[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a scent evidence pad holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear top perspective view of the scent evidence pad holder of the present invention showing our new design with the phantom lines depicting environmental structure and forming no part of the claimed design;
