The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

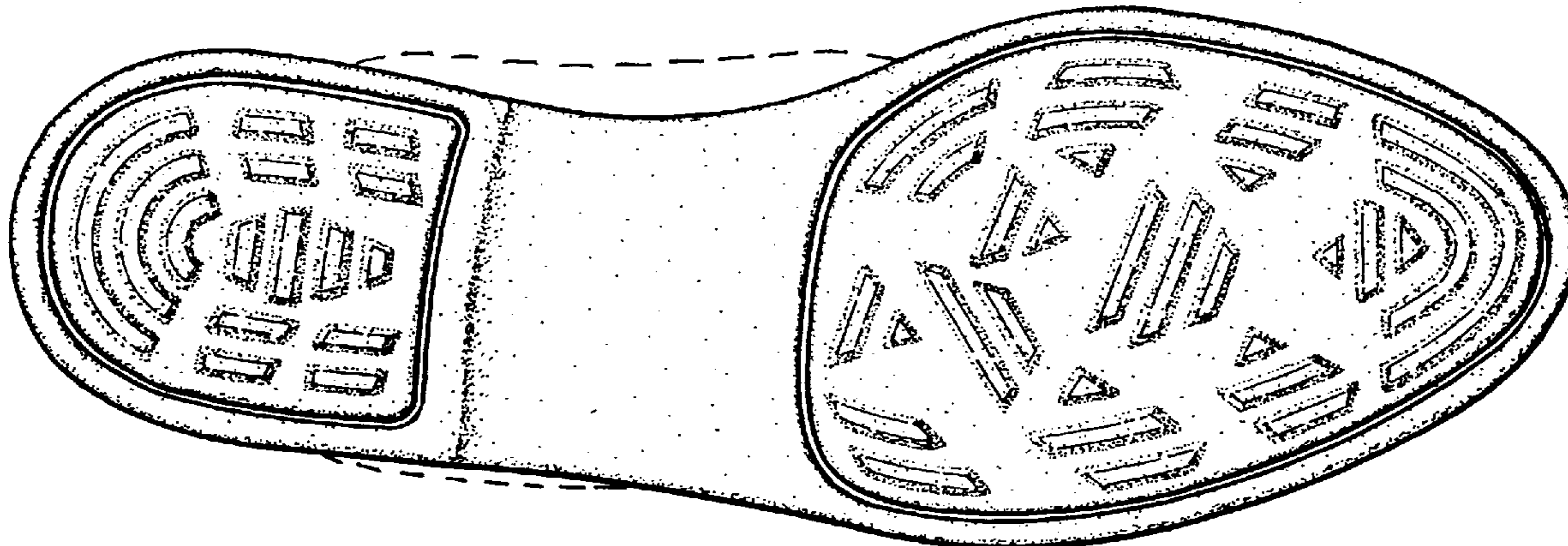
DESCRIPTION

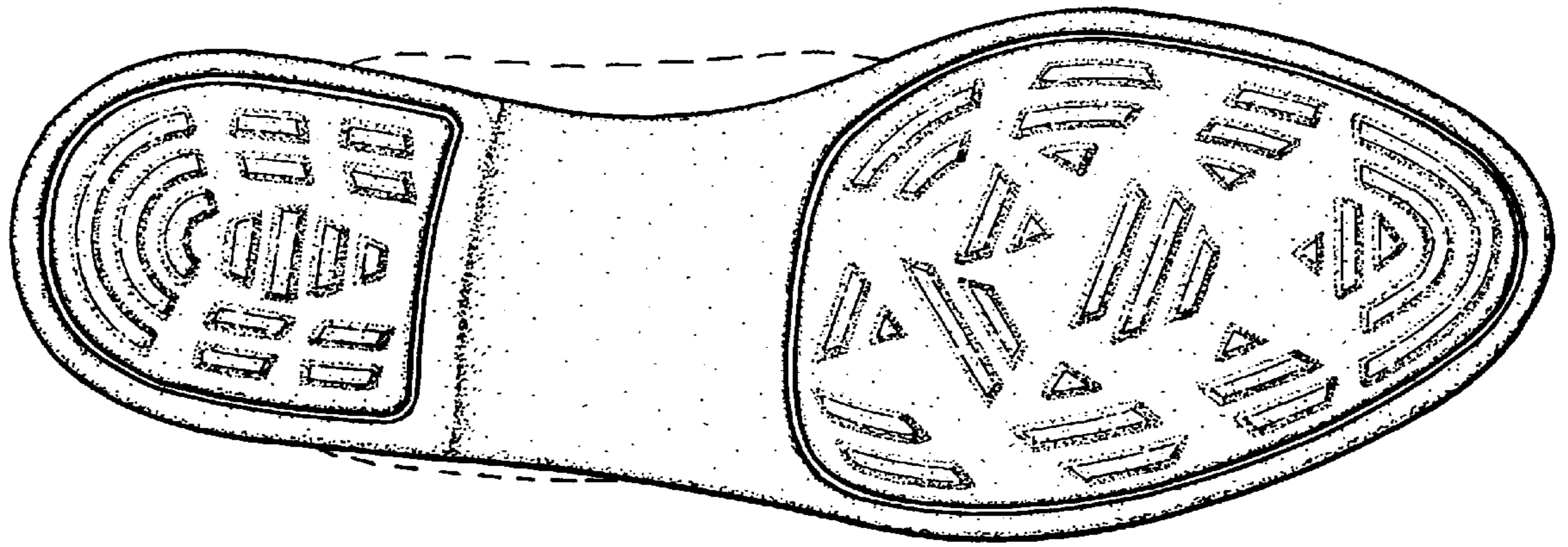

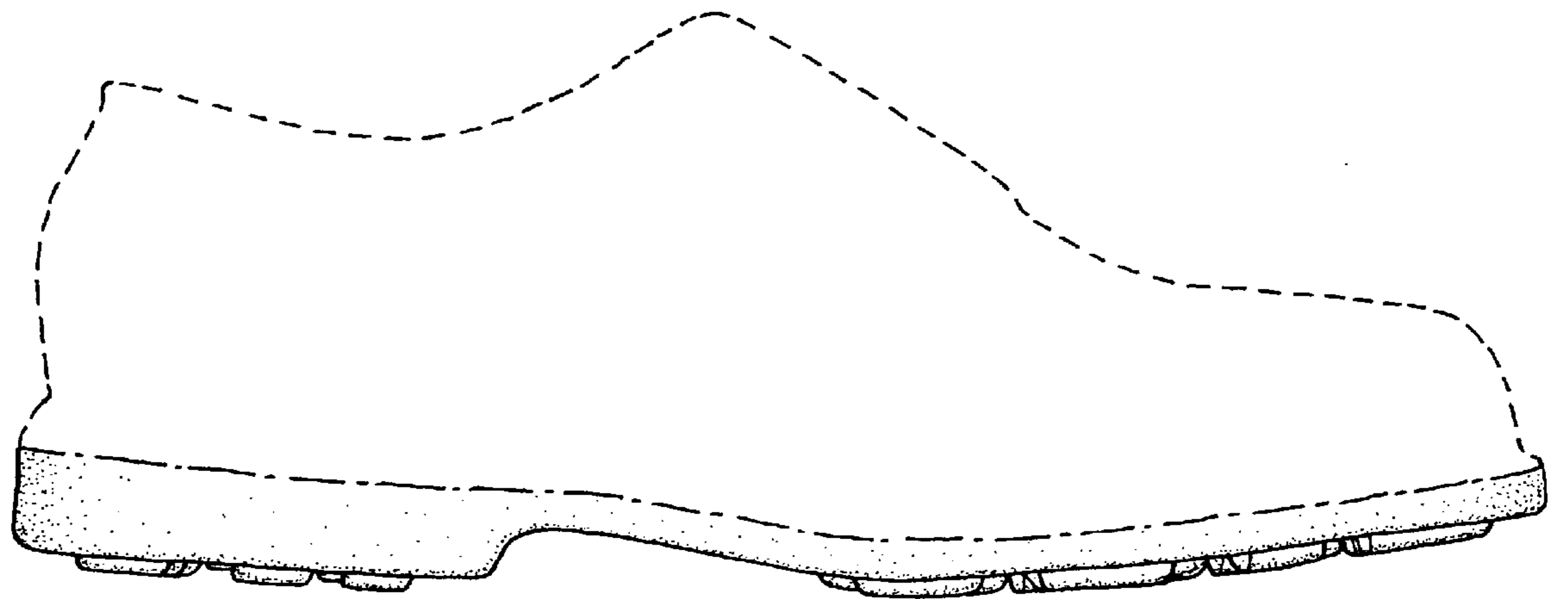

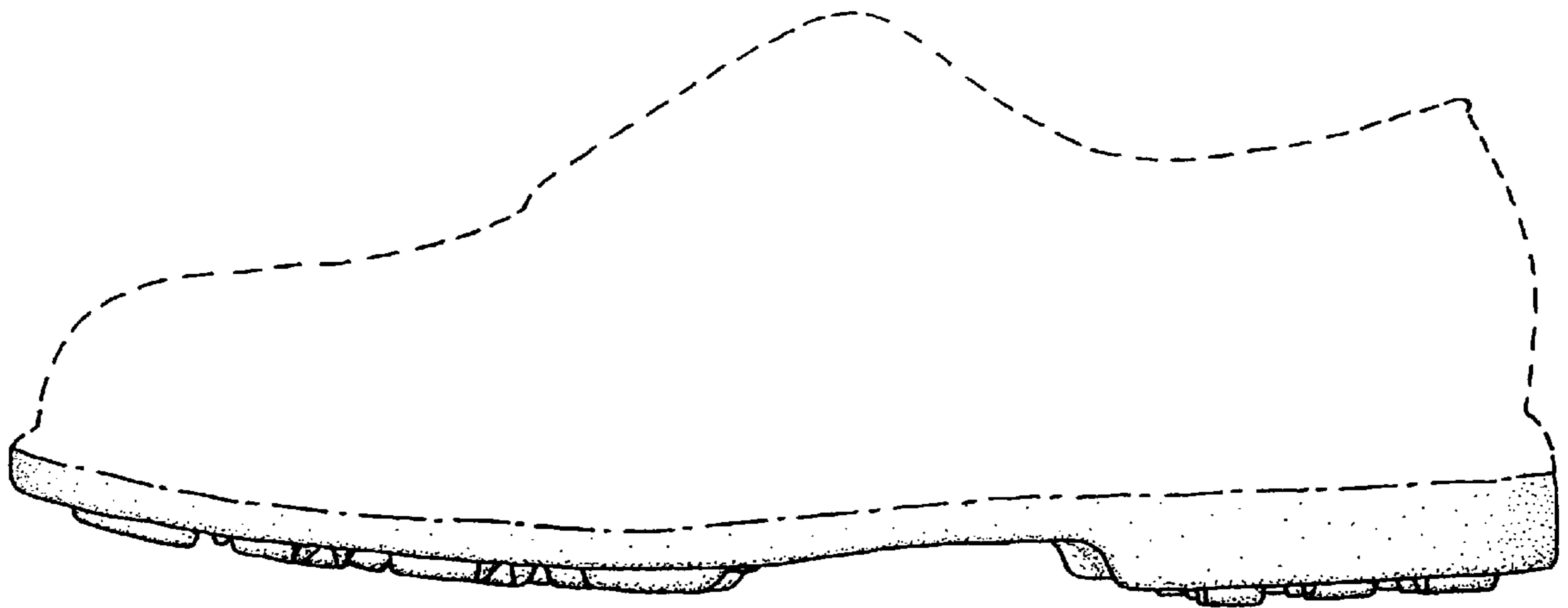

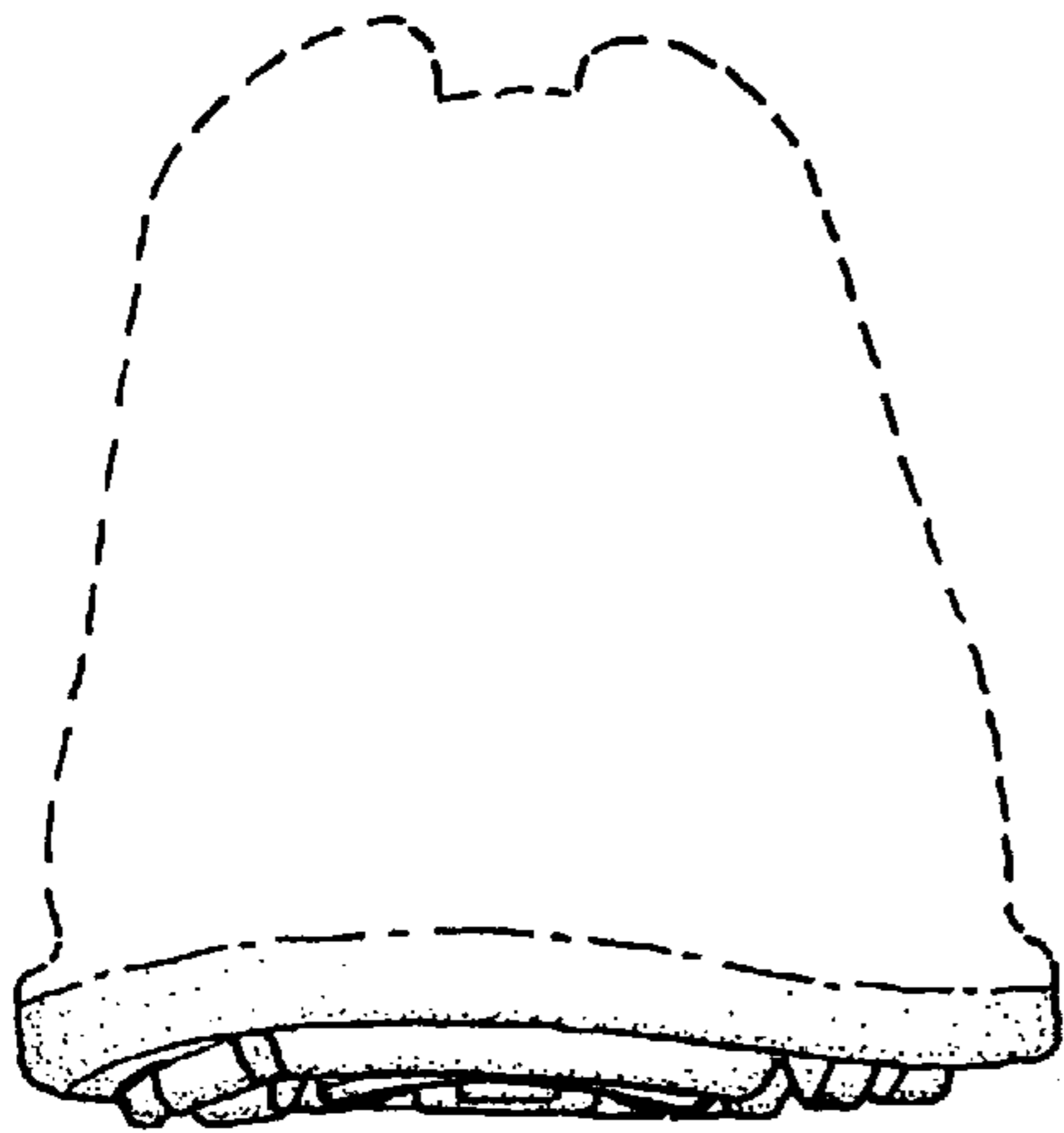

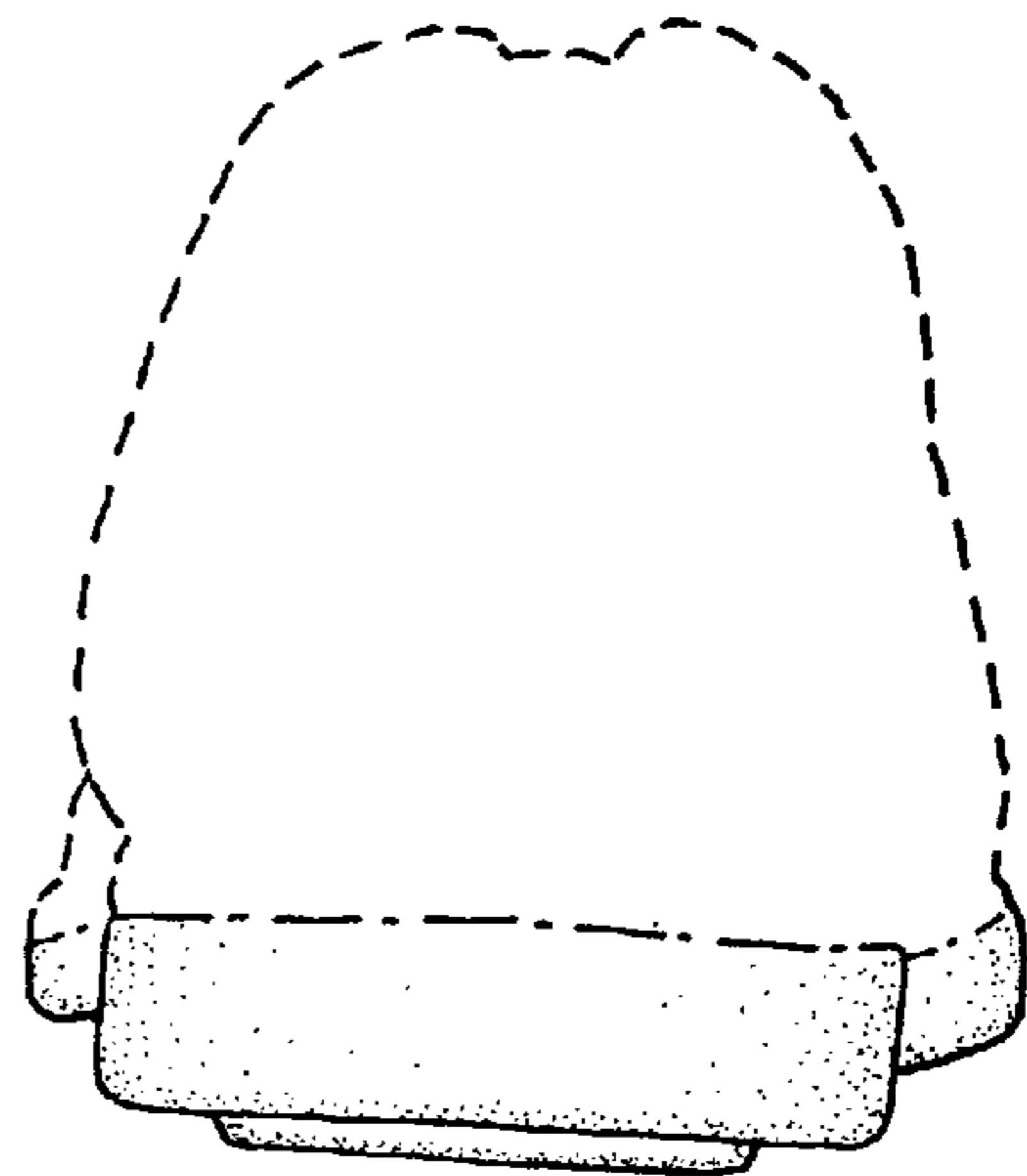
