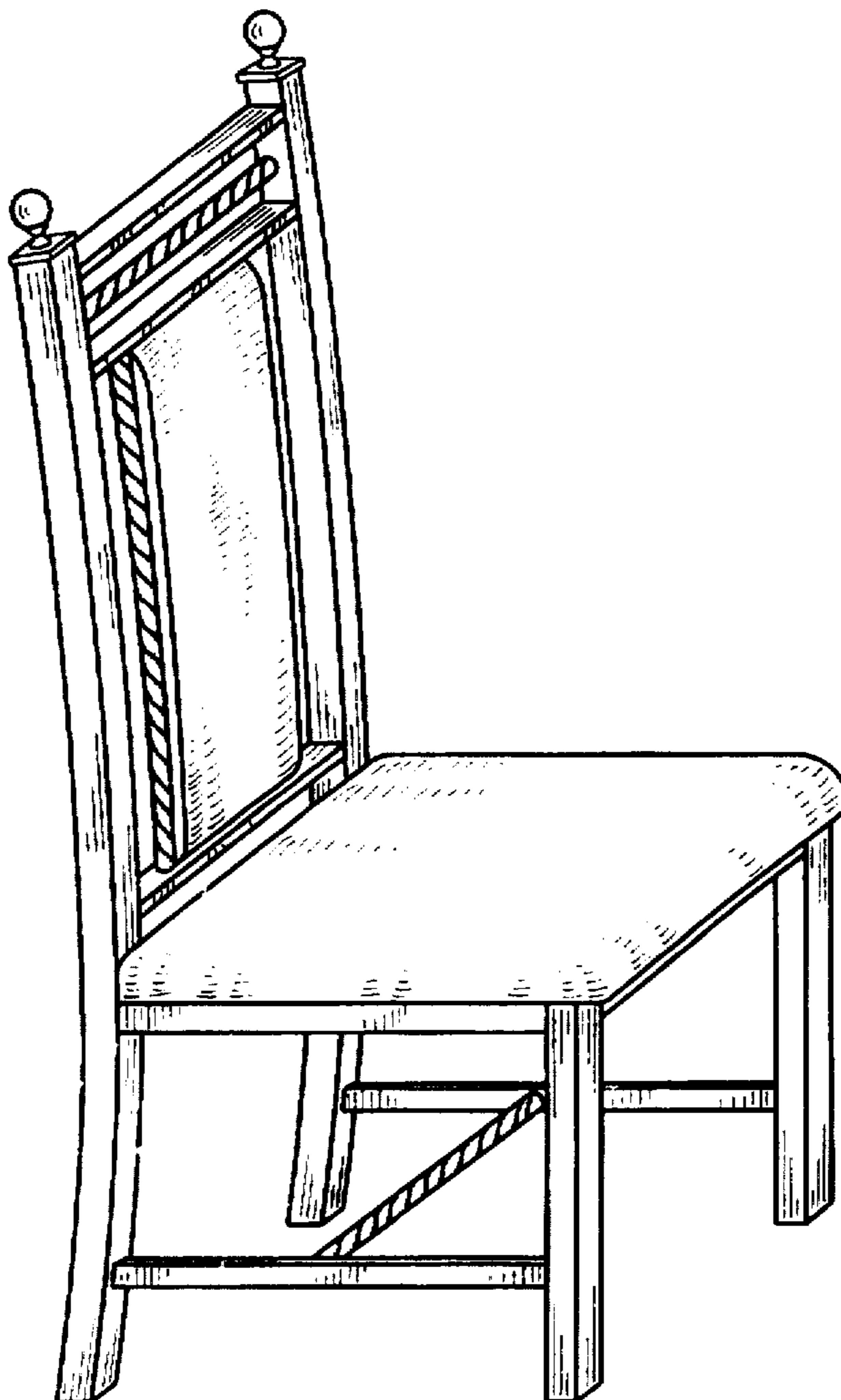
DESCRIPTION

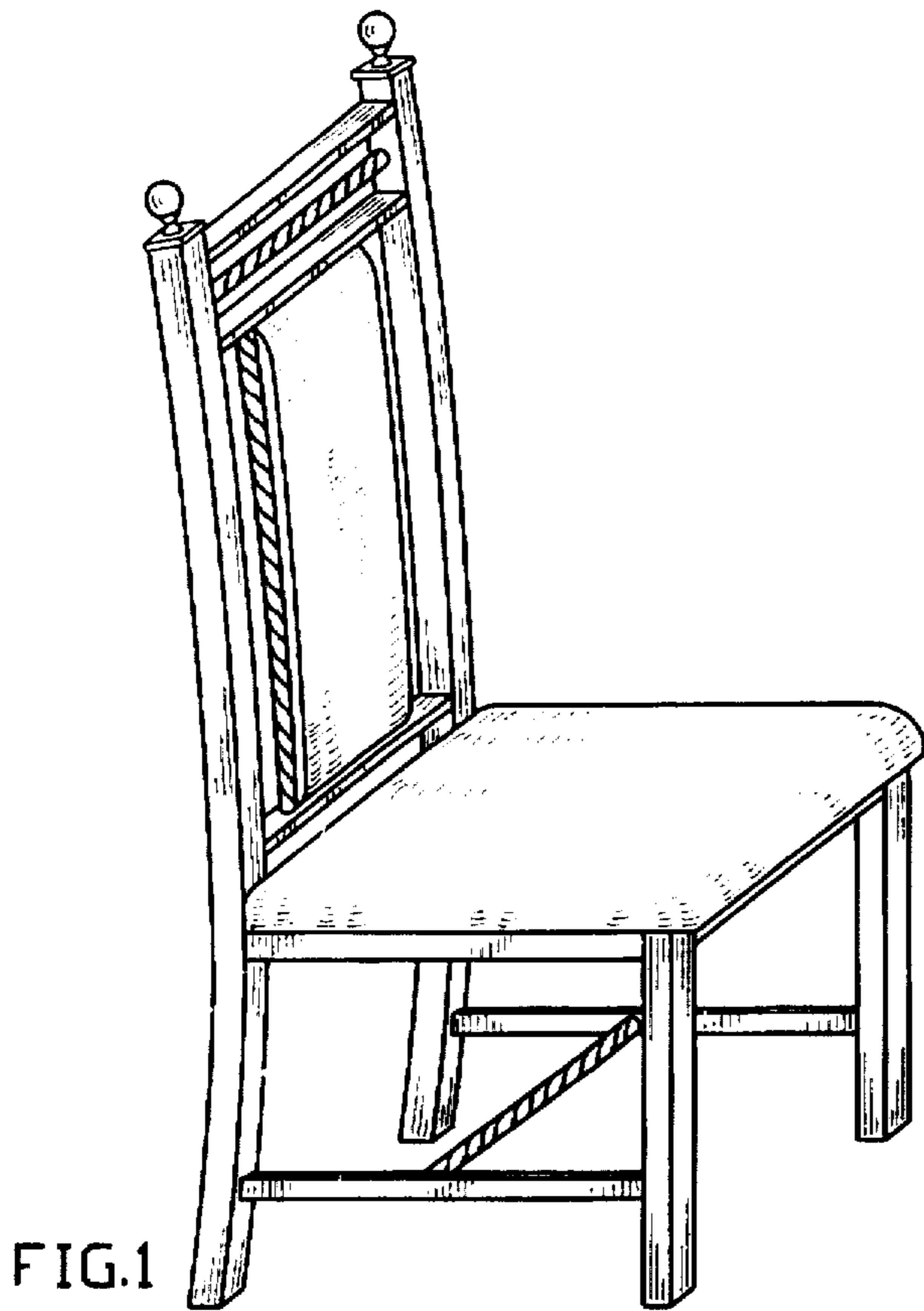

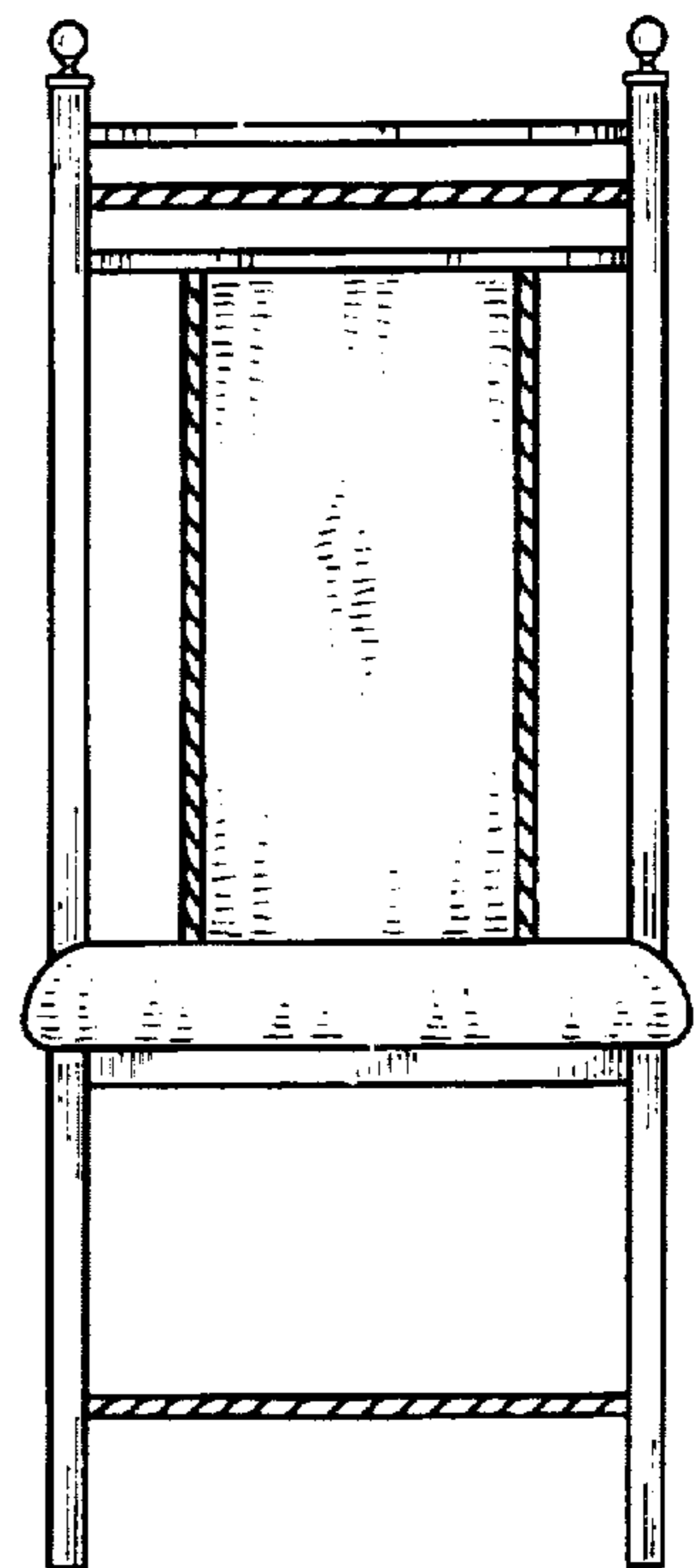

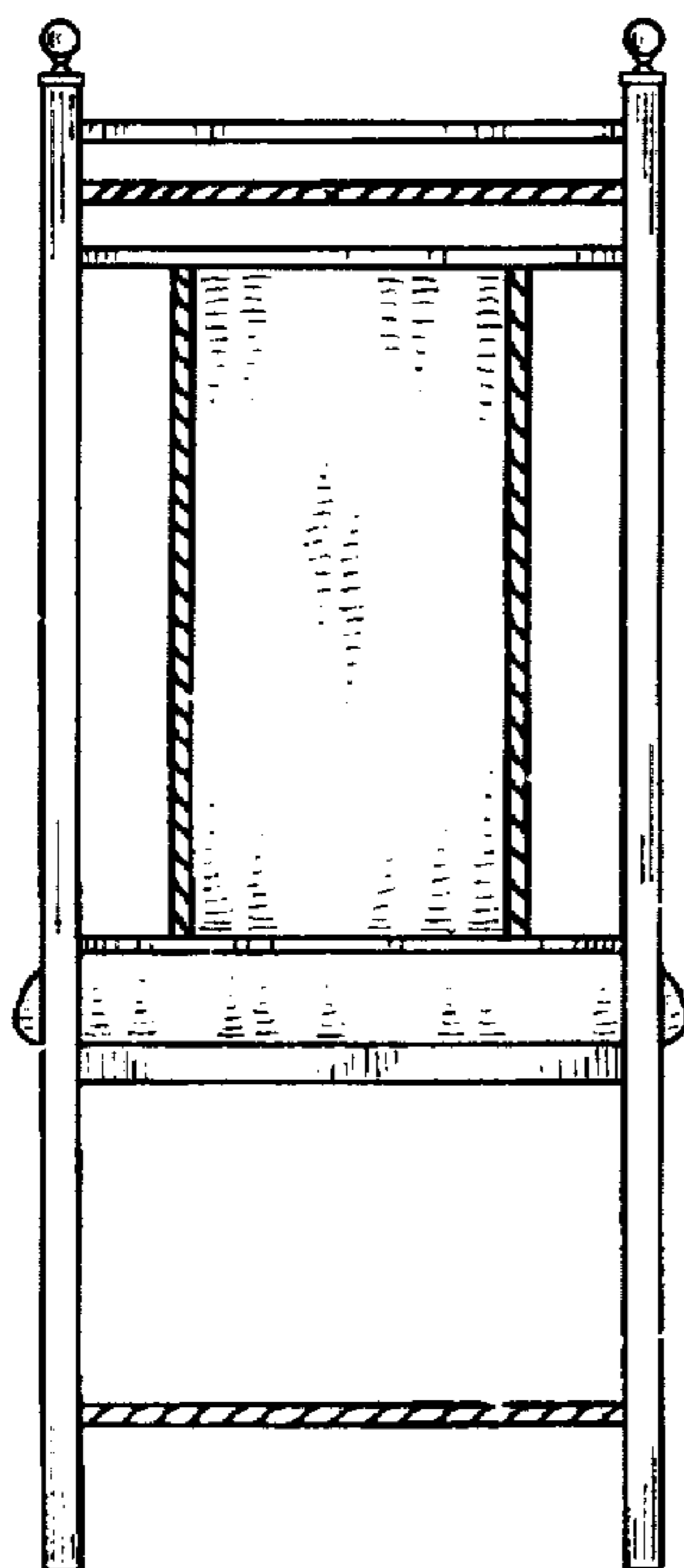

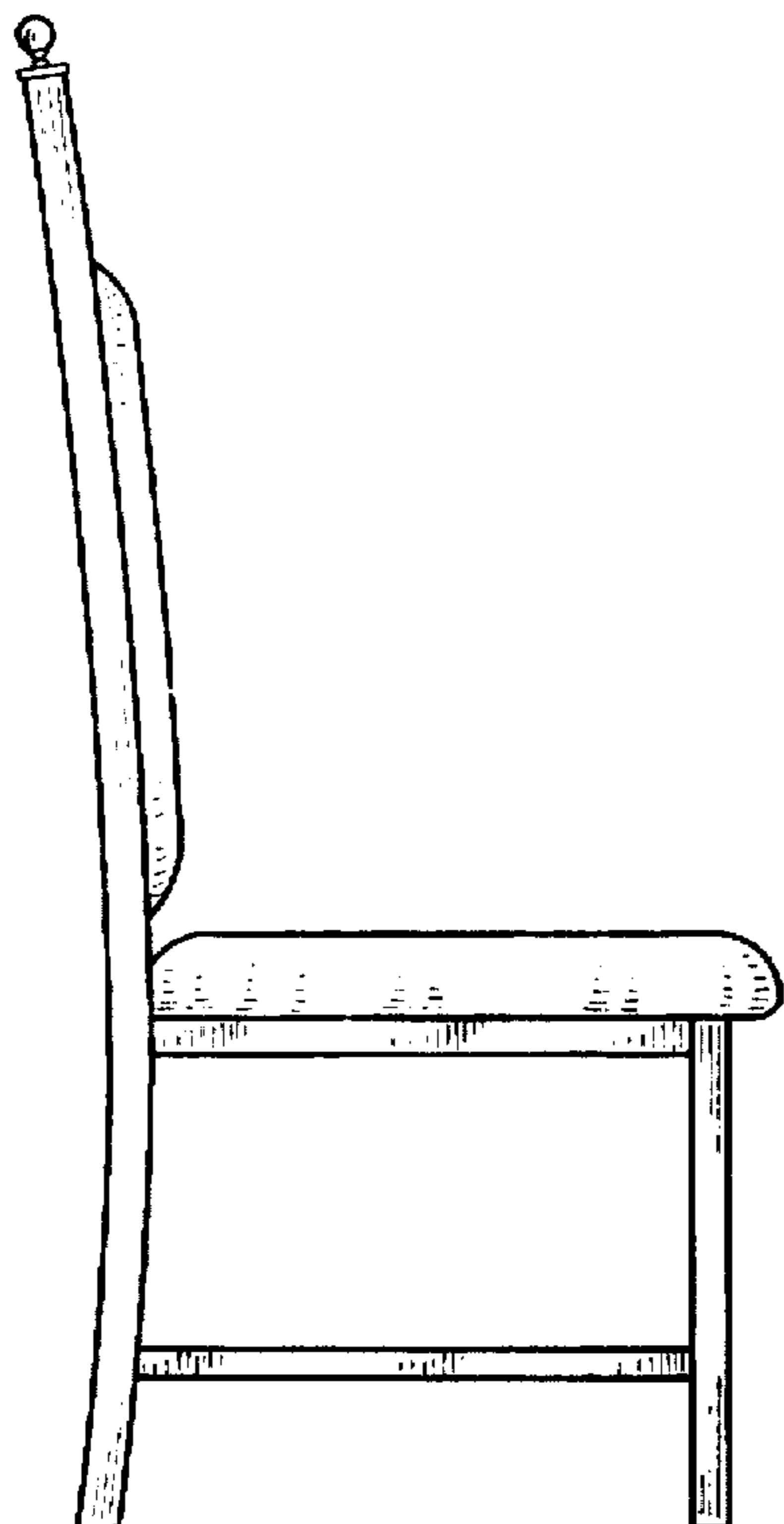

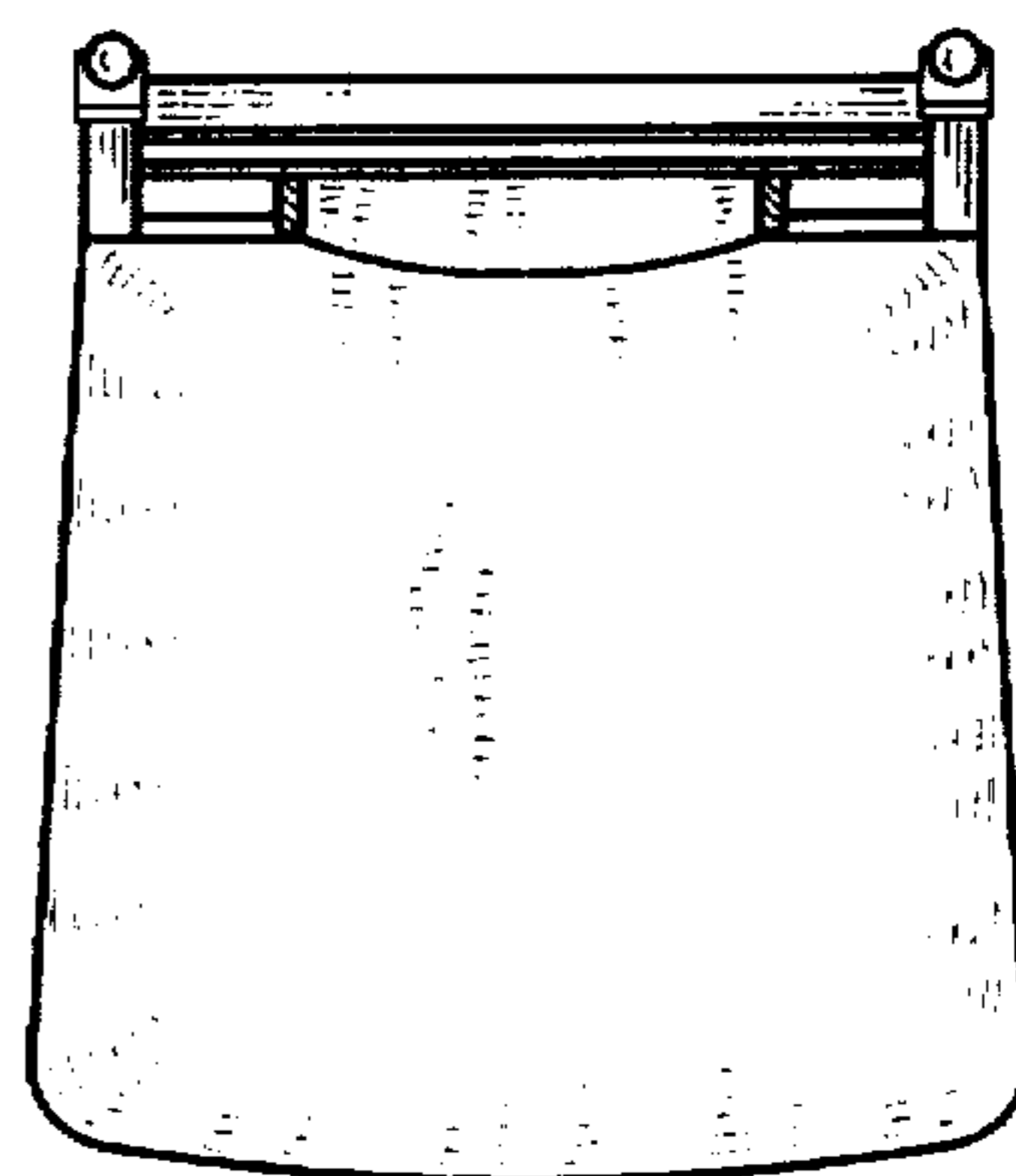
