[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a metalwood golf club head, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the metalwood golf club
head according to the invention taken from the toe end;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation of the metalwood golf club head
according to the invention;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the metalwood golf club head
according to the invention;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the metalwood golf club
head according to the invention;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation of the metalwood golf club head
according to the invention;

FIG. 6 is side elevation of the metalwood golf club head
taken from the toe end;

FIG. 7 is a side elevation of the metalwood golf club head
taken from the heel end; and,

FIG. 8 is a reduced top front perspective view of the metal
wood golf club head according to the invention.

The broken line showing of a shaft and handle, grooves on
the striking face and bottom surface detail is for illustrative
purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.














