DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right-front perspective view of a chair showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;

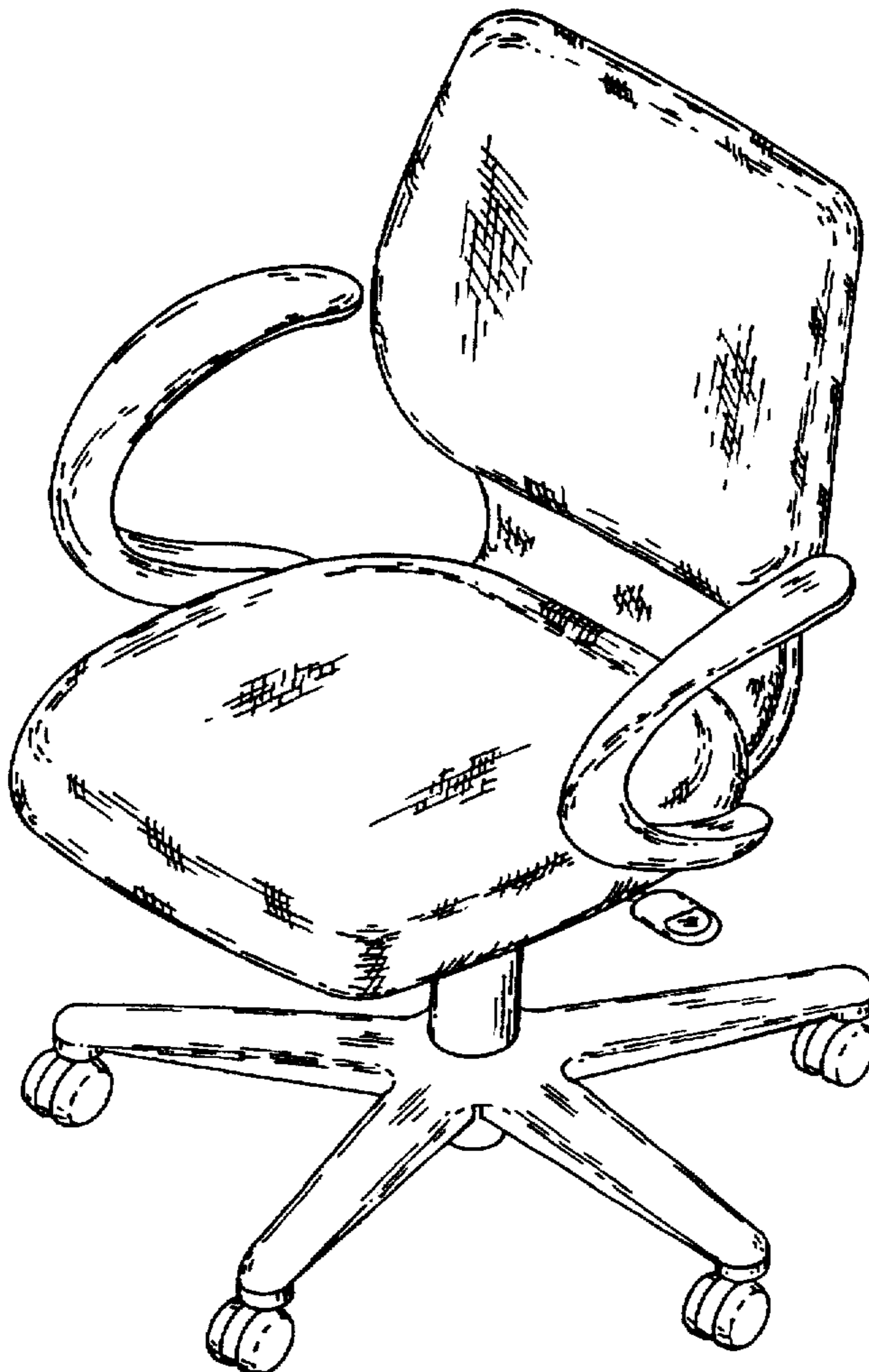
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;

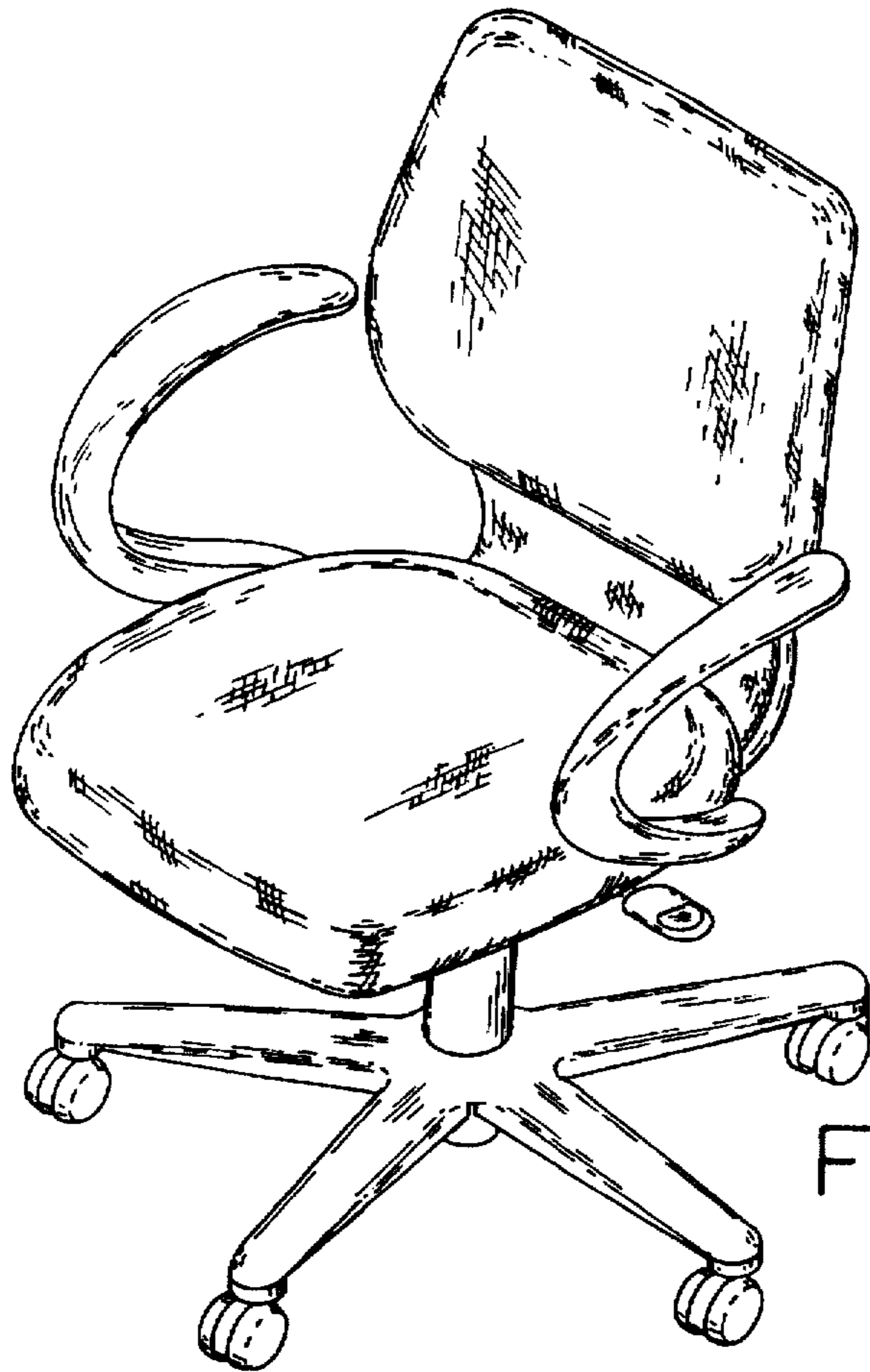

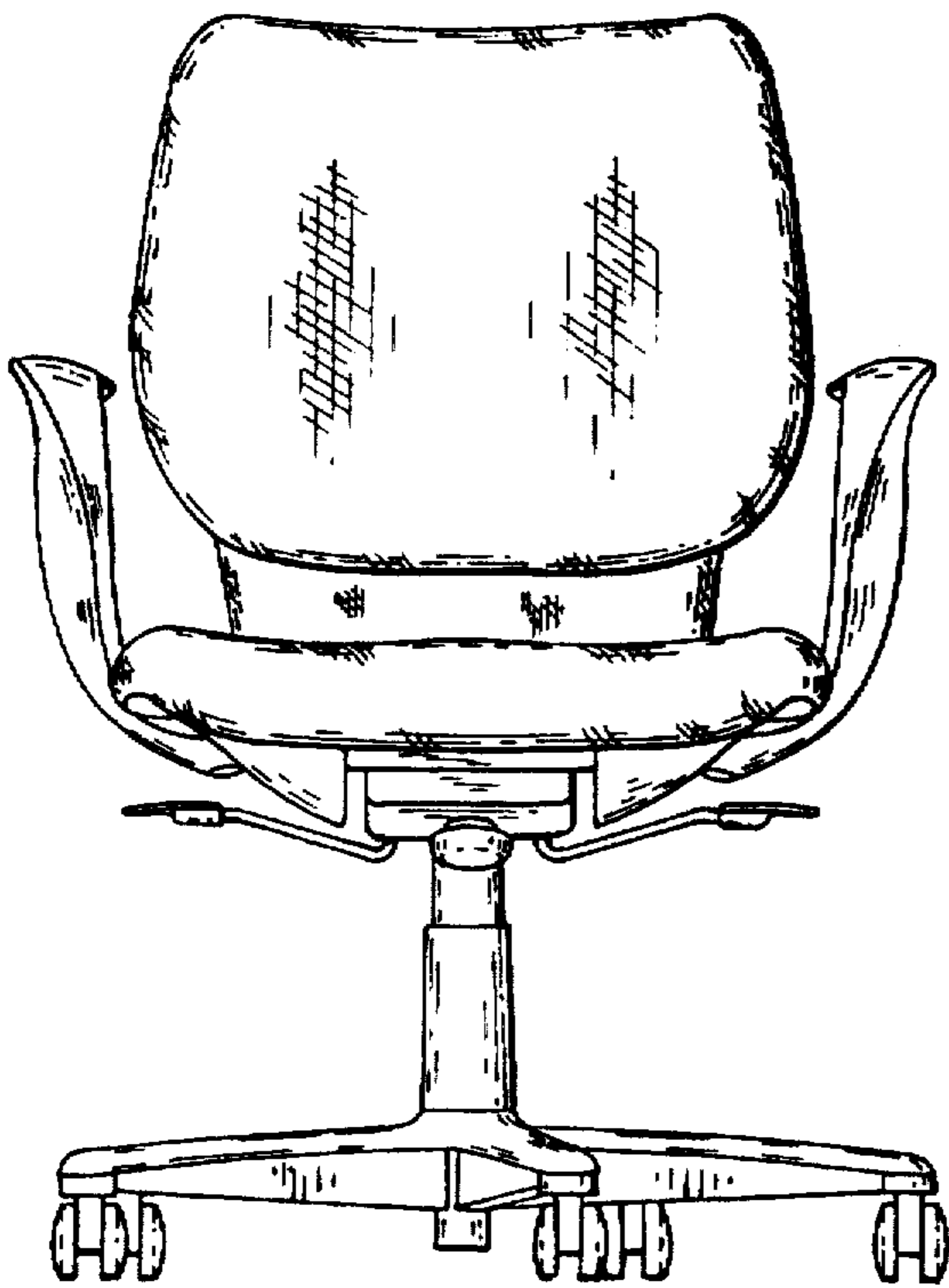

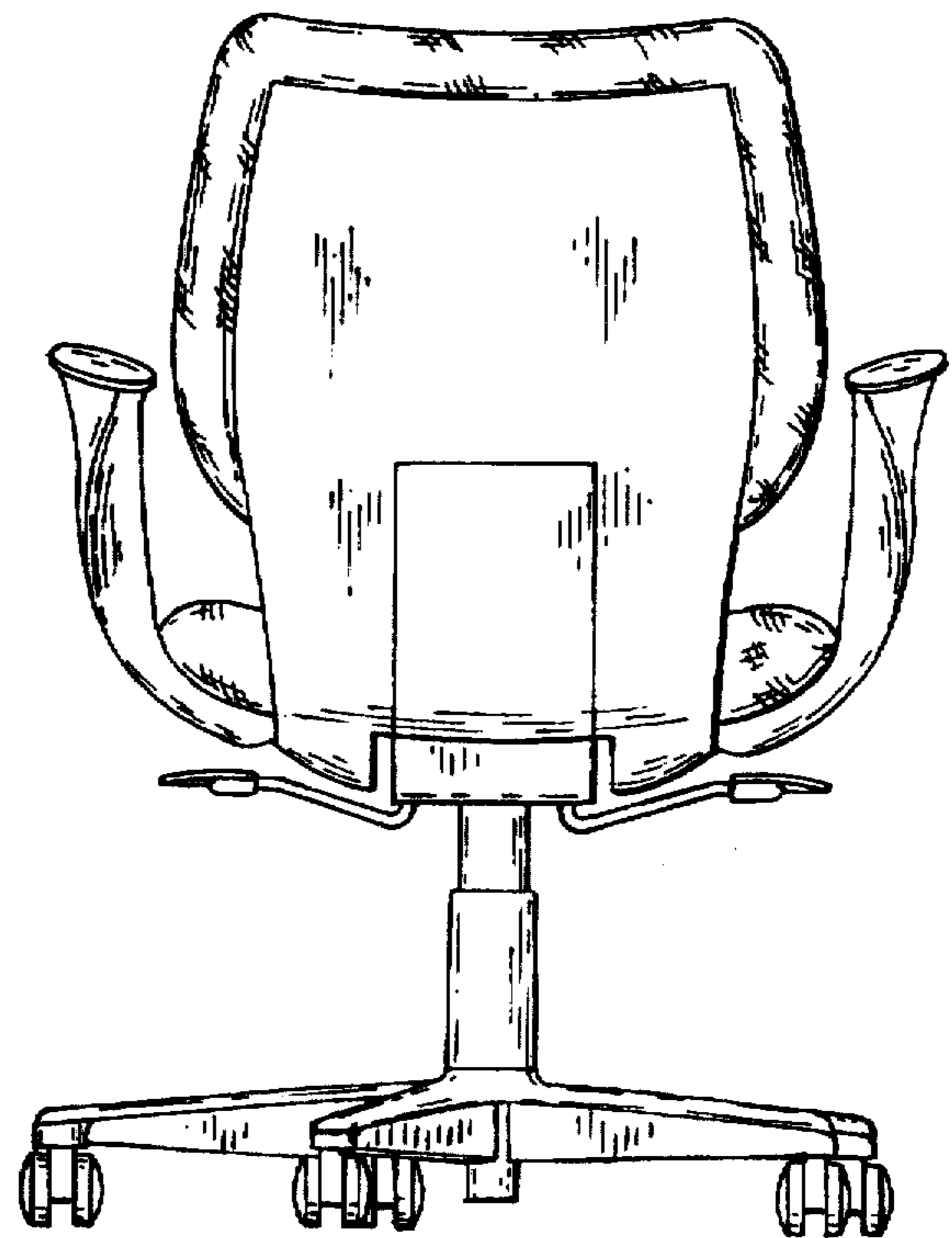

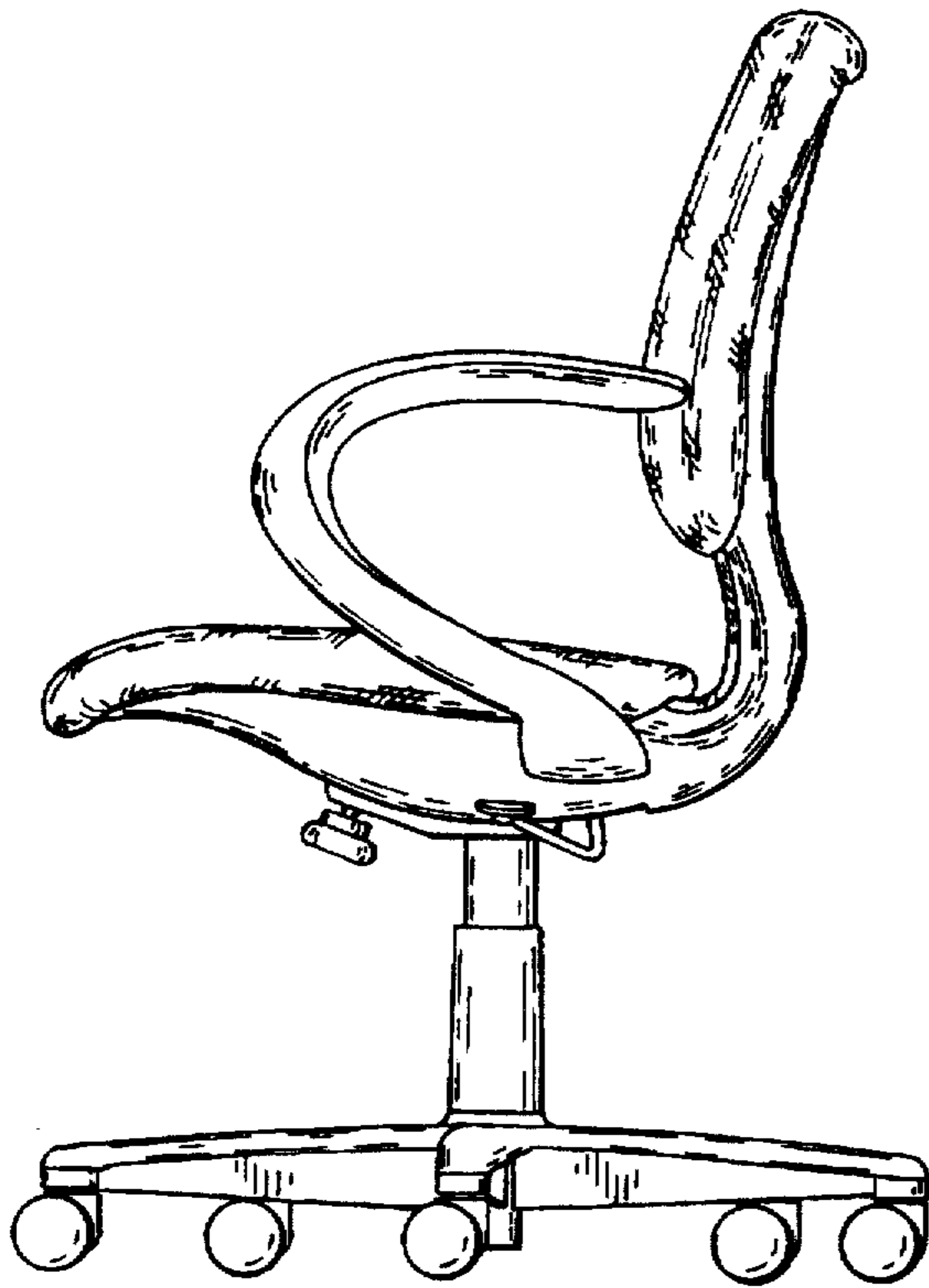

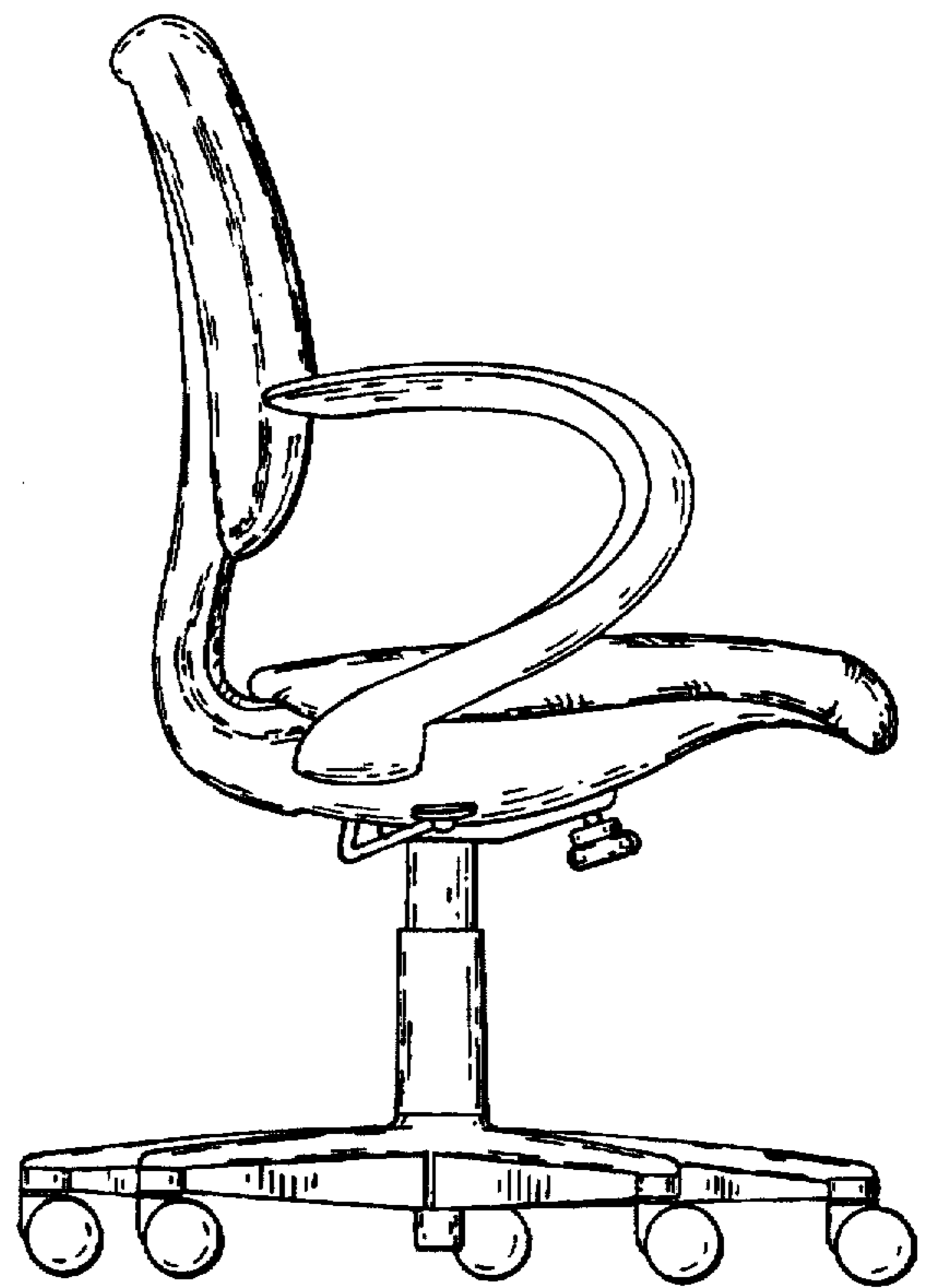

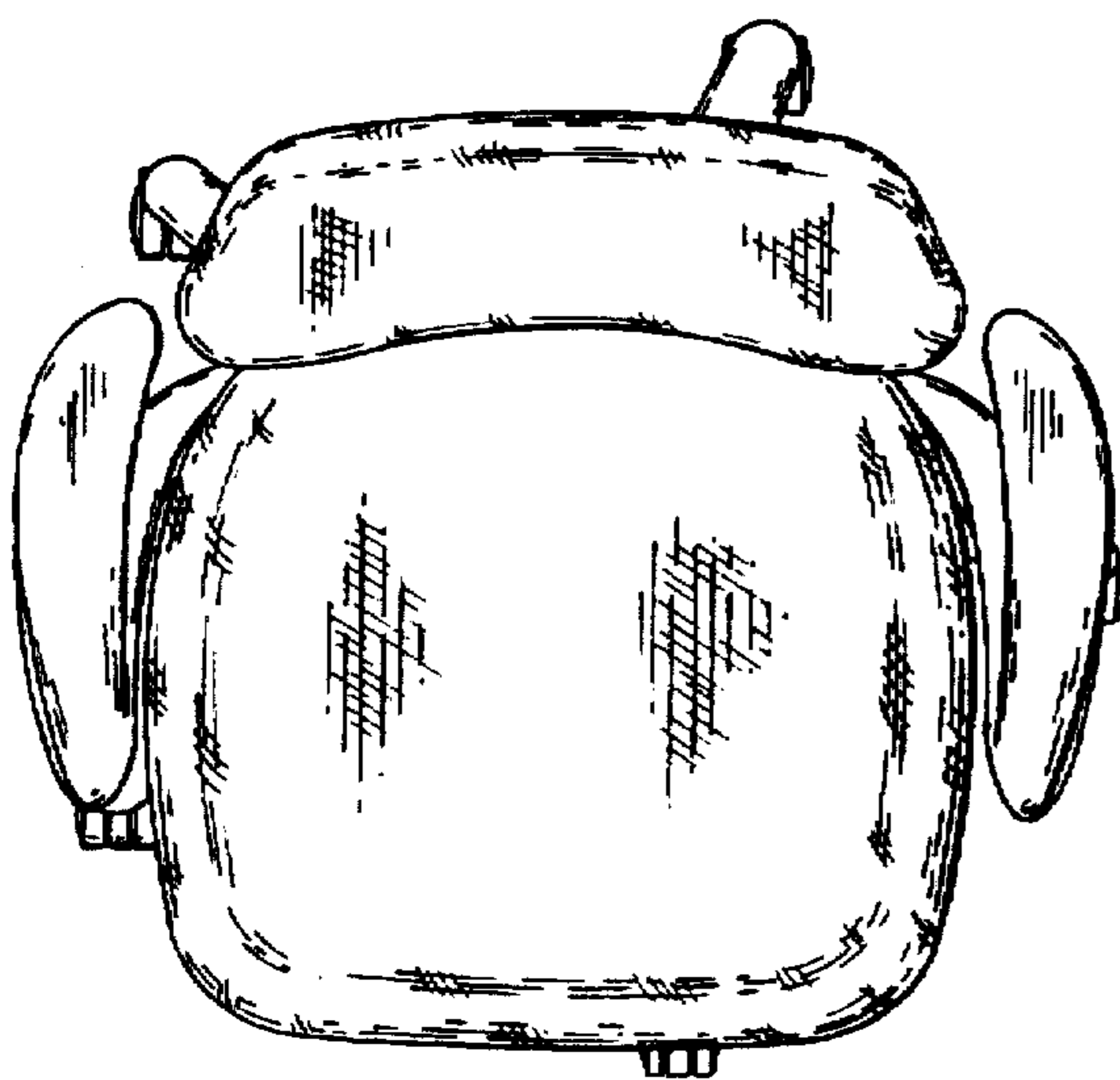

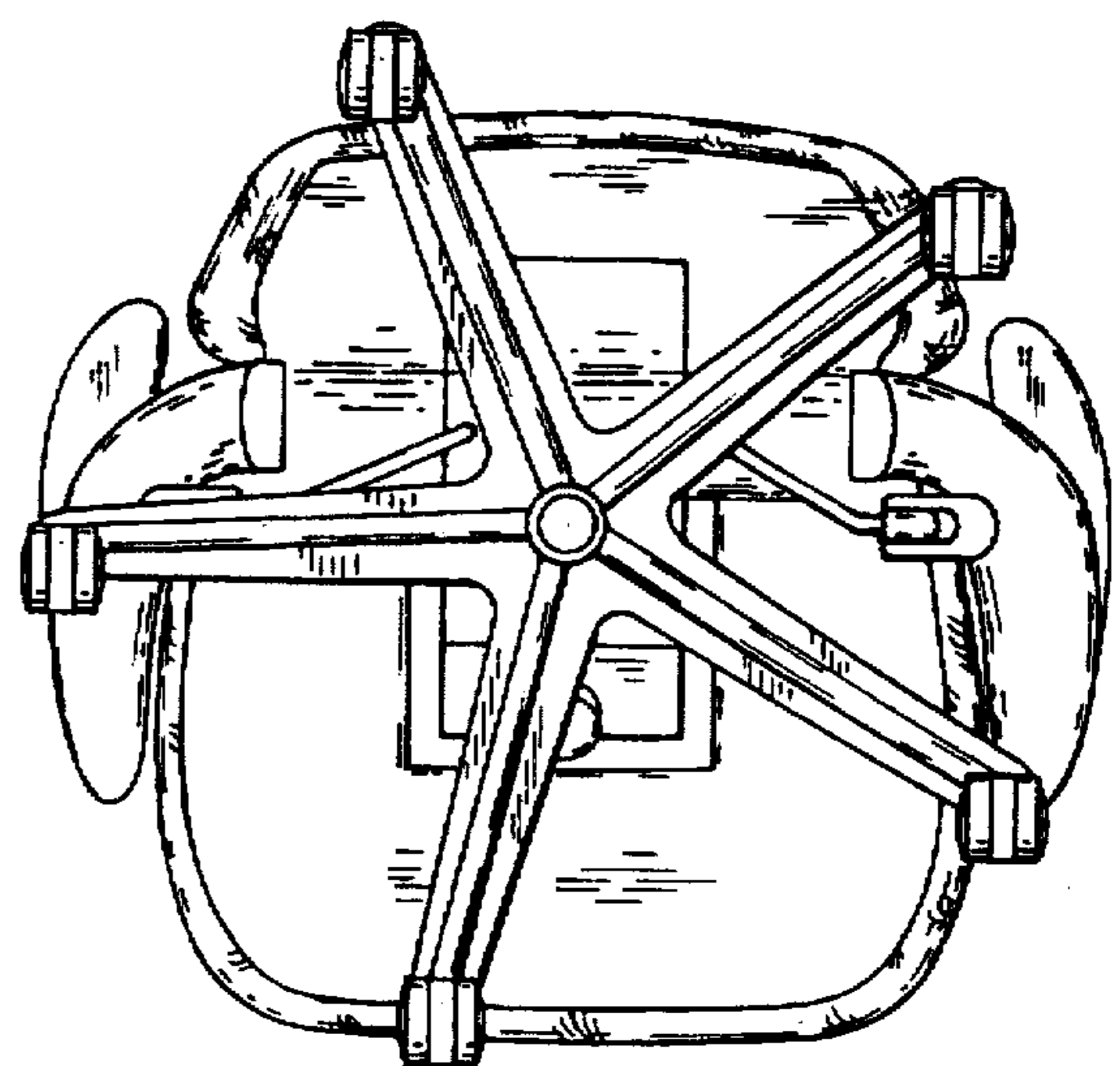

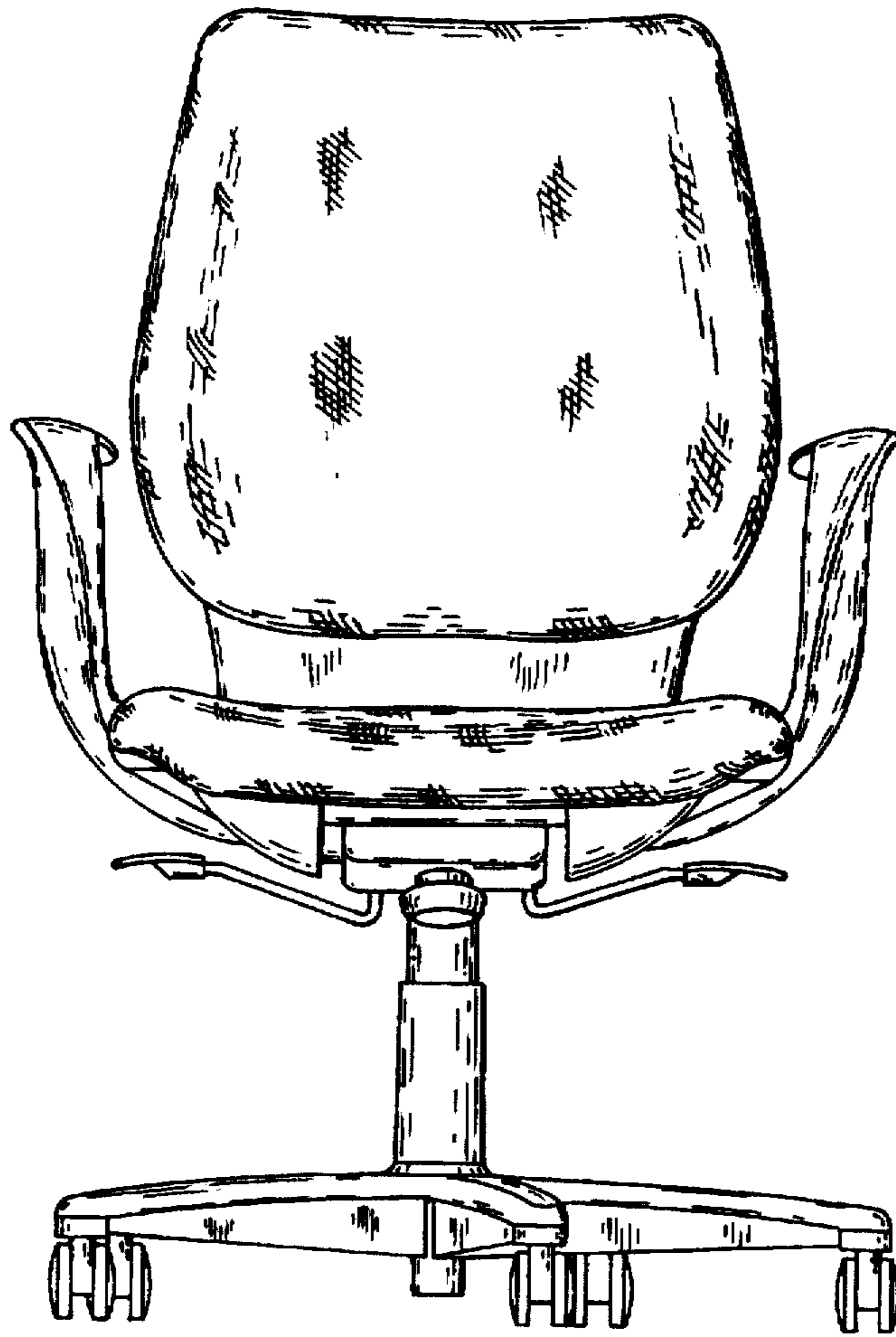
