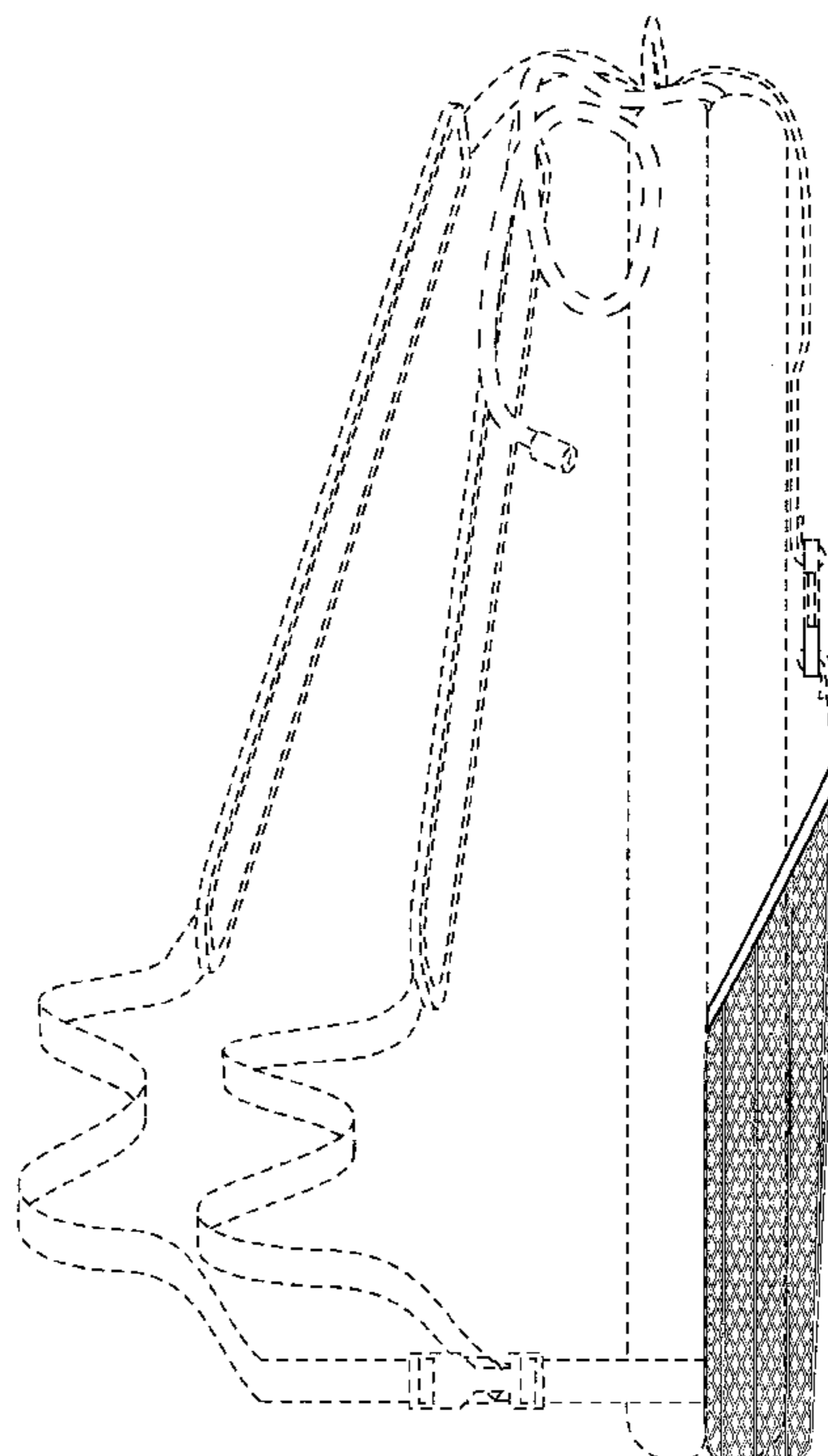
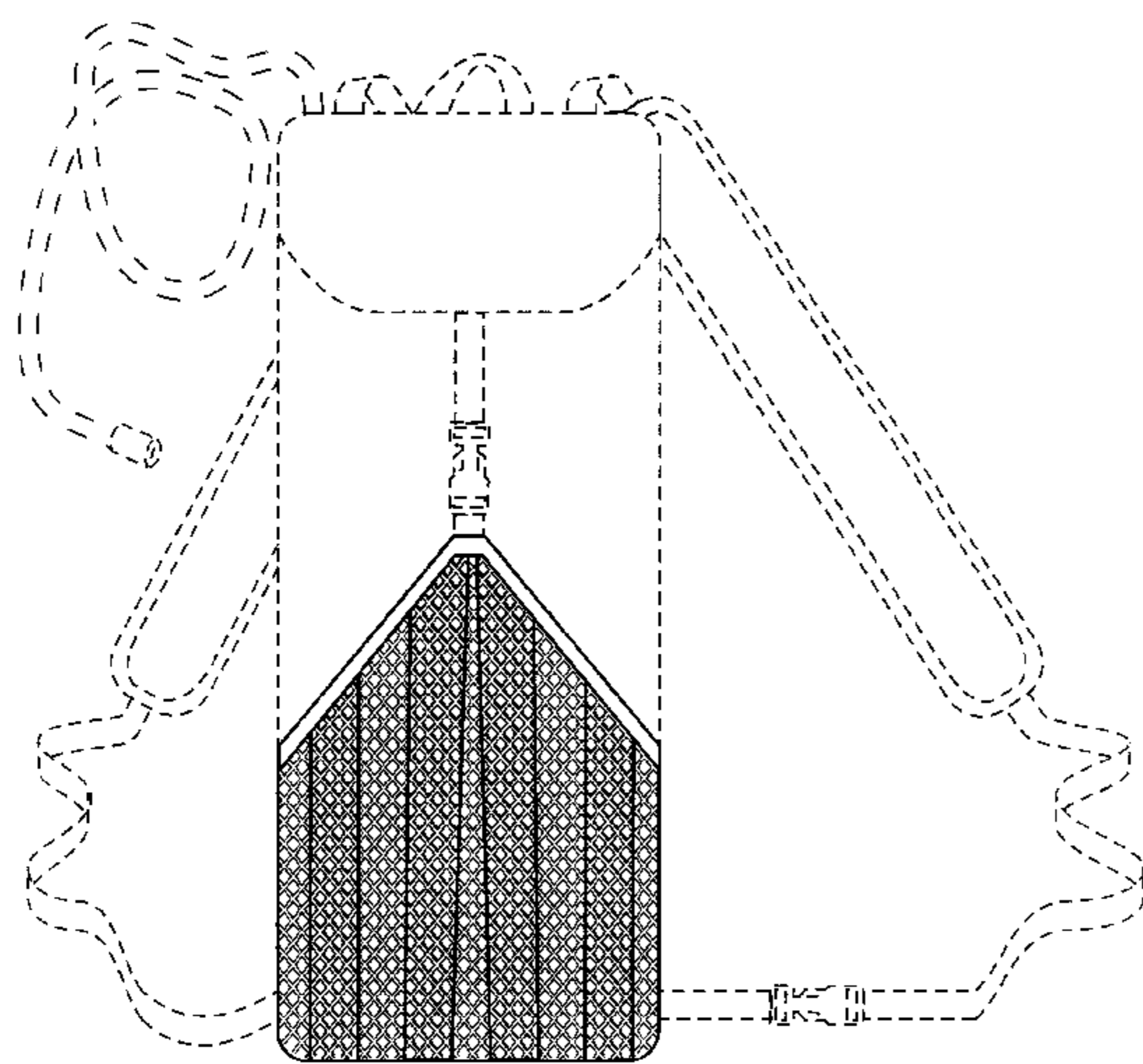
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pack with pocket, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a pack with pocket showing the preferred embodiment of my new design; FIG. 2 is an isometric view of an alternative embodiment thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the preferred embodiment shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1, similar to FIG. 3, with the broken lines removed for clarity; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the preferred embodiment shown in FIG. 1; and, FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the preferred embodiment shown in FIG. 1, with the right side elevation view being a mirror image of FIG. 6. The broken lines shown in the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claim.

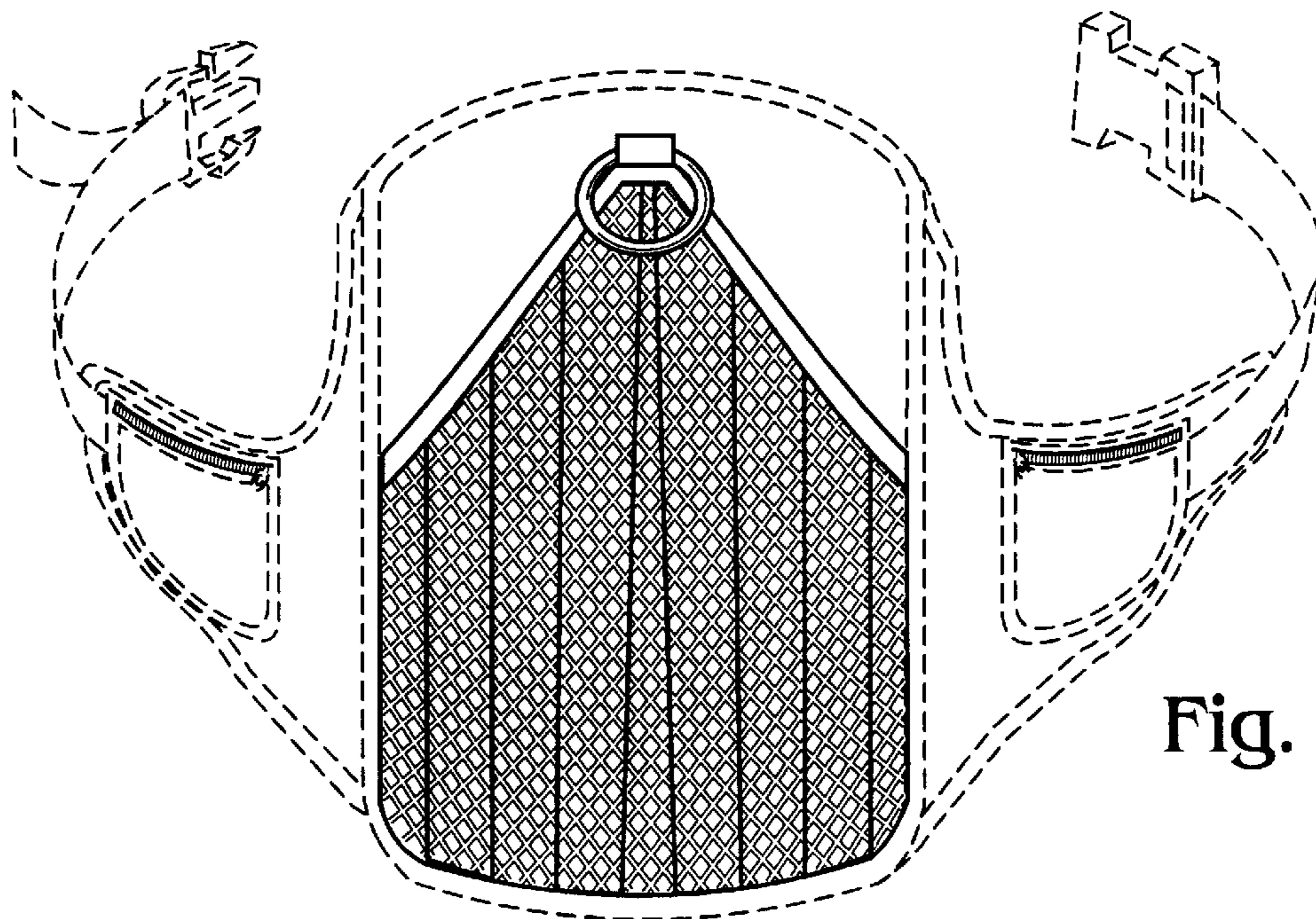
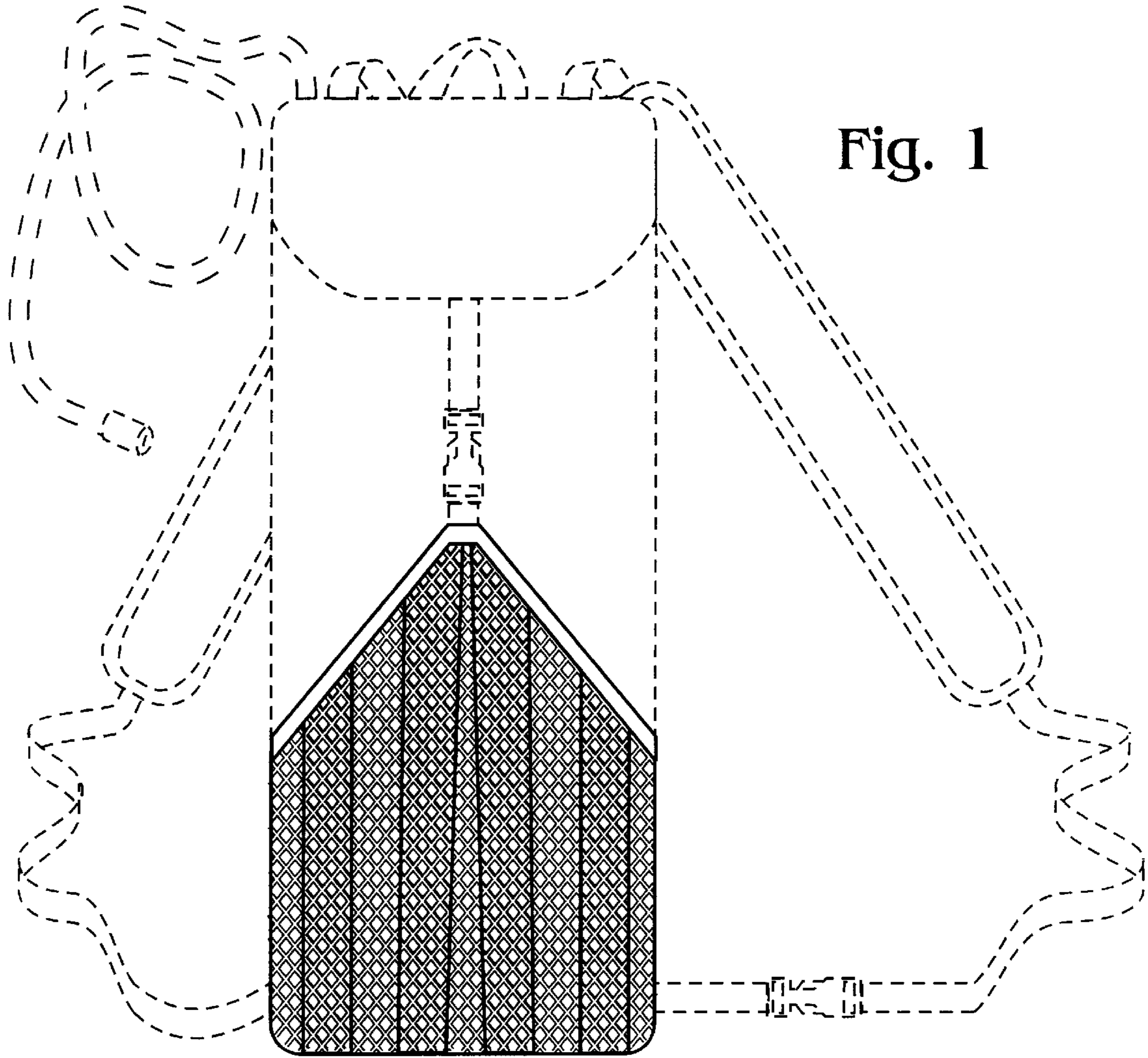

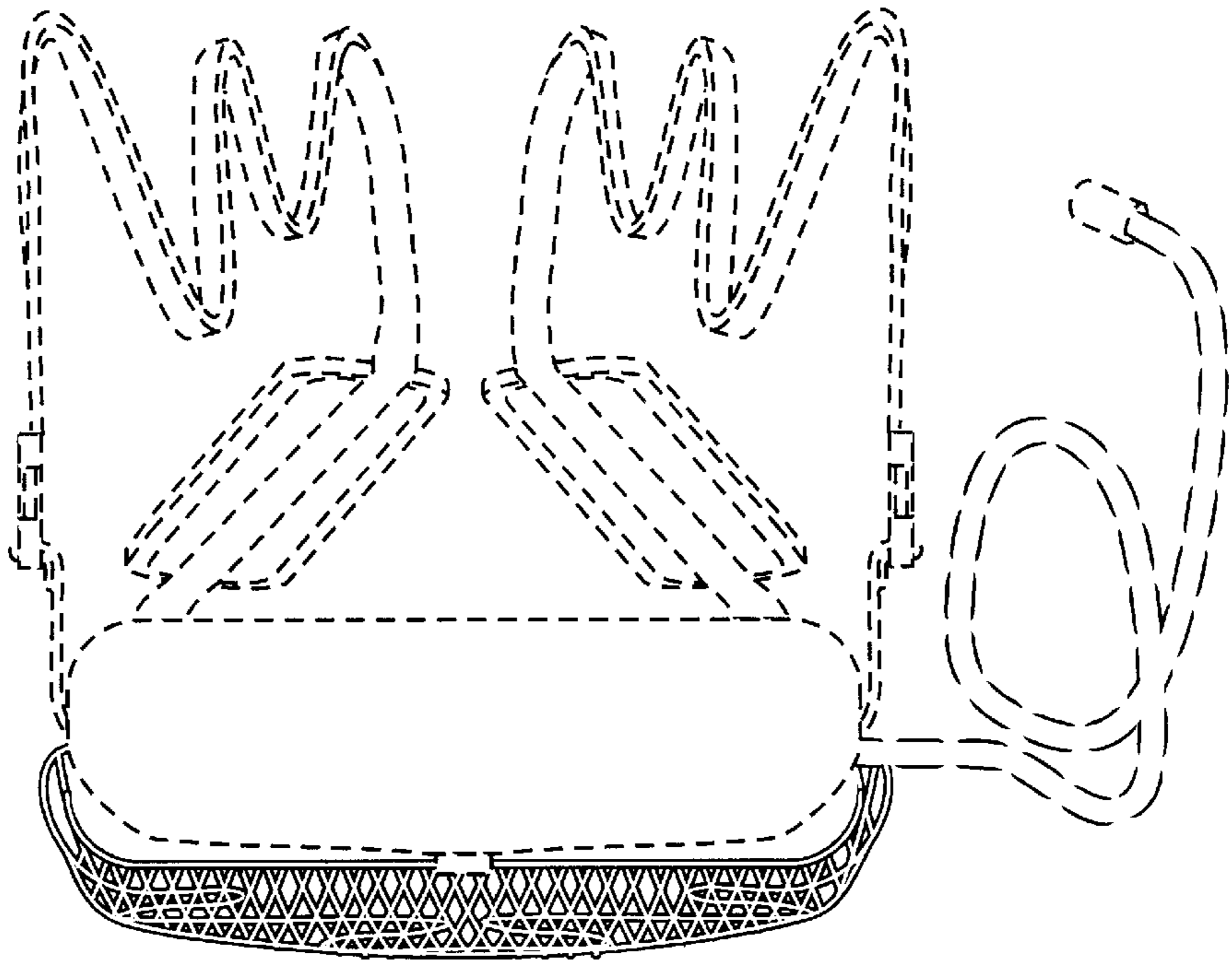

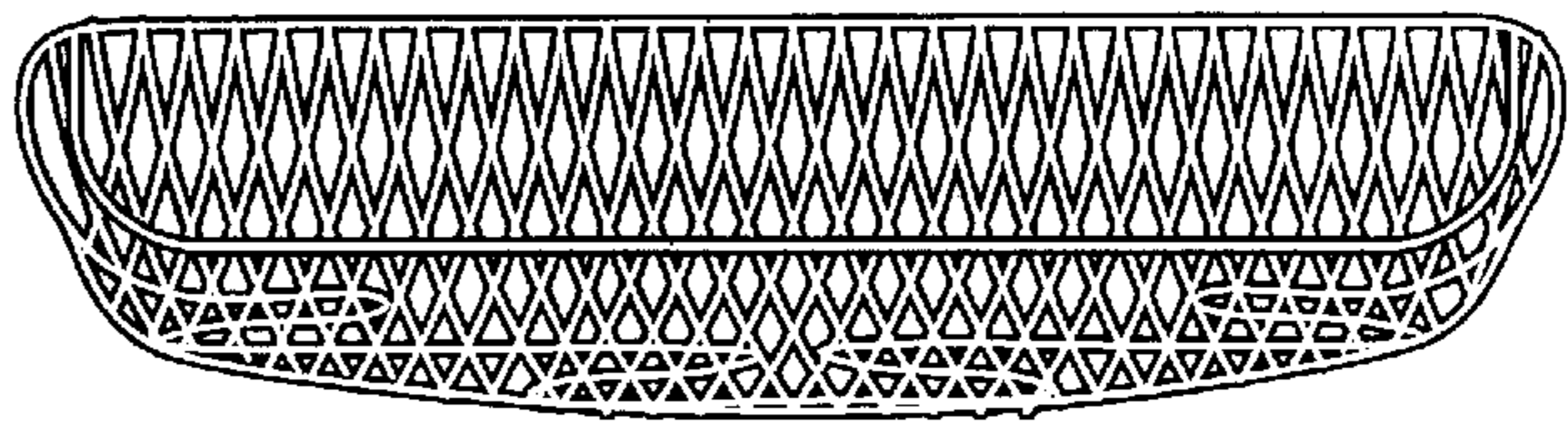

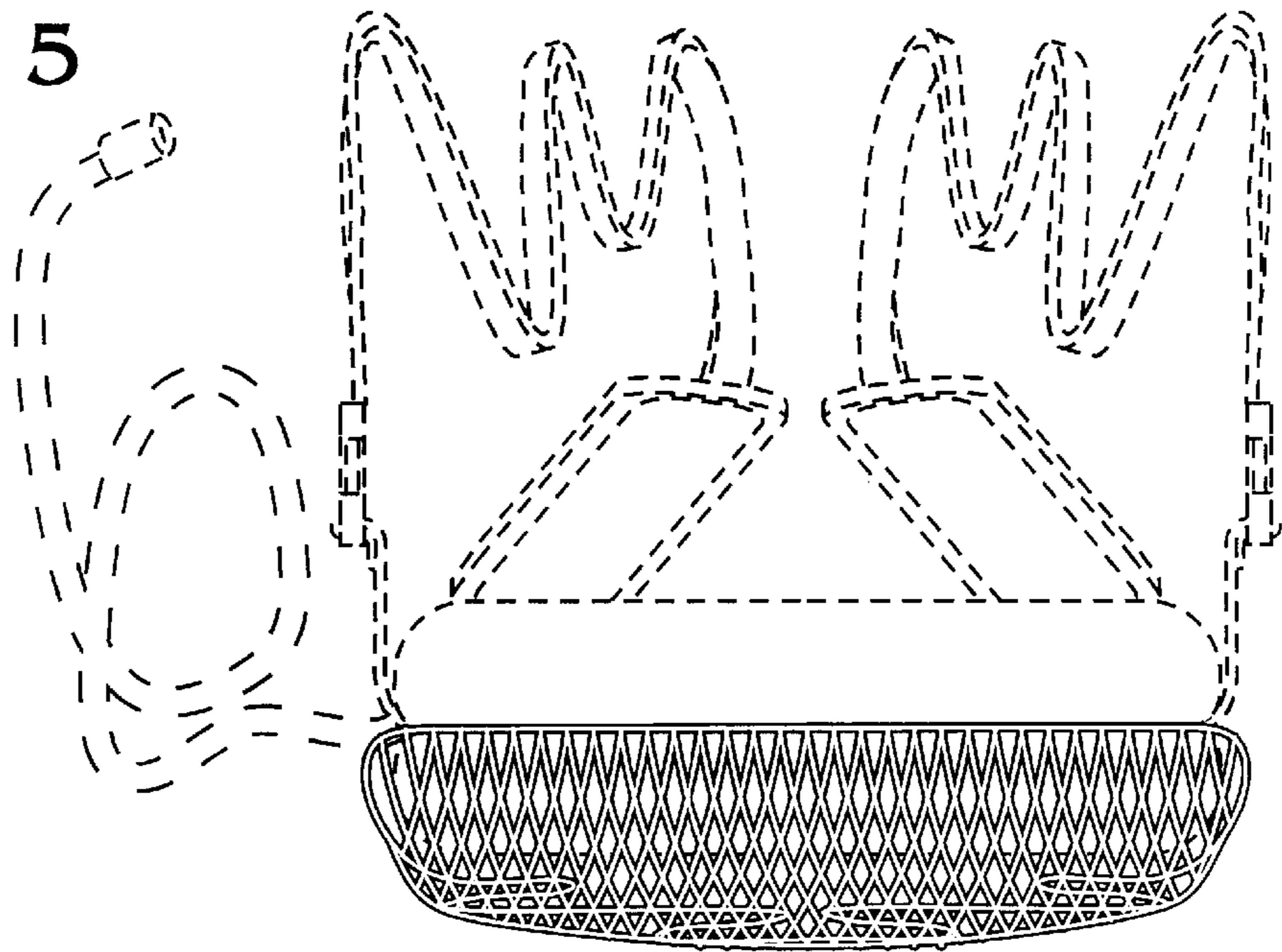
