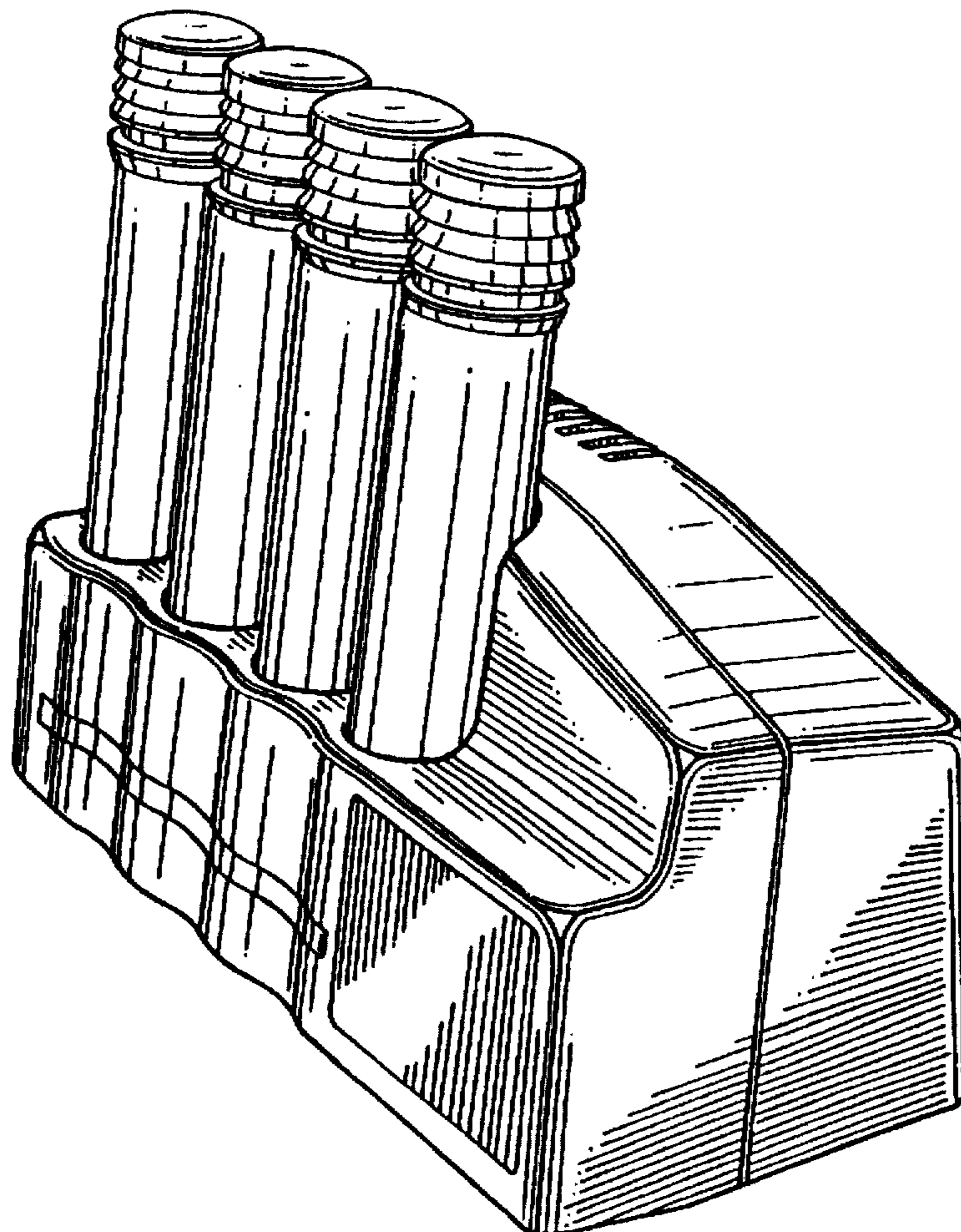
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined four port charger with batteries, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined port charger with batteries showing my new design with batteries; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1. The broken lines shown in FIGS. 3 through 7 are included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure only and form no part of the claimed design.

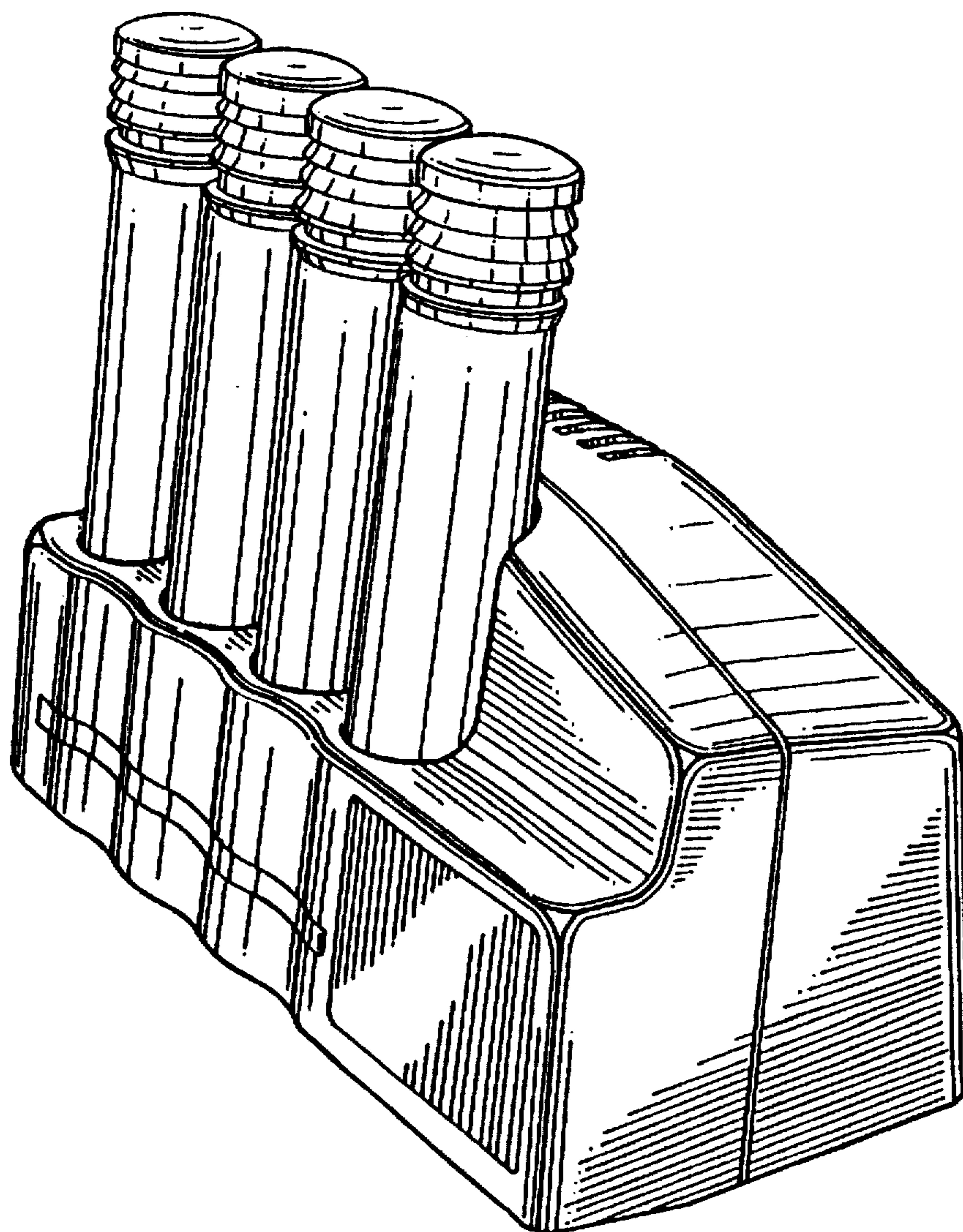

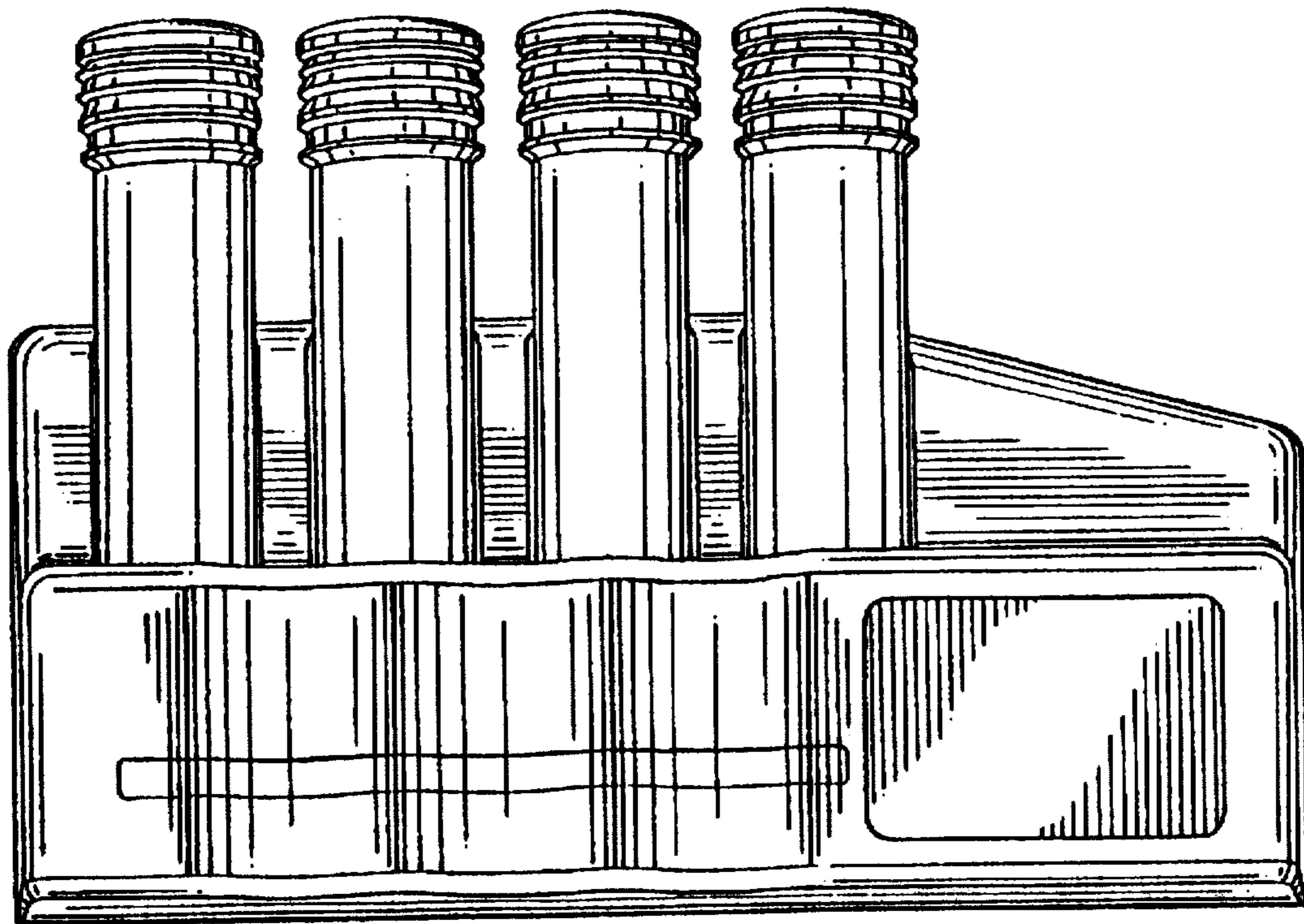

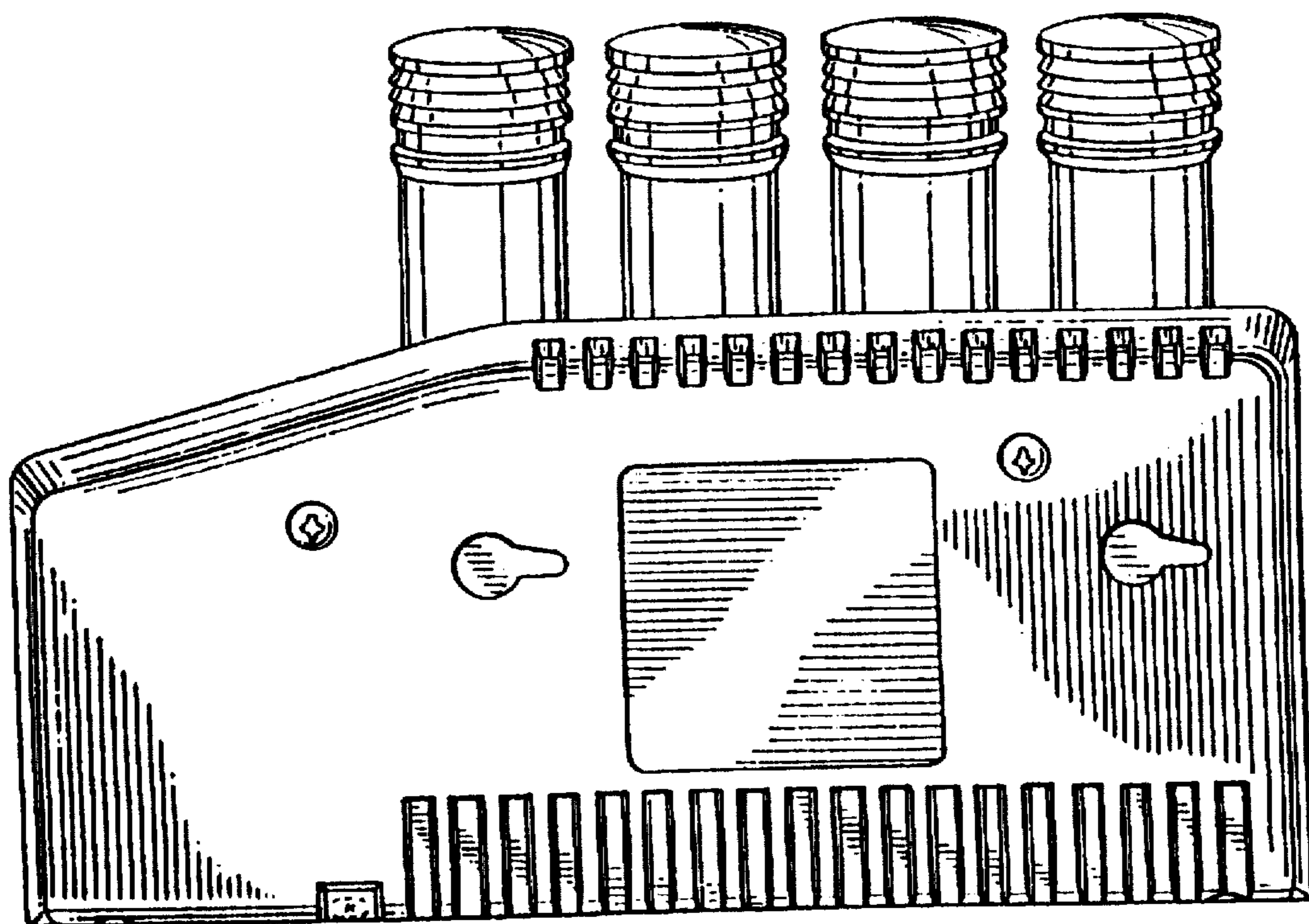

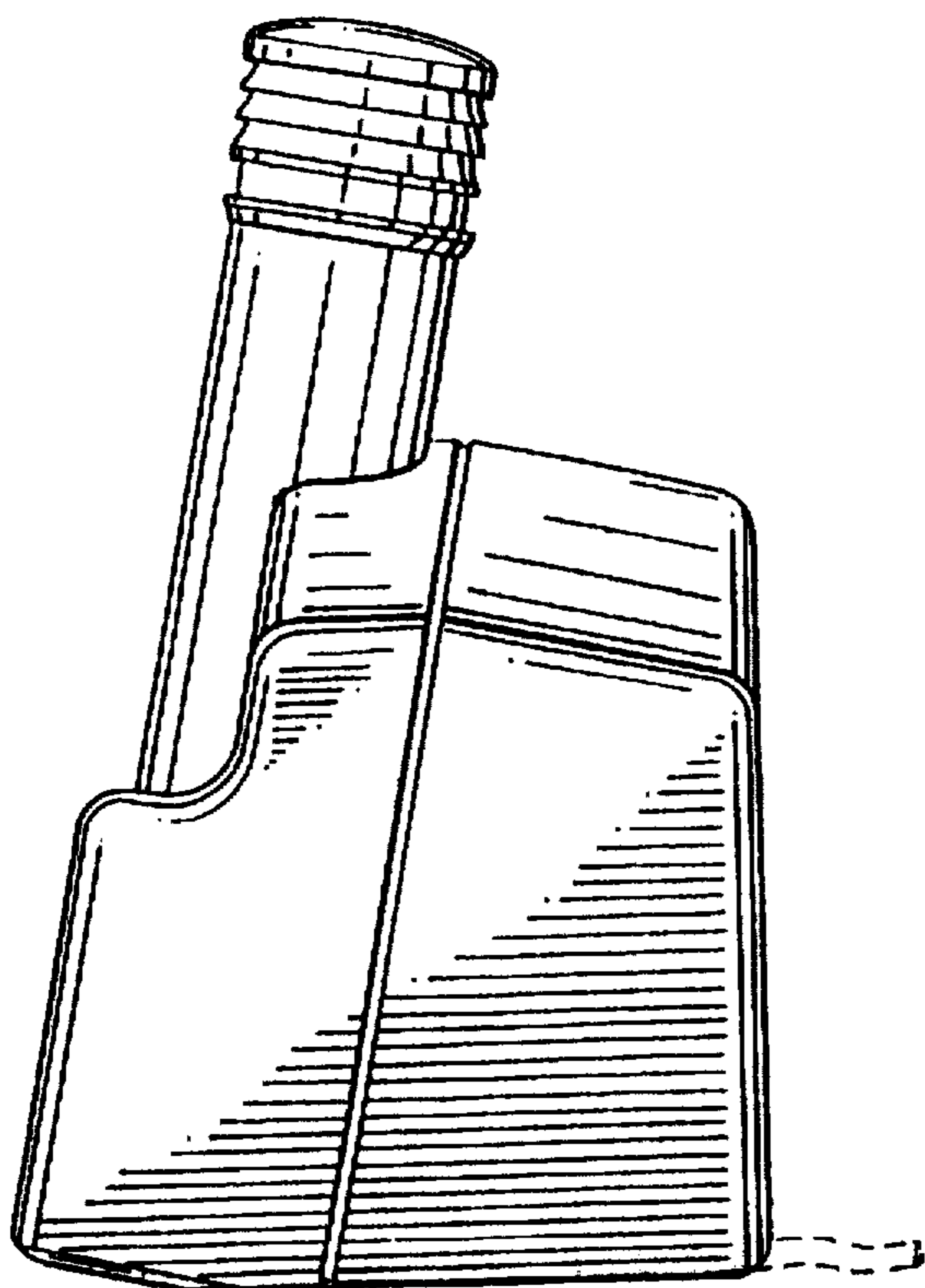

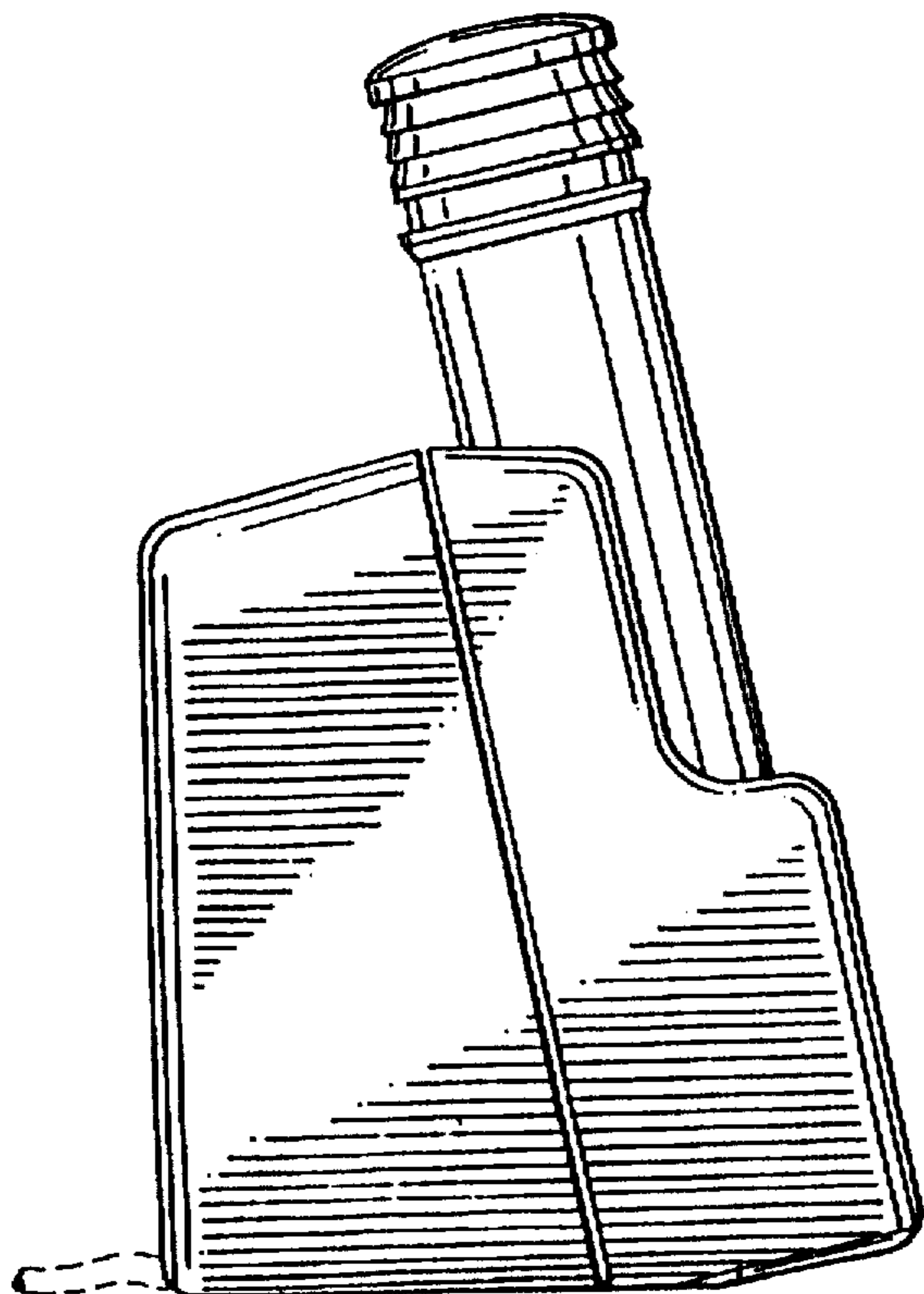

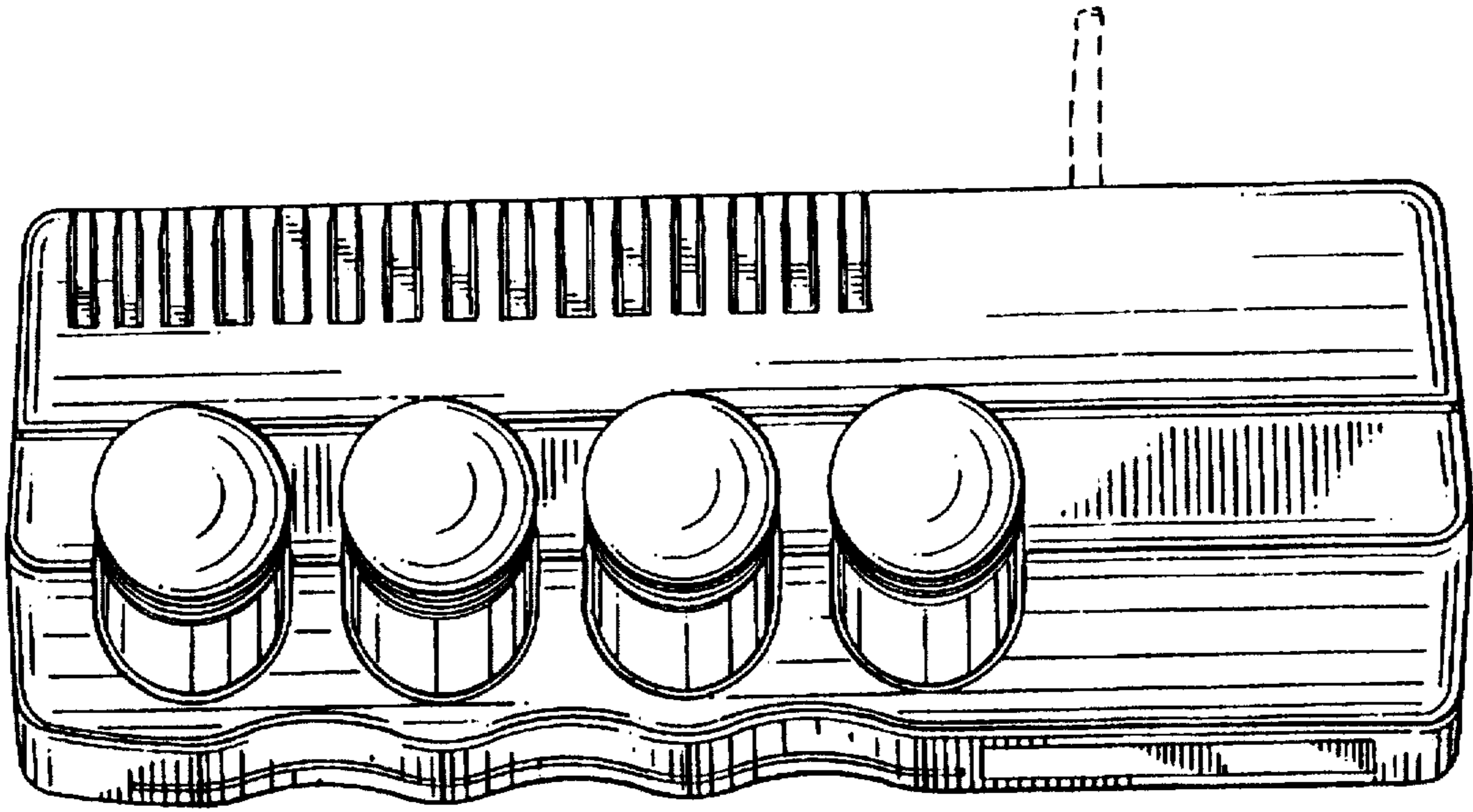

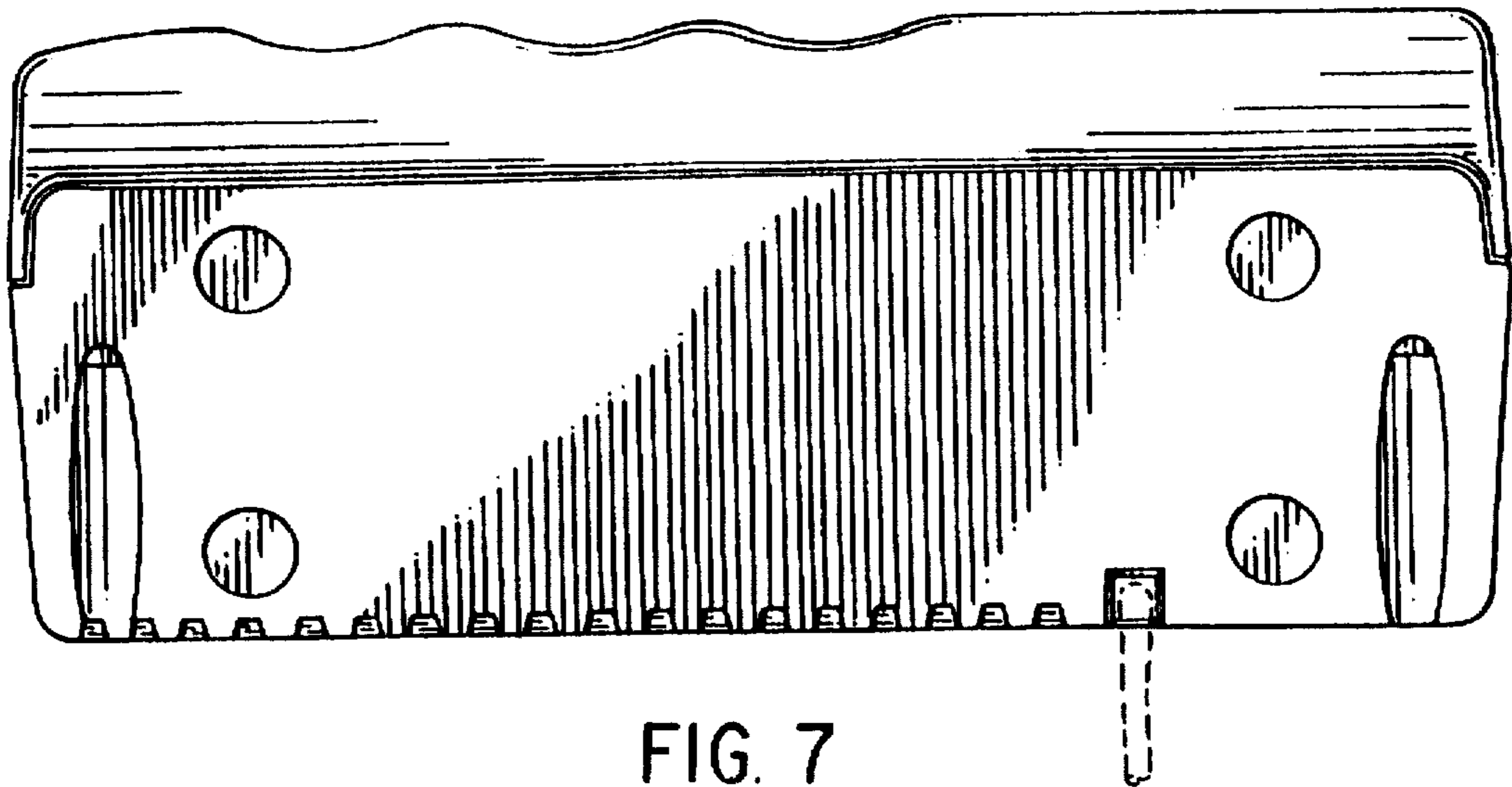
