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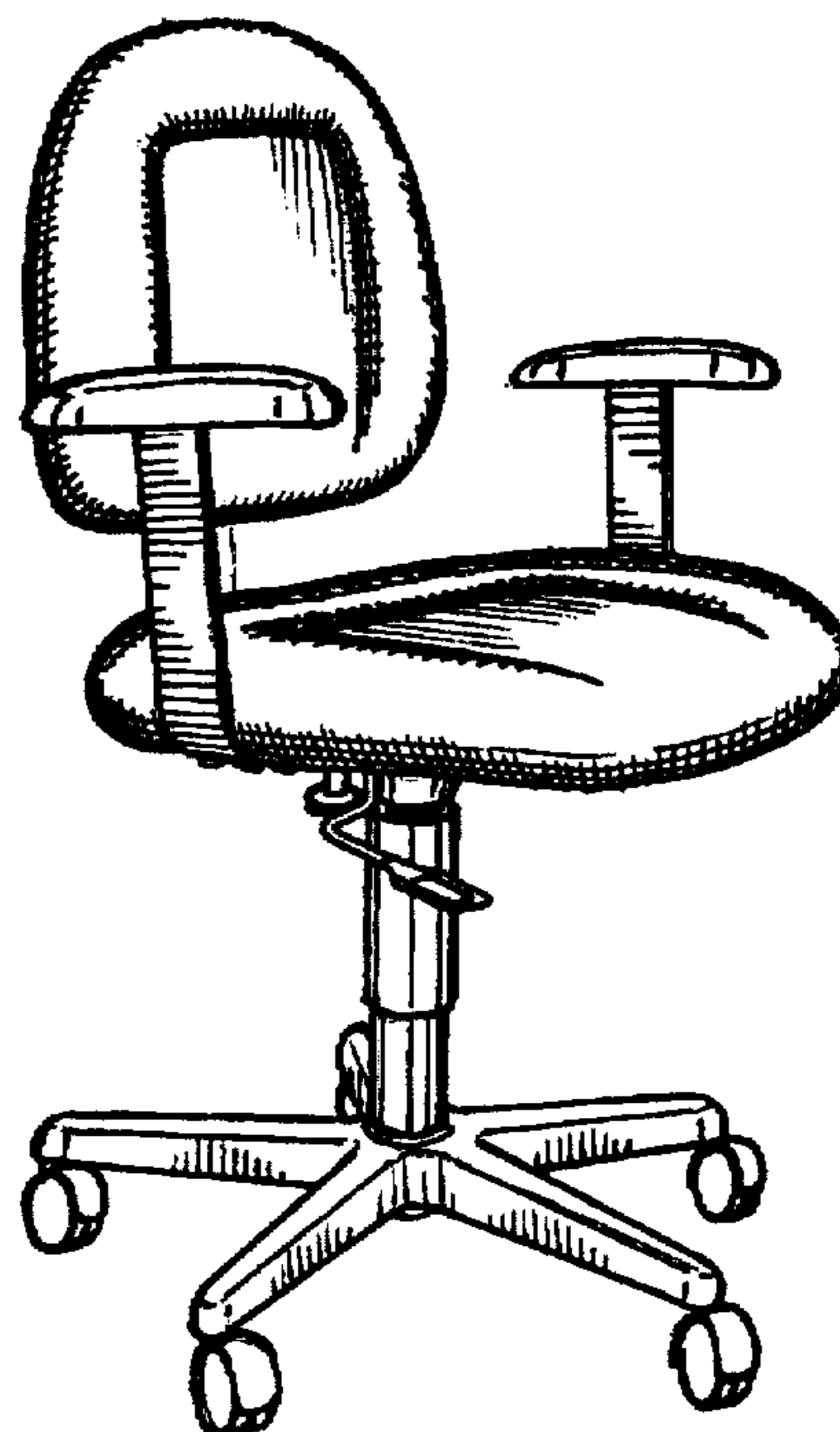
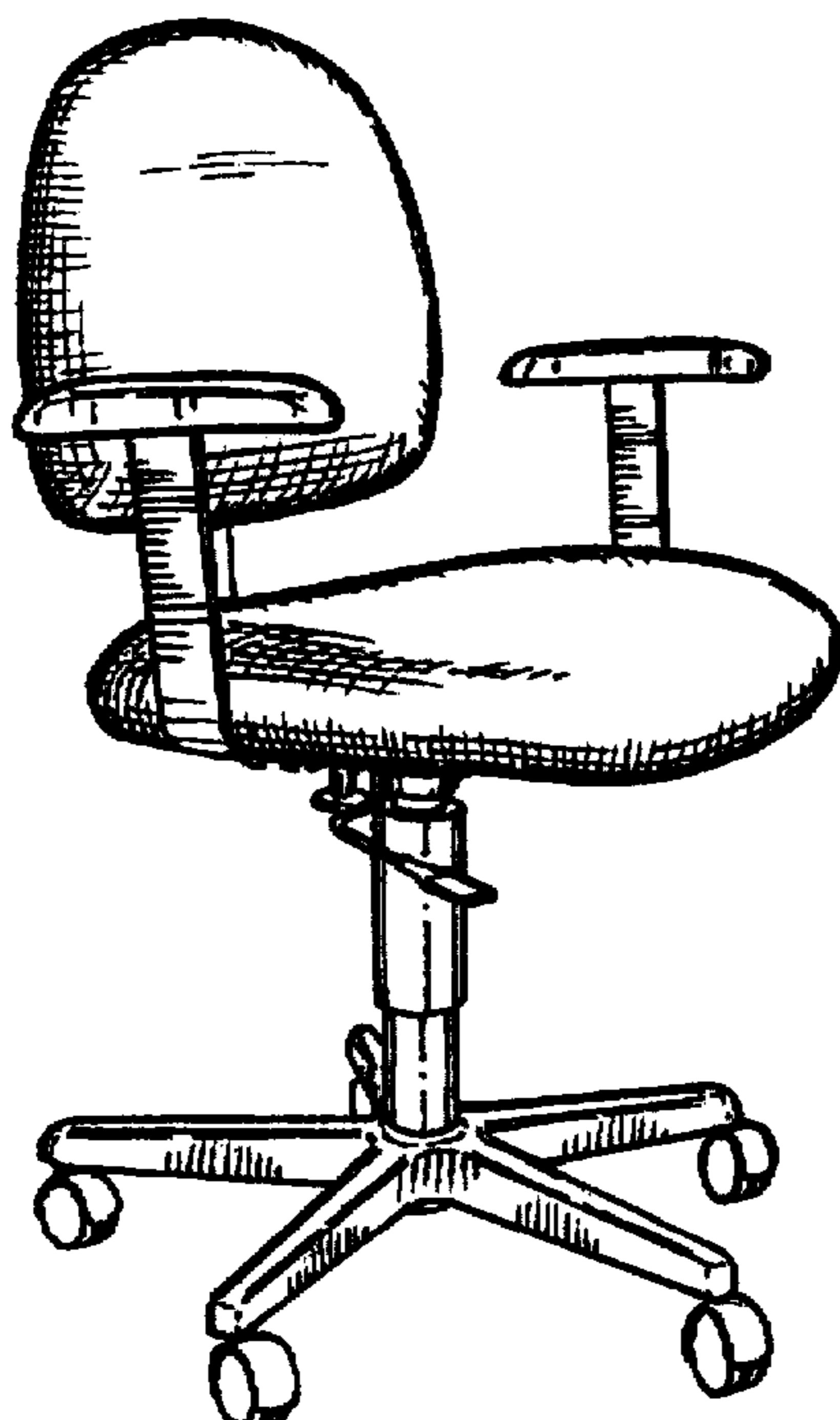
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front and to one side of the chair;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1, the other side of the chair being the mirror image of this view with the exception of the adjustment handle;  
 FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the chair of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the chair of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 6 is a perspective view from the front and to one side of an alternate embodiment of the chair of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the chair of FIG. 6; and,  
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the chair of FIG. 6.  
 The side elevational views of FIG. 6 are like FIG. 3 and the rear elevational view is like FIG. 4. The fragmented cross-hatching shown on the front of the backrest and the top of the seat is understood to represent fabric which would be continuous throughout the implied areas.

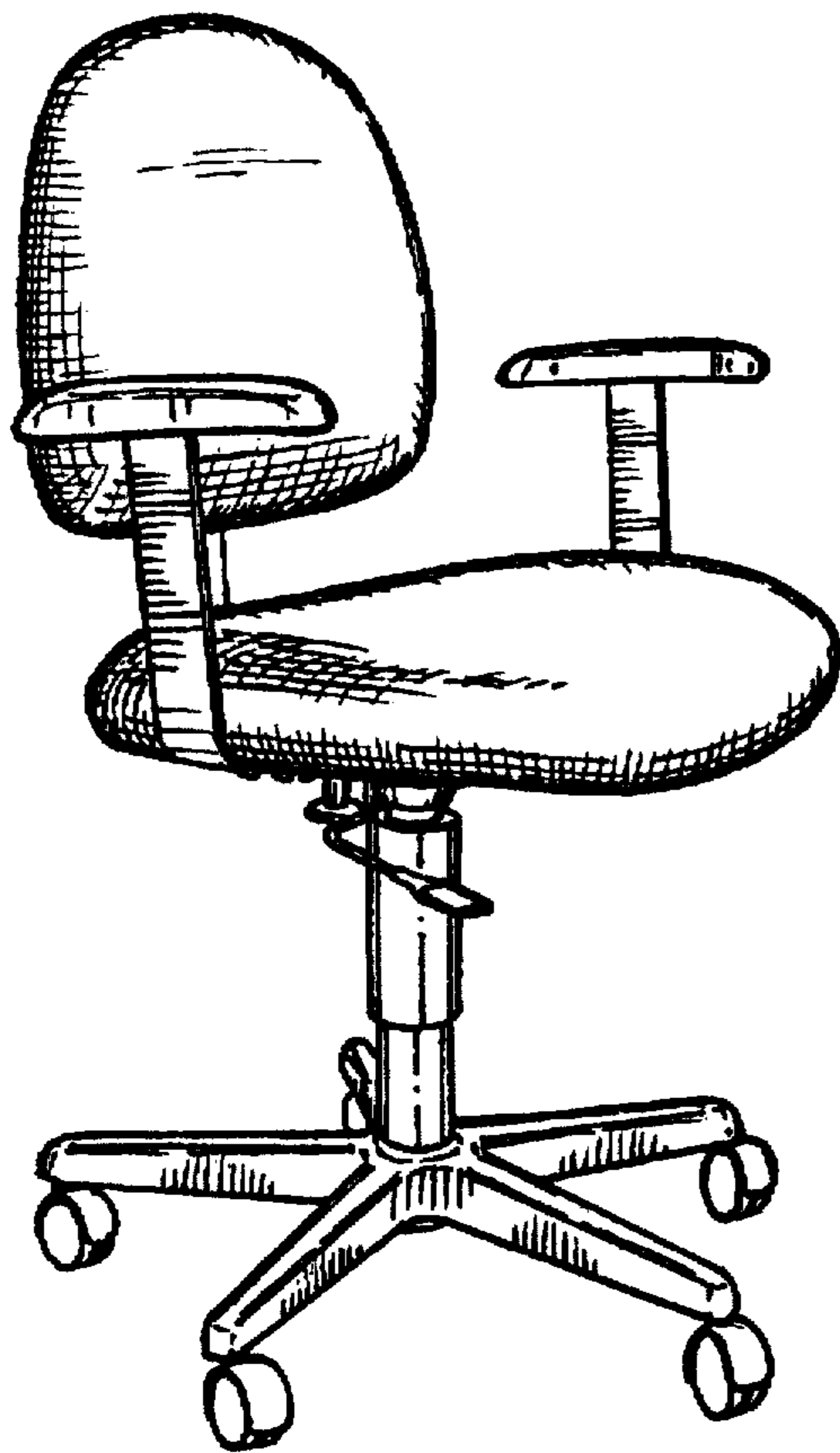

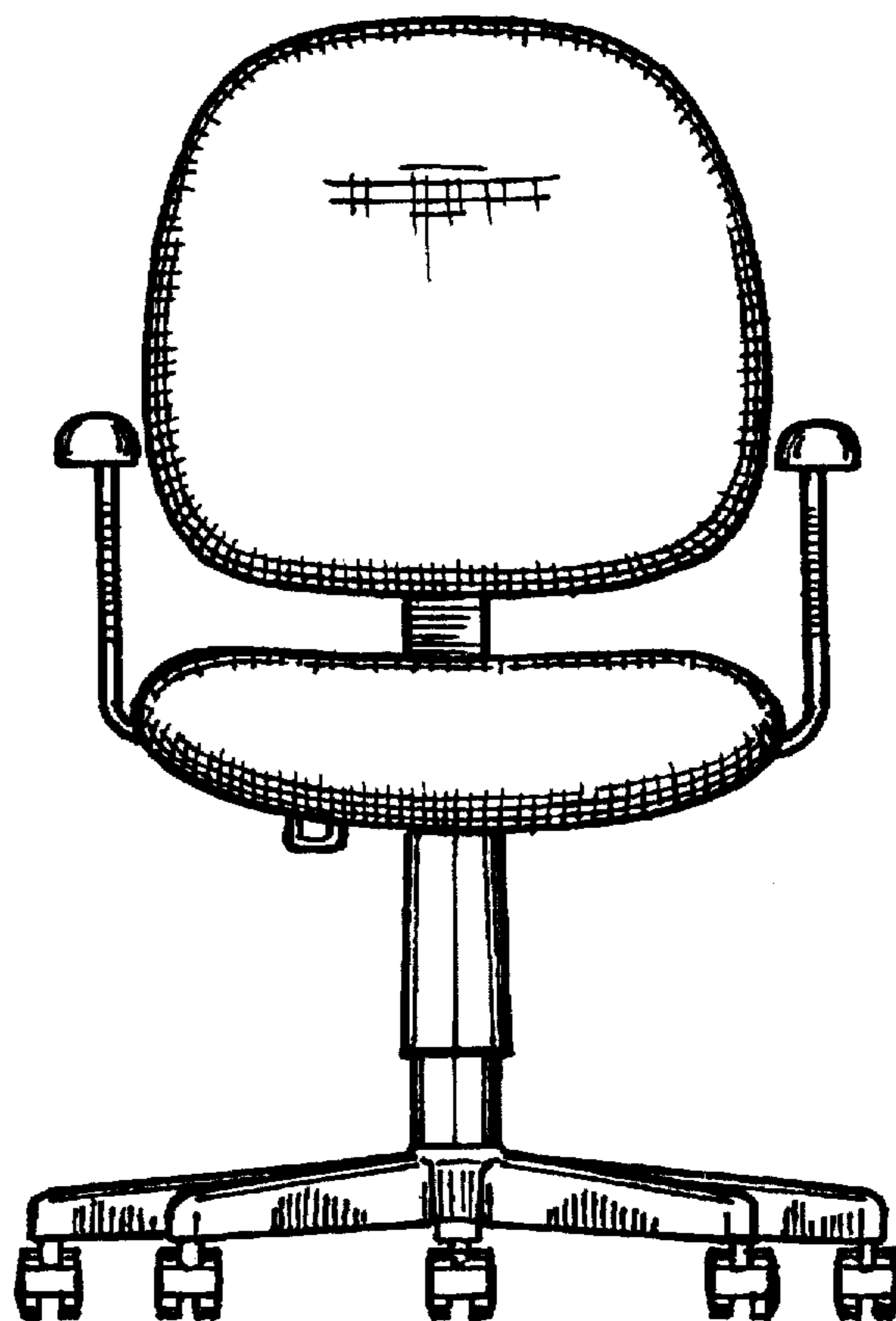

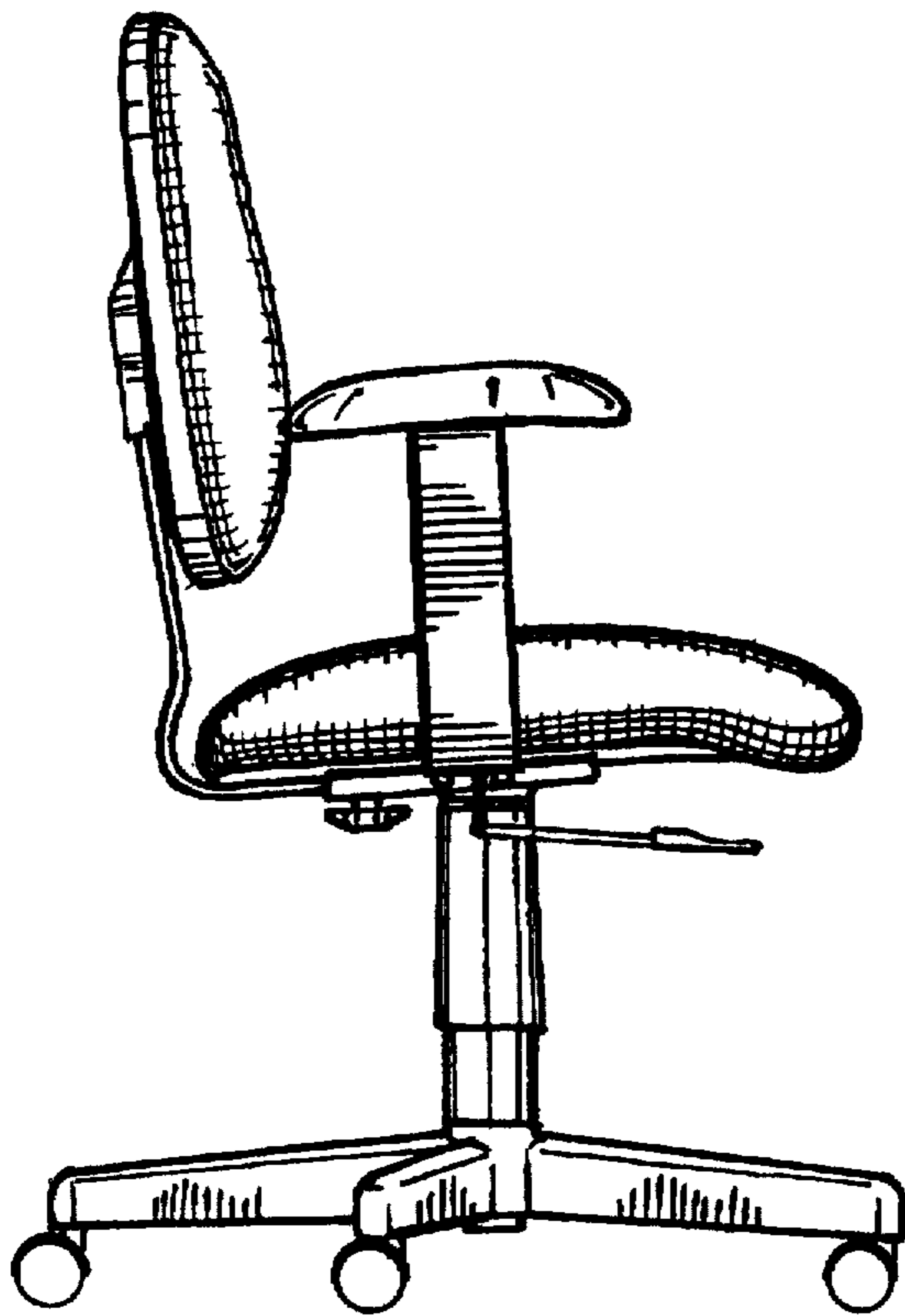

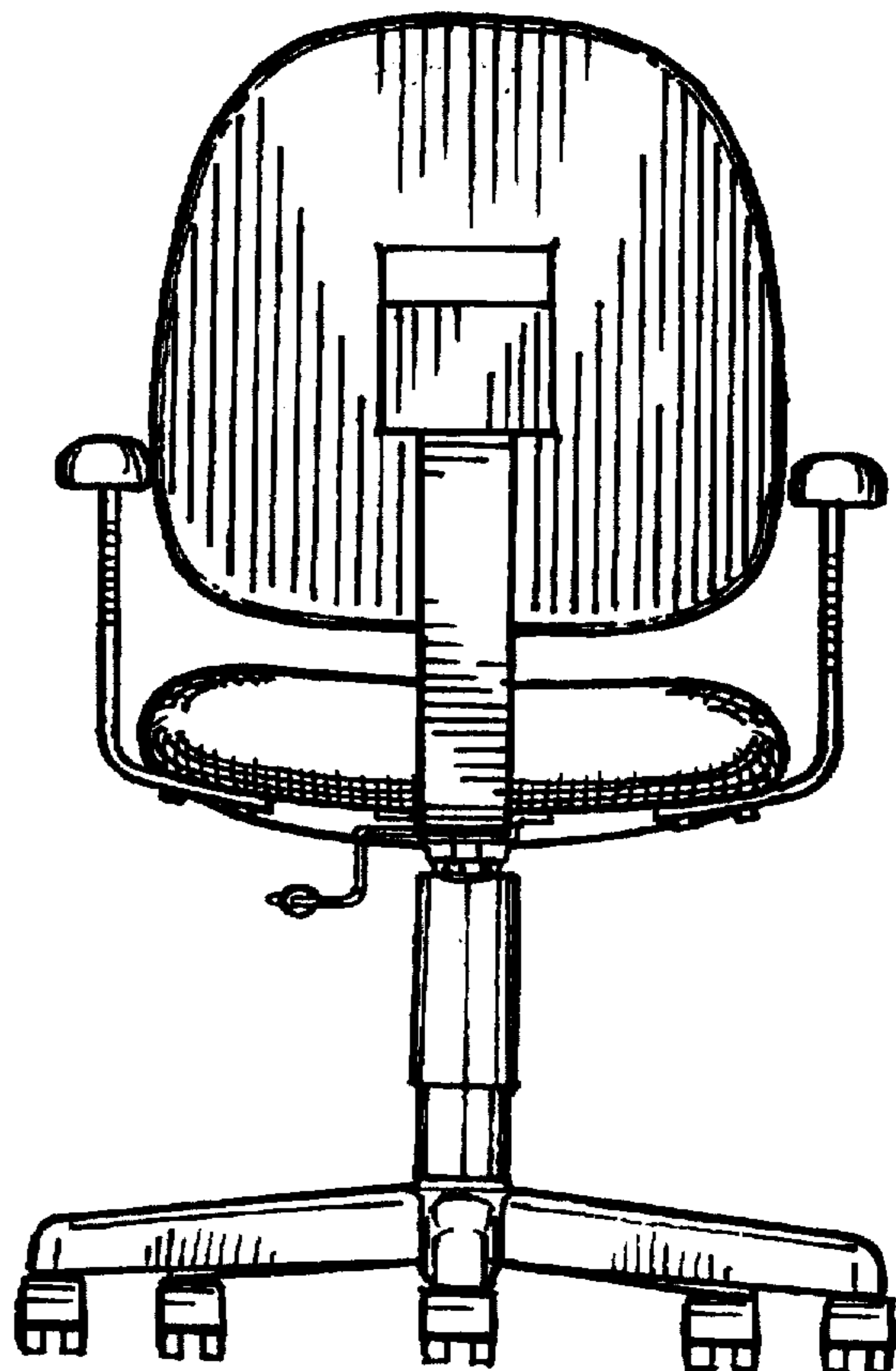

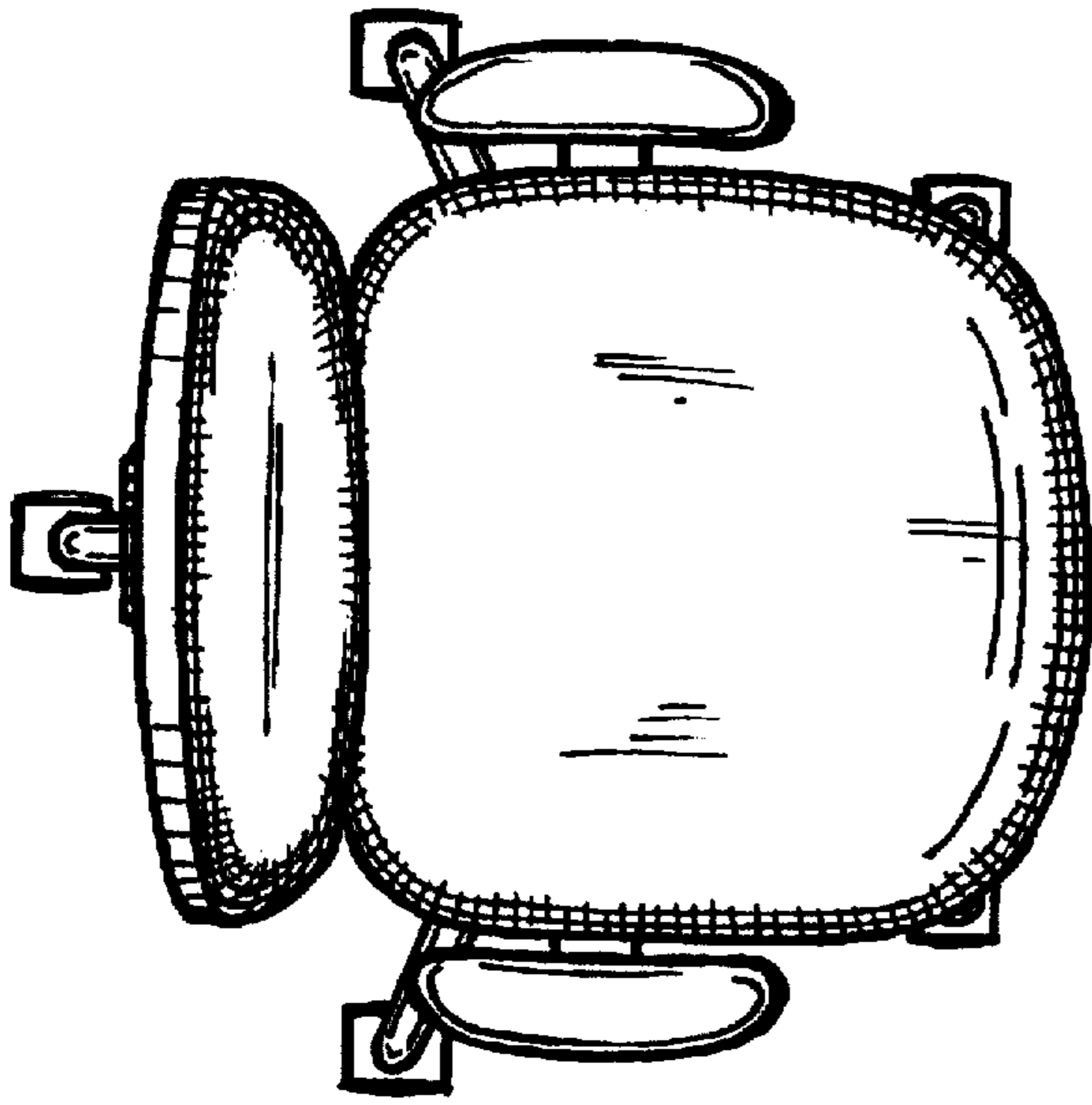

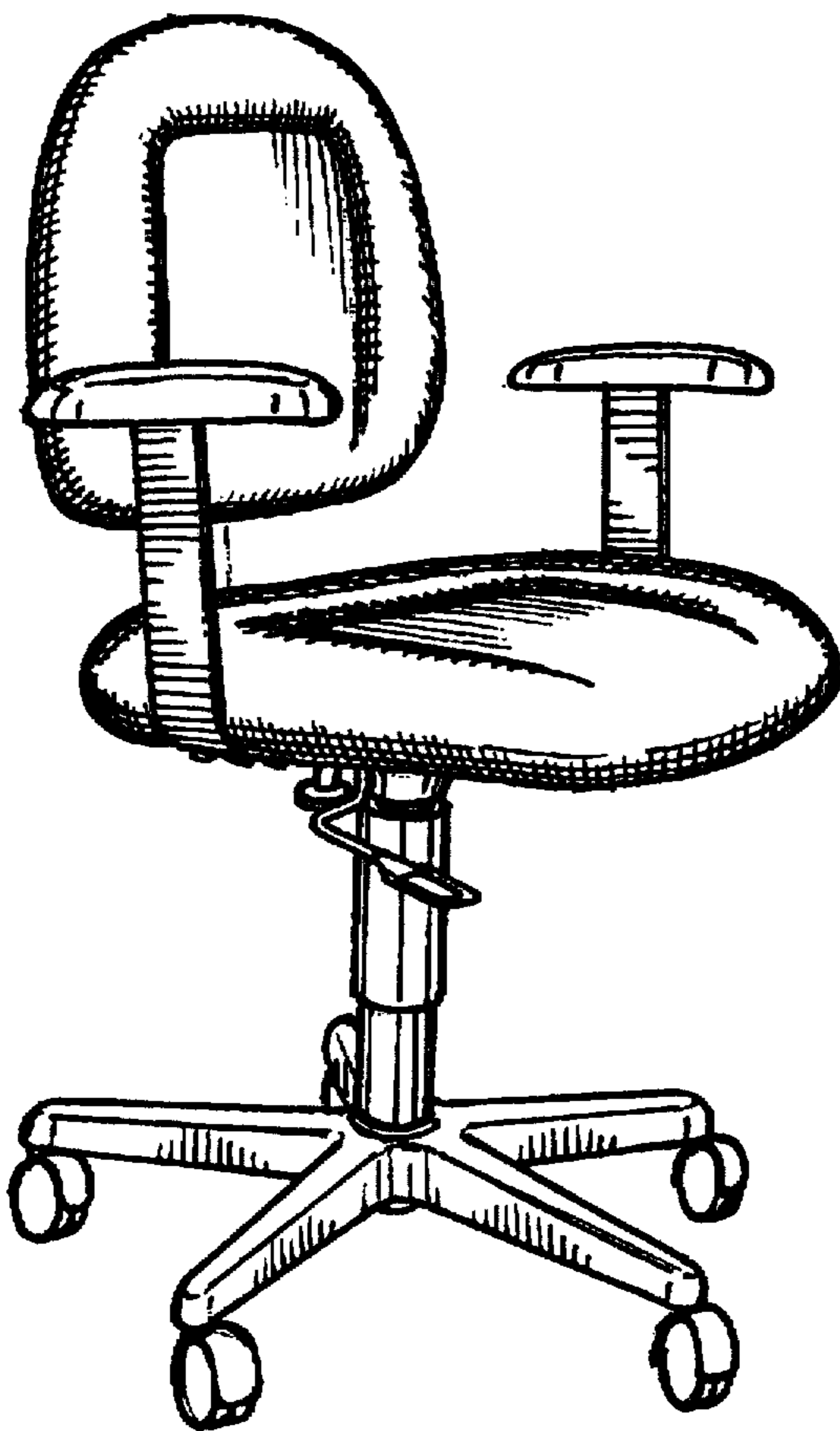

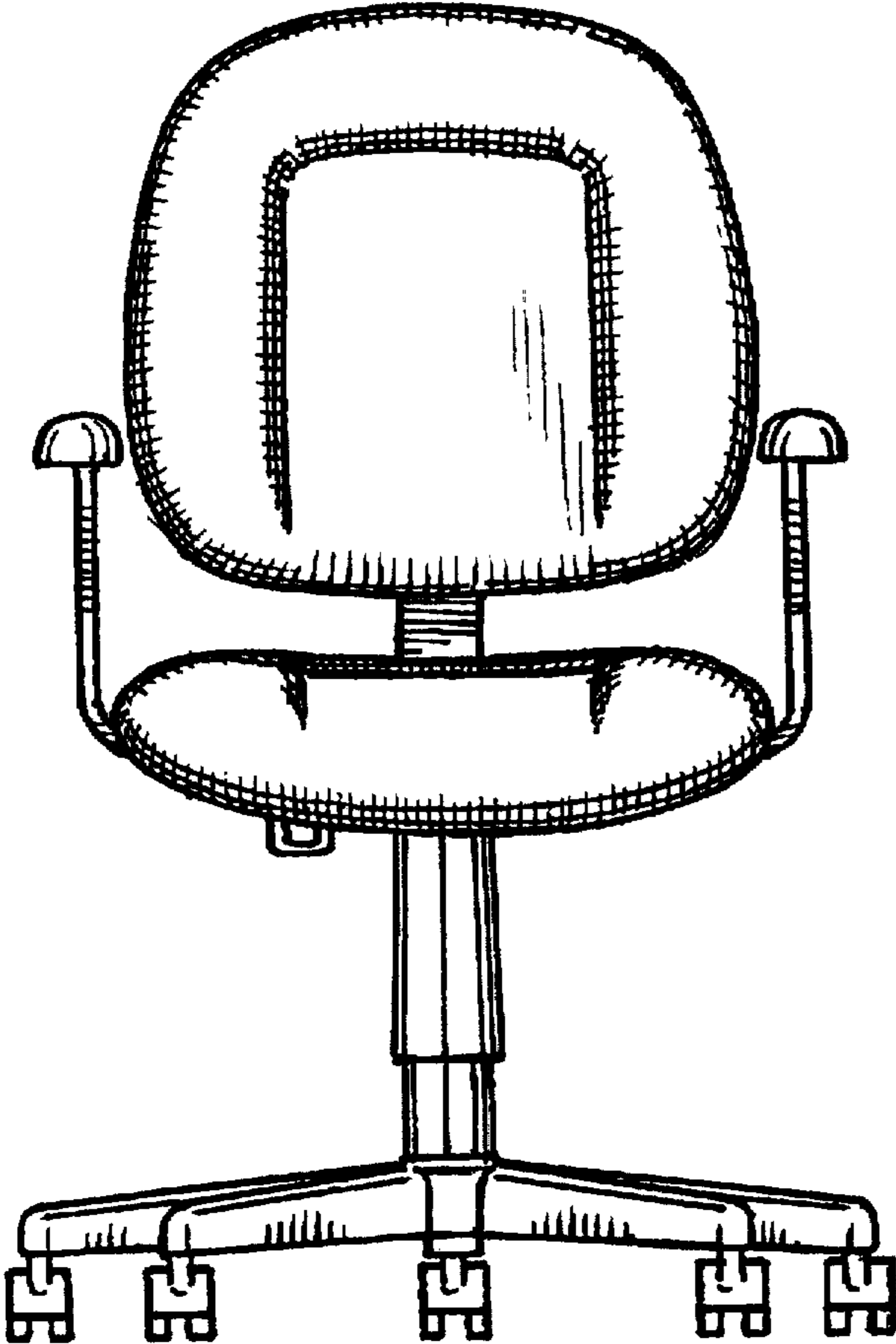

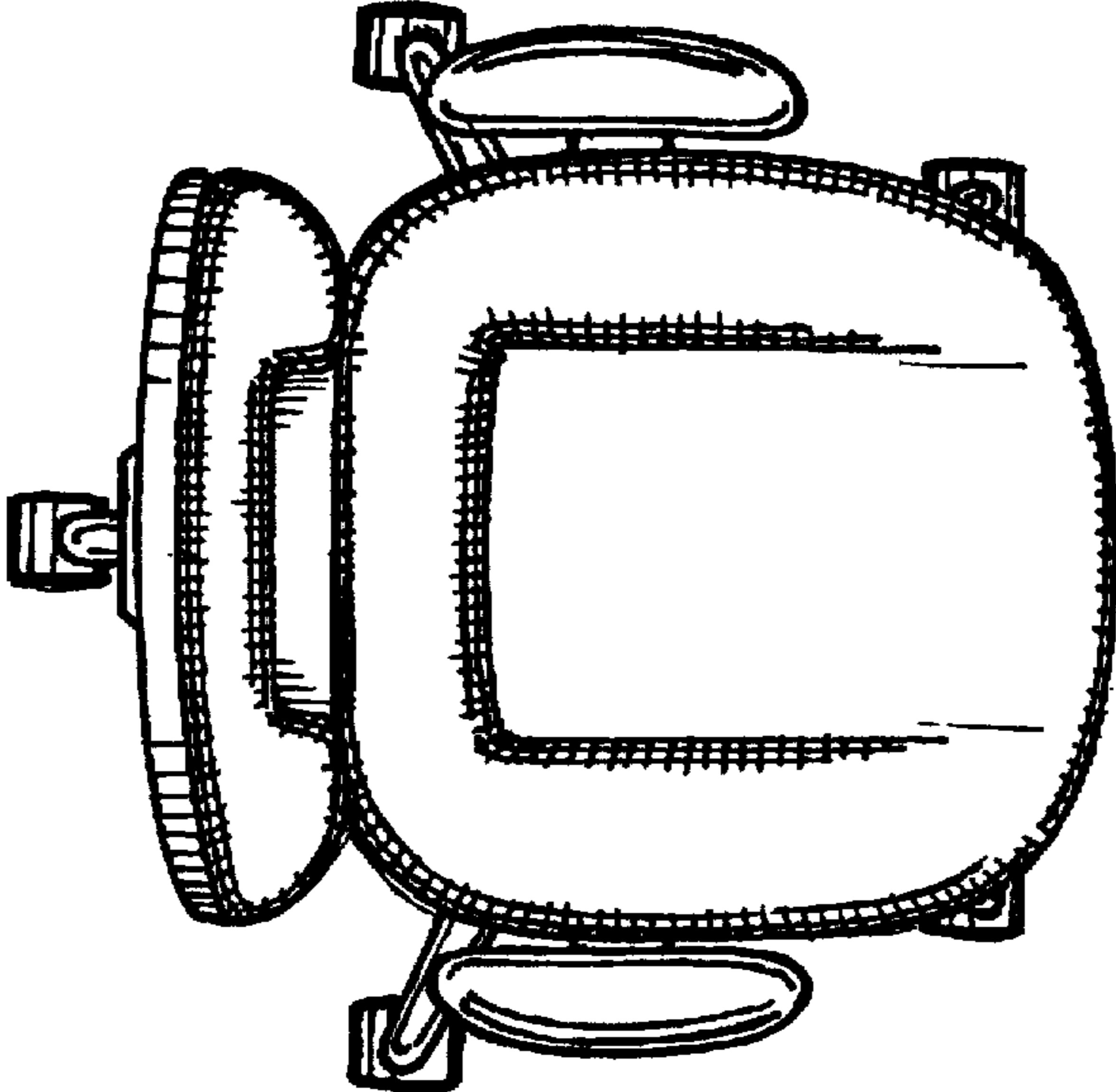
