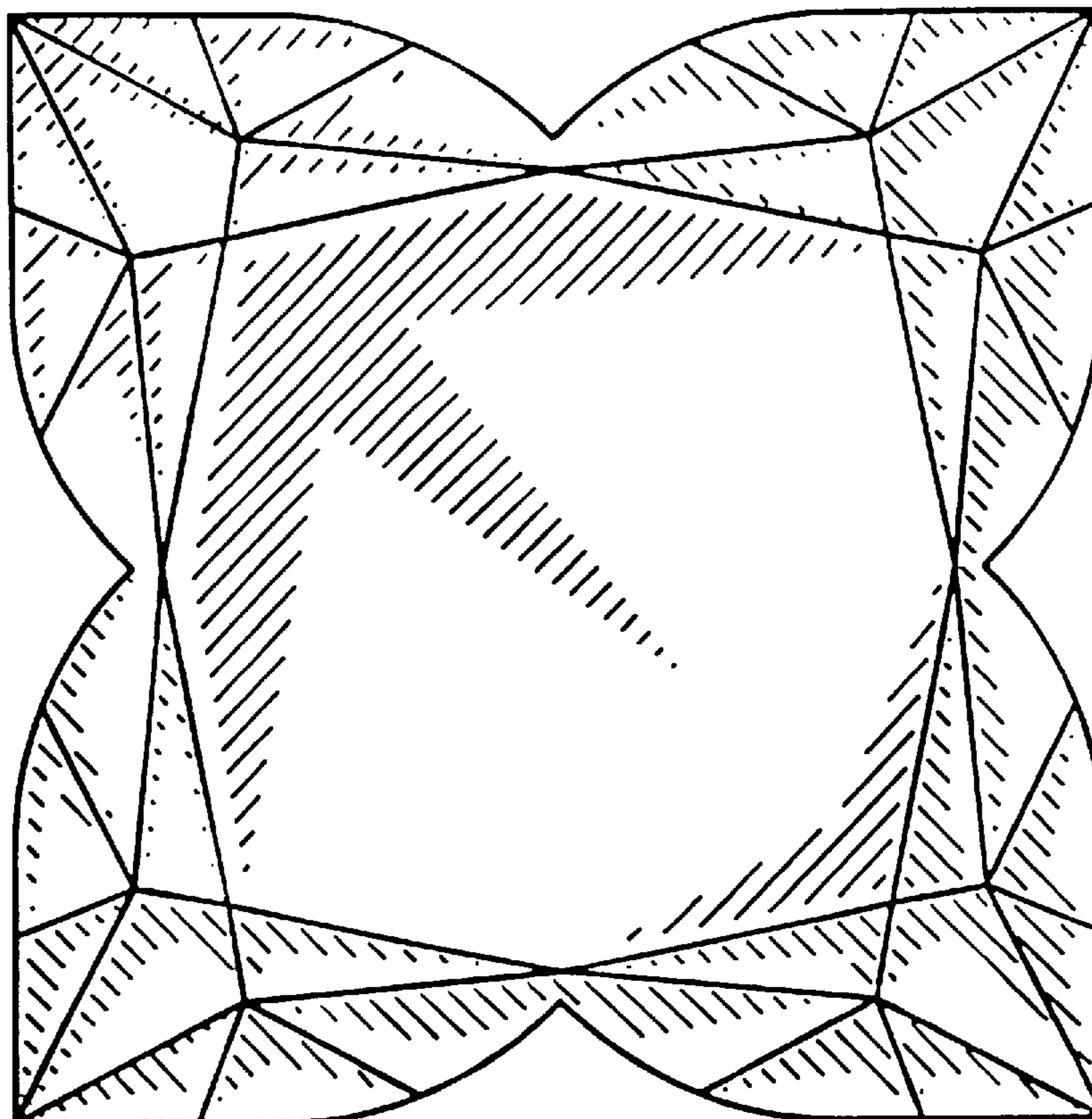
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for the flower-shaped cut diamond, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a flower-shaped cut diamond showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side view being the same;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view, the rear elevational view being same; and,
FIG. 5 is a perspective view.

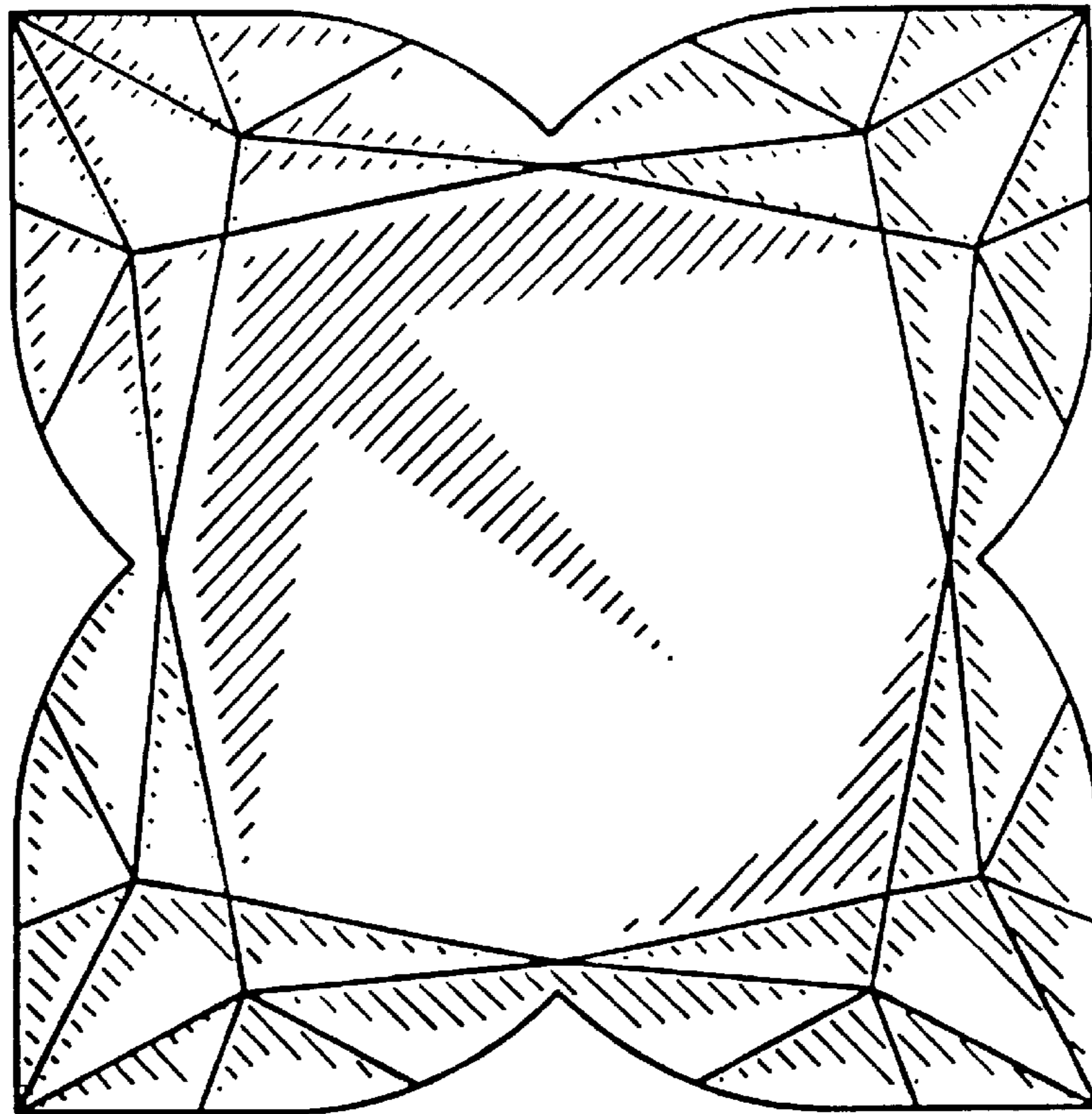

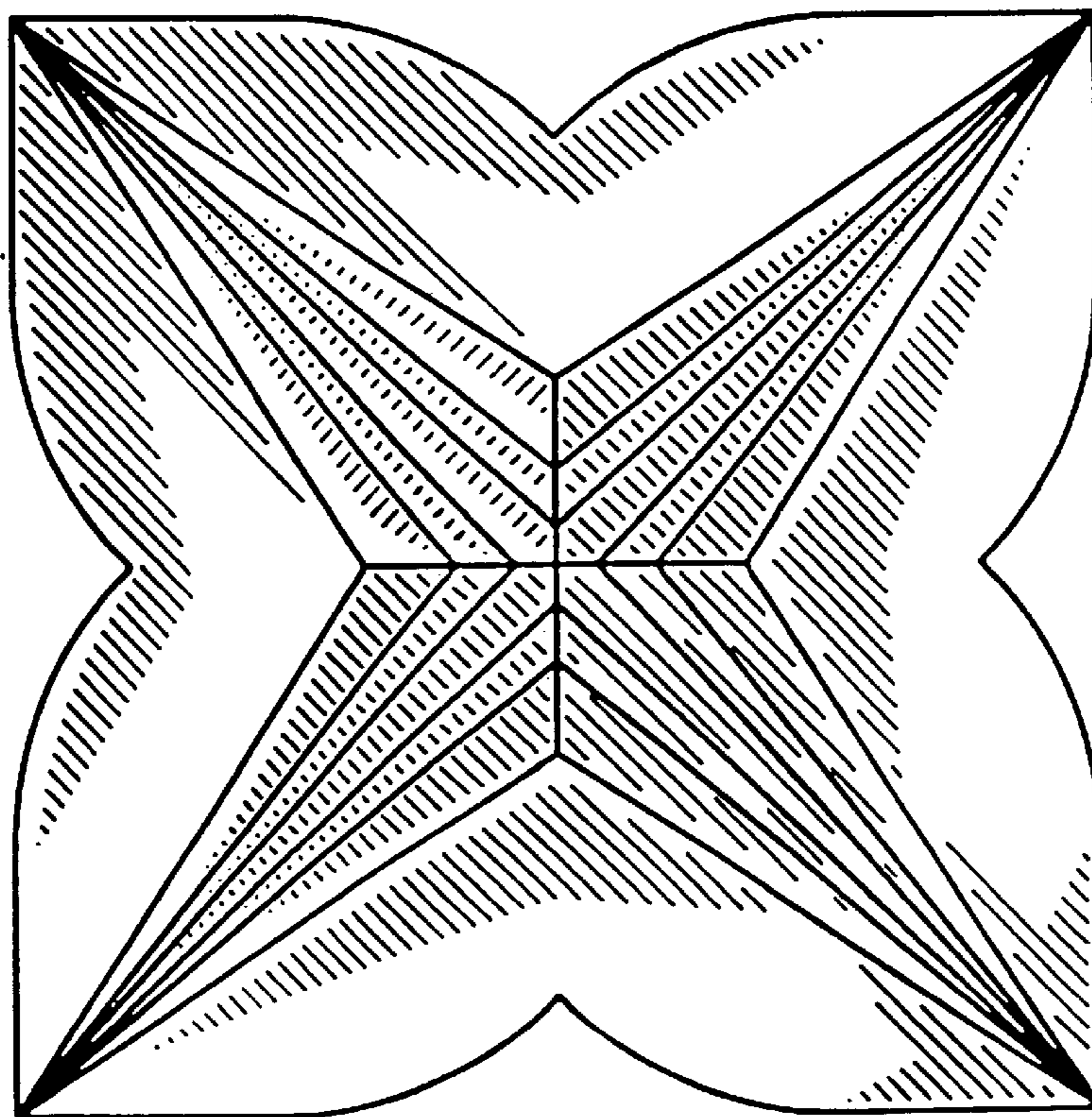

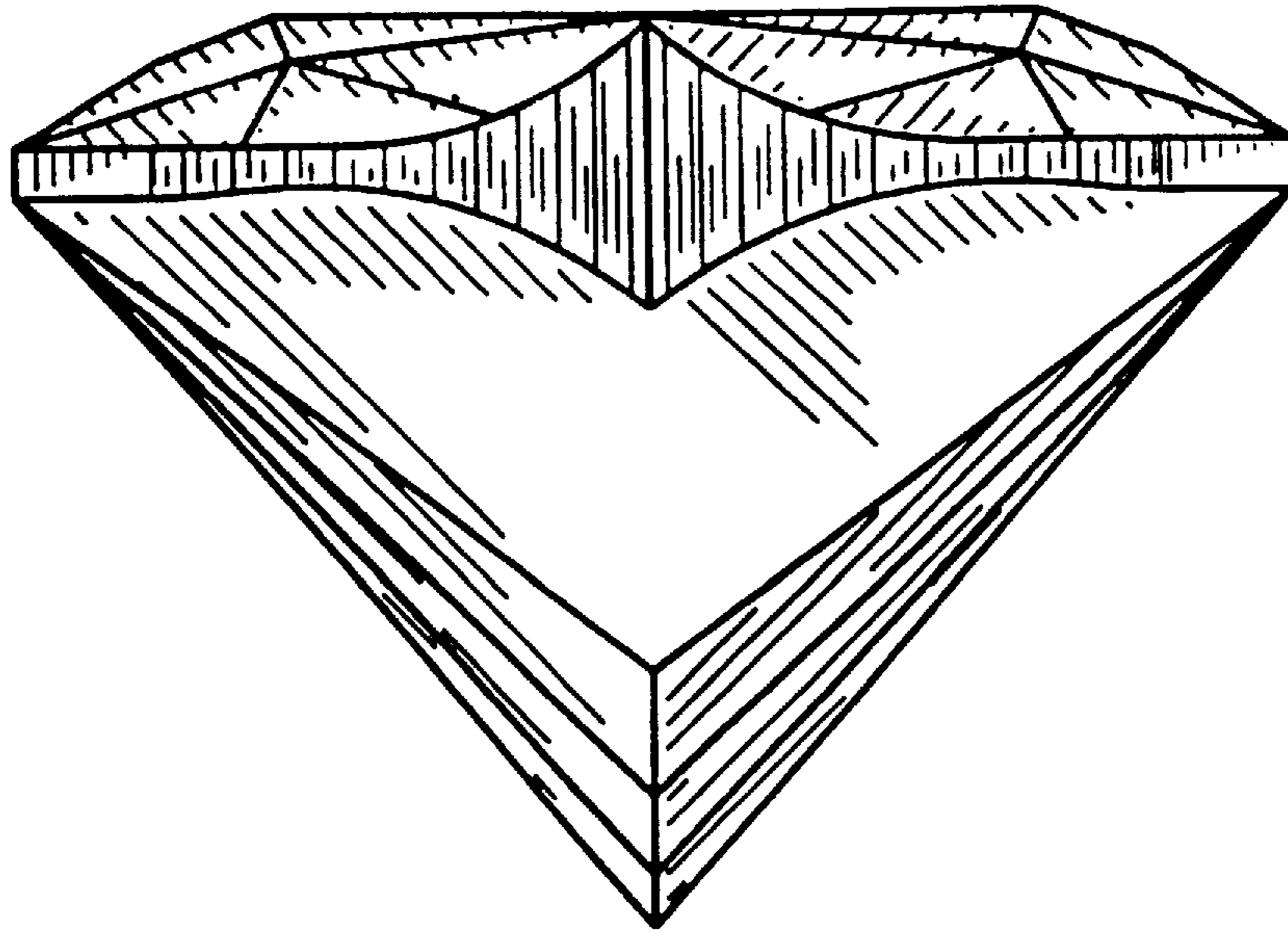

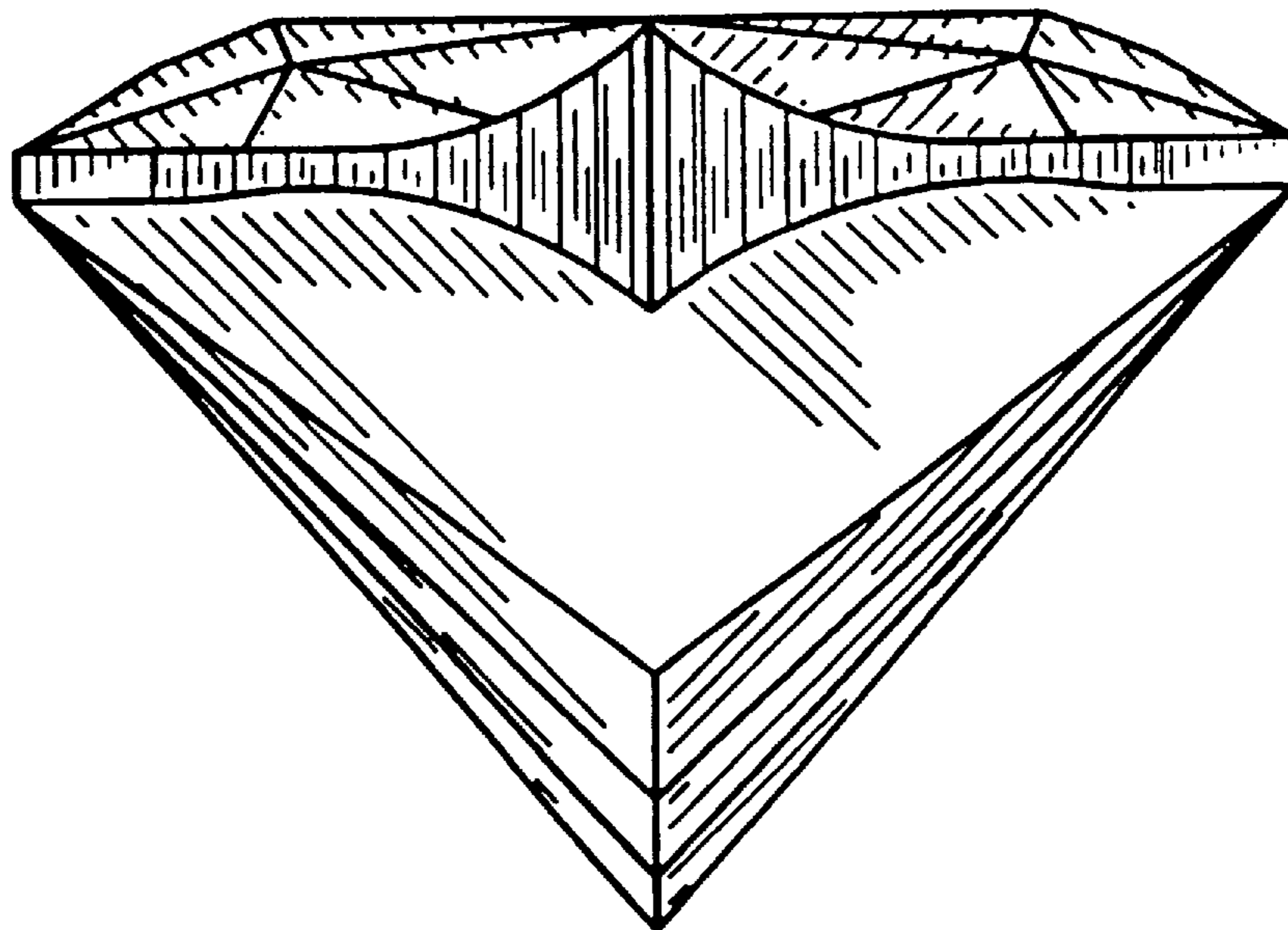

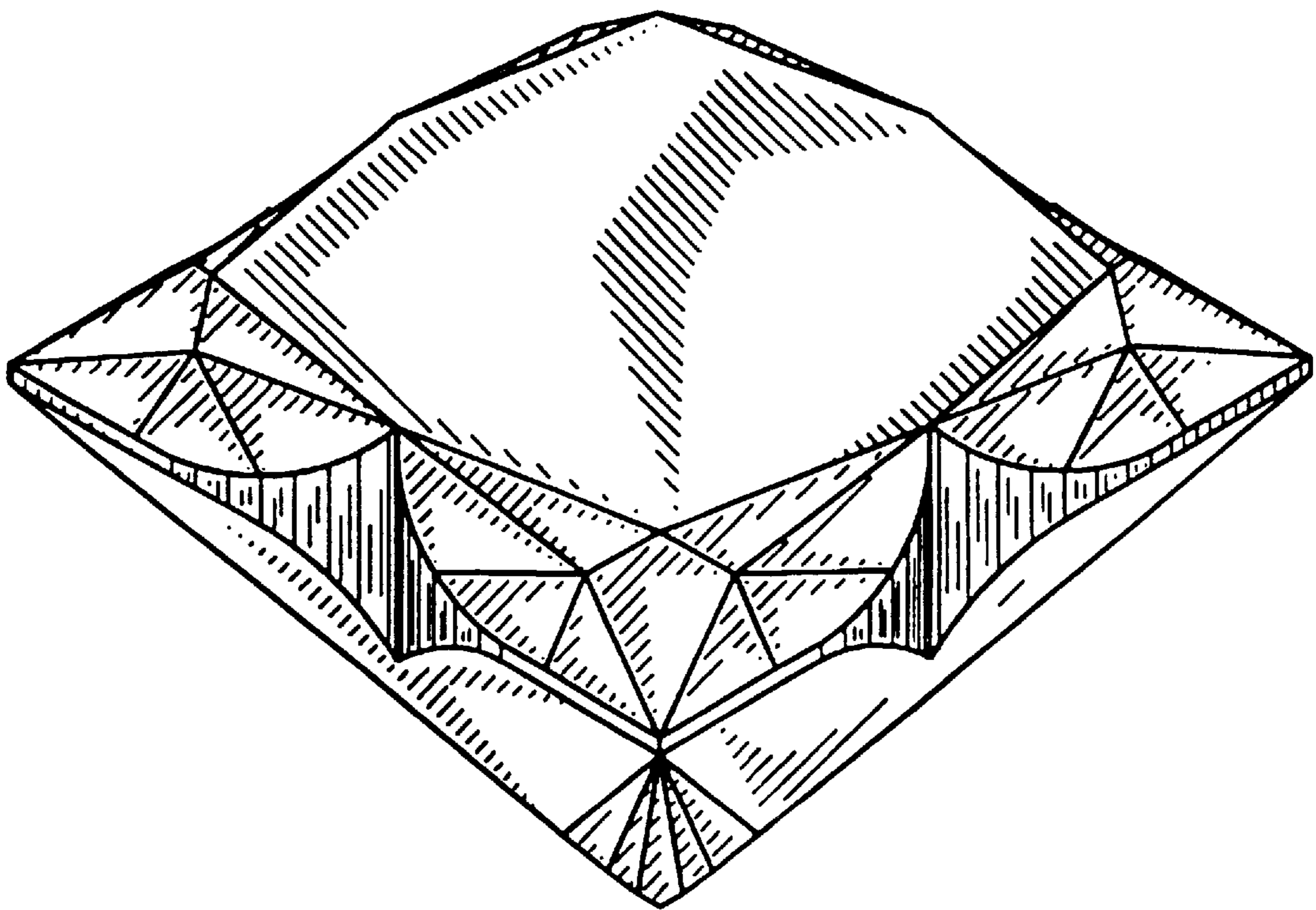
