FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the integrated receiver/decoder;

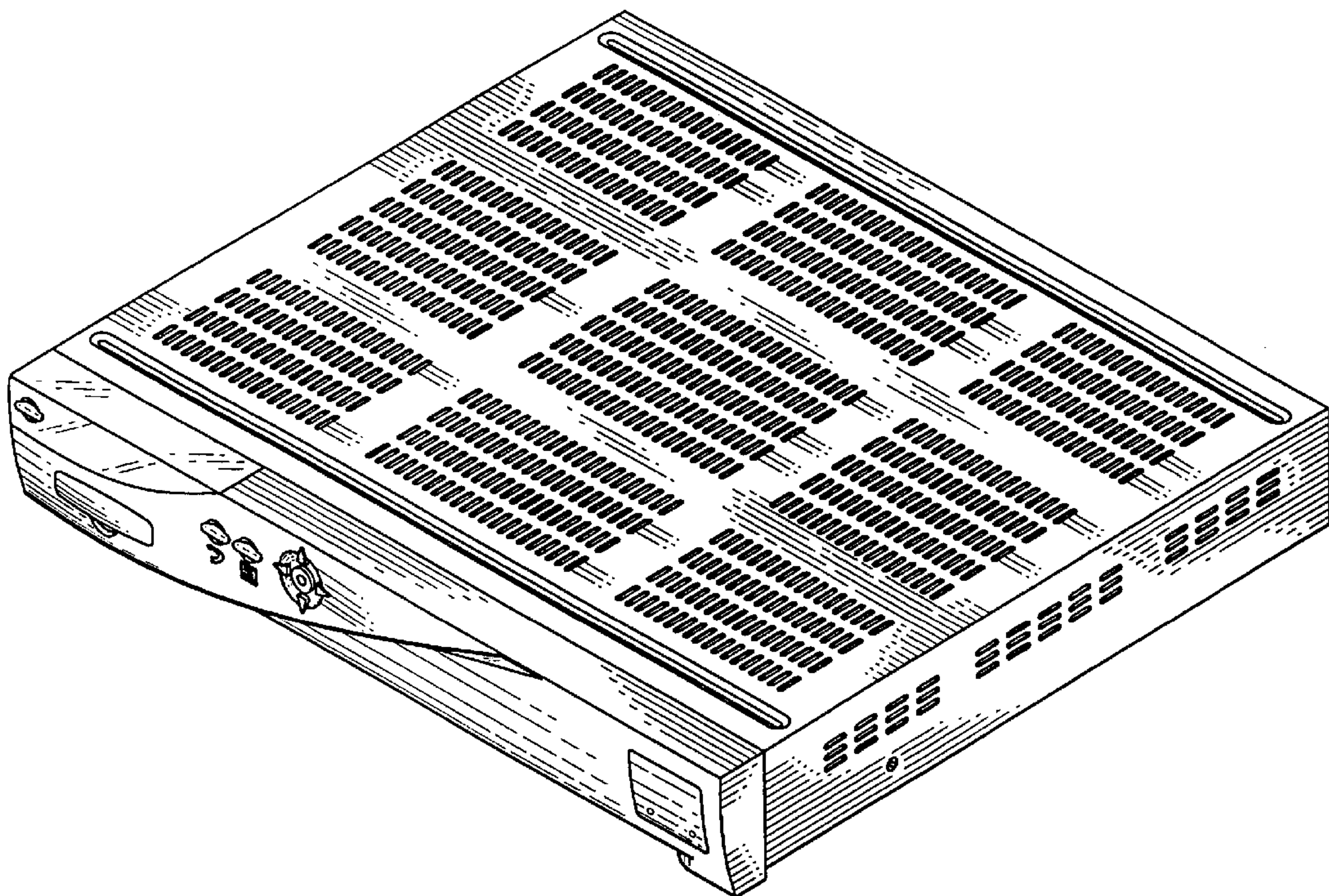
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the integrated receiver/decoder;

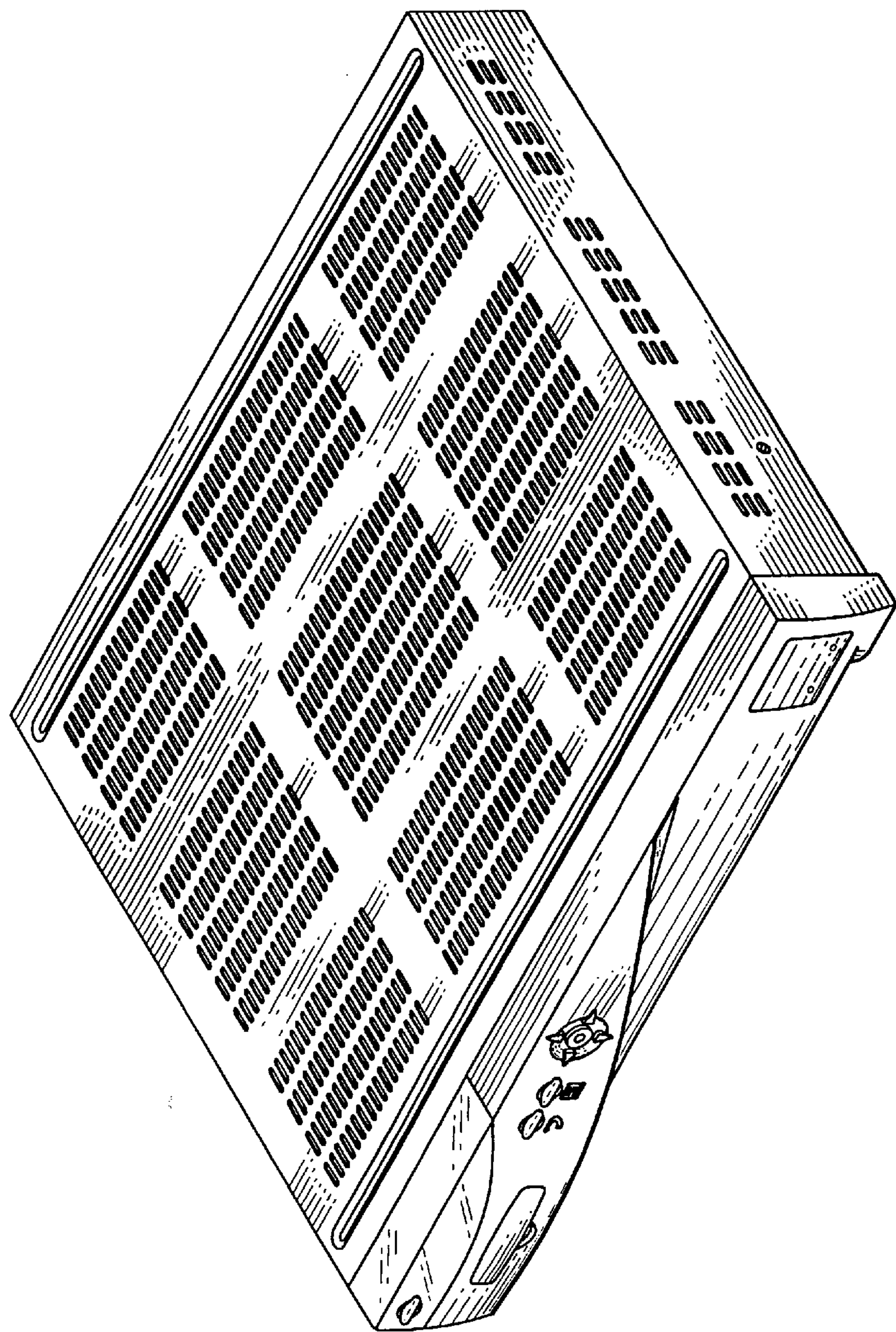

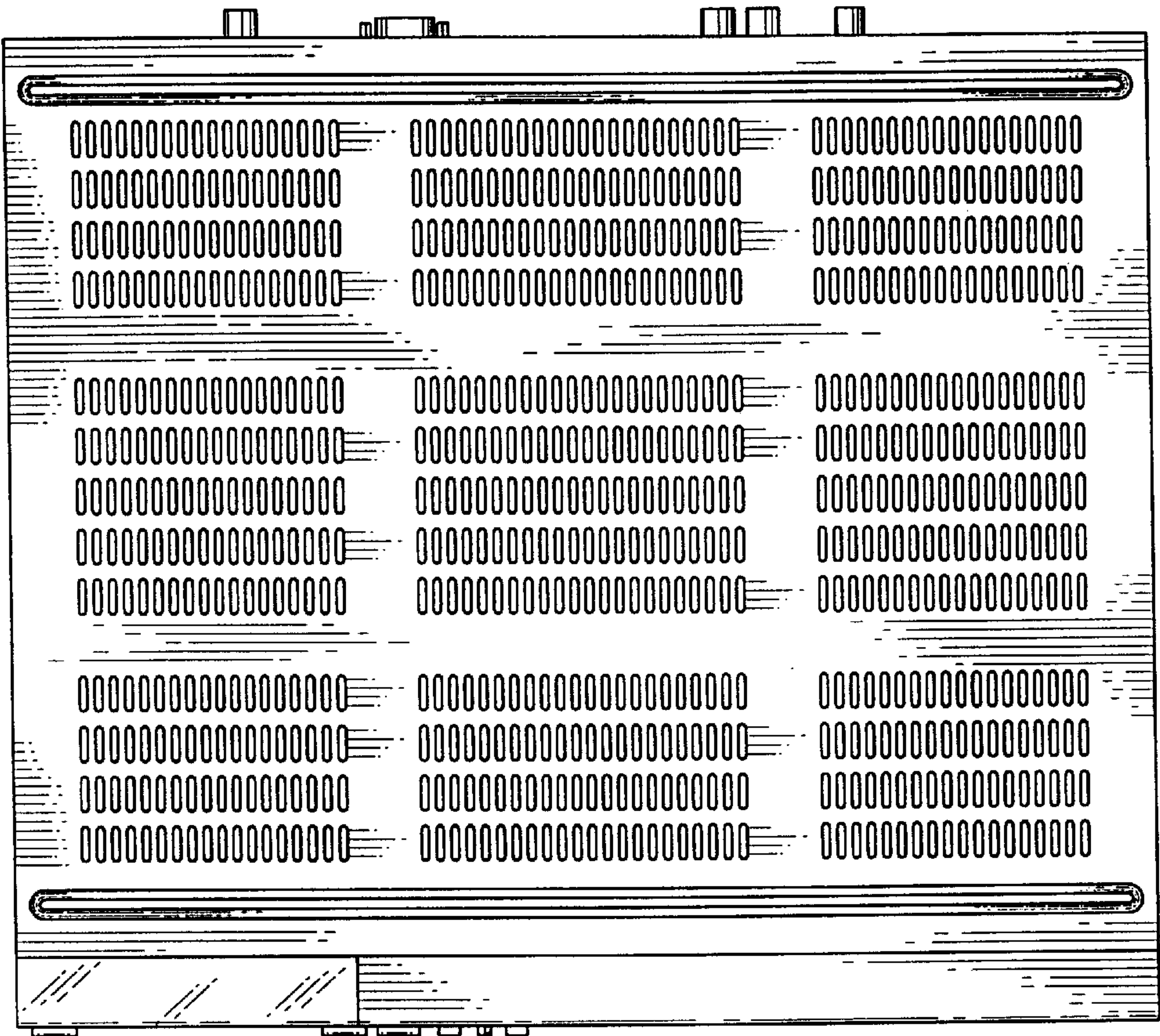

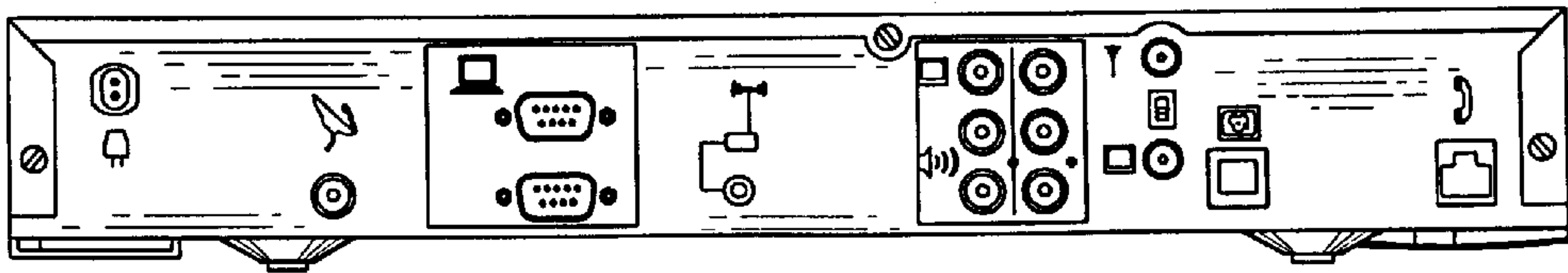

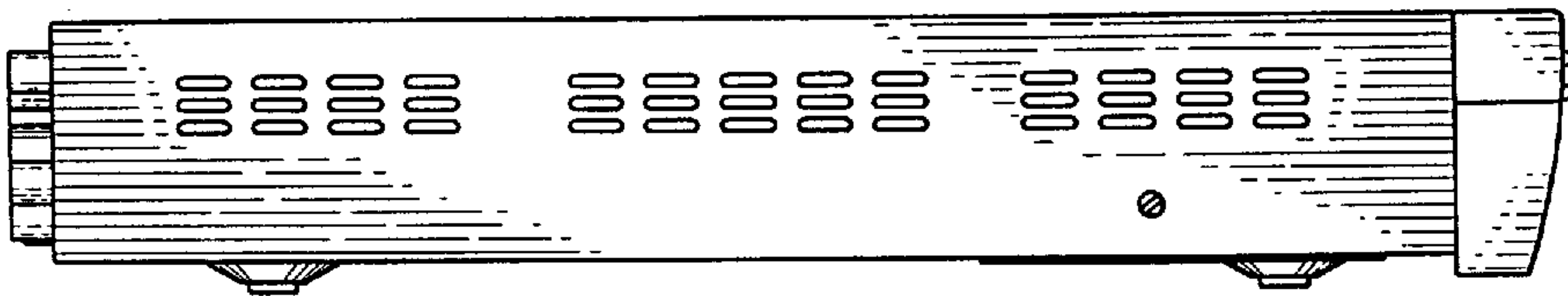

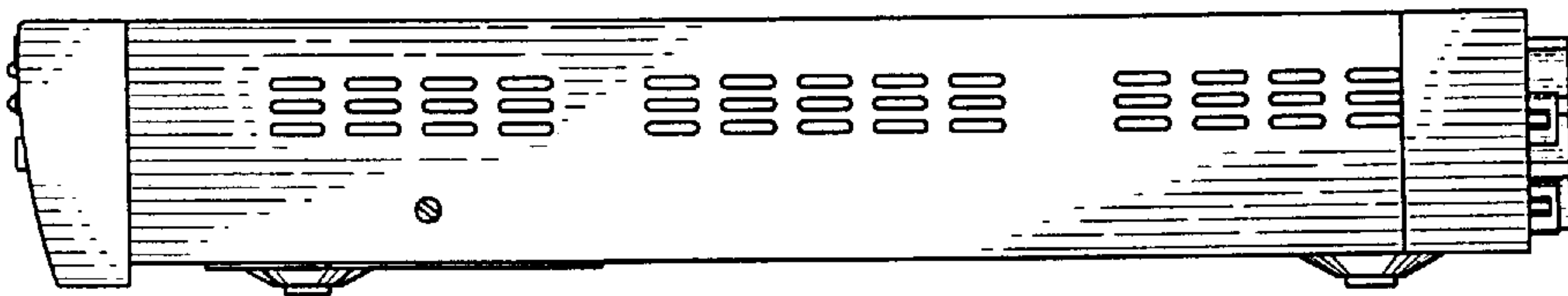

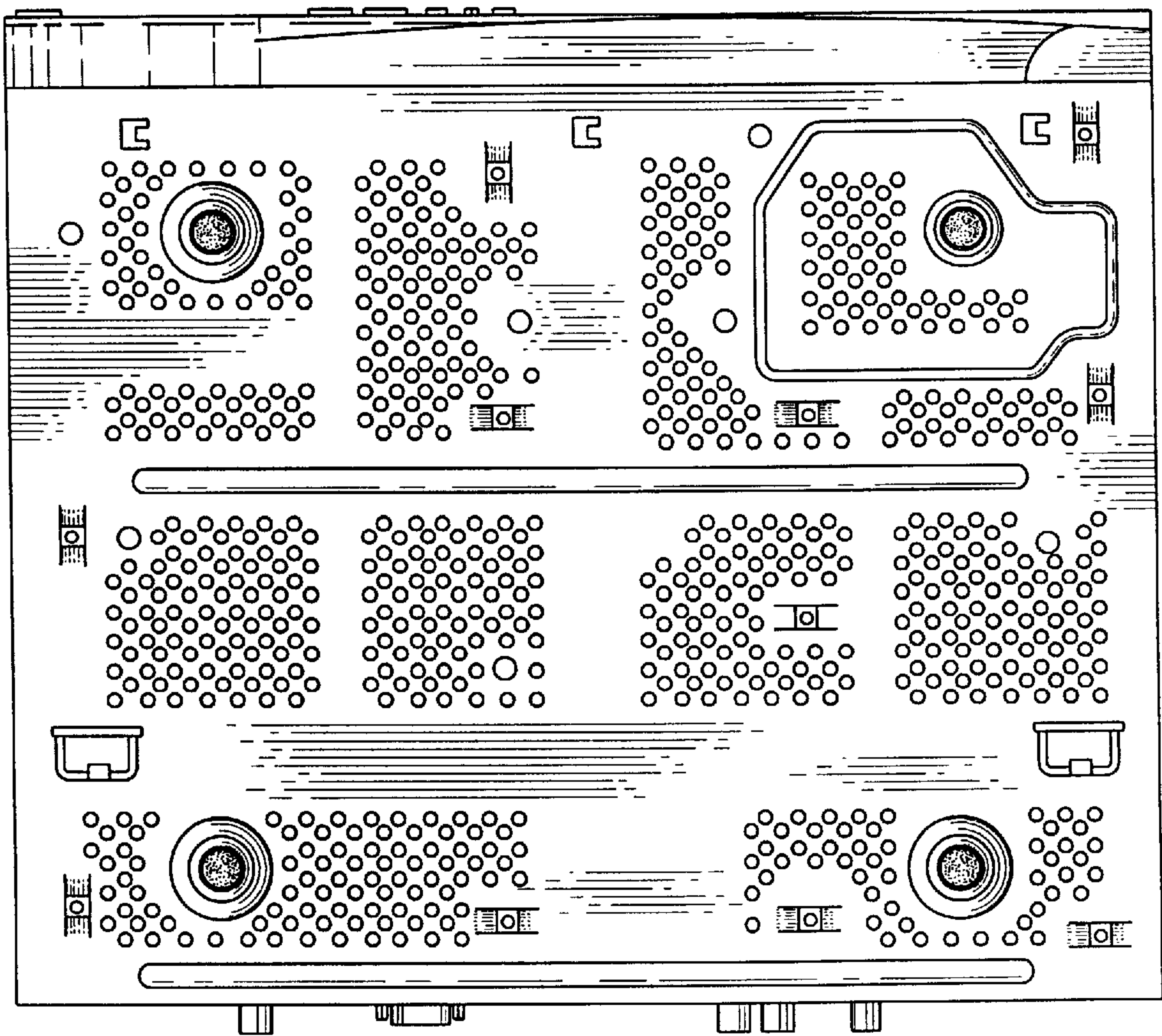

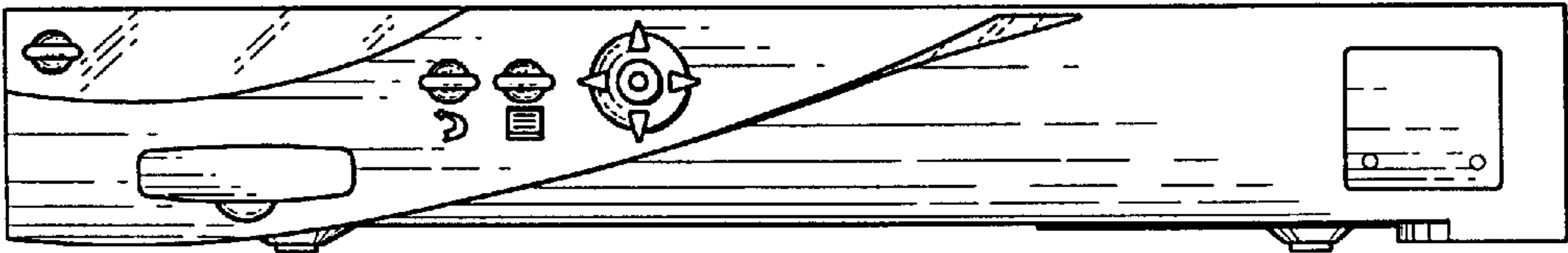

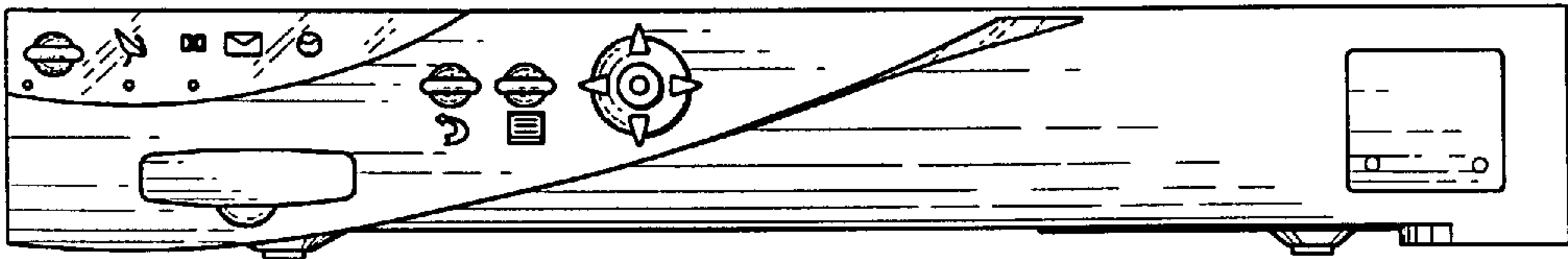
