## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wall mountable shower fixture, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right, top, frontal perspective view of a wall mountable shower fixture embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being the mirror image of the right side shown;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right, top, frontal perspective detailed view of the spout portion thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being the mirror image of the right side shown;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevation view thereof; and,

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof.

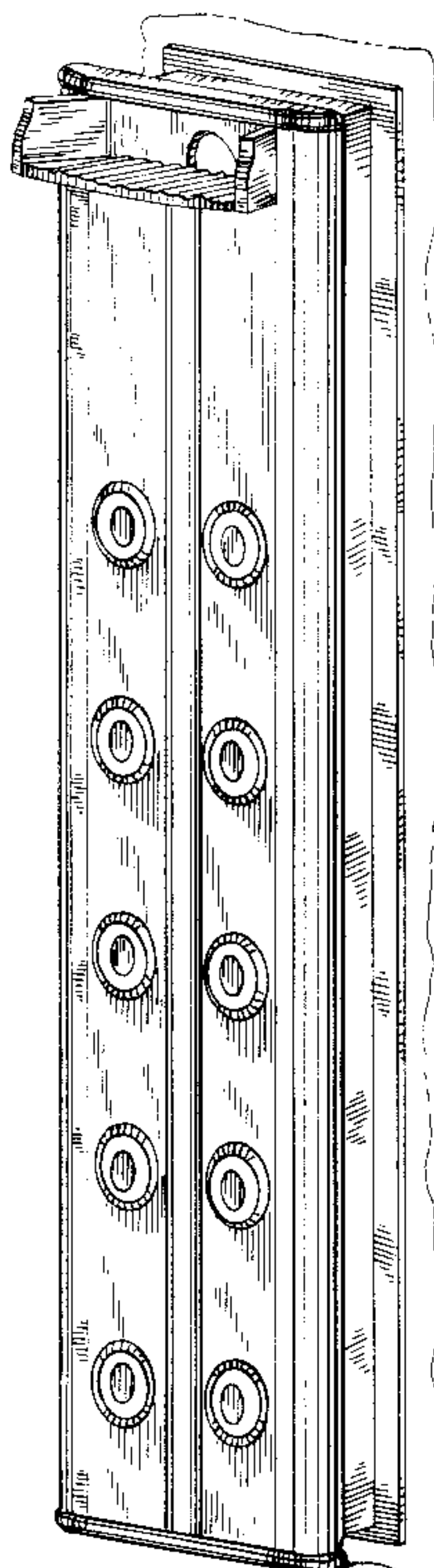

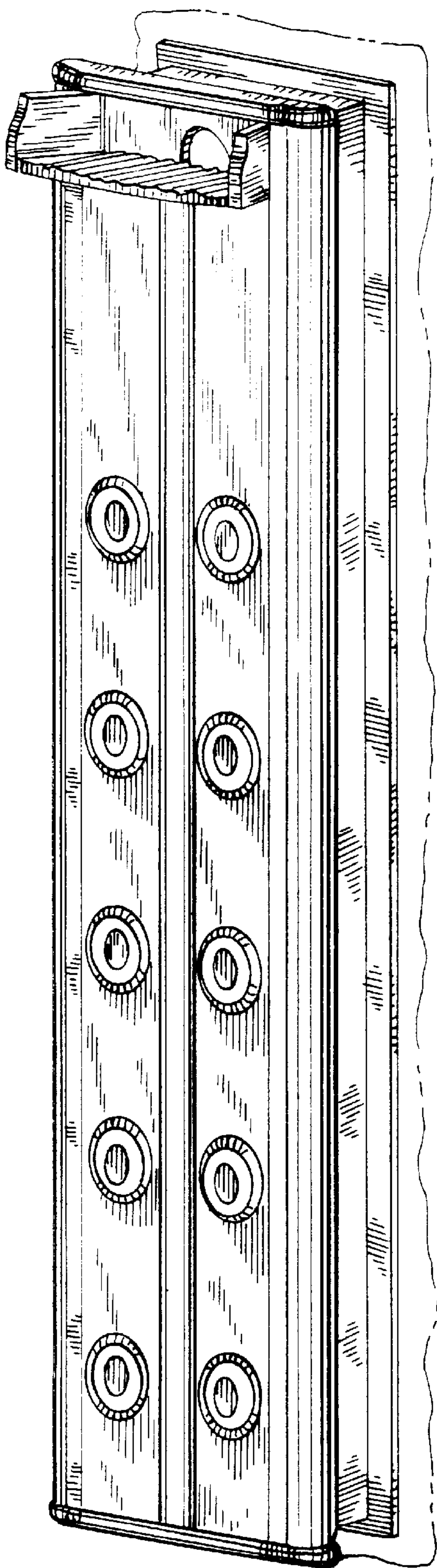
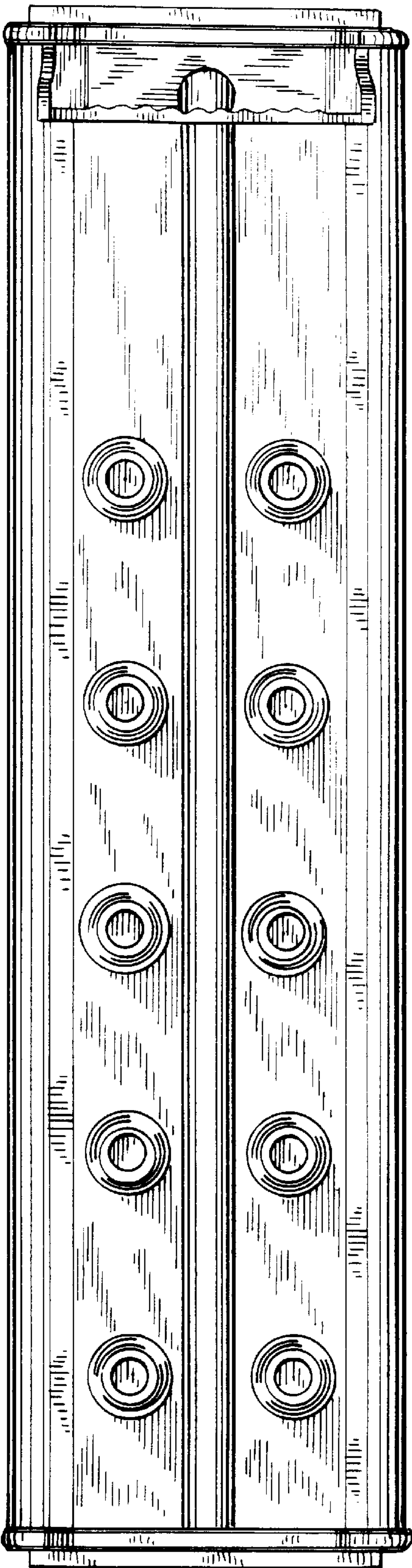

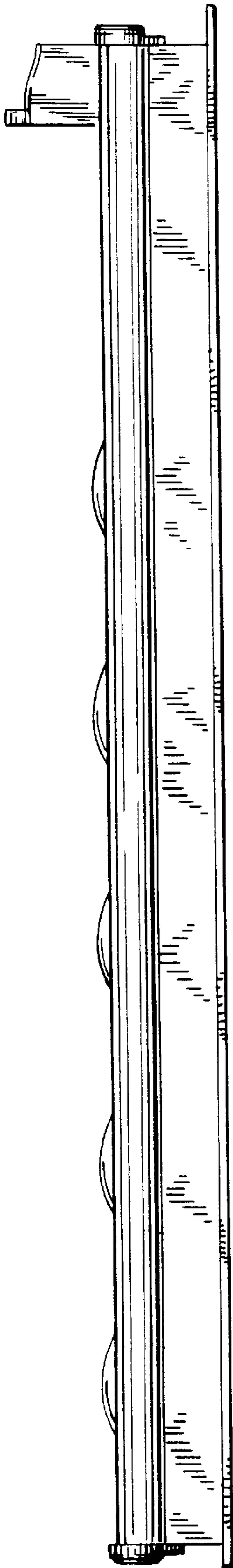

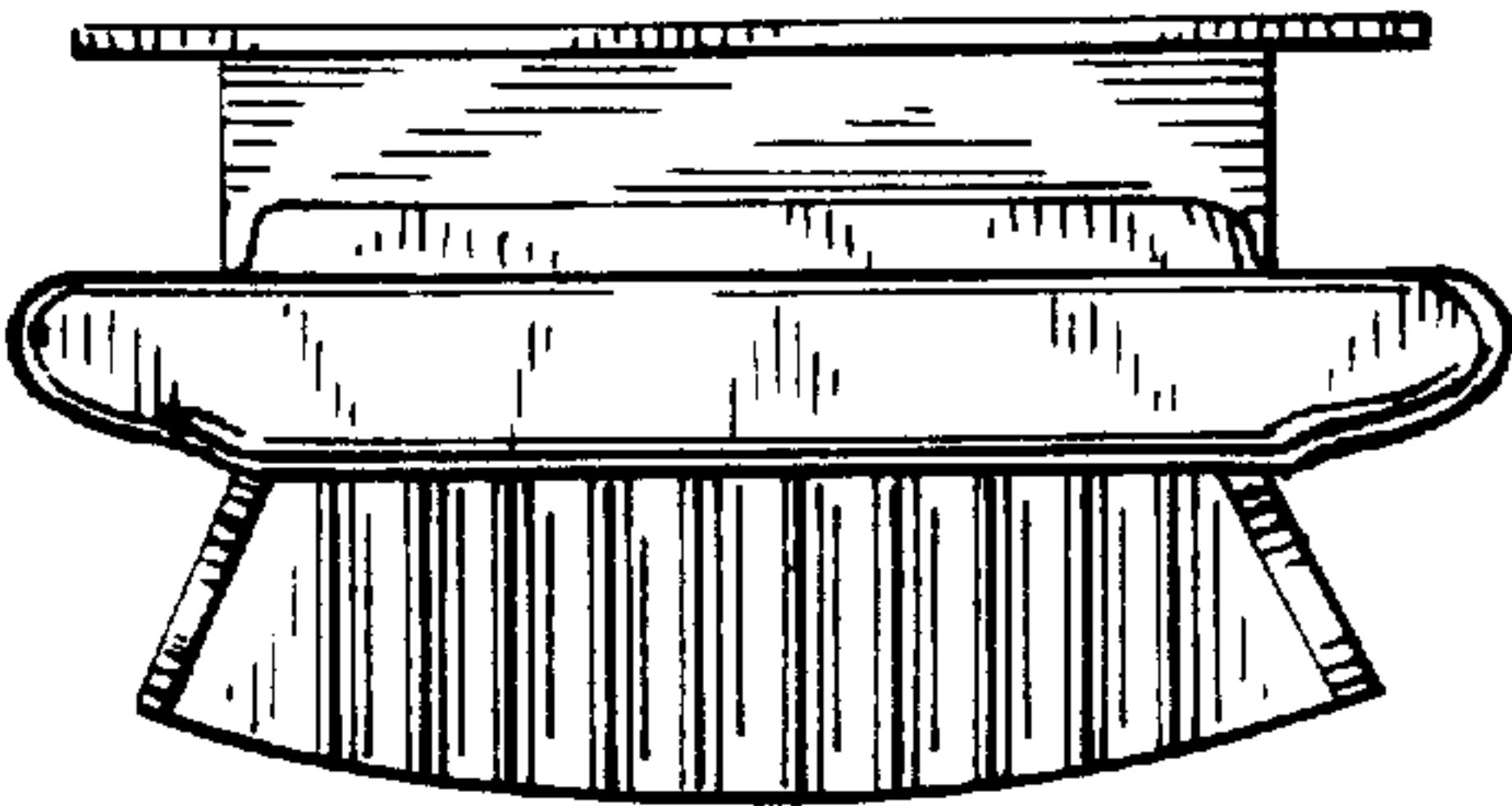

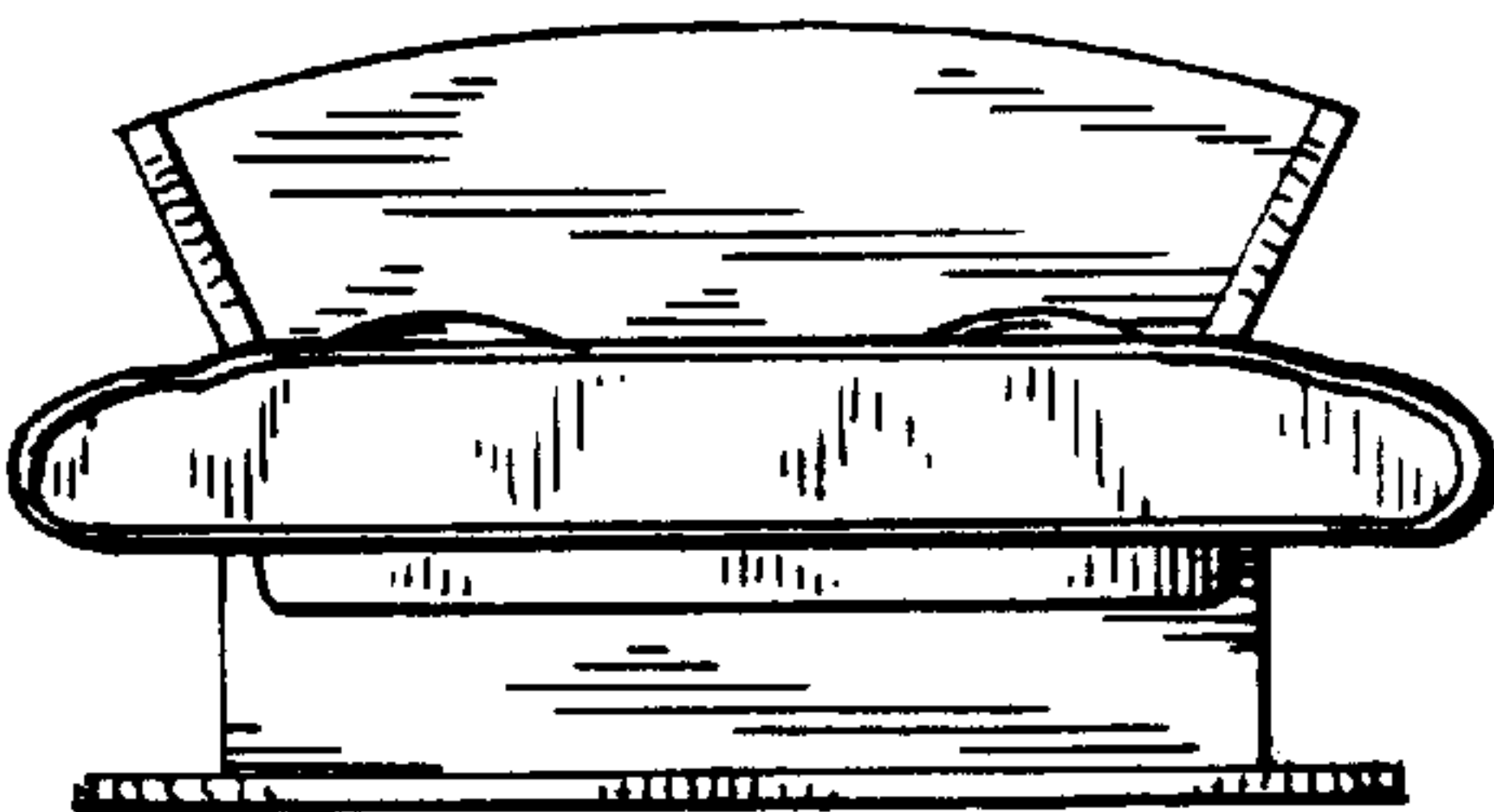

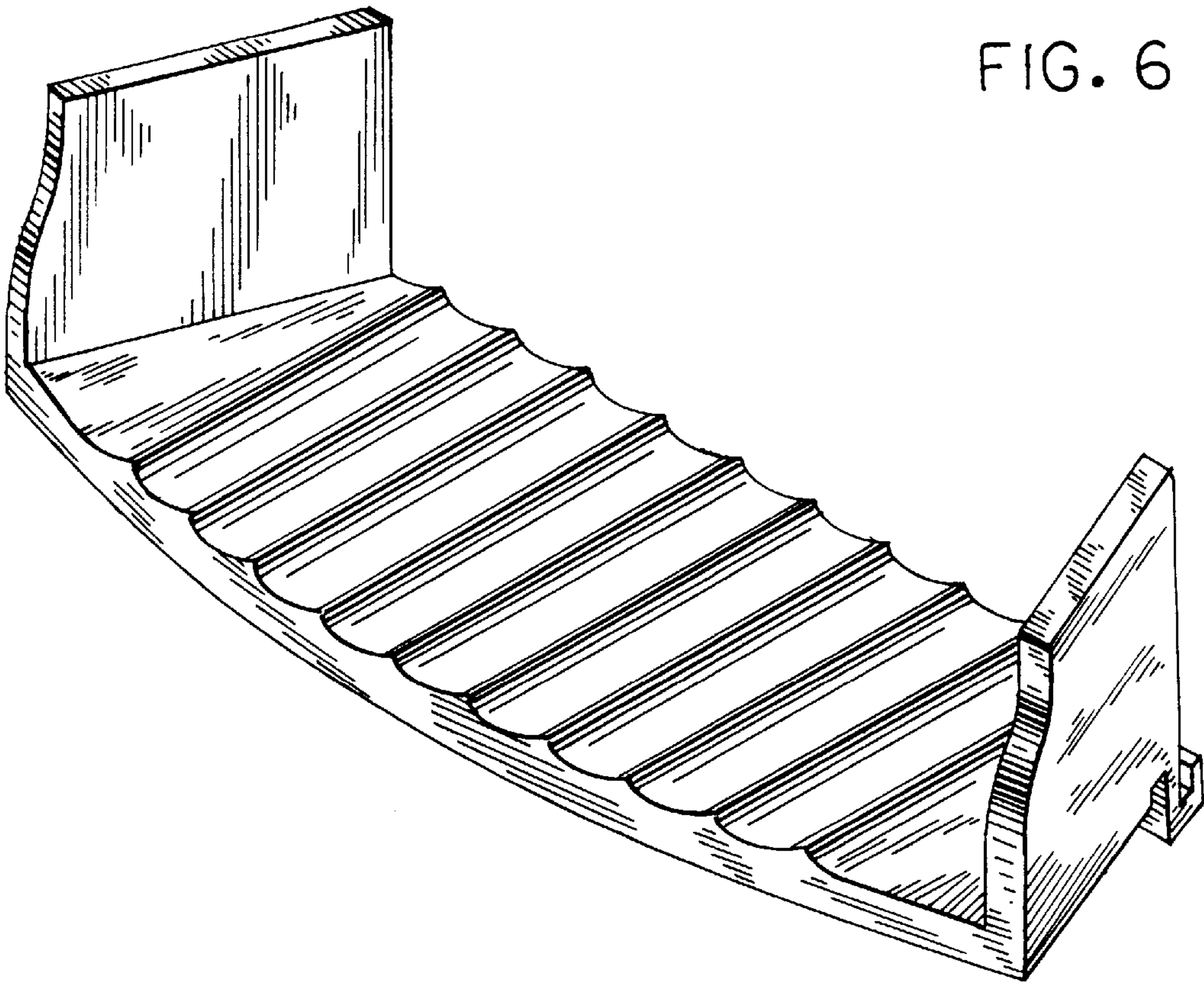

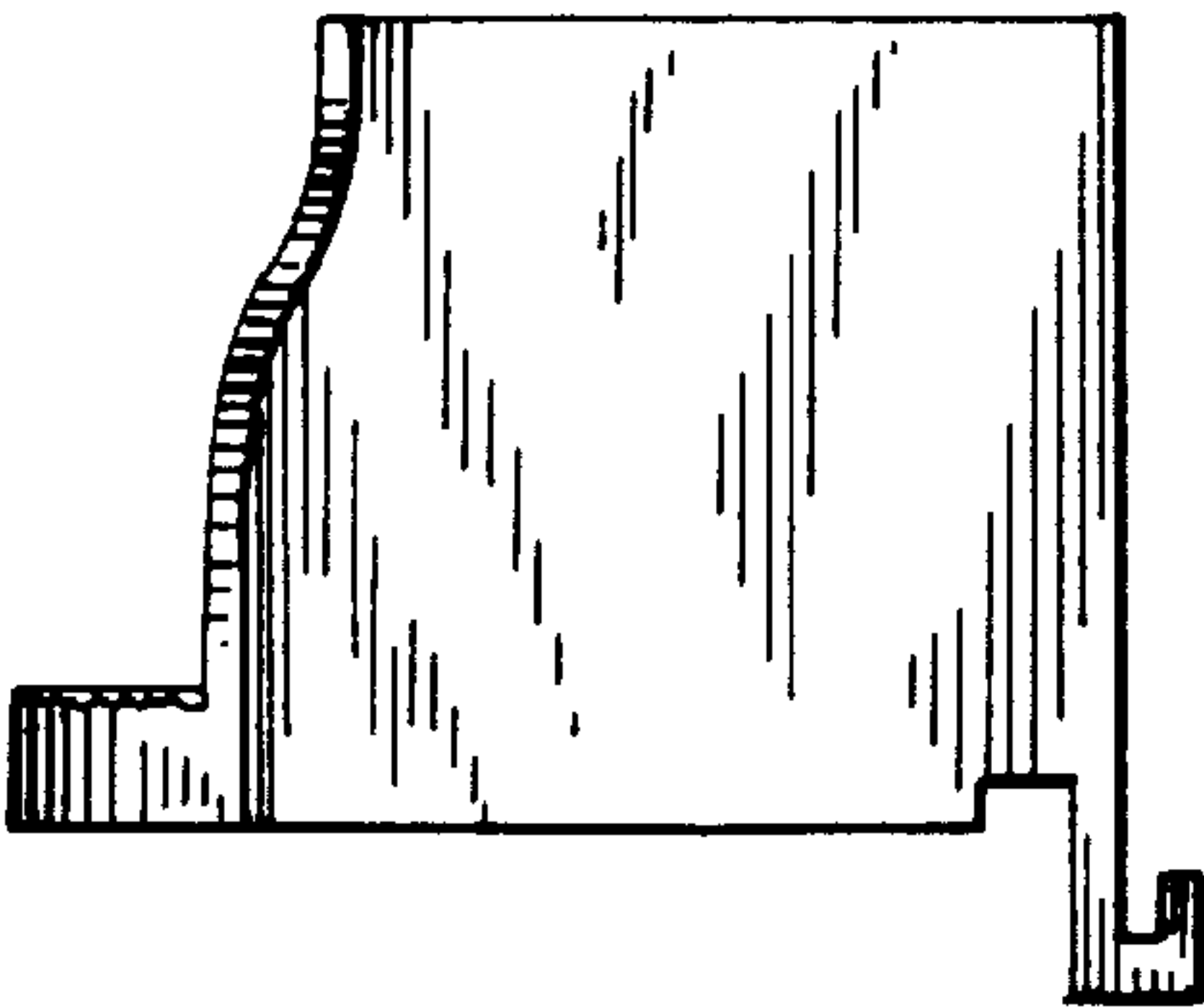

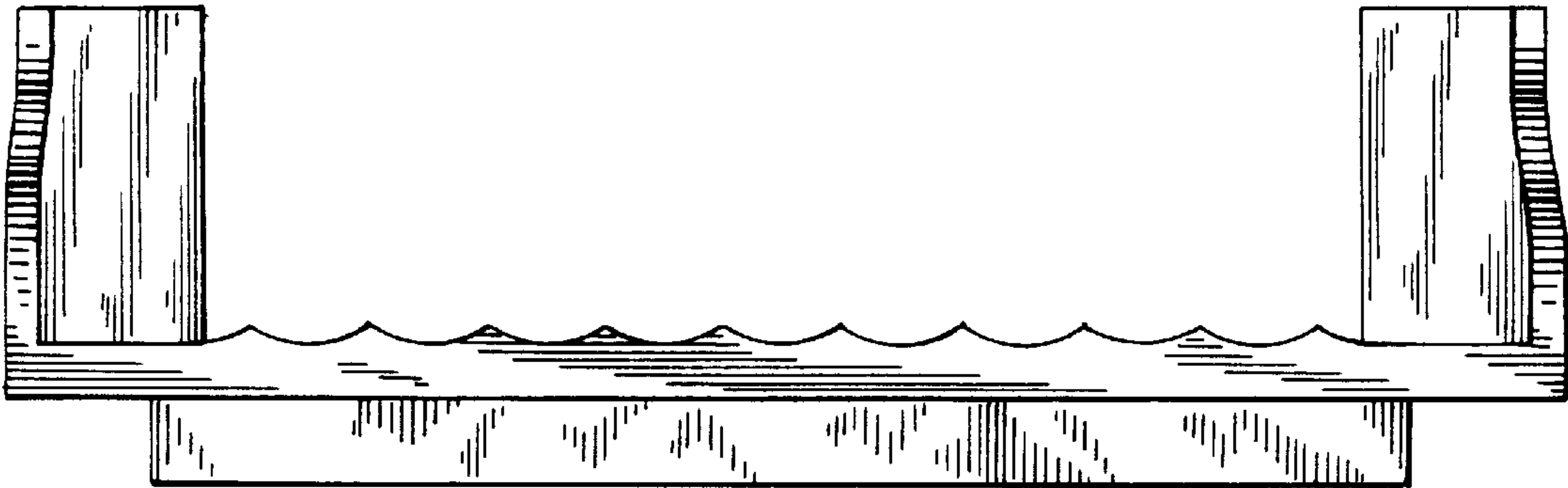

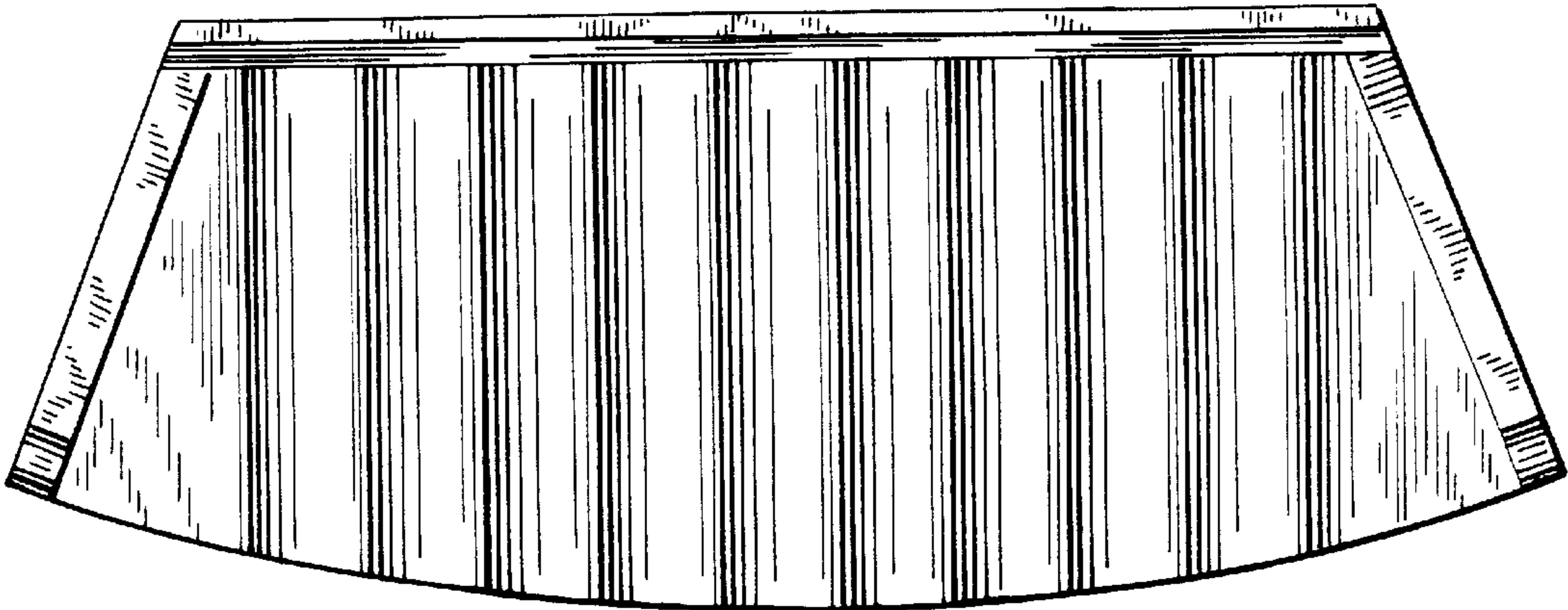

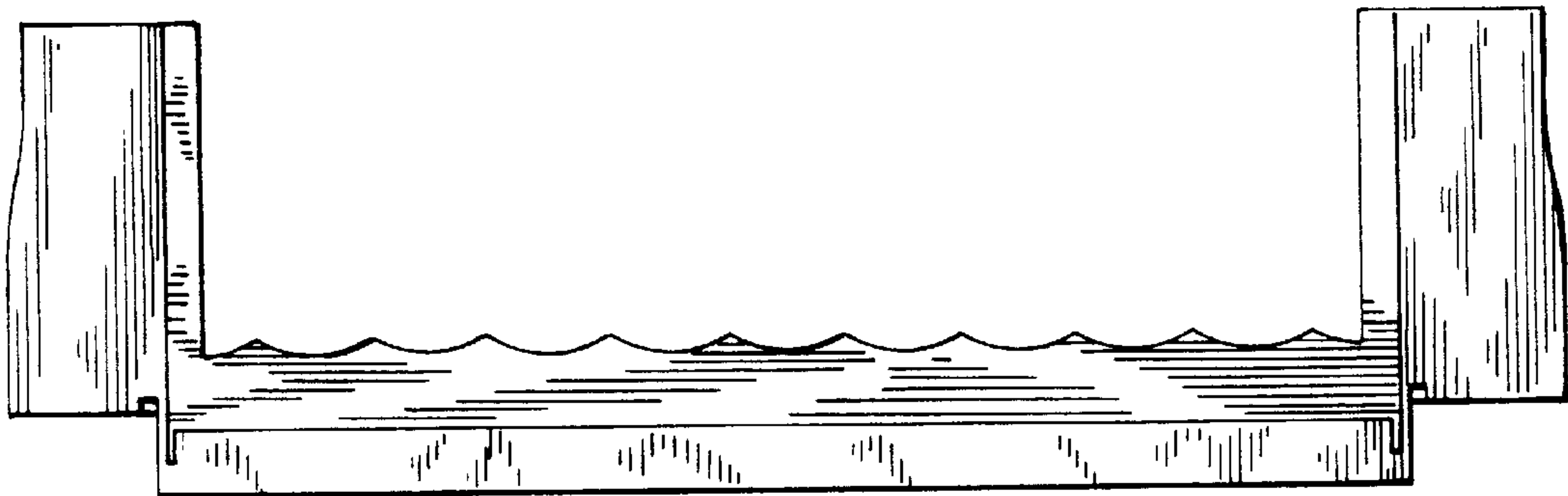
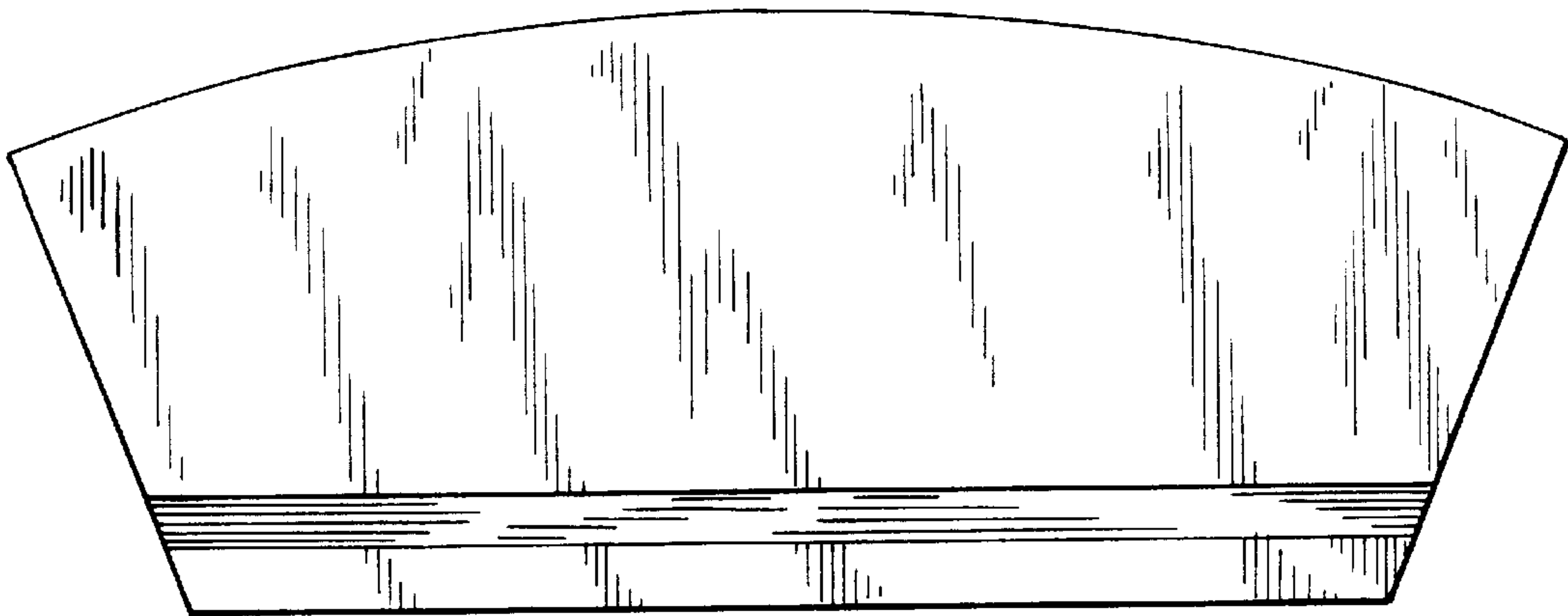
