[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a motor housing for a ceiling fan, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a motor housing for a ceiling fan showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an additional perspective view of the motor housing for a ceiling fan shown in FIG. 1 with a portion of the environmental structure removed;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the motor housing for a ceiling fan shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

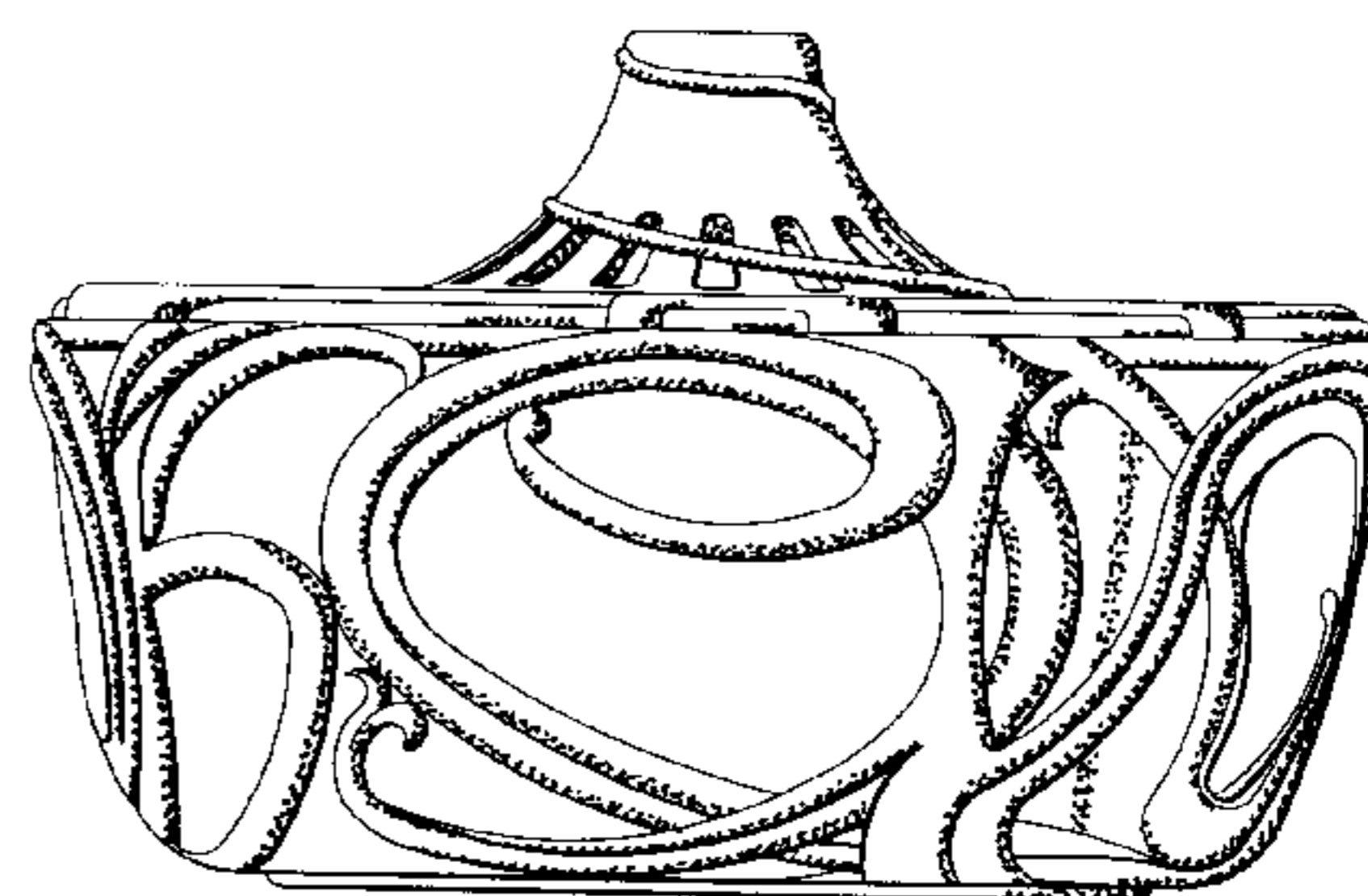
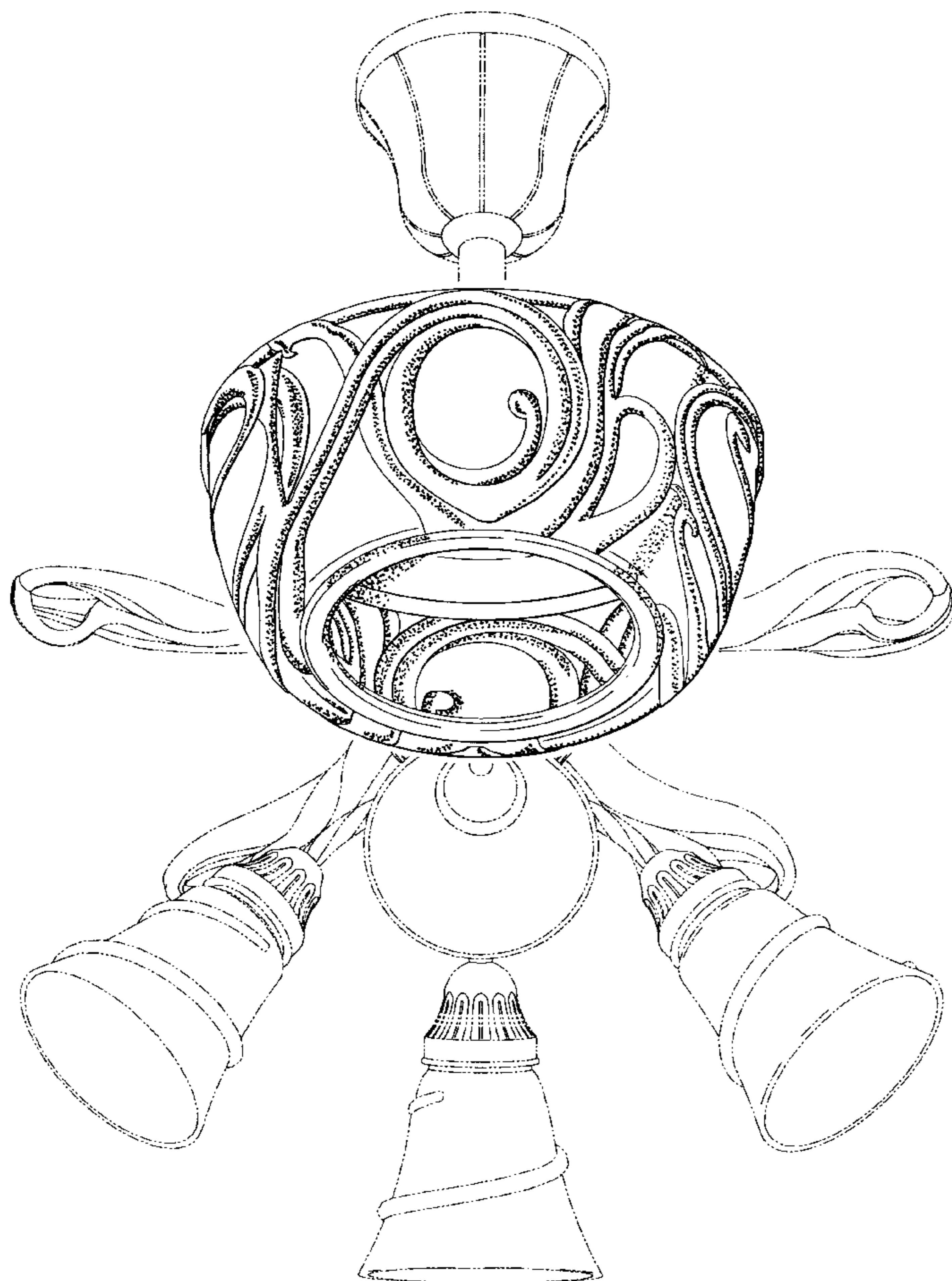
FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

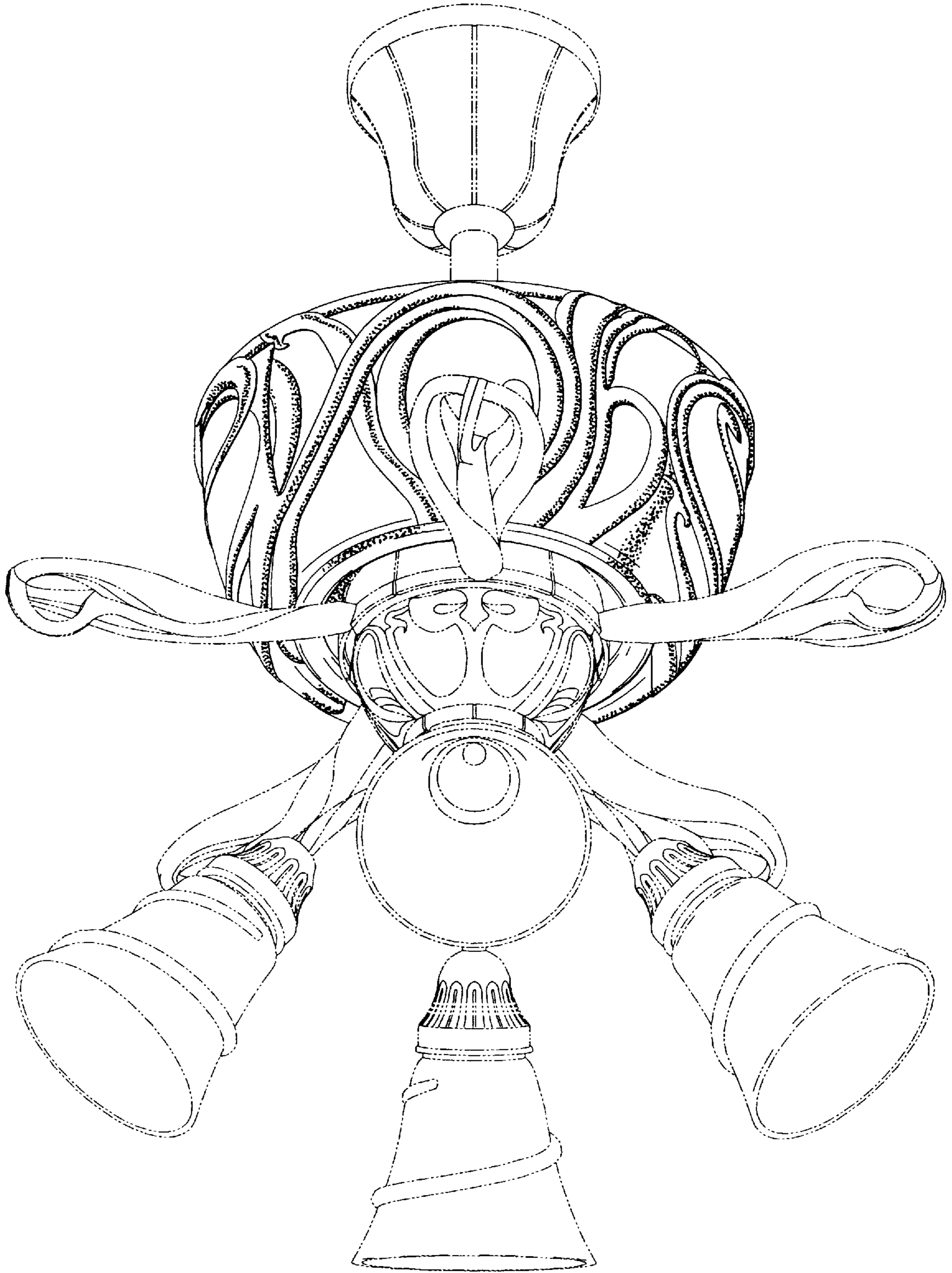

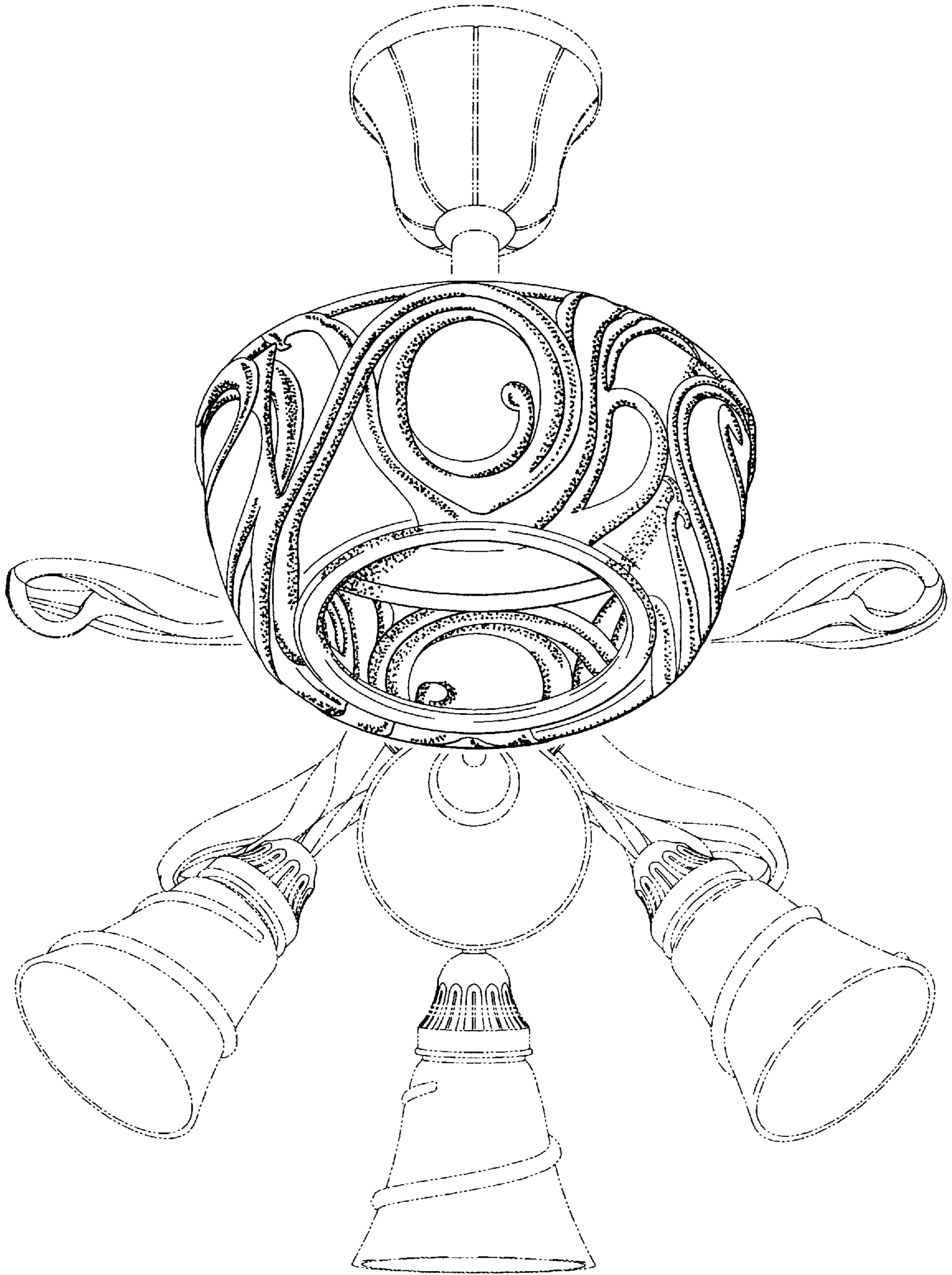

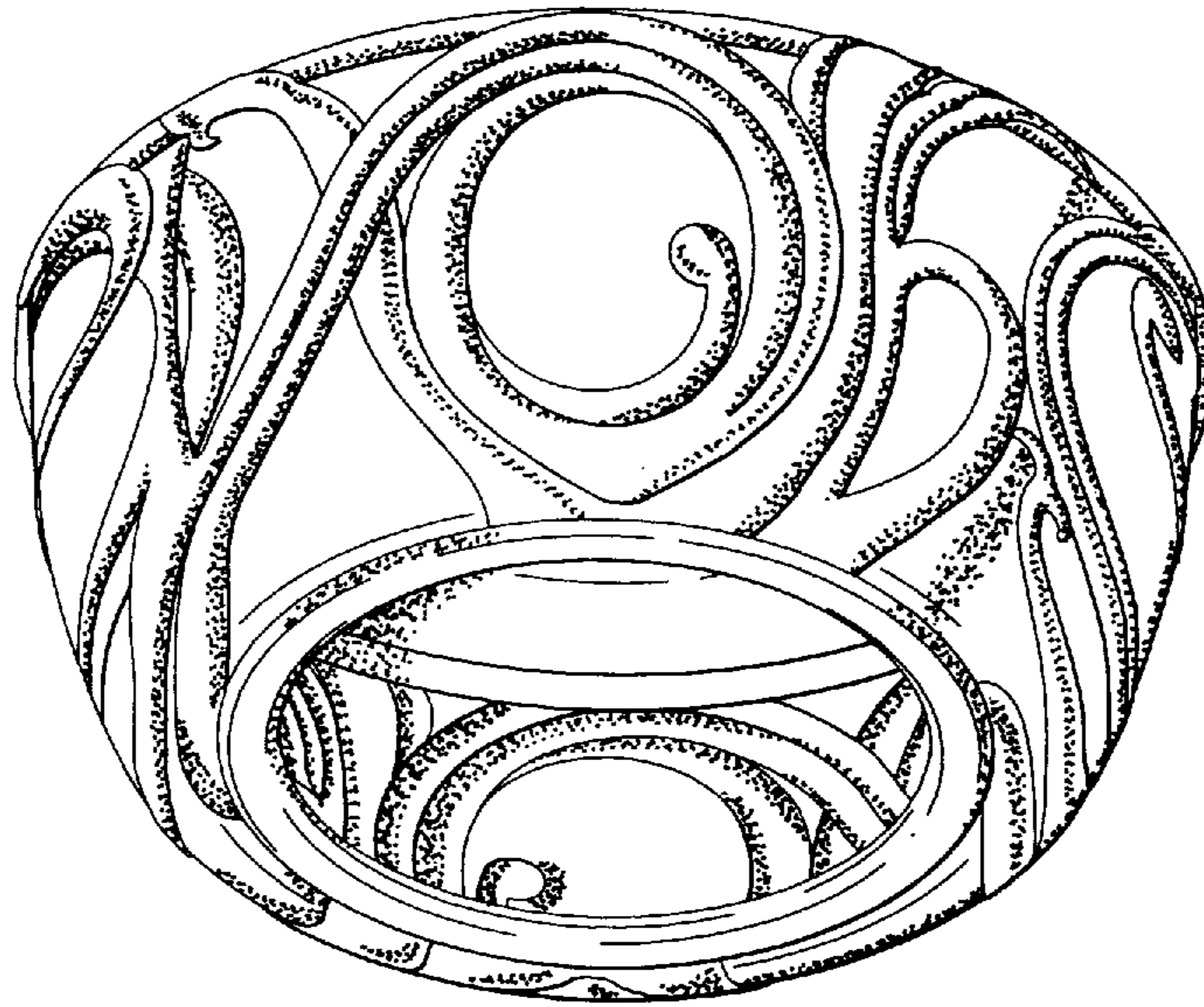

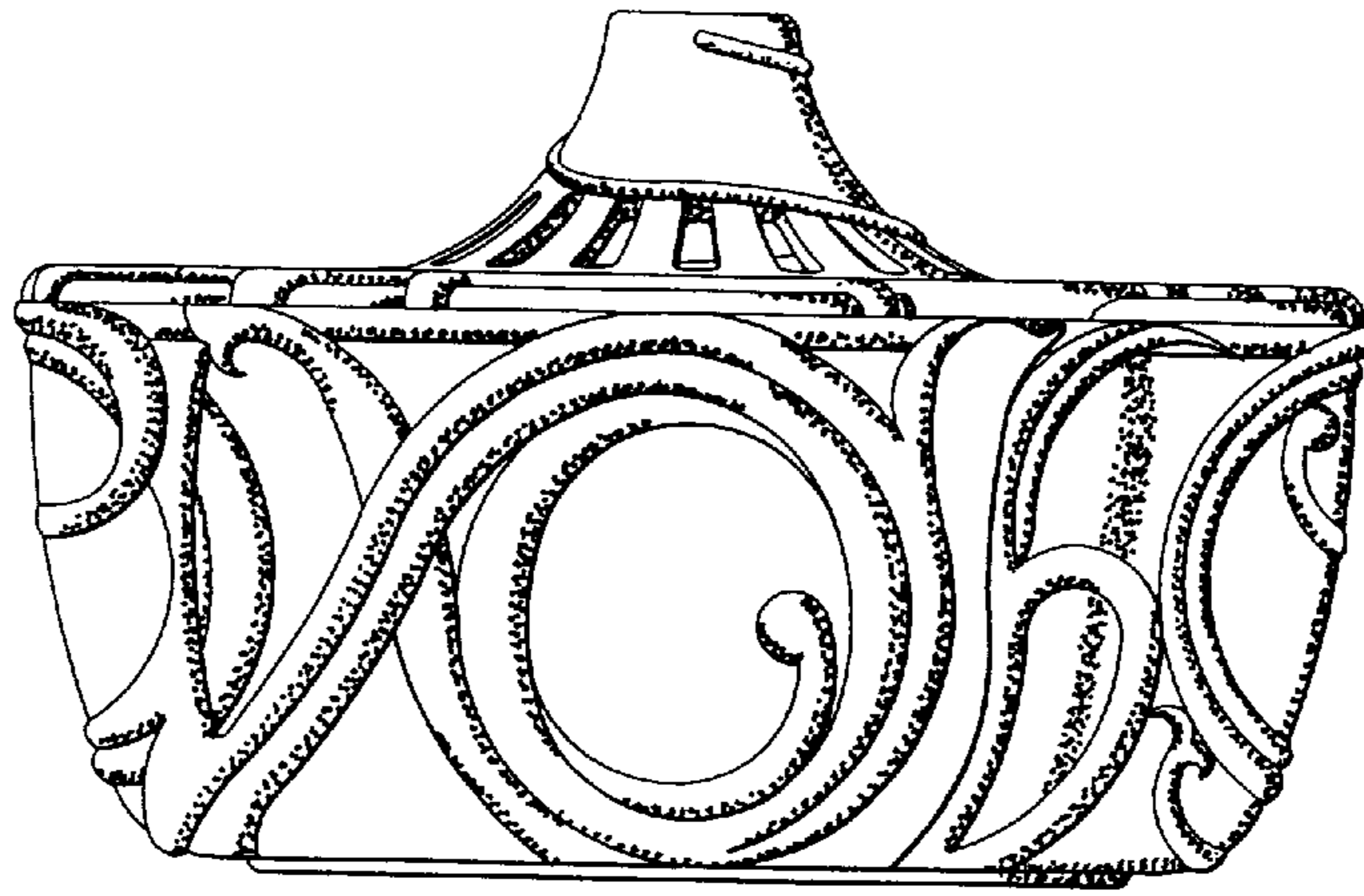

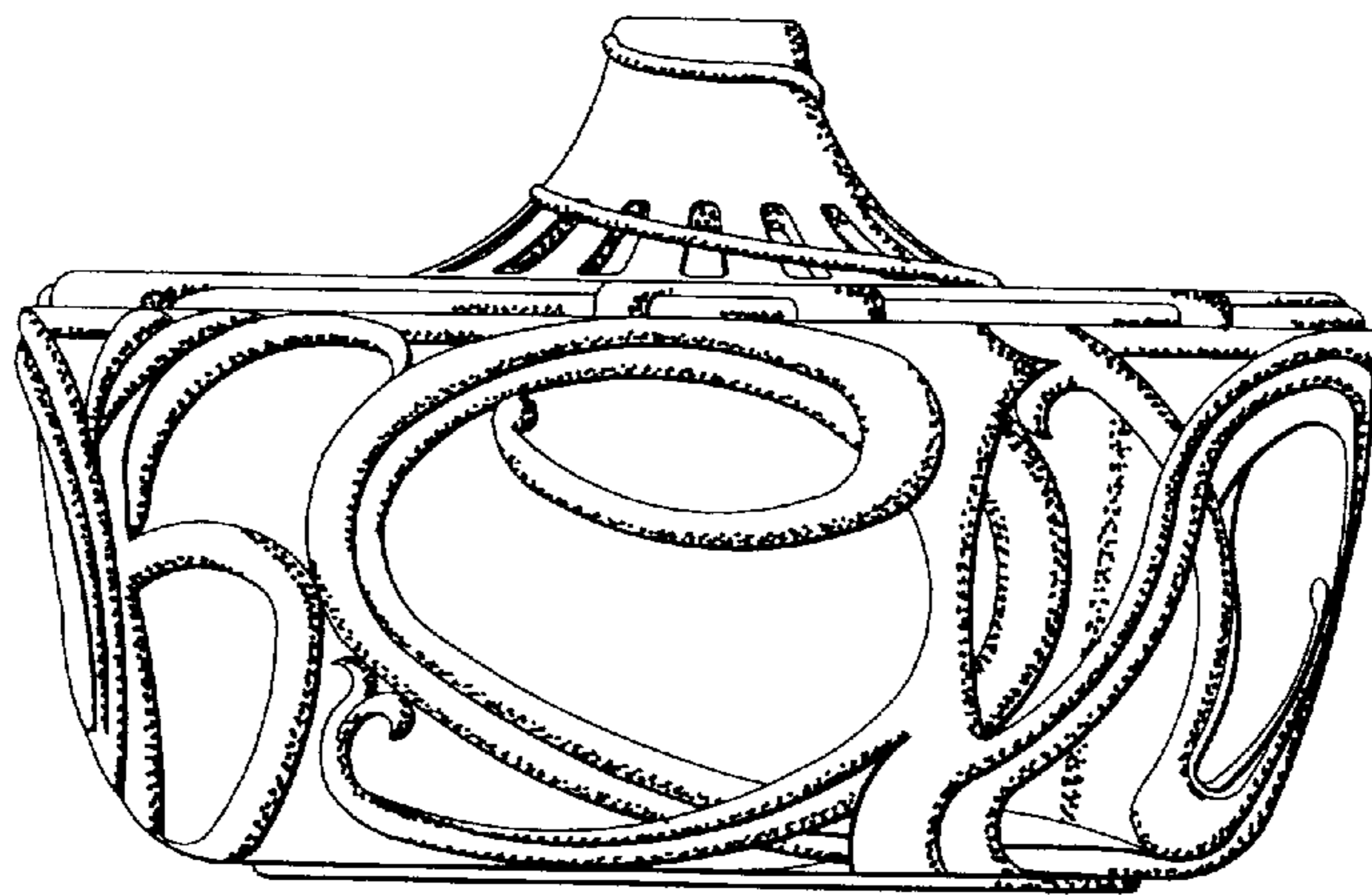

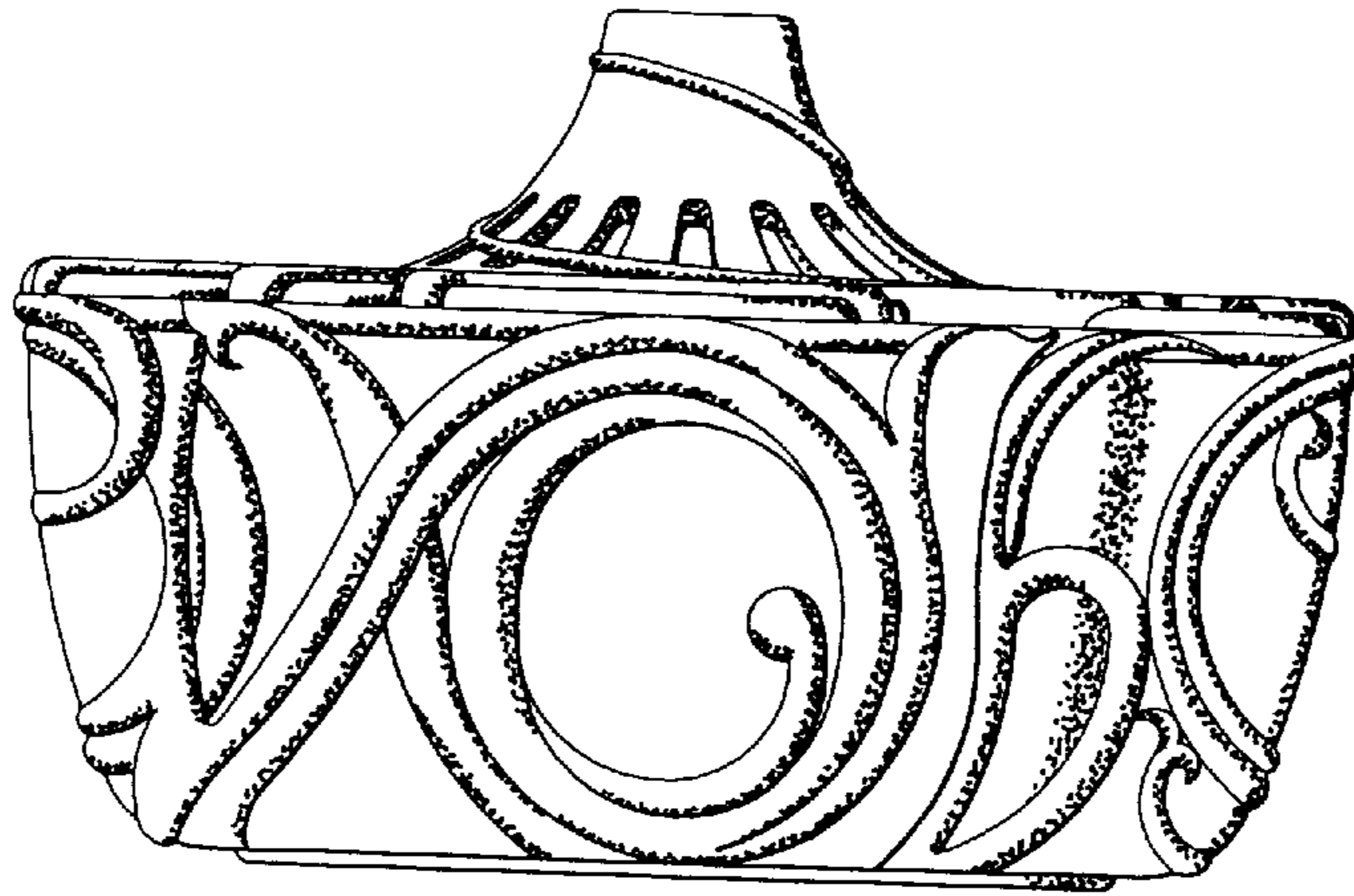

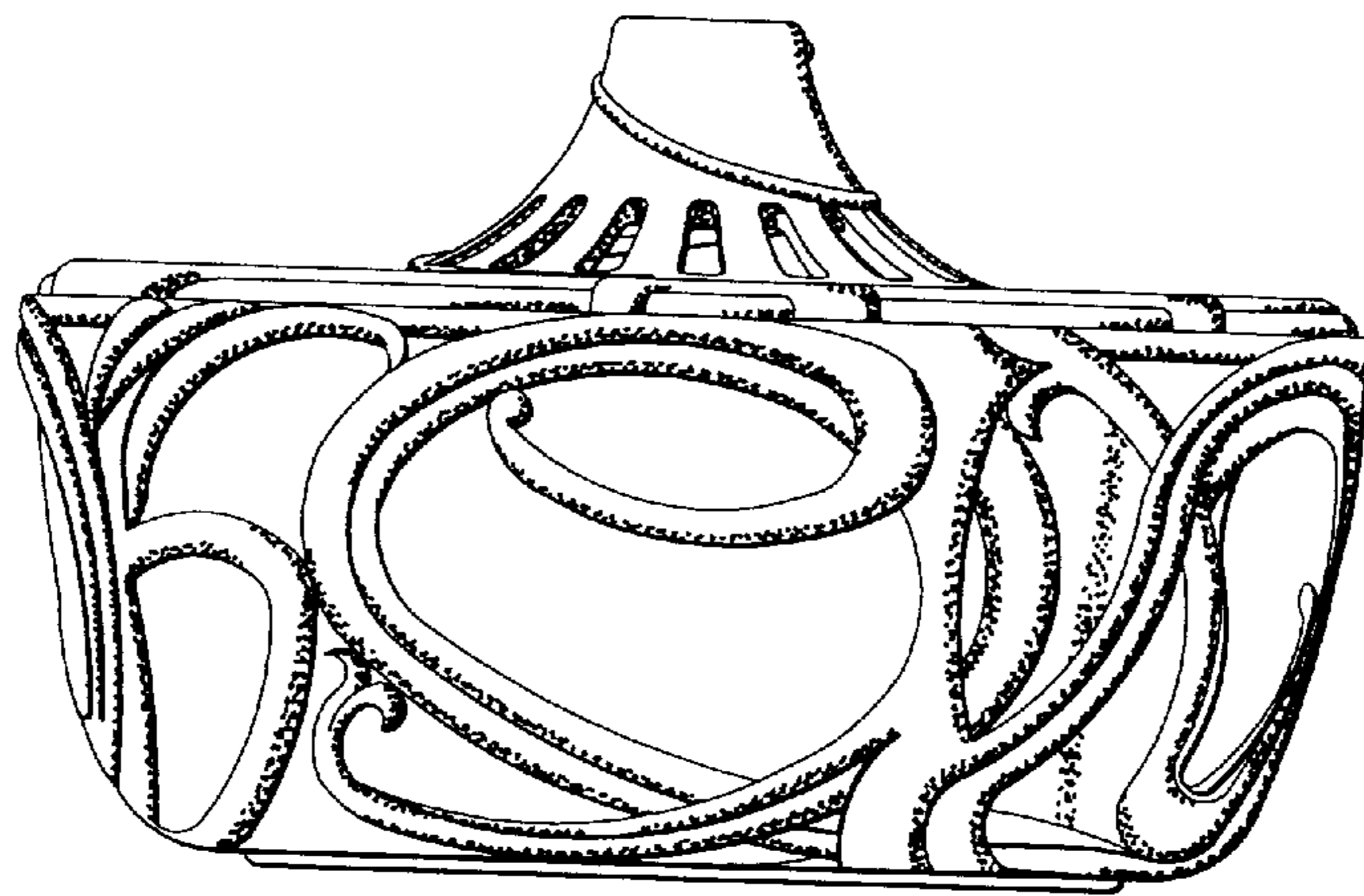

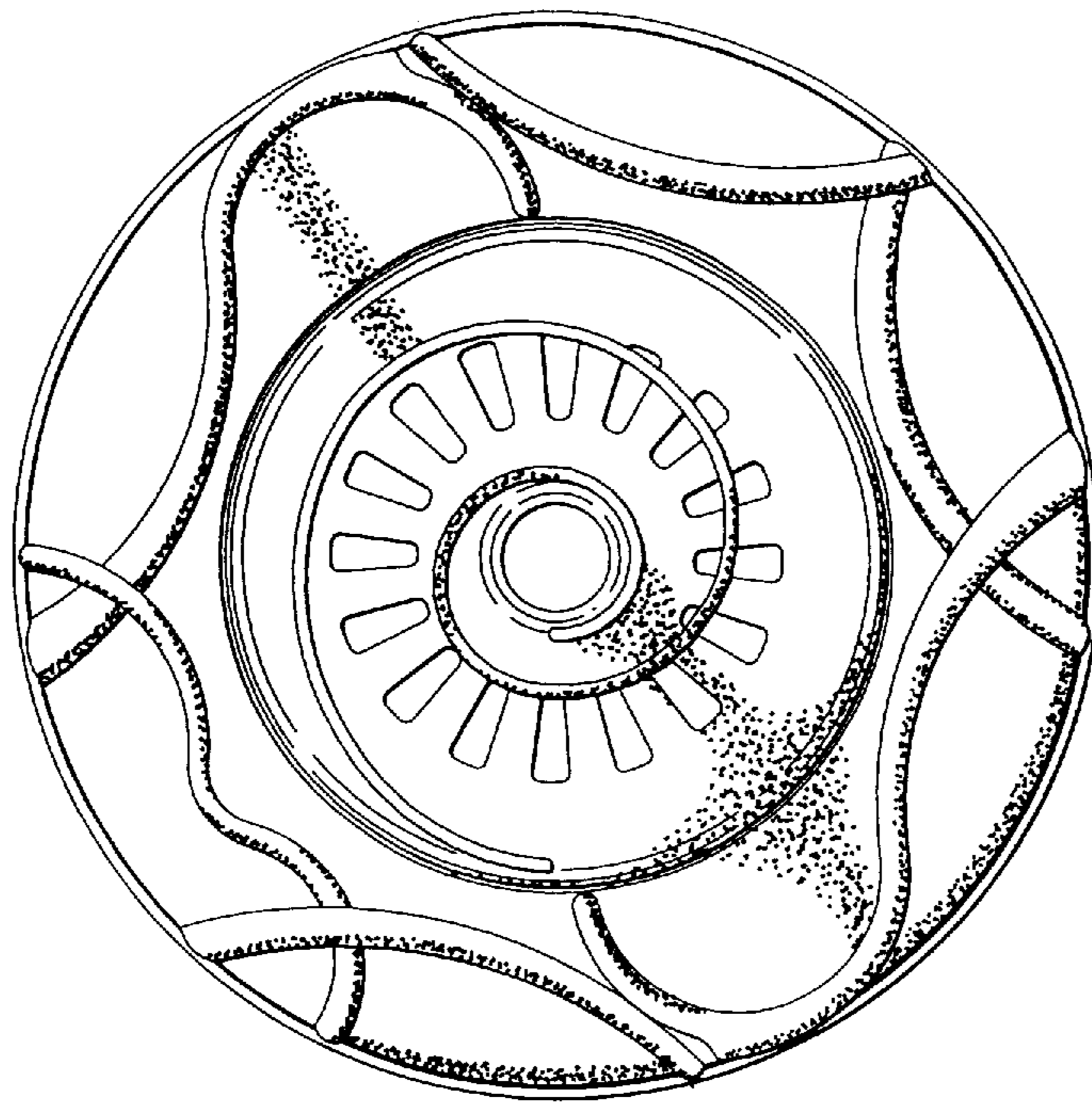

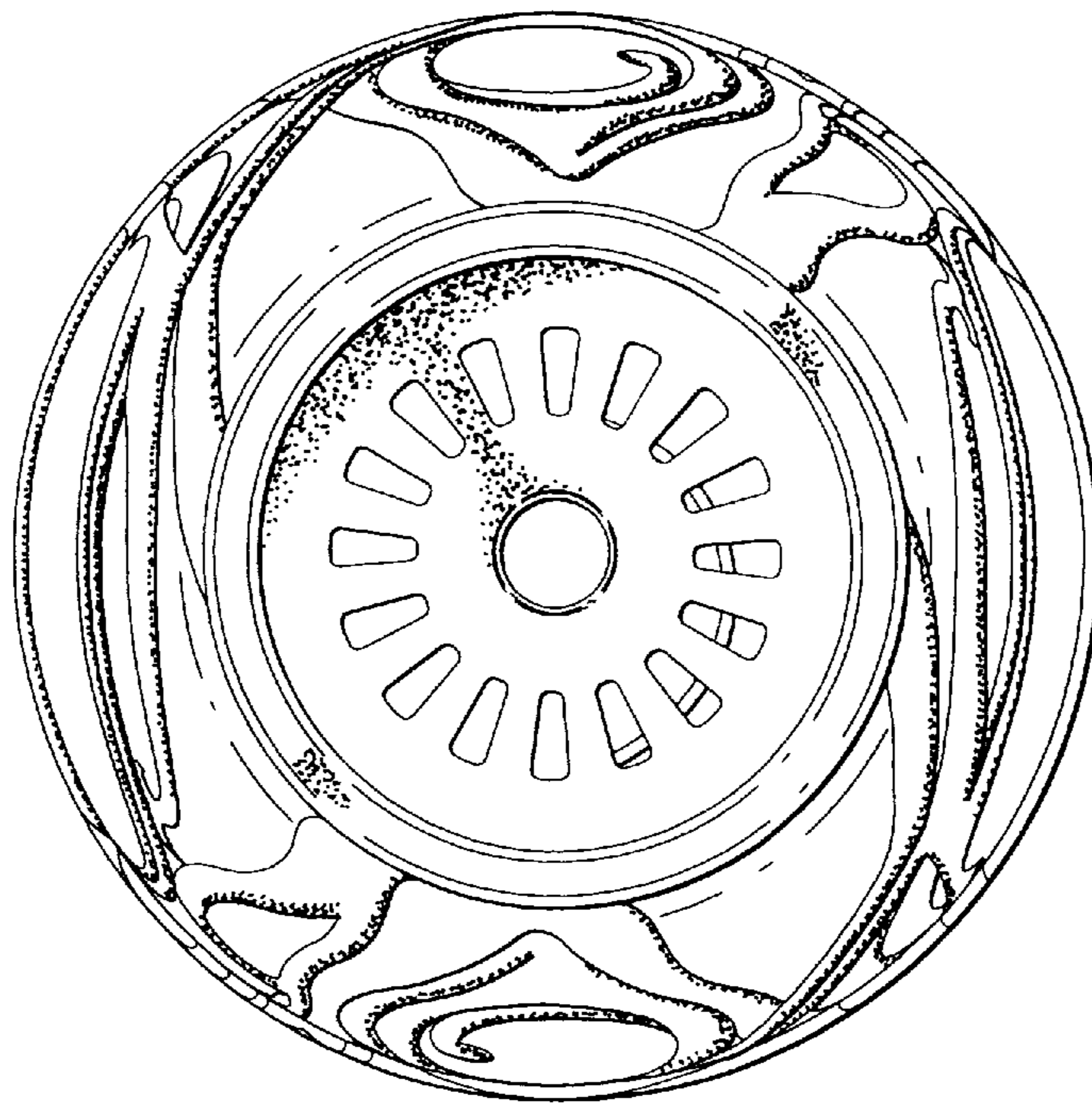
