The ornamental design for a side element of a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a side element of a shoe upper in accordance with my invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the side element of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the side element of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the side element of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1.

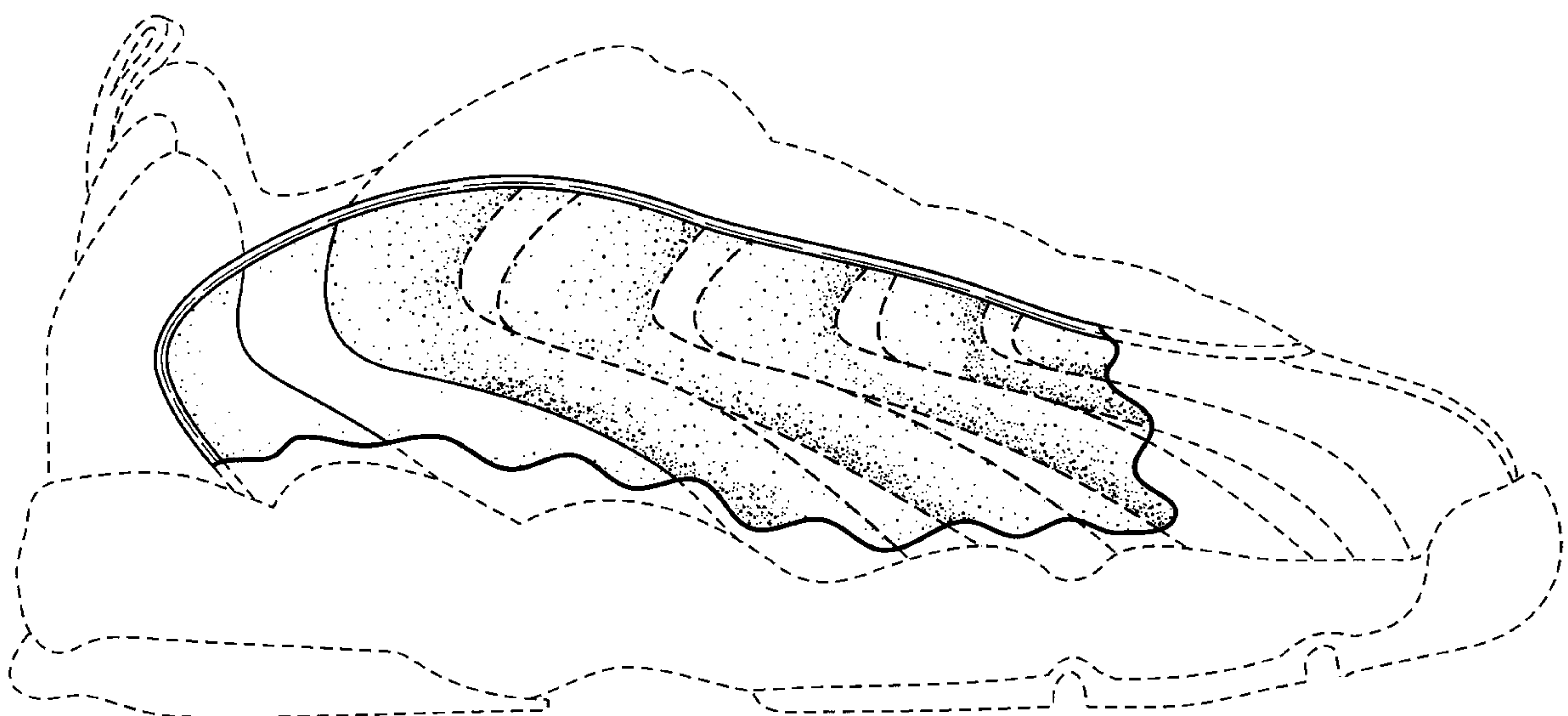

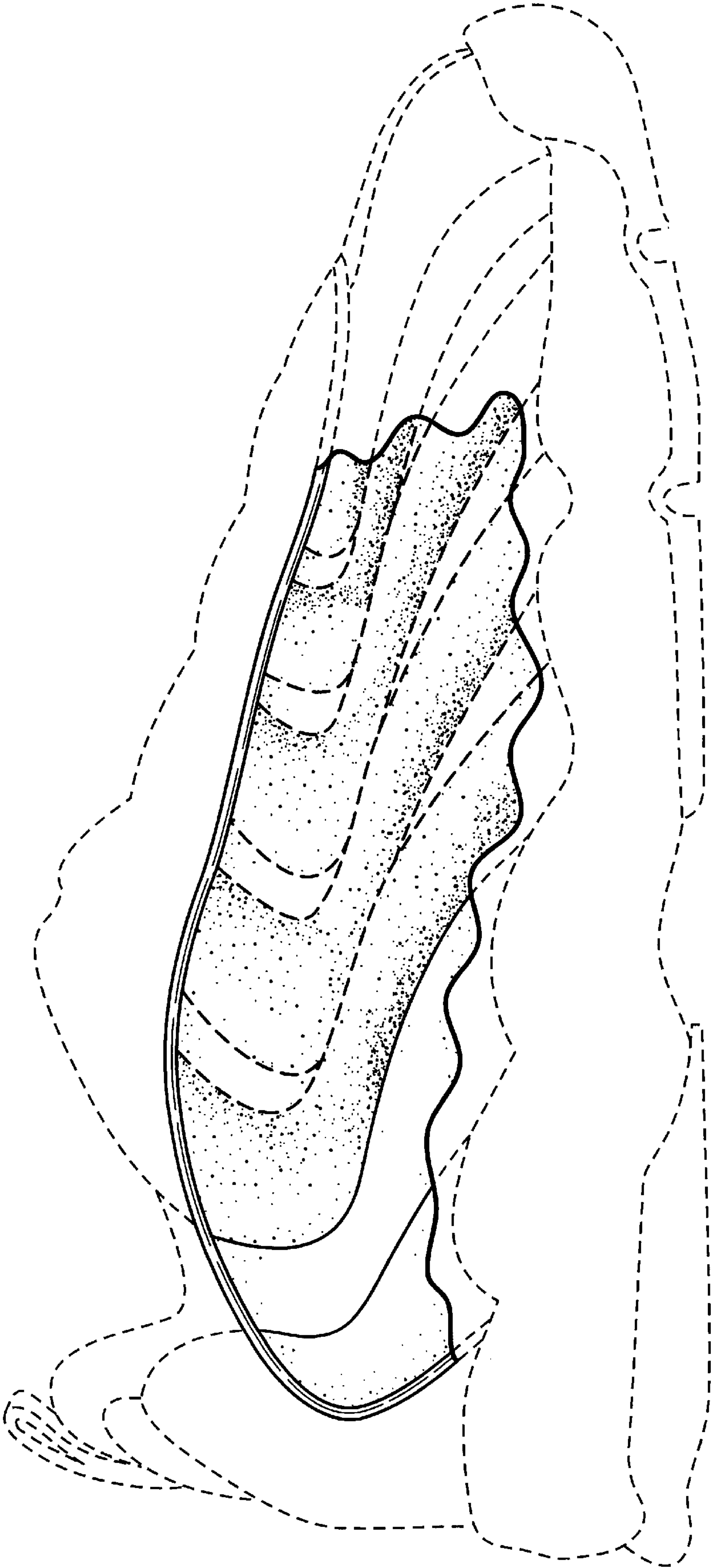

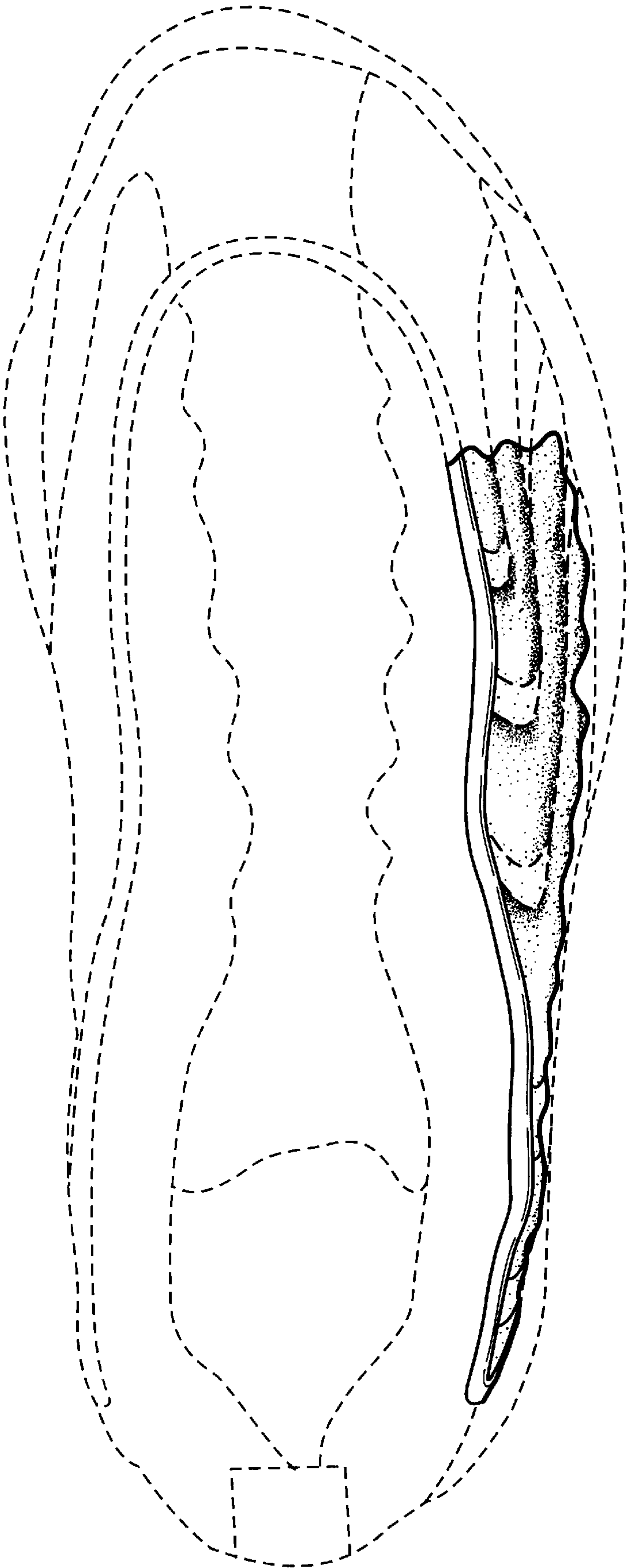

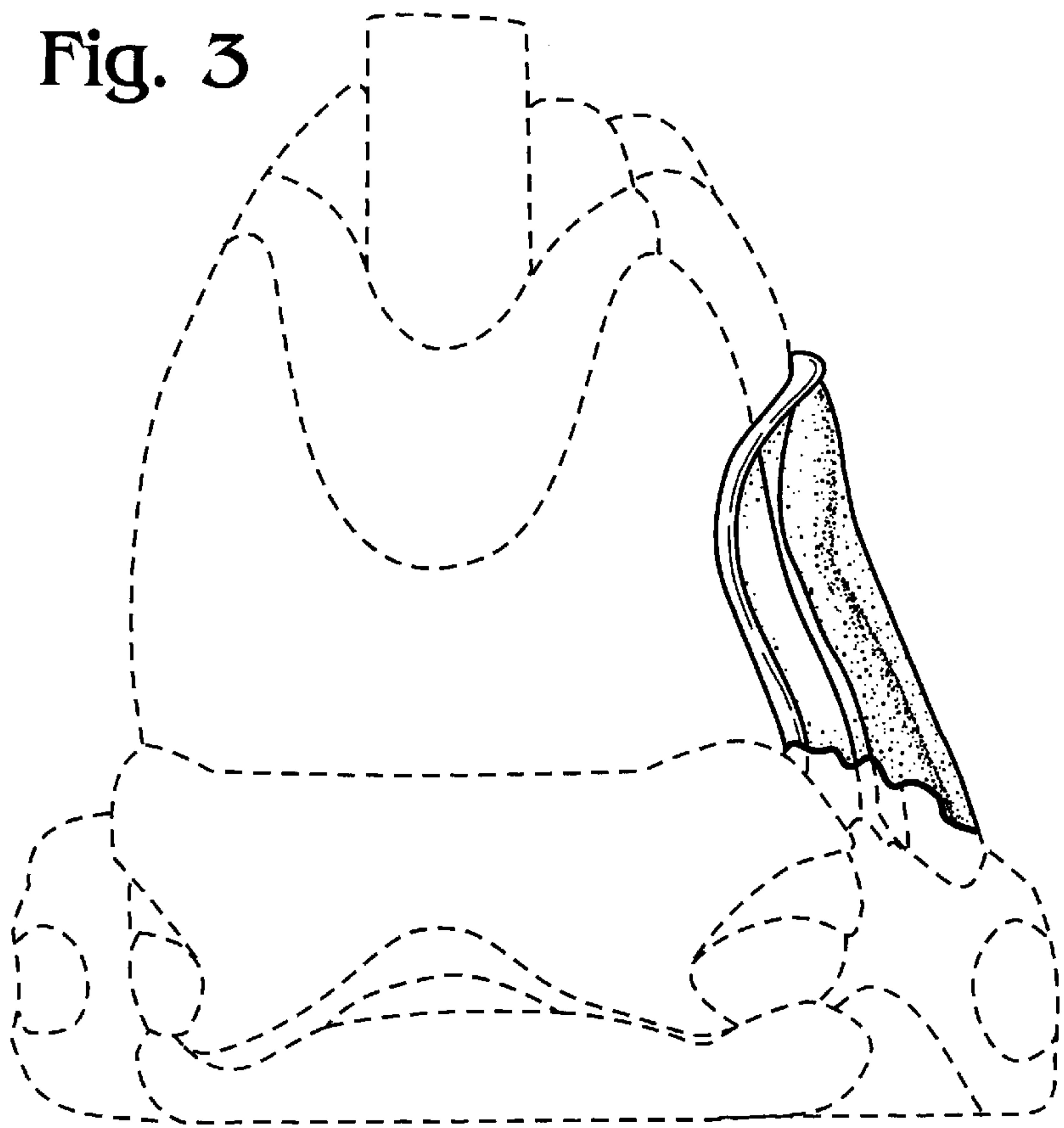
