FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

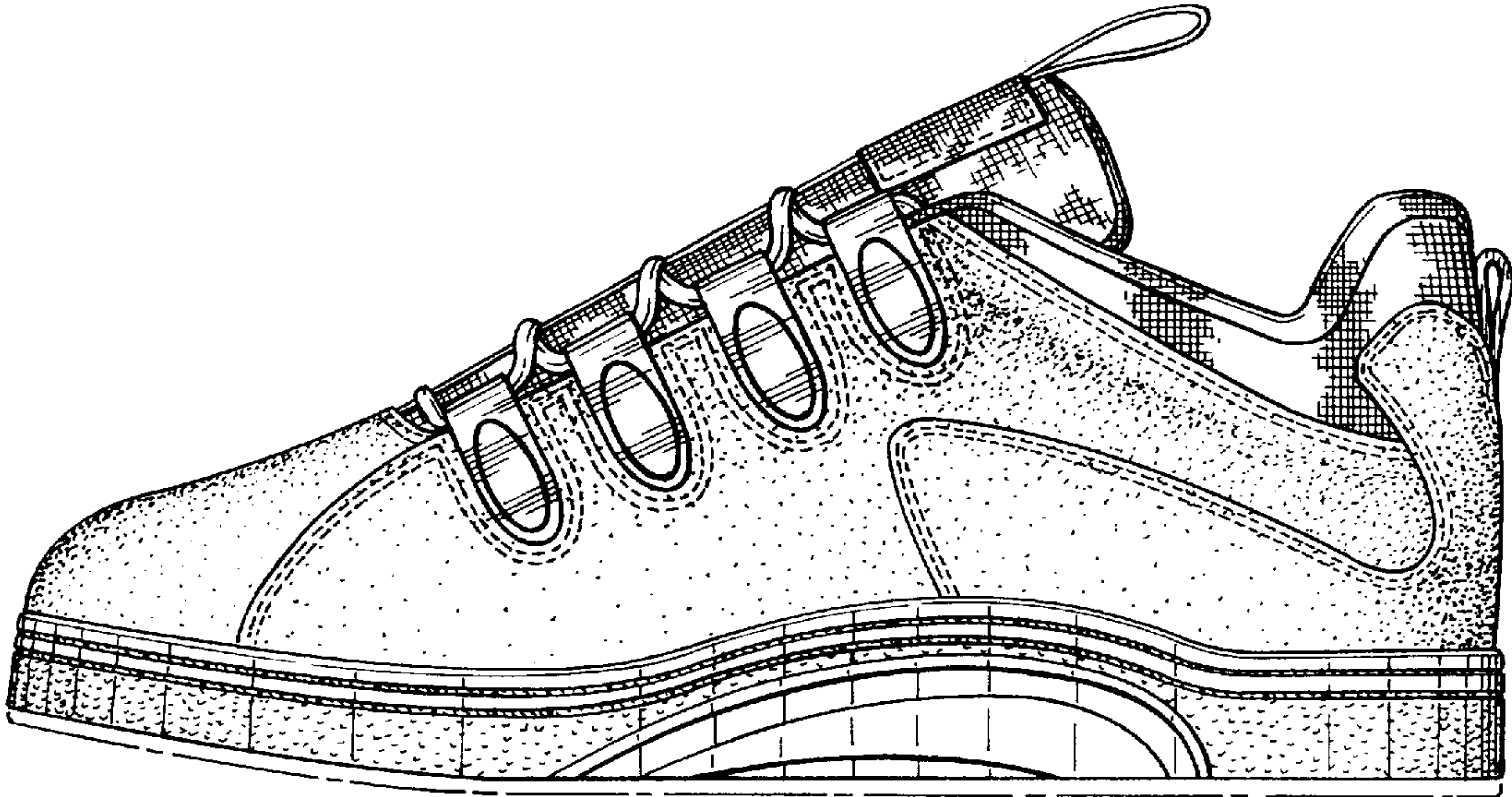
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

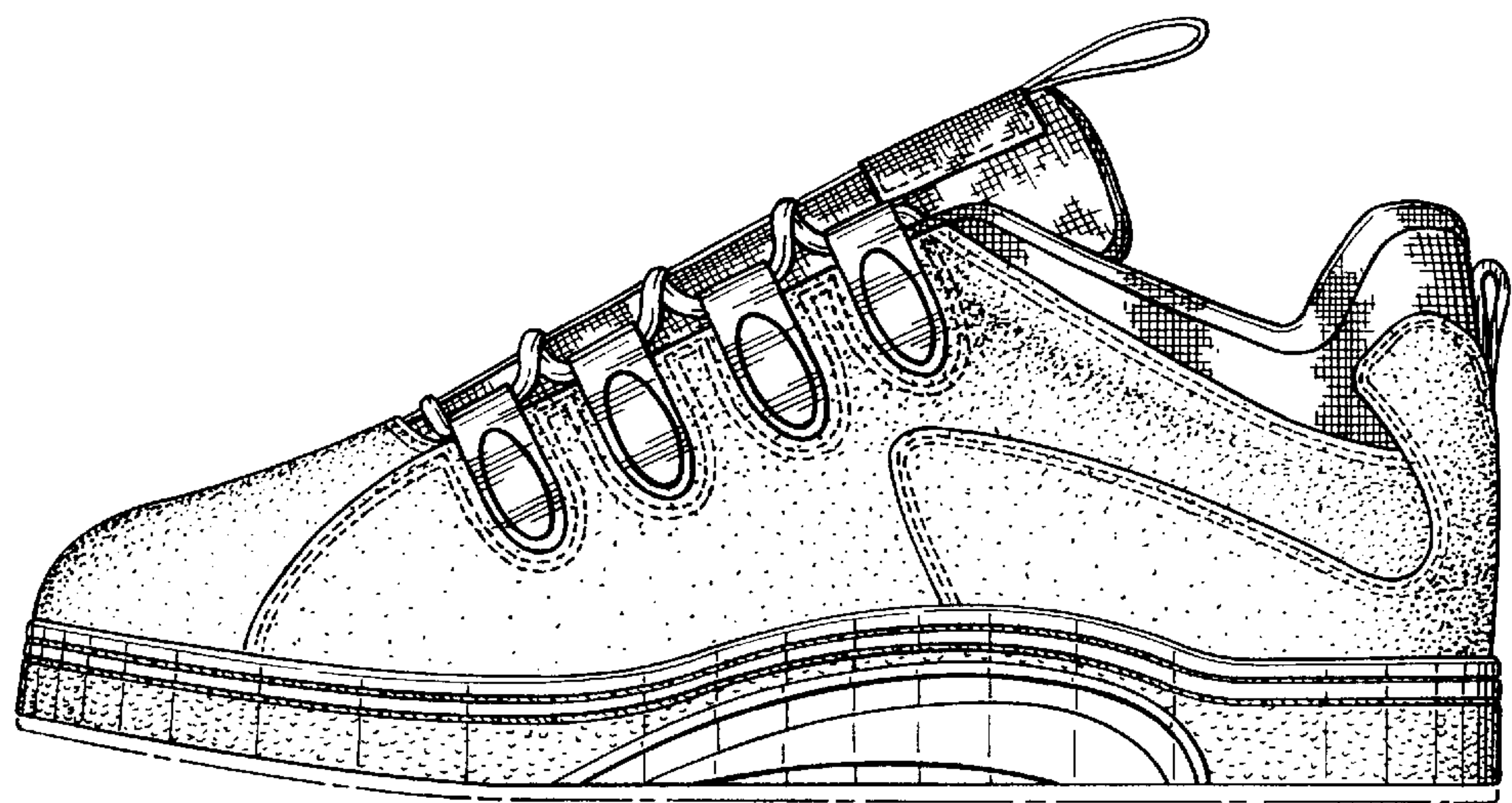

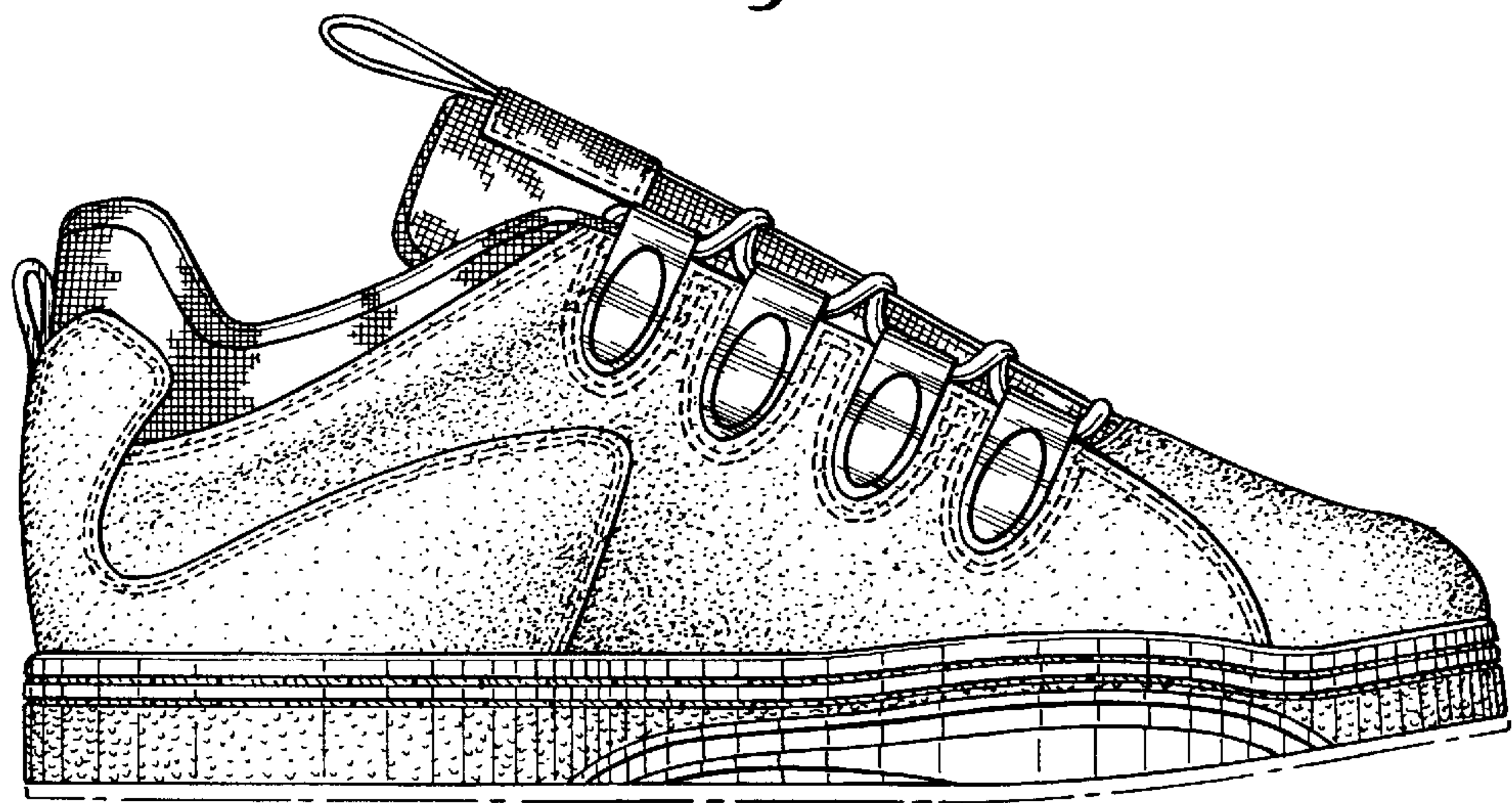

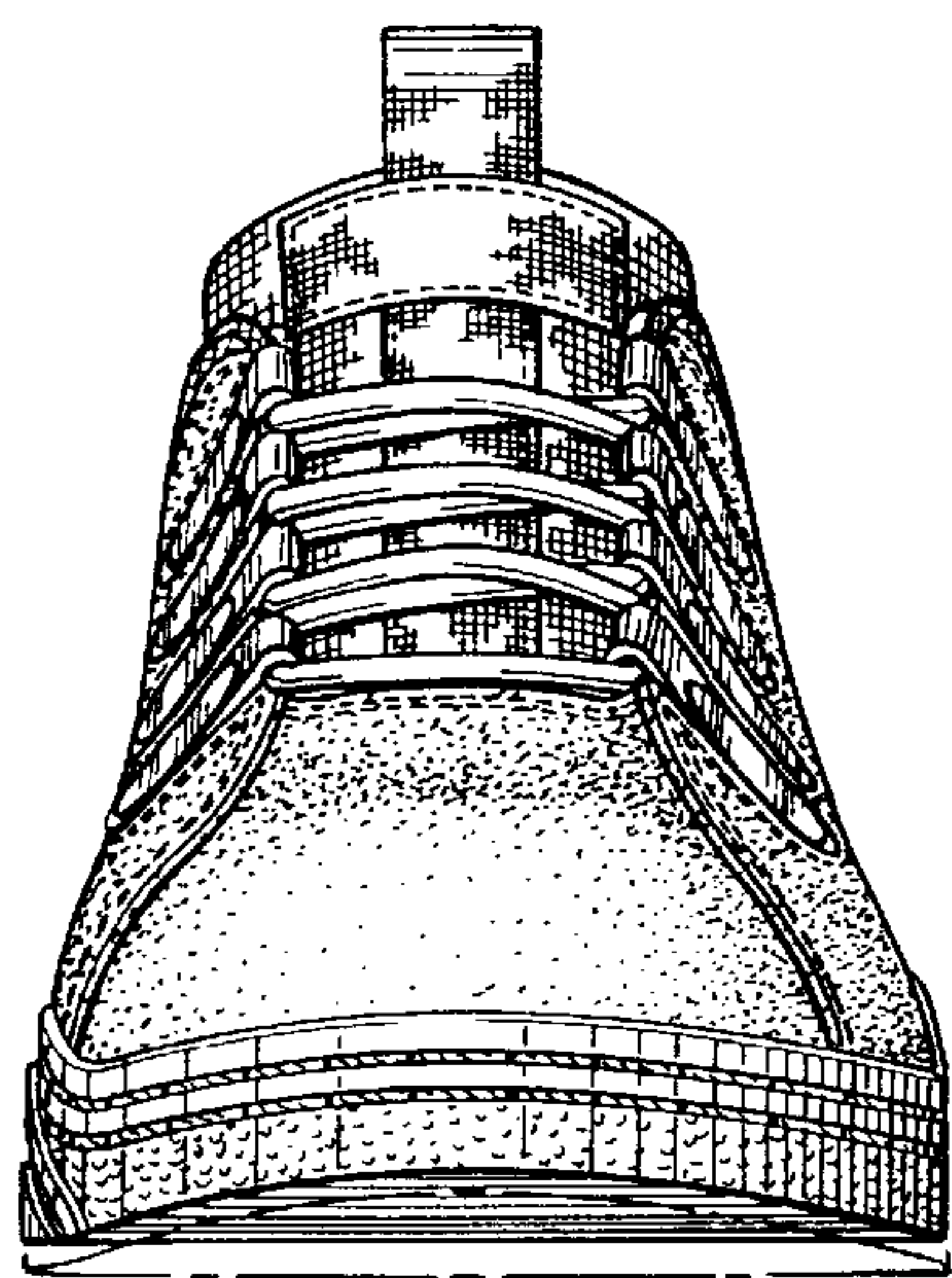

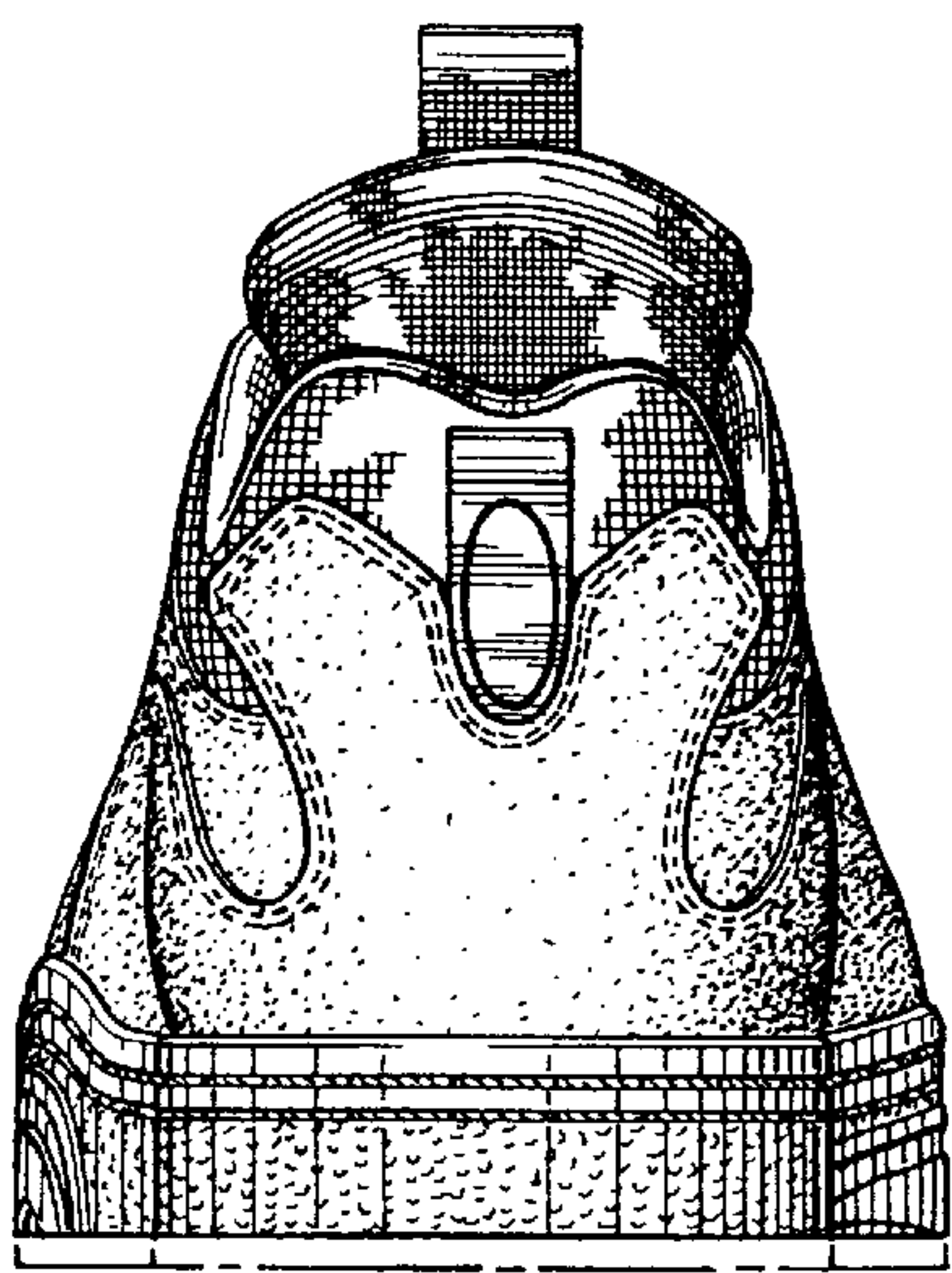

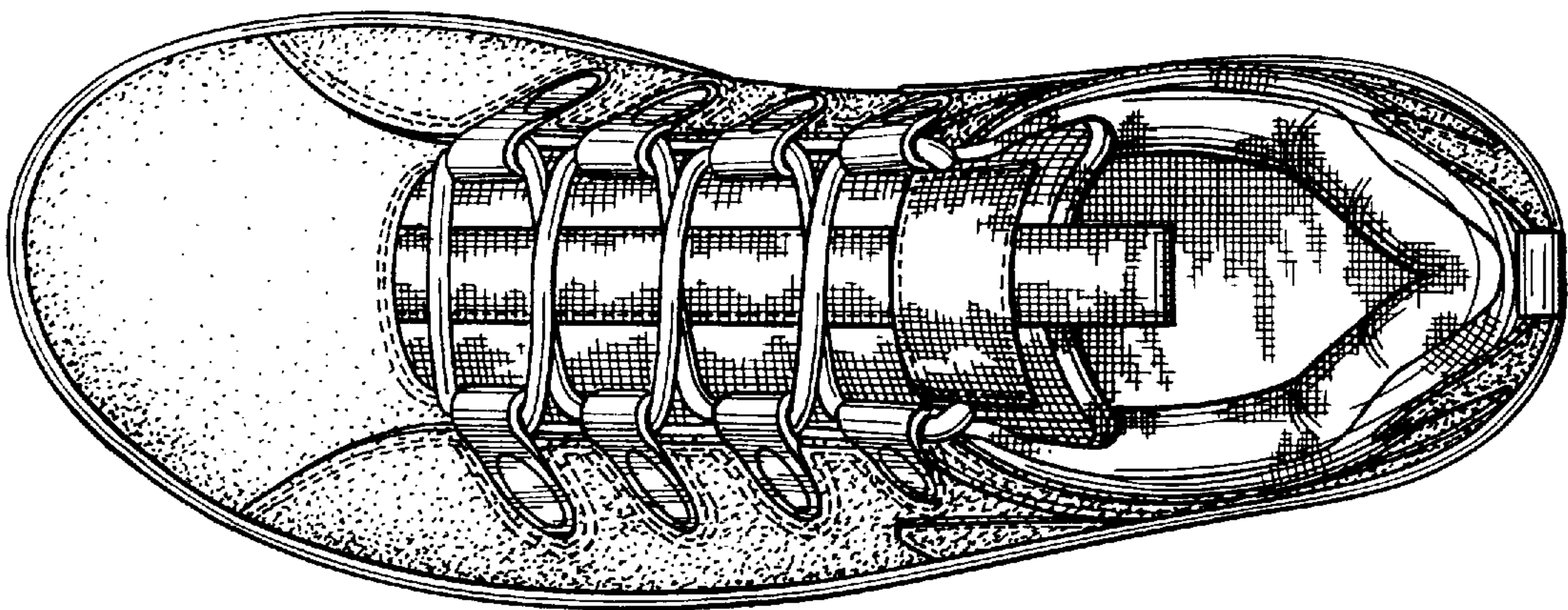
