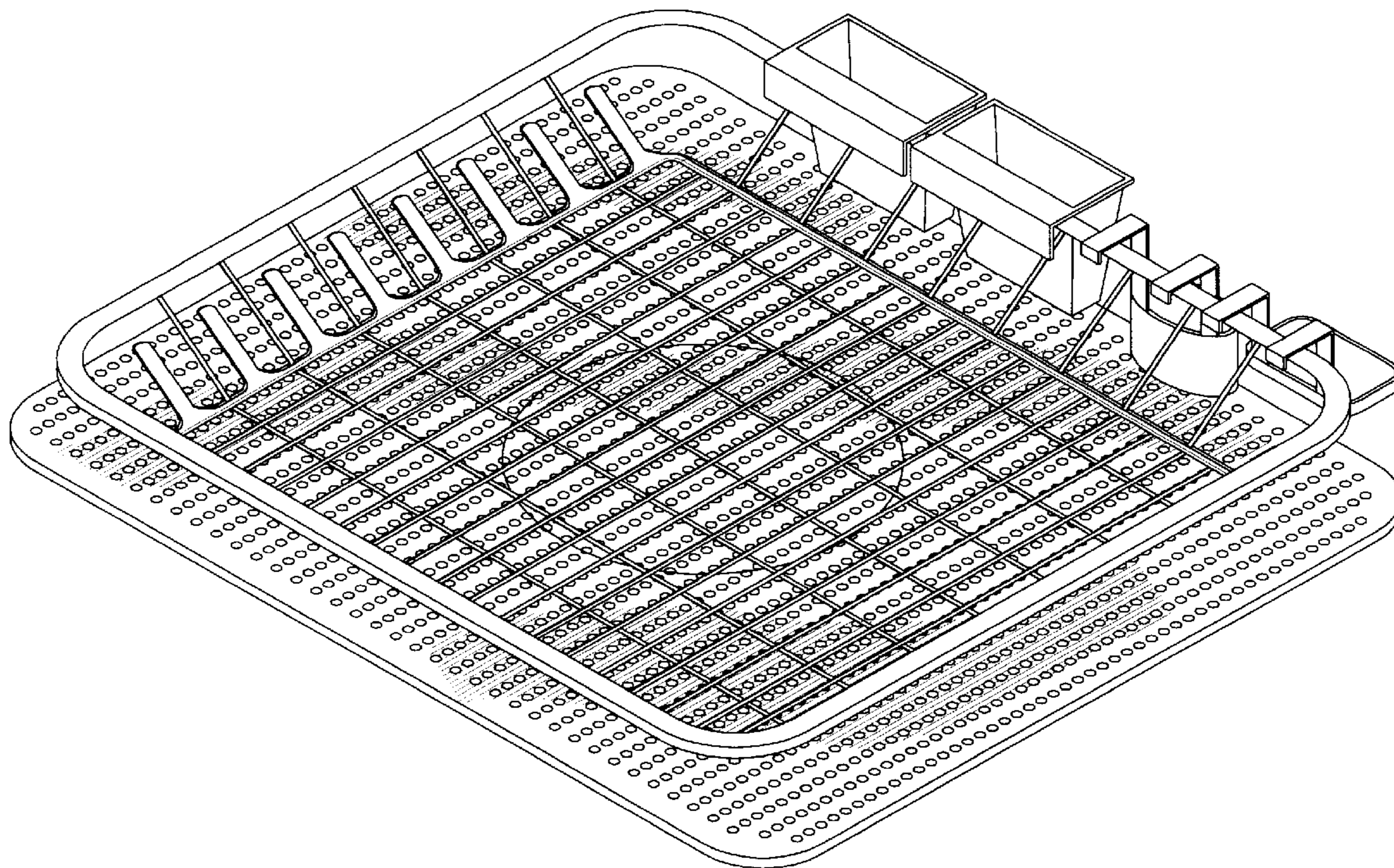
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the combination wire dish

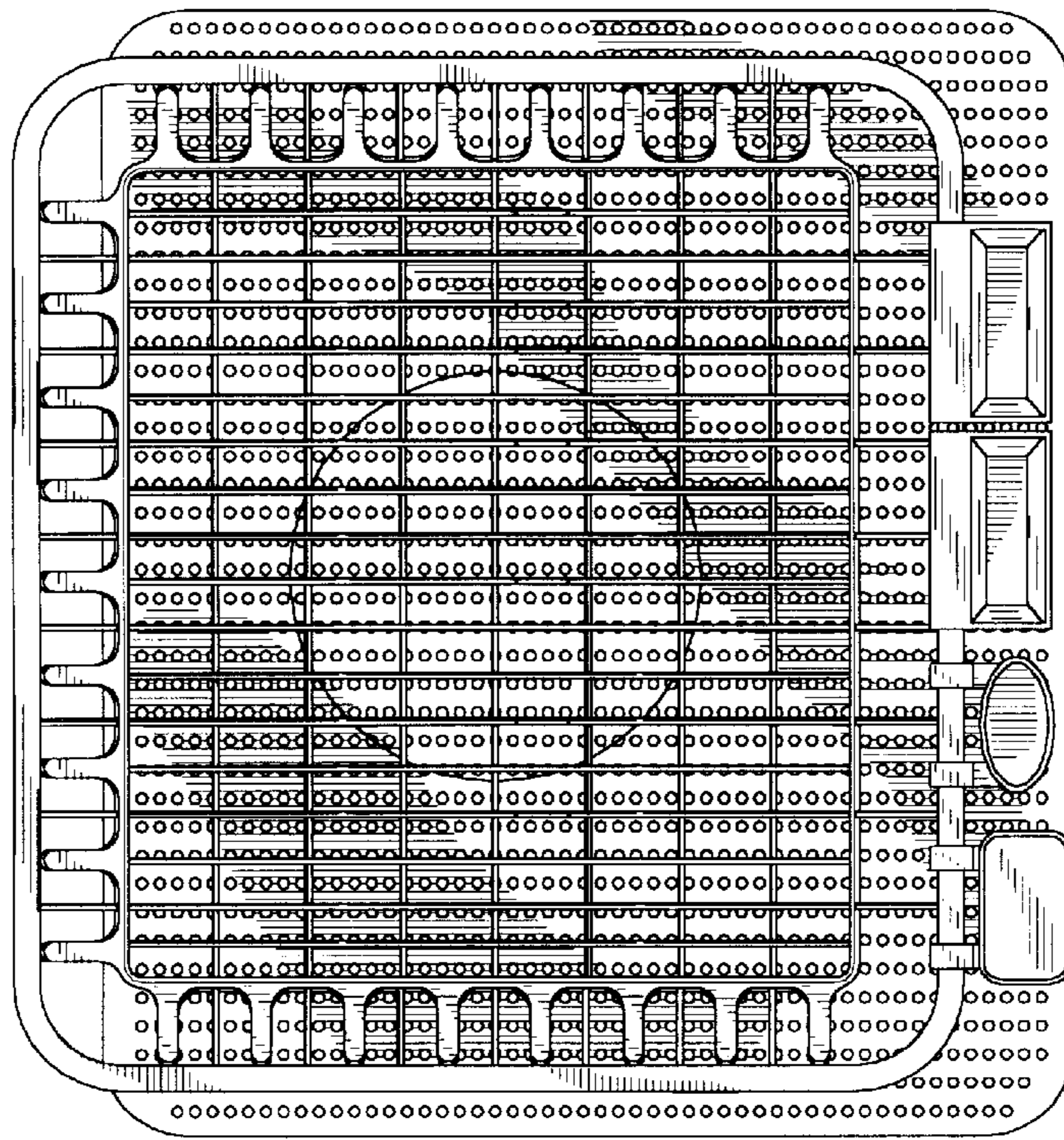

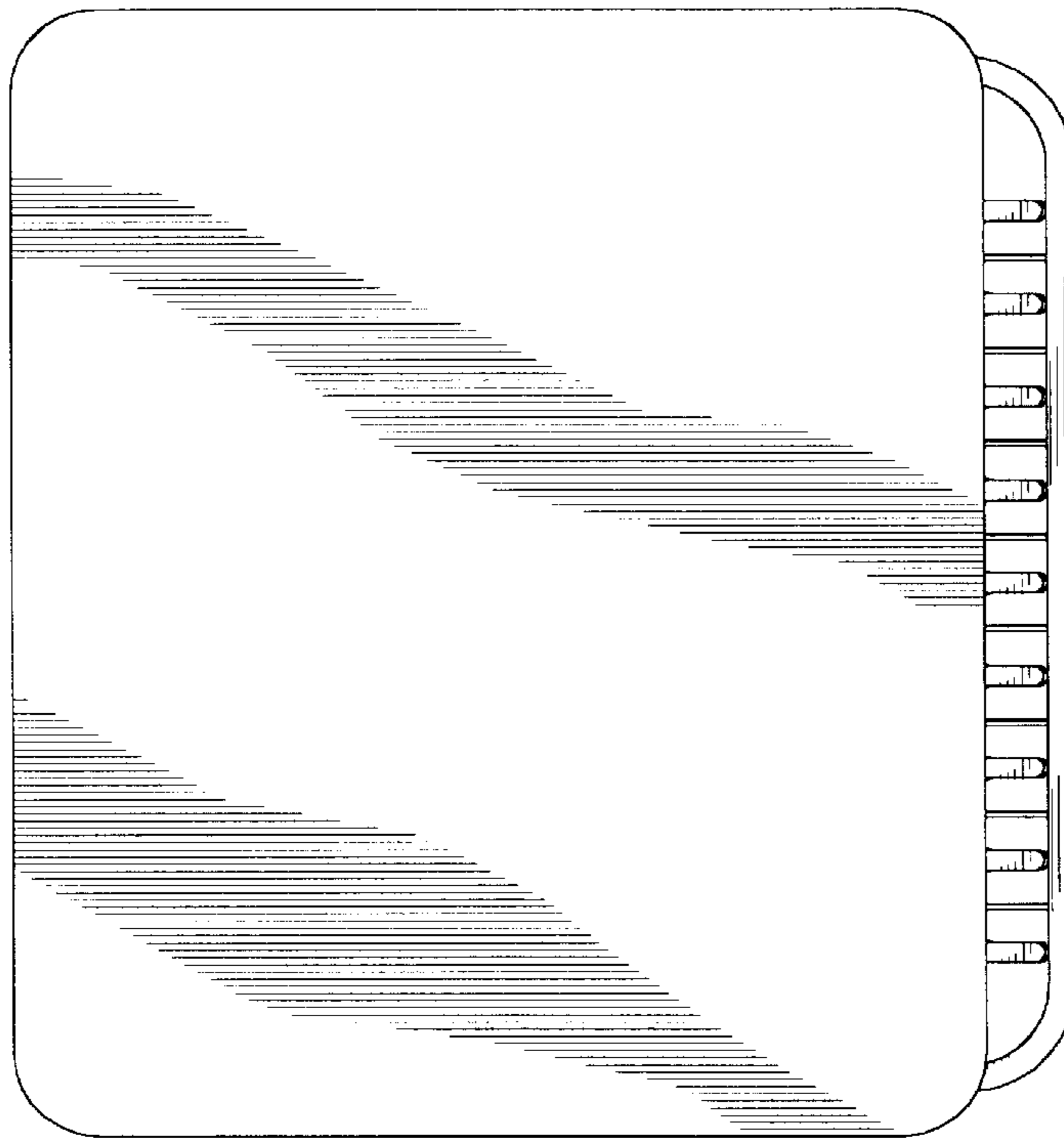

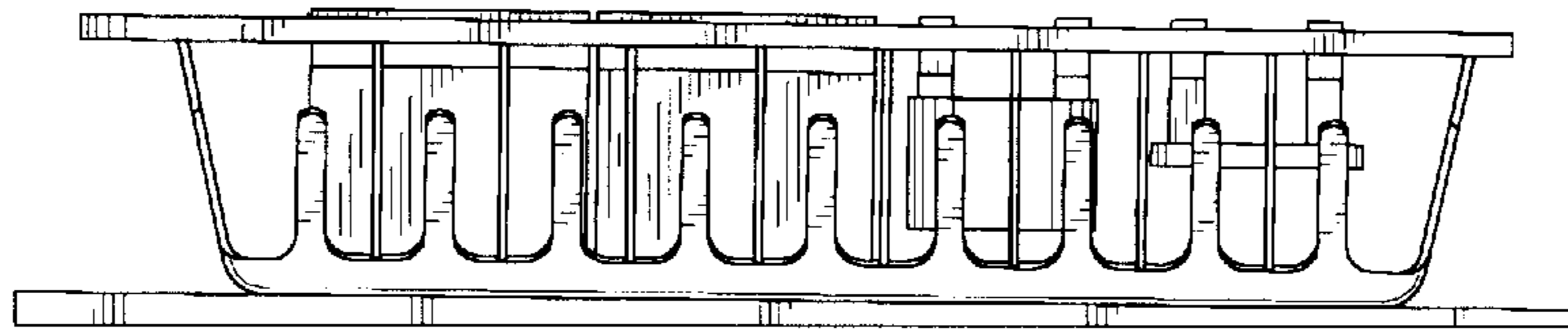

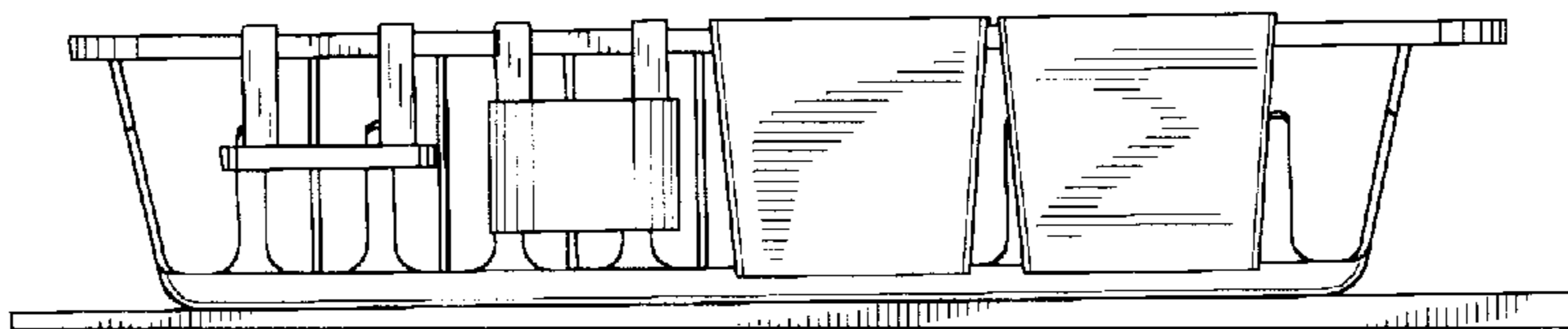

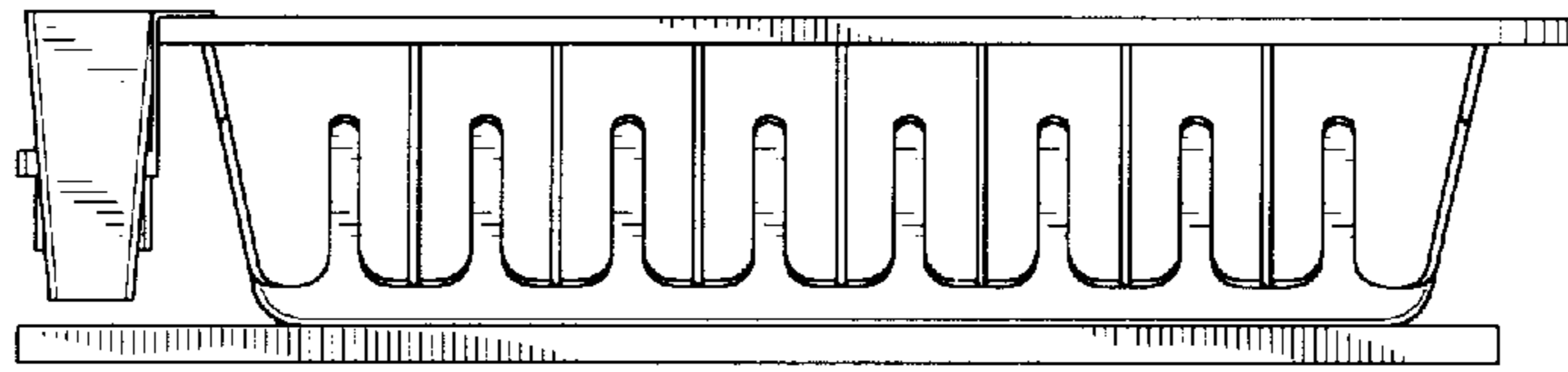

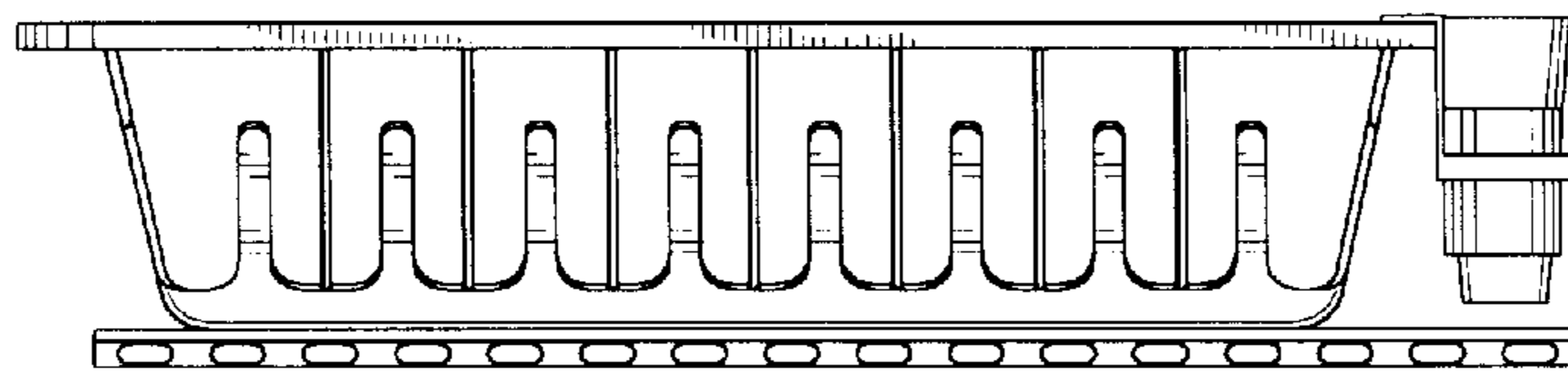

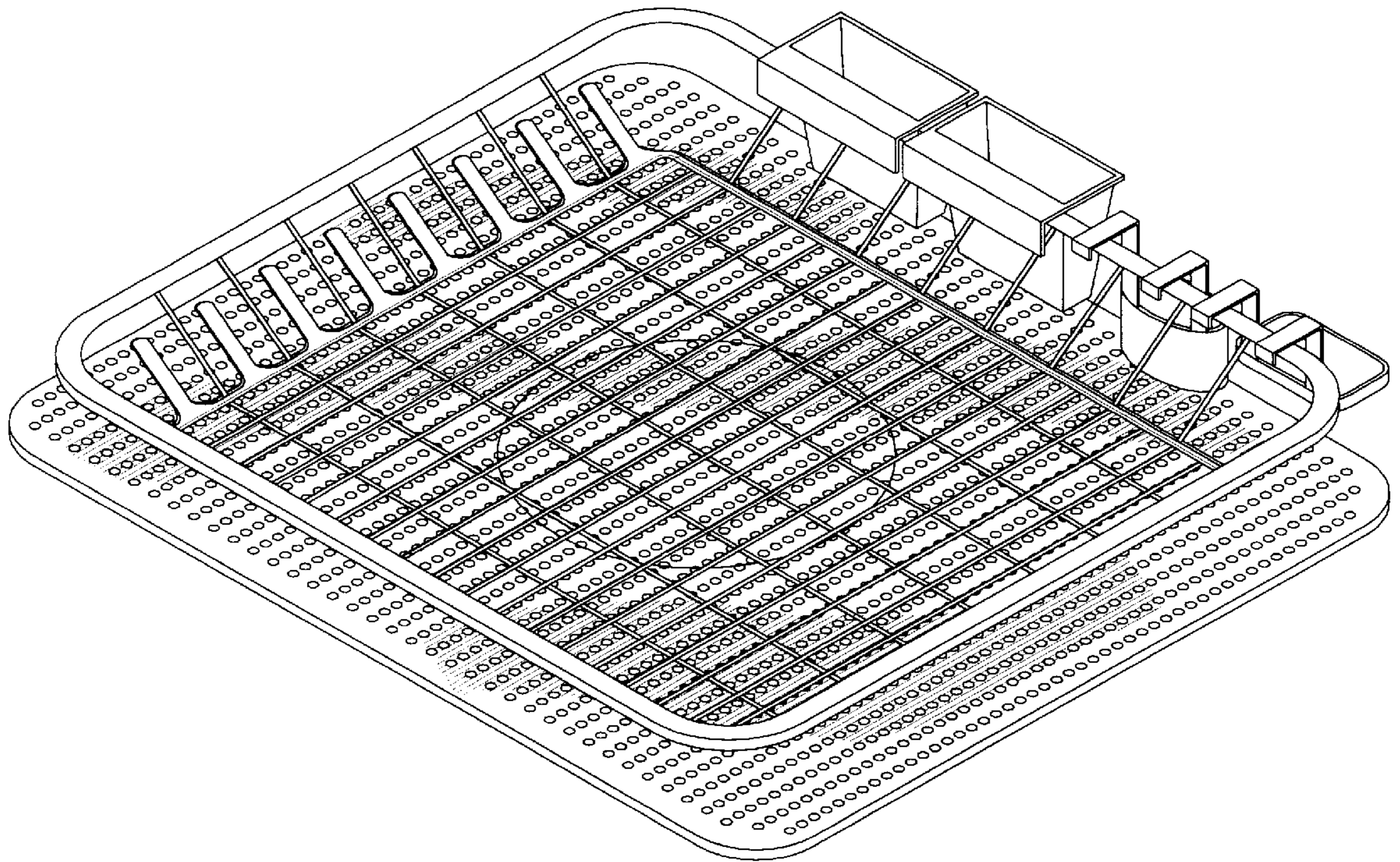
