DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the office chair of the invention;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the office chair shown in FIG. 1;

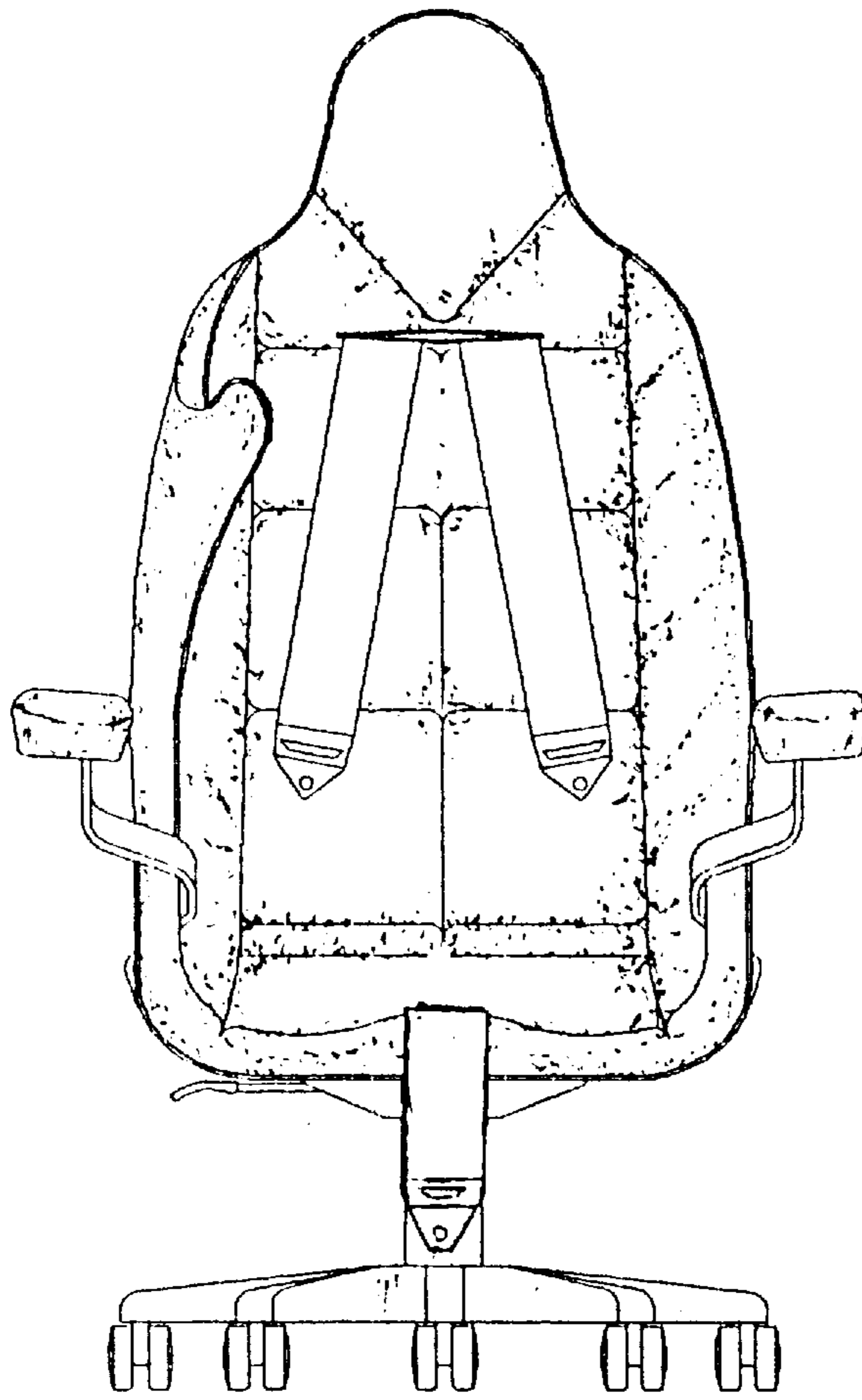

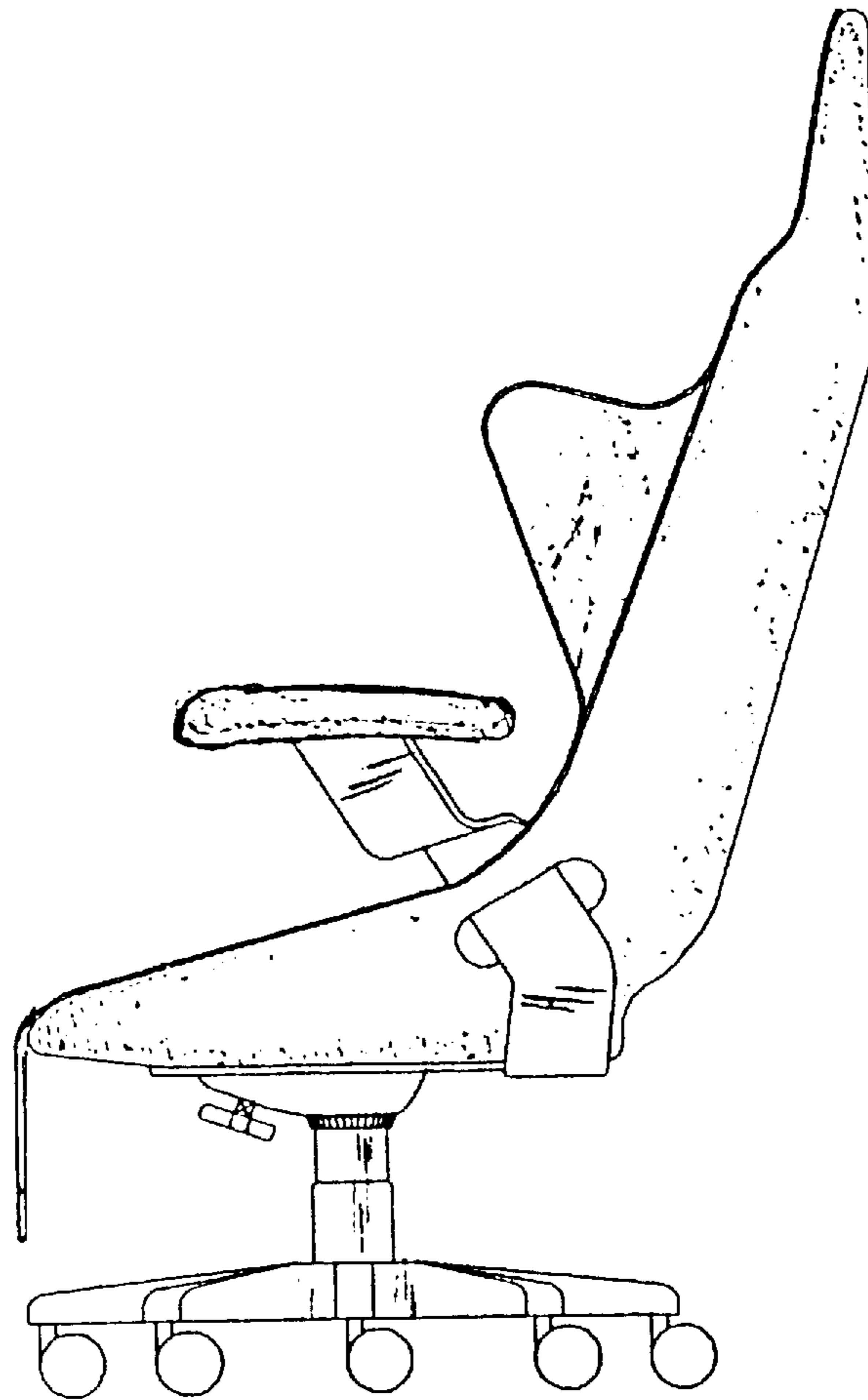

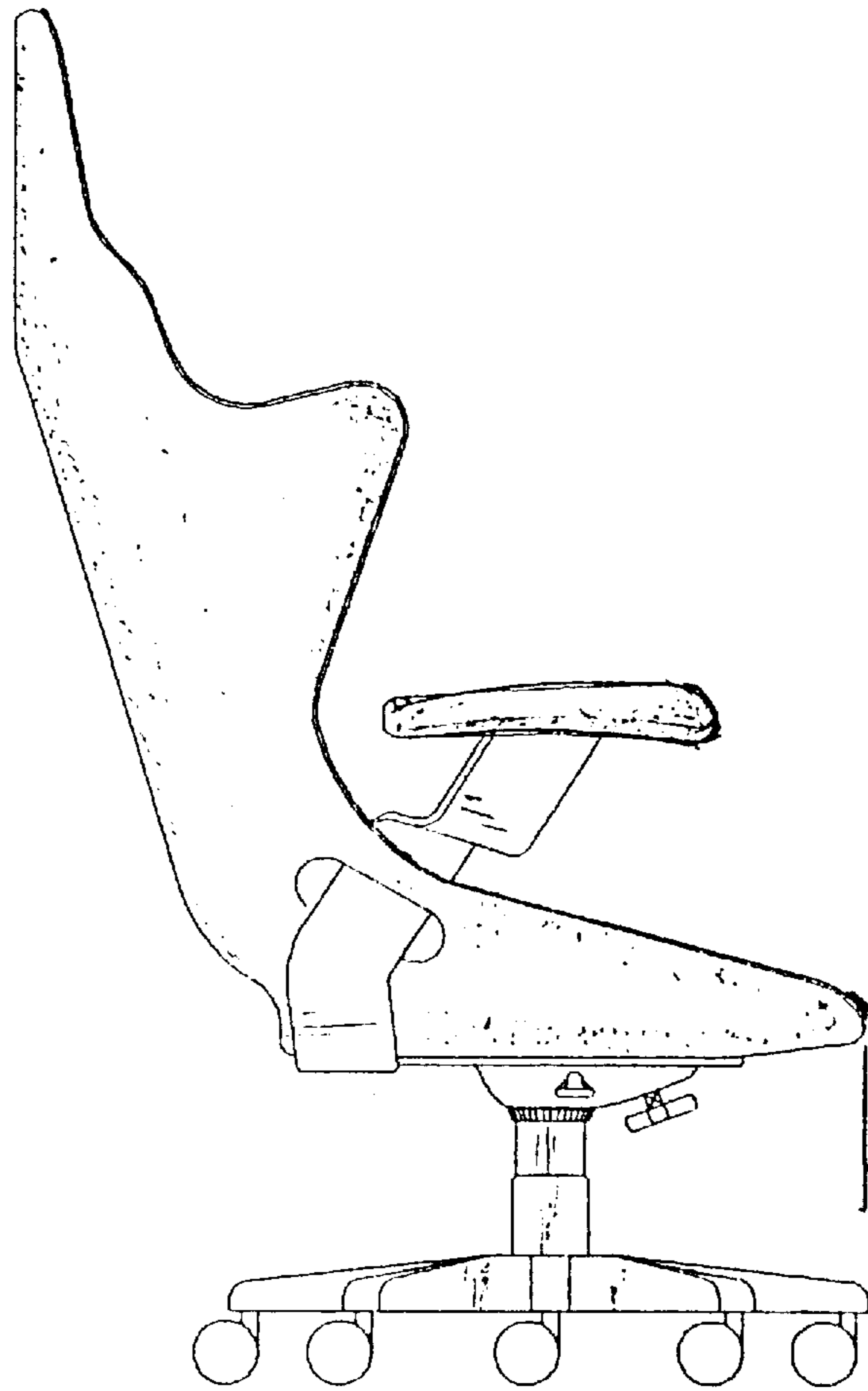

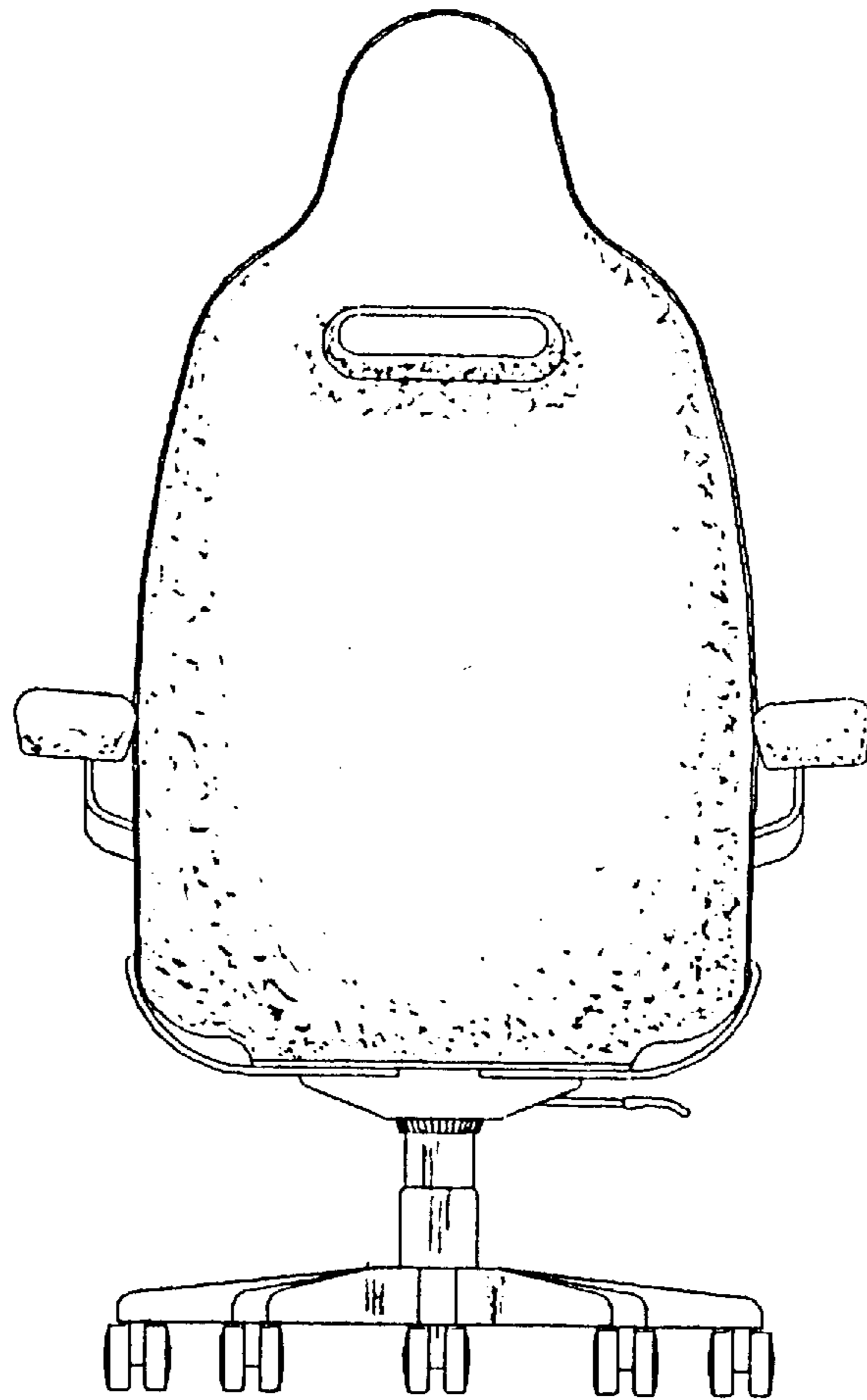

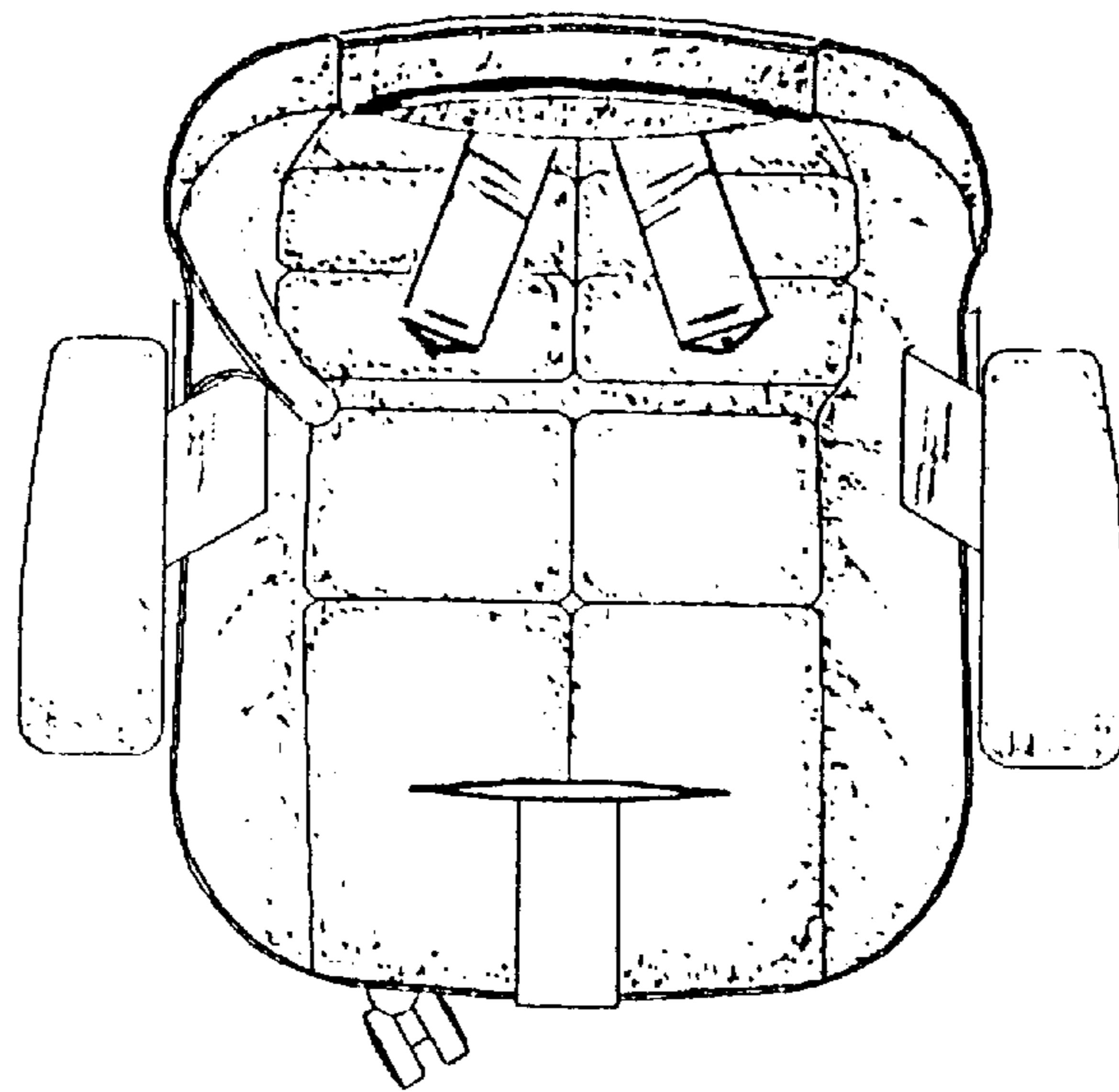
