[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a raised roof truck exterior surface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a raised roof truck exterior surface showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a back view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a raised roof truck exterior surface showing a second embodiment of my new design; FIG. 9 is a front view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 8;


FIG. 10 is a right side view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 8;


FIG. 11 is the left side view of the raised roof truck exterior surface of FIG. 8; and,




The broken lines shown in all views of the drawin are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.










