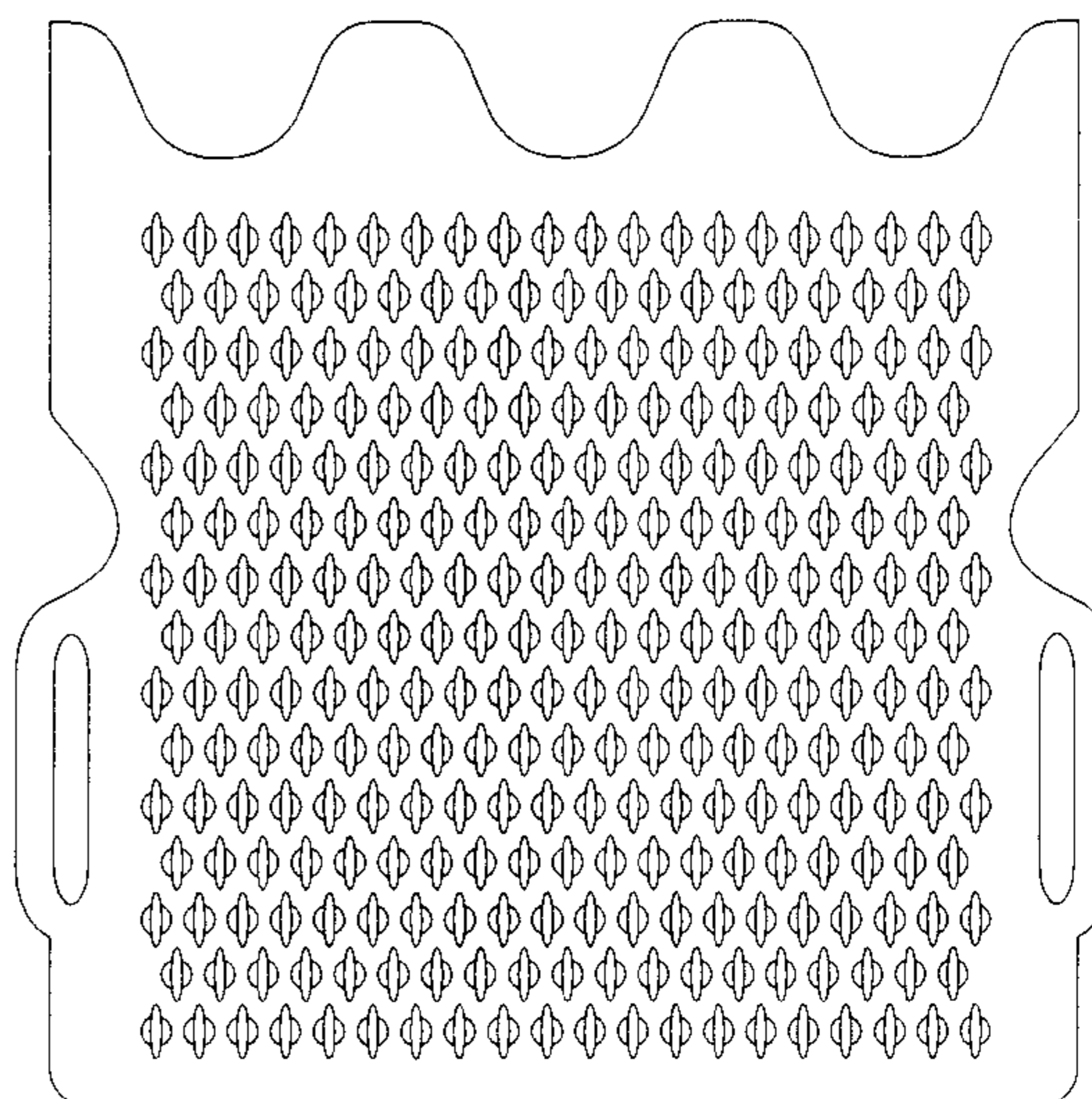
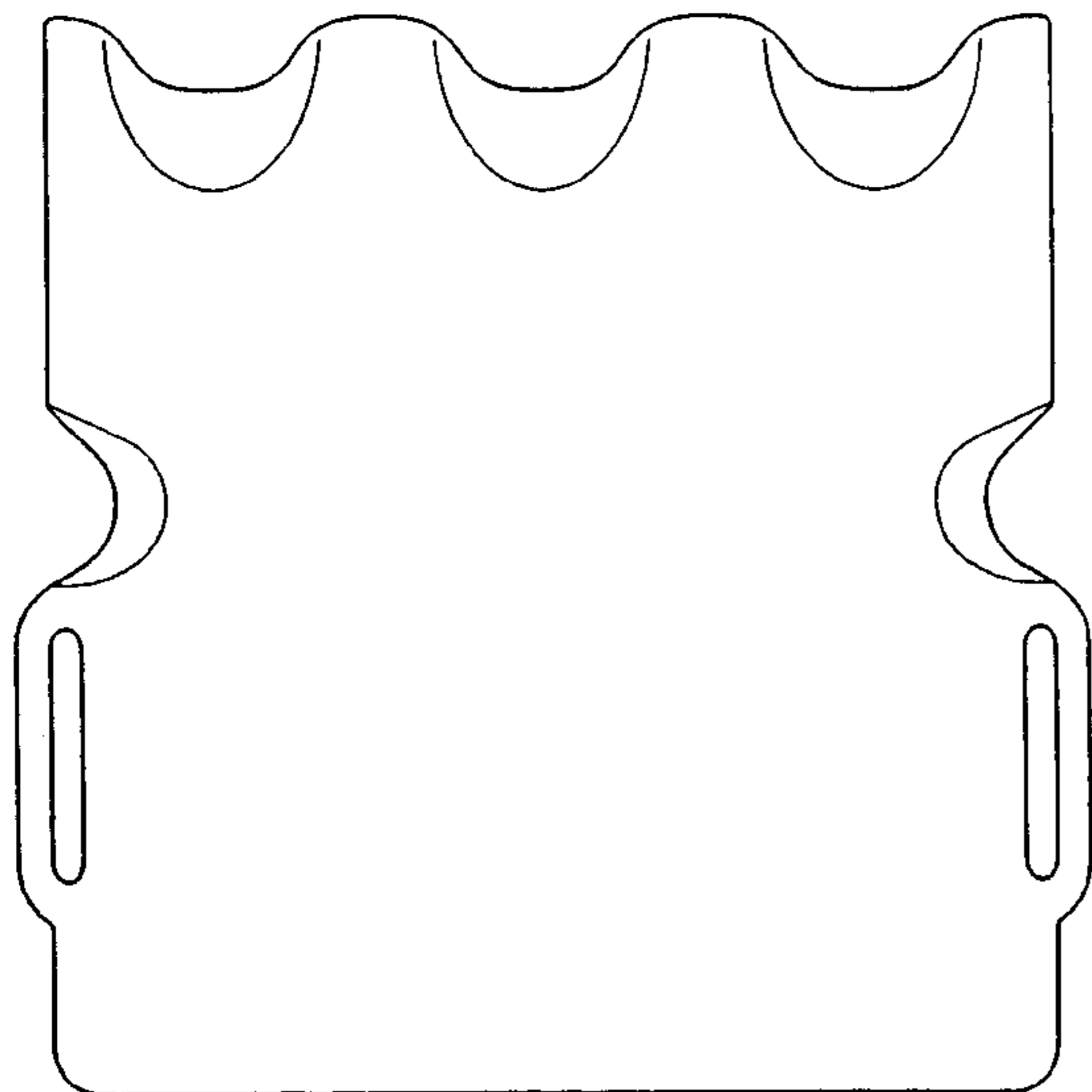
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a polishing pad holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the polishing pad holder according to our design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the holder according to FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the holder according to FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the holder according to FIG. 2; and,
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the holder according to FIG. 2.

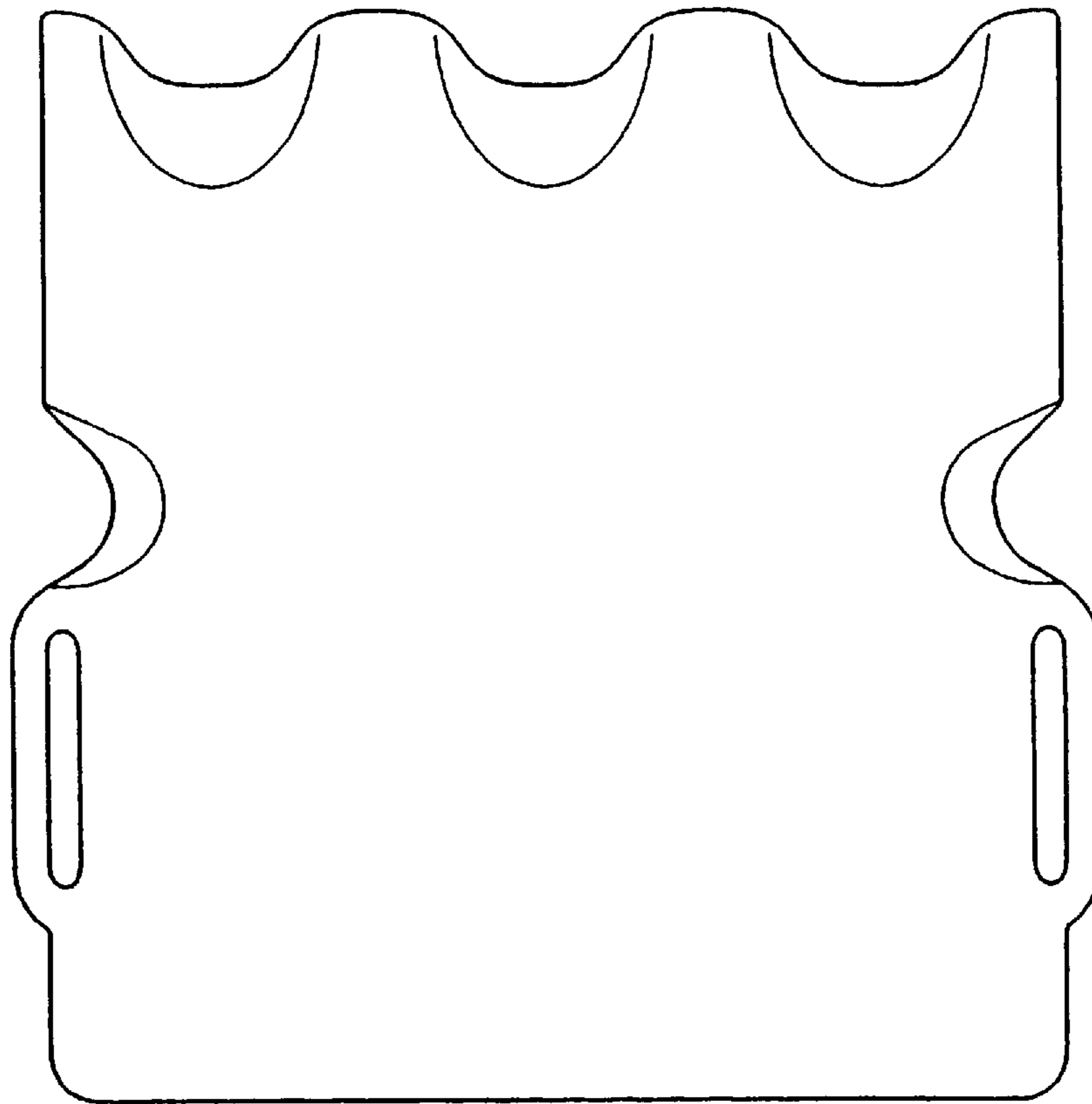

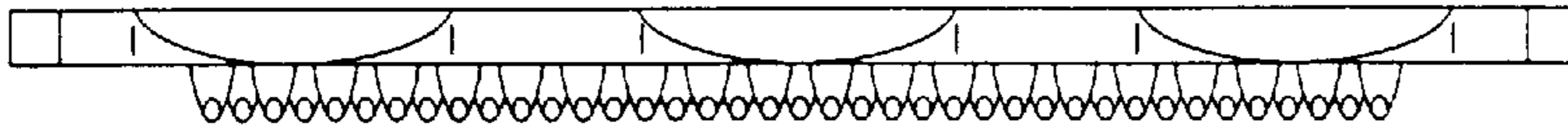

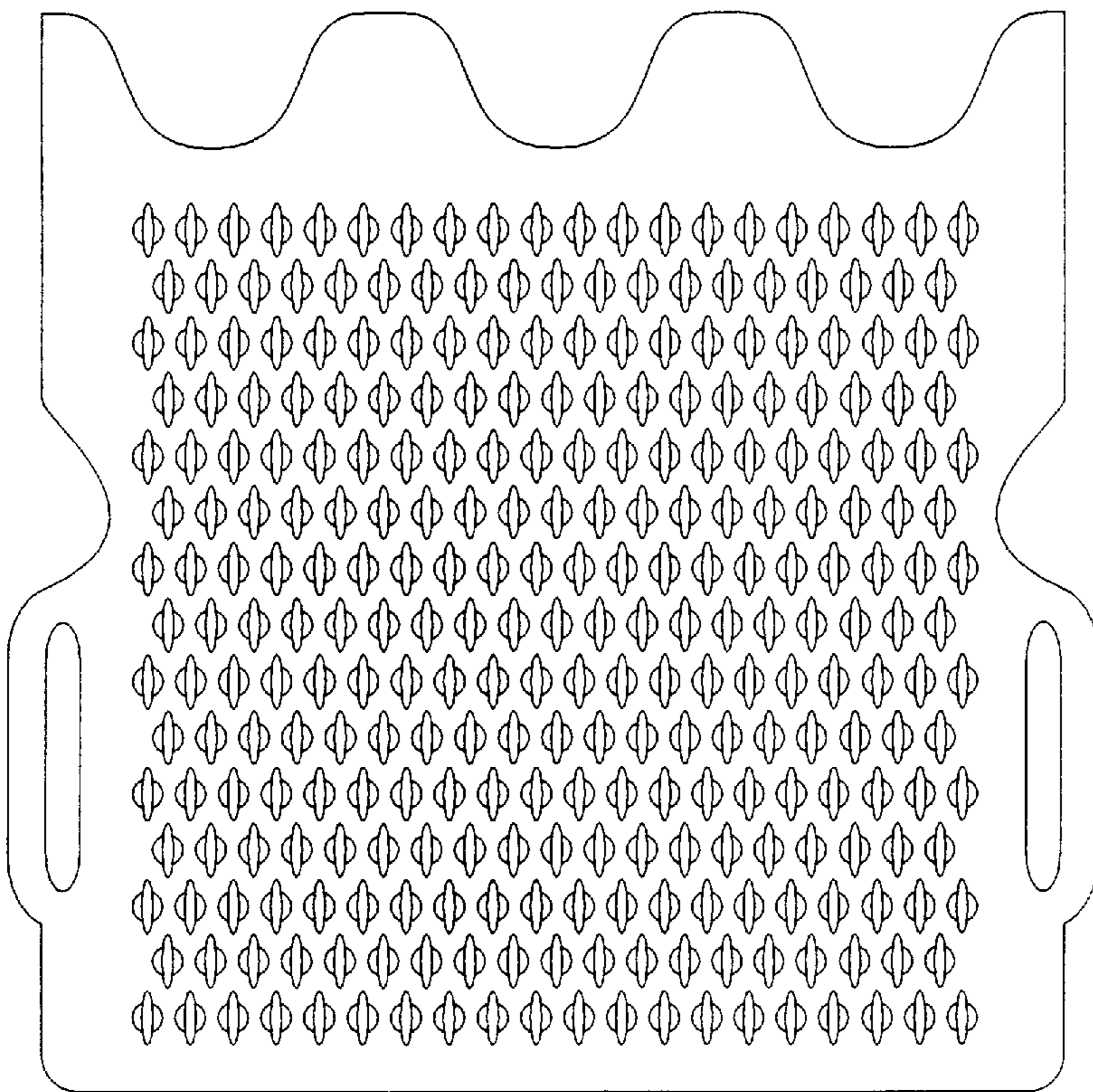

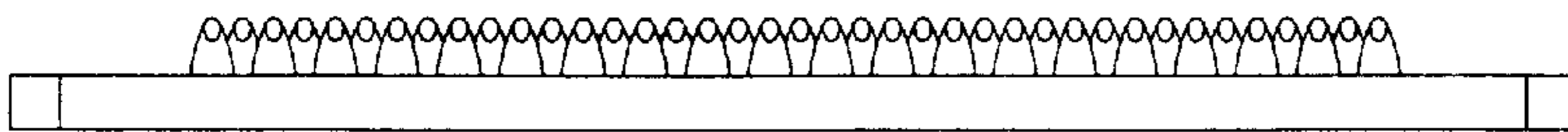
