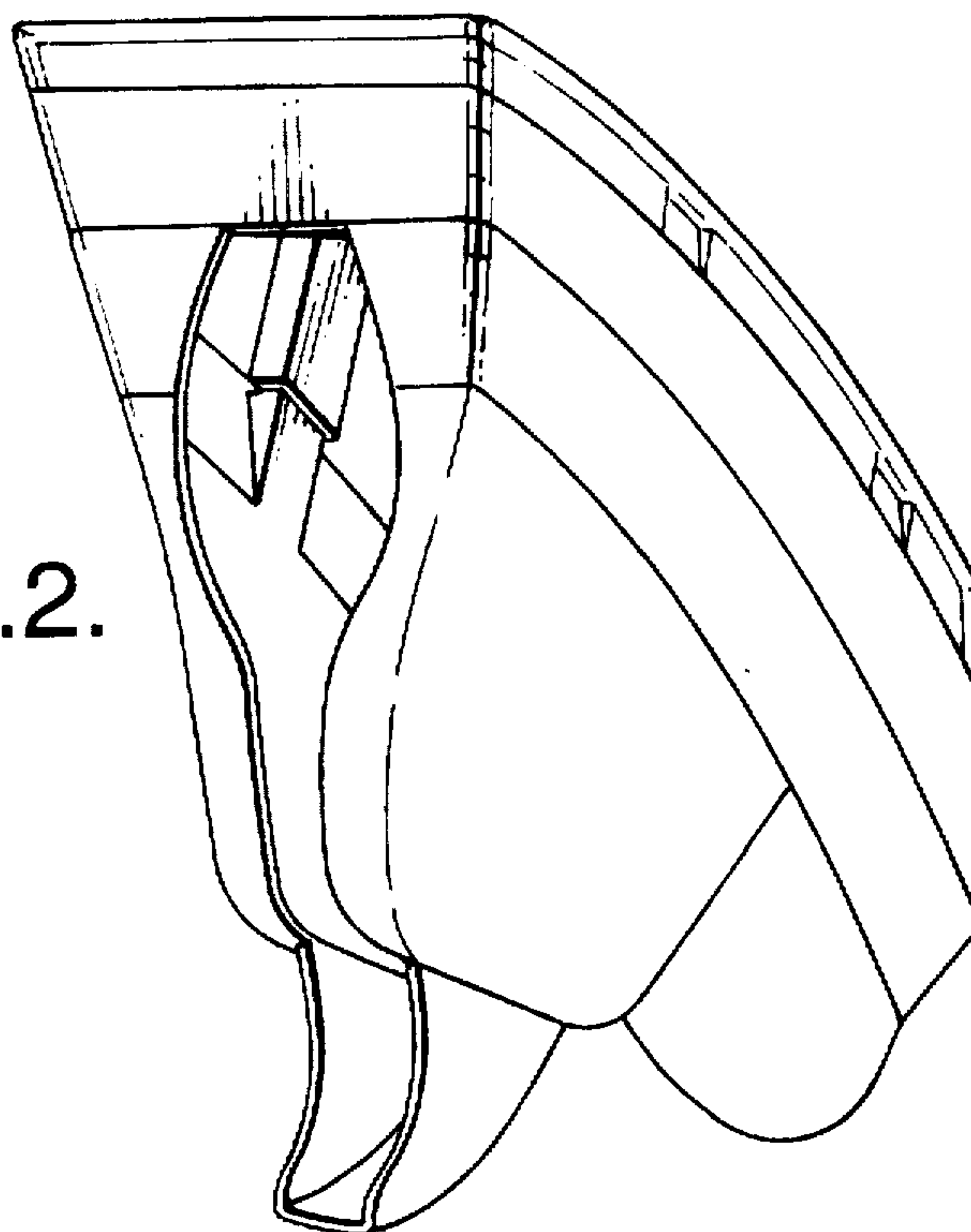

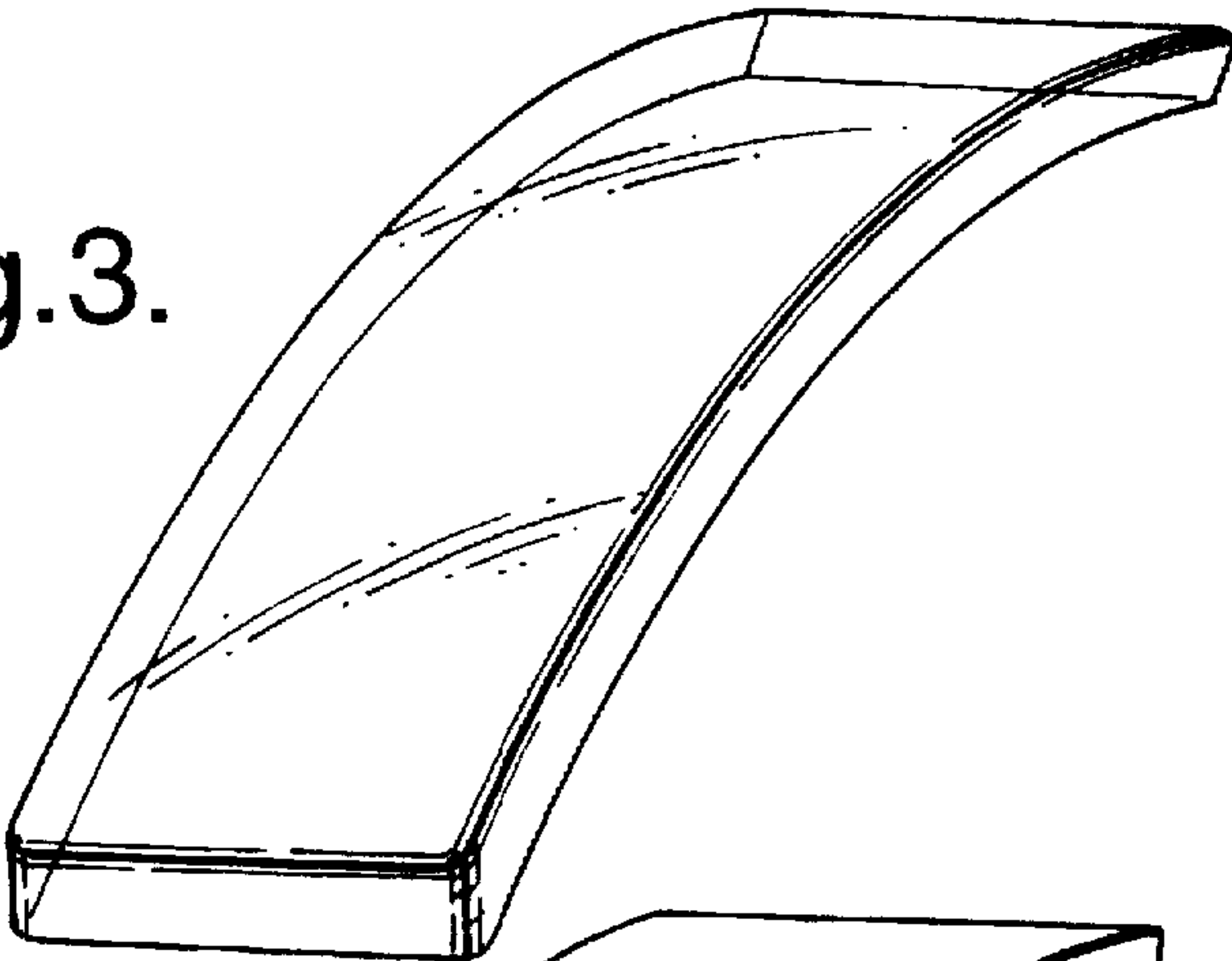

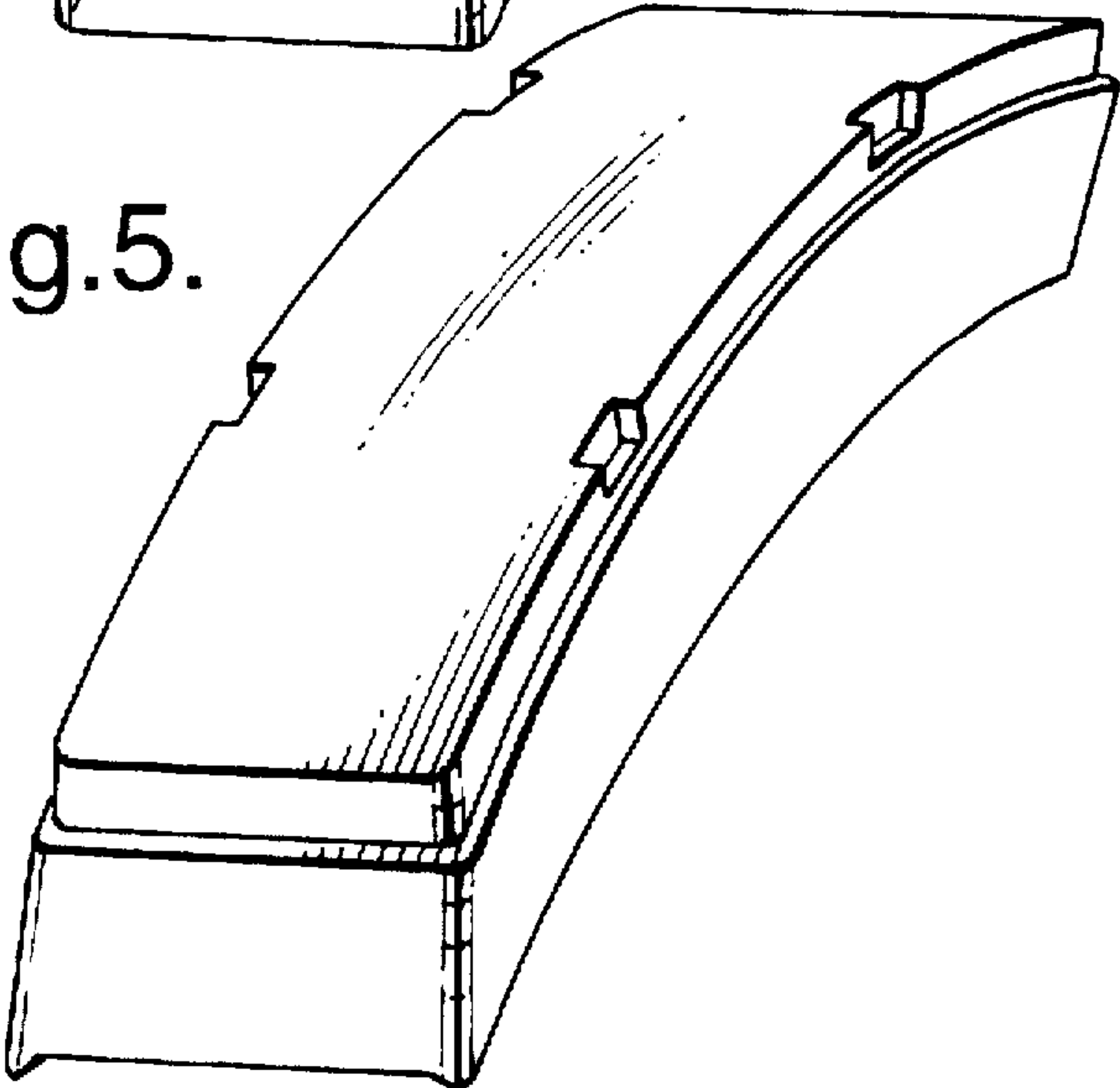

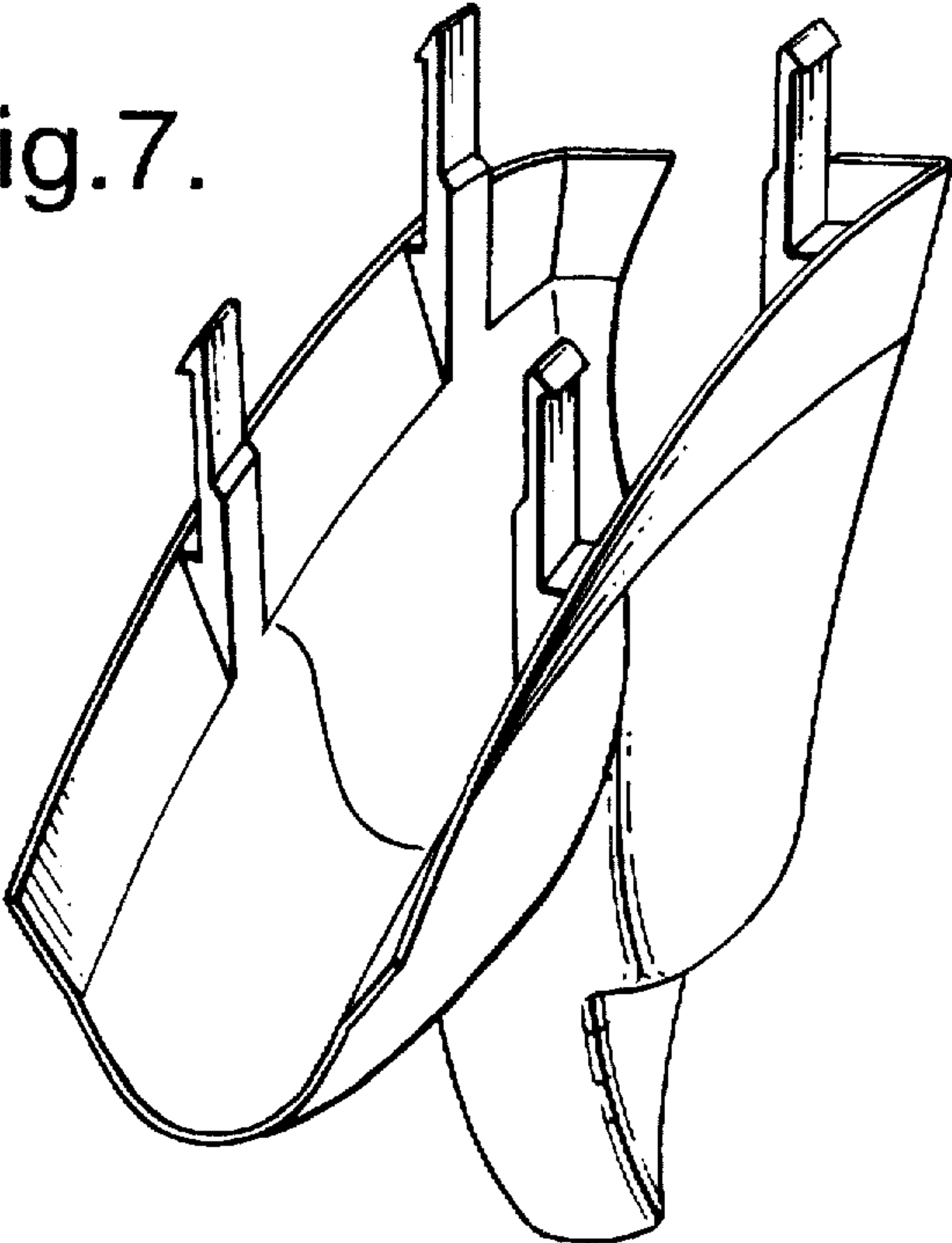

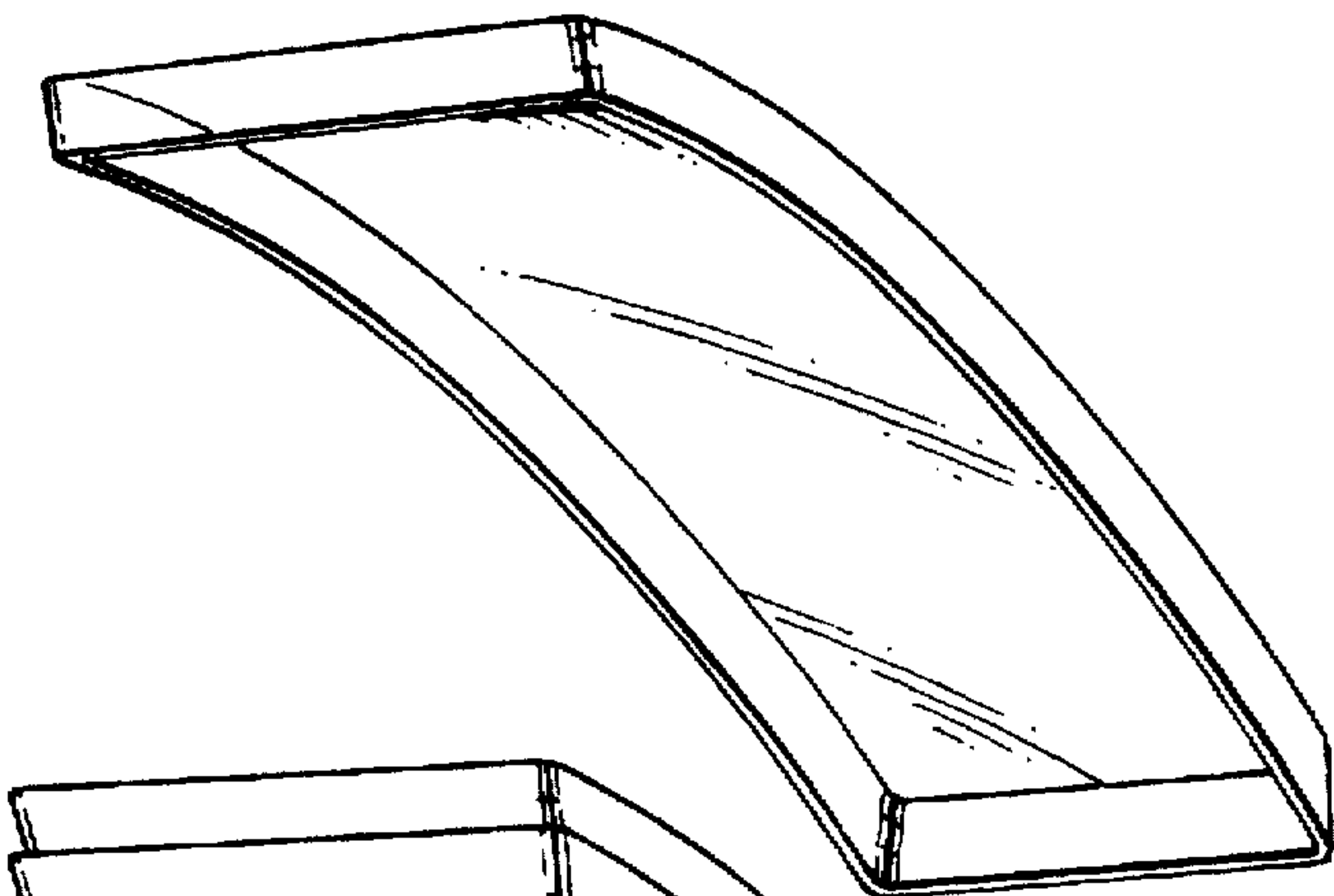

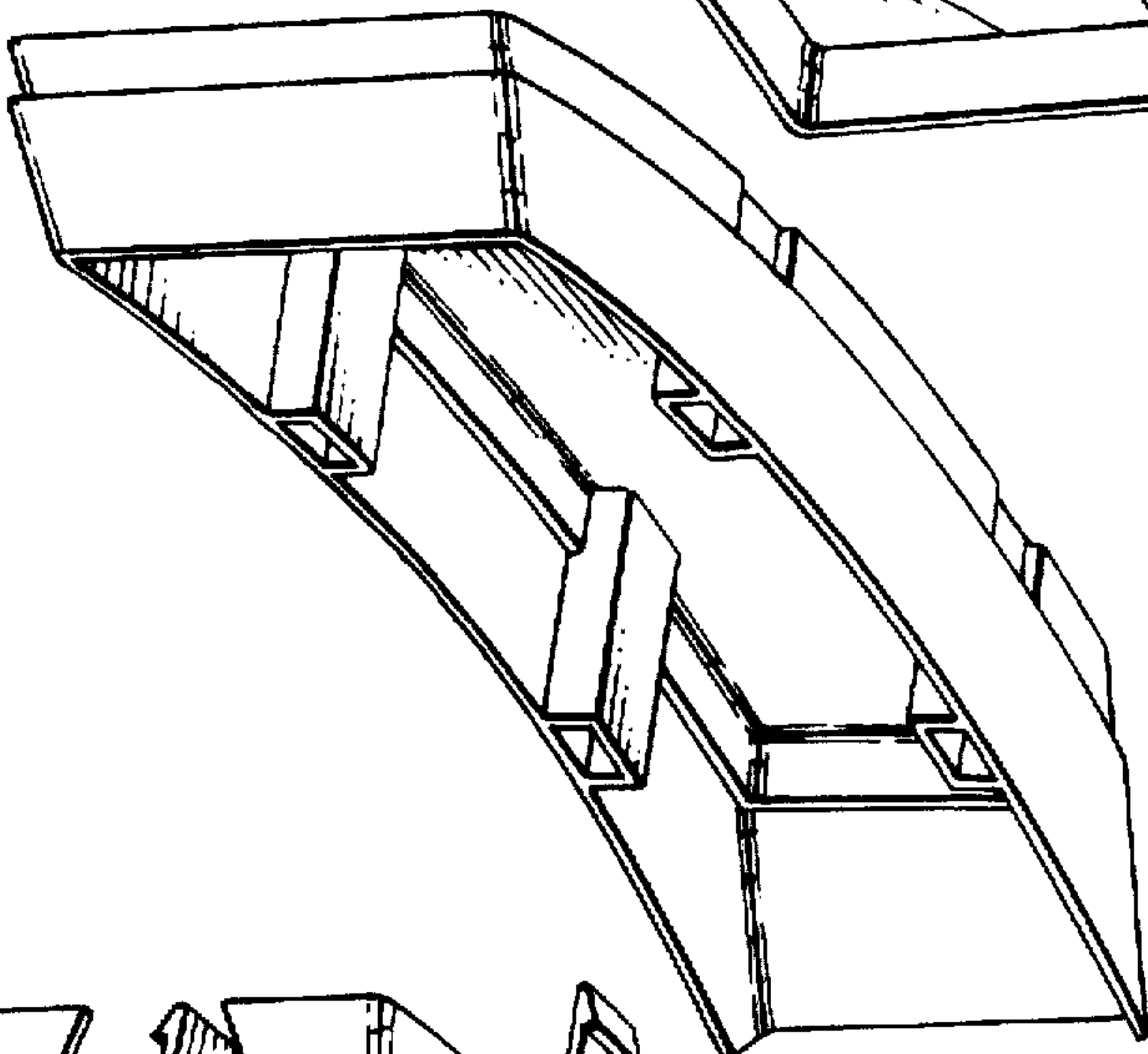
