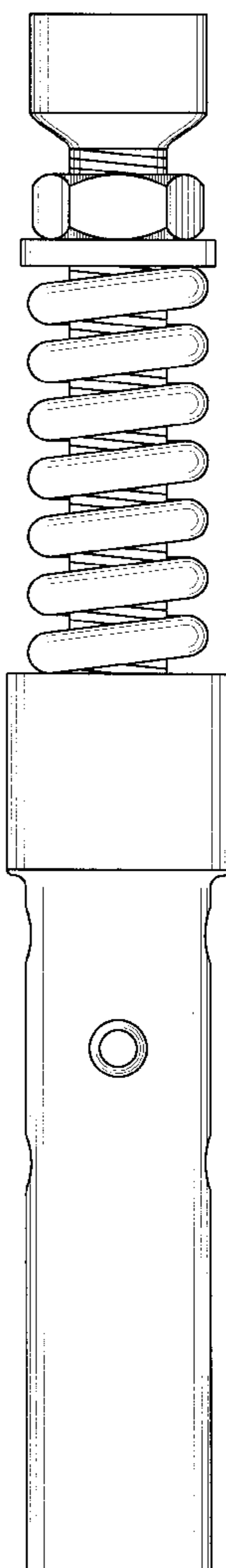

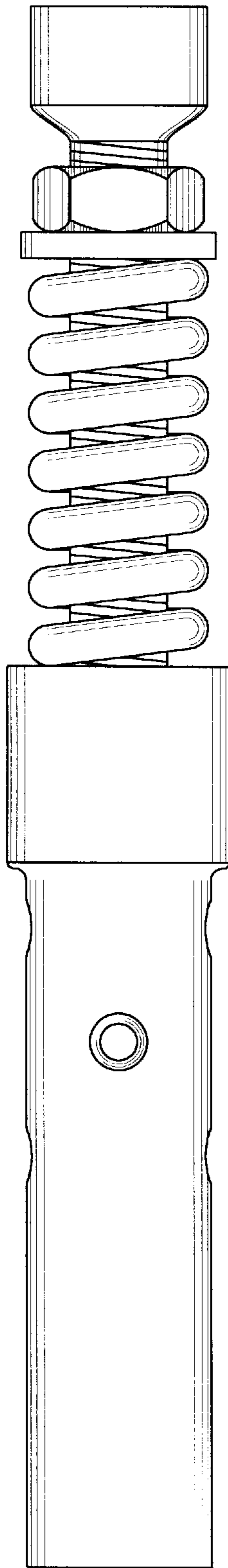

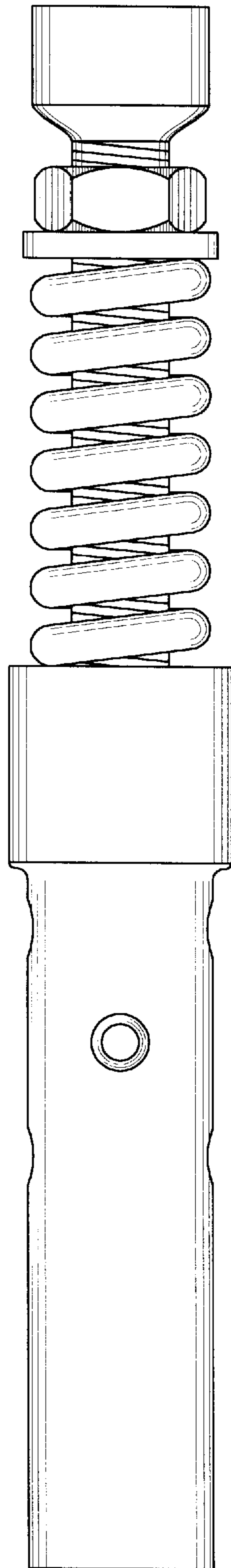
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the shock absorbing seat post of FIG. 1.

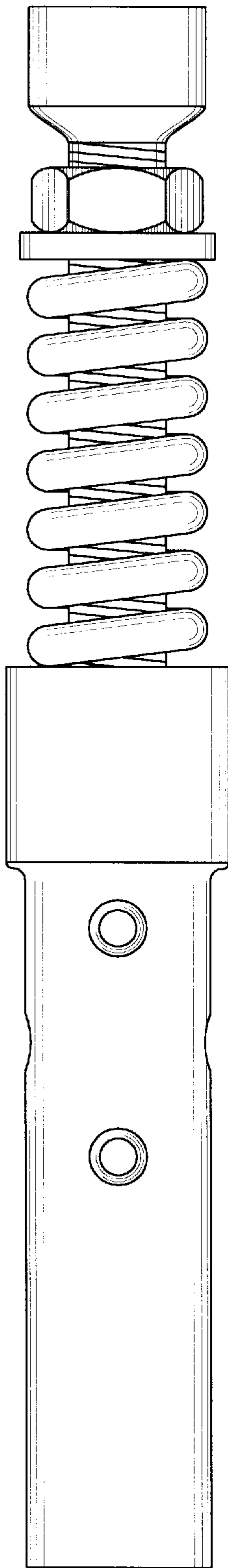




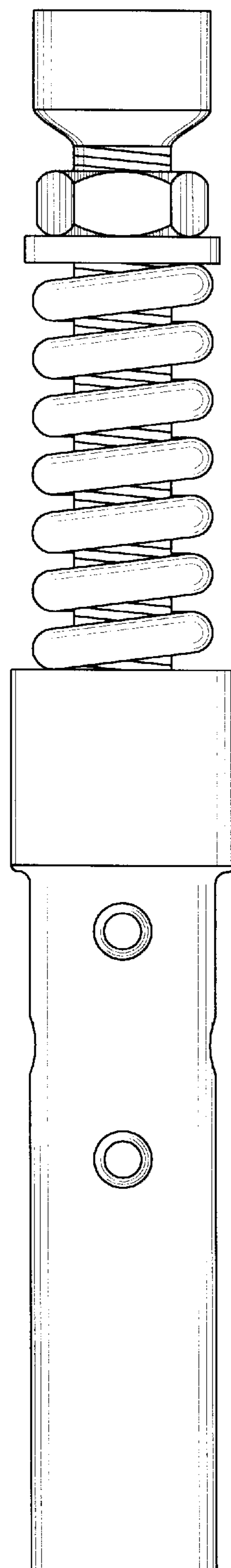

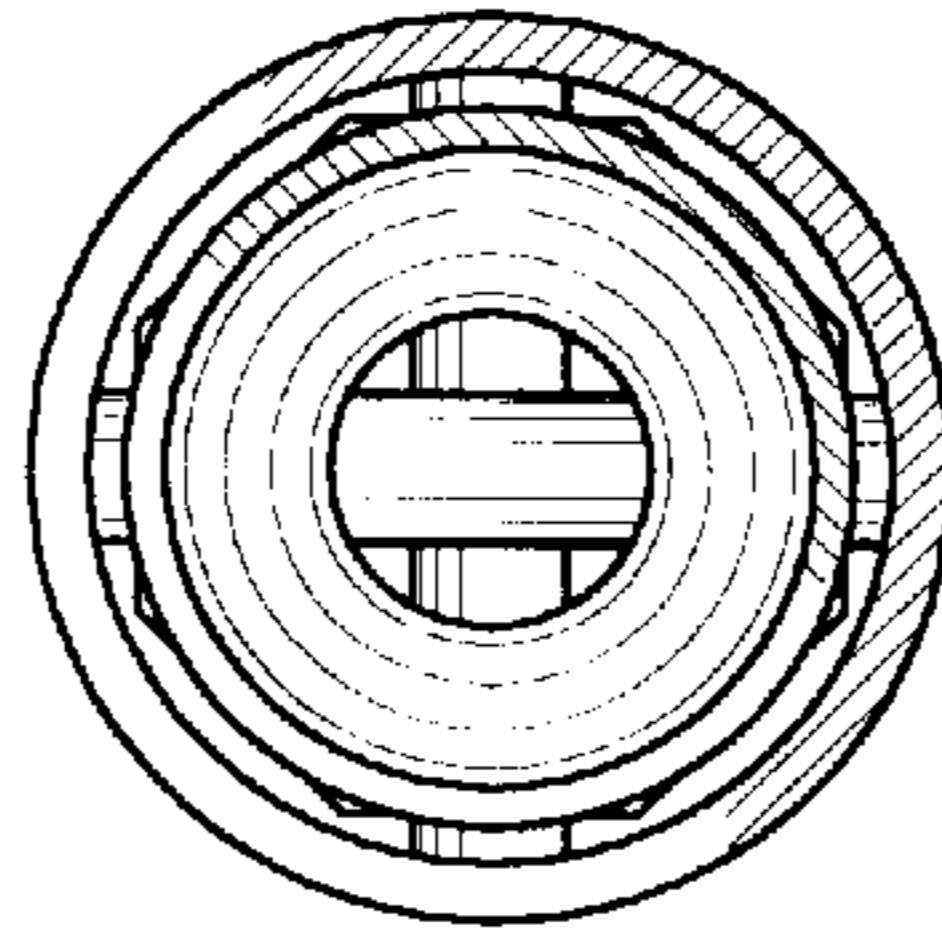

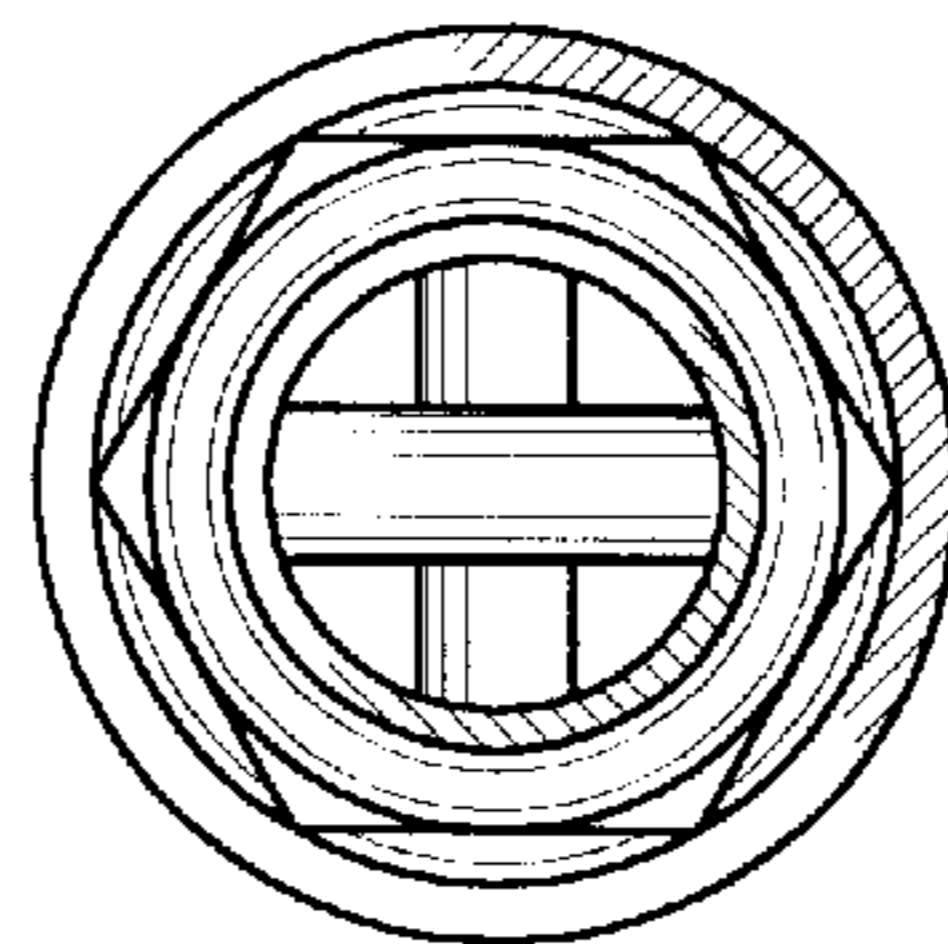
