[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a split sport baseball cap, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a split sport baseball cap showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a split sport baseball cap showing my new design;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of a split sport baseball cap showing my new design, the sole difference being the placement of the shaded areas to show contrast; and,

FIG. 9 is a front perspective view thereof.

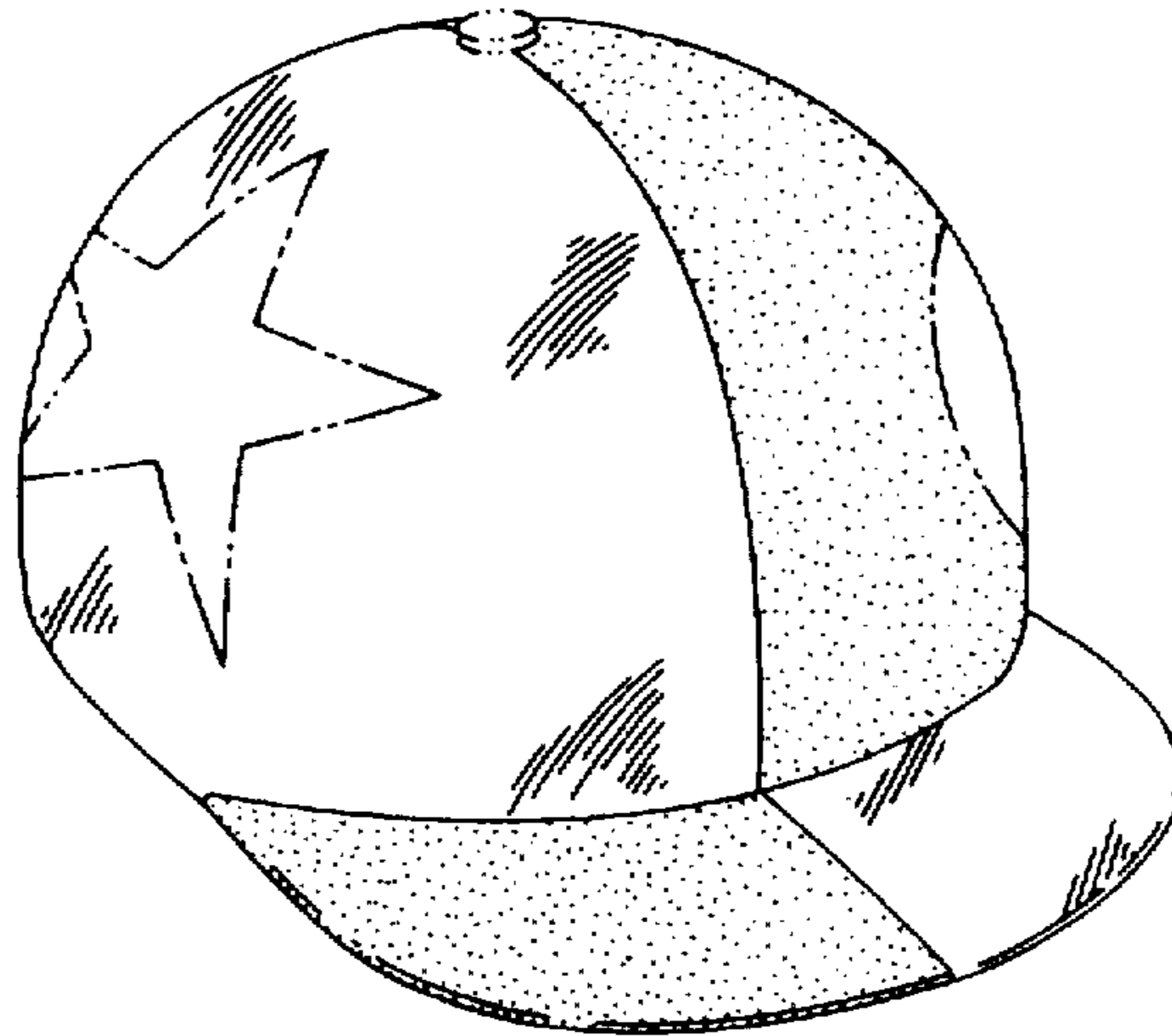

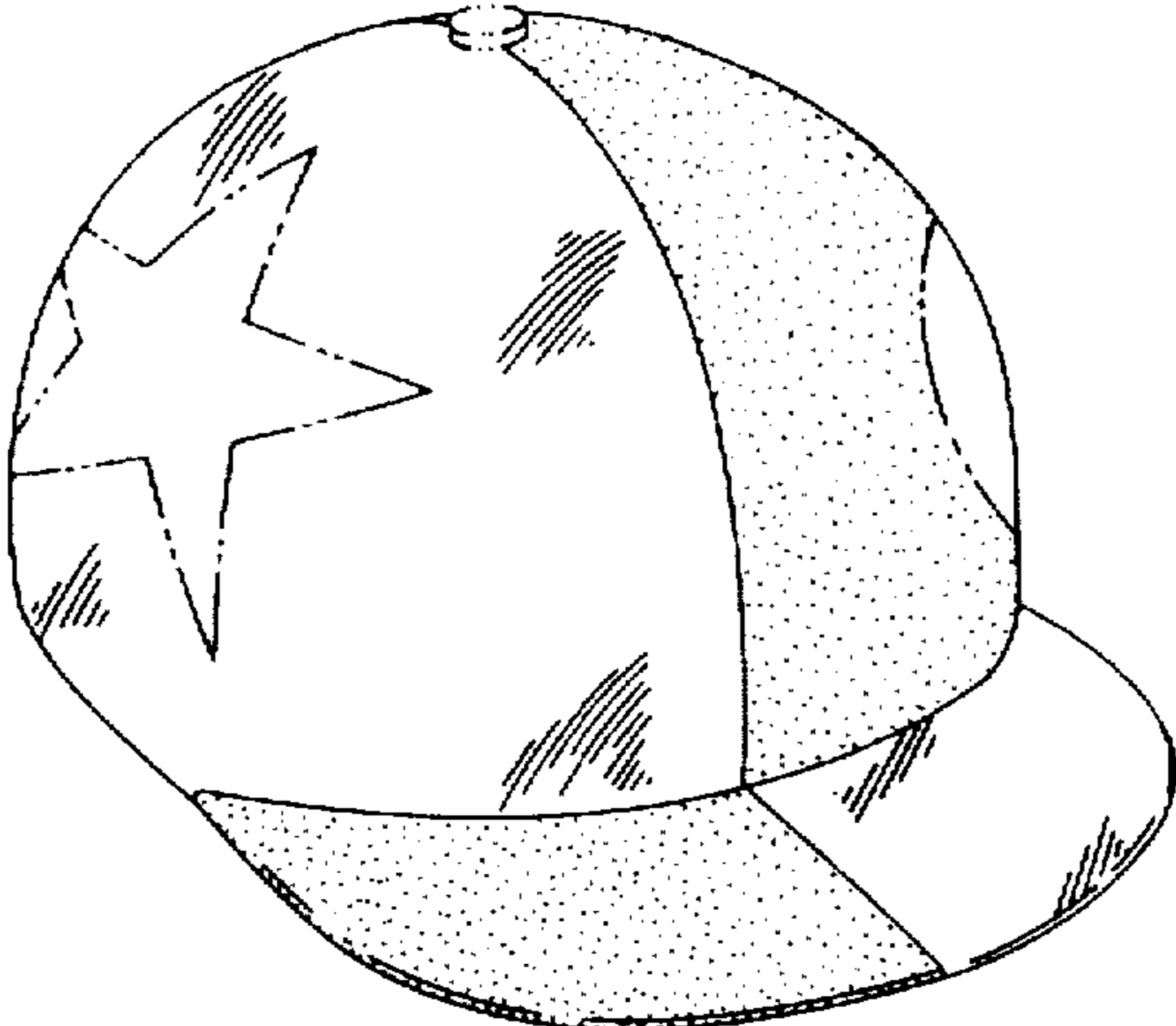

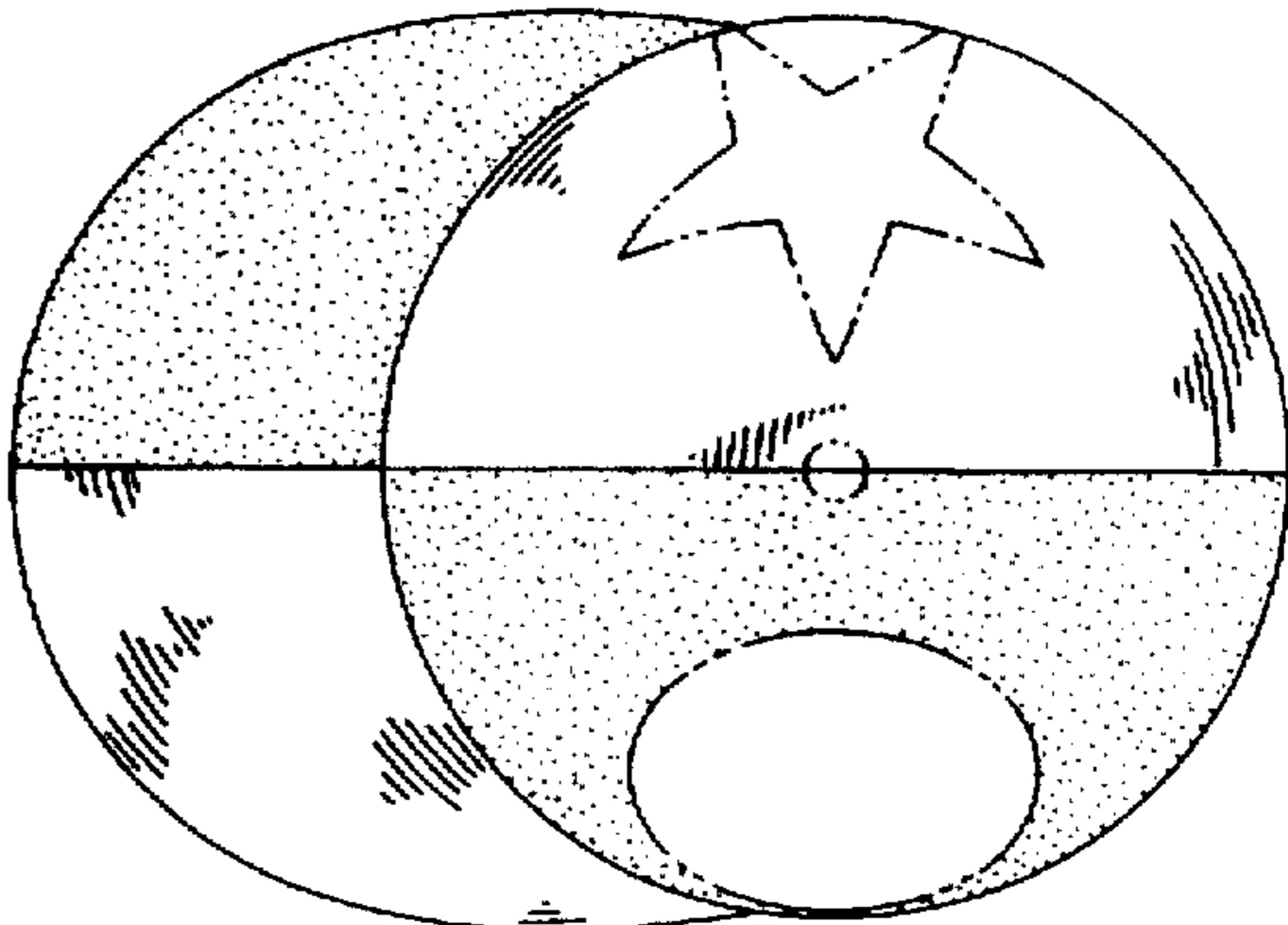

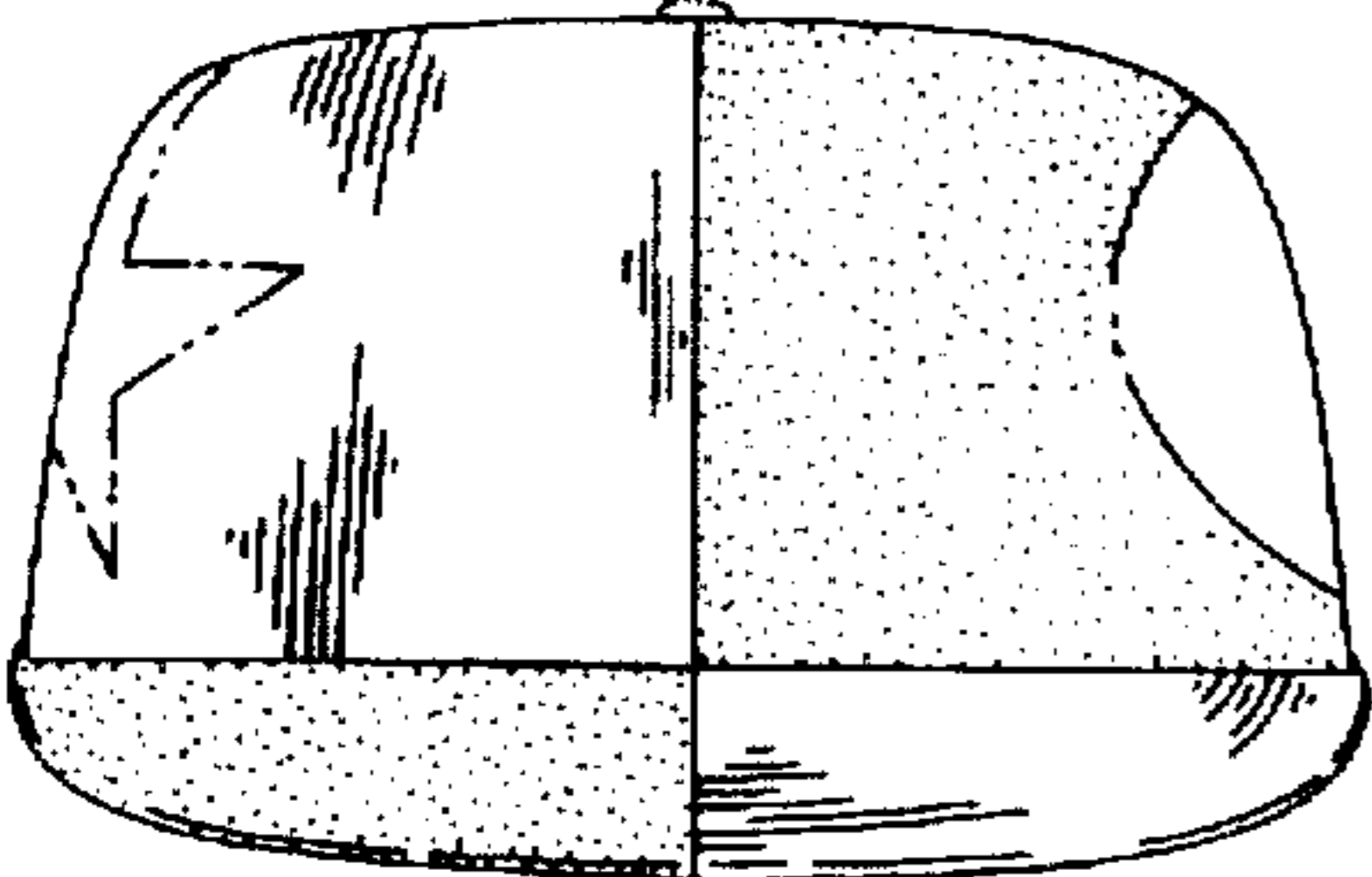

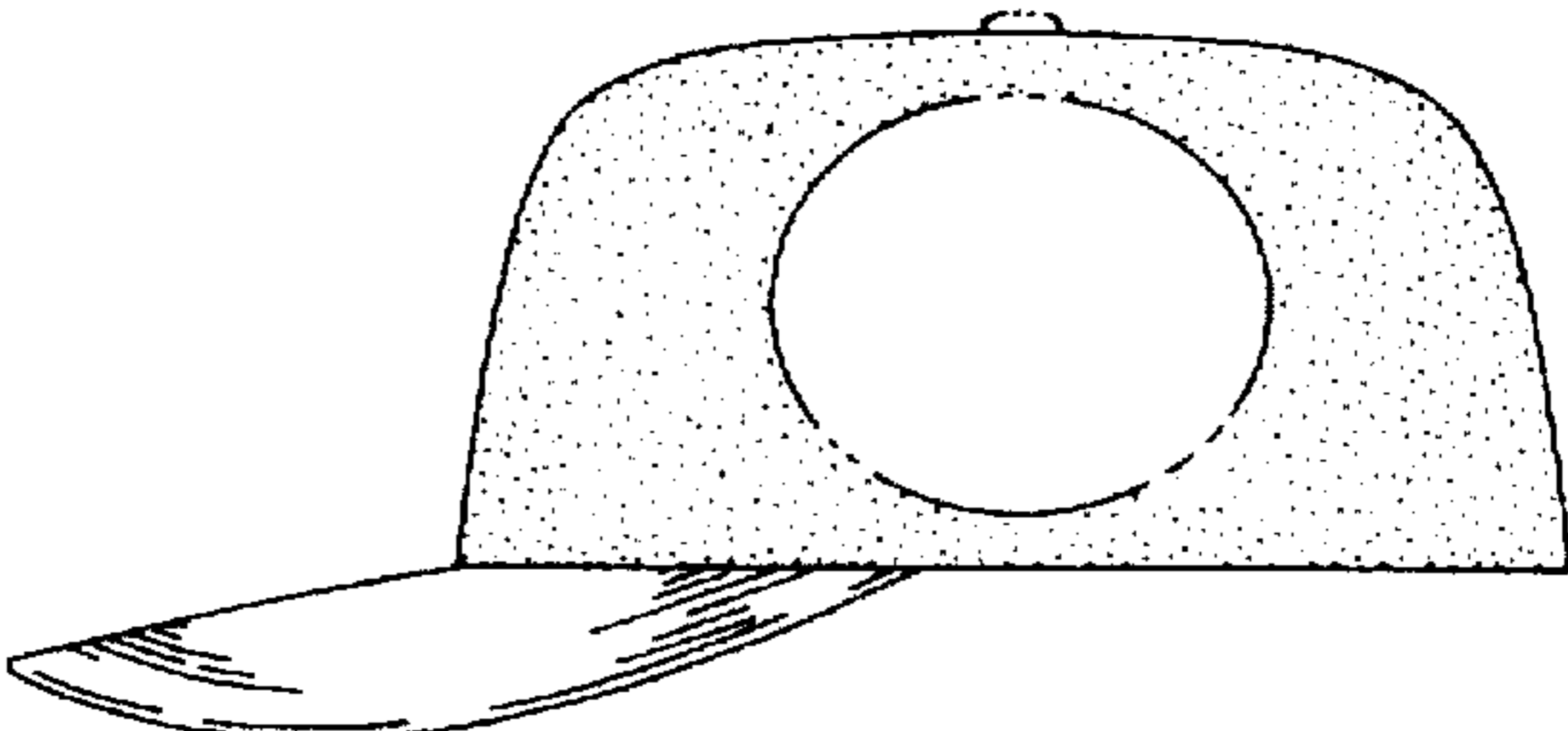

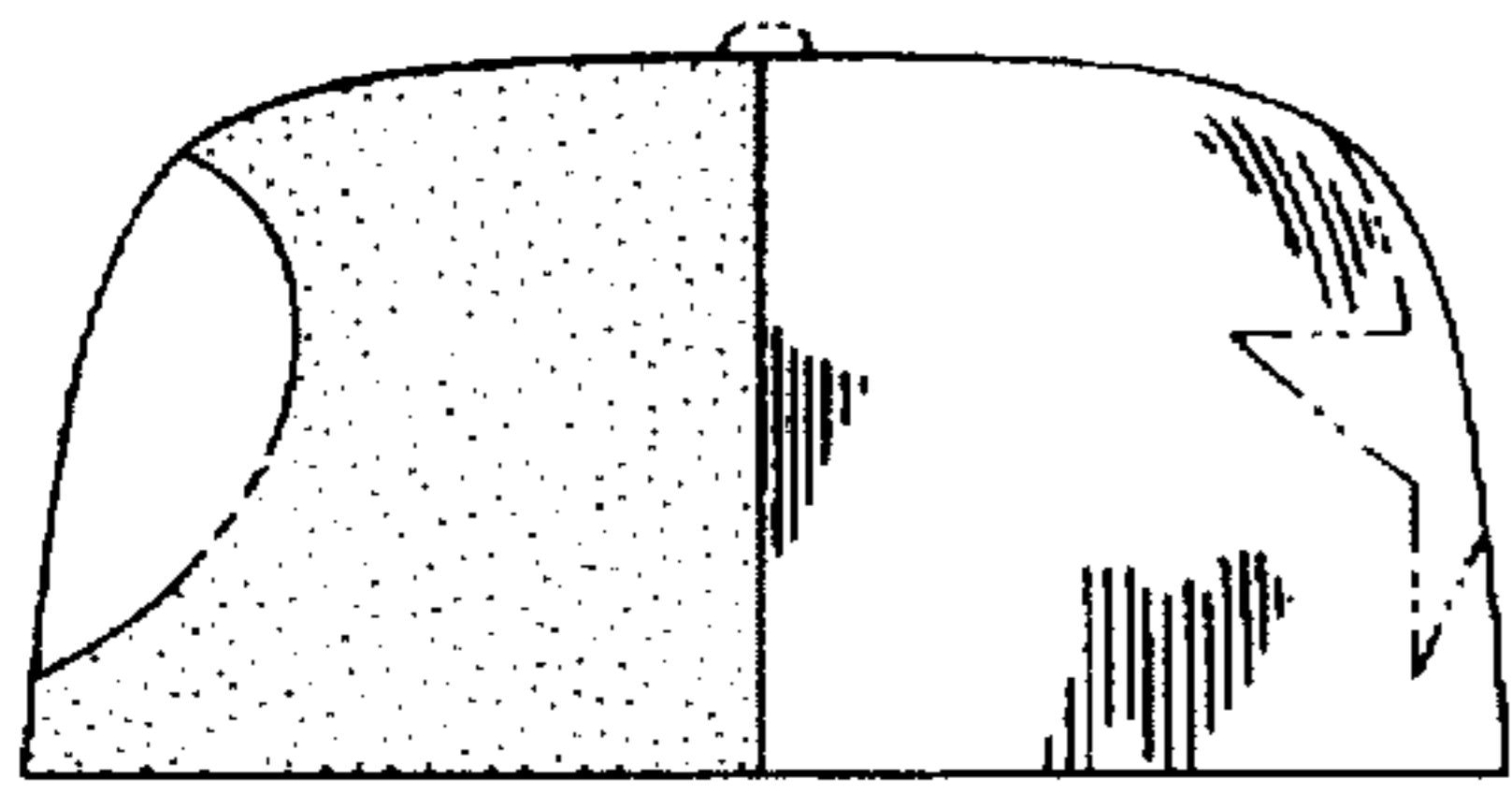

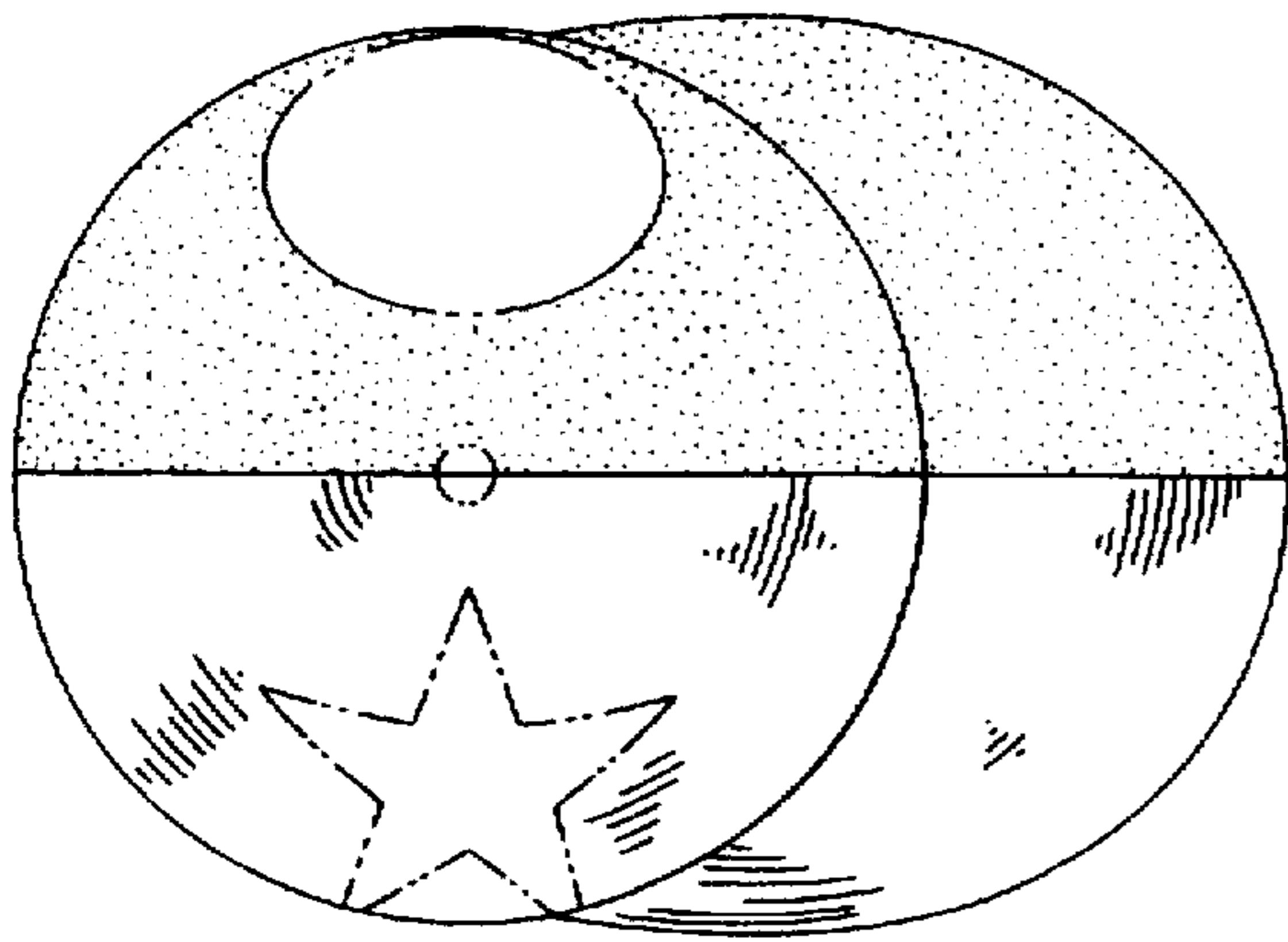
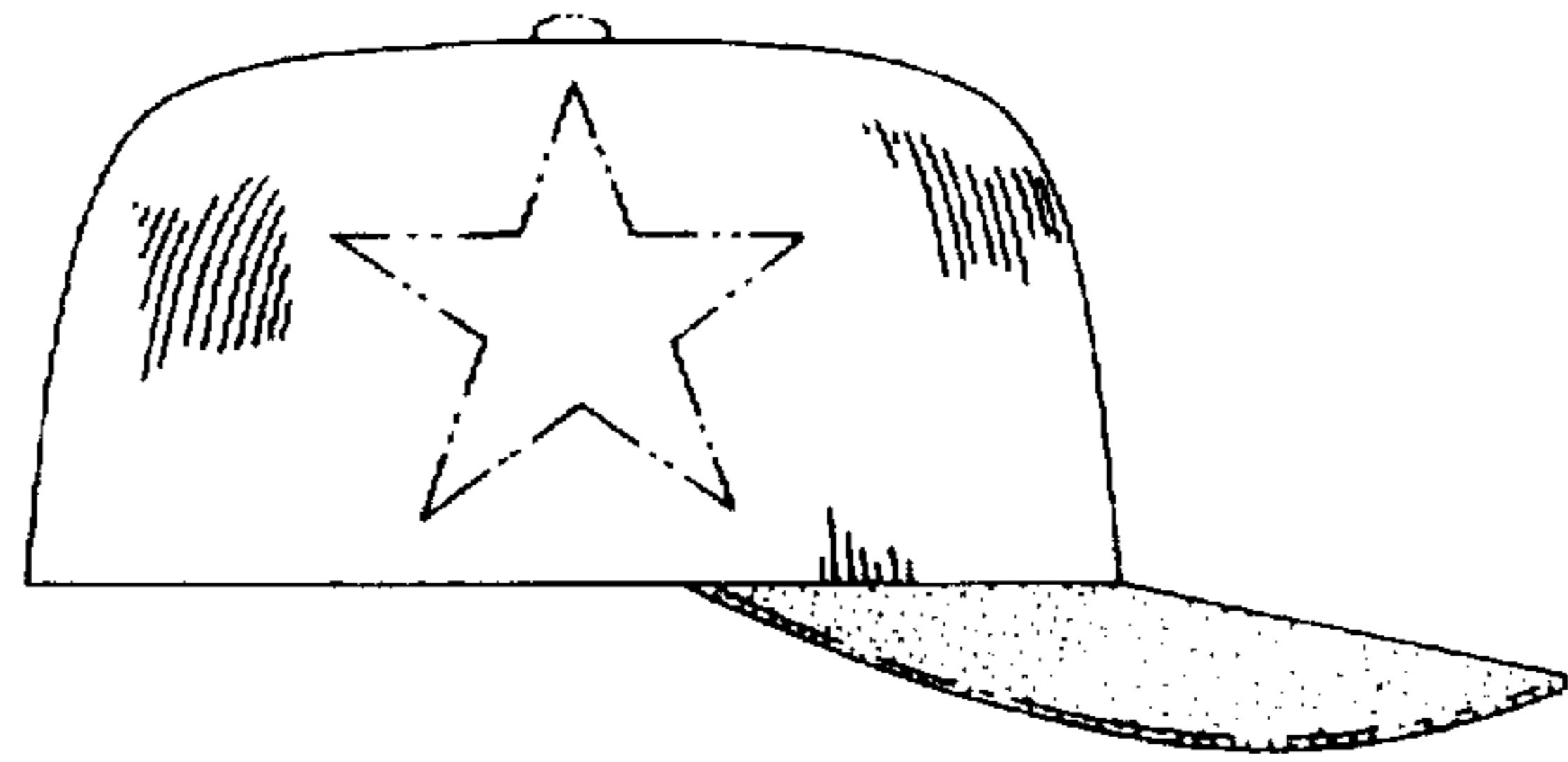

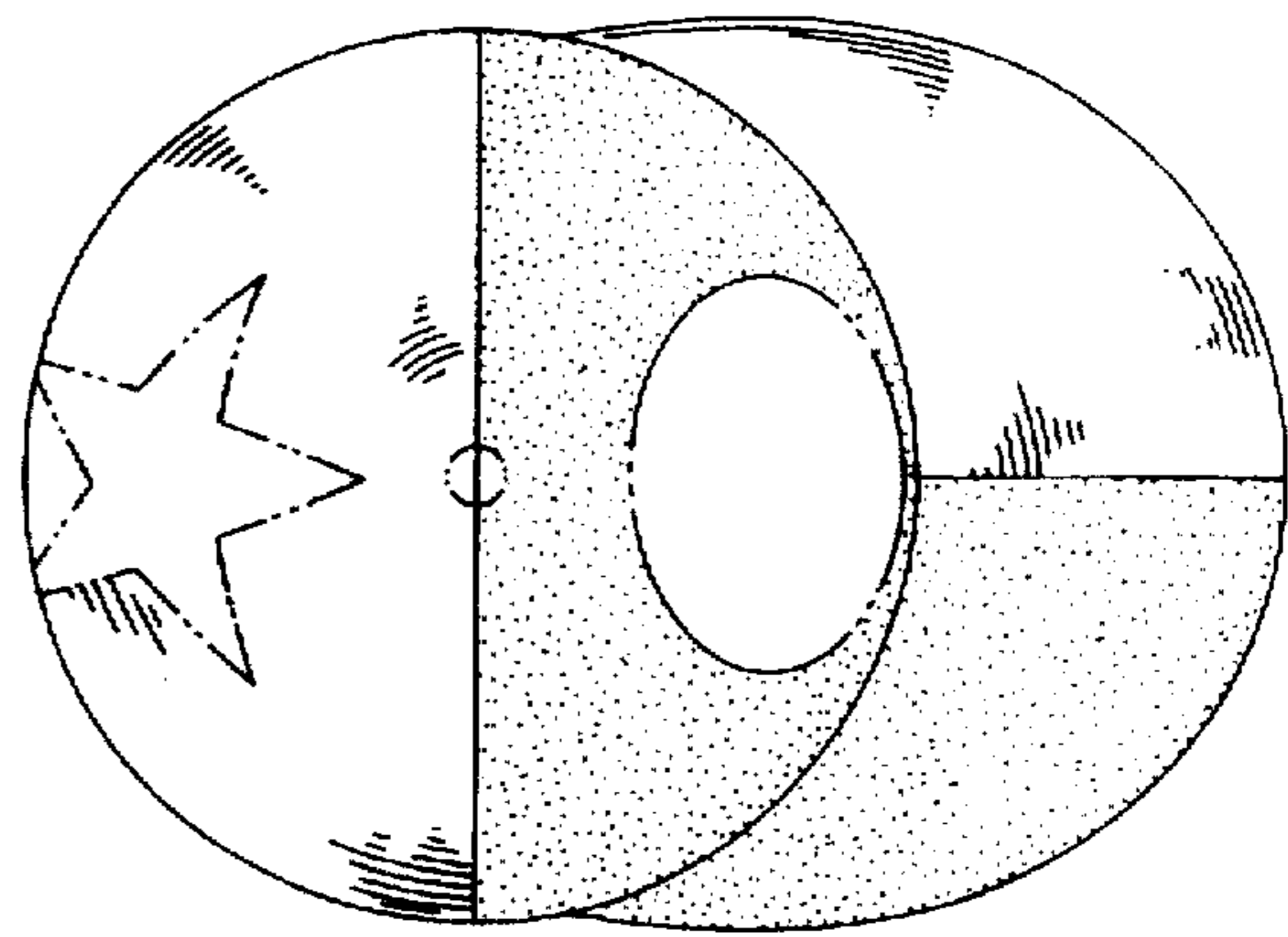

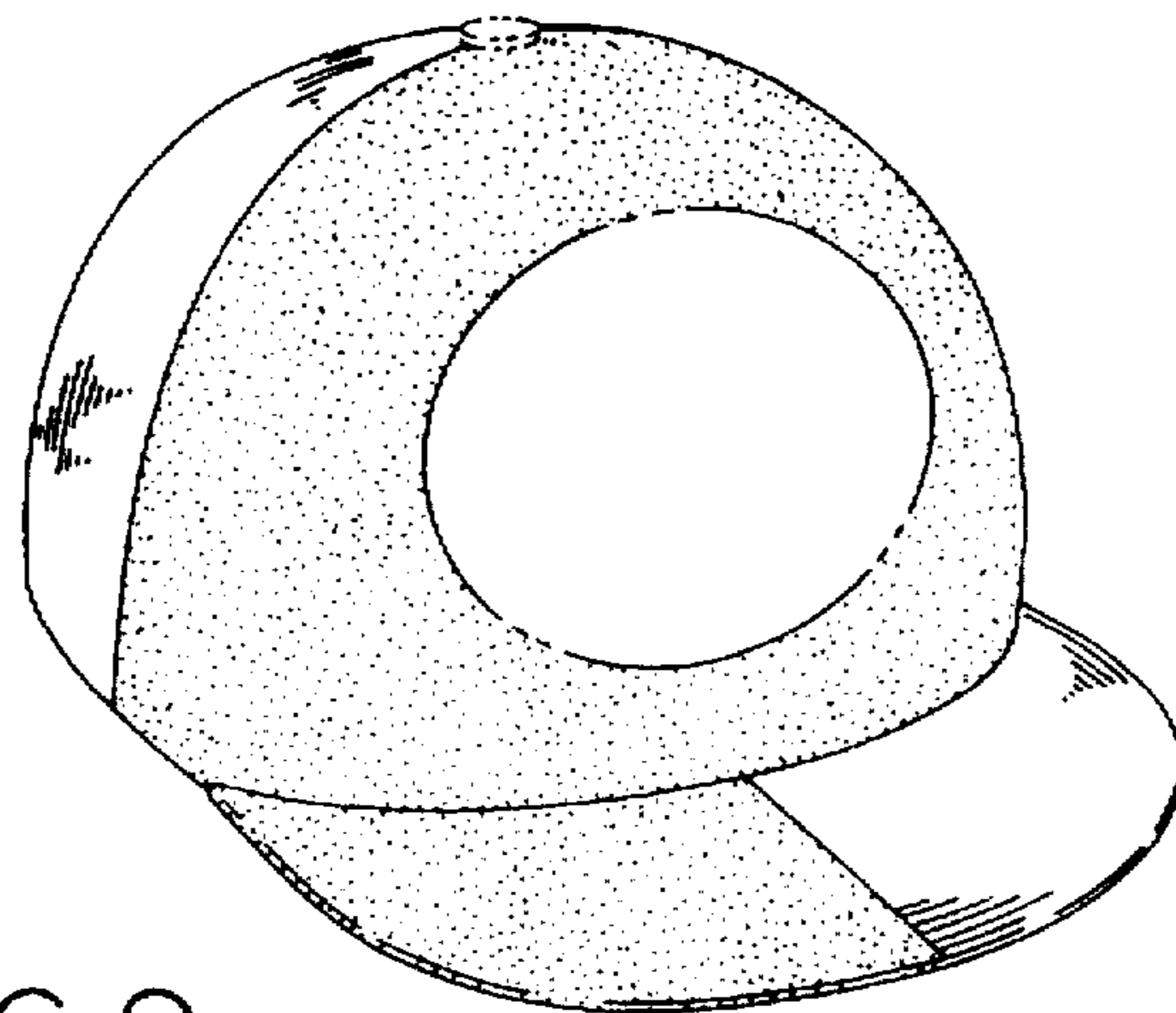
