[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a paper product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The sole FIGURE is a top plan view of a paper product; and, The product embodied by the attached drawing is a single-ply product.

The three rows of dashed lines within the lined perimeter of the paper product form part of the claimed design. The bottom surface of the paper product forms no part of the claimed design. The sides of the paper product have no substantial thickness.
