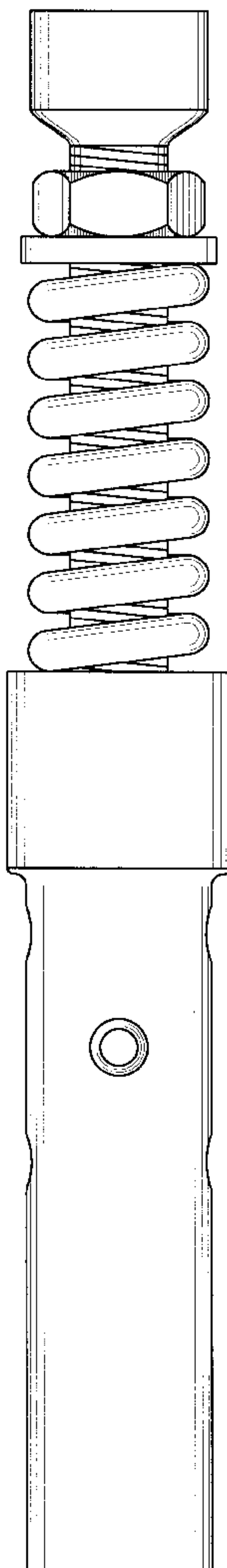

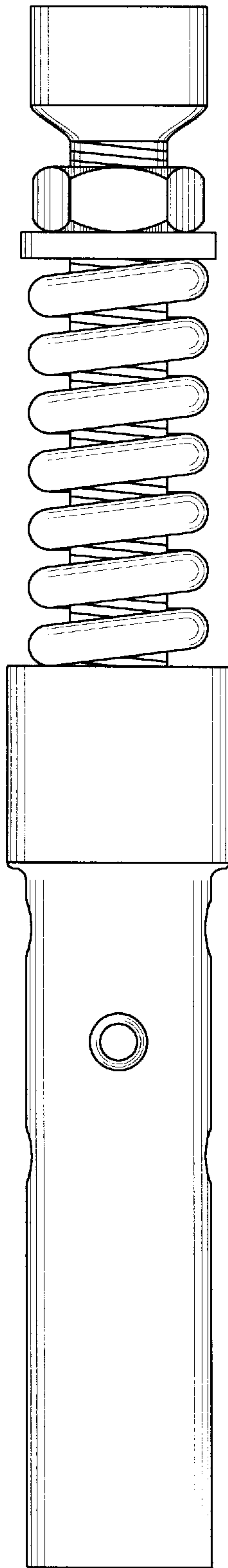

FIG. 5 is a top view of the shock absorbing seat post of FIG. 1; and,

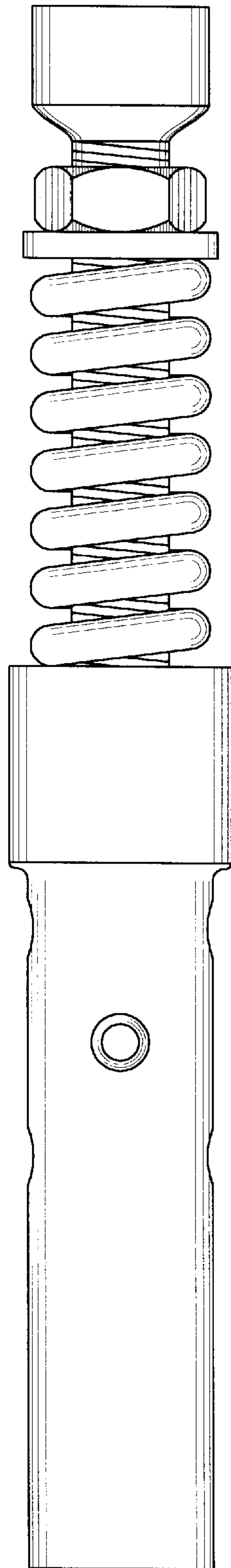
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the shock absorbing seat post of FIG. 1.

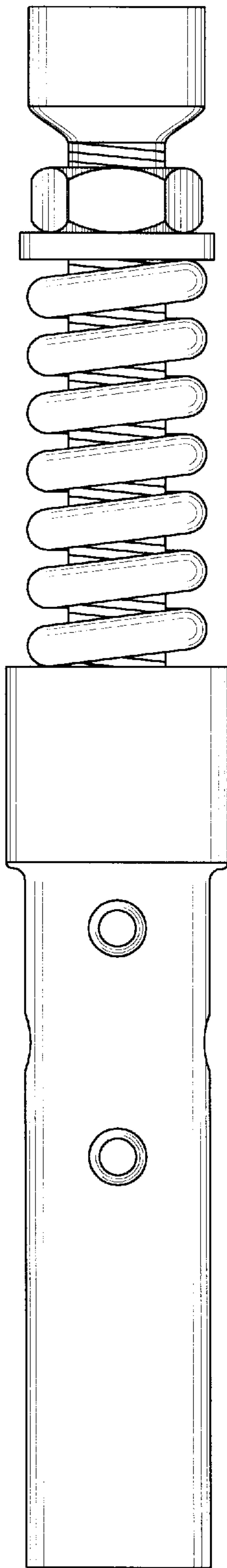




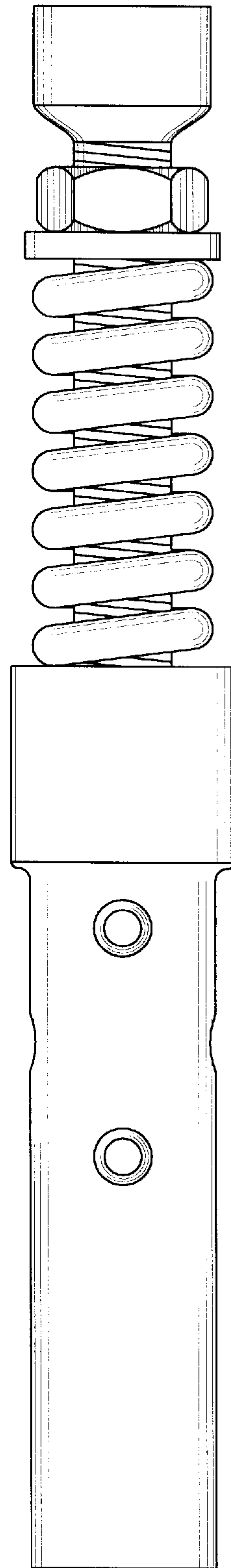

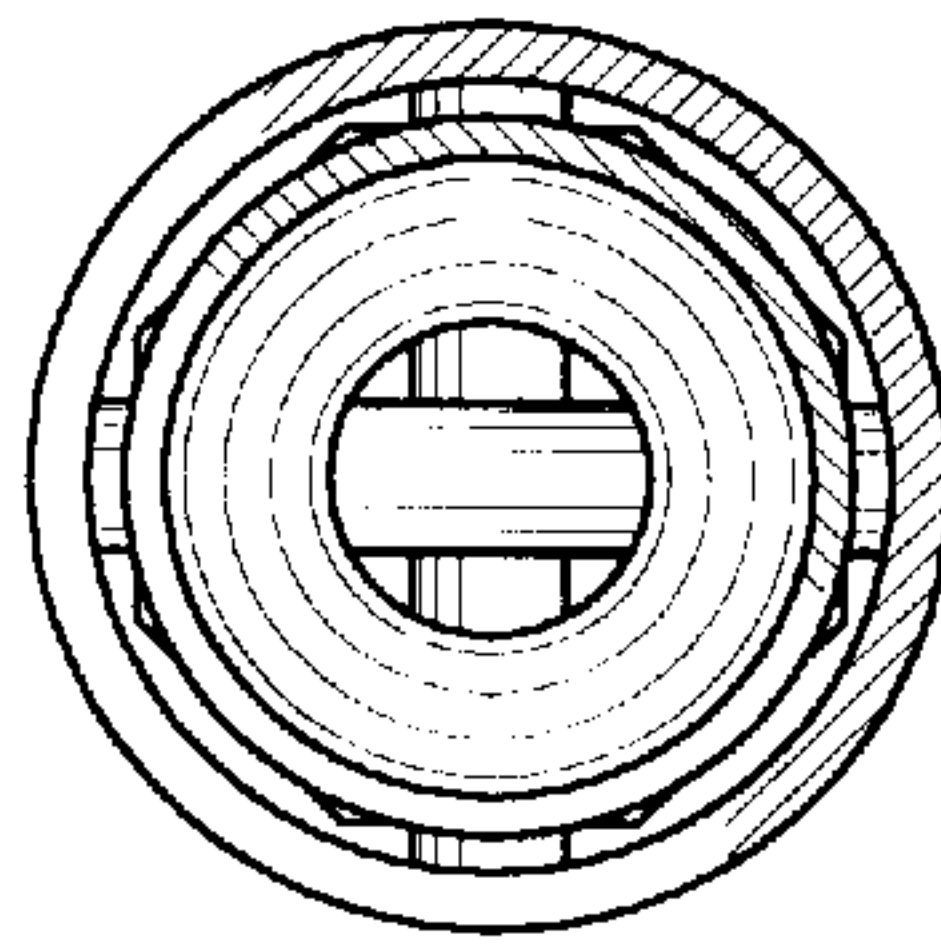

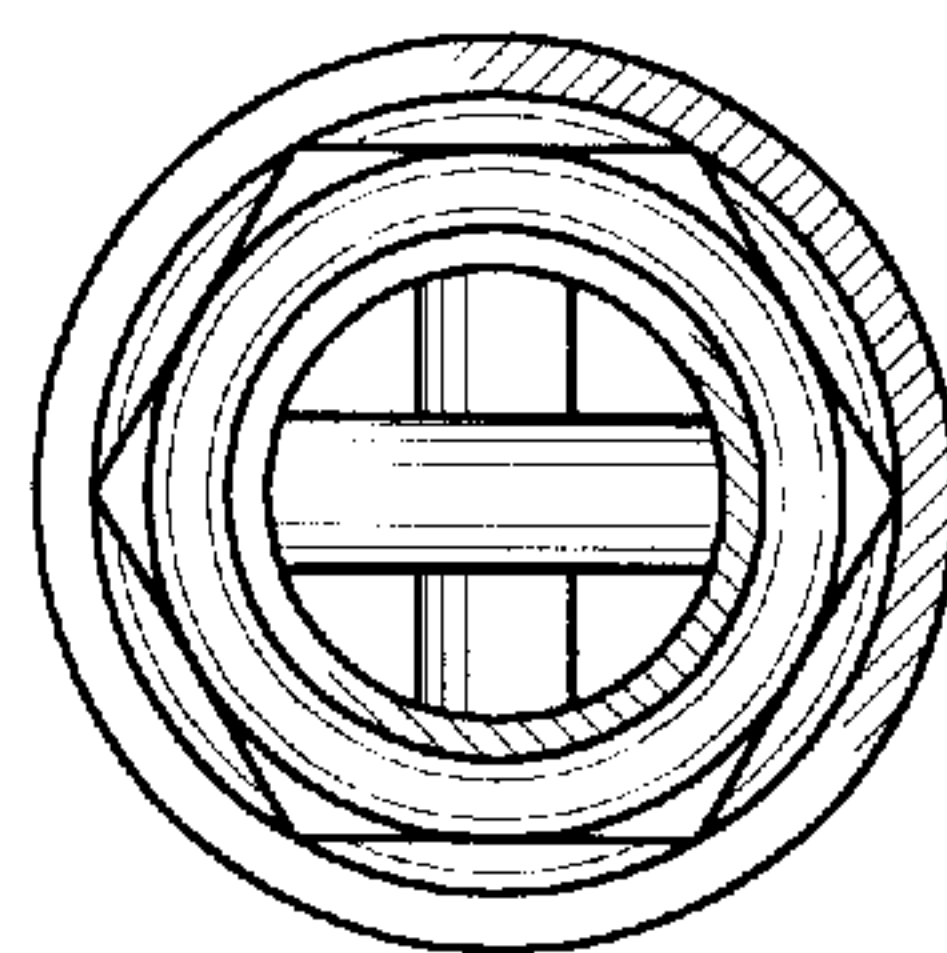
