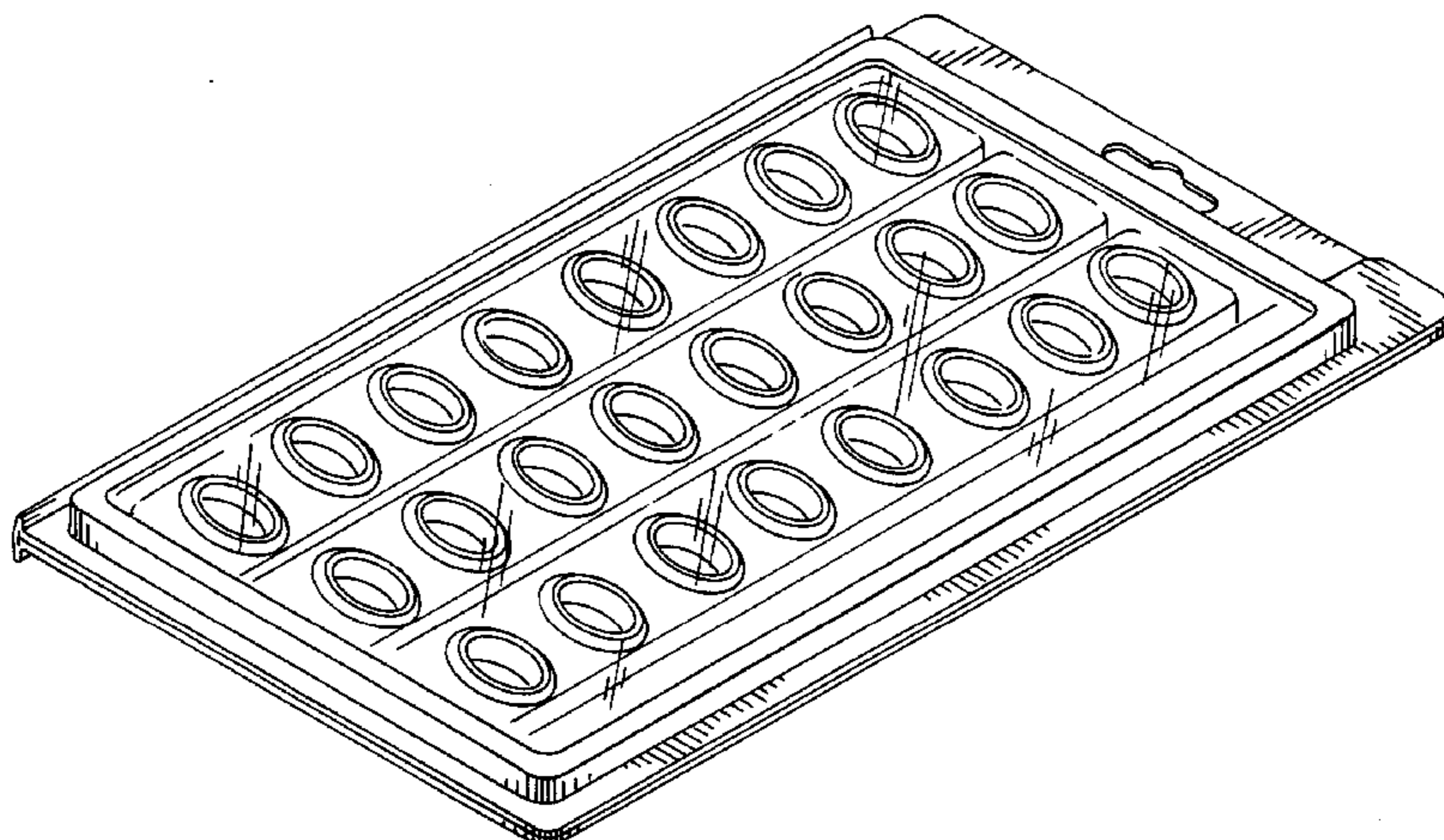
## [57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for package for paint, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the package for paint with the lid in the closed position;  
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof with the lid in the open position;  
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof with the lid in the closed position;  
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof with the lid in the open position;  
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a front view thereof;  
FIG. 8 is a rear view thereof; and,  
FIG. 9 is a bottom view thereof.

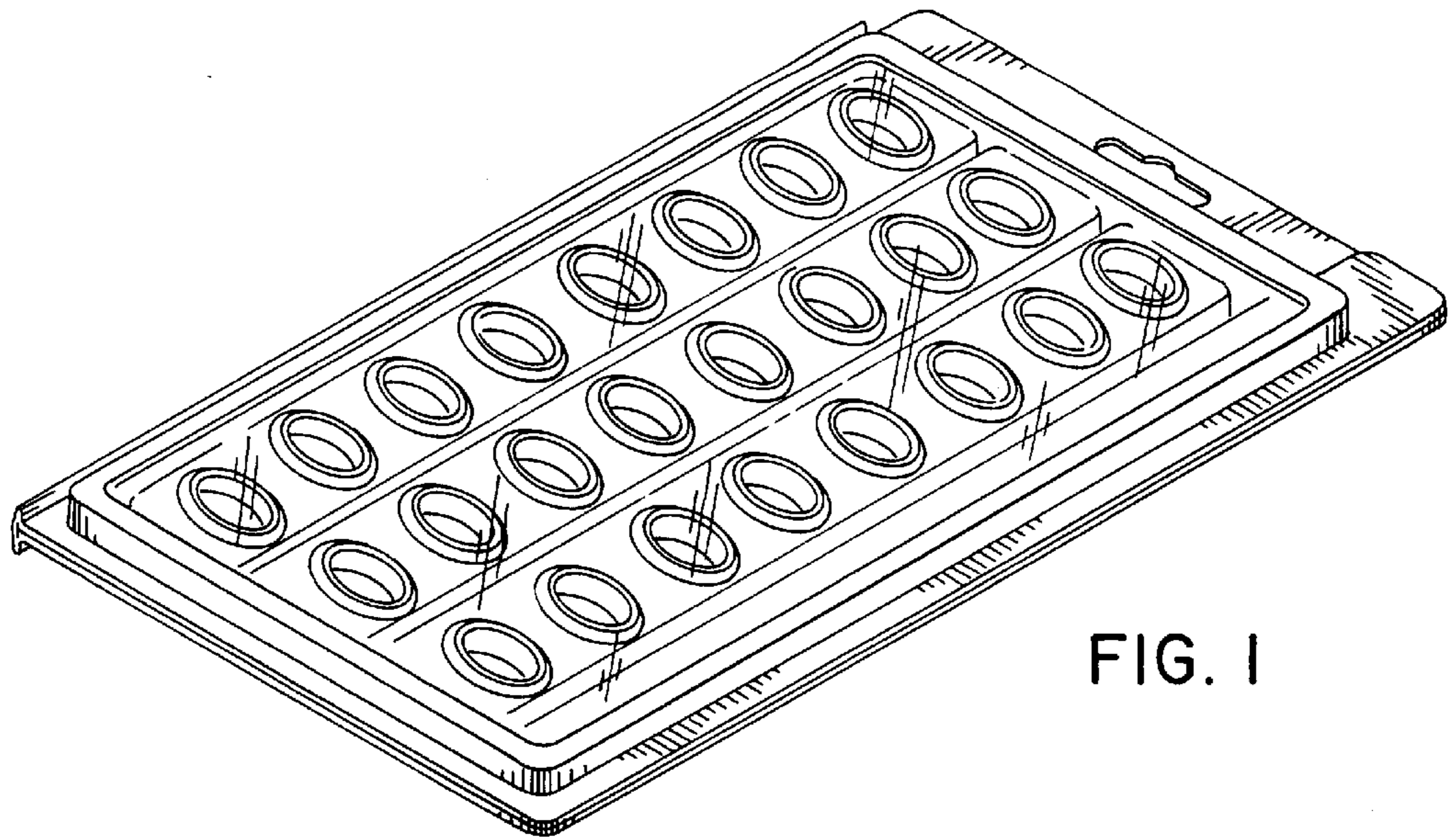

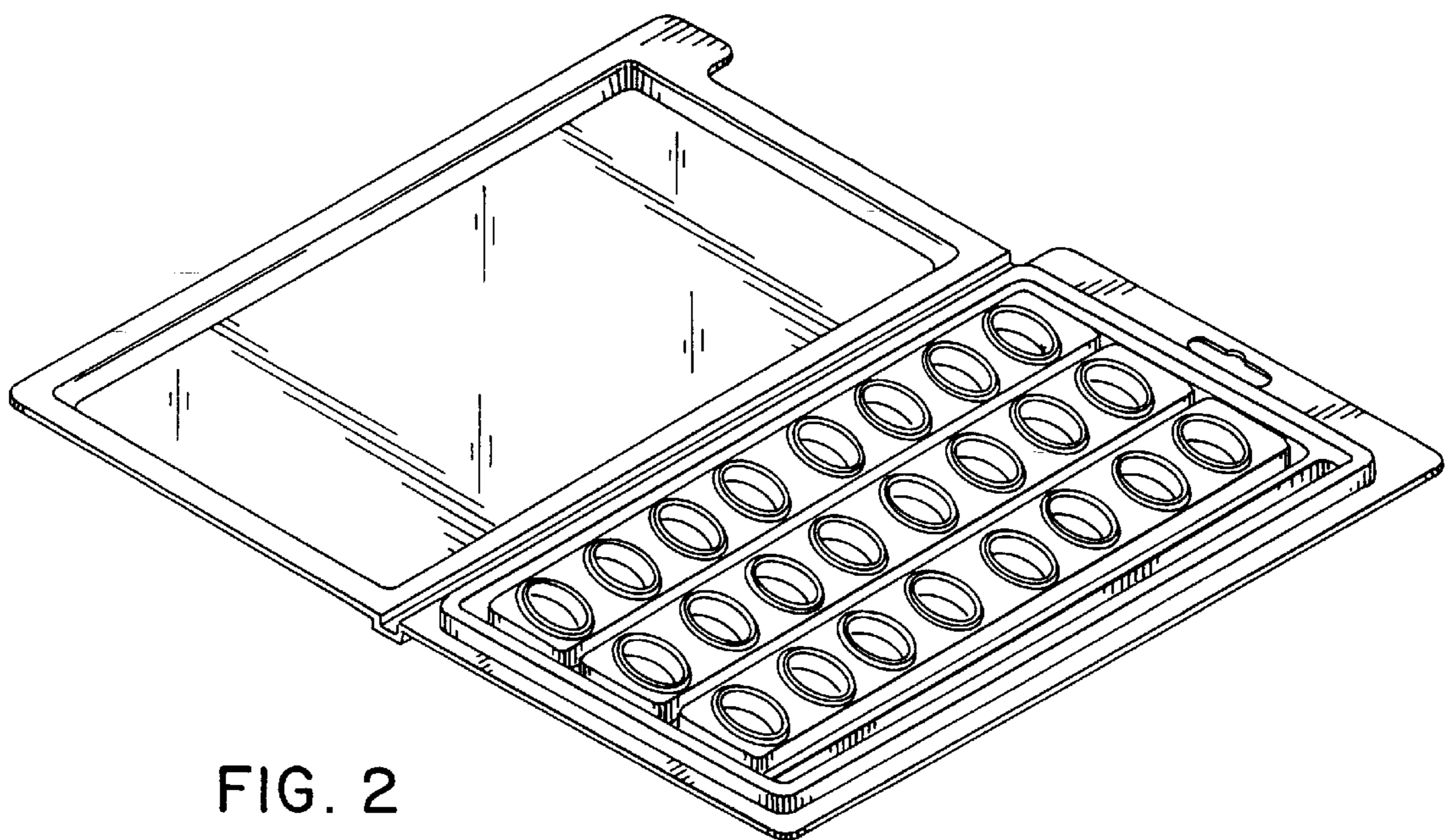

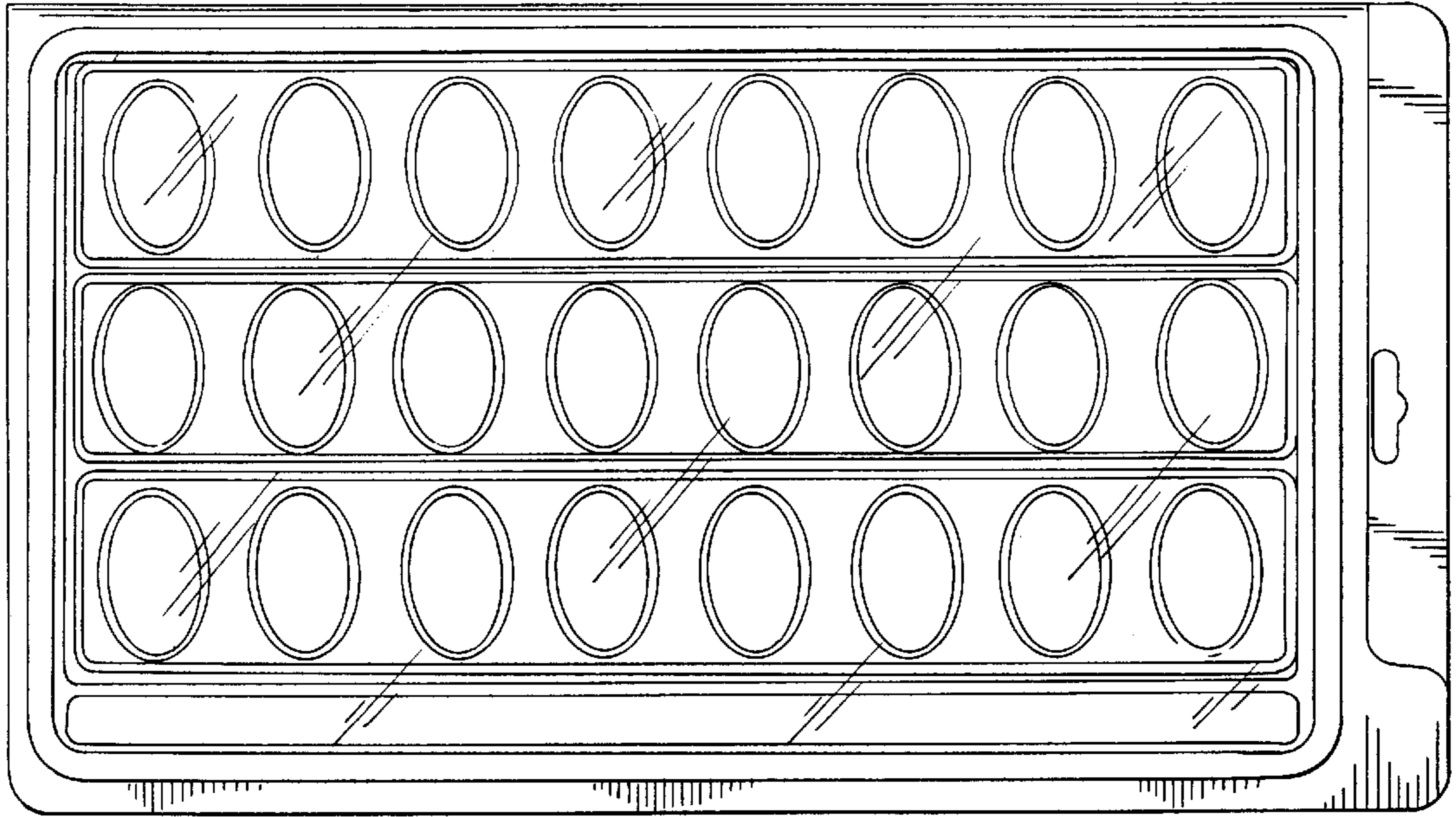

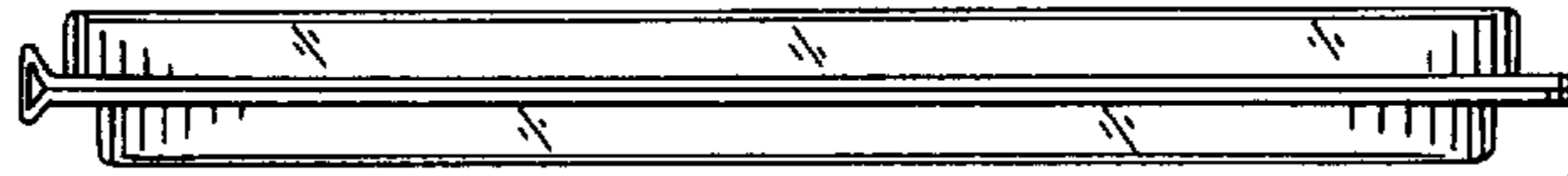

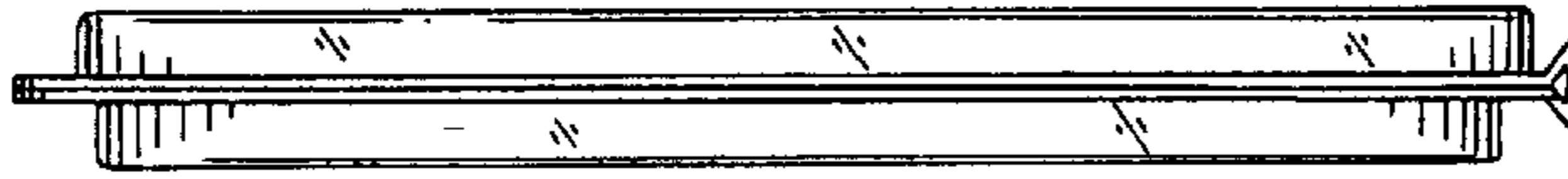

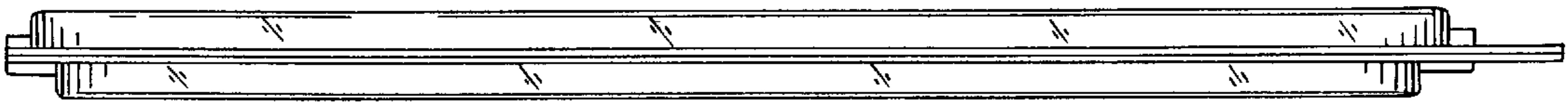
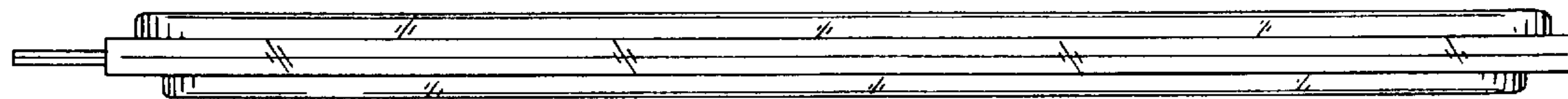

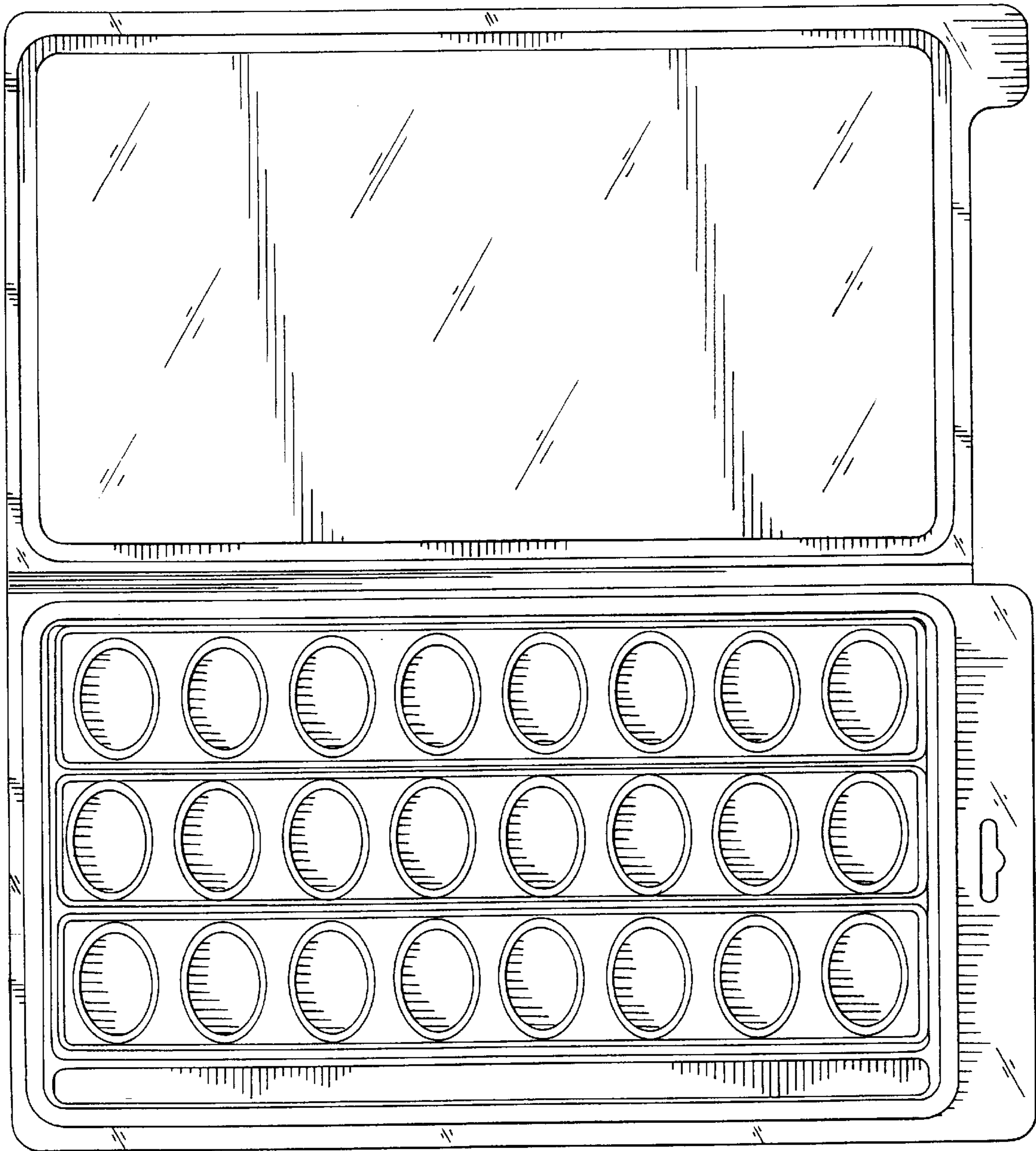

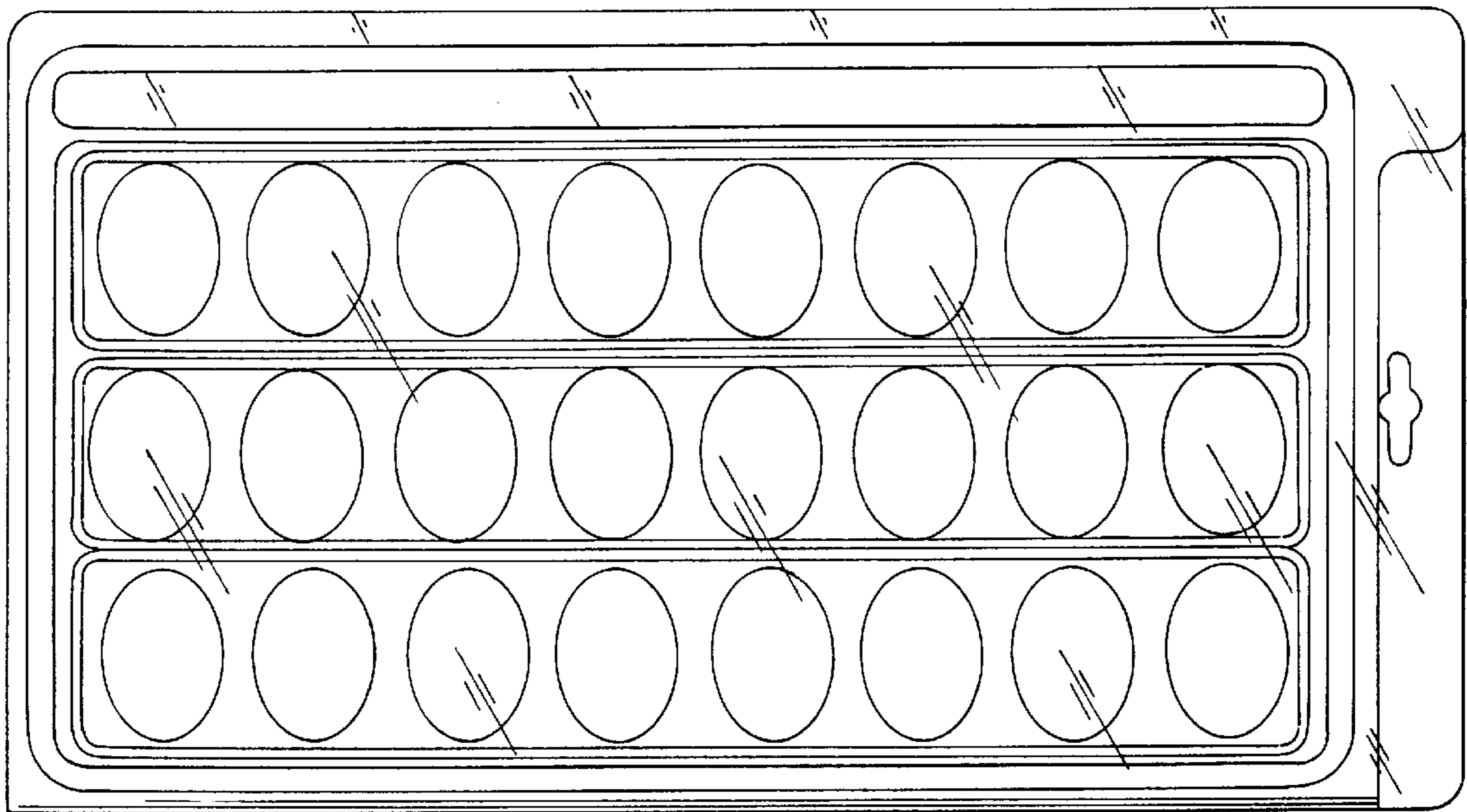
