DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first side elevational view of a cutlery handle showing my new design and showing a knife blade in broken line, this broken line element is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a second side elevational view of the cutlery handle, showing a knife blade in broken line, this broken line element is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 3 is a third side elevational view of the cutlery handle, showing a knife blade in broken line, this broken line element is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 4 is a fourth side elevational view of the cutlery handle, showing a knife blade in broken line, this broken line element is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;


FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the cutlery handle, showing a portion of a knife blade in broken line, and broken away, this broken line element is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the cutlery handle; and,

While a dotted outline of a knife blade is shown, it is to be understood that other forms of flatware could be provided.













