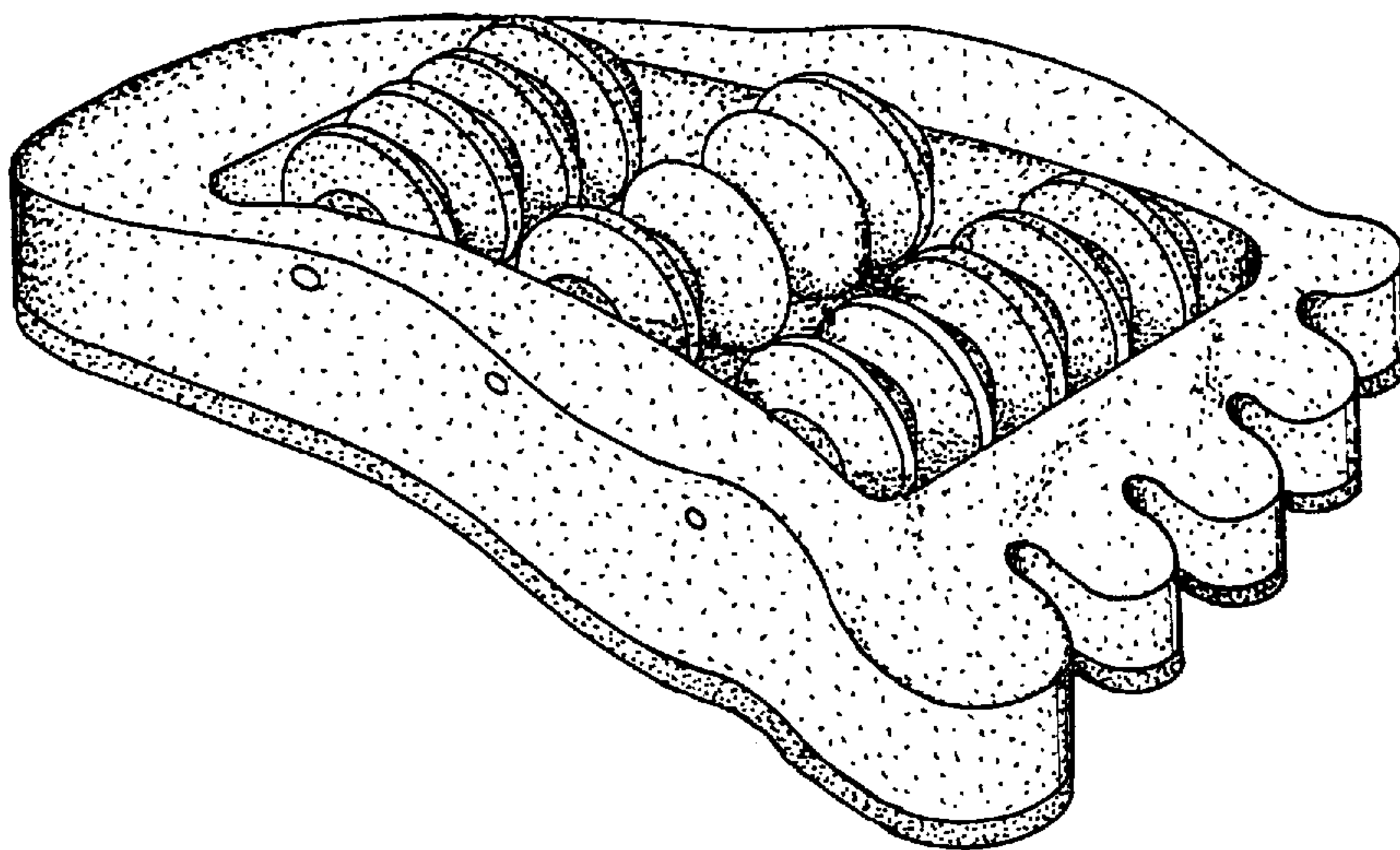
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a sole massager, showing my new design;

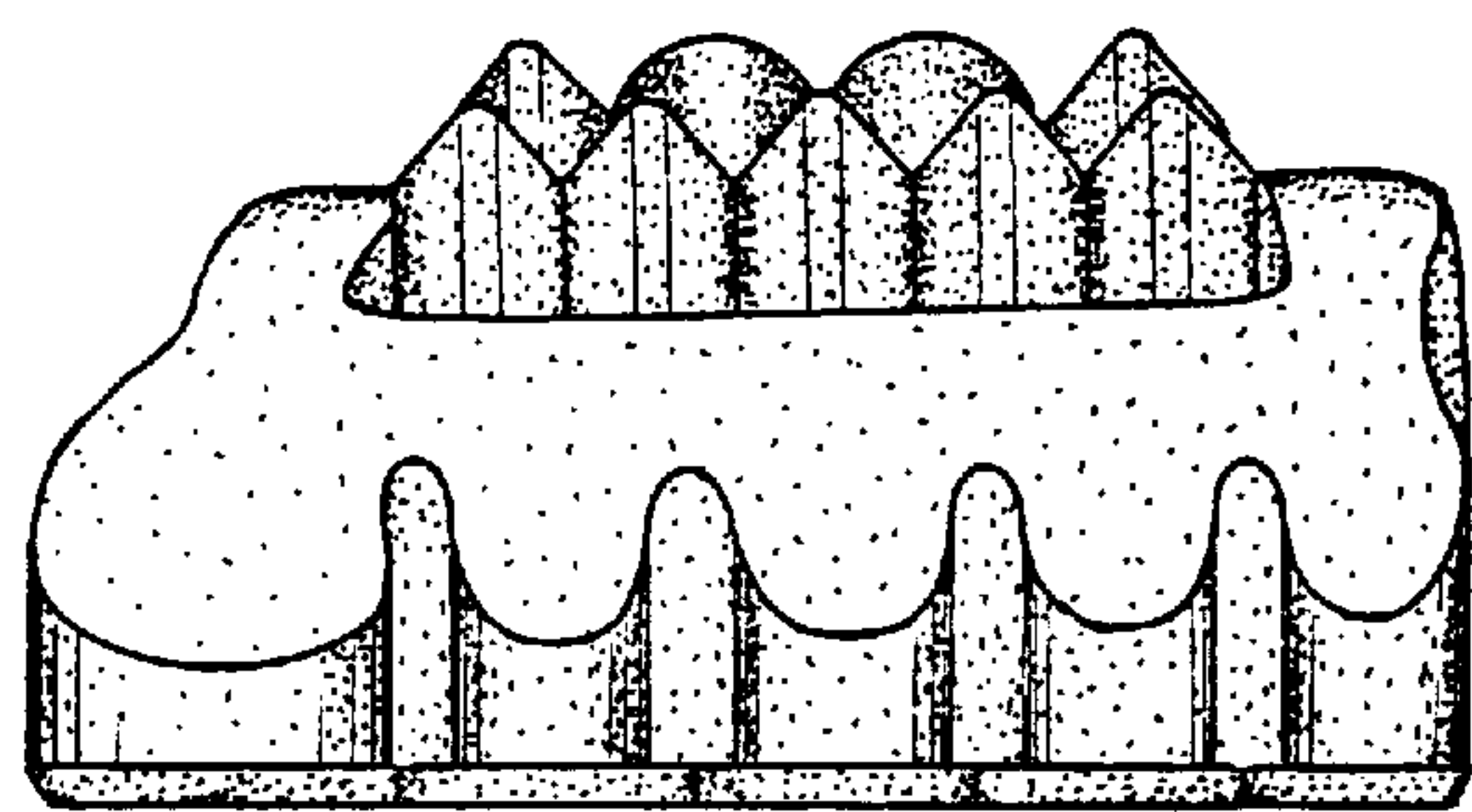

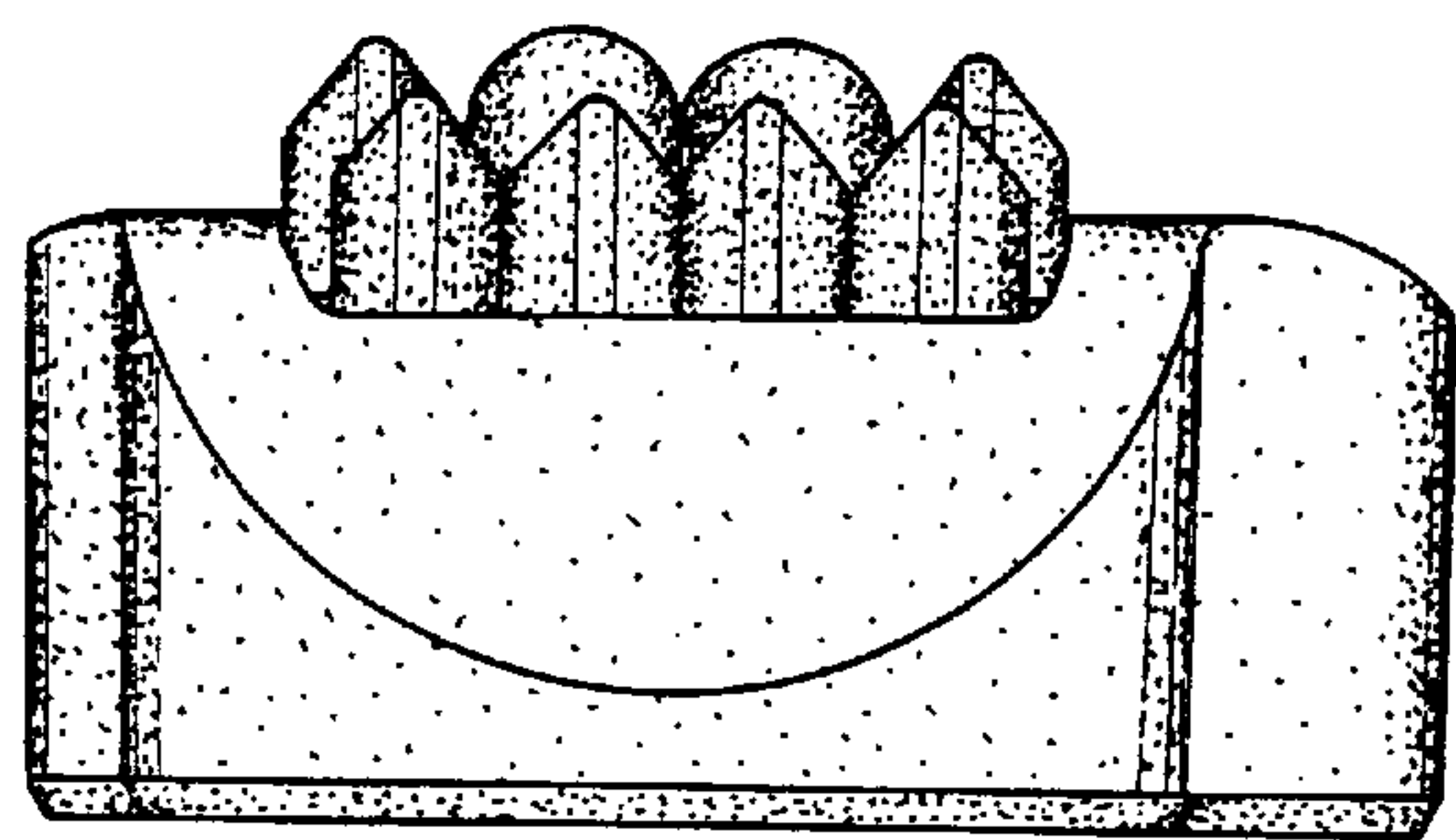

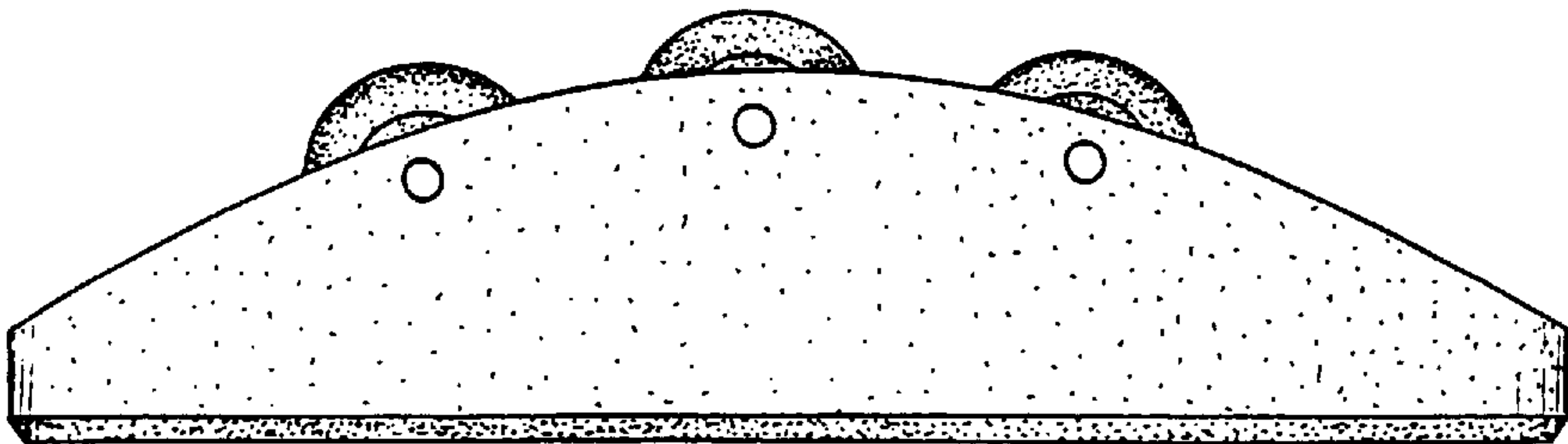

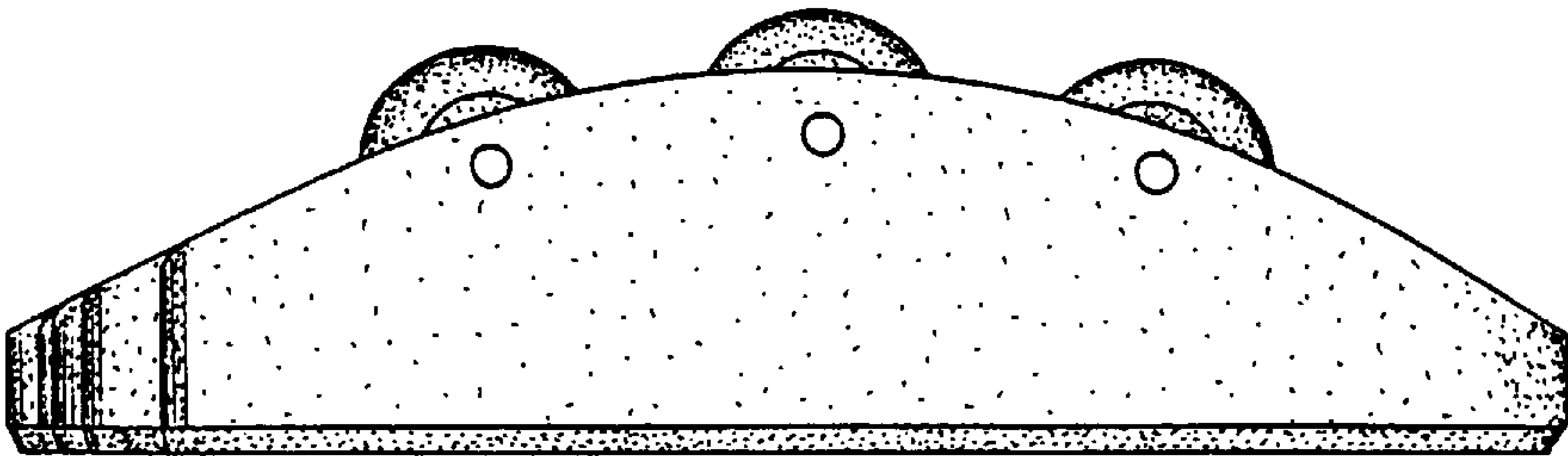

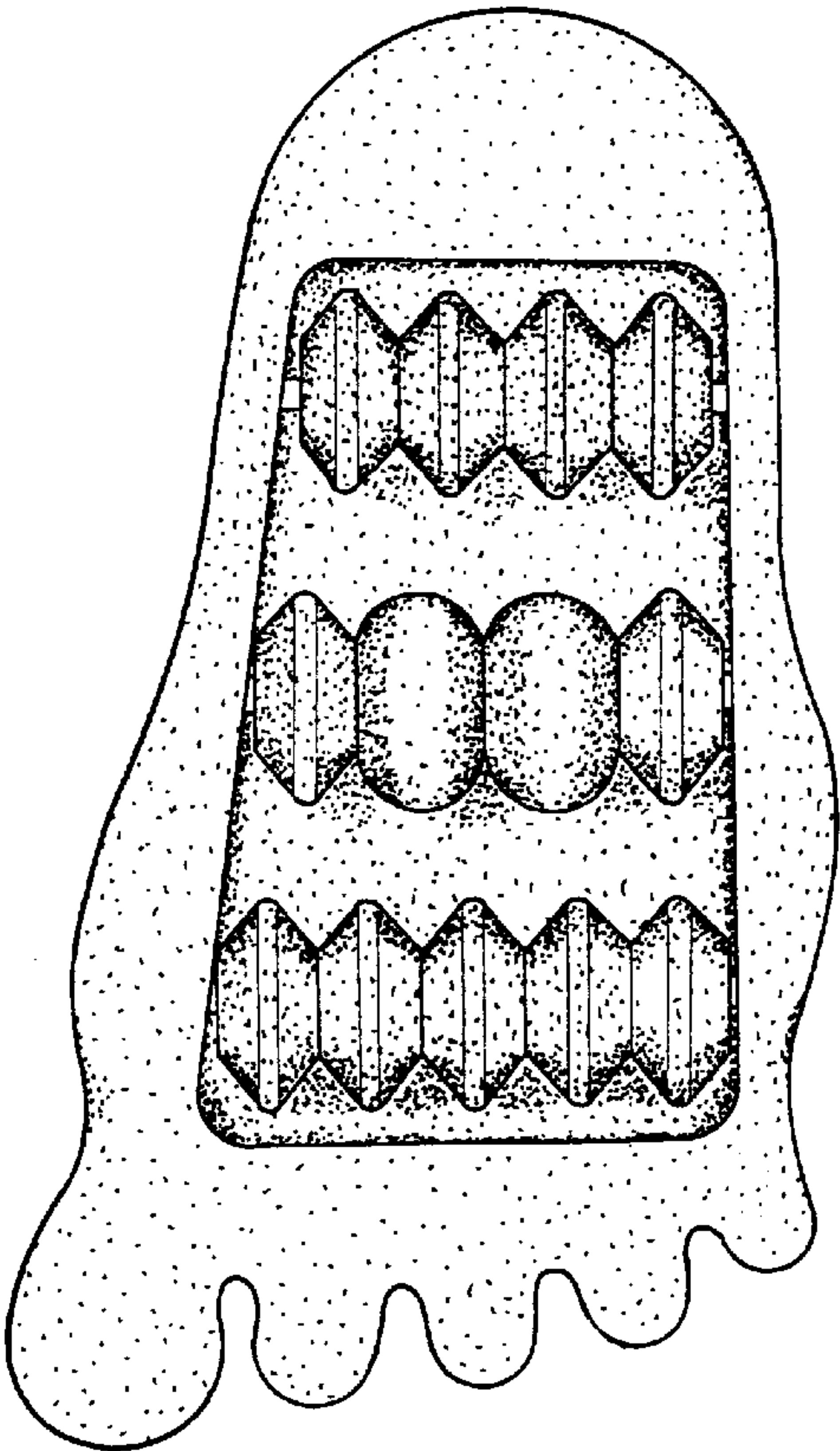

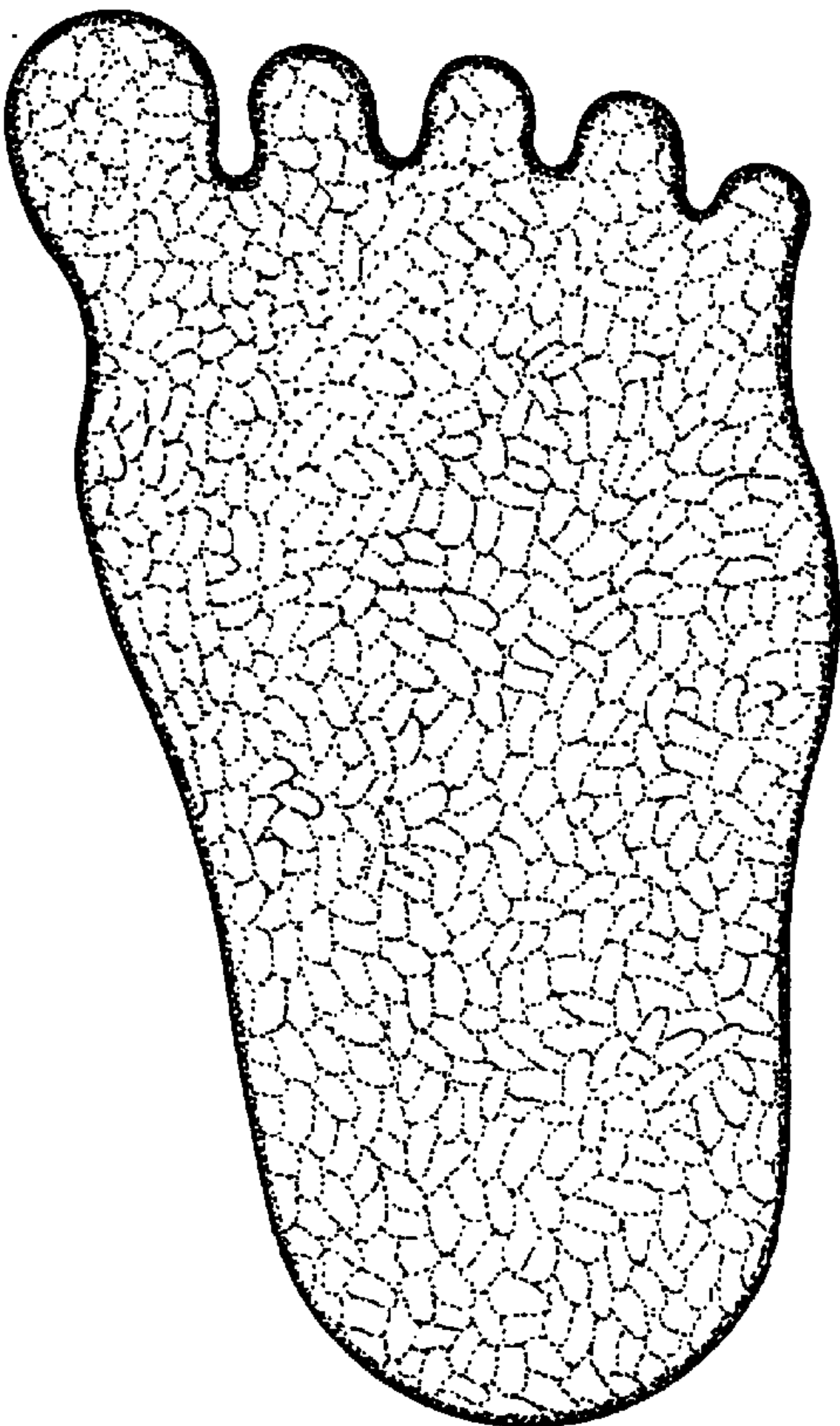

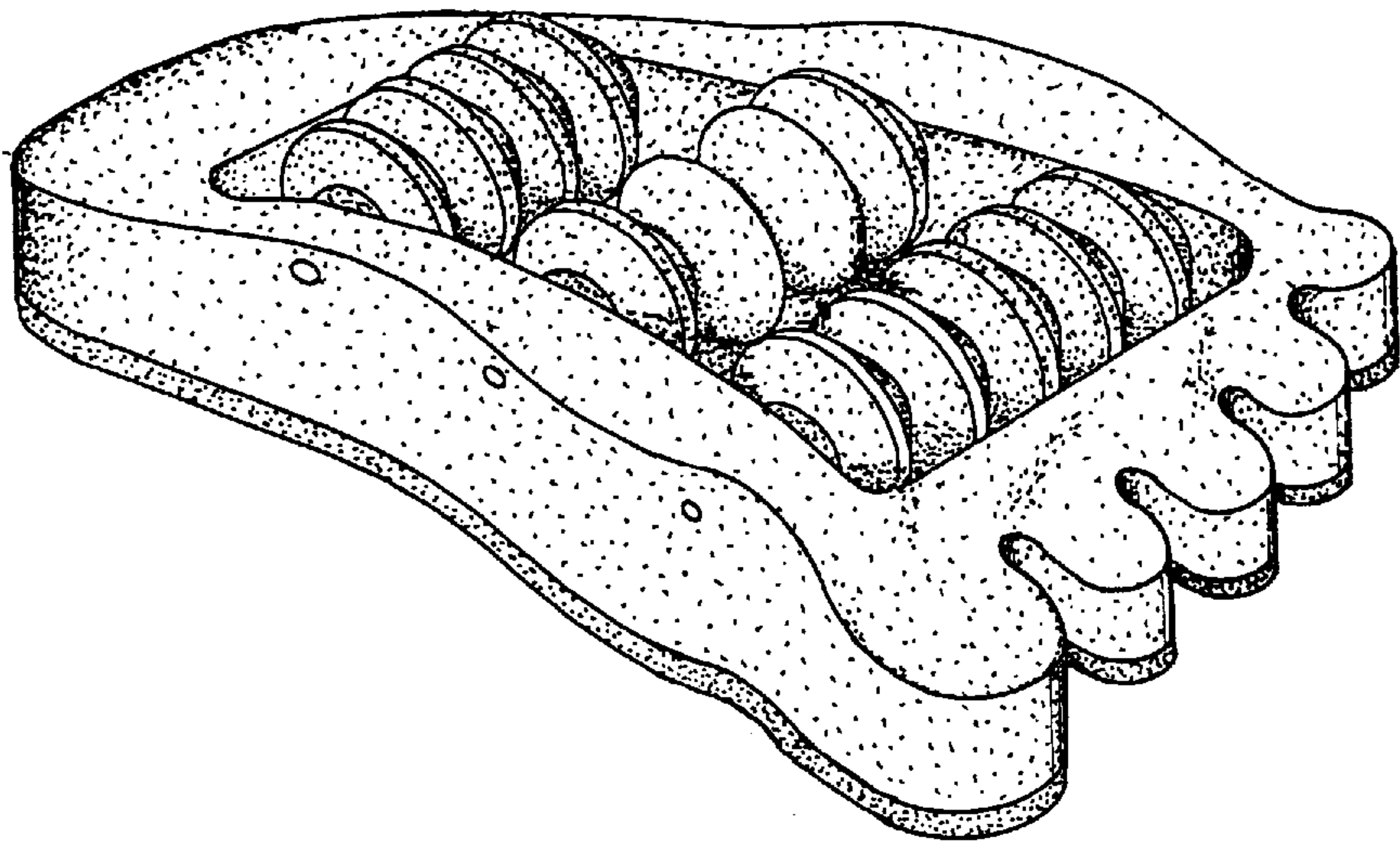
