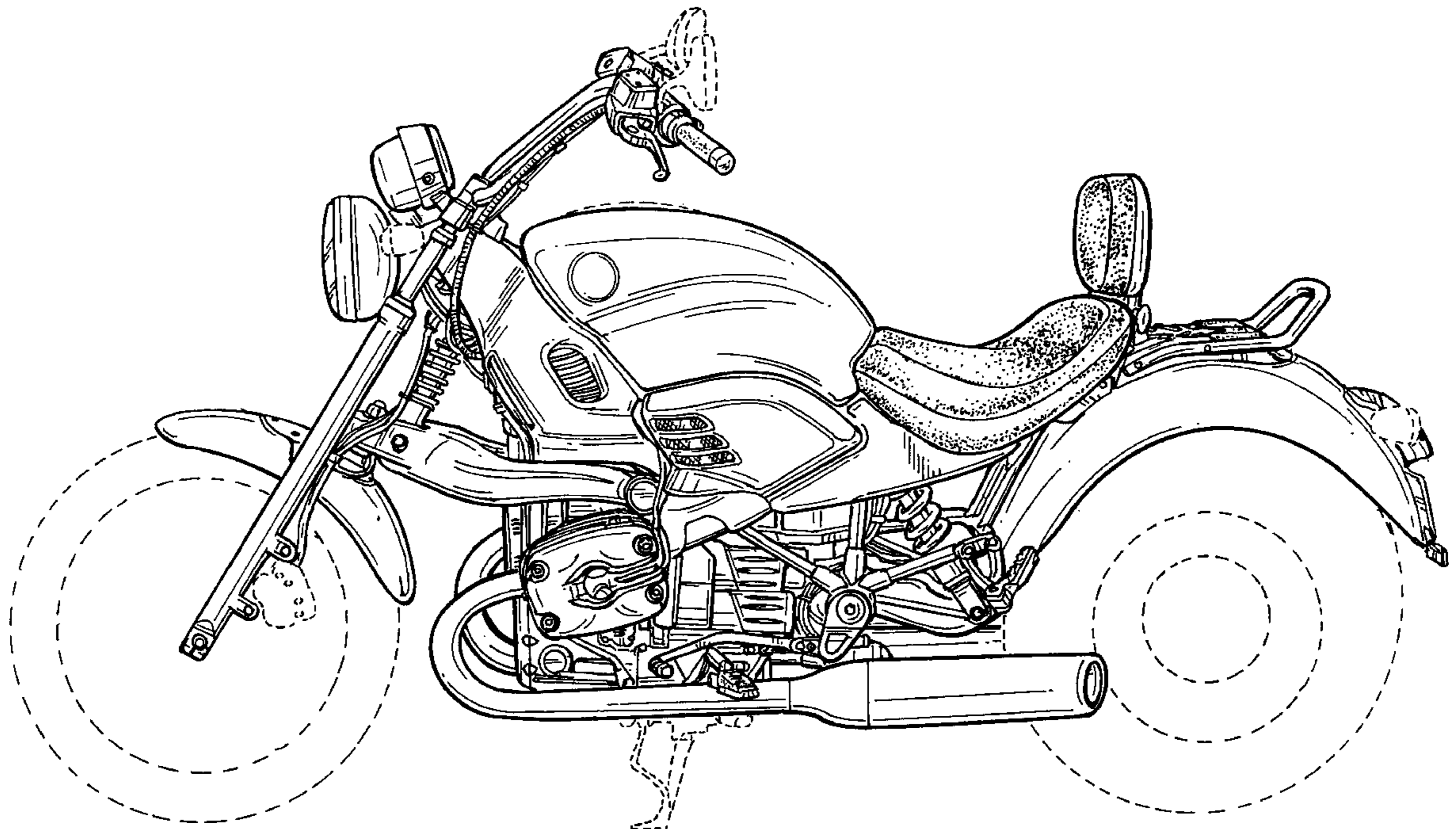
FIG. 11 is a right side view of the motorcycle body with the backrest shown in downright position according to our novel design.

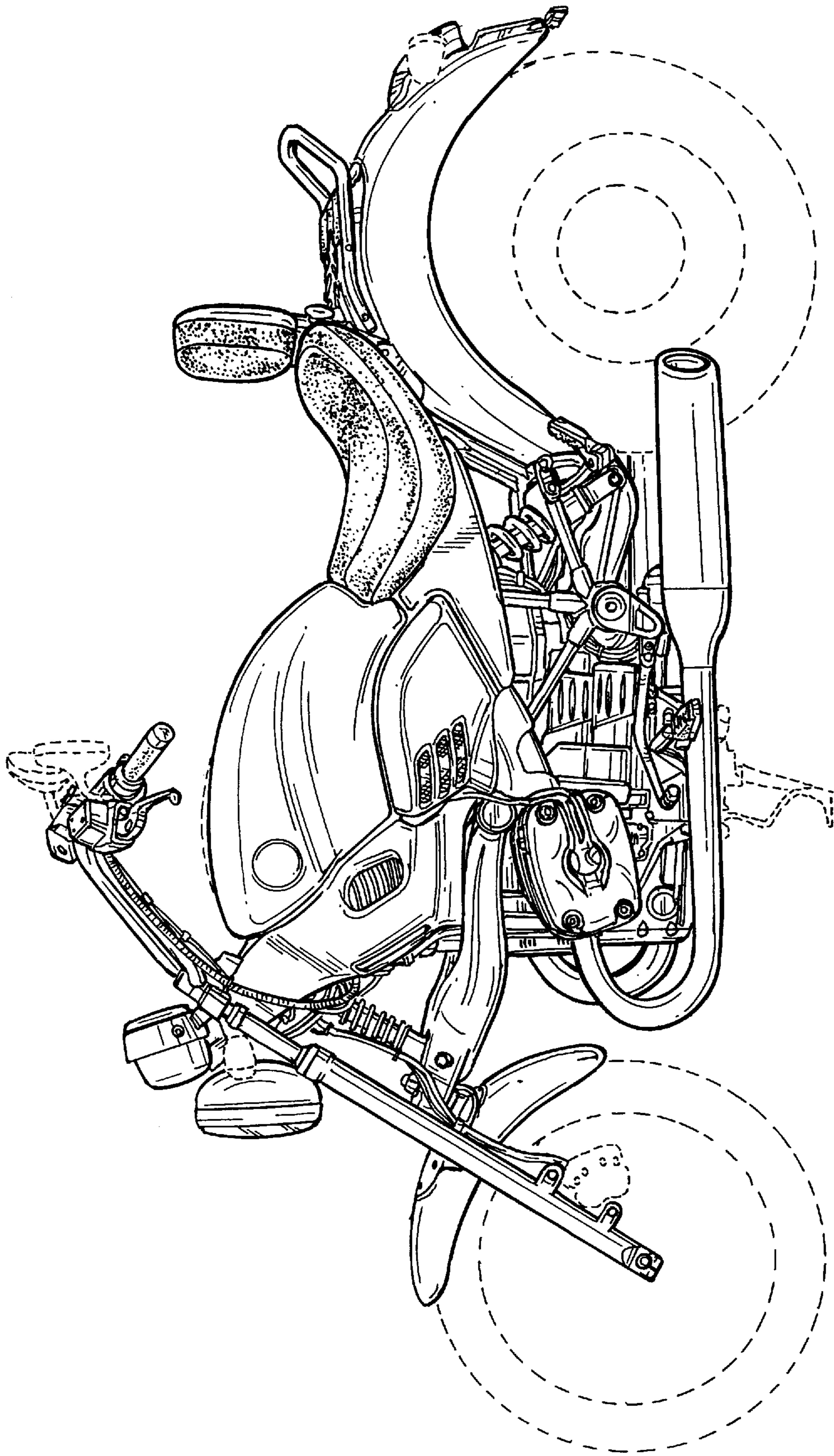

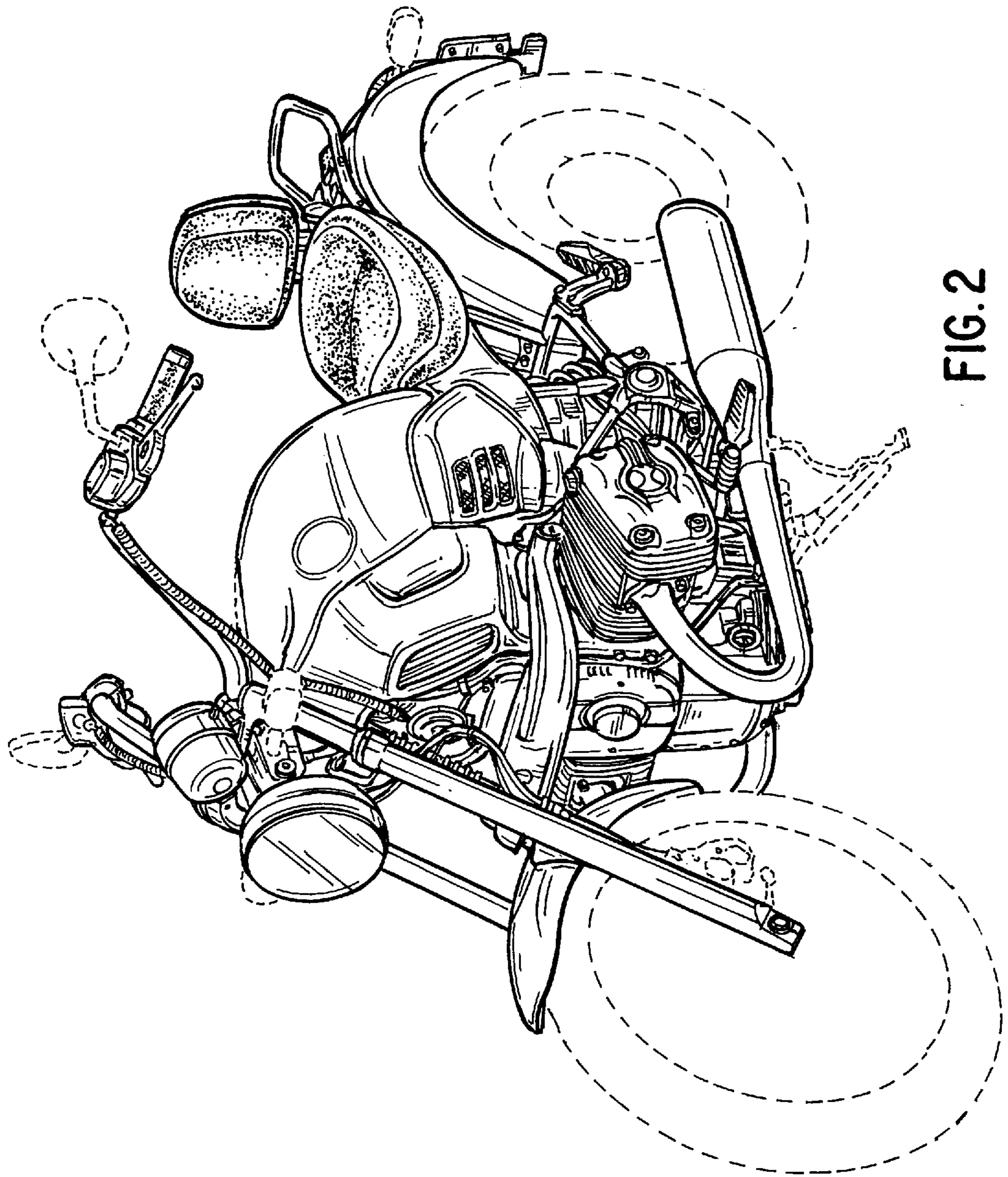

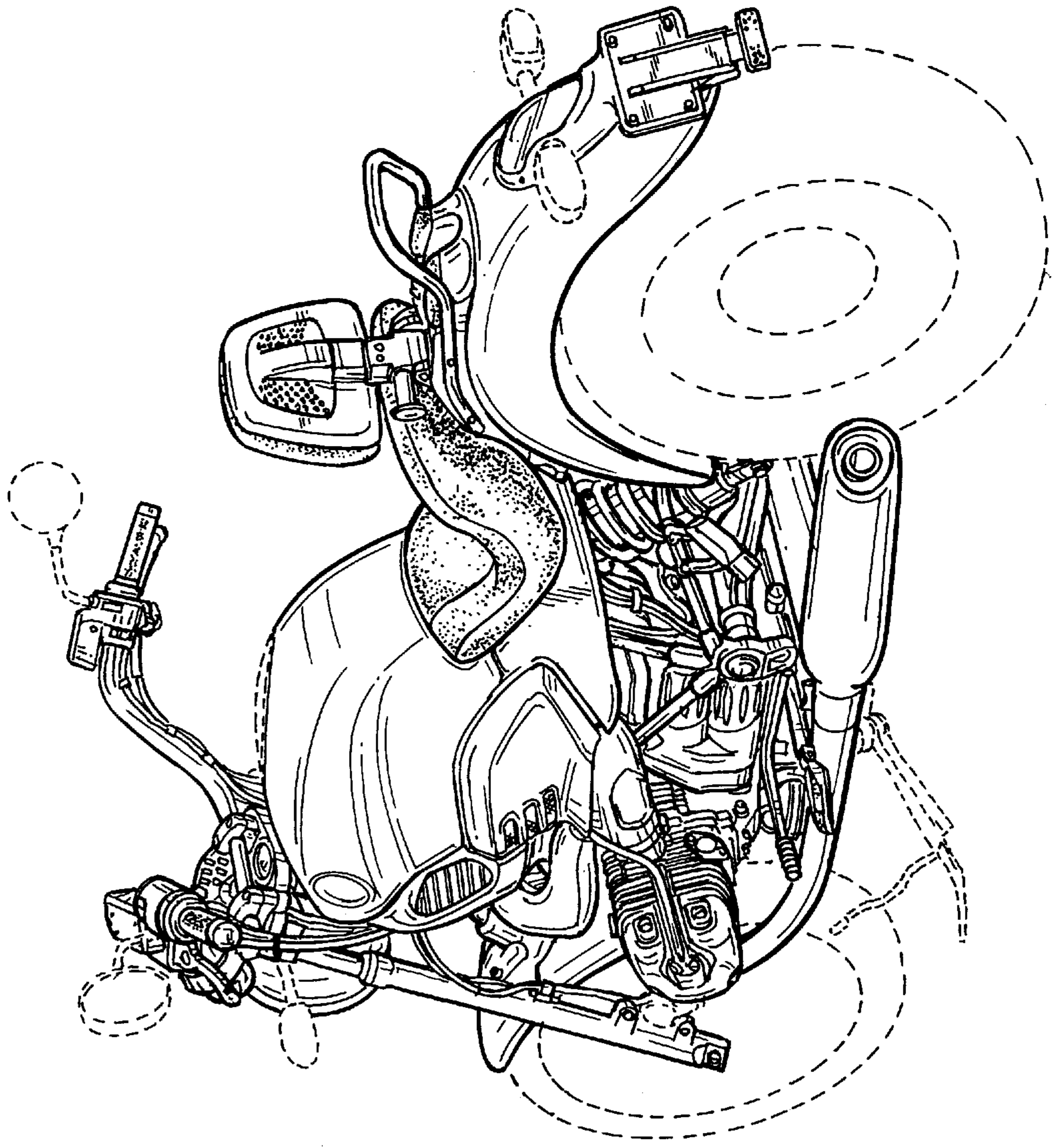

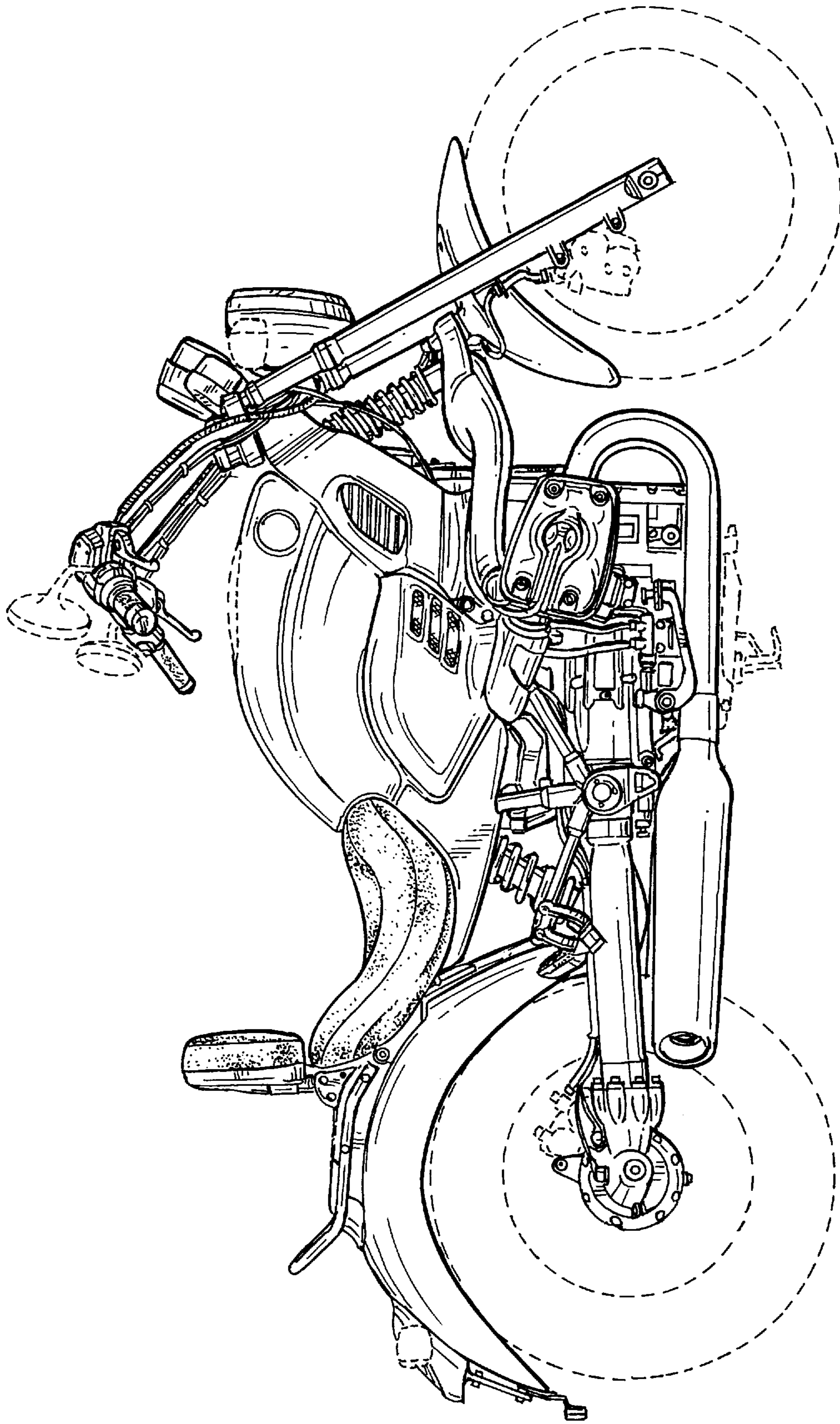

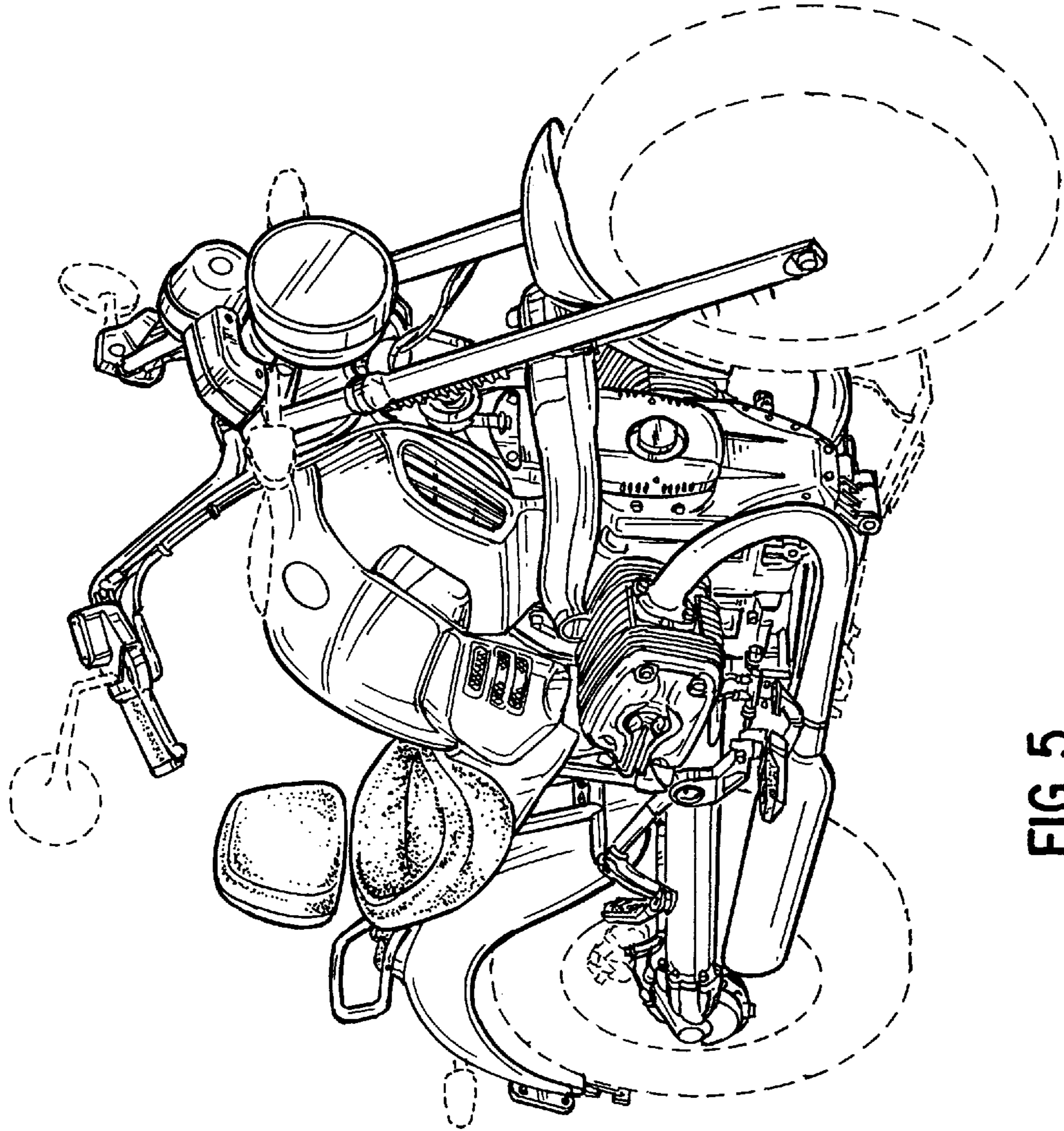

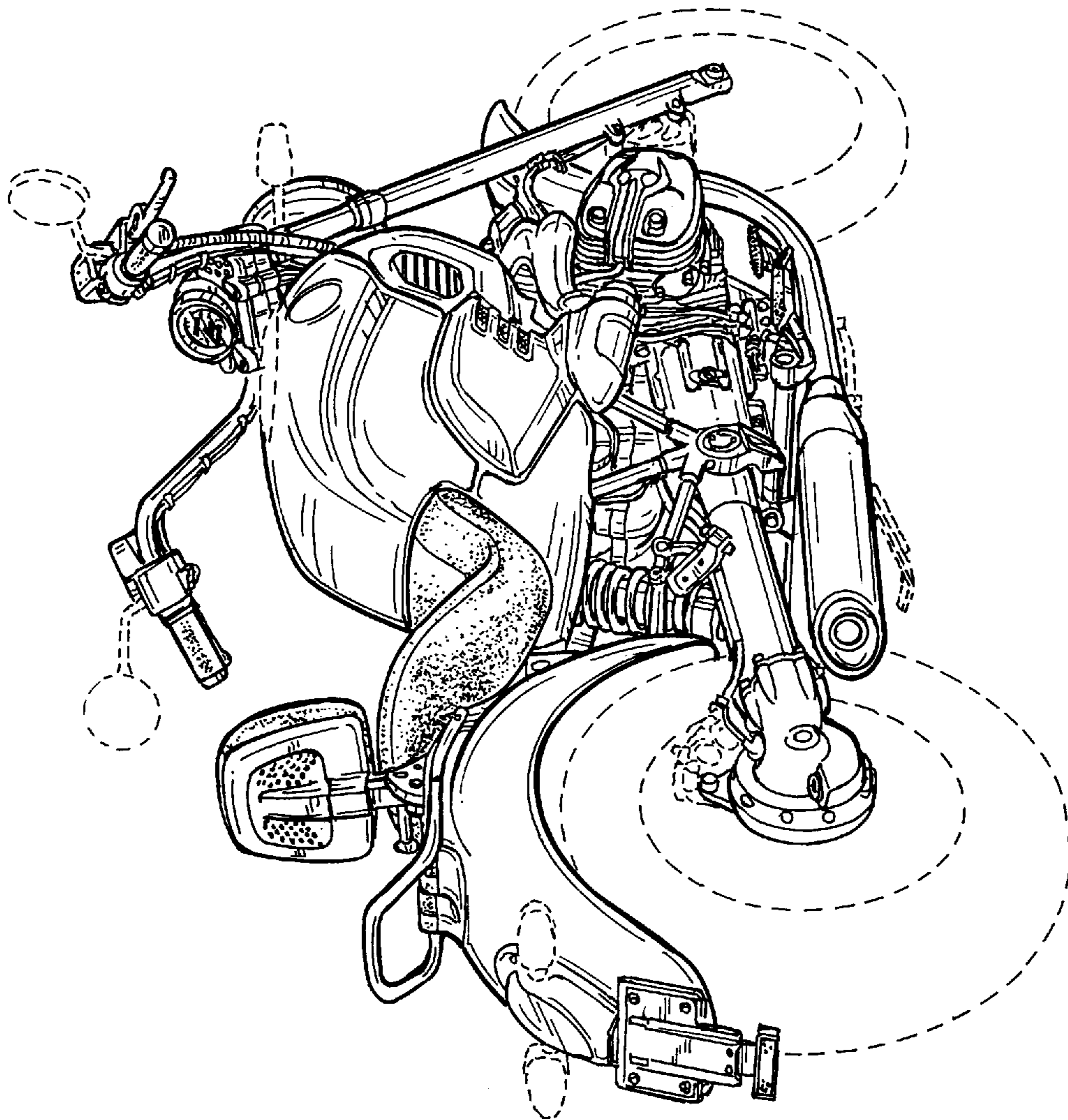

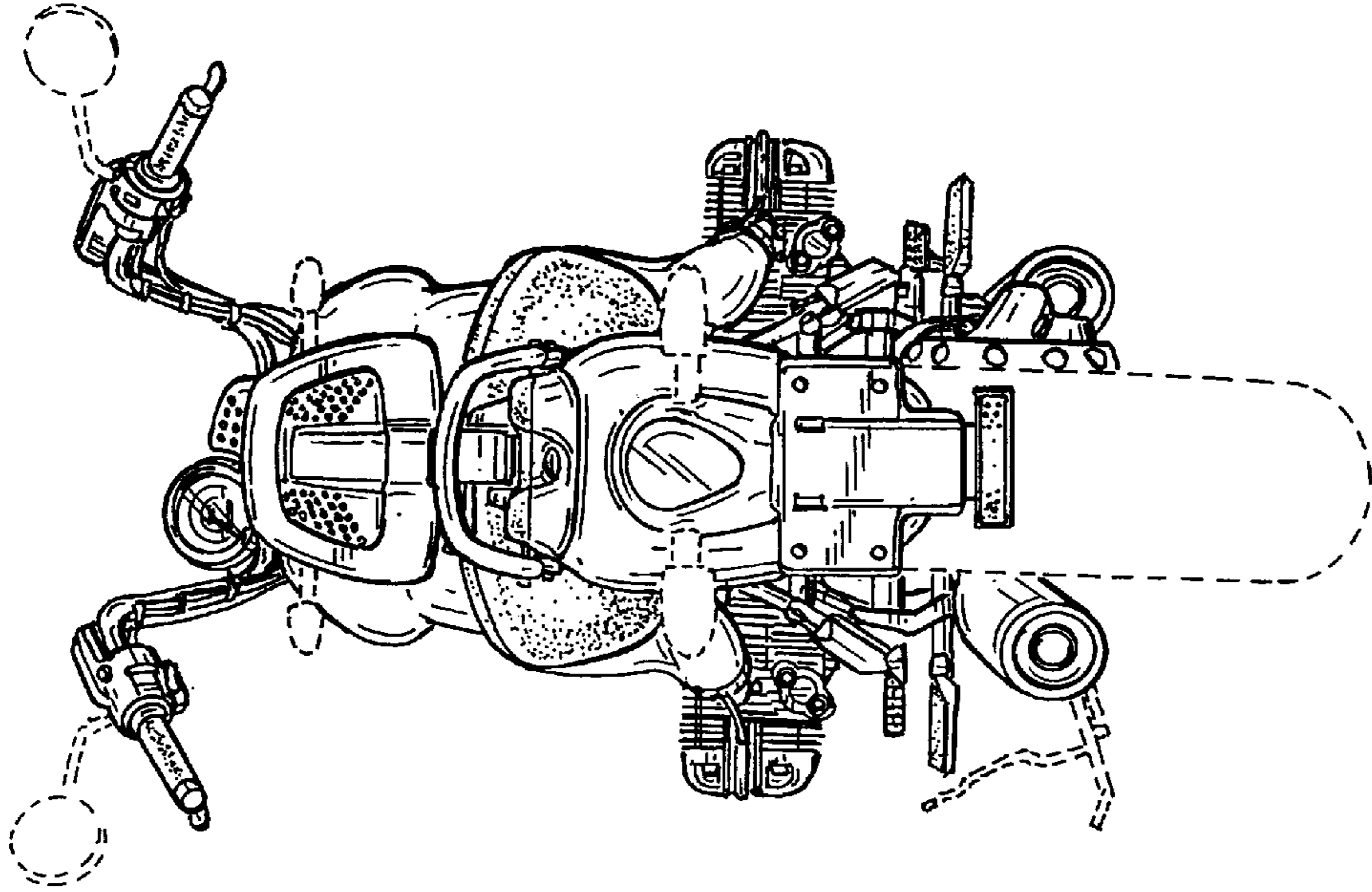

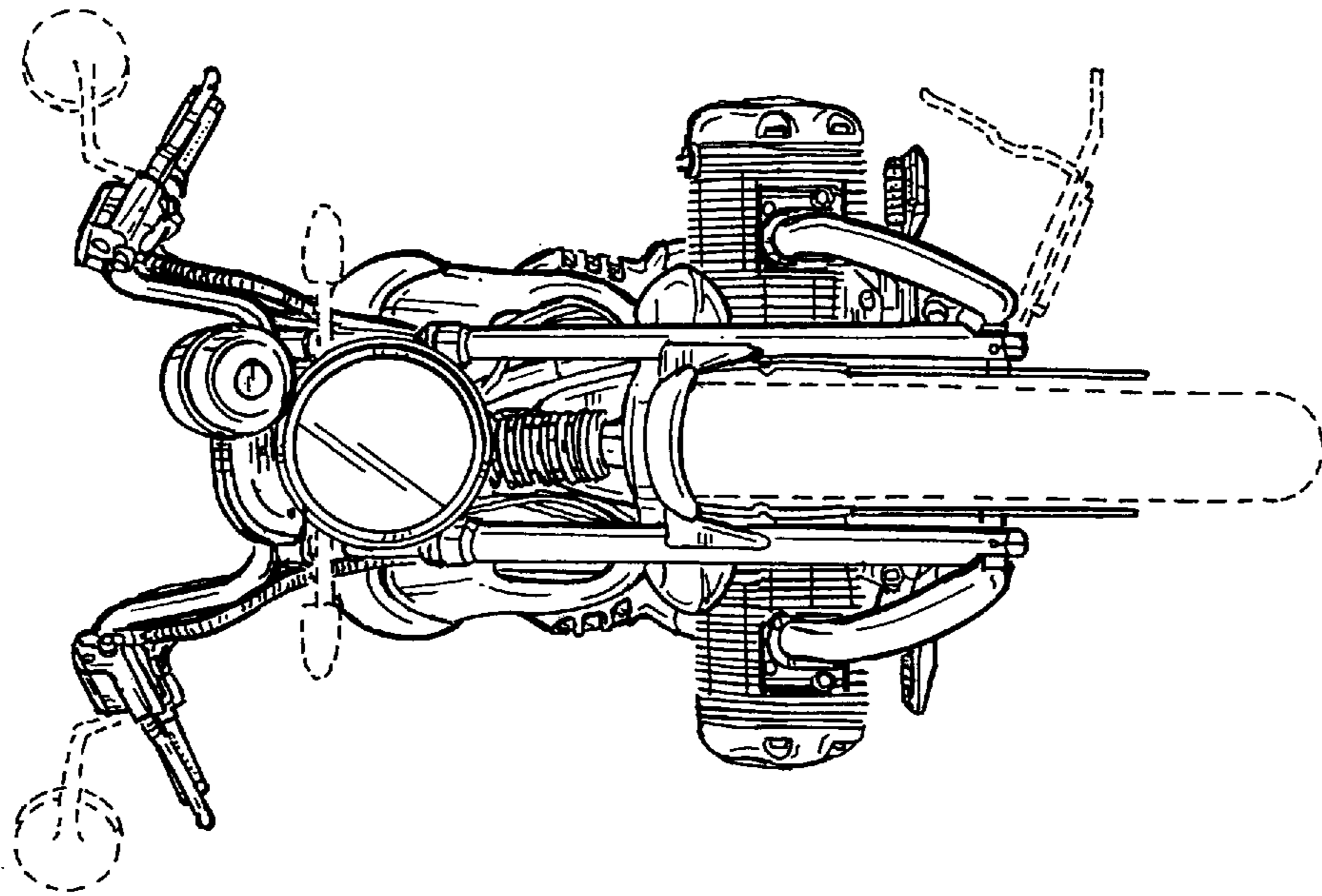

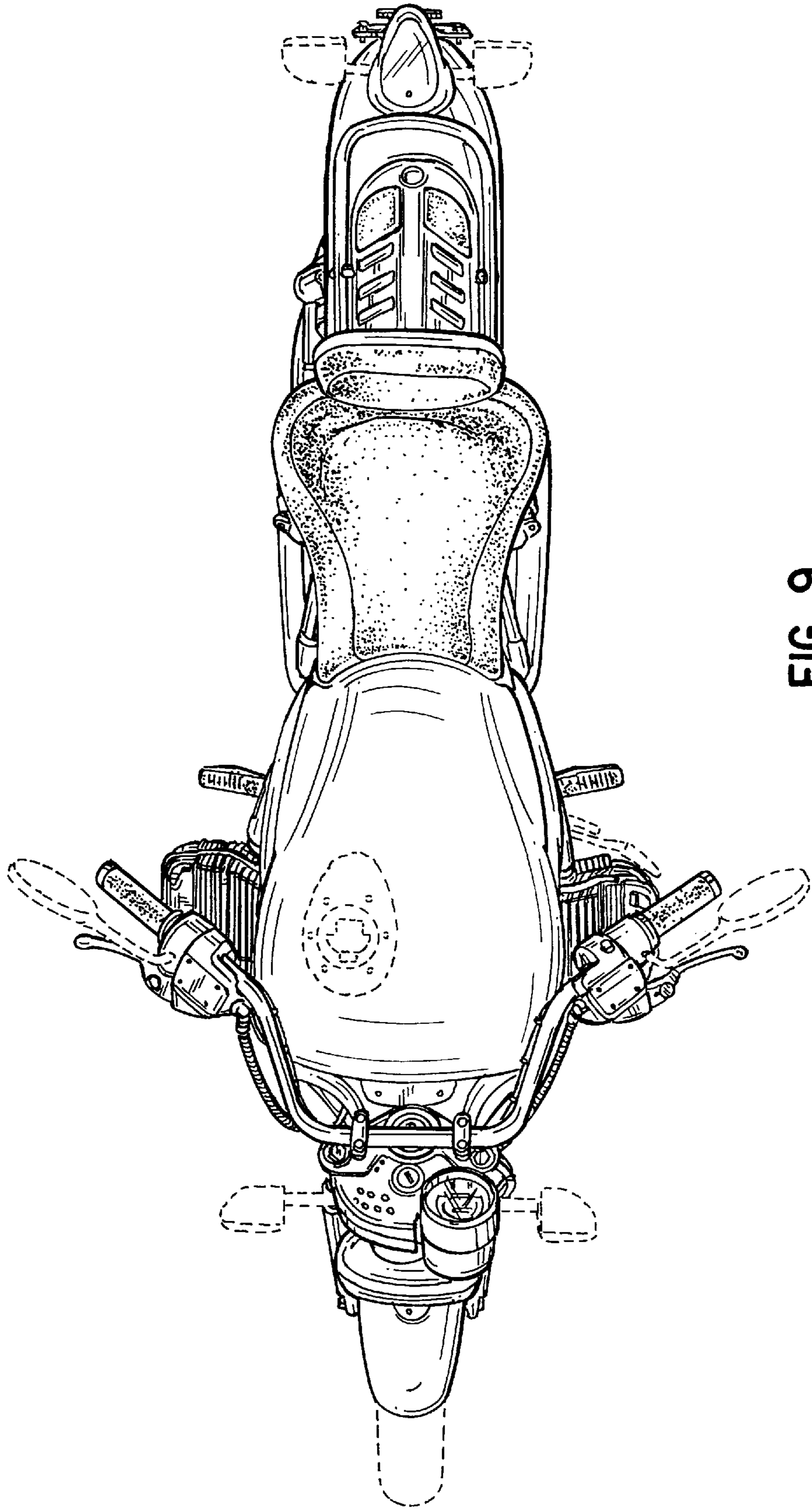

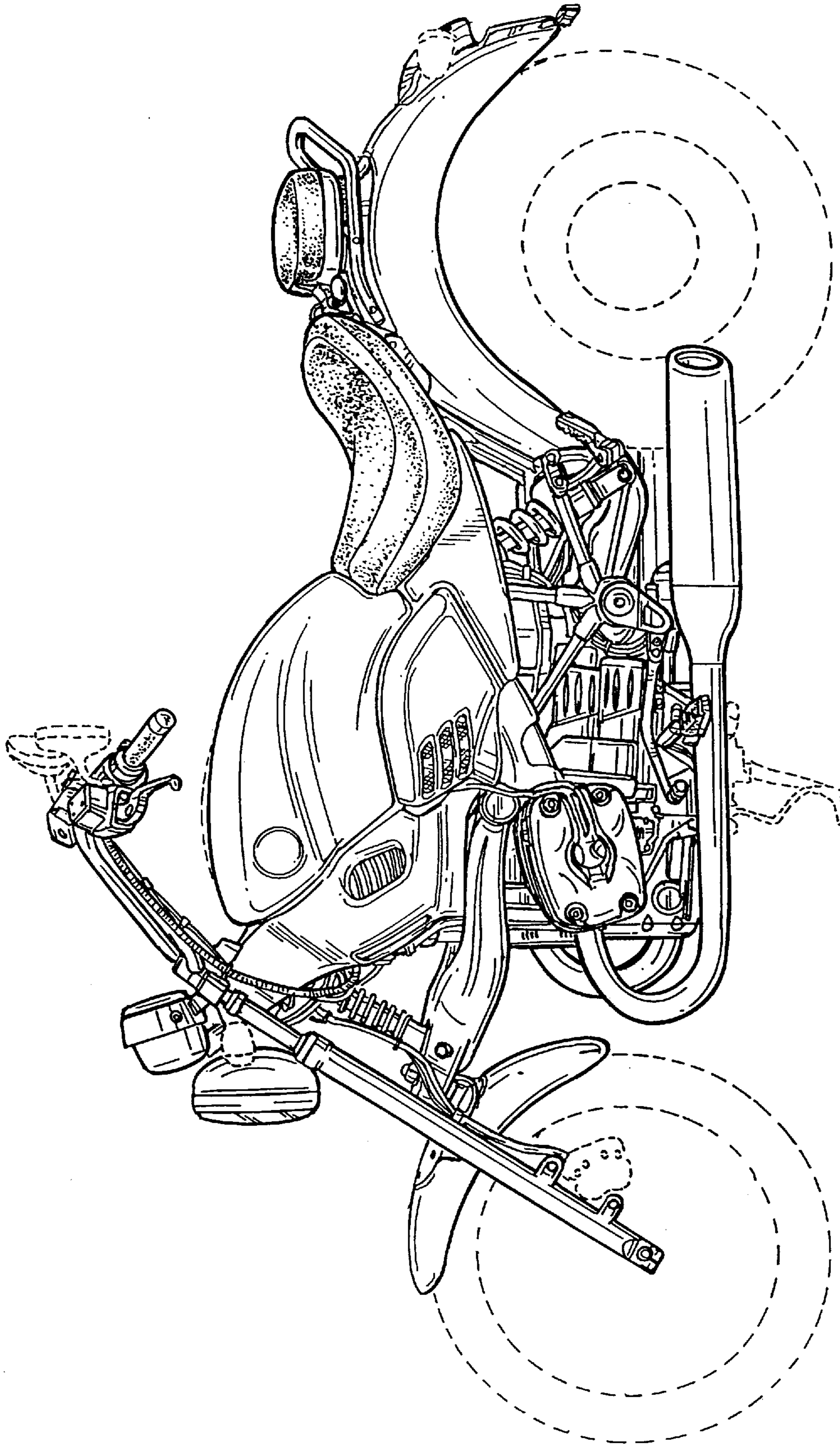

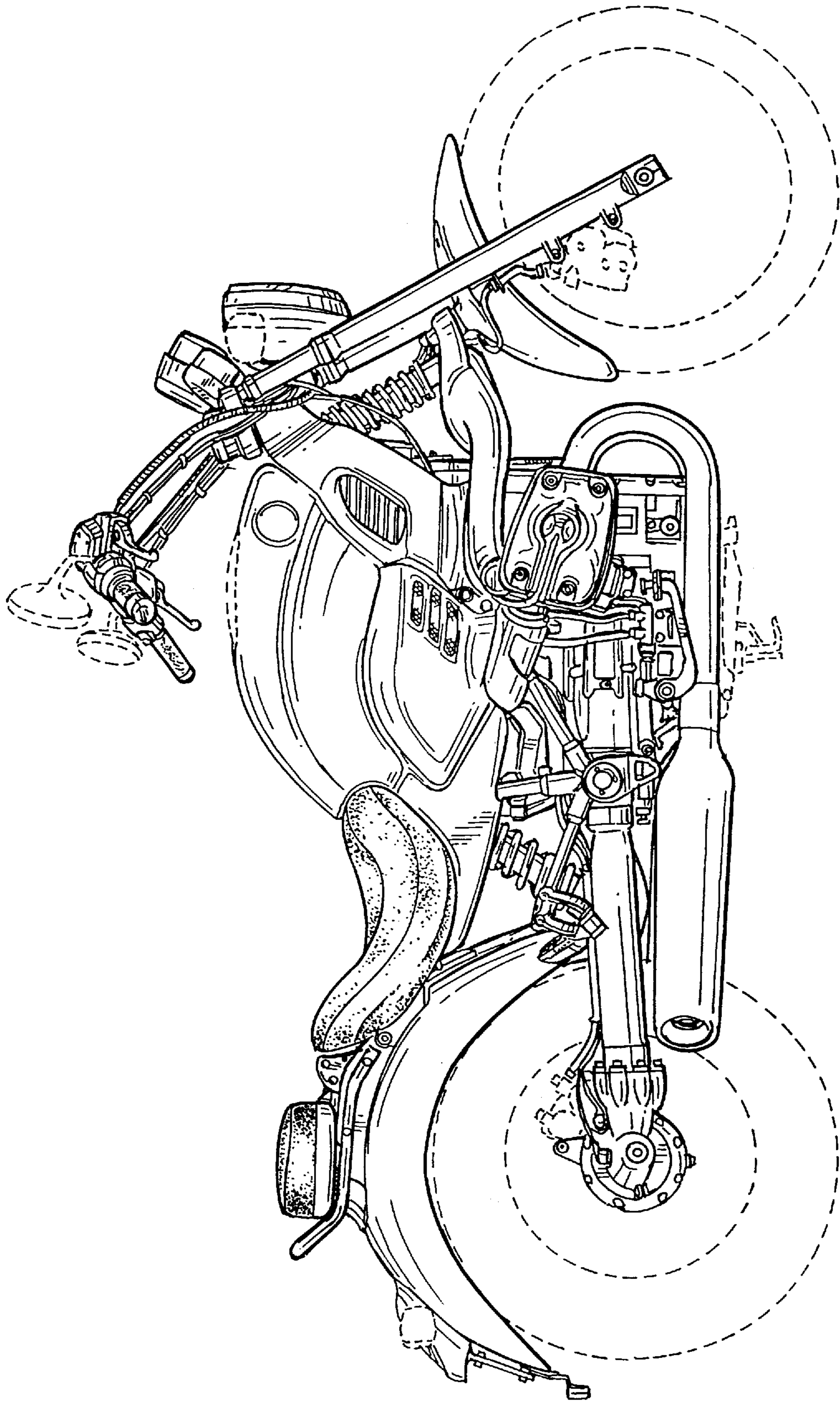
