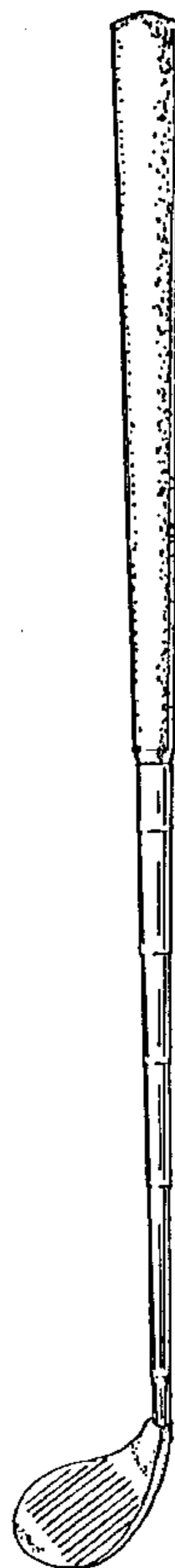
The broken line showing of the human figure and the ball in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms up part of the claimed design.

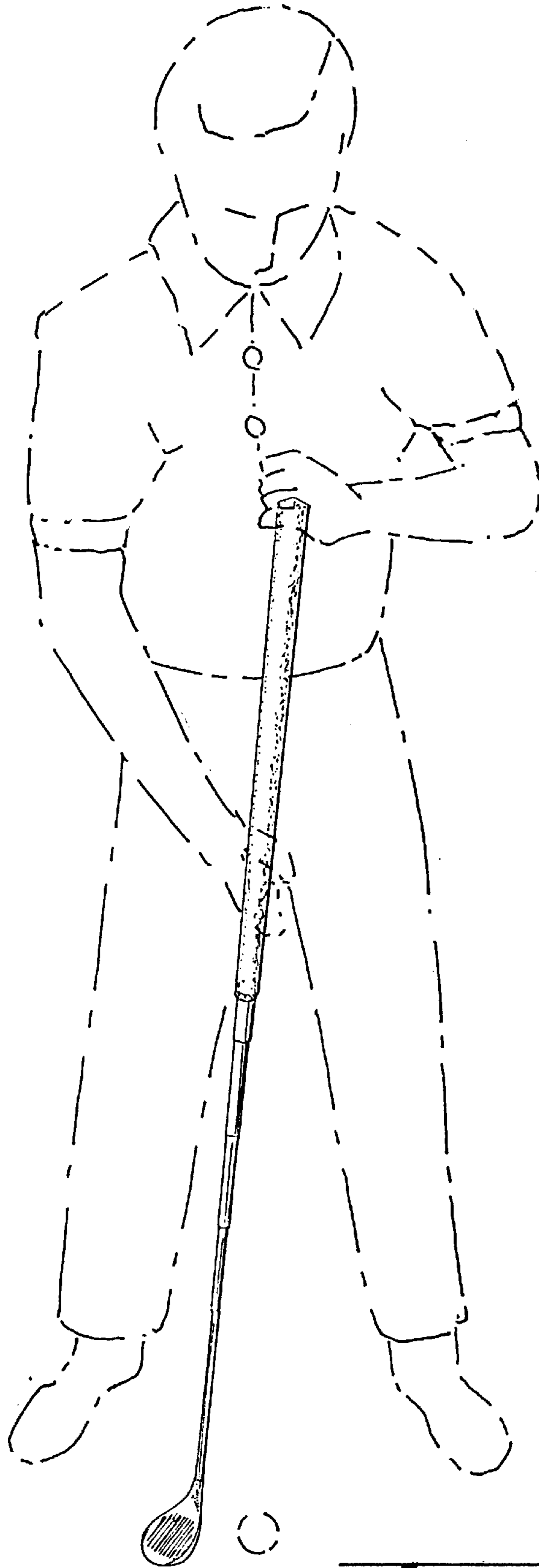

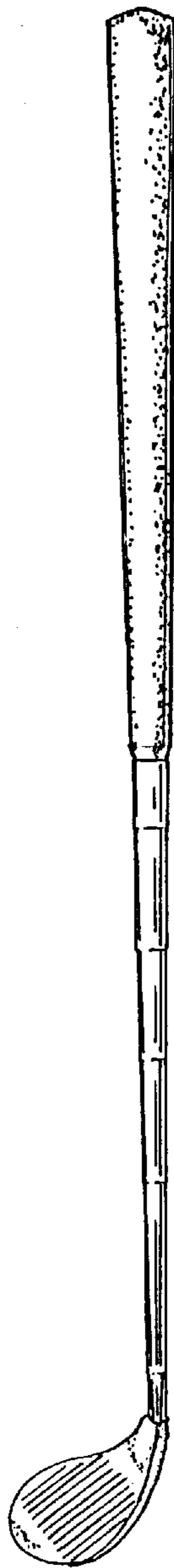

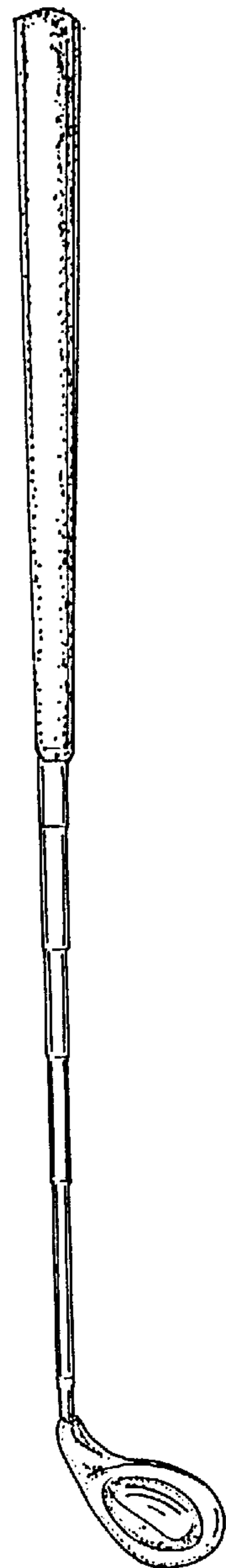

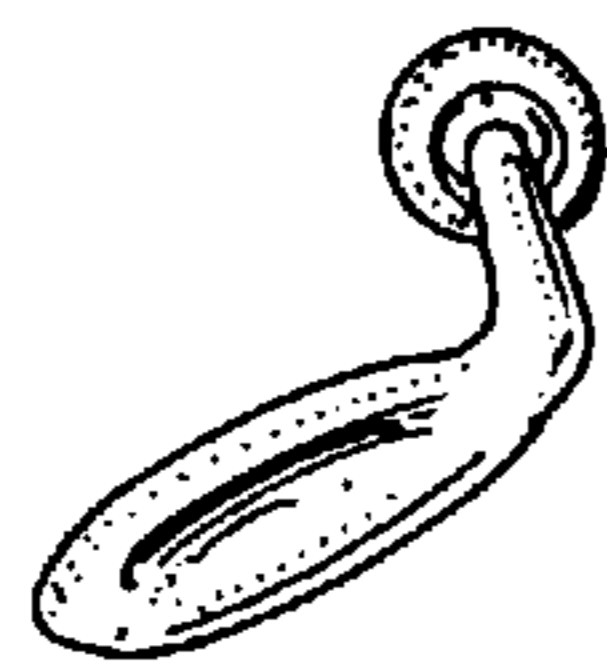

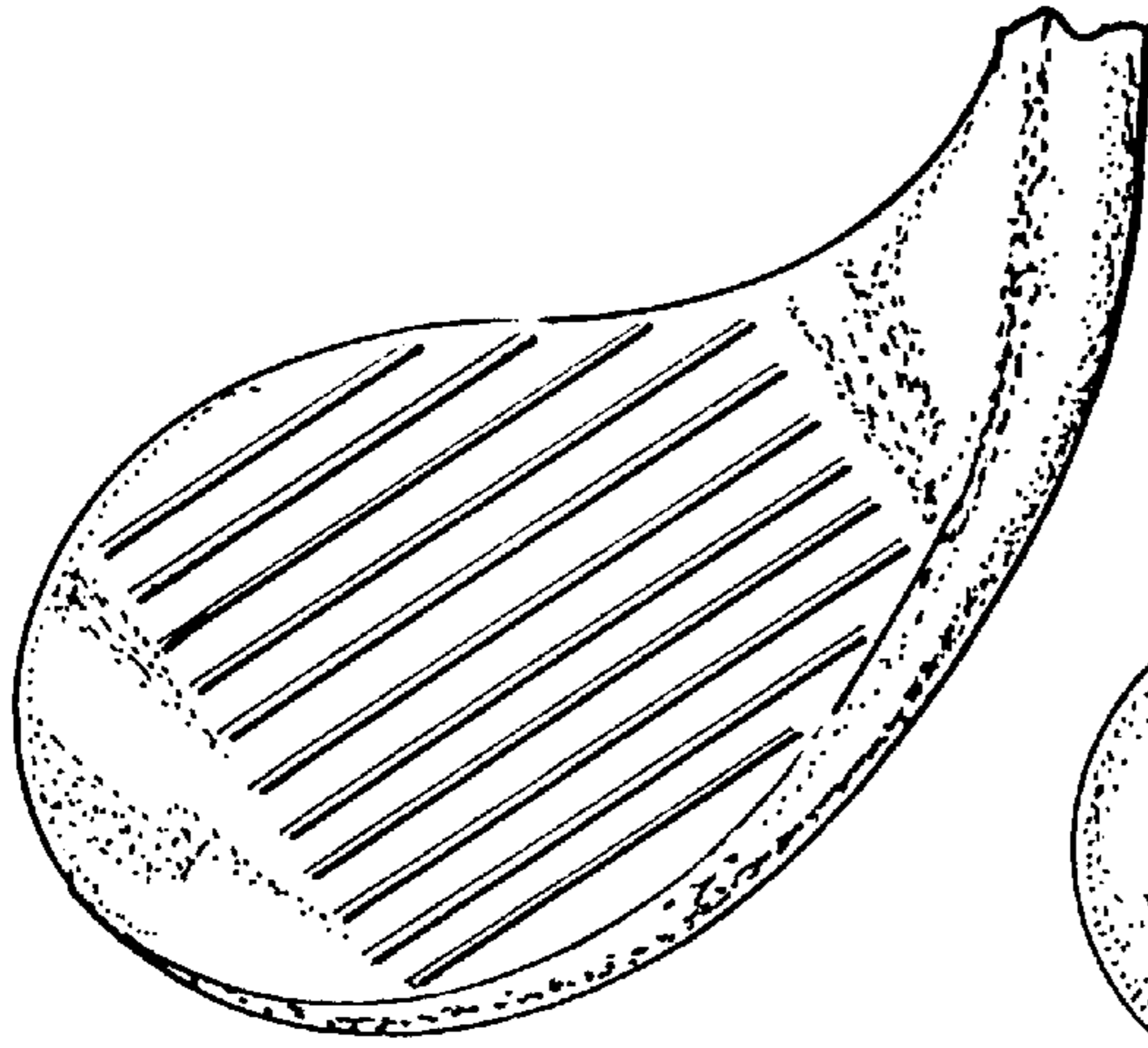

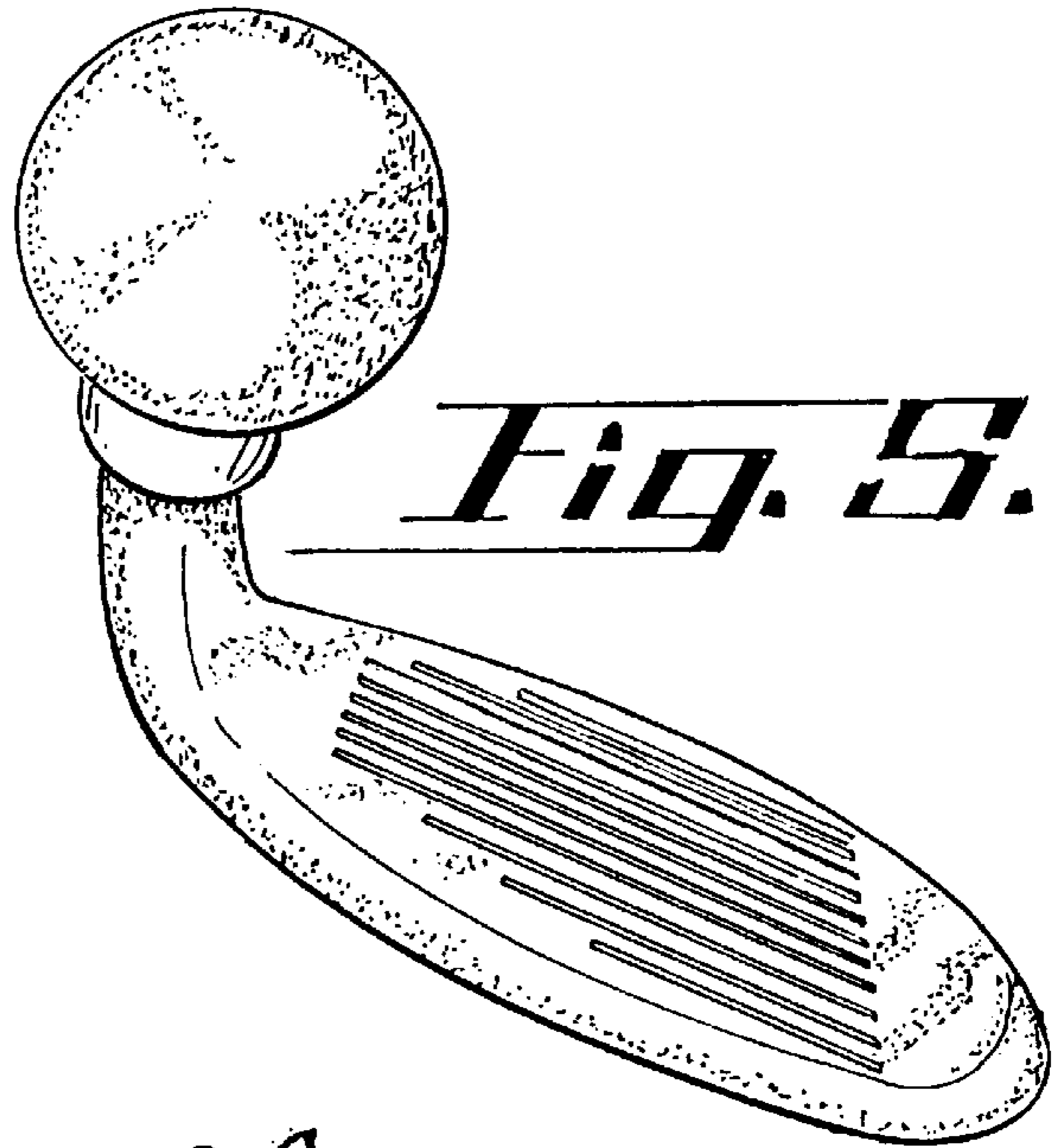

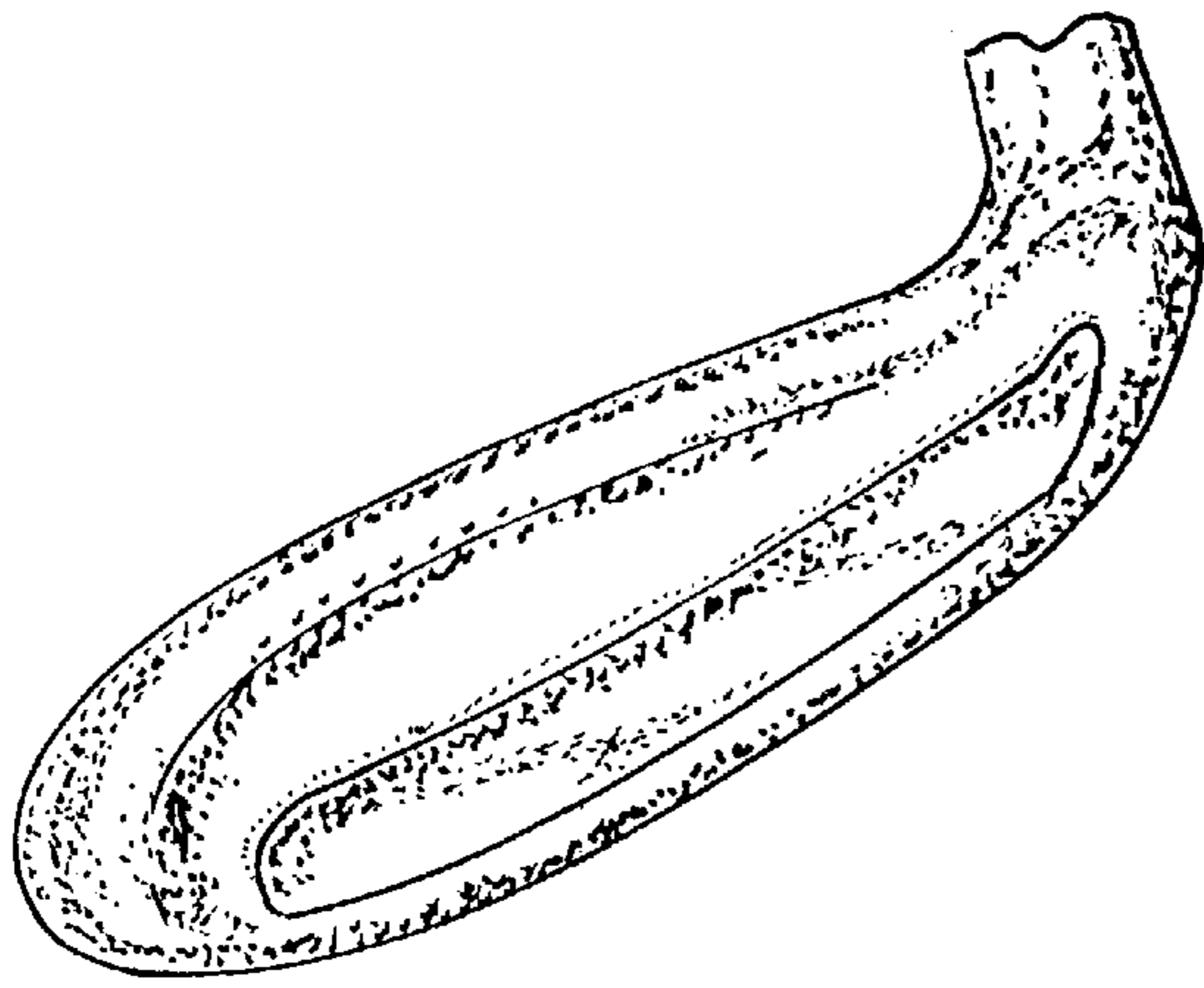

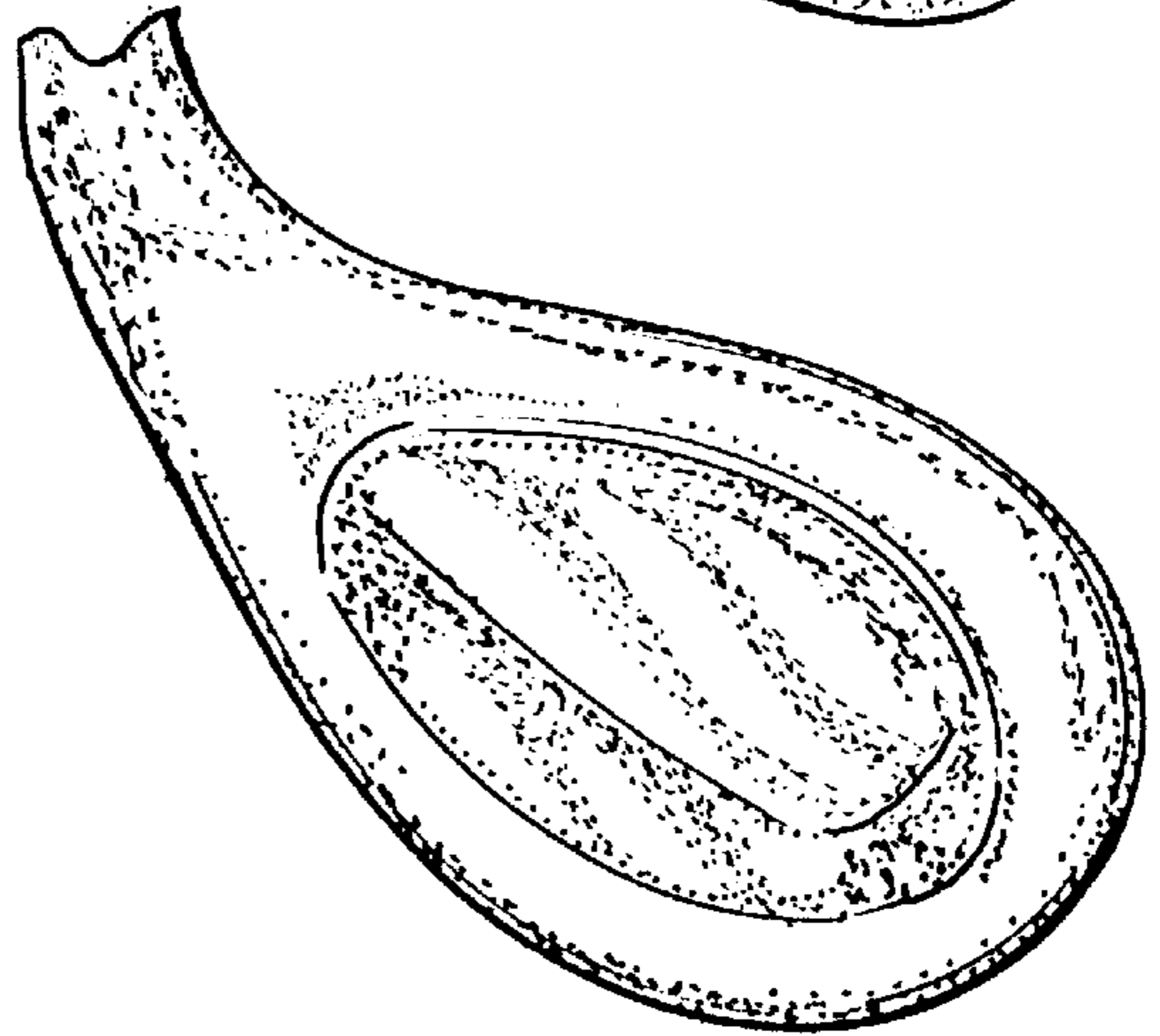
