 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

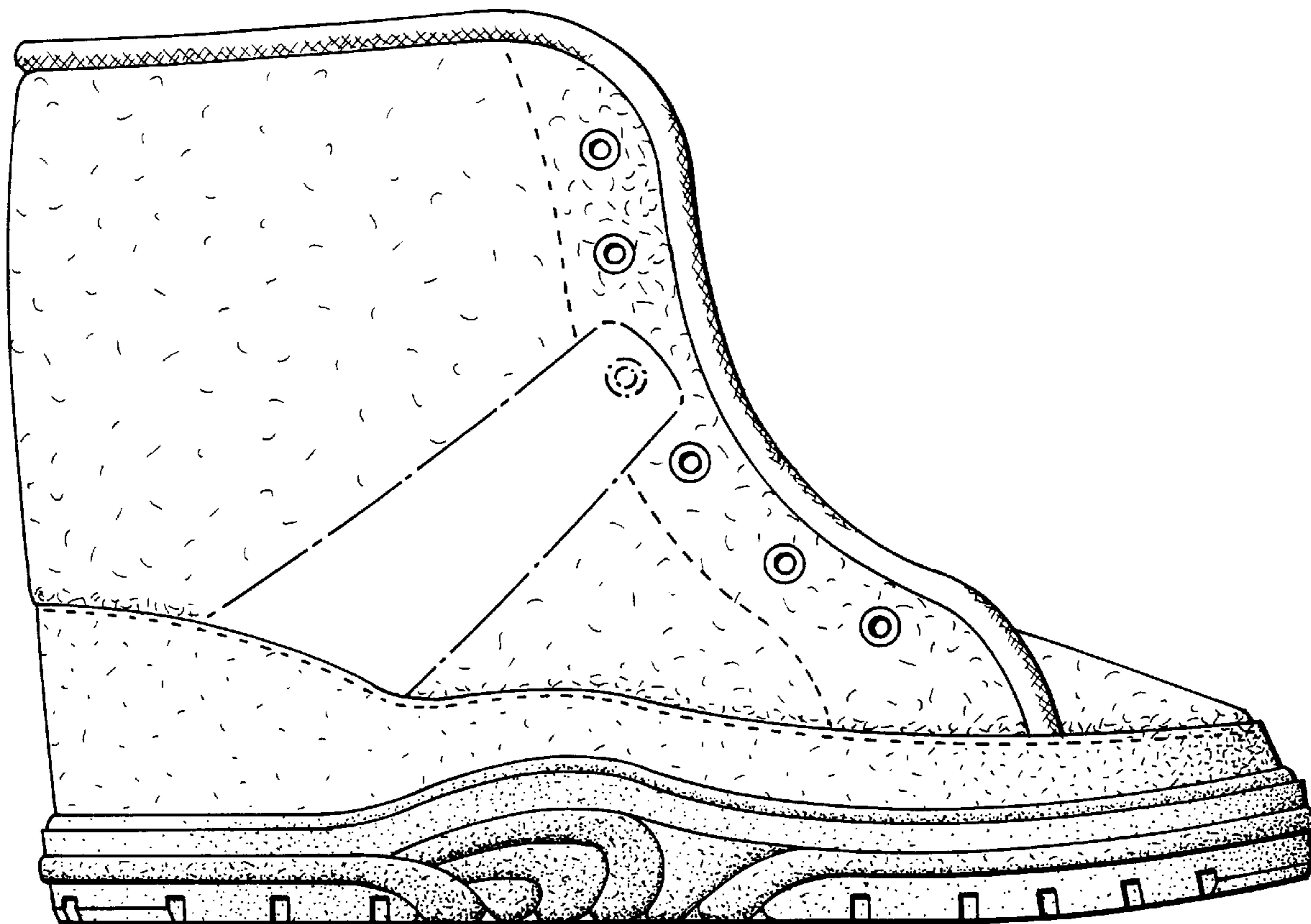
The broken line showing of the stabilizer in FIGS. 1-4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

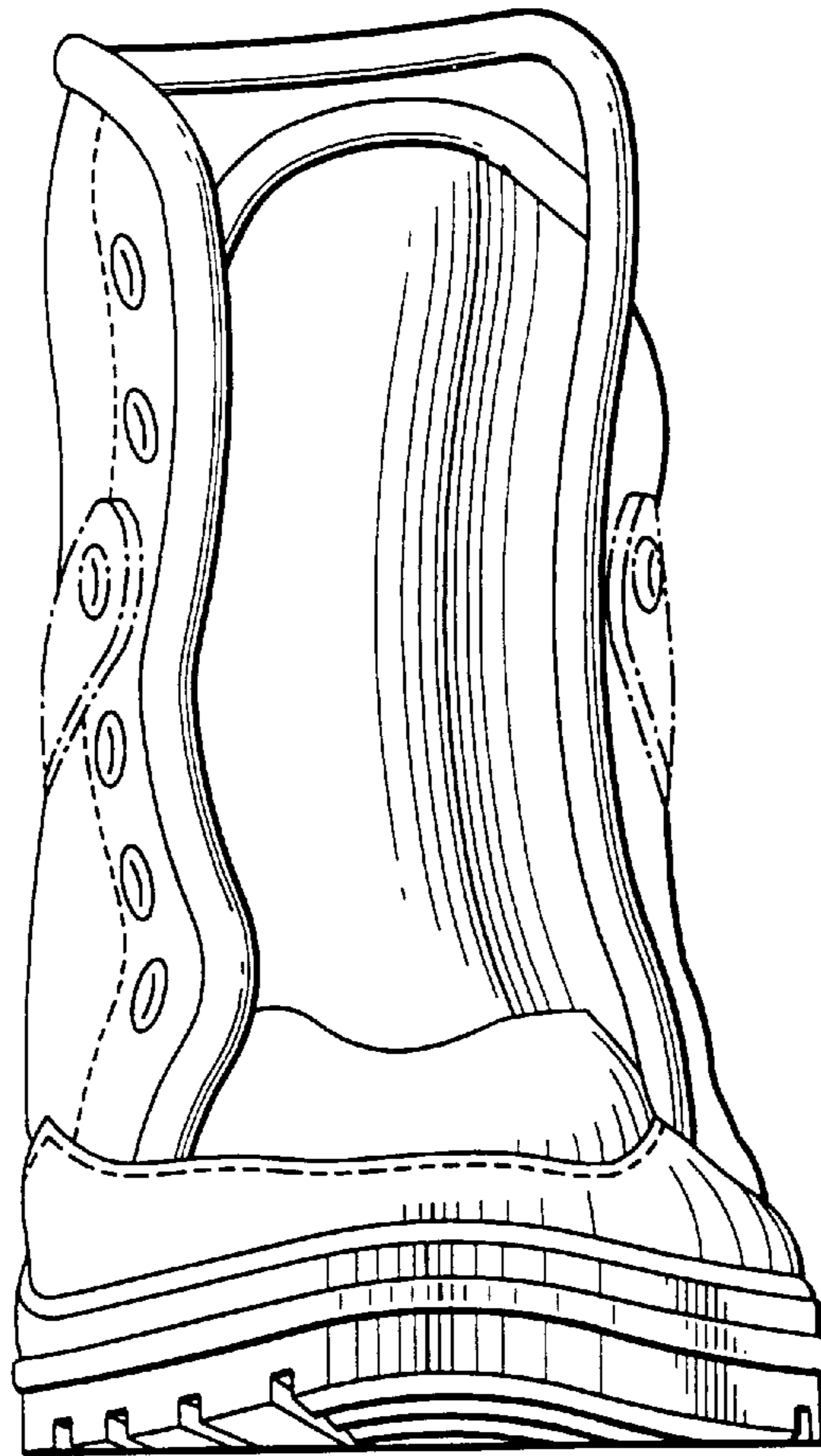

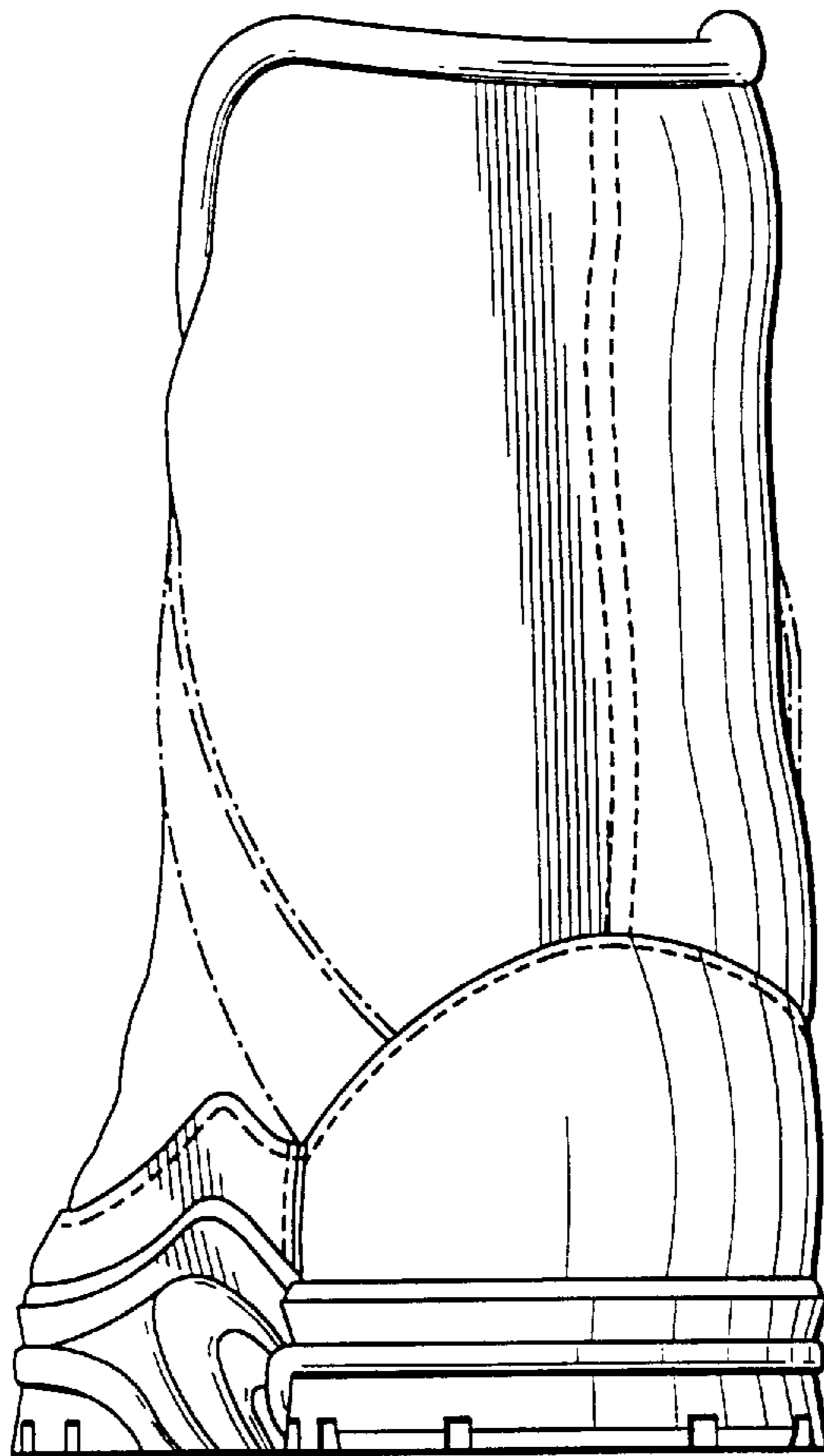

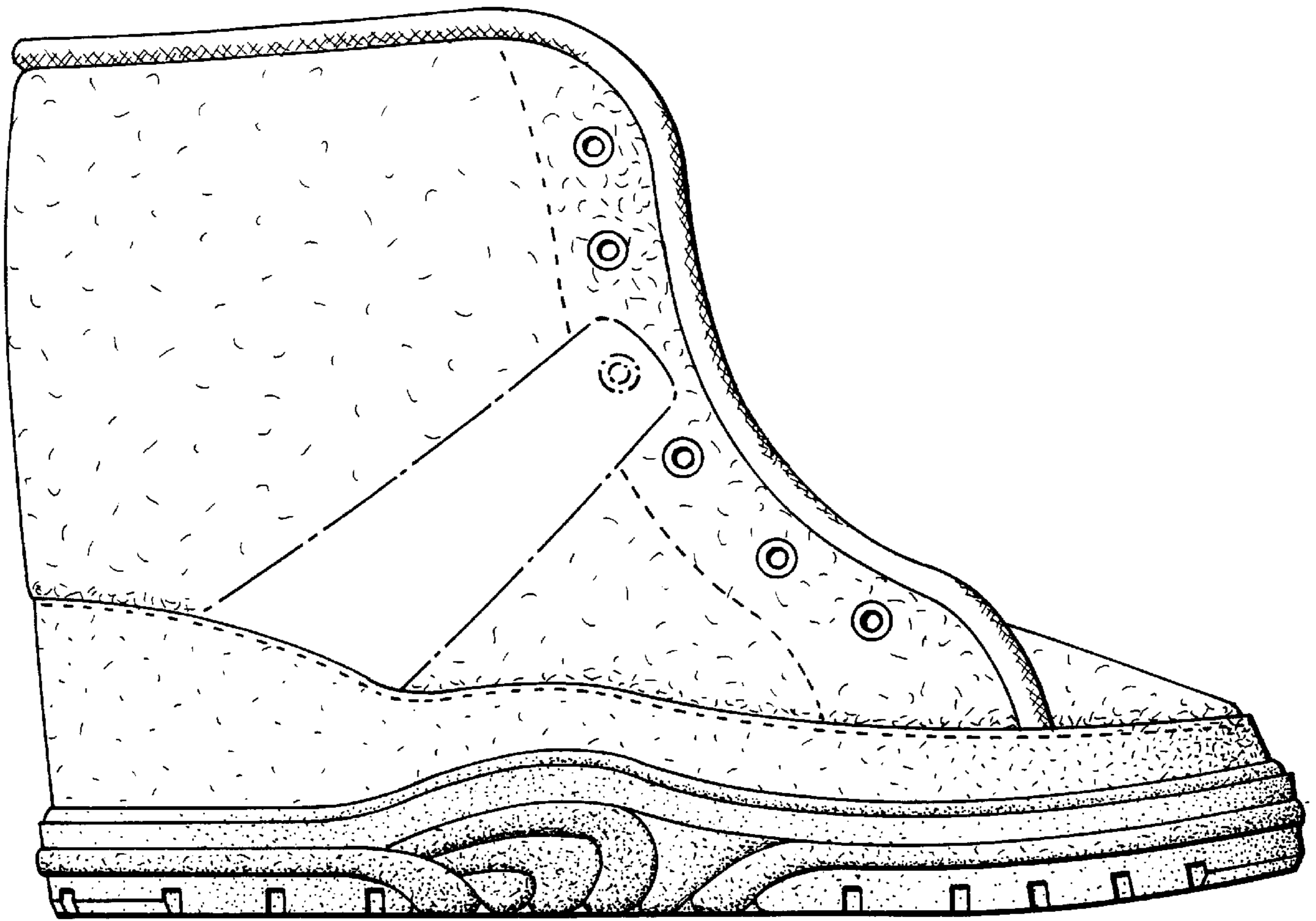

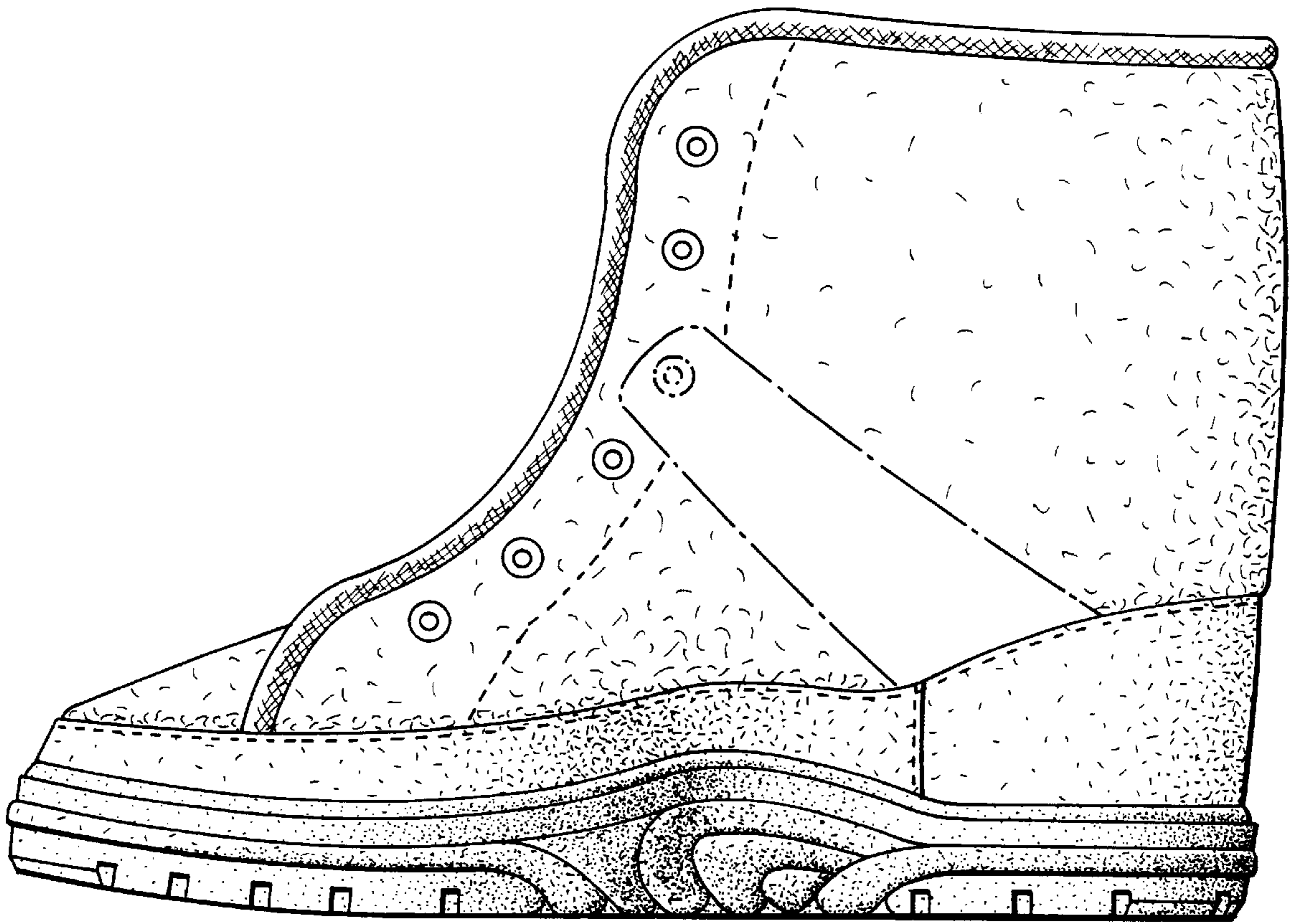

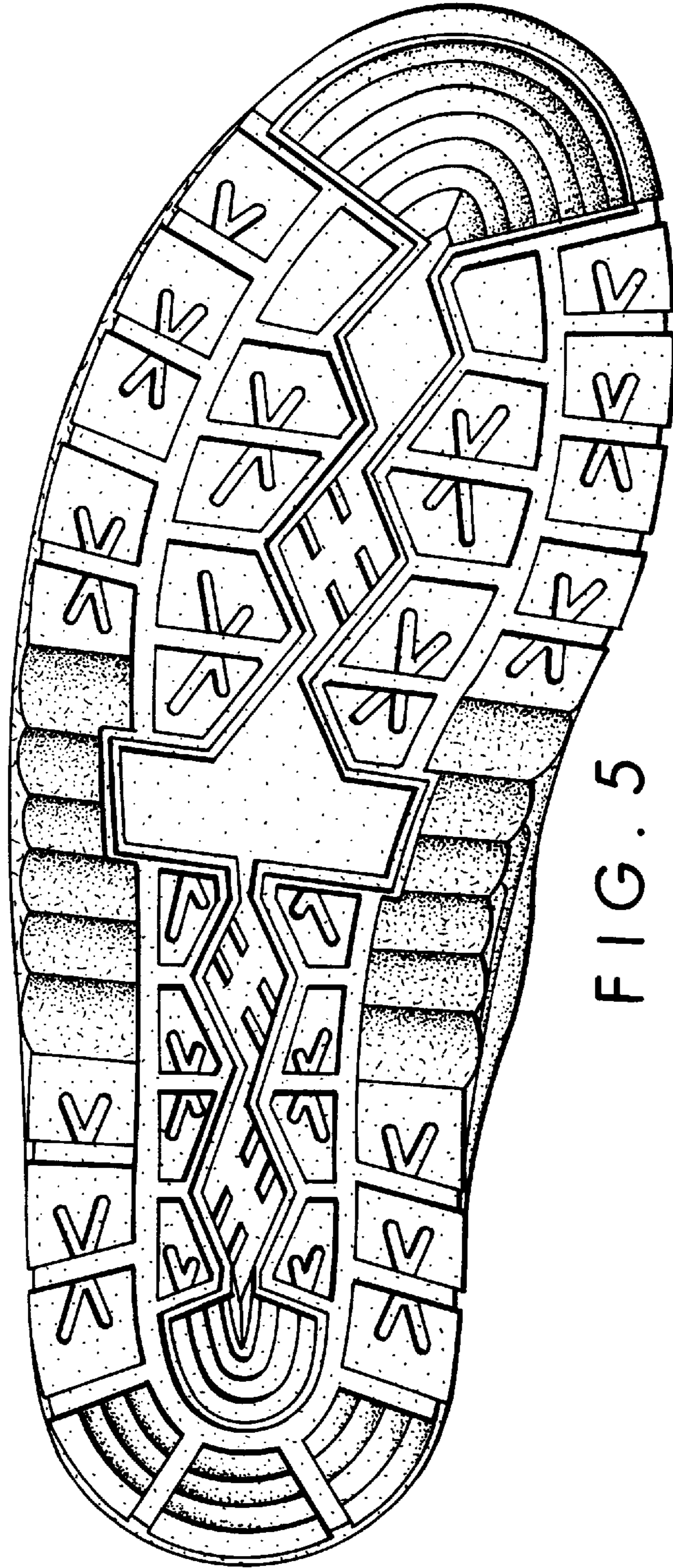
