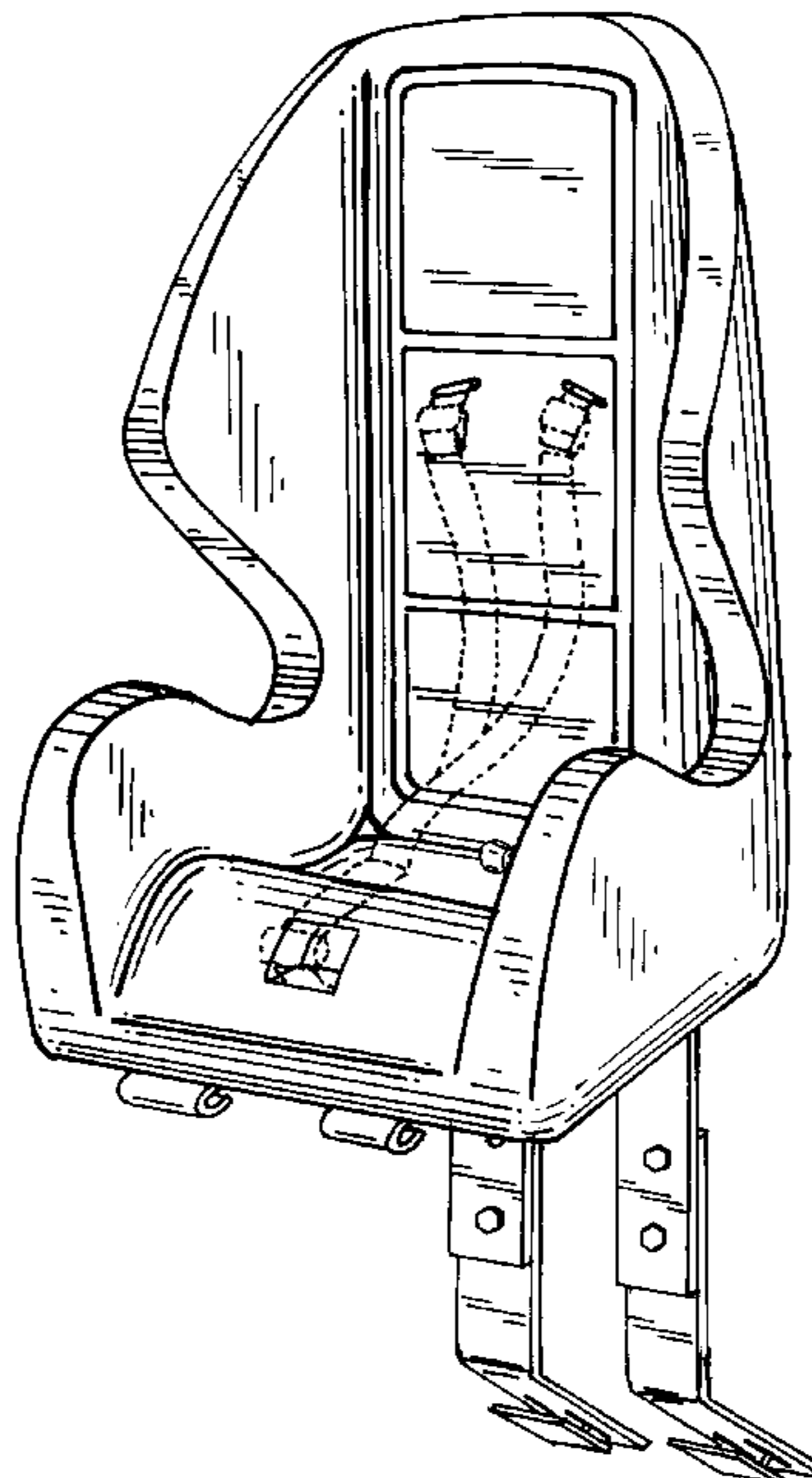

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the present infant carrier seat, with straps shown in broken lines for purposes of illustration only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the infant carrier seat of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale showing a second infant carrier seat and shopping carts in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary side elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a front view of the infant carrier seat of FIG. 1 on a reduced scale. FIG. 5 is a side view of the infant carrier seat of FIG. 4; FIG. 6 is a rear view of the infant carrier seat of FIG. 4; FIG. 7 is a top view of the infant carrier seat of FIG. 4; and, FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the infant carrier seat of FIG. 4.

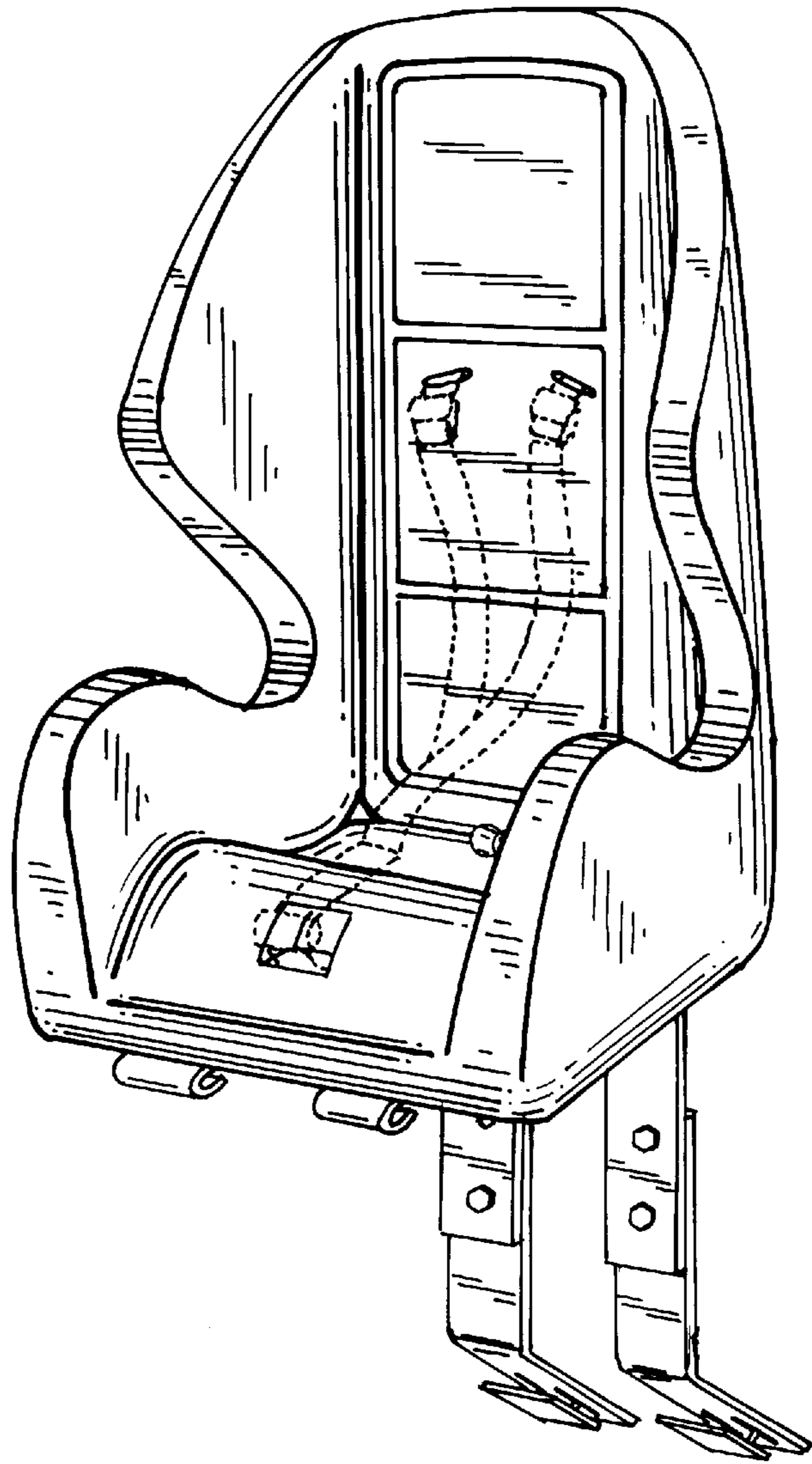
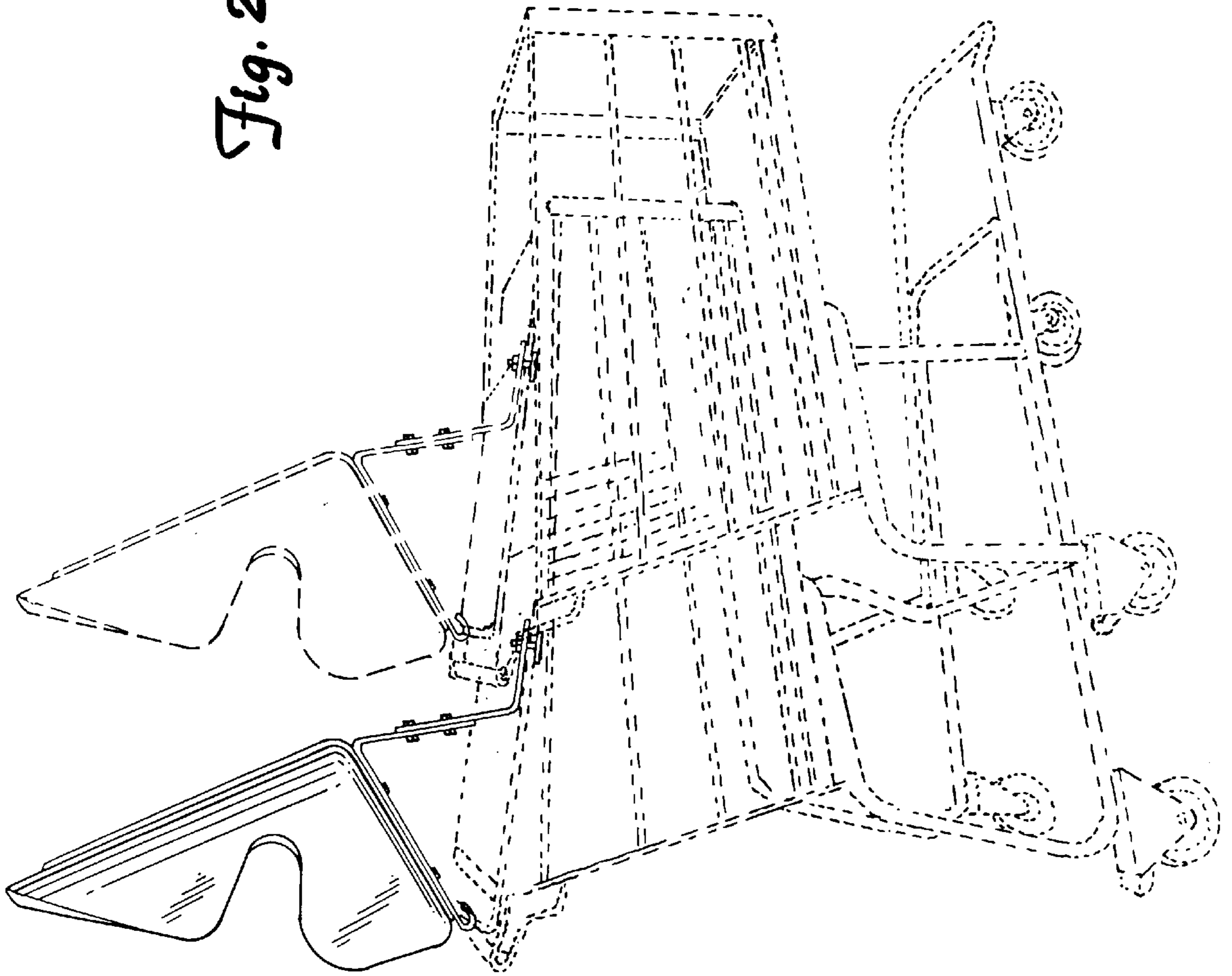
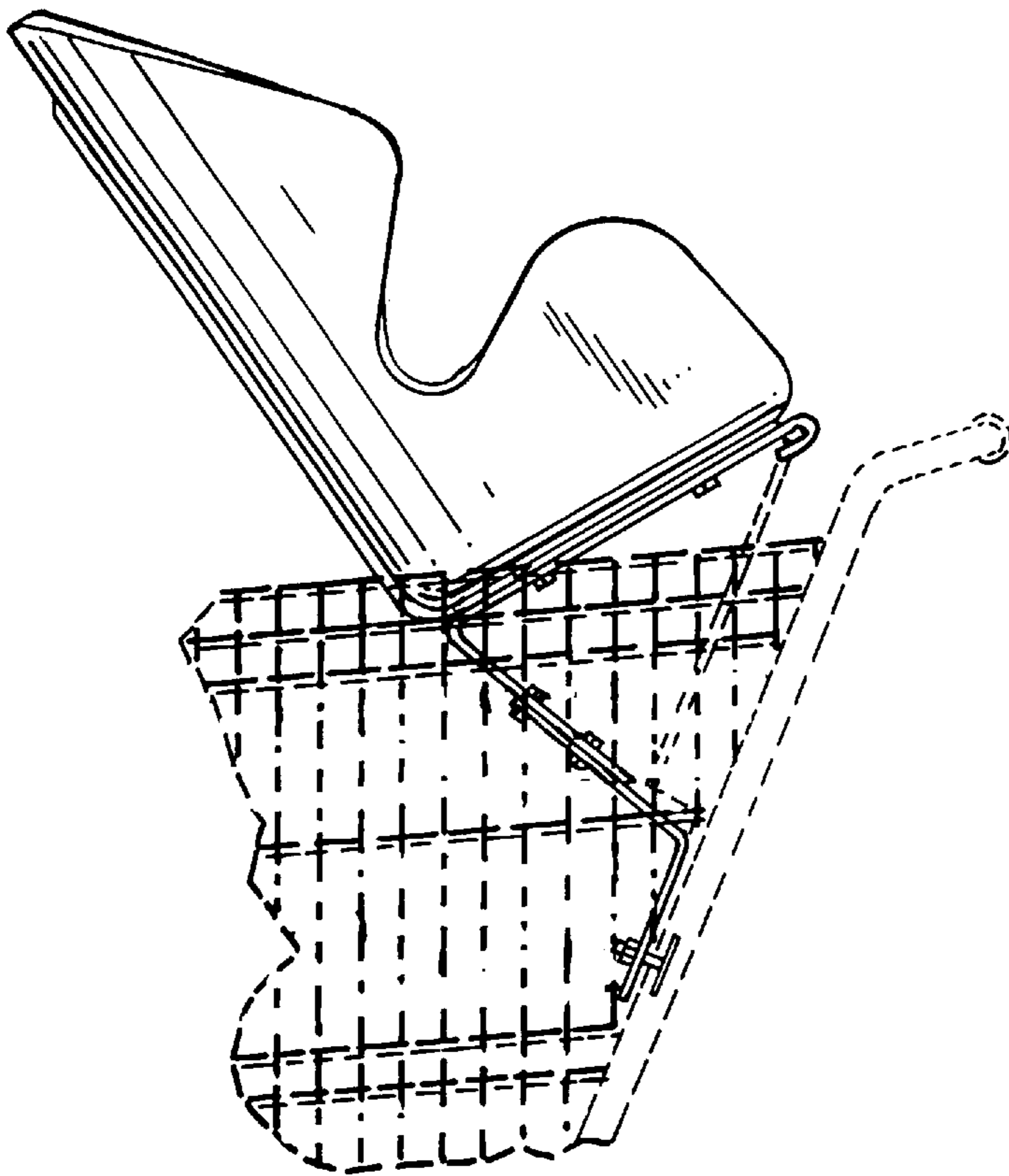


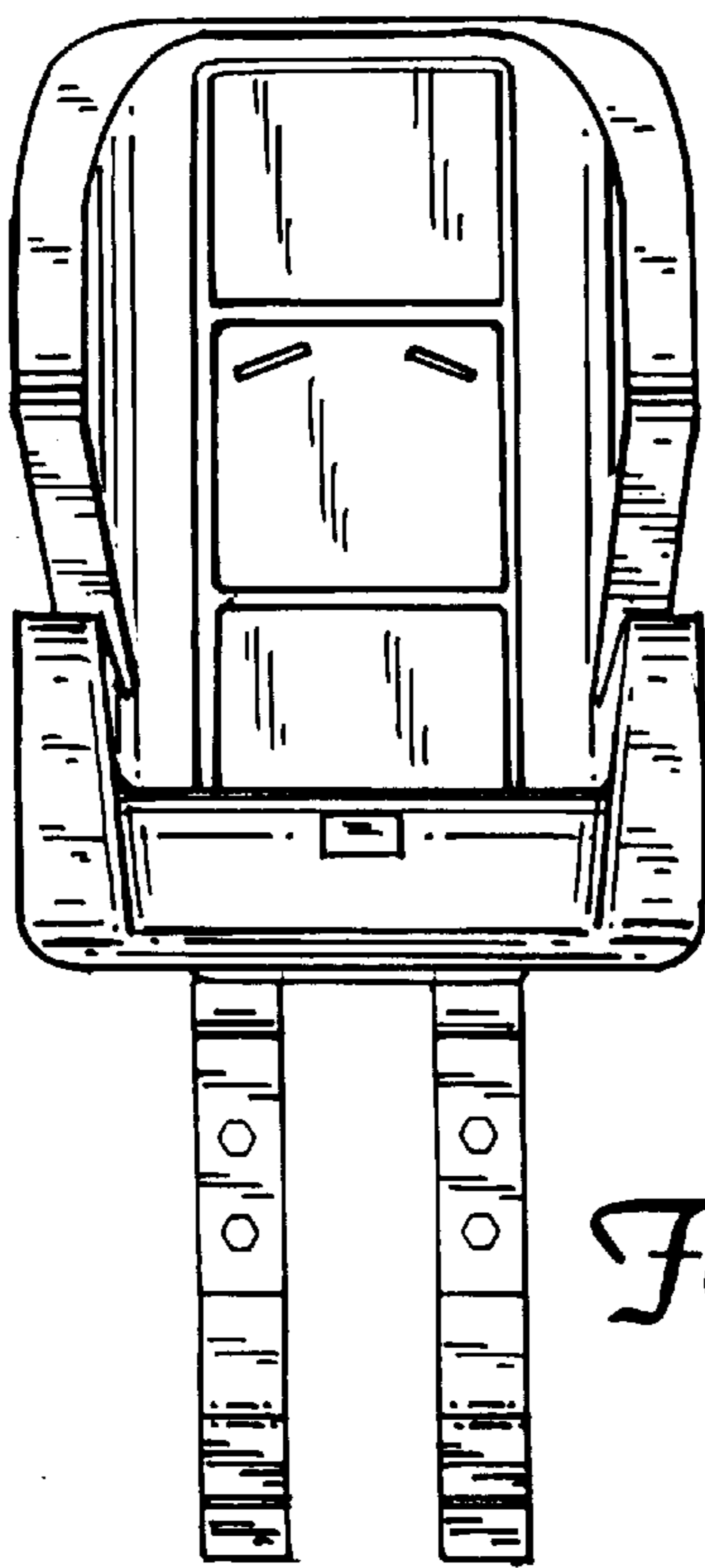

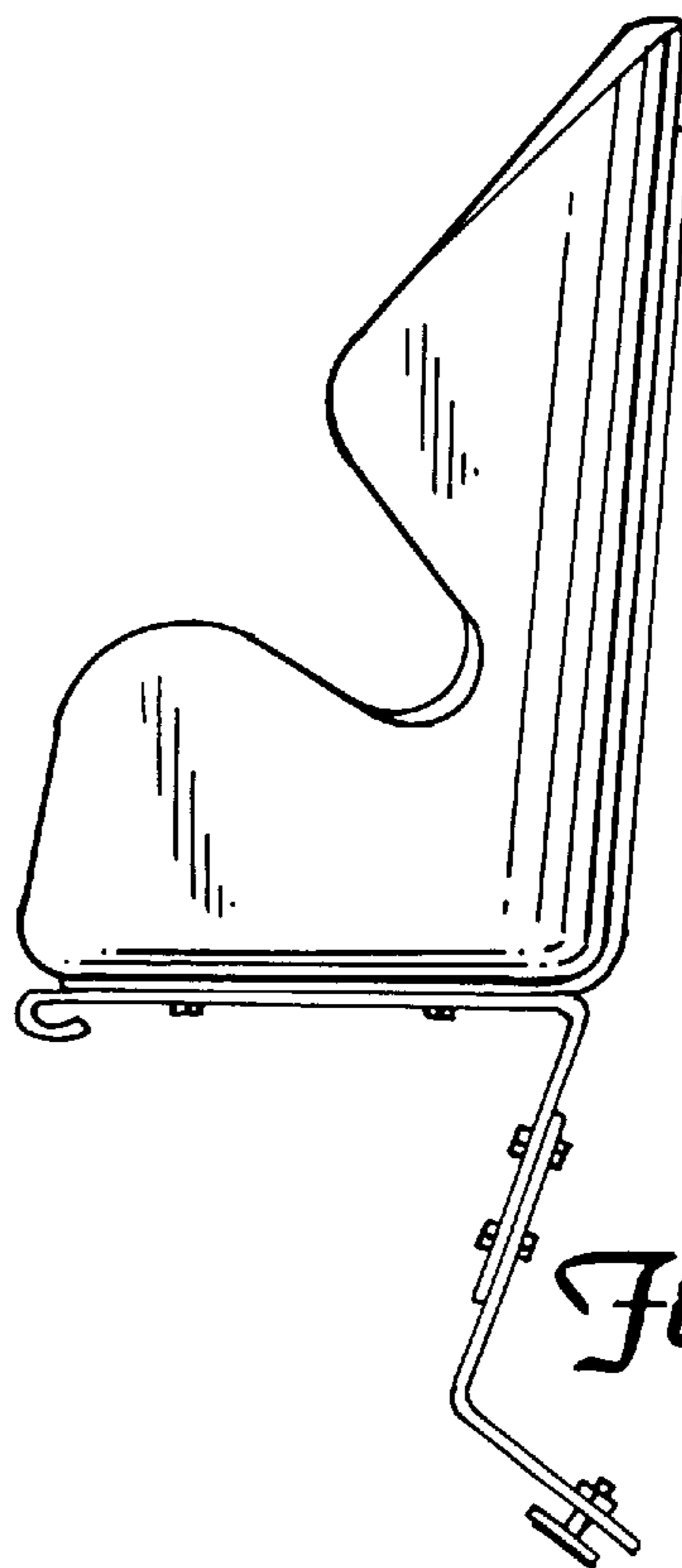

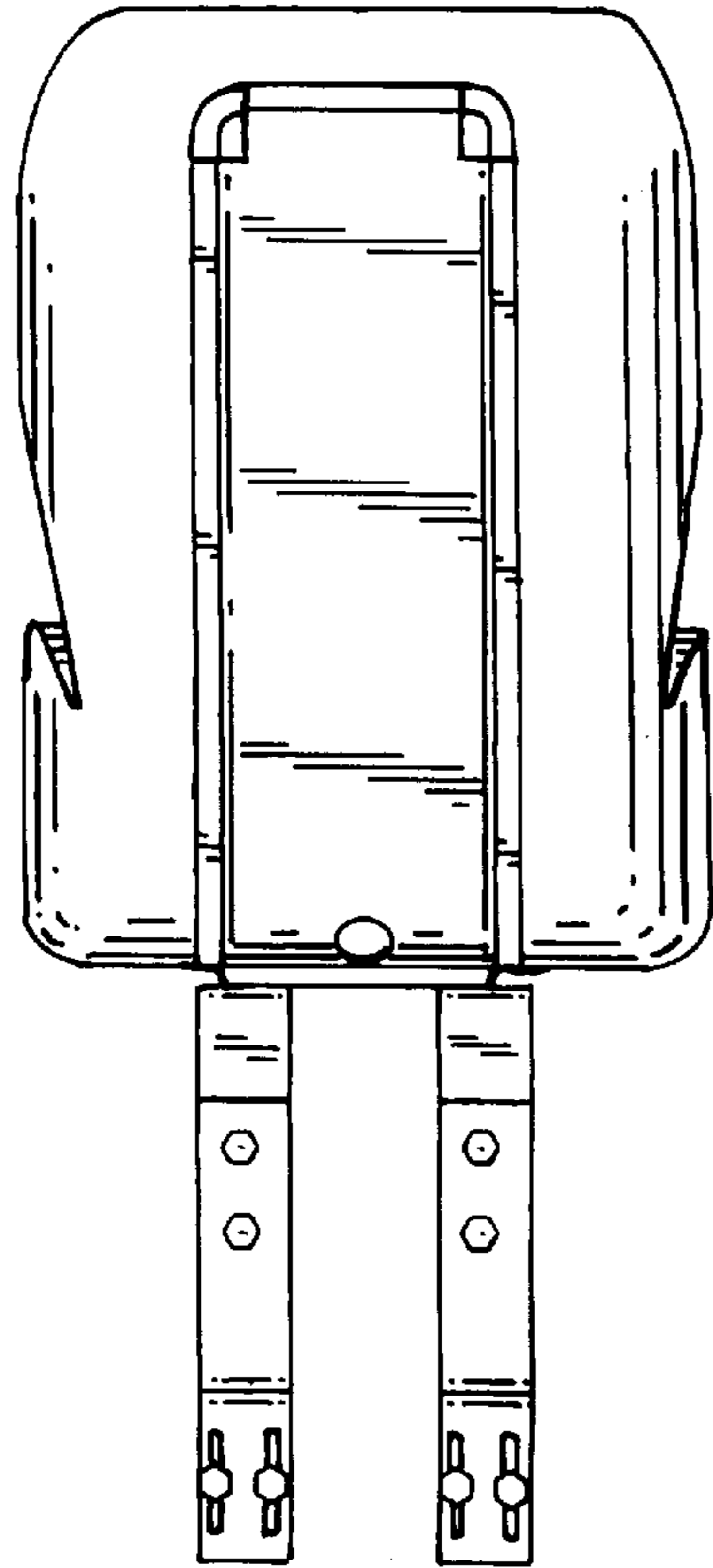

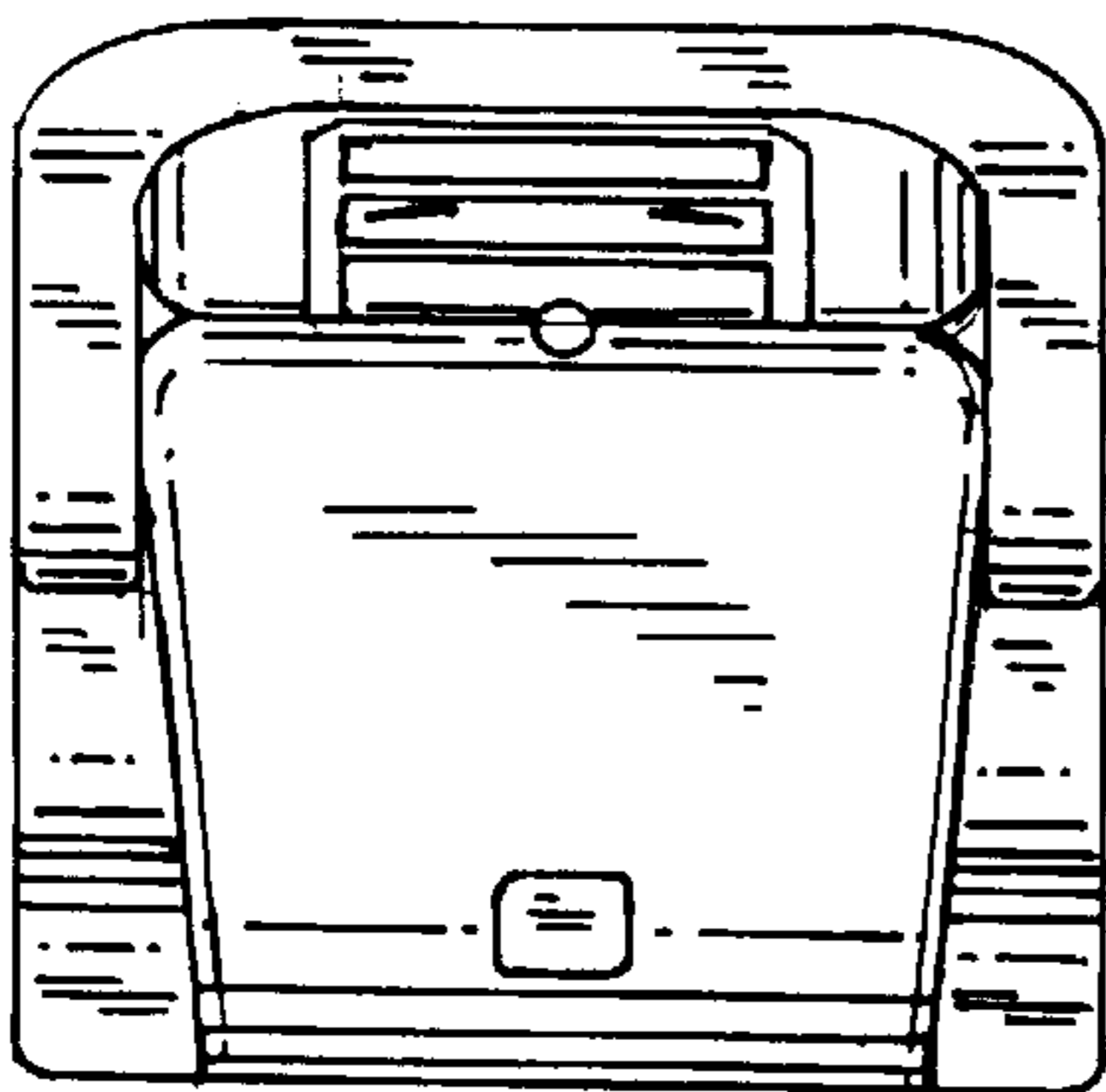
