FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

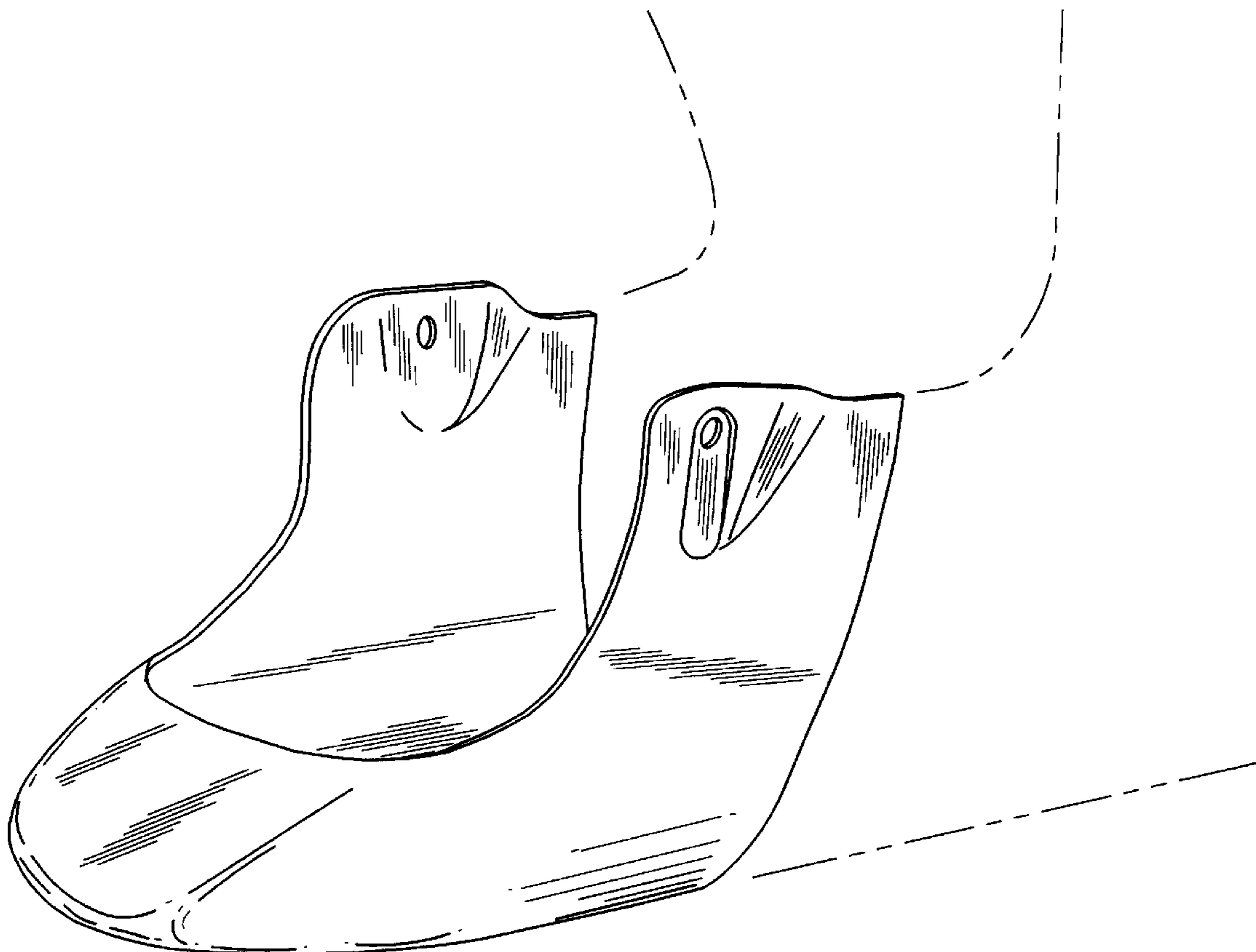
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

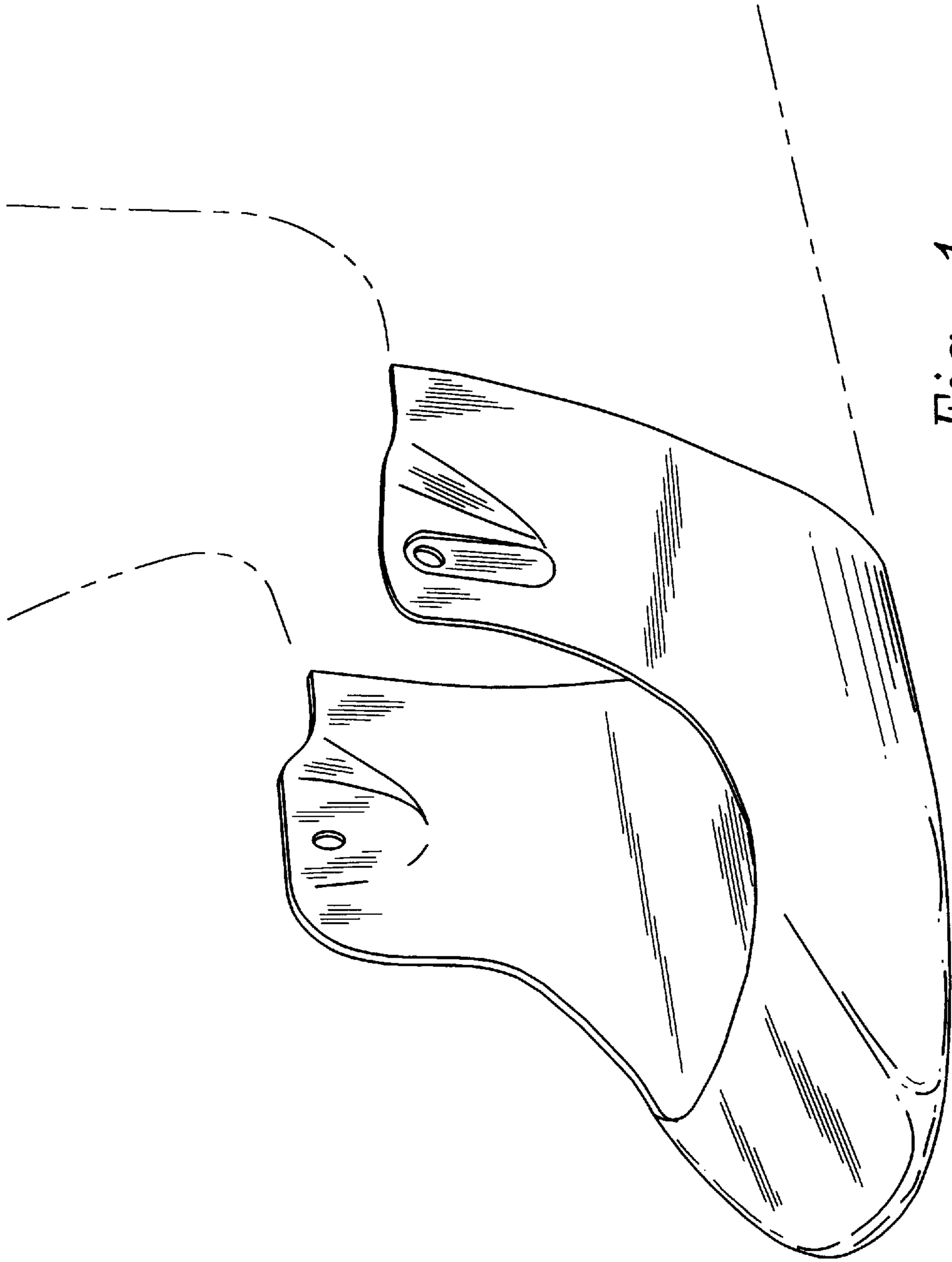
FIG. 6 is a front view thereof; and,

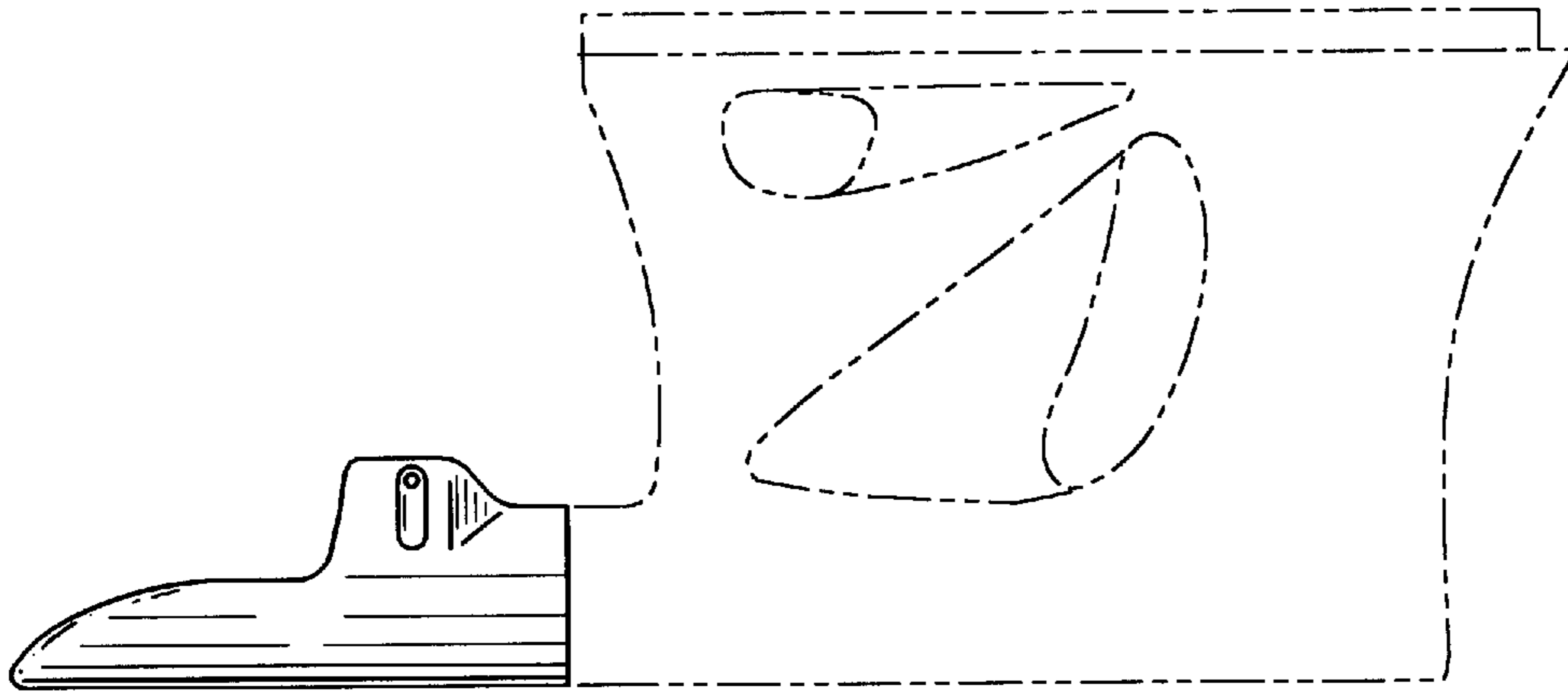

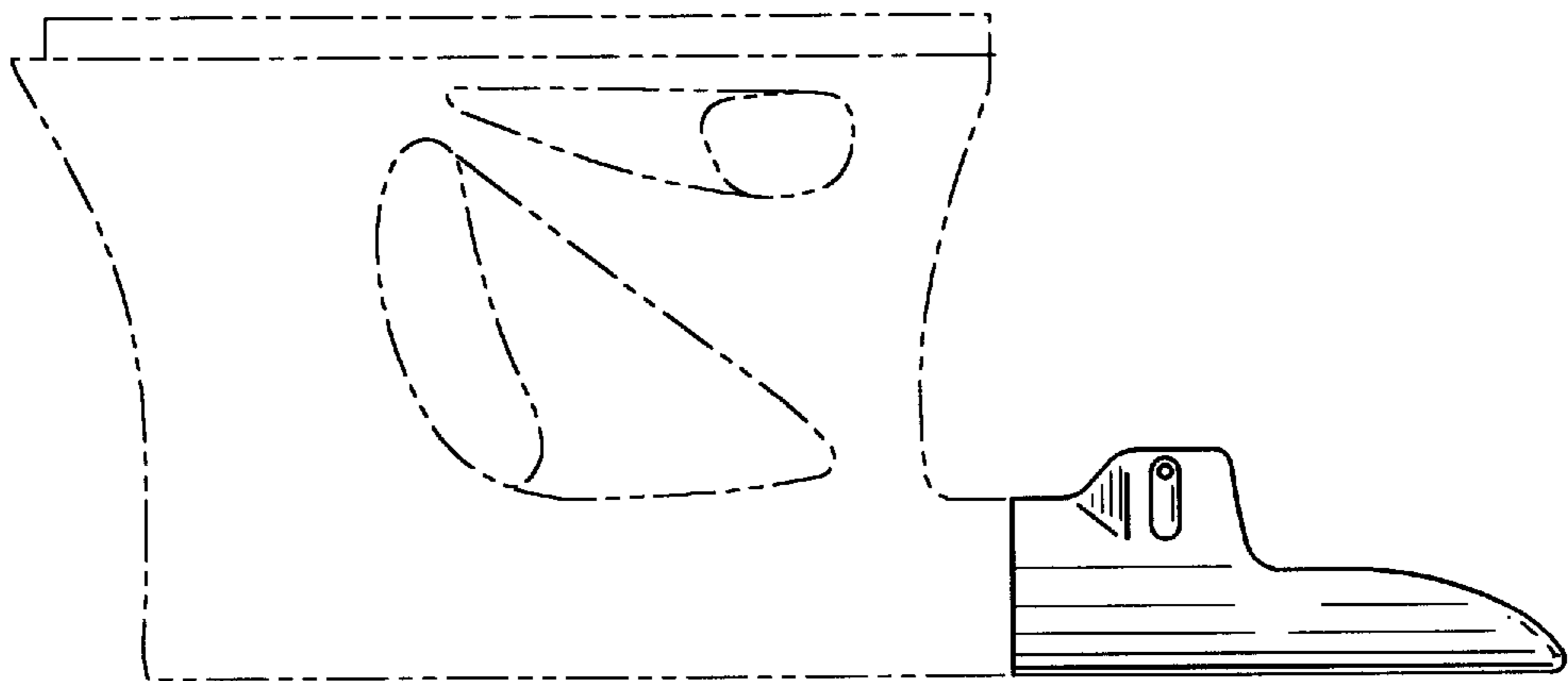

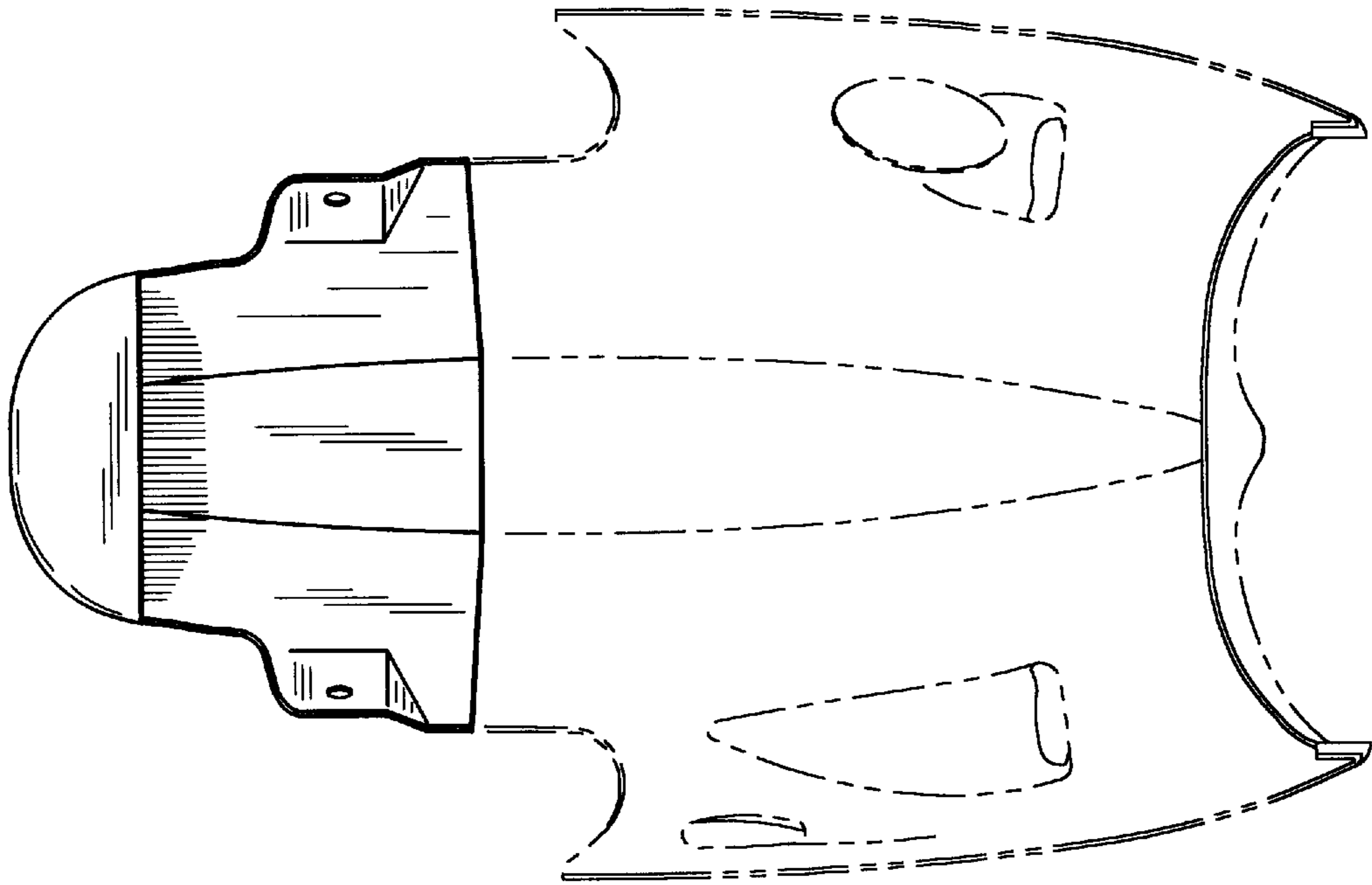

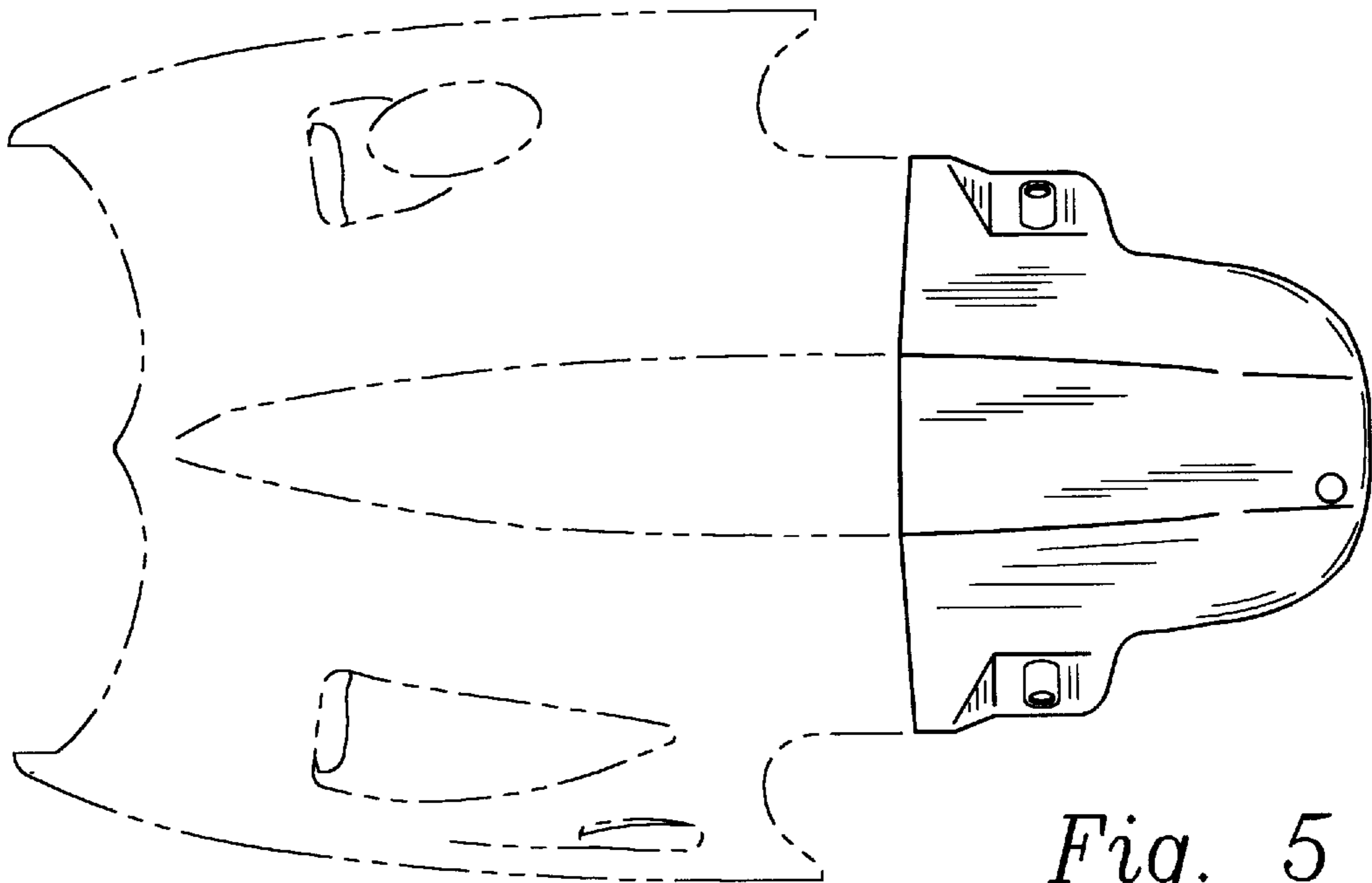

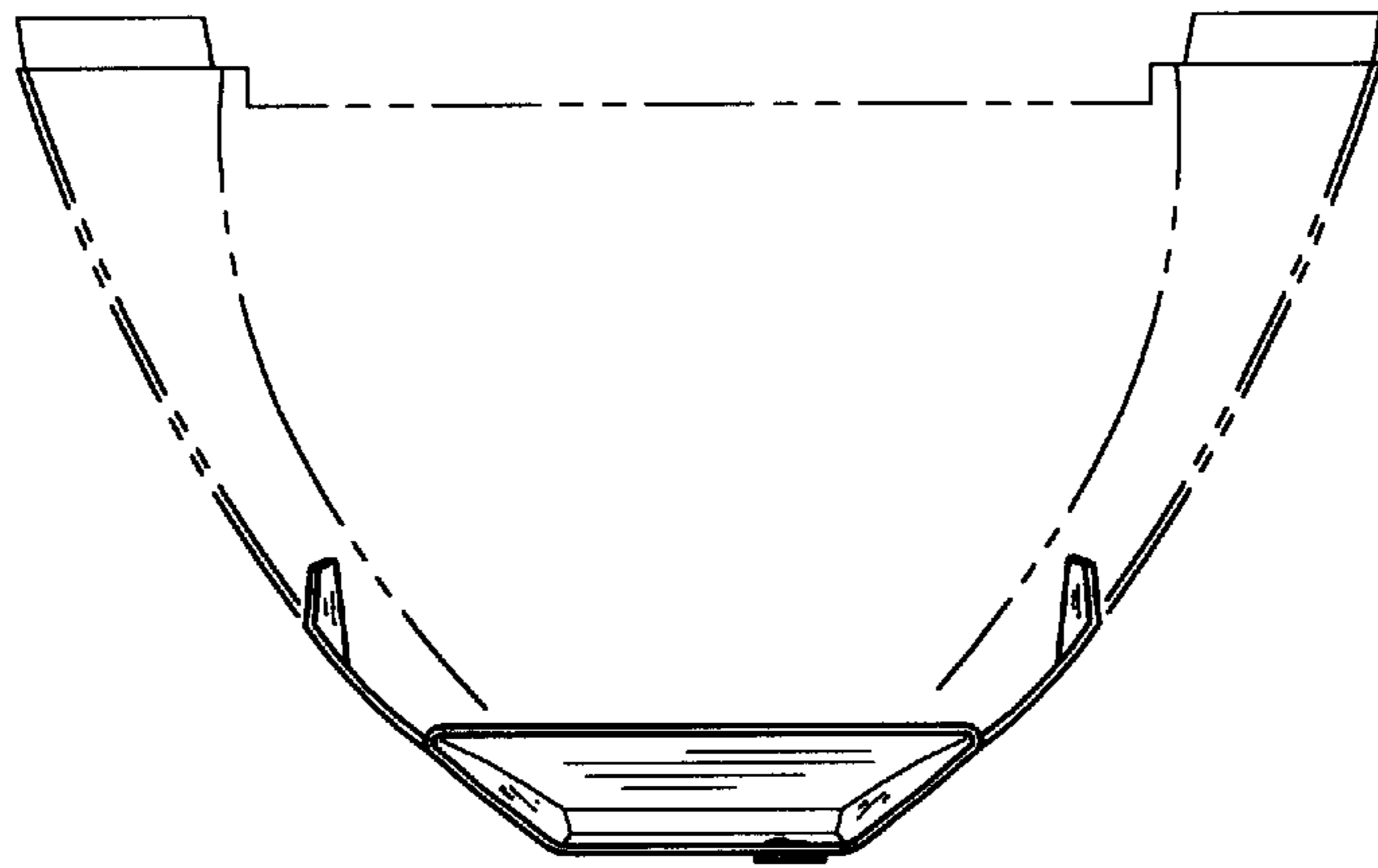

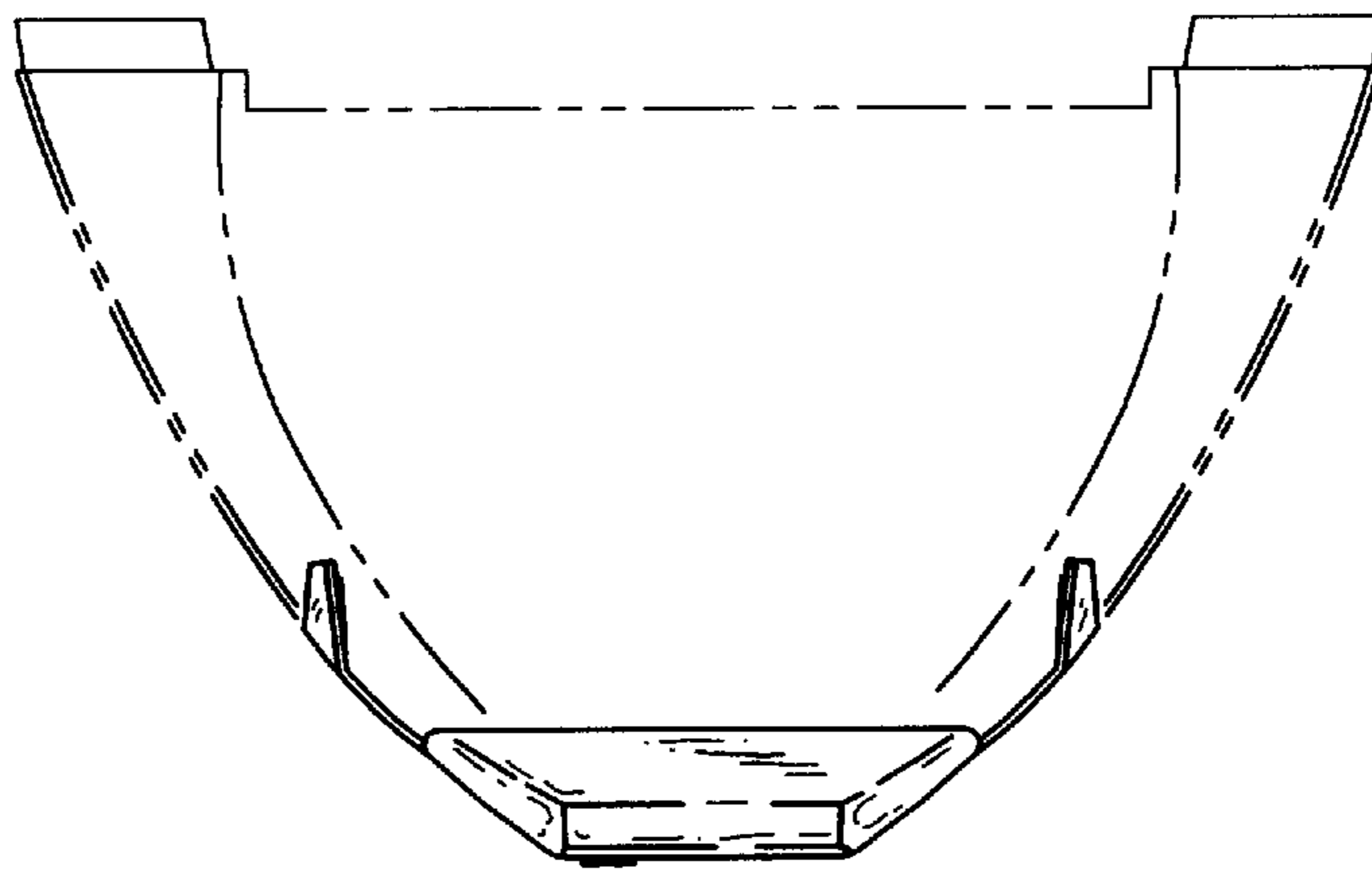
