[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a puppet hat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a puppet hat depicting my design; the broken line representing the arm and hand of a wearer is for illustration only and forms no part of the design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

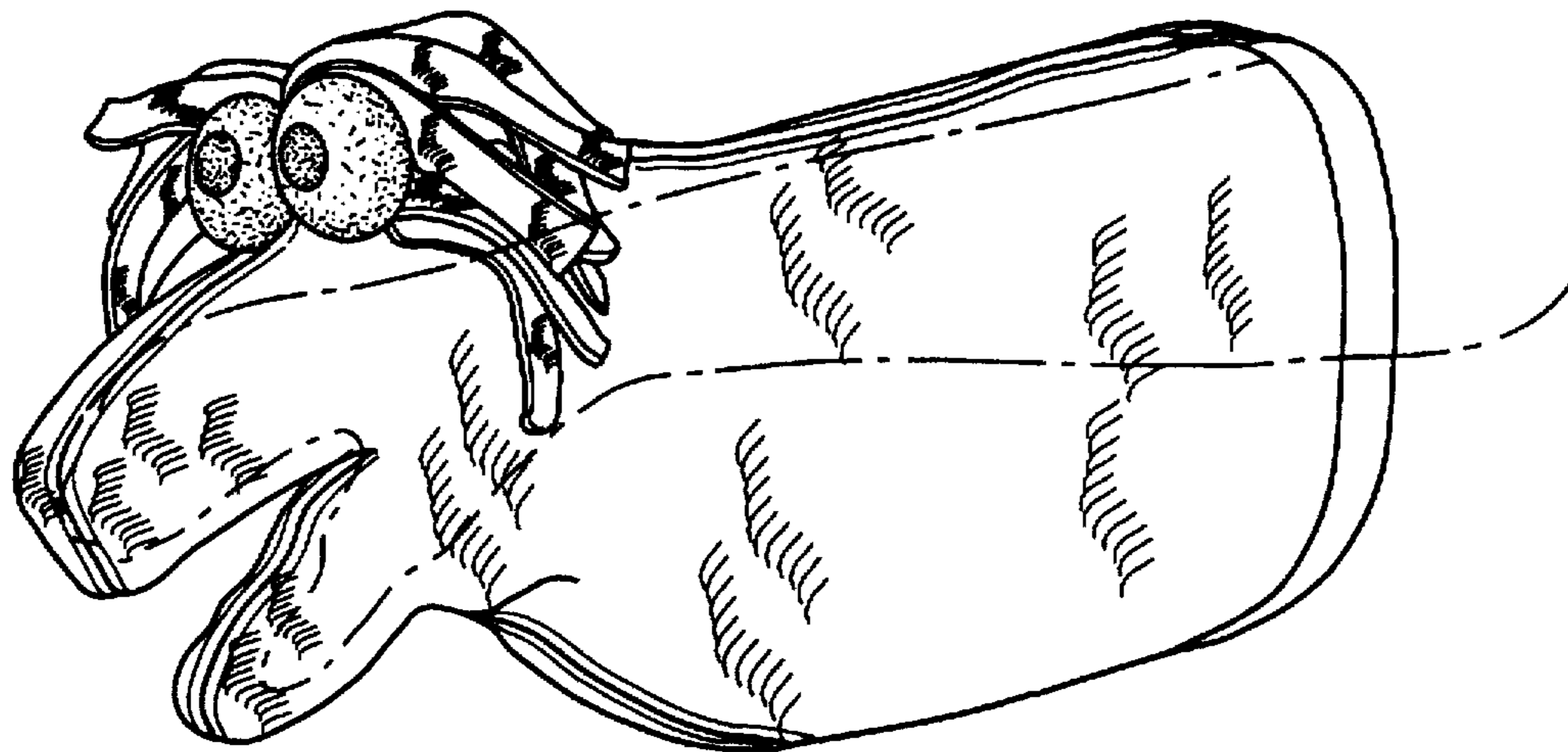
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view; the bottom plan view being plain and non-ornamental;

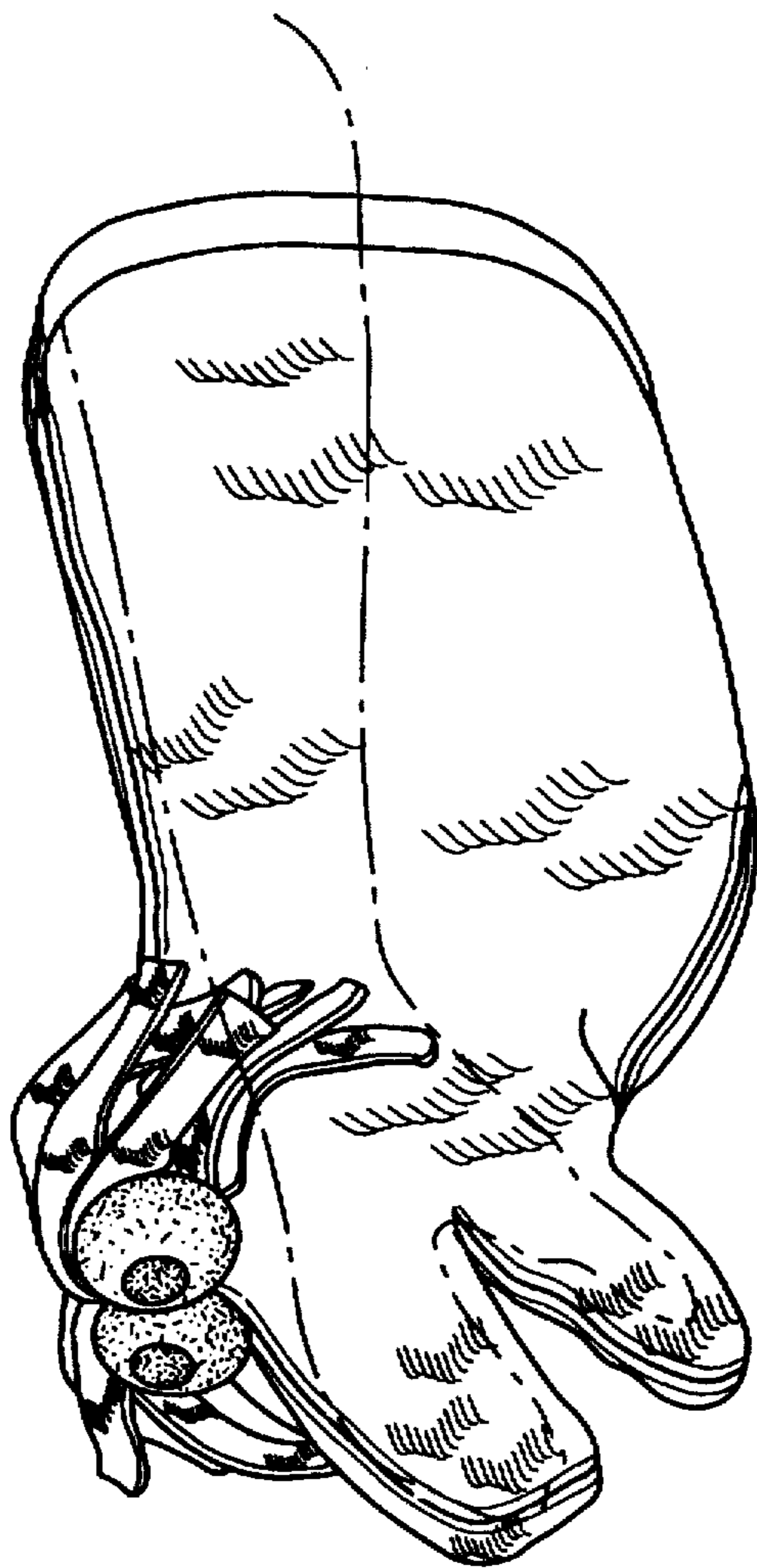

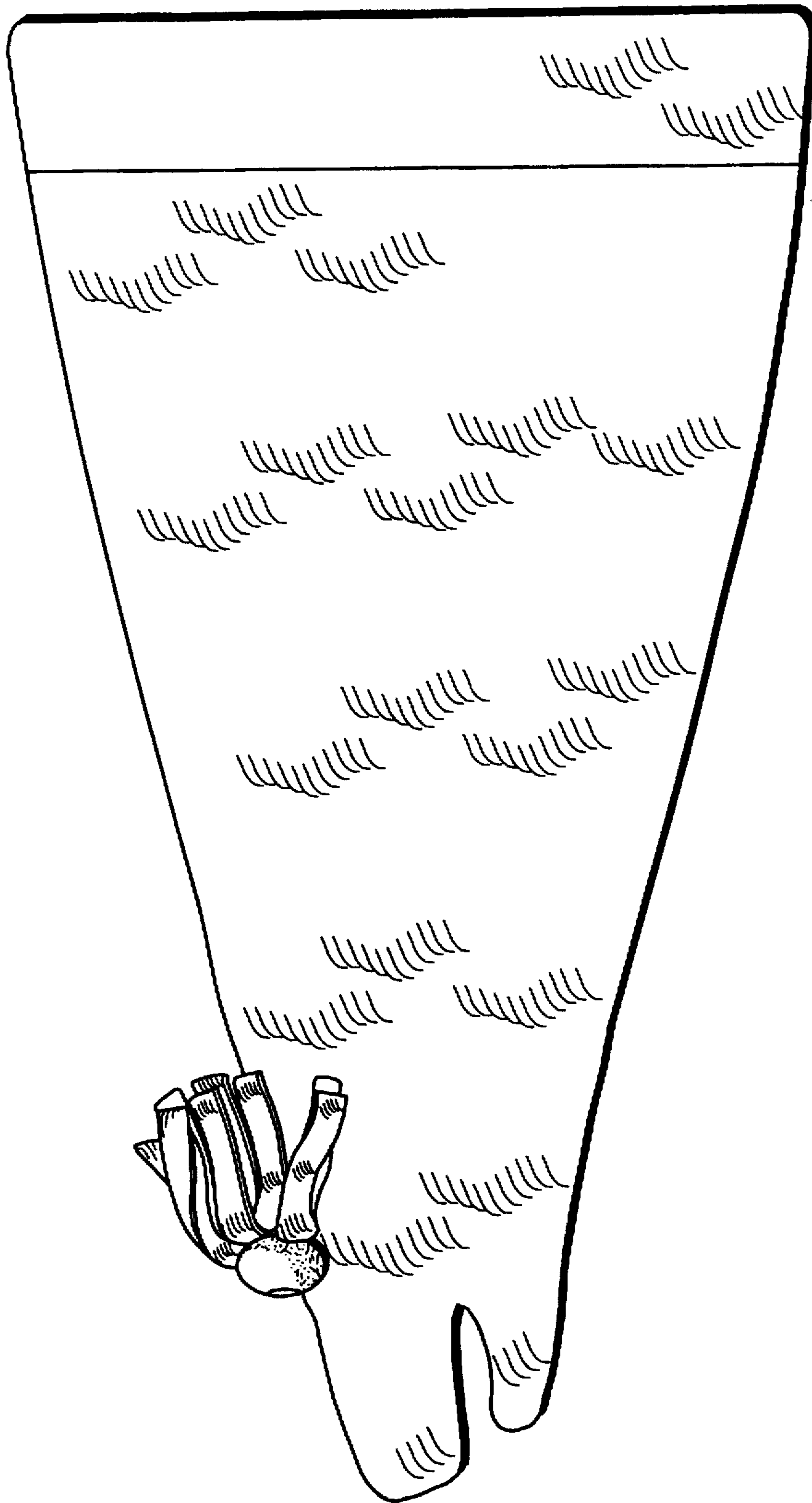

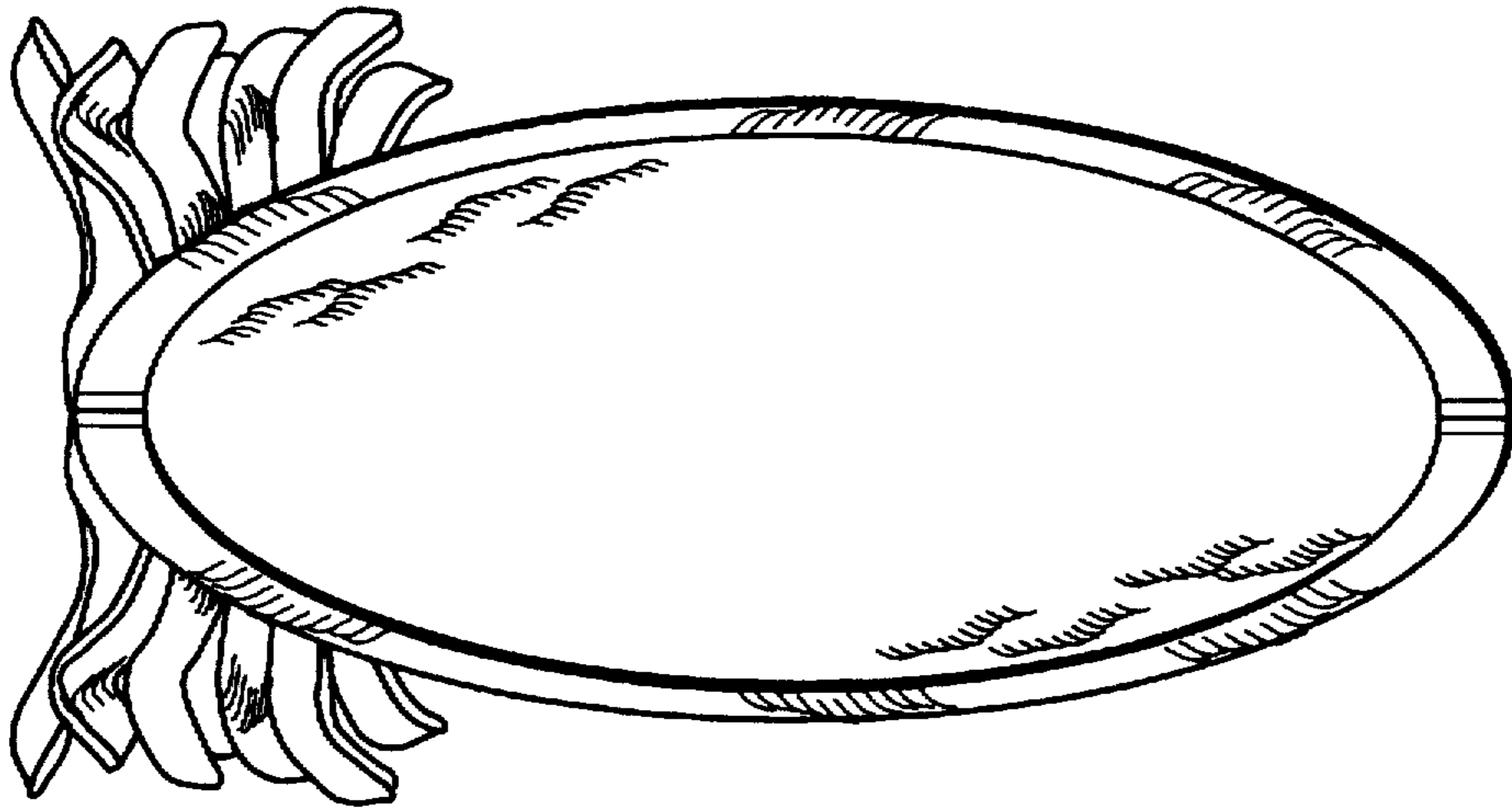

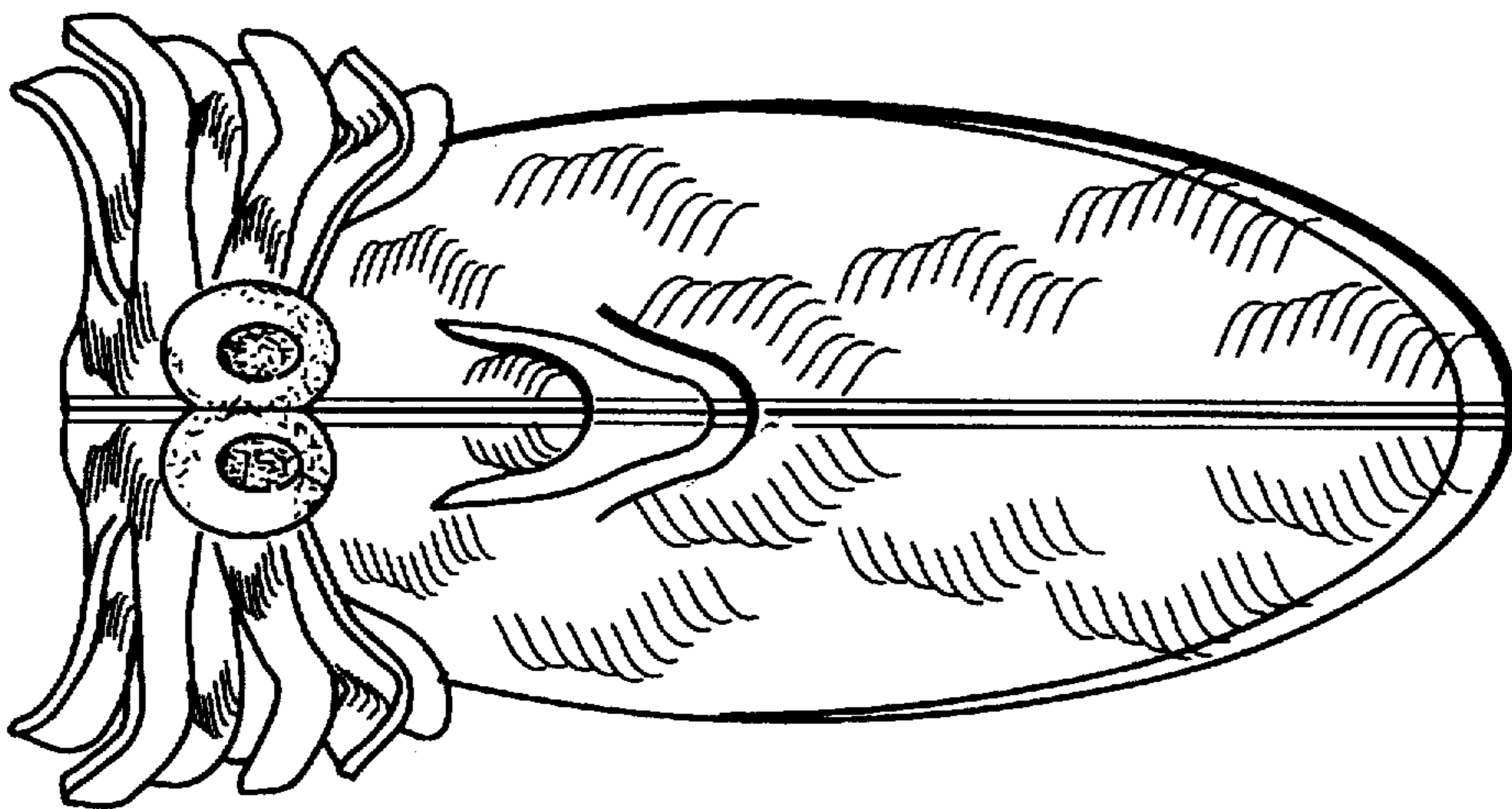

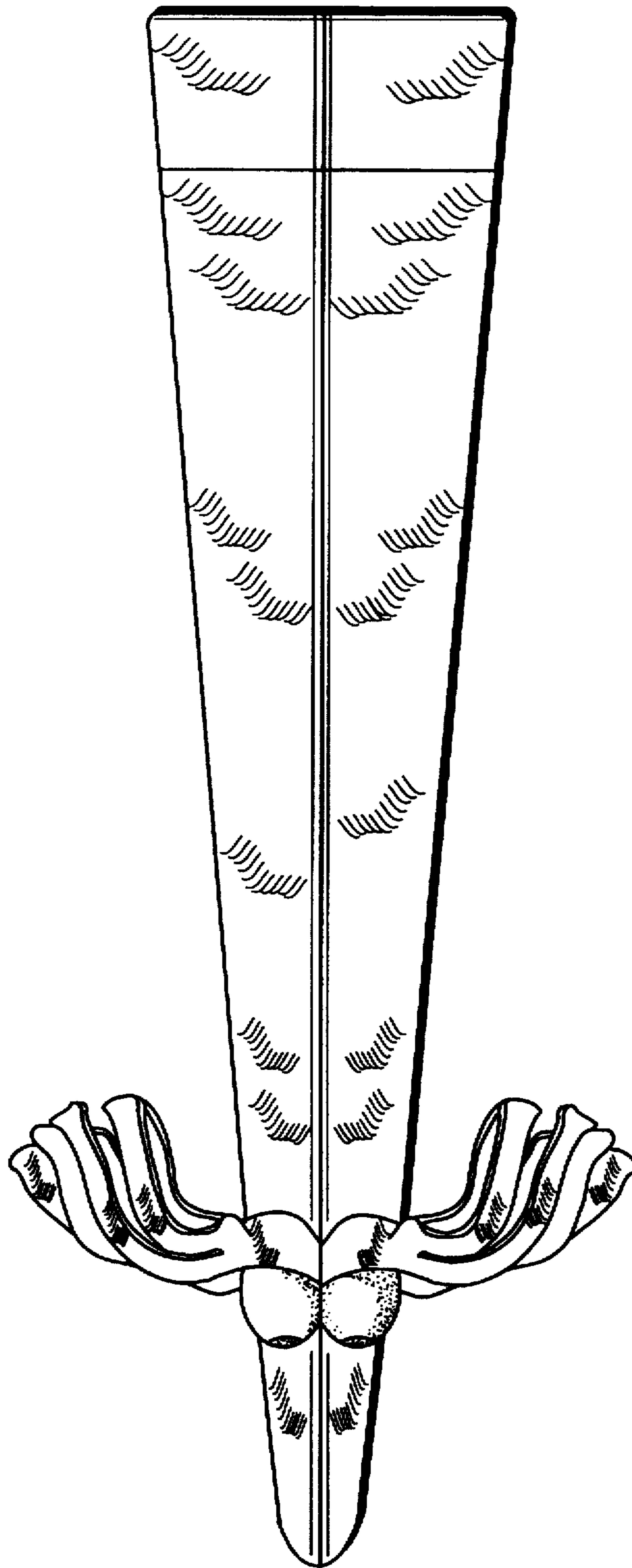

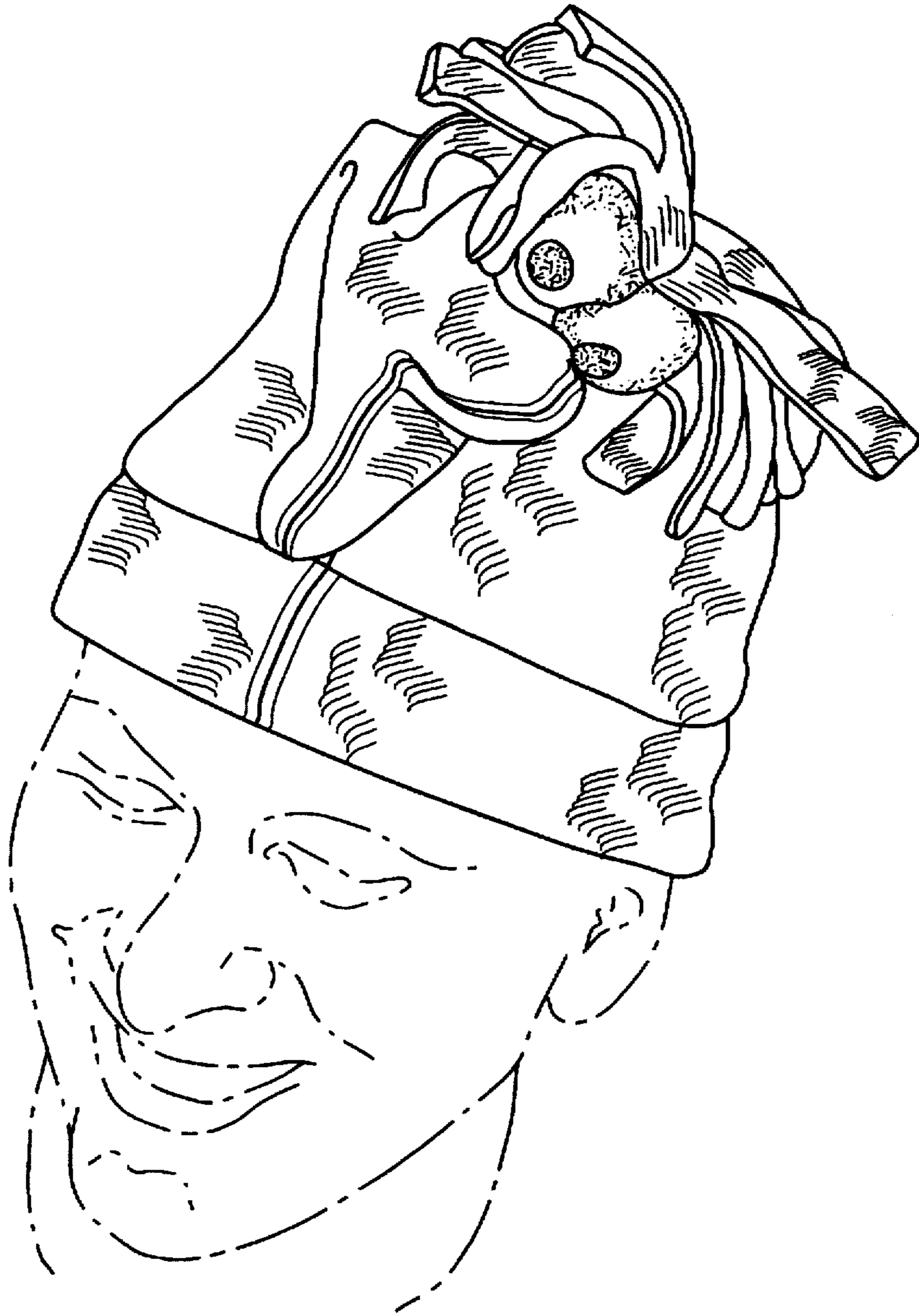
