The ornamental design of a combined medical aspirator tube and mirror assembly, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined medical aspirator tube and mirror assembly showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a view of one end thereof;
FIG. 6 is a view of the opposite end thereof;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of another embodiment thereof;
FIG. 8 is a top view of the other embodiment;
FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the other embodiment;
FIG. 10 is a side view of the other embodiment, the opposite side view being a mirror image; and,
FIG. 11 is an end view of the other embodiment, the opposite end view being the same.
