The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a chair, showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front and side perspective view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, taken from the left of FIG. 1, the side elevational view from the right of FIG. 1 being the mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear and side perspective view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

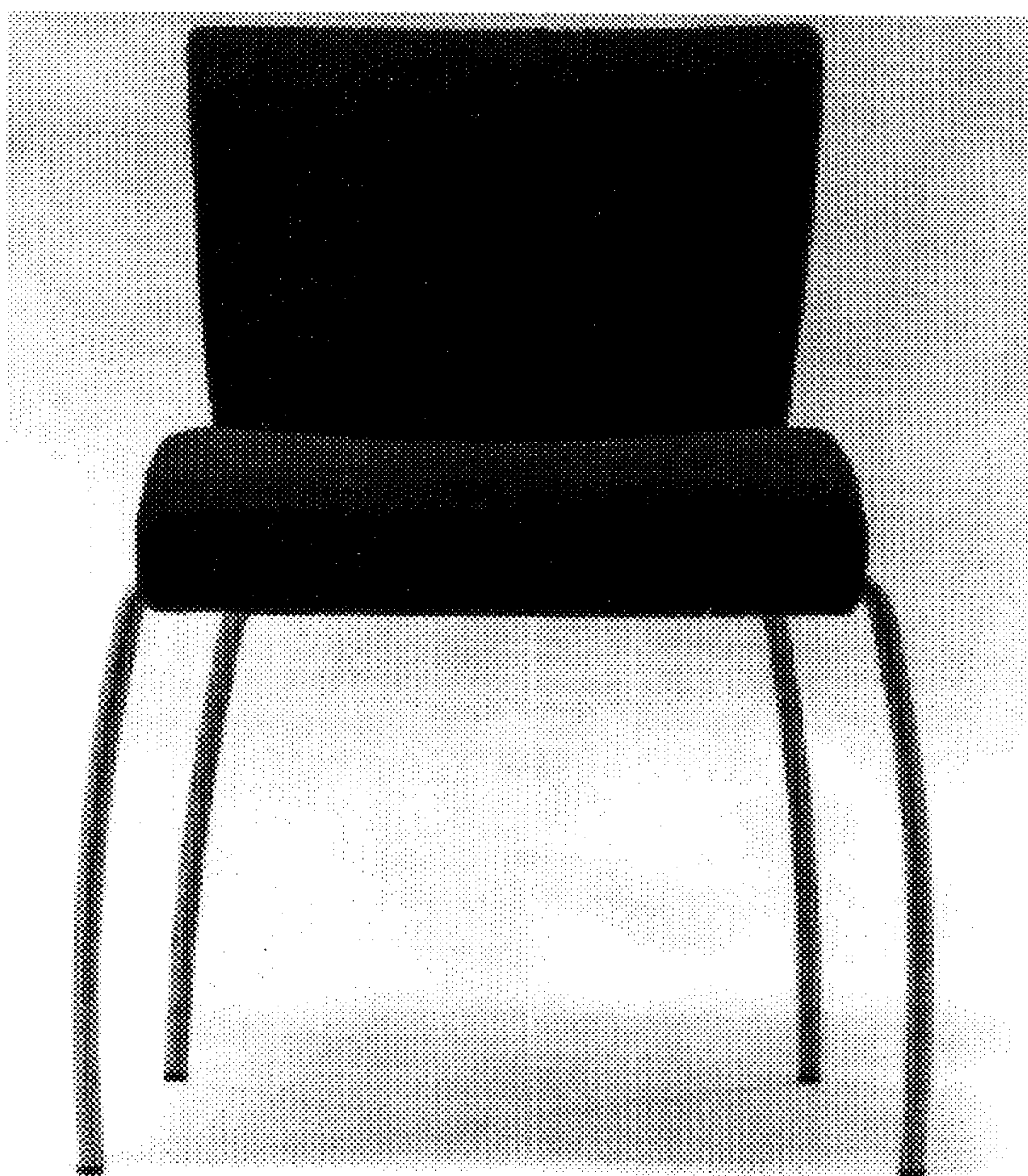

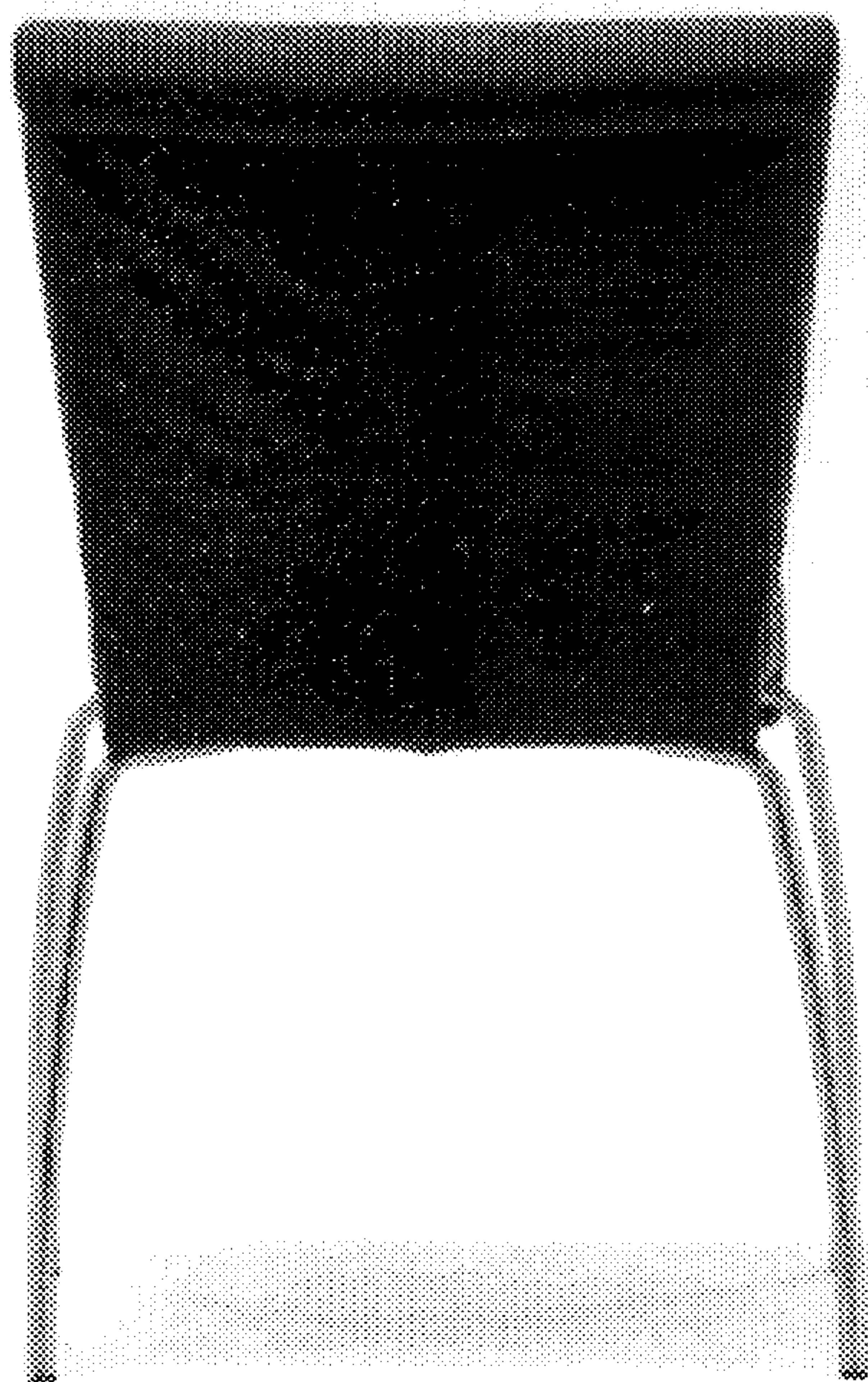
