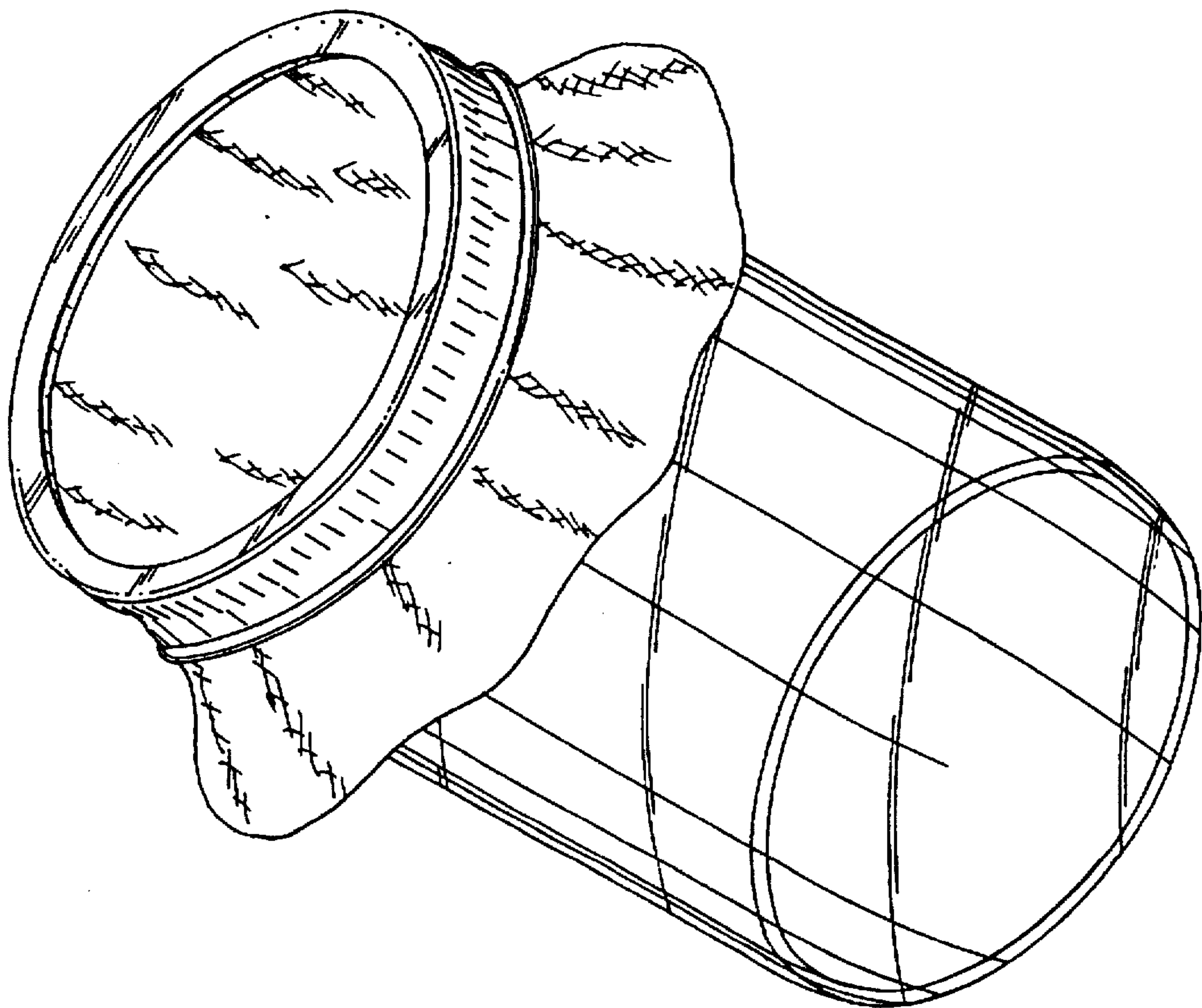
The cross hatching in FIGS. 1-4 represents conventional

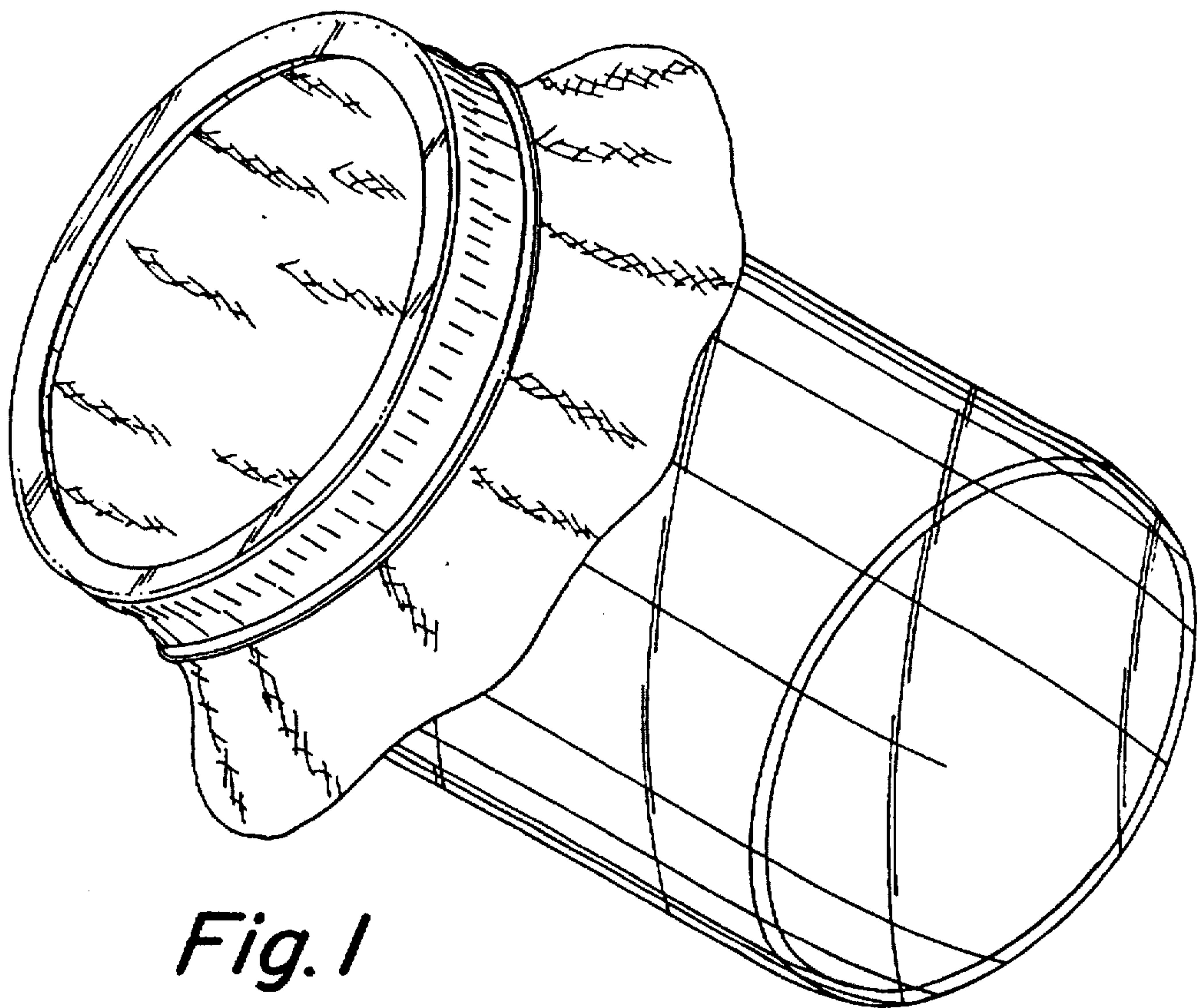

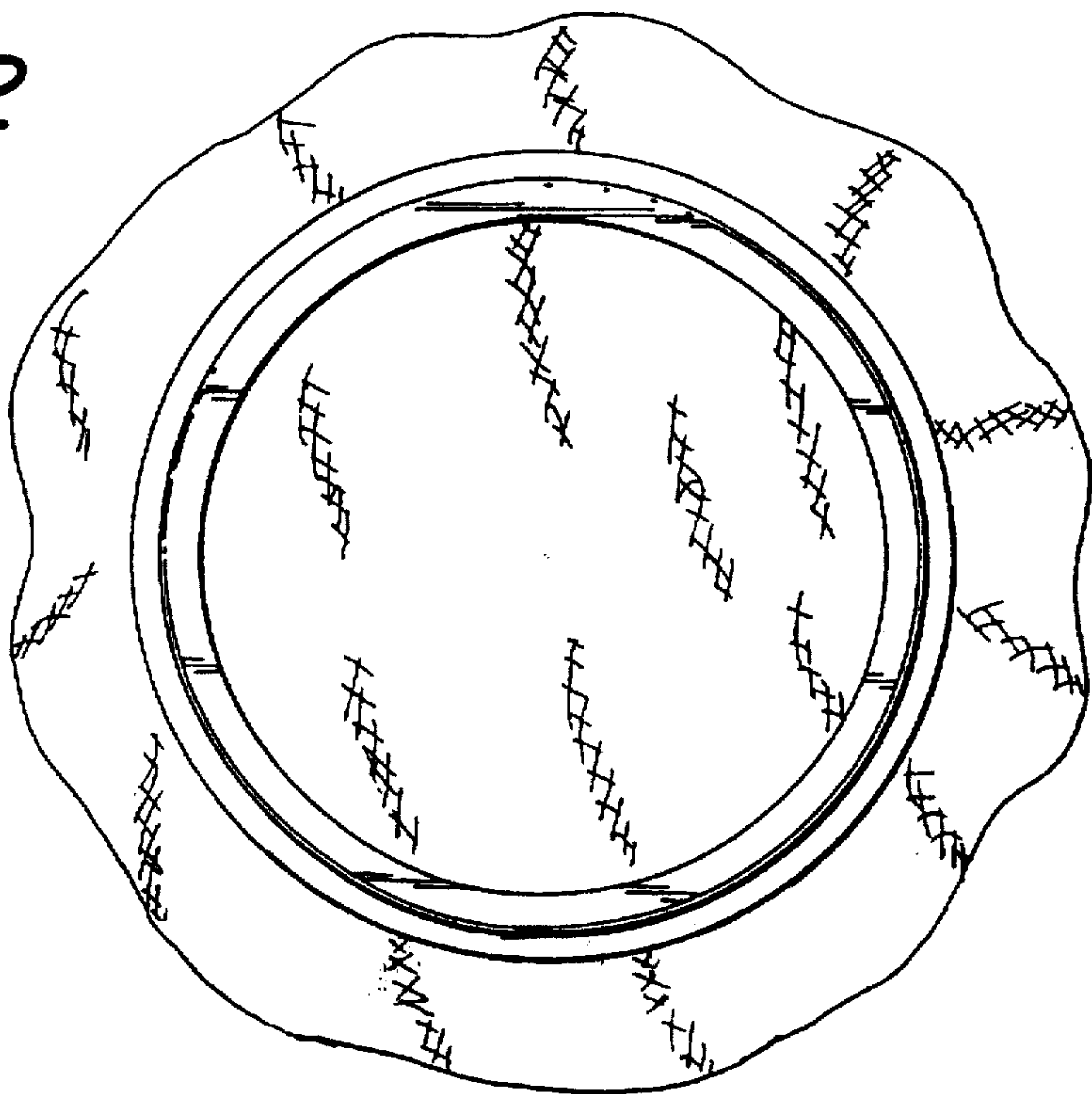

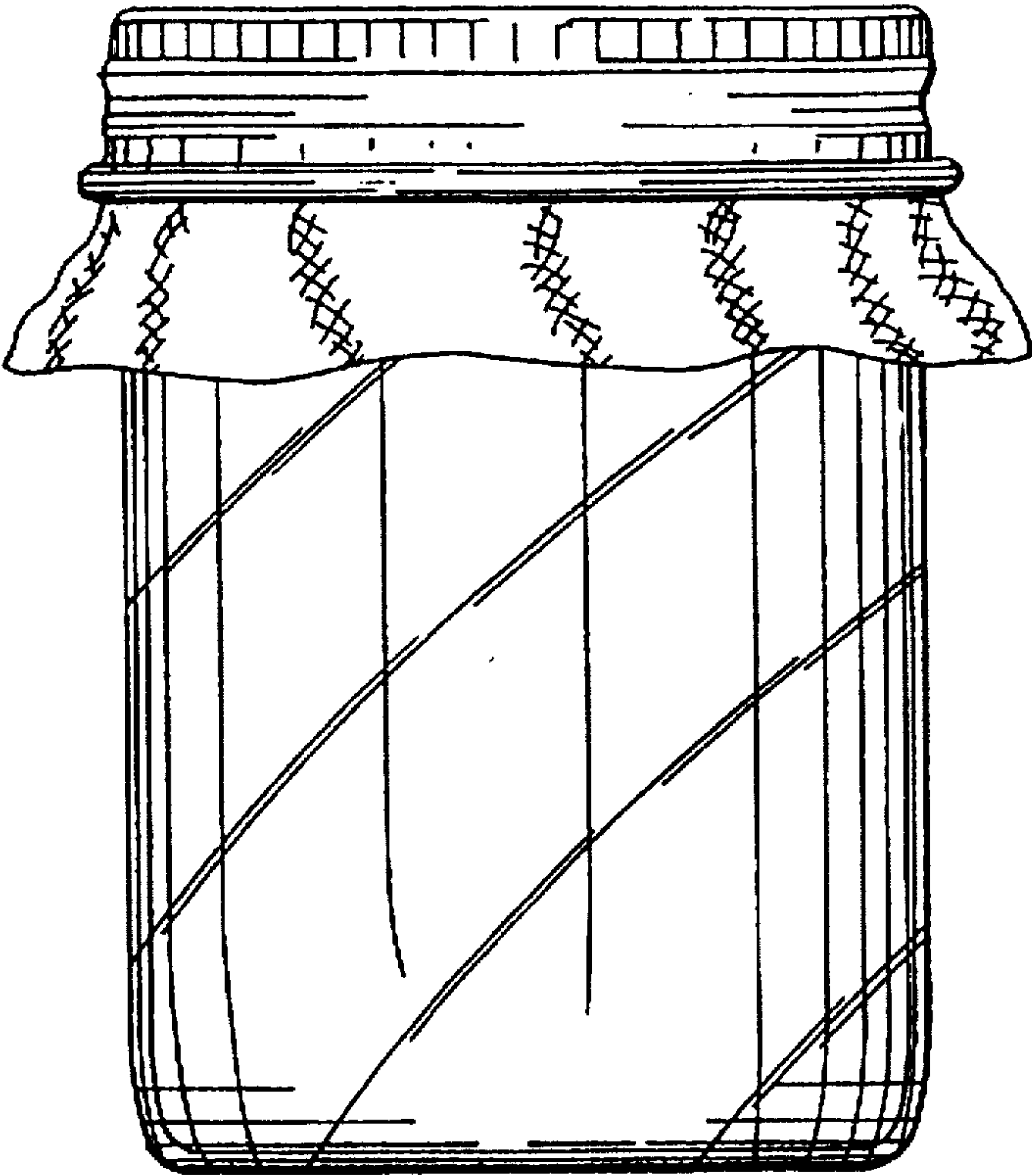
