#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a grandfather clock showing my design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the front side thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from the left side thereof;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the back side thereof;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken from the right side thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line VII—VII of FIG. 4;

FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line VIII—VIII of FIG. 4;

FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line IX—IX of FIG. 4;

FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line X-X of FIG. 4; and,

FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view thereof as taken from line XI—XI of FIG. 4.
















