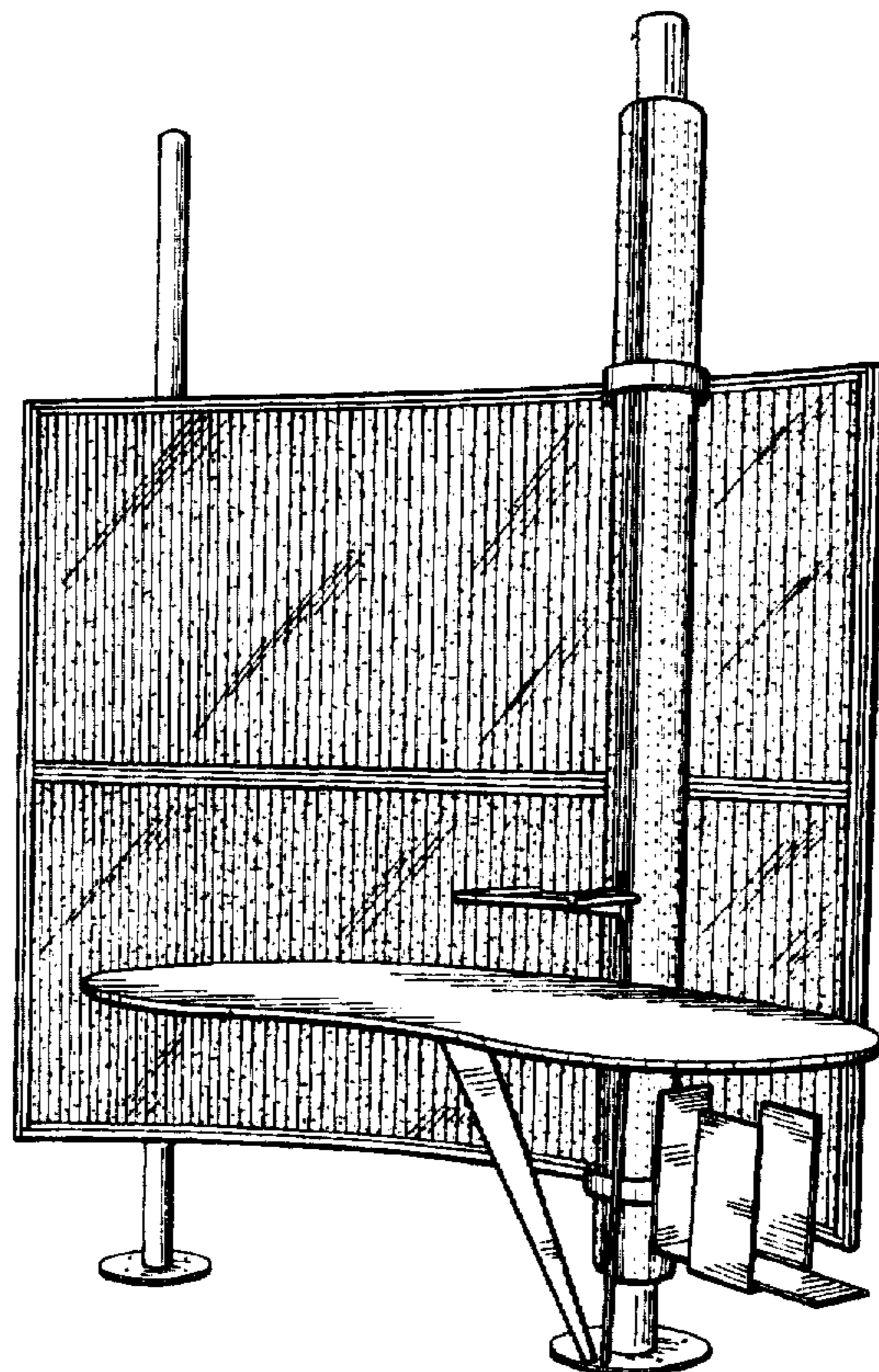
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a modular display stand with table, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a modular display stand with table embodying the new and ornamental design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof shown on an enlarged scale; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1 shown on a greatly reduced scale; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of FIG. 3; FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 3; FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 3; FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 3; FIG. 9 is a greatly enlarged fragmentary elevational view showing the pattern of circles on the front of the display panel encircled as number 9 in FIG. 2, it being understood that the pattern repeats uniformly across the entire surface of the front and the rear of the panel; and, FIG. 10 is an enlarged fragmentary section view taken along line 10—10 in FIG. 2.

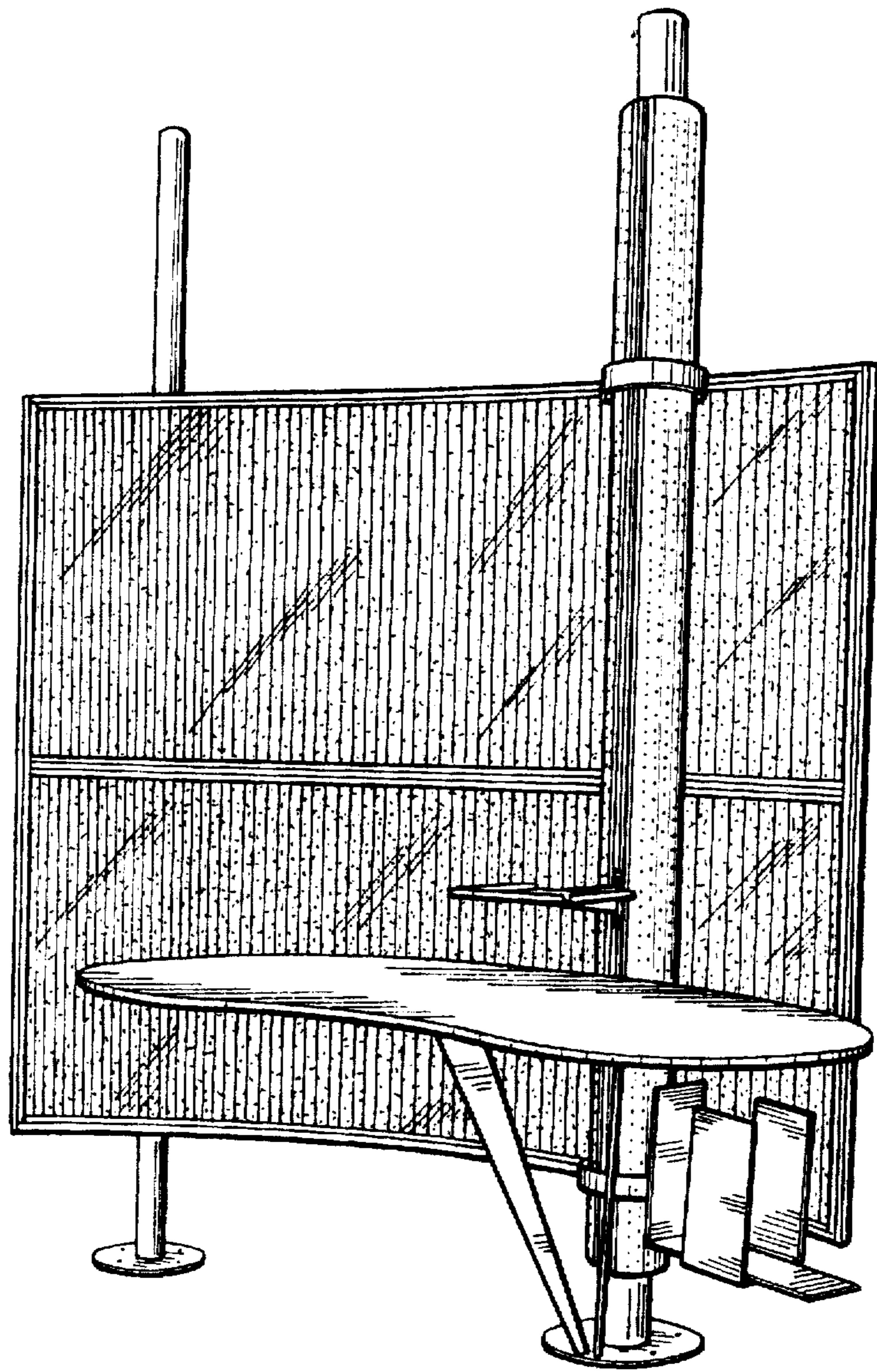

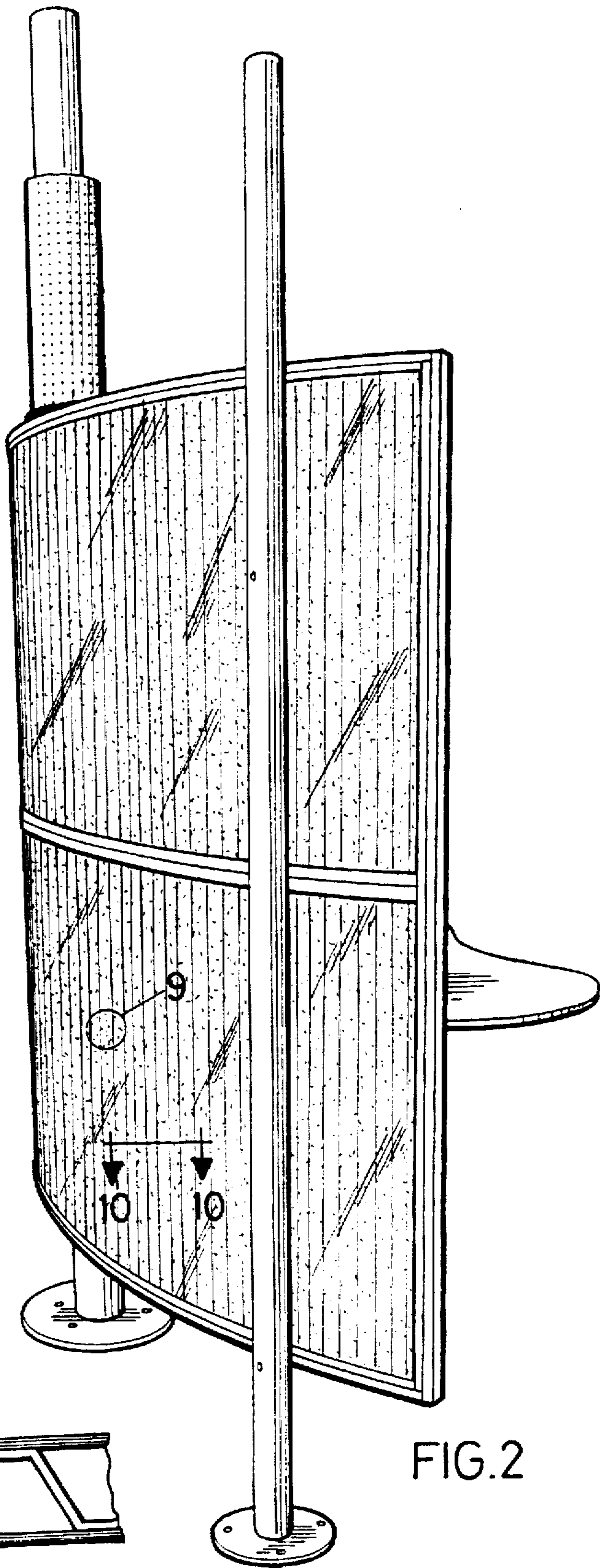

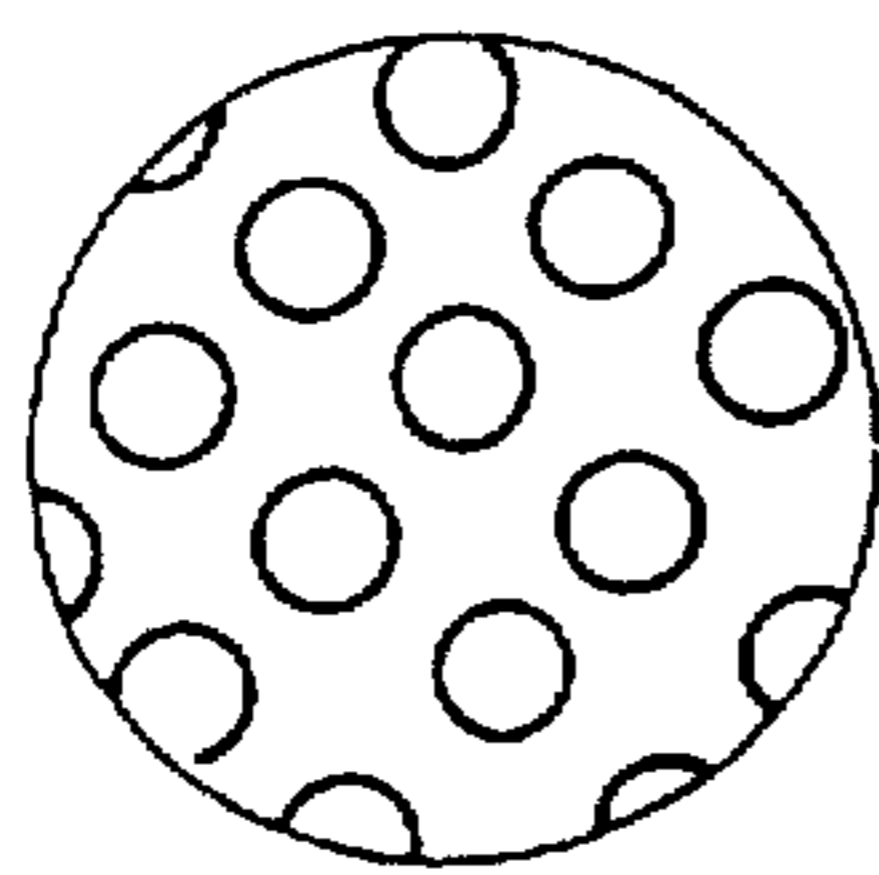

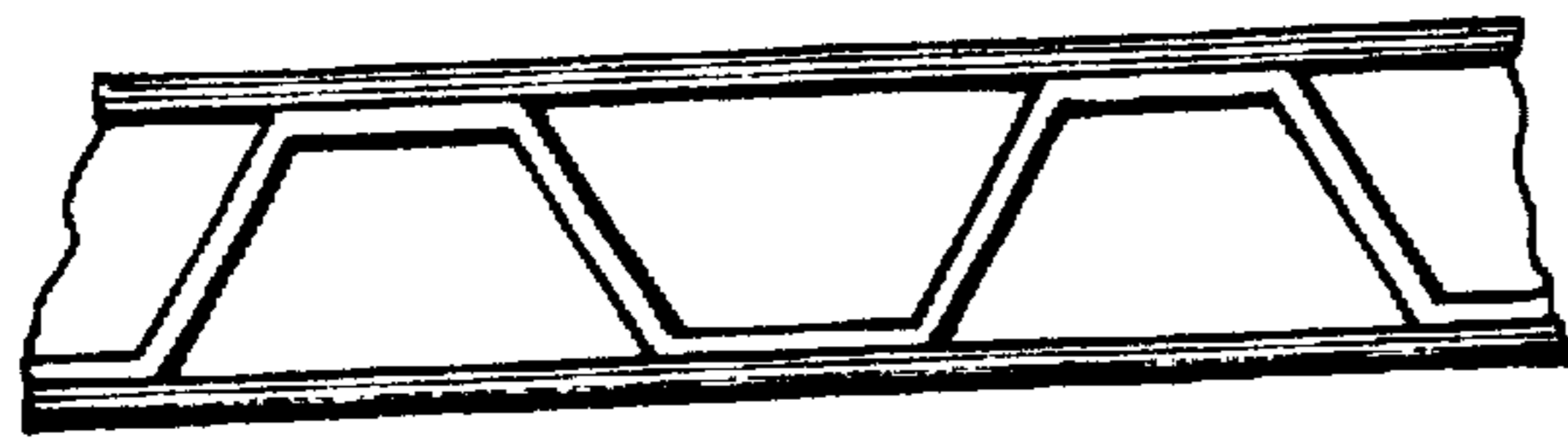

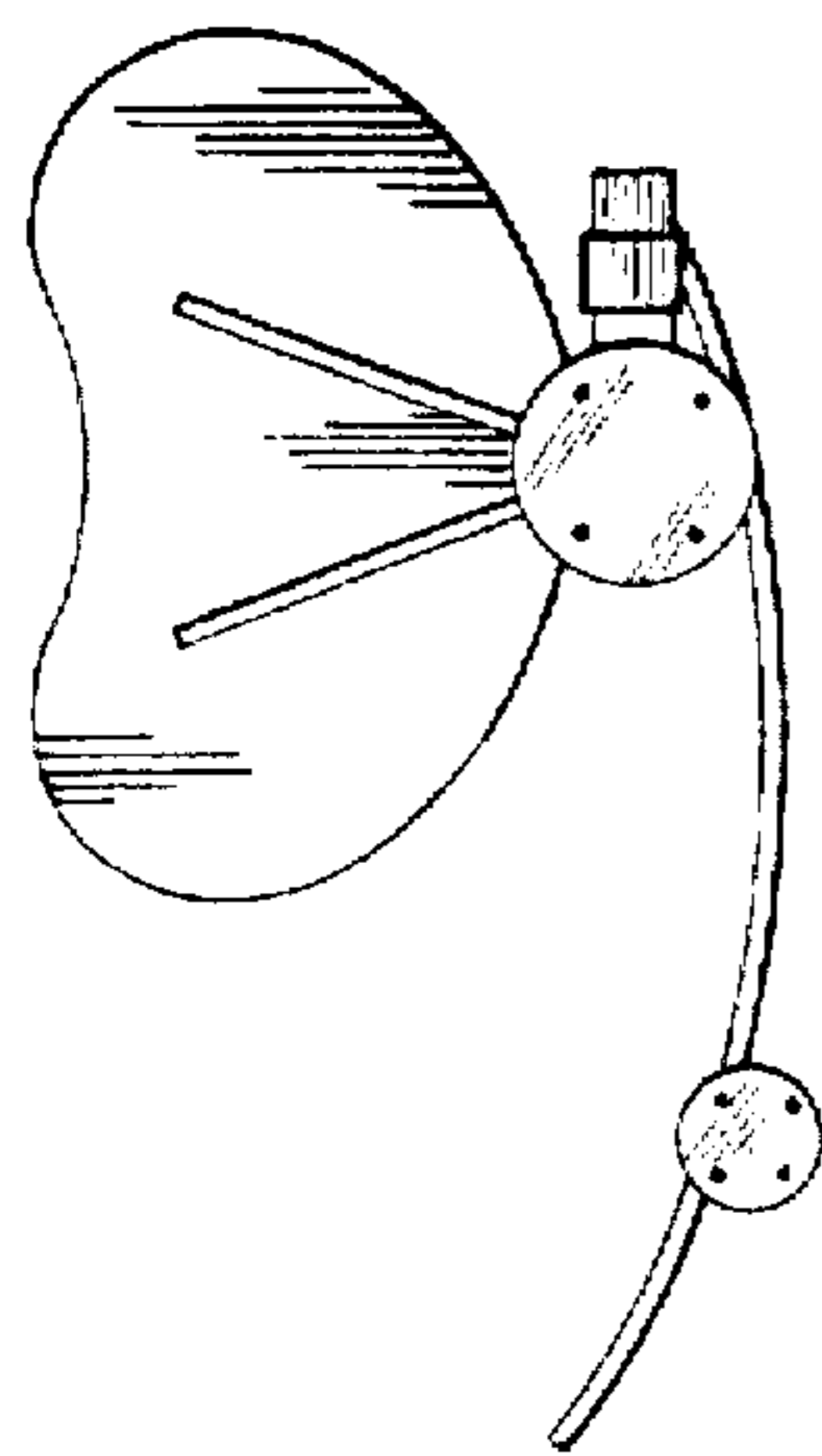

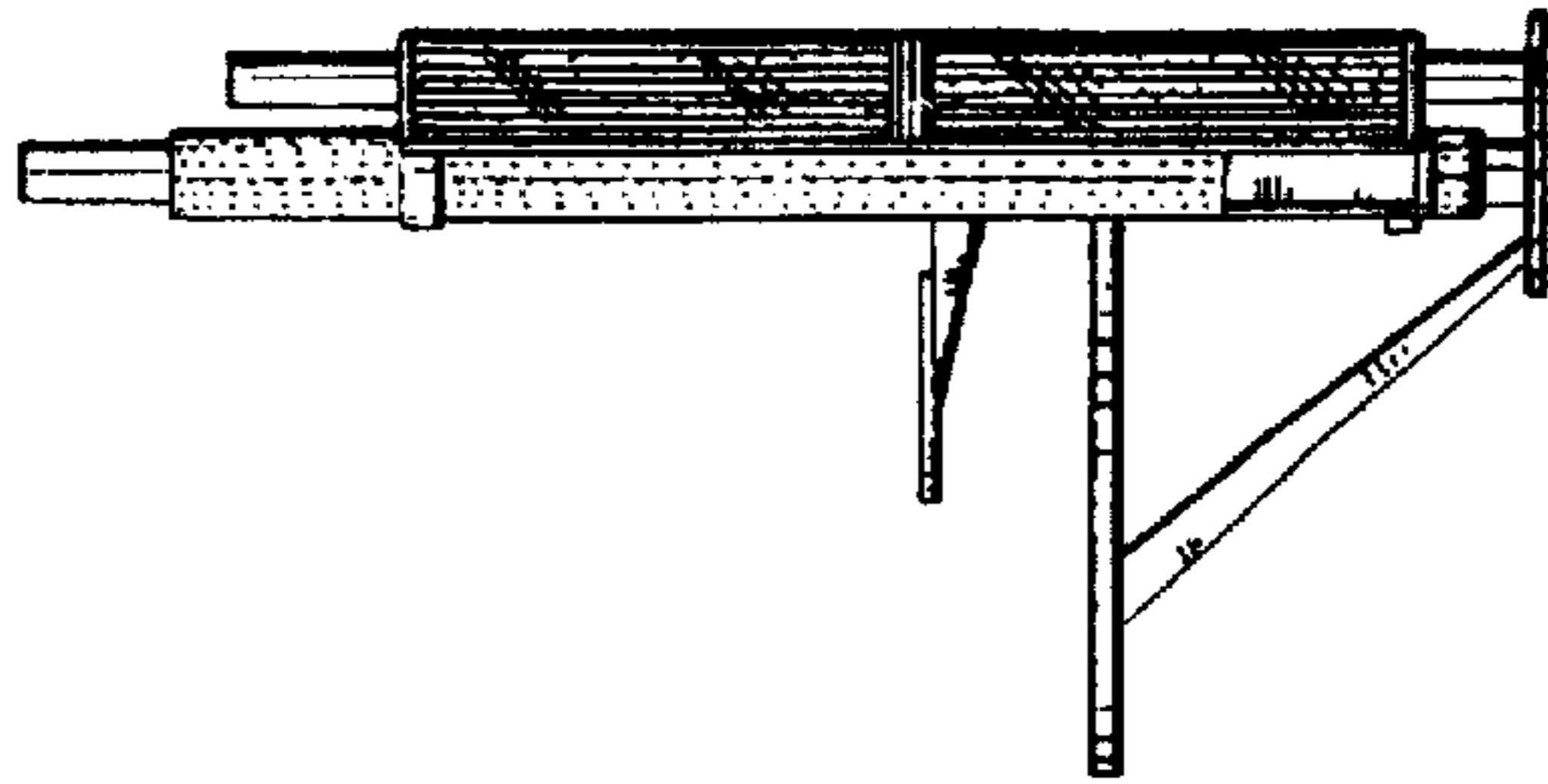

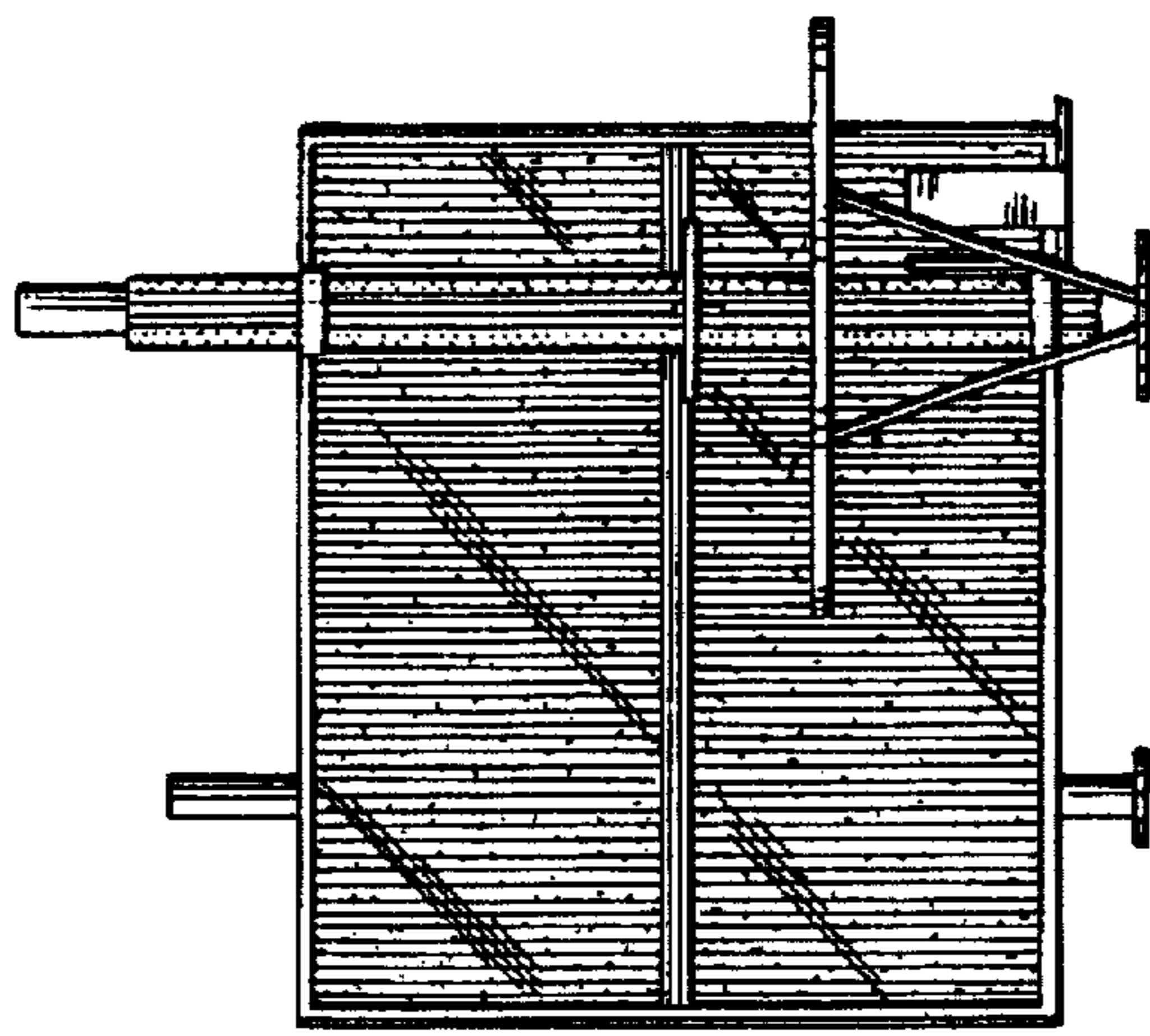

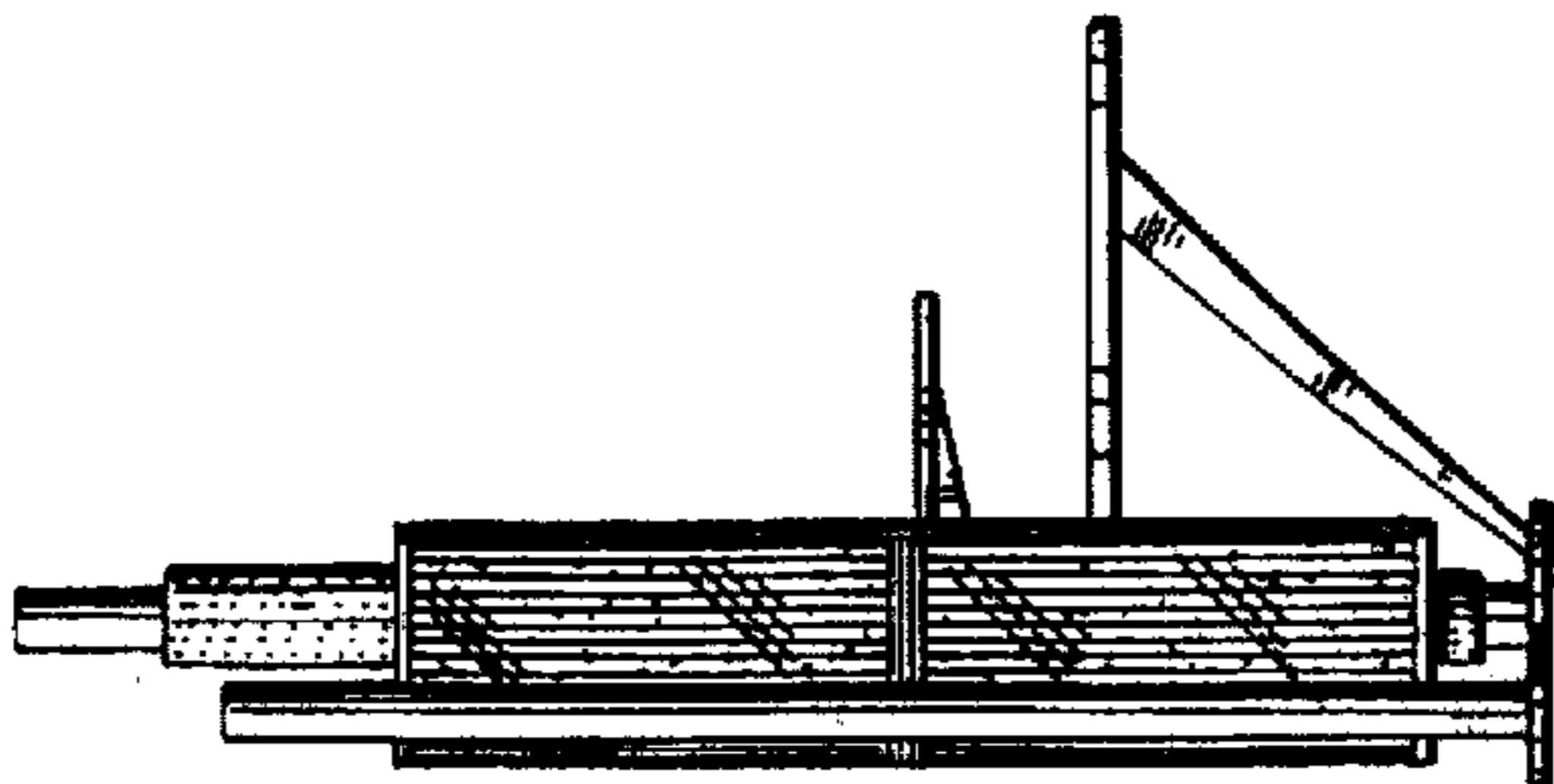

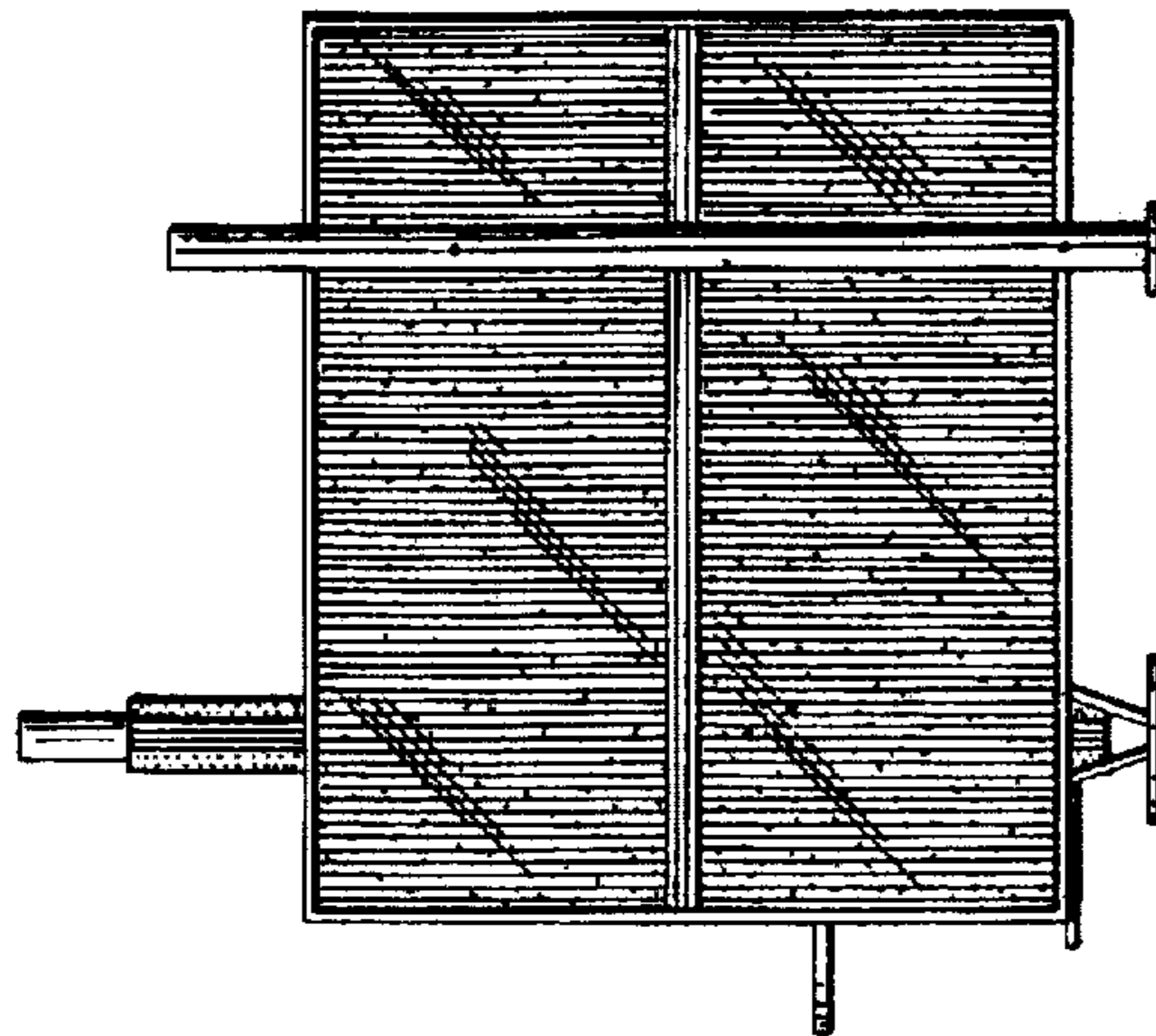

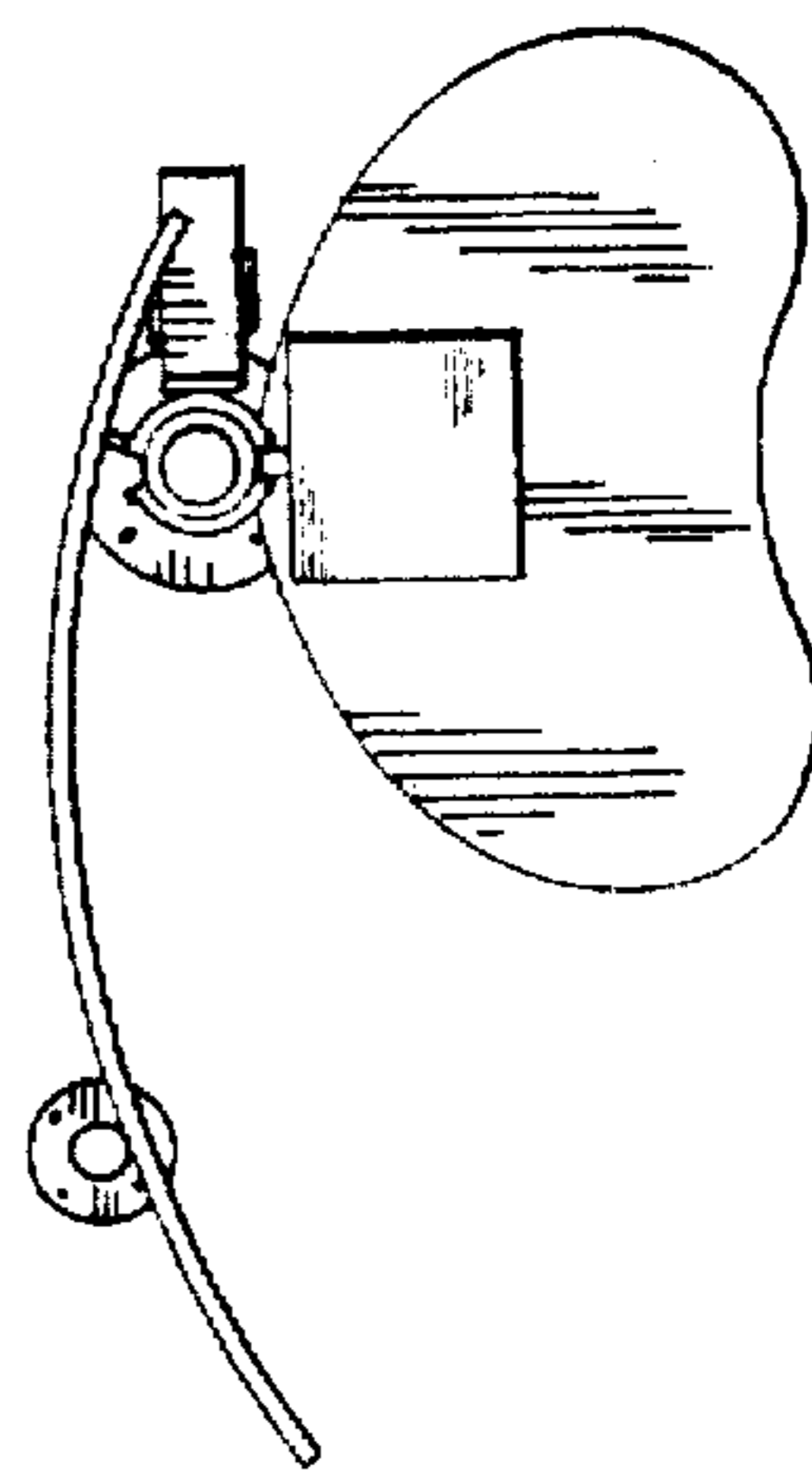
