FIG. 12 is a rear end elevational view thereof; and,

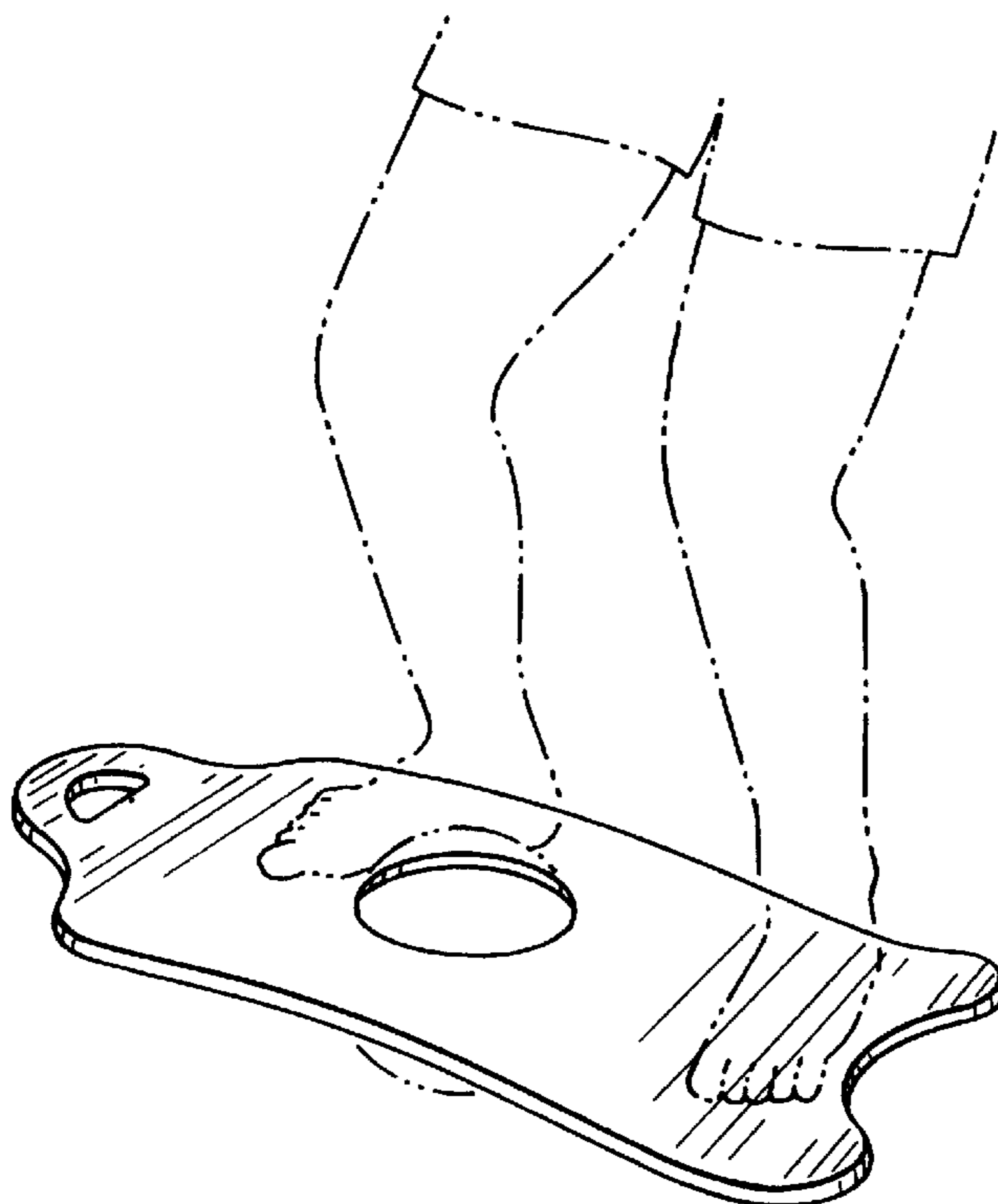
FIGS. 8–12 are shown on an enlarged scale.

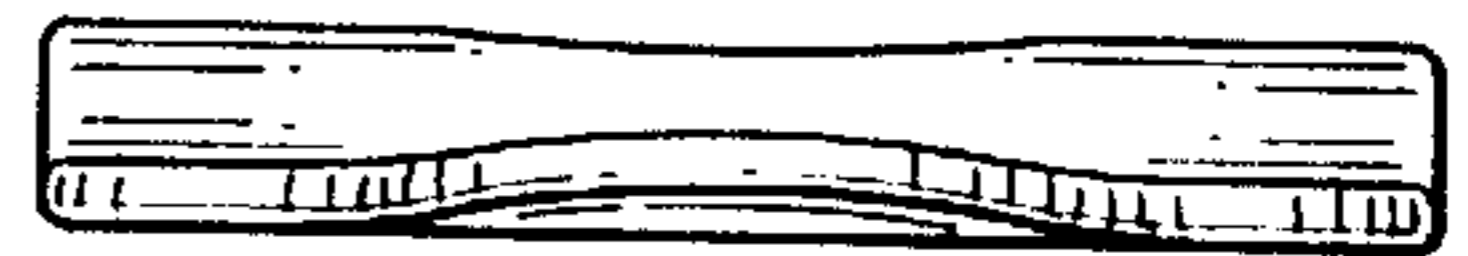
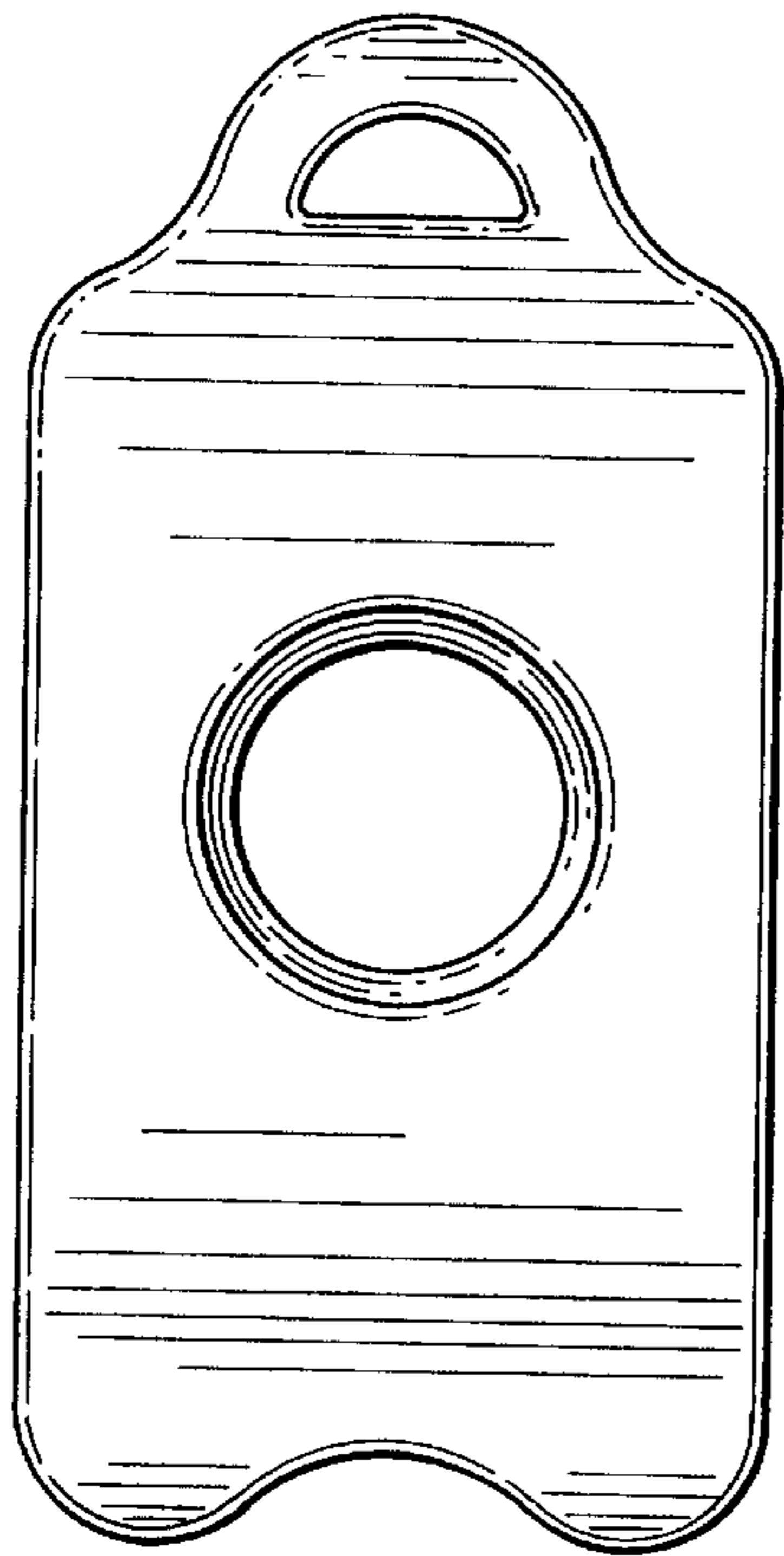
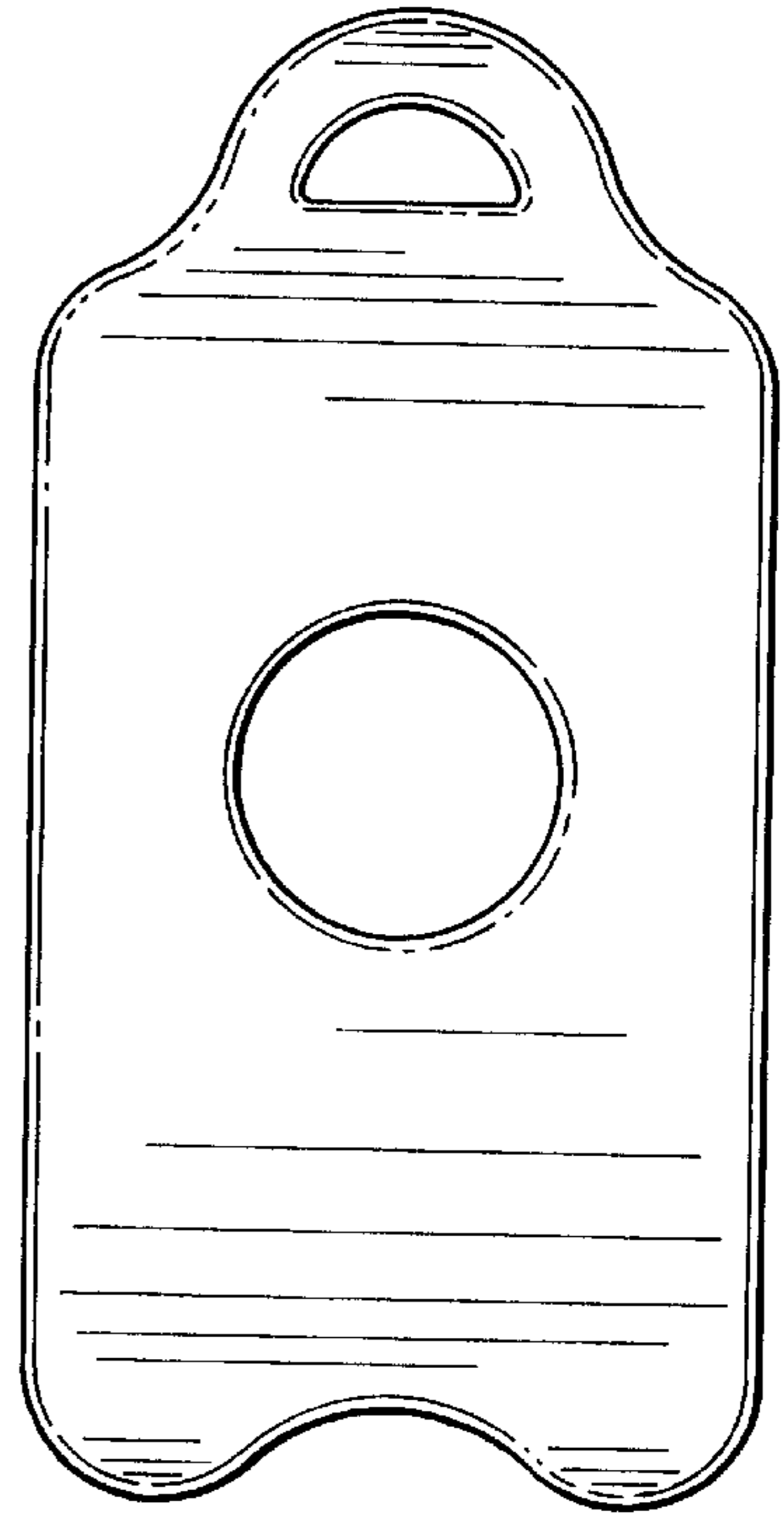
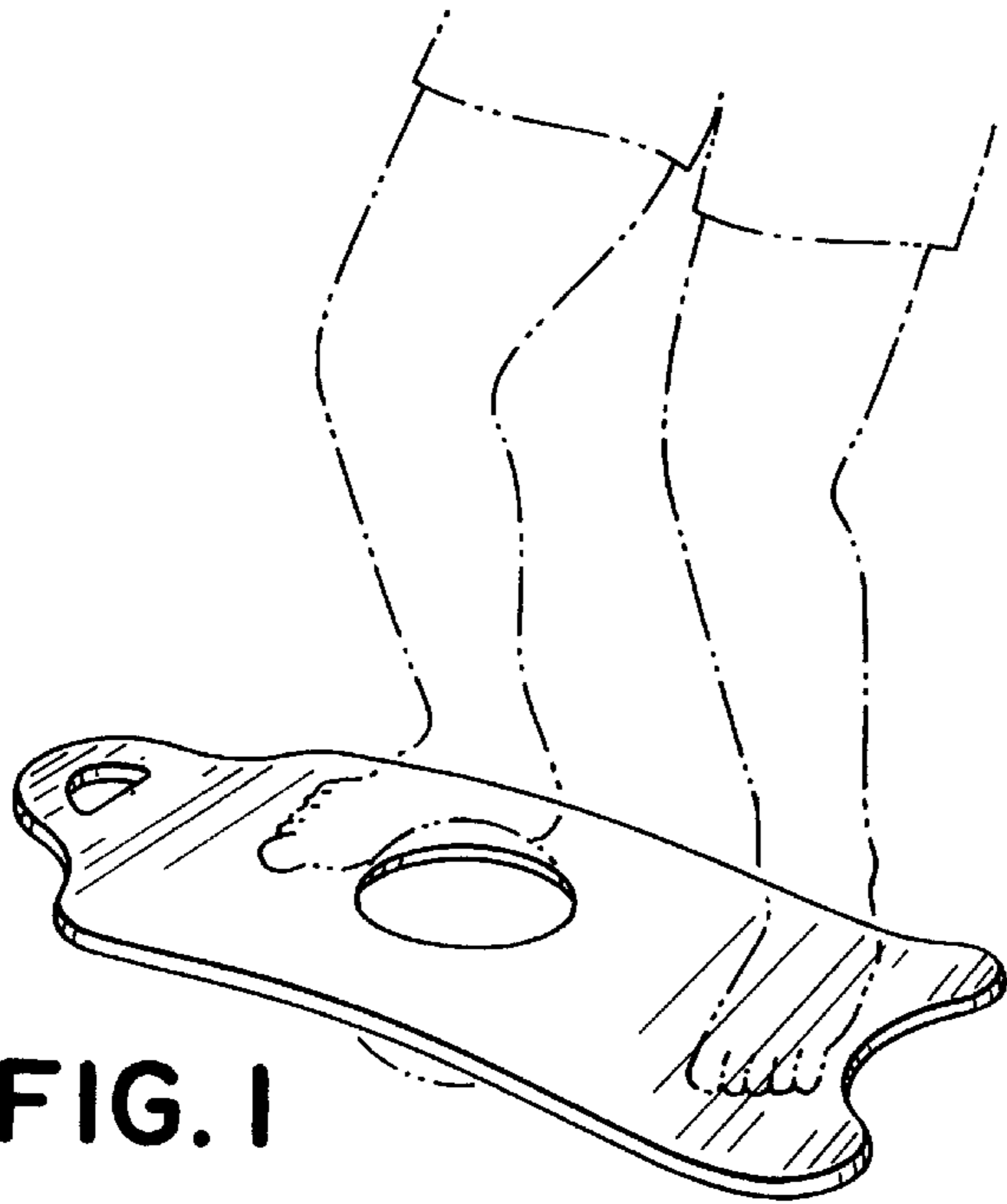

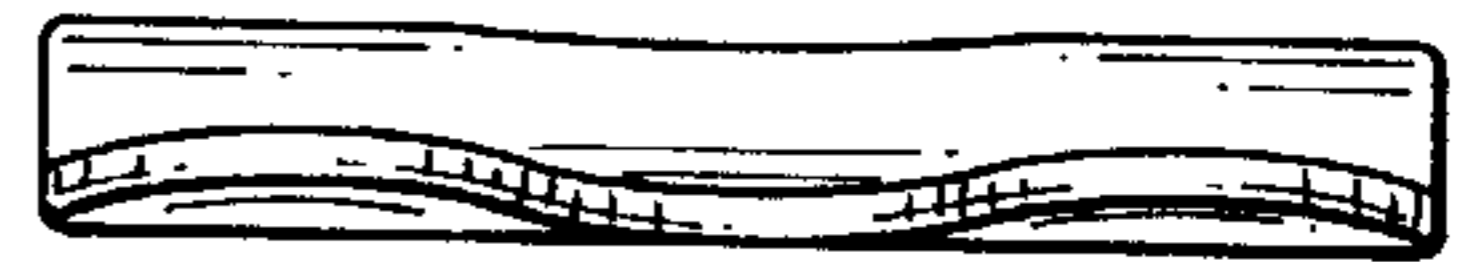

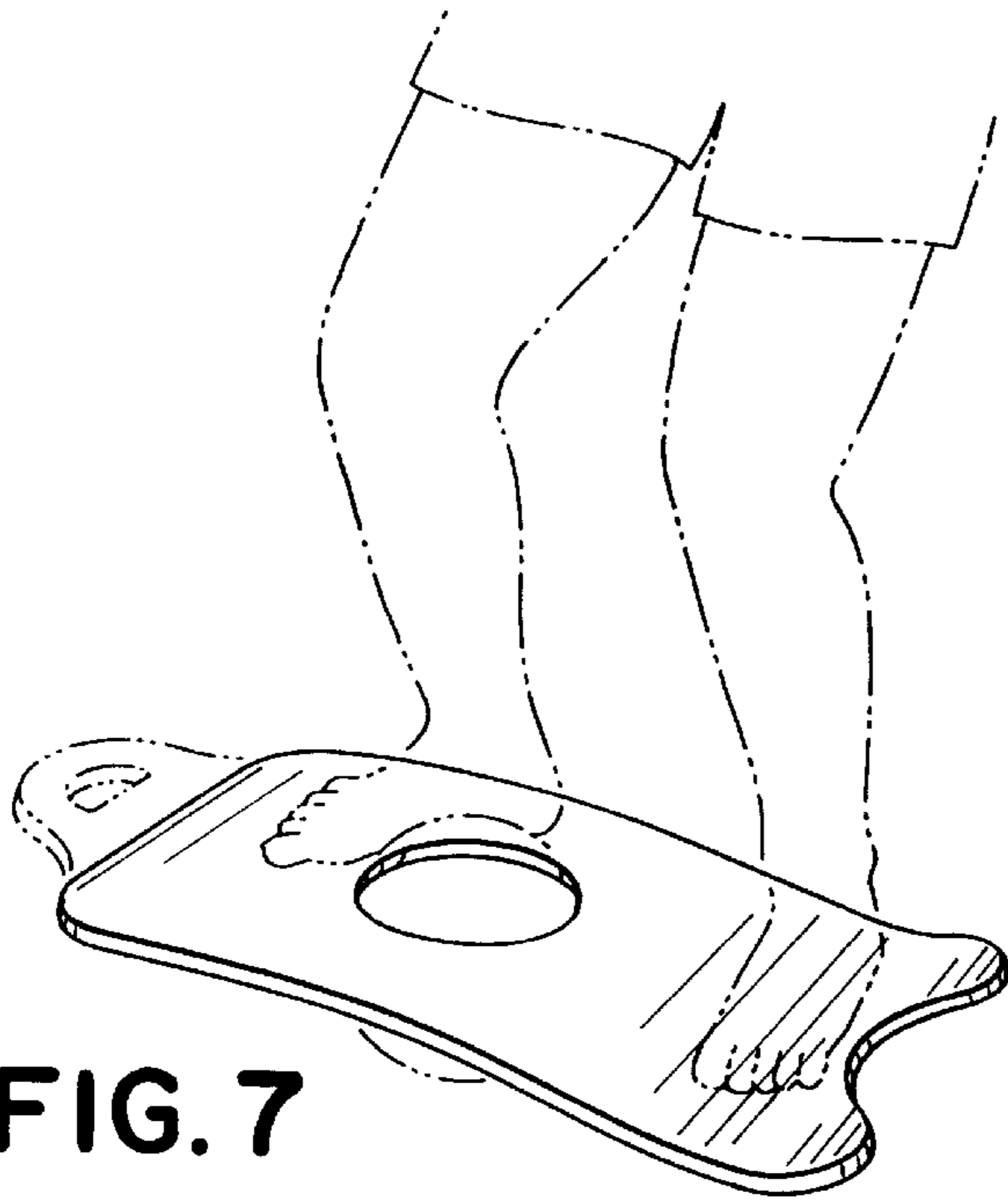

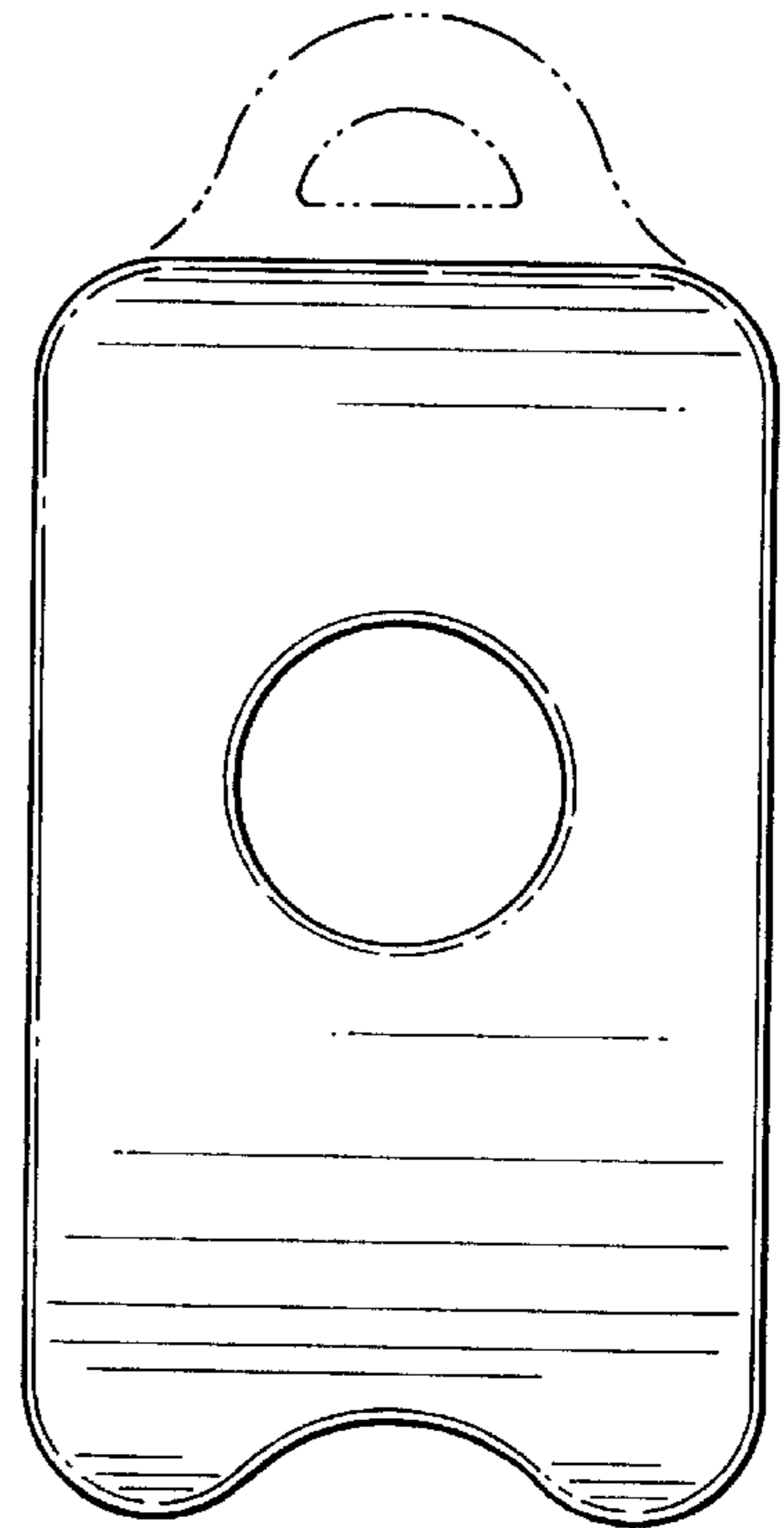

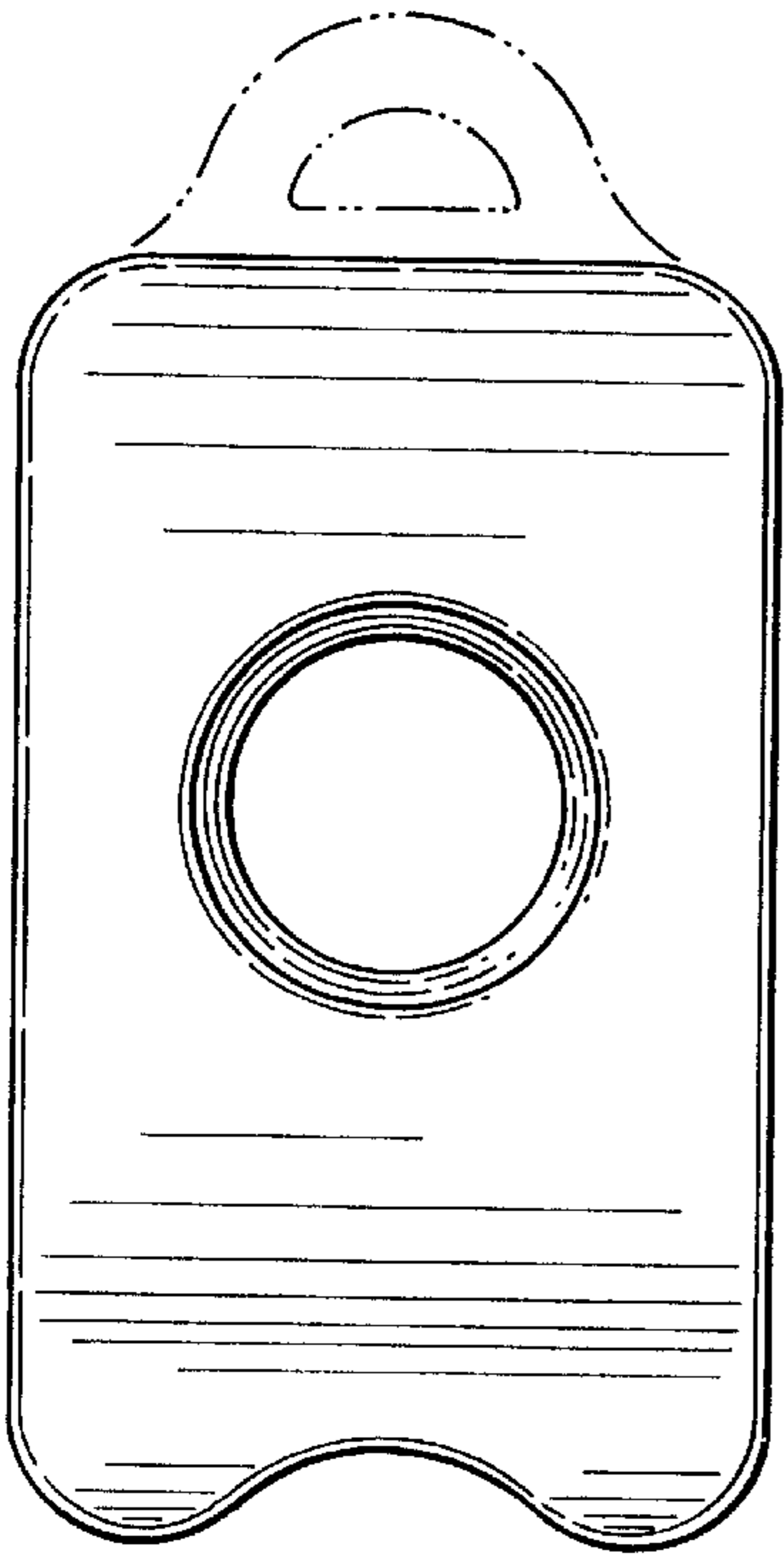

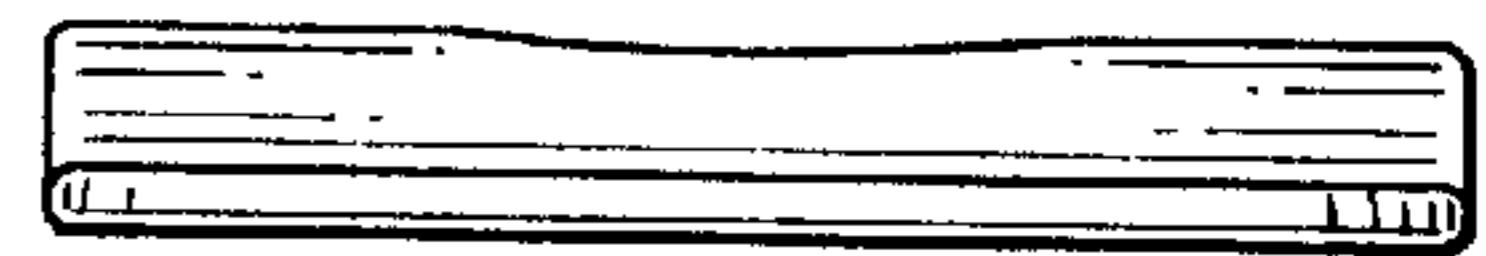

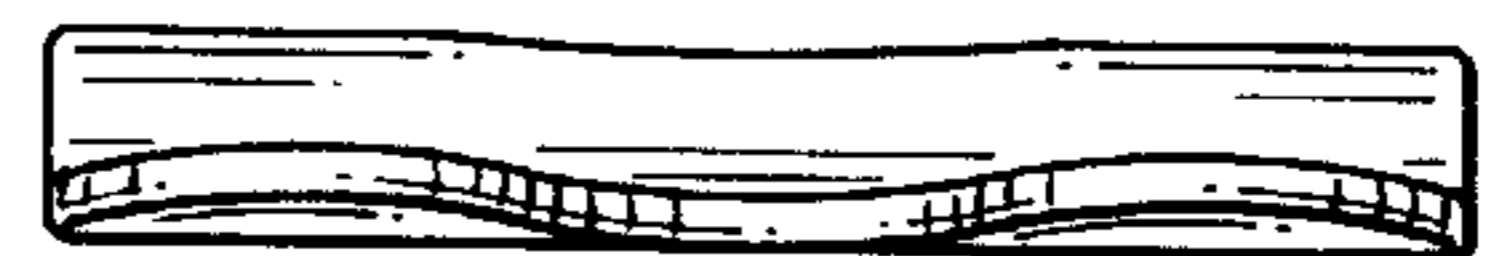
